The ornamental design for a pharmaceutical tablet, as shown and described.

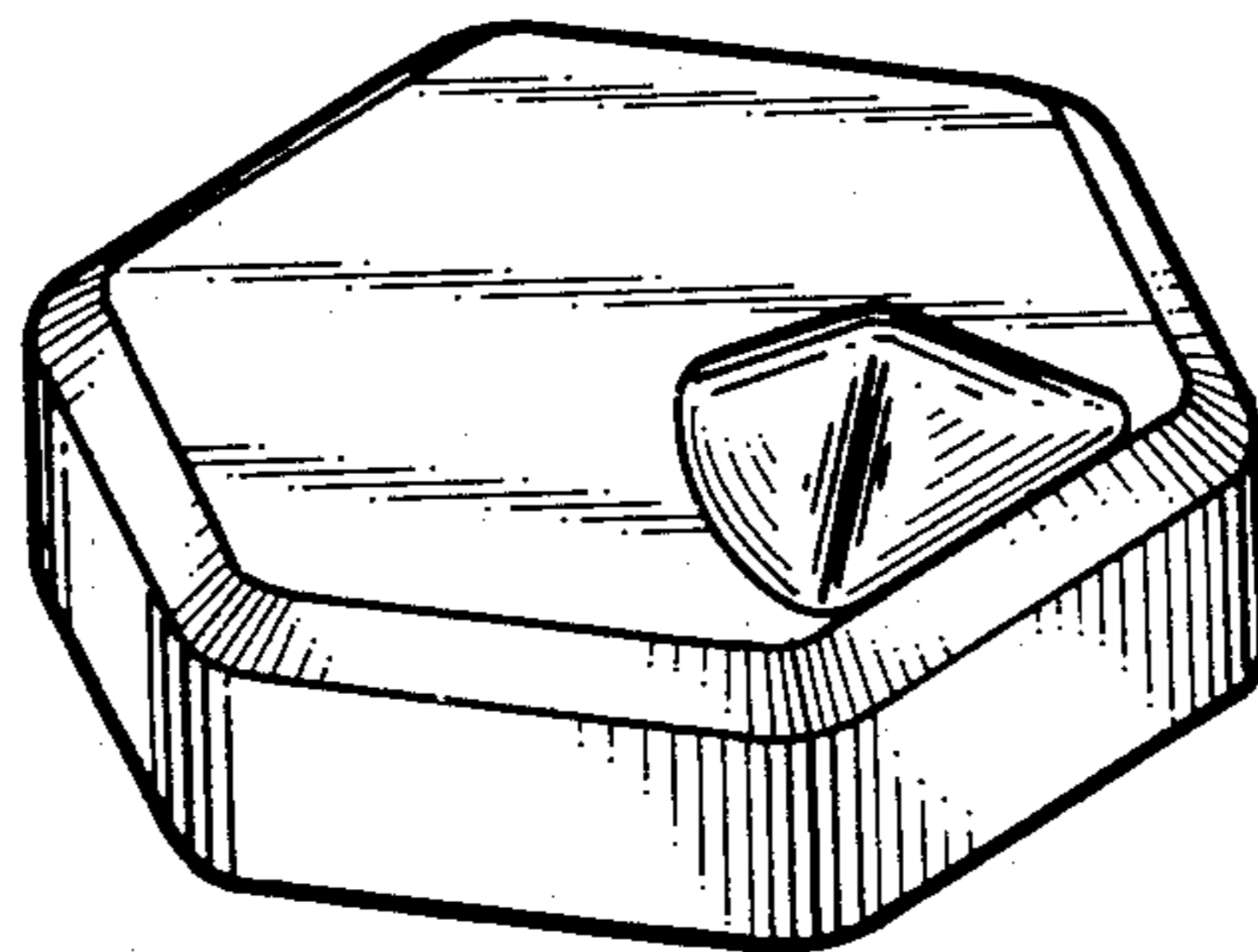
DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a perspective view from above and one side of a pharmaceutical tablet showing my design;

FIG. 2 is a top plan view thereof, the bottom view being a mirror image of that shown;

FIG. 3 is a side elevational view thereof, the opposite side being a mirror image of that shown;

FIG. 4 is an end elevation view thereof, the opposite end being a mirror image of that shown.



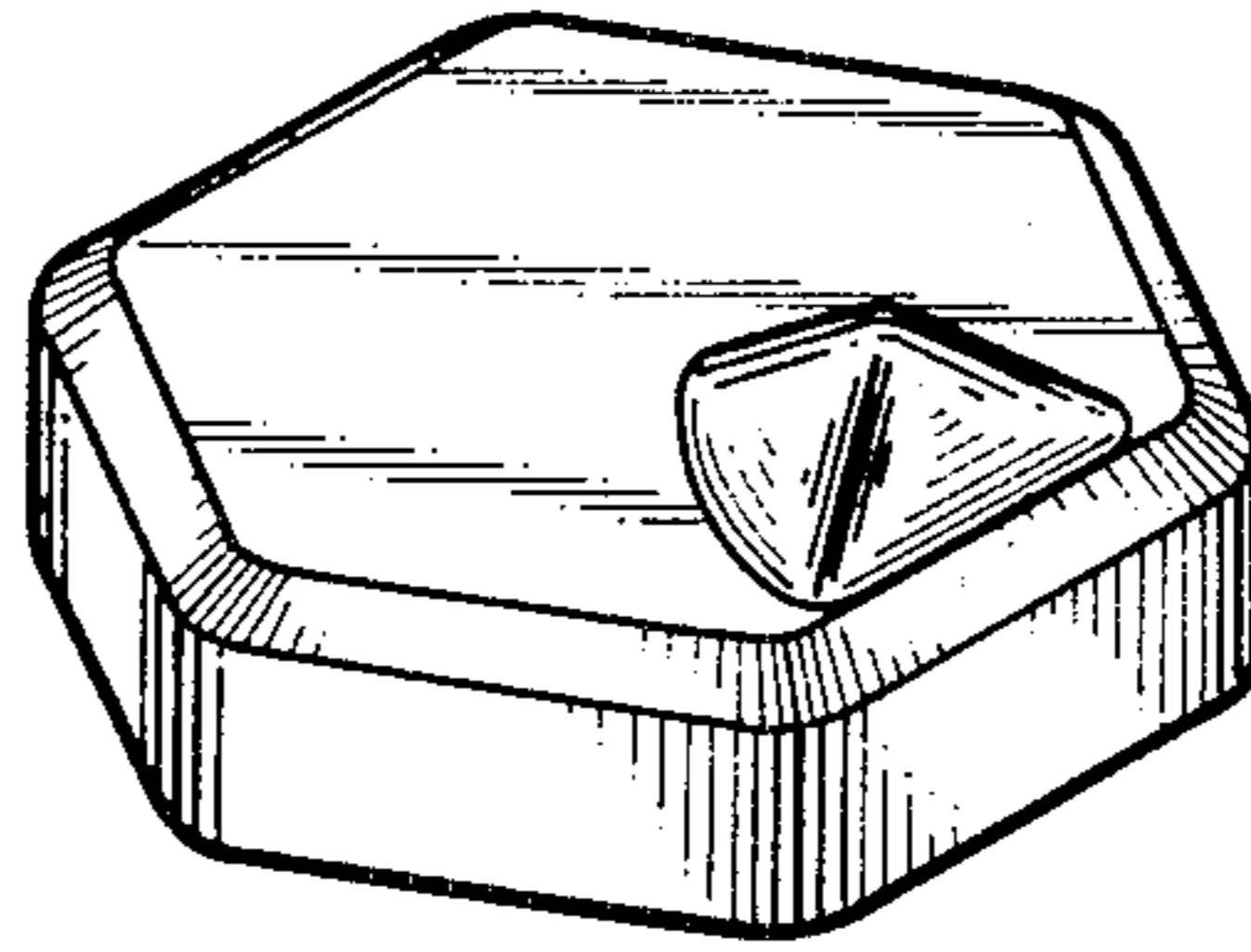

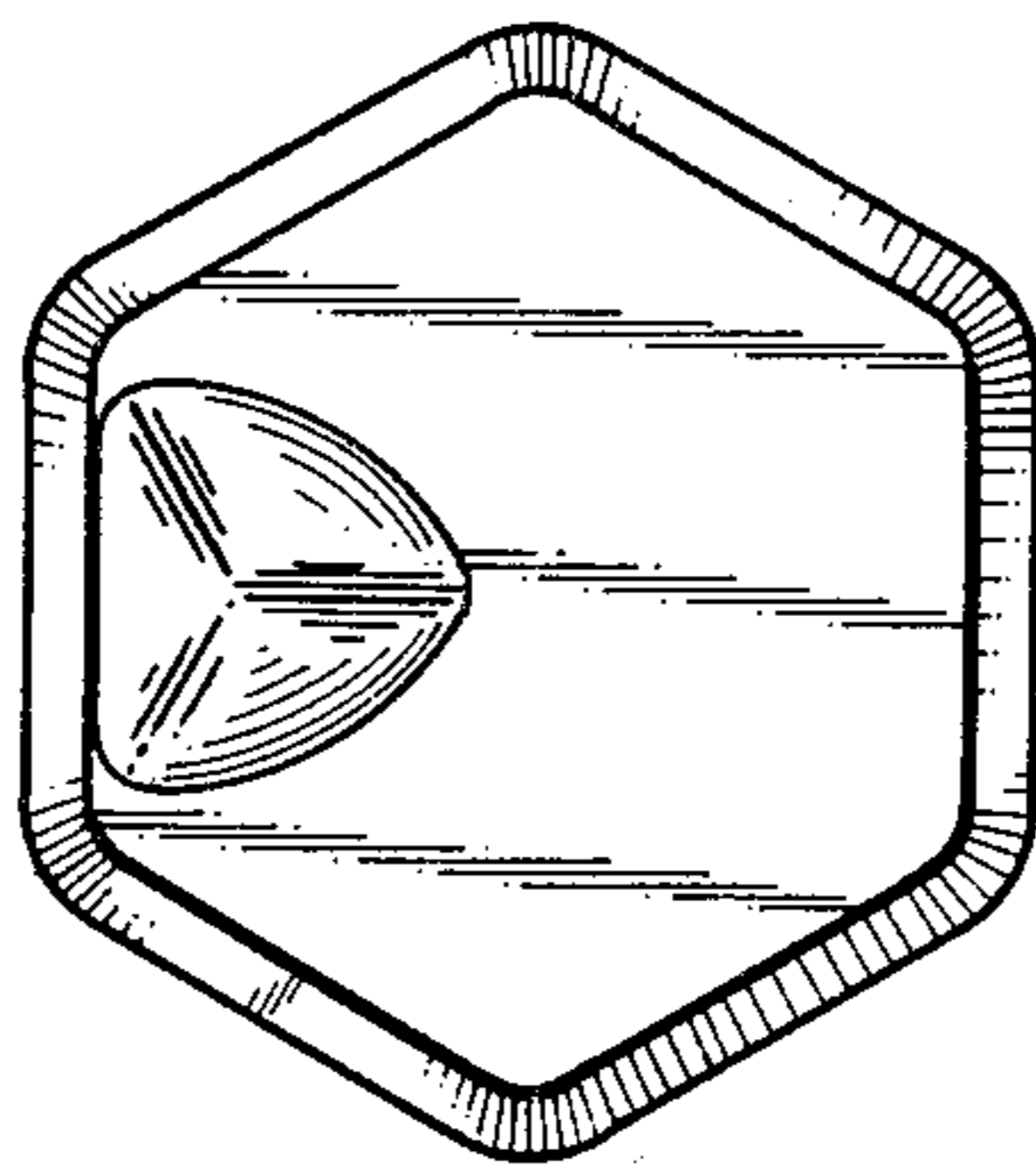

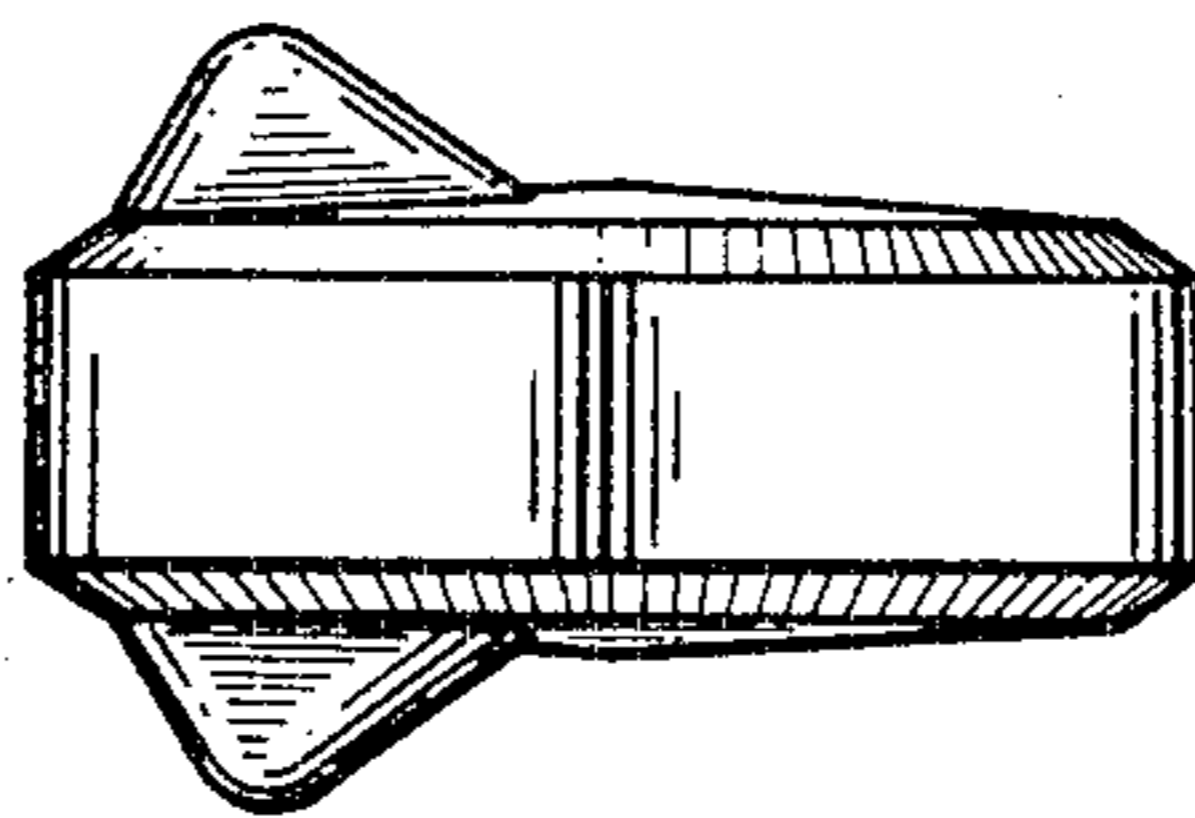

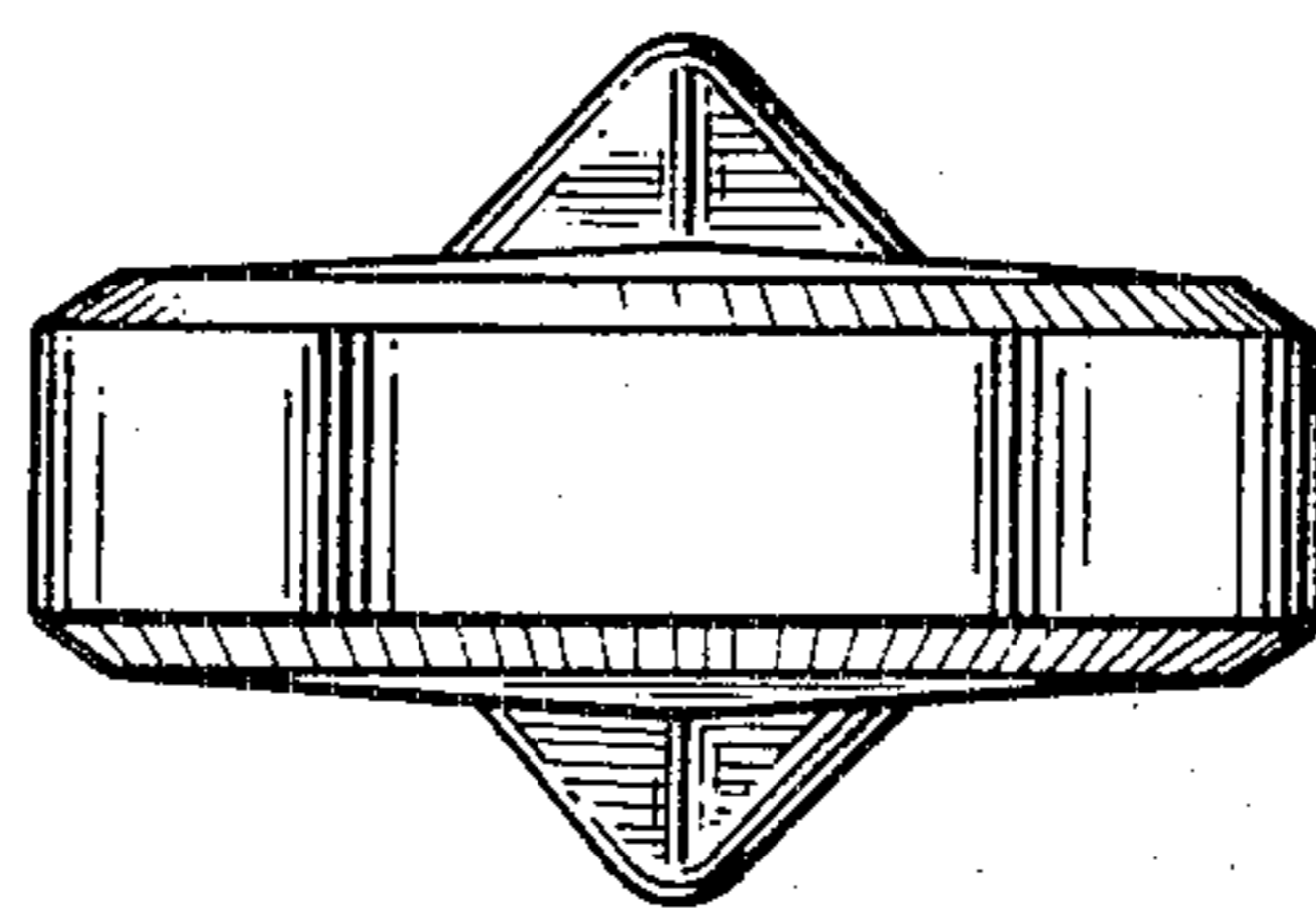
