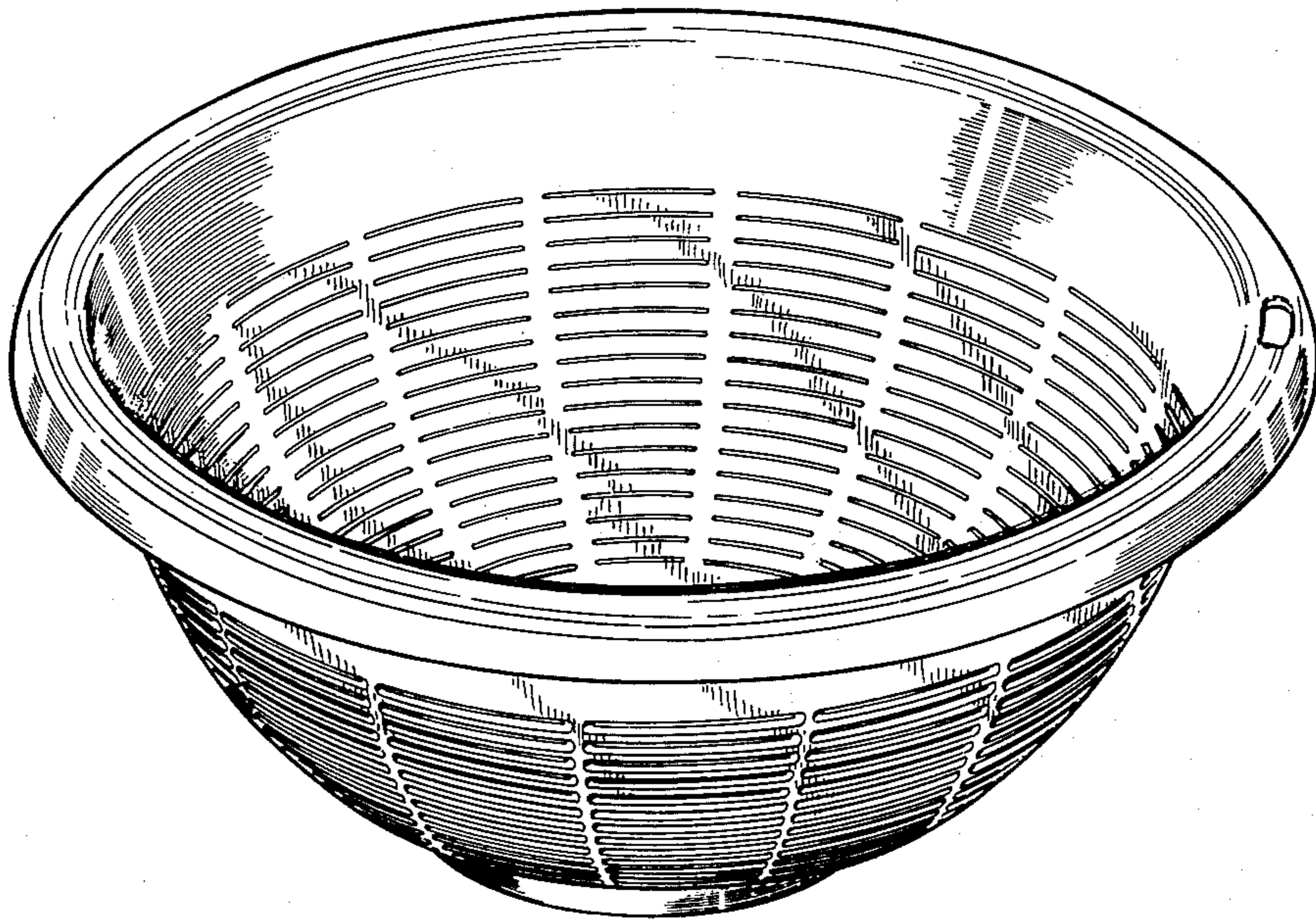

The ornamental design for a colander, as shown and described.

DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a top, front perspective view of a colander, showing my new design, the top rear perspective view being a mirror image thereof;
 FIG. 2 is a bottom plan view thereof;
 FIG. 3 is a right-side elevational view thereof, the left side being a mirror image thereof omitting the depression in the rim; and
 FIG. 4 is a top plan view thereof.



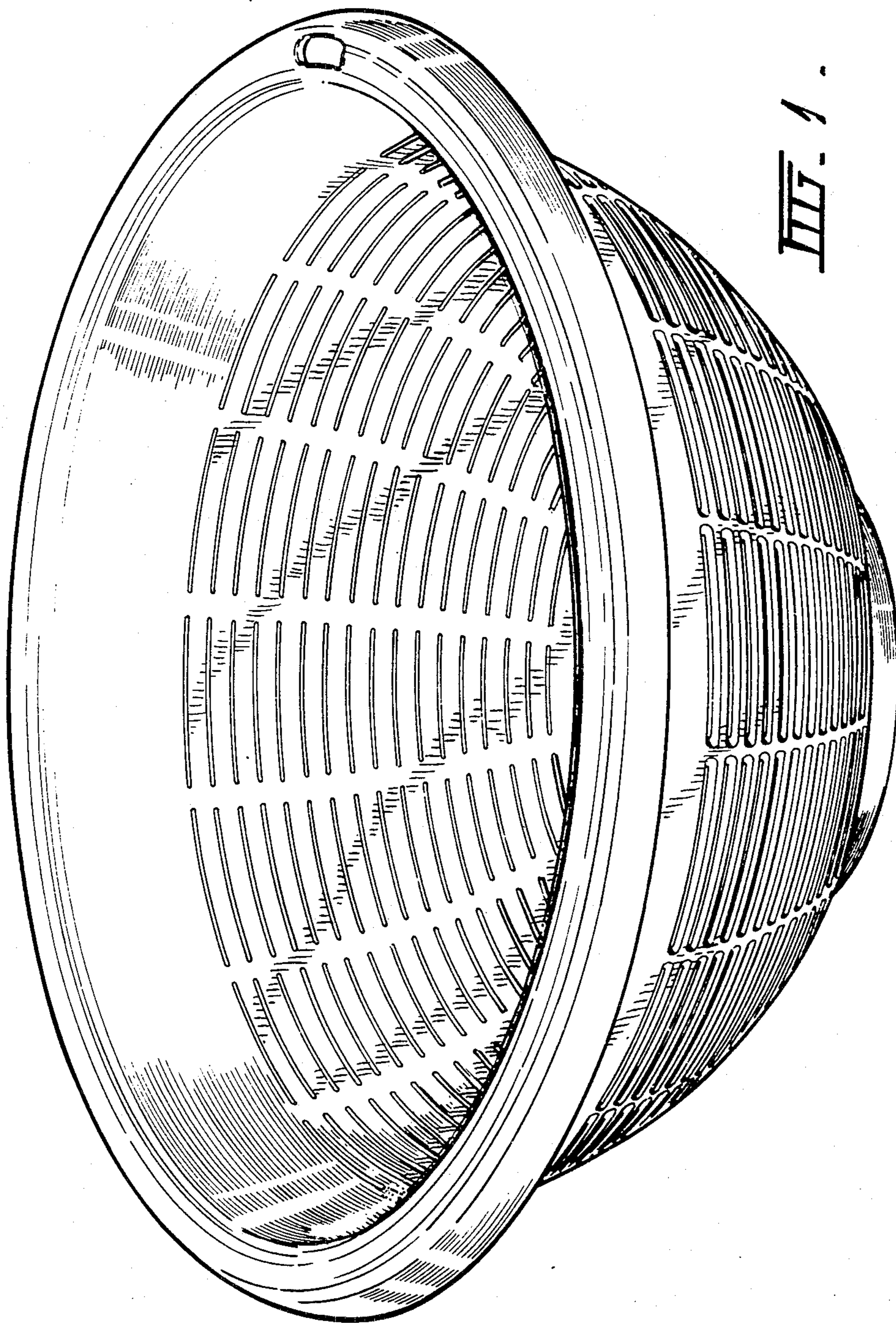
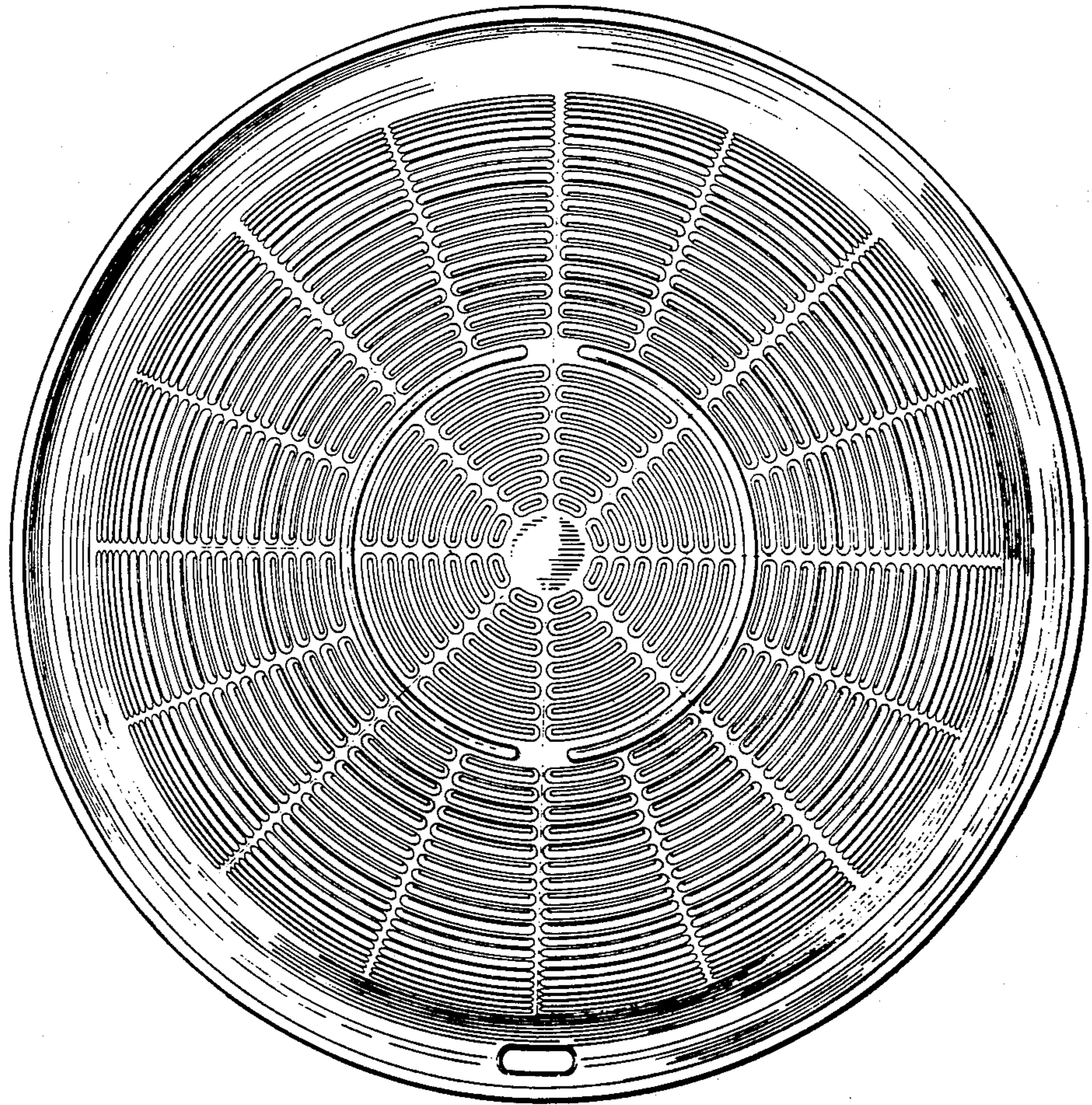
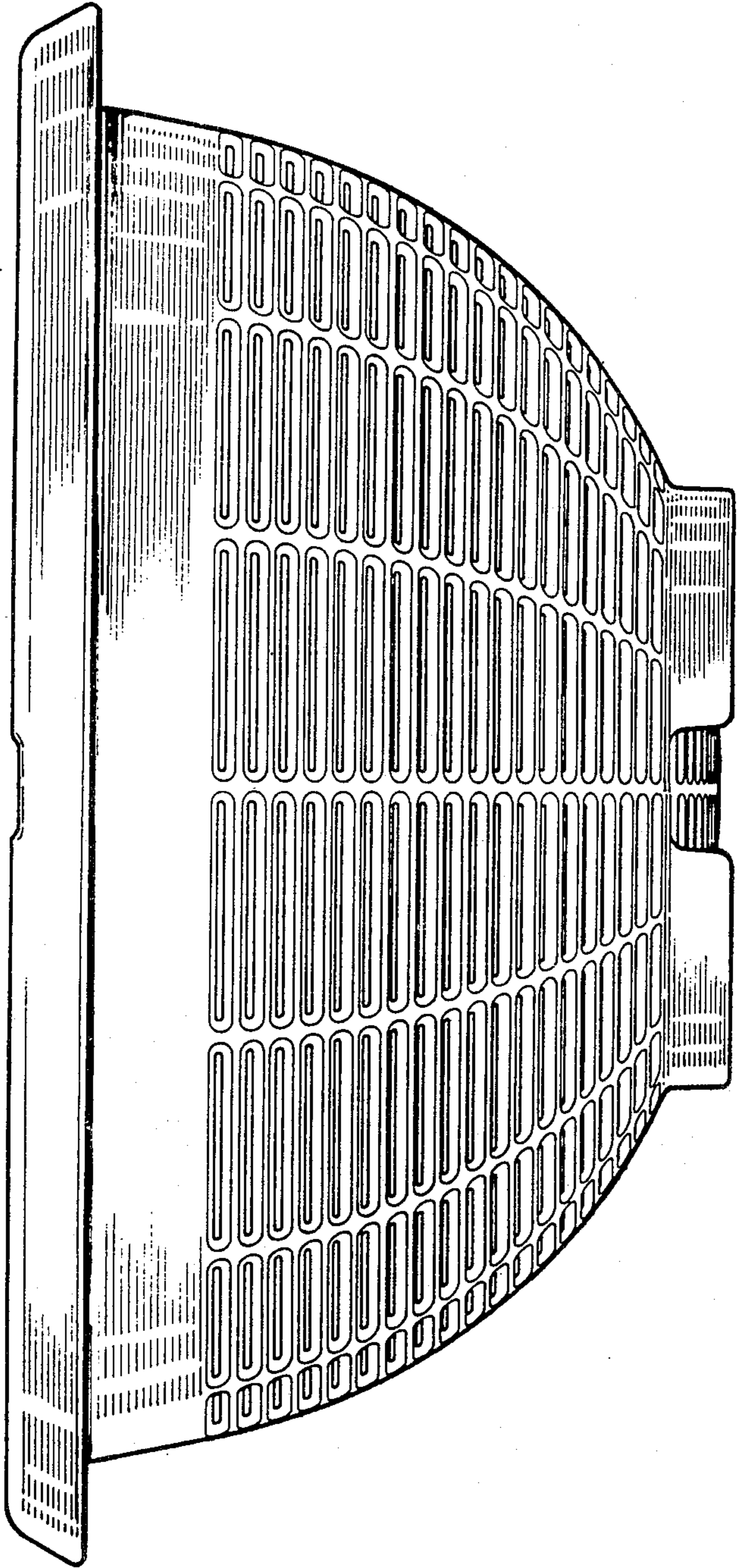

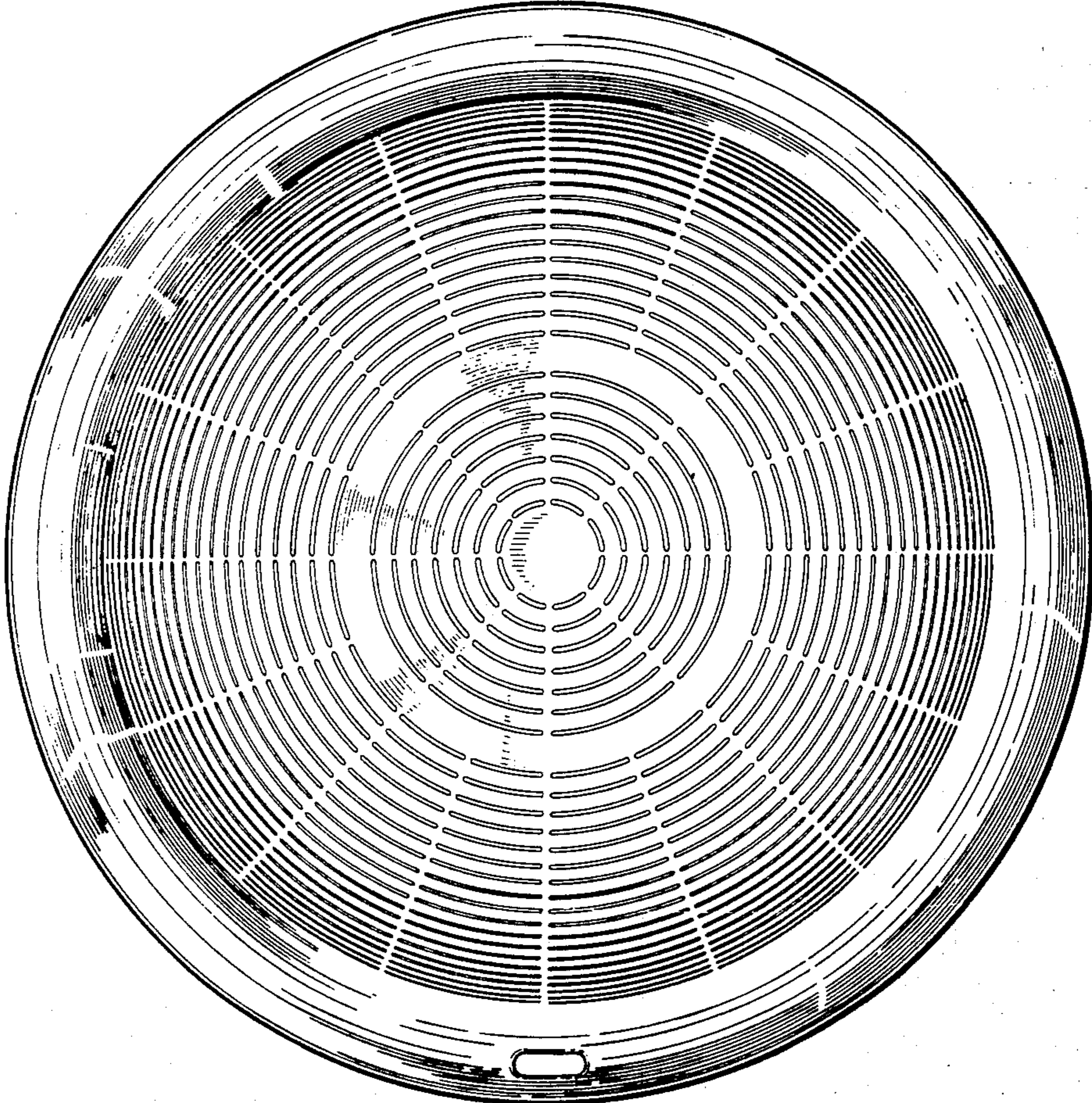
