[57] The ornamental design for a tureen, as shown and described.

DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a top plan view of a tureen showing my new design;
FIG. 2 is a front elevational view thereof, the rear view is identical thereto;
FIG. 3 is a side elevational view thereof, the side opposite is identical thereto; and,
FIG. 4 is a bottom plan view thereof.

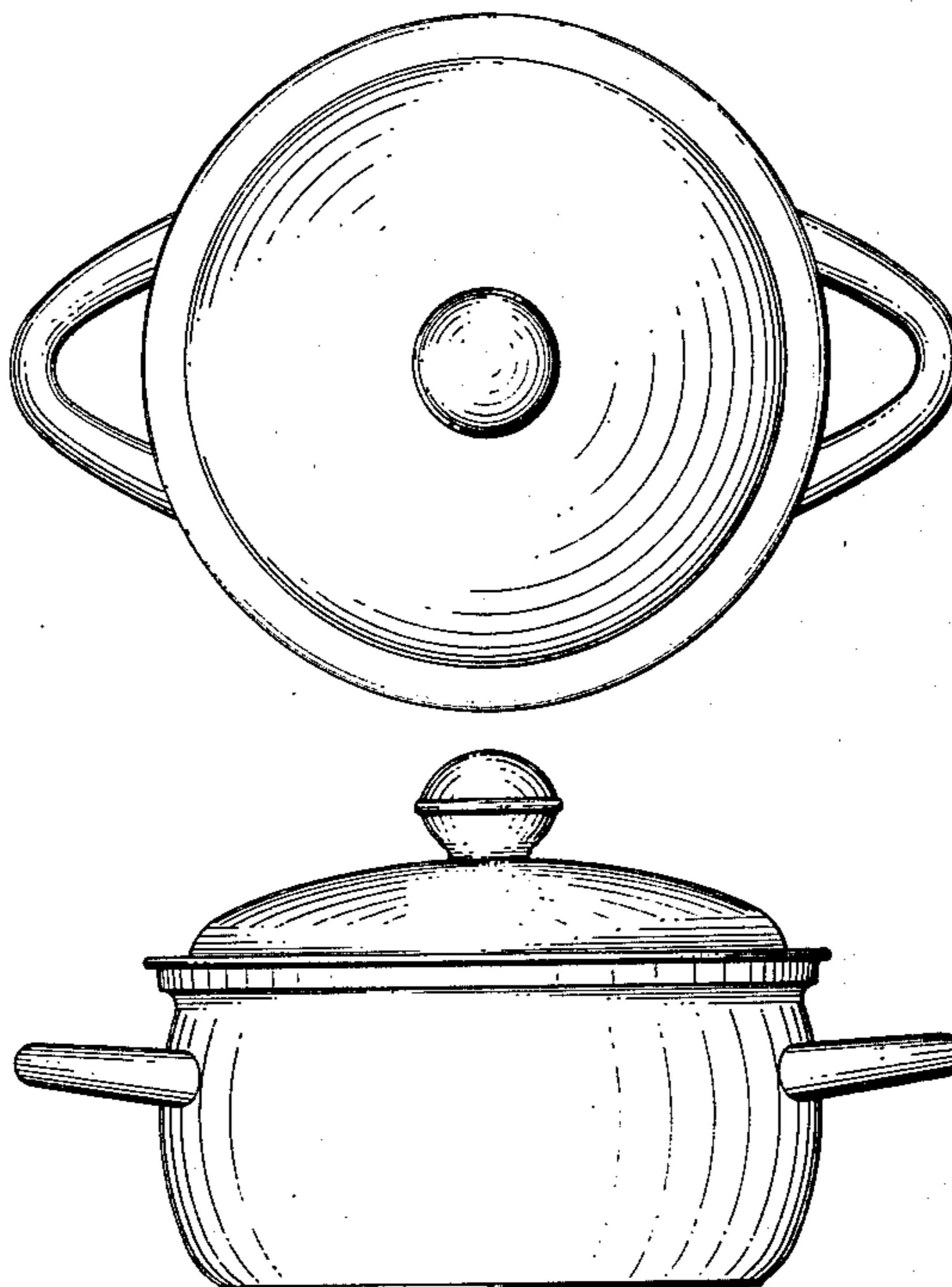

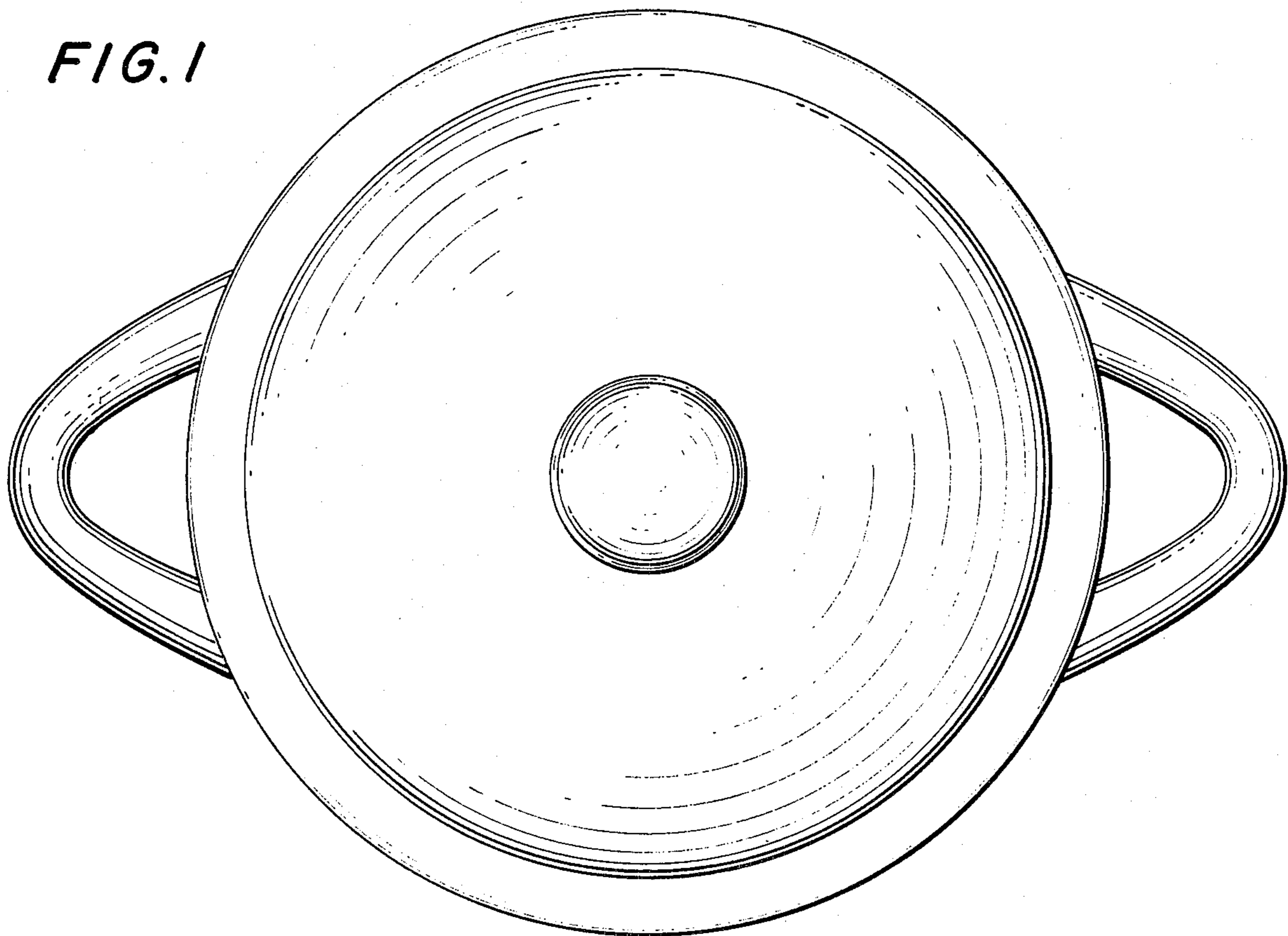

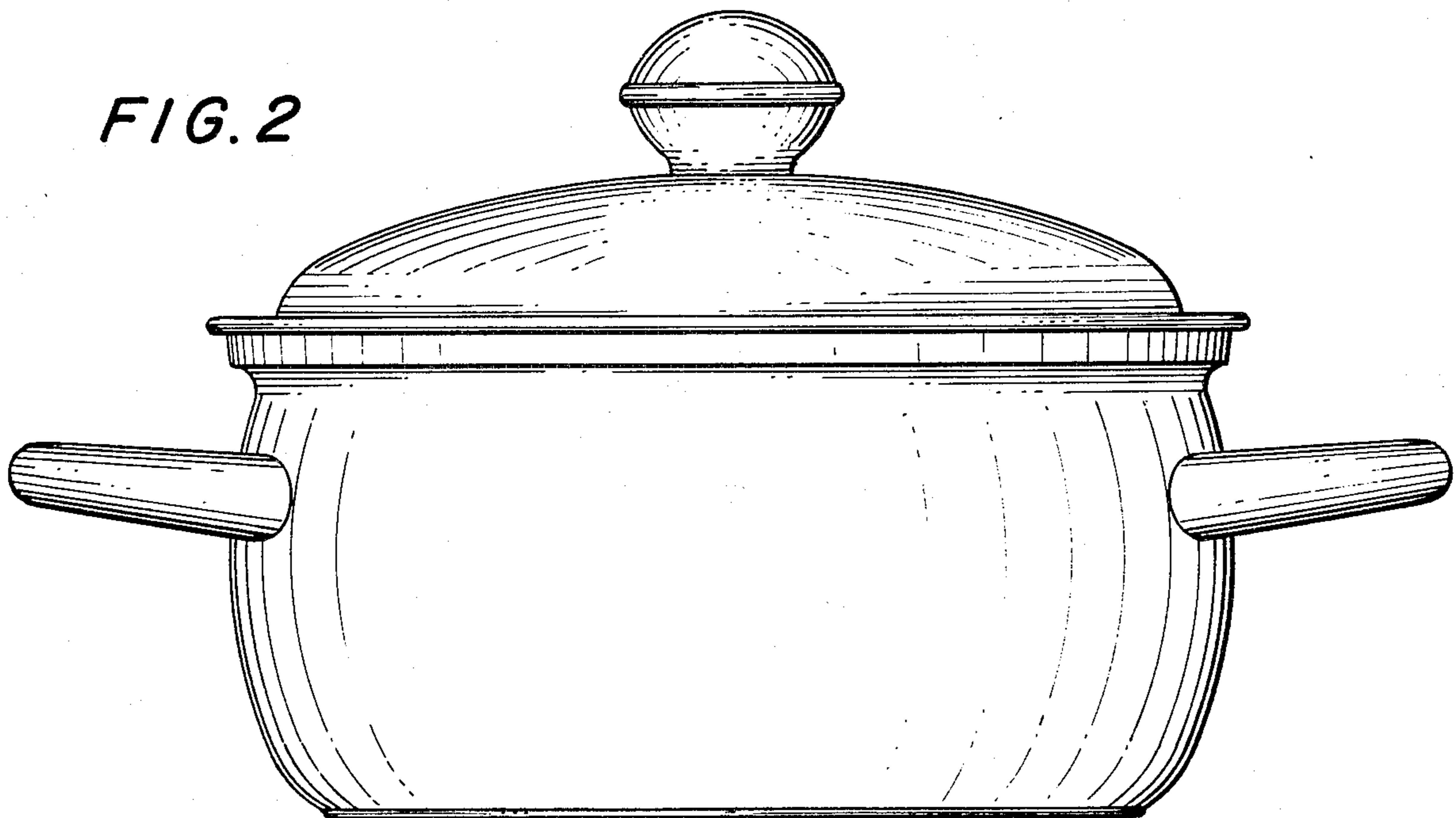

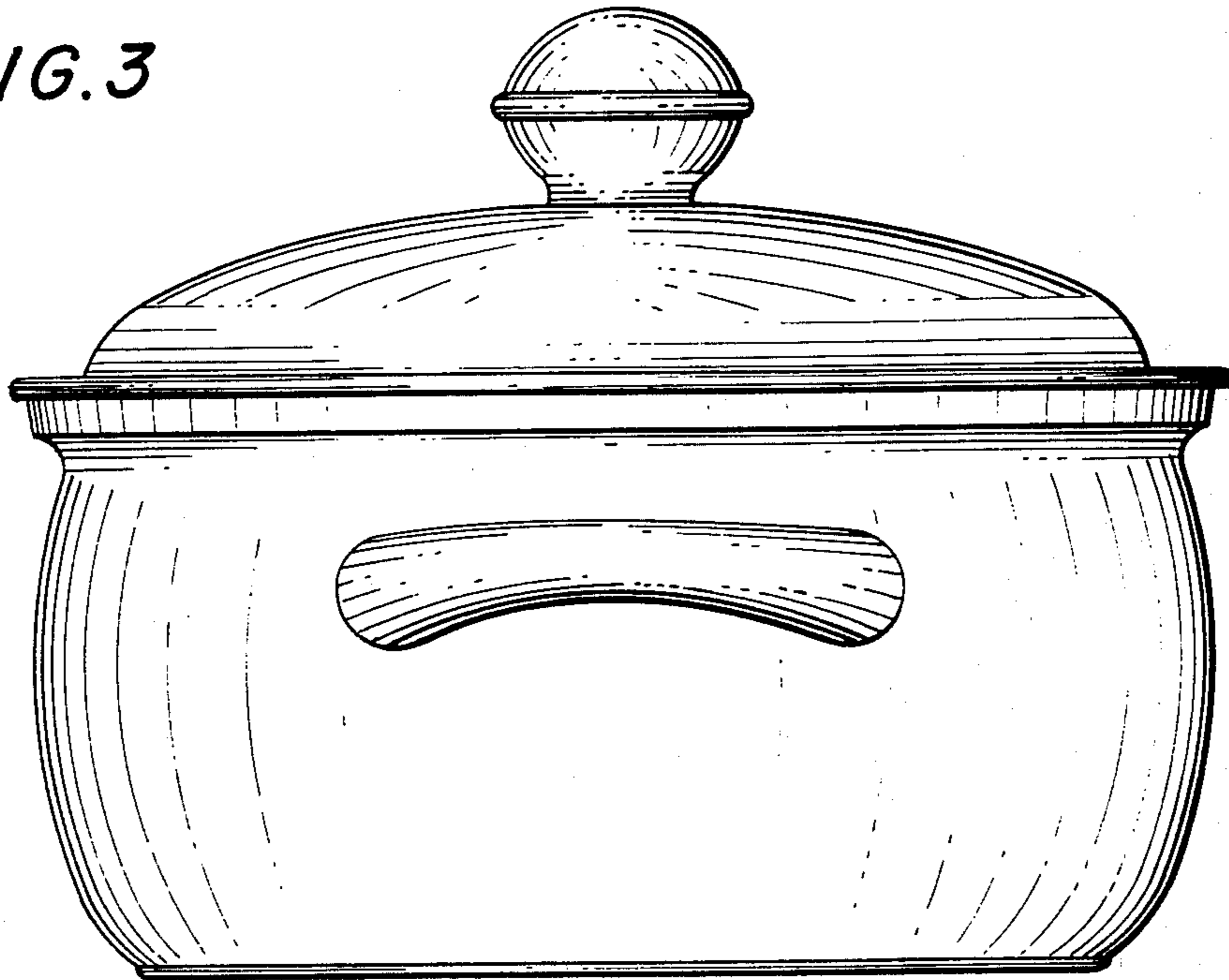
