FIG. 3 is a side elevational view of the teether.

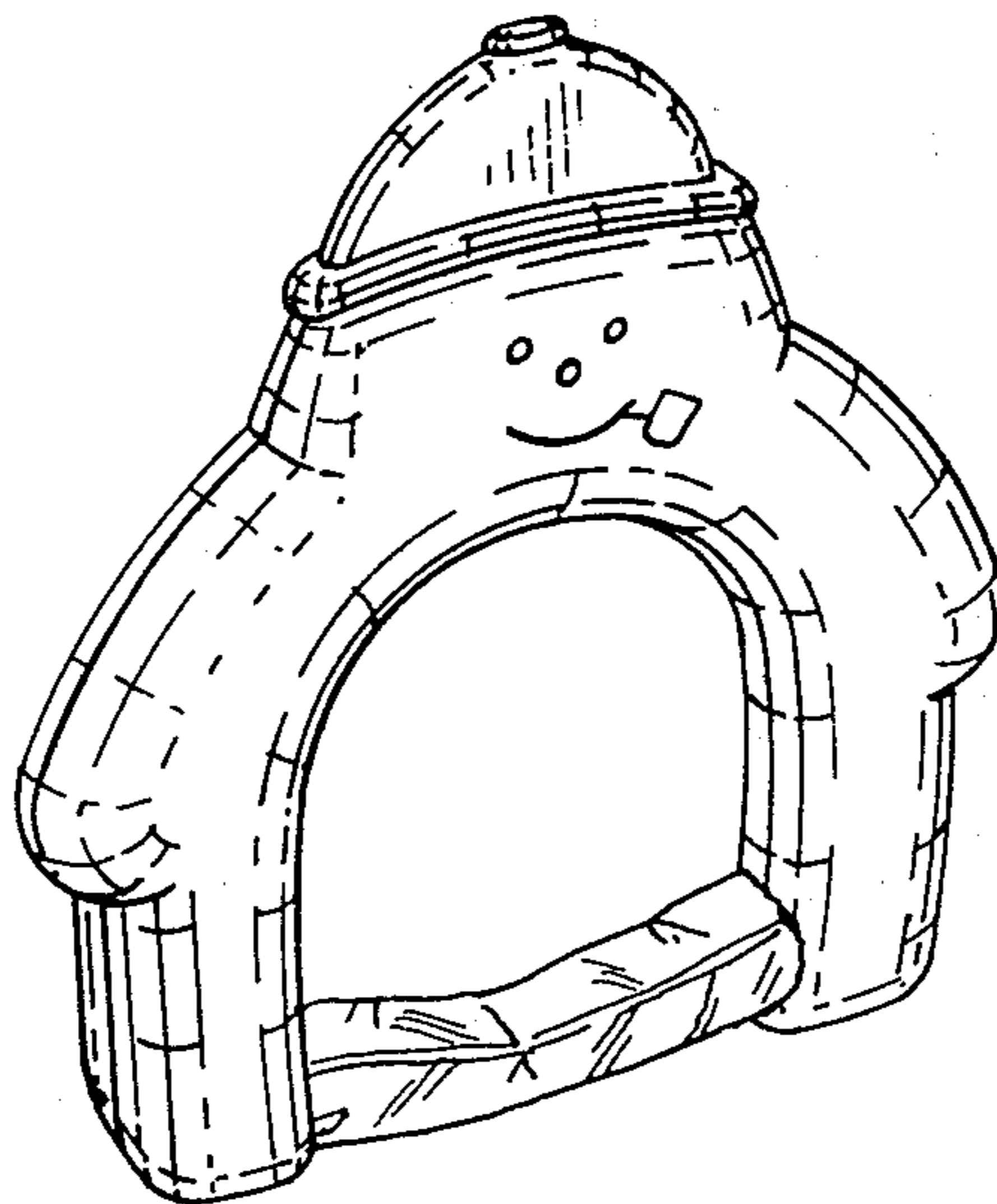

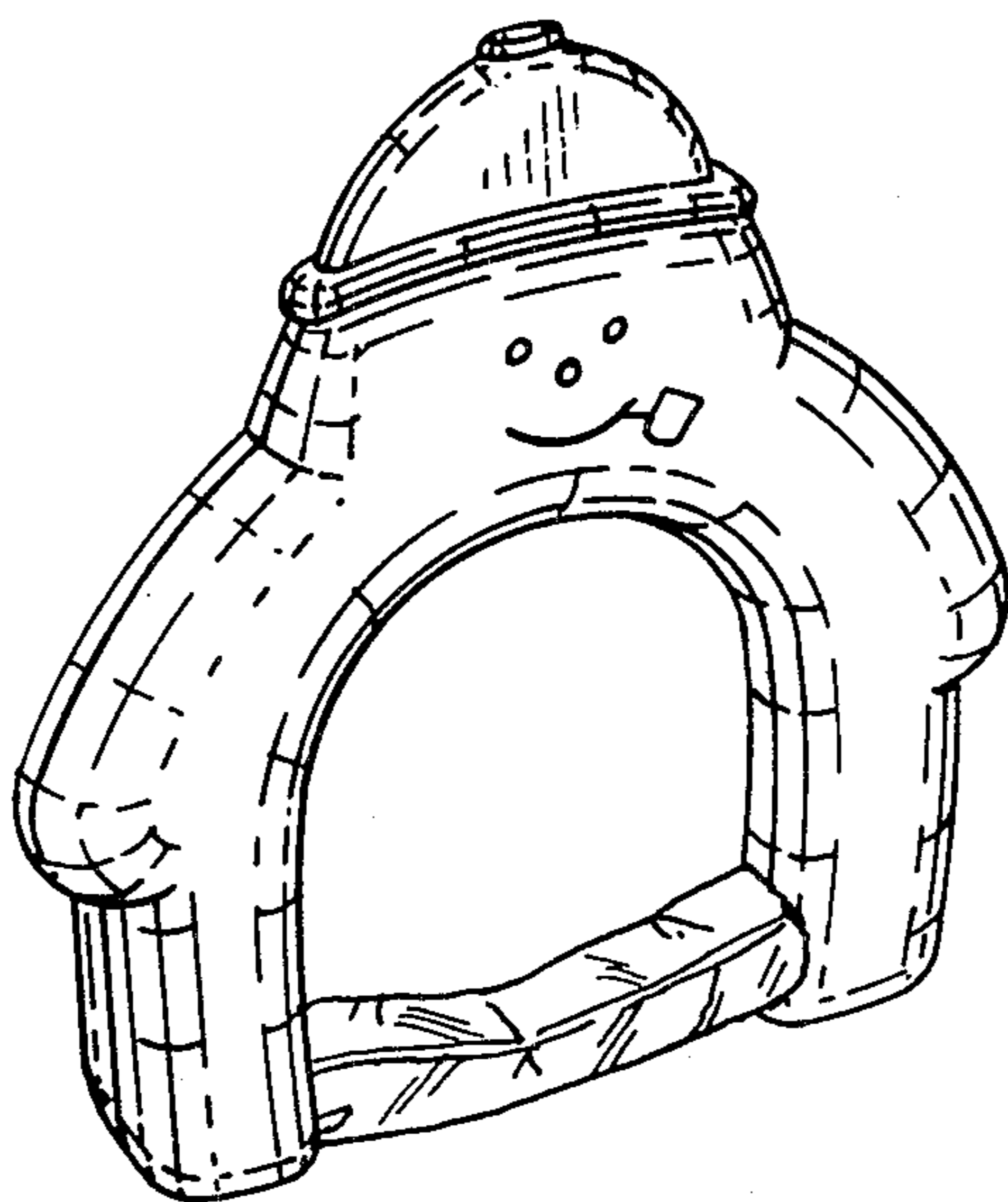

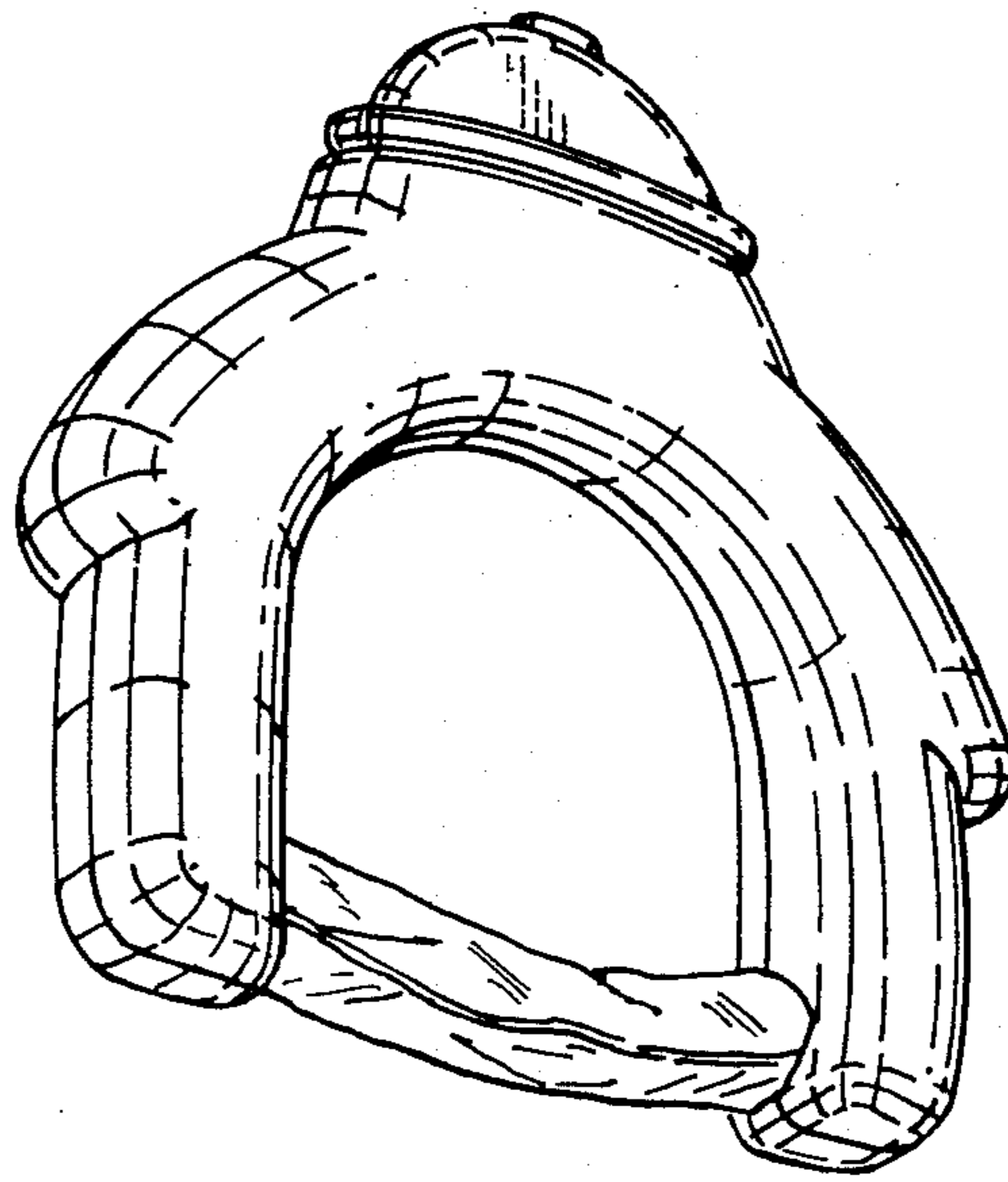
