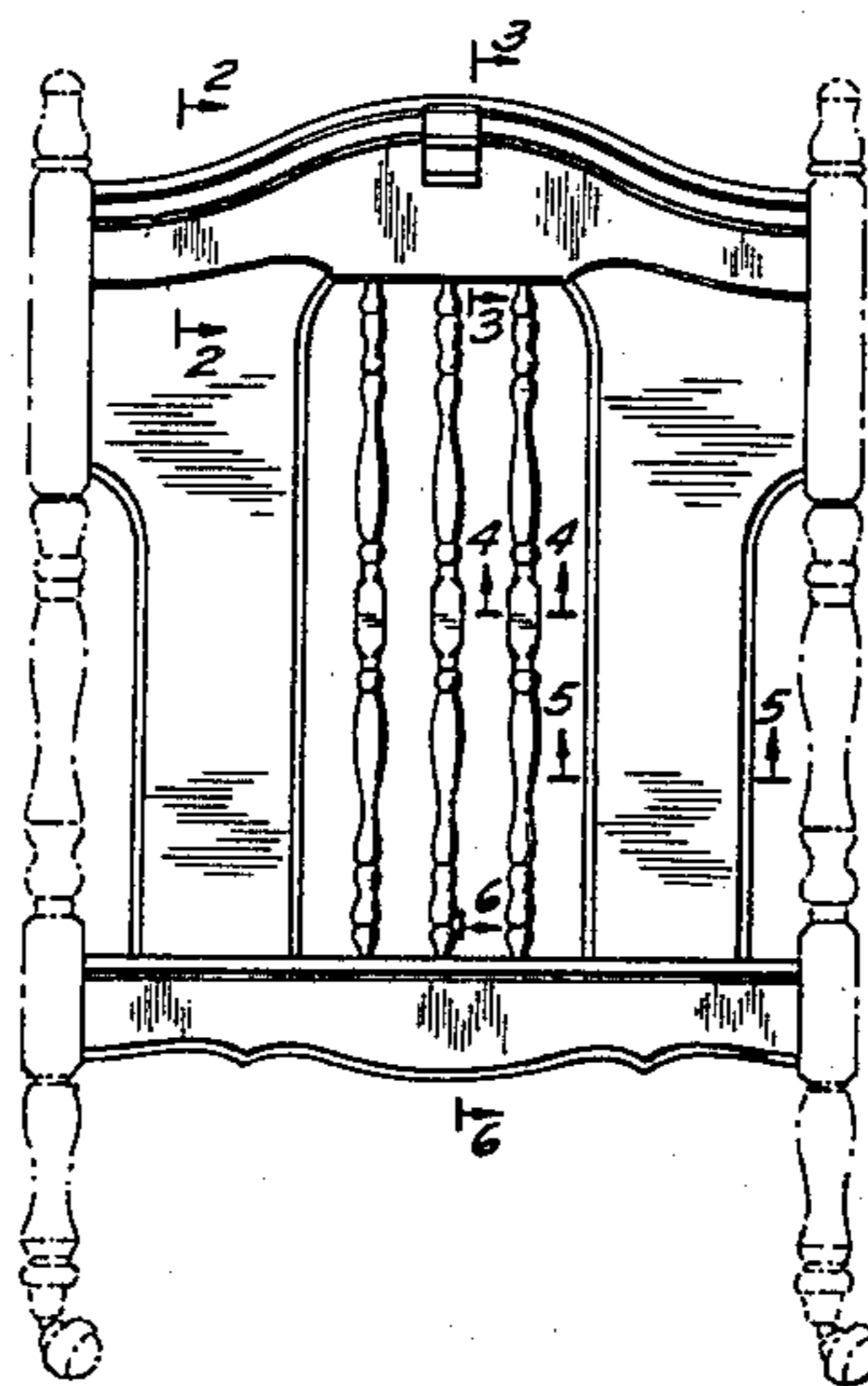

The undisclosed rear surface of the panel is conventional in appearance.



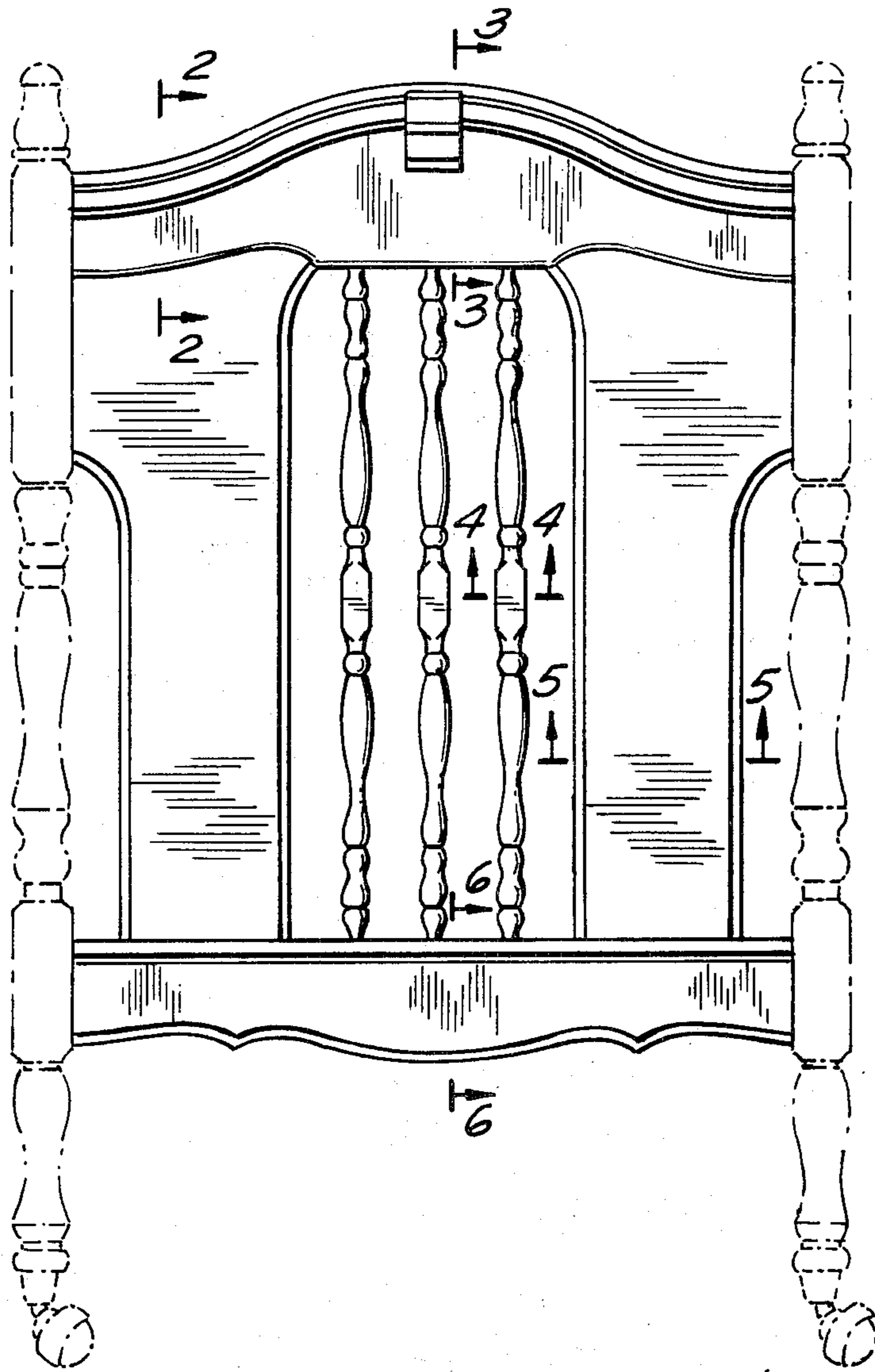

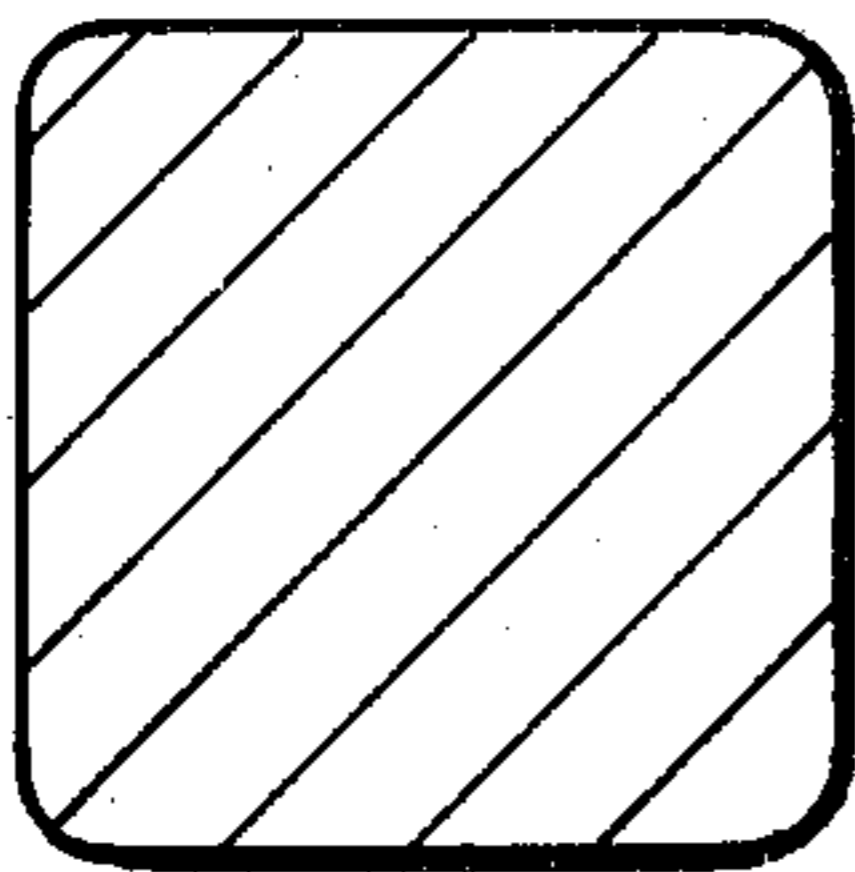

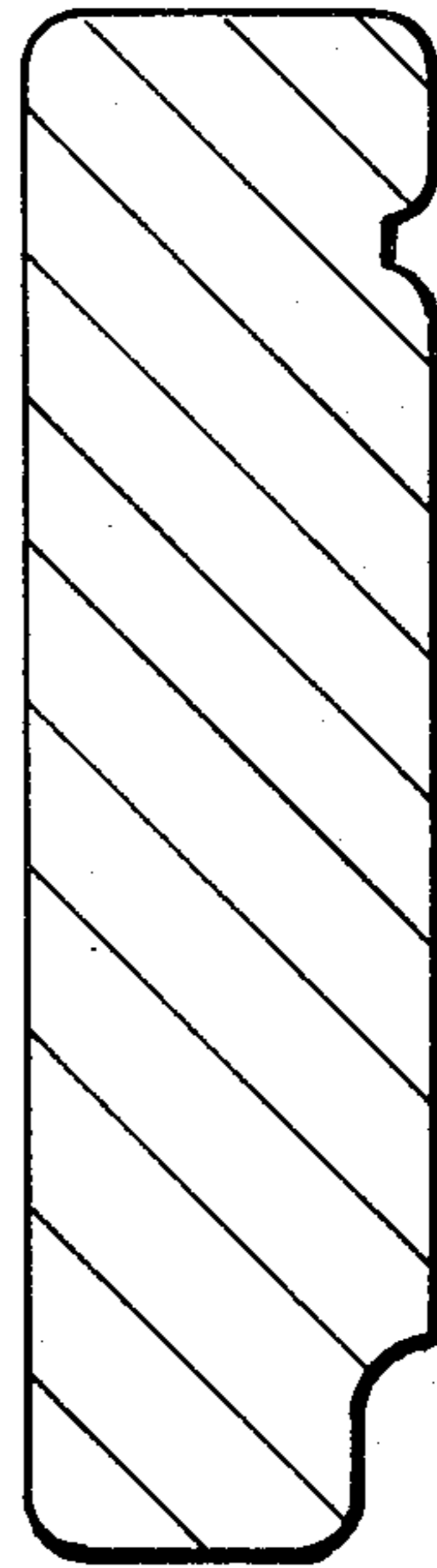

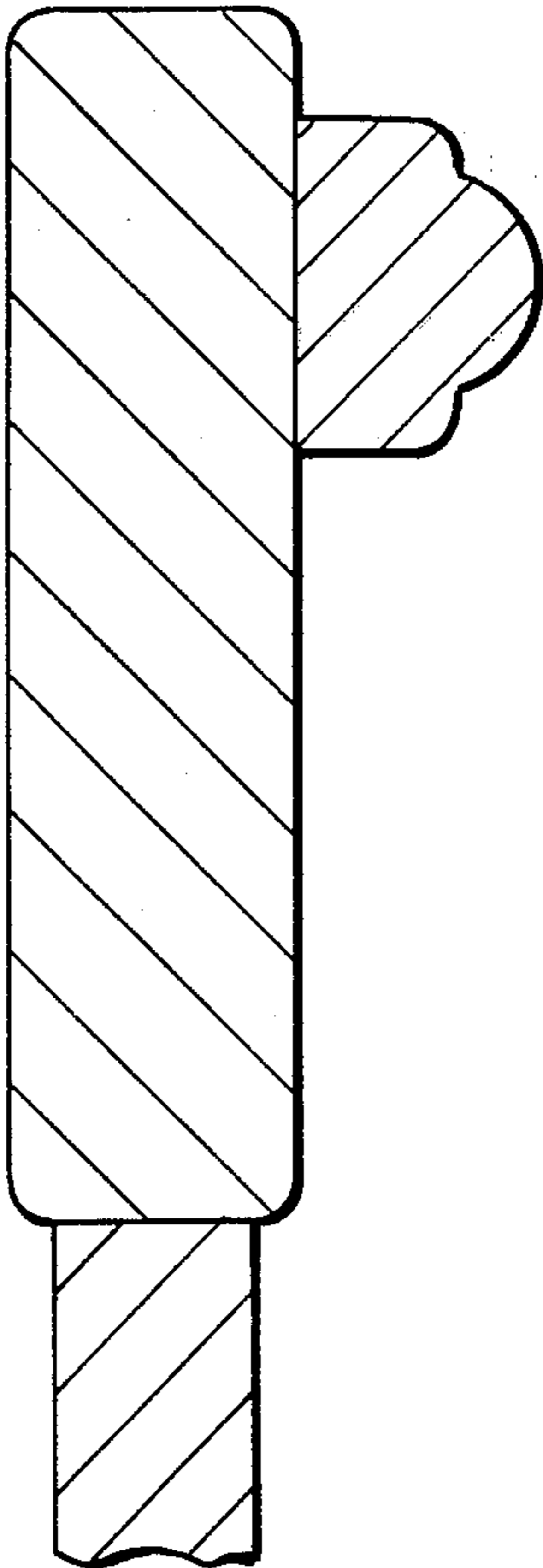

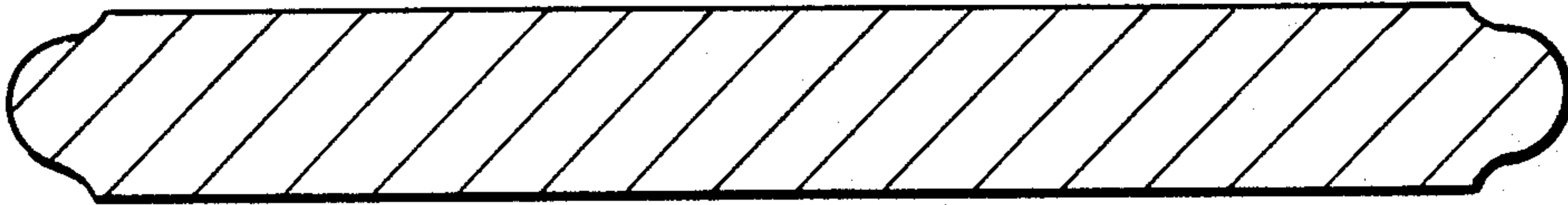
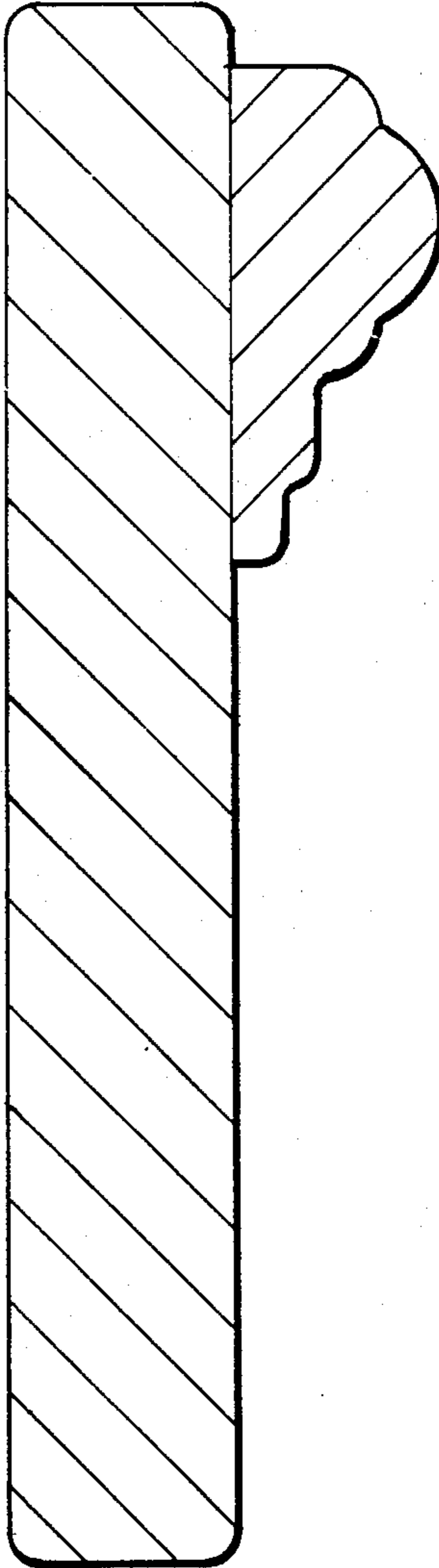
