[57] CLAIM

The ornamental design for a container holder, as shown and described.

DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a front right side perspective view of a container holder showing my new design, the broken lines indicating a container are shown for illustrative purposes only;

FIG. 2 is a front elevational view thereof;

FIG. 3 is a right side elevational view thereof, the left side being a mirror image thereof;

FIG. 4 is a rear elevational view thereof;

FIG. 5 is a bottom plan view thereof;

FIG. 6 is a top plan view thereof;

FIG. 7 is a front elevational view of a second embodiment of that shown in FIG. 1;

FIG. 8 is a rear elevational view thereof;

FIG. 9 is a bottom plan view thereof;

FIG. 10 is a top plan view thereof; and

FIG. 11 is a left side elevational view thereof, the right side being a mirror image thereof.

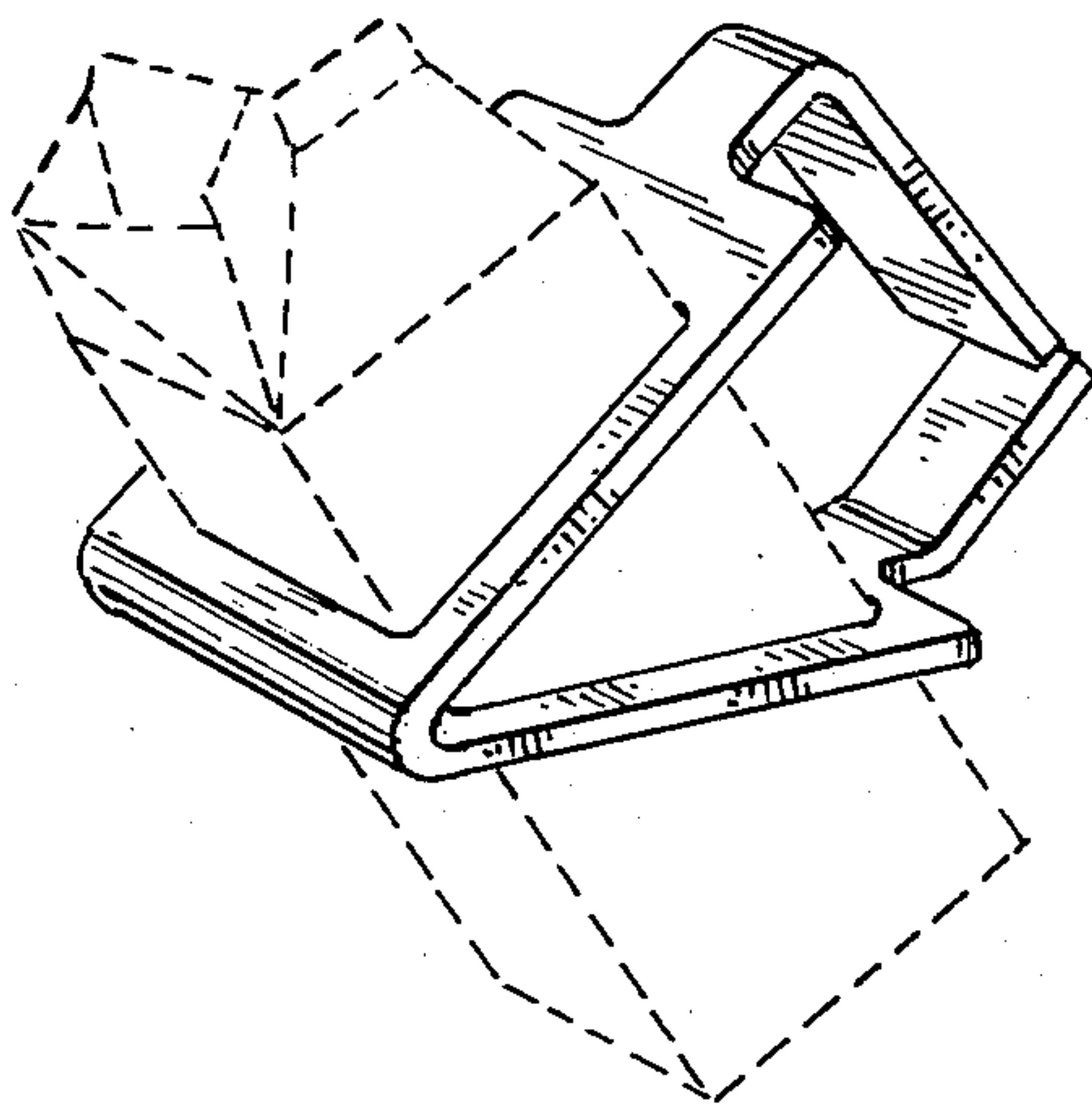

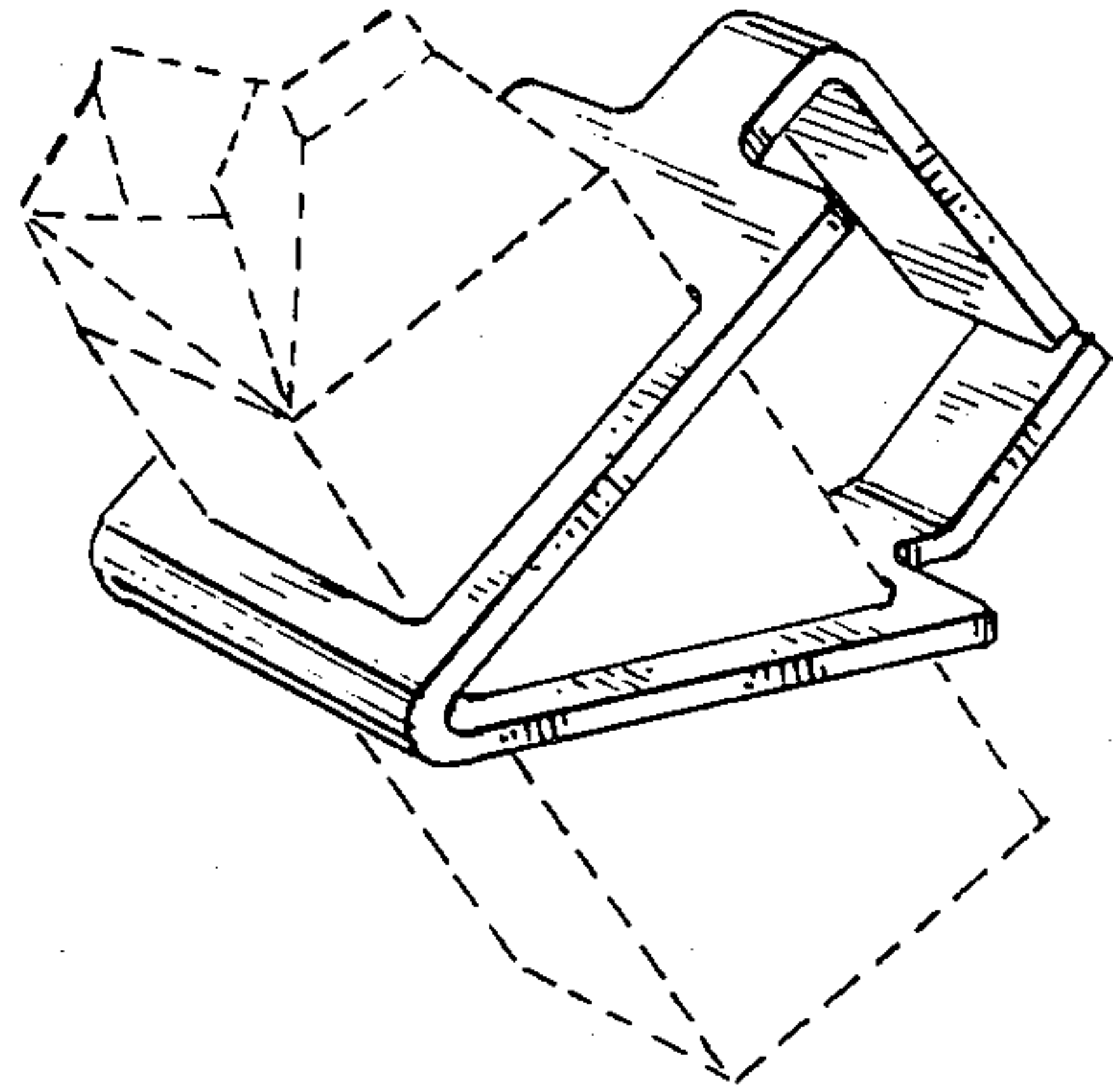

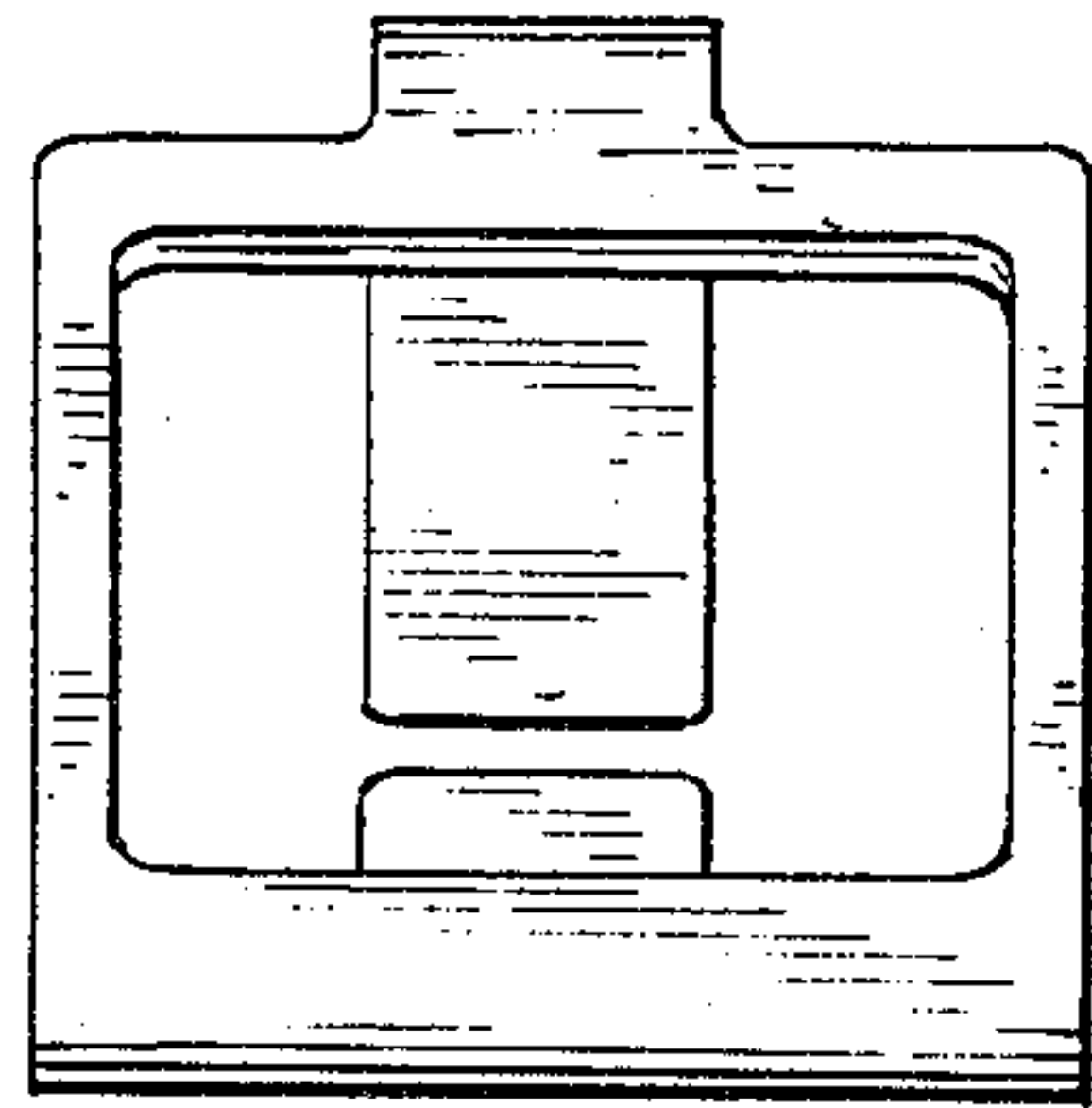

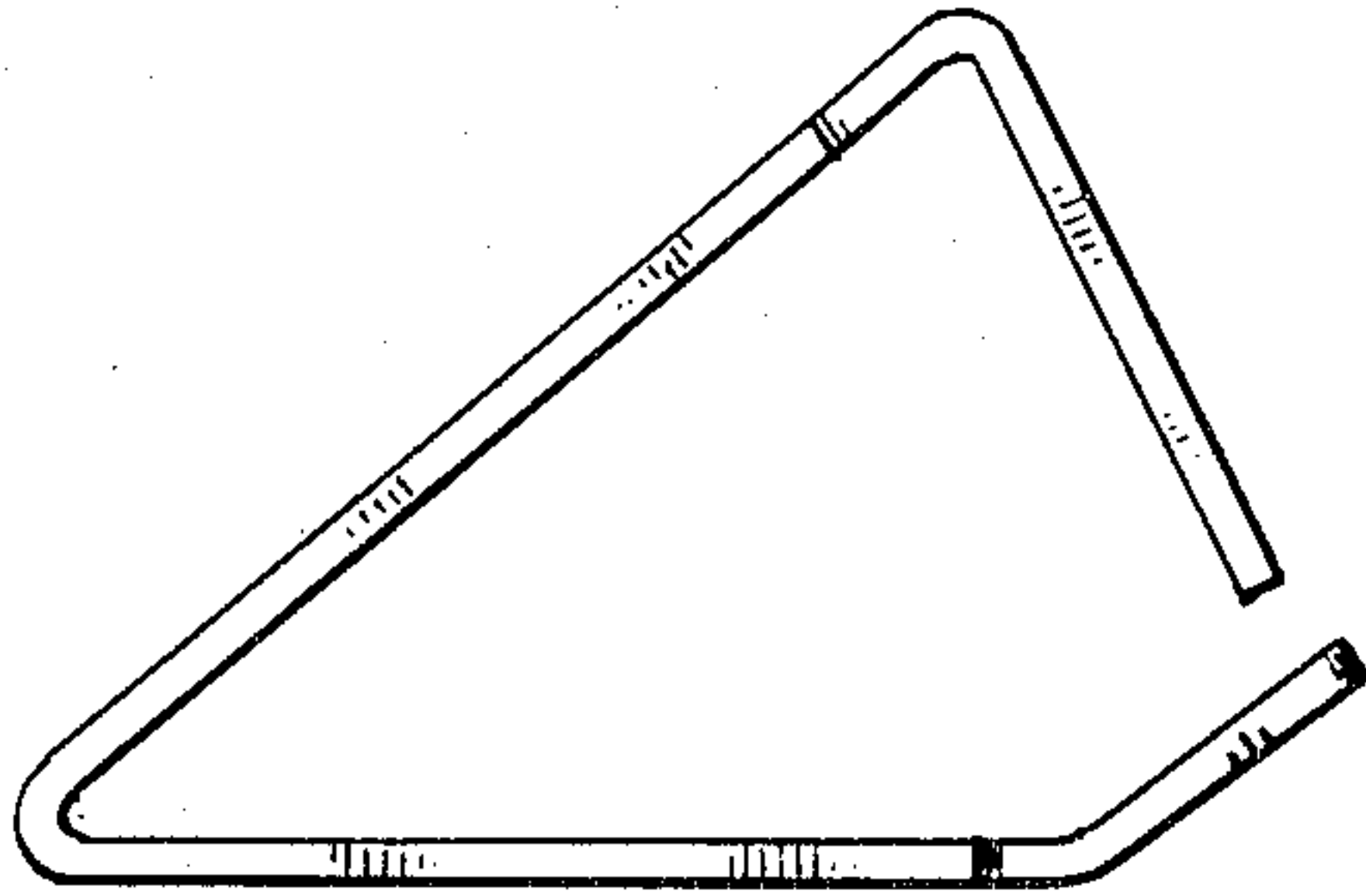

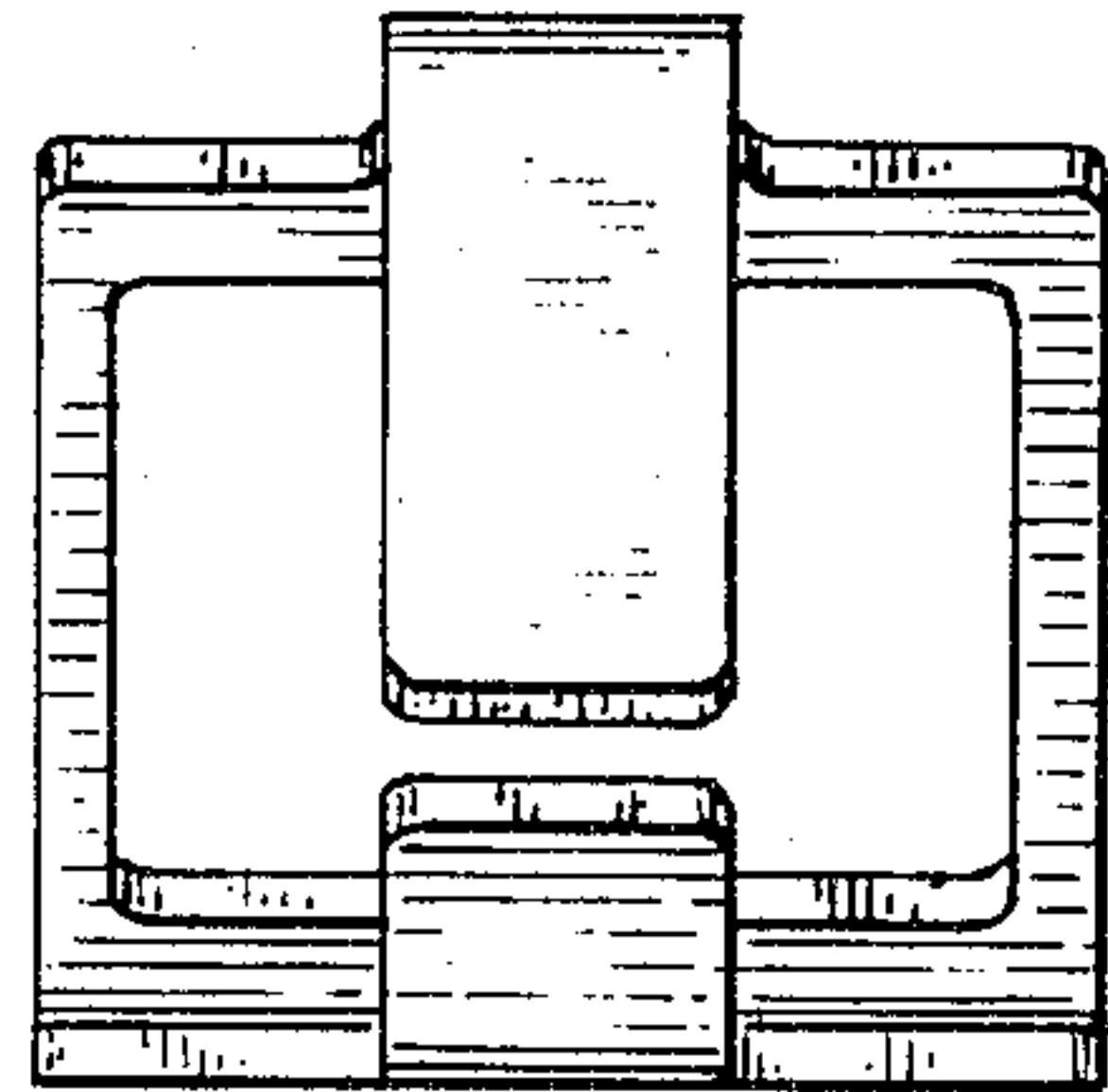

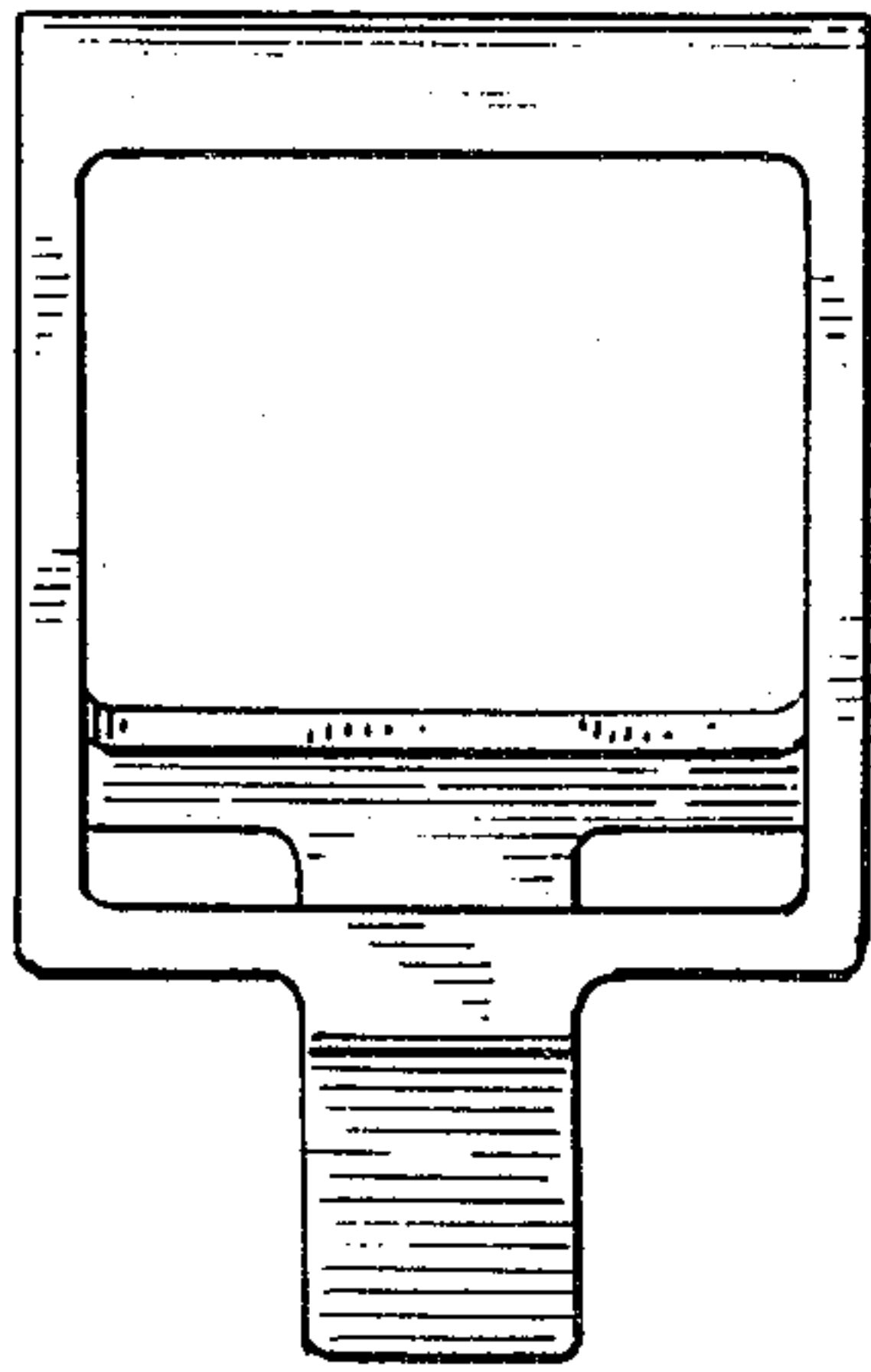

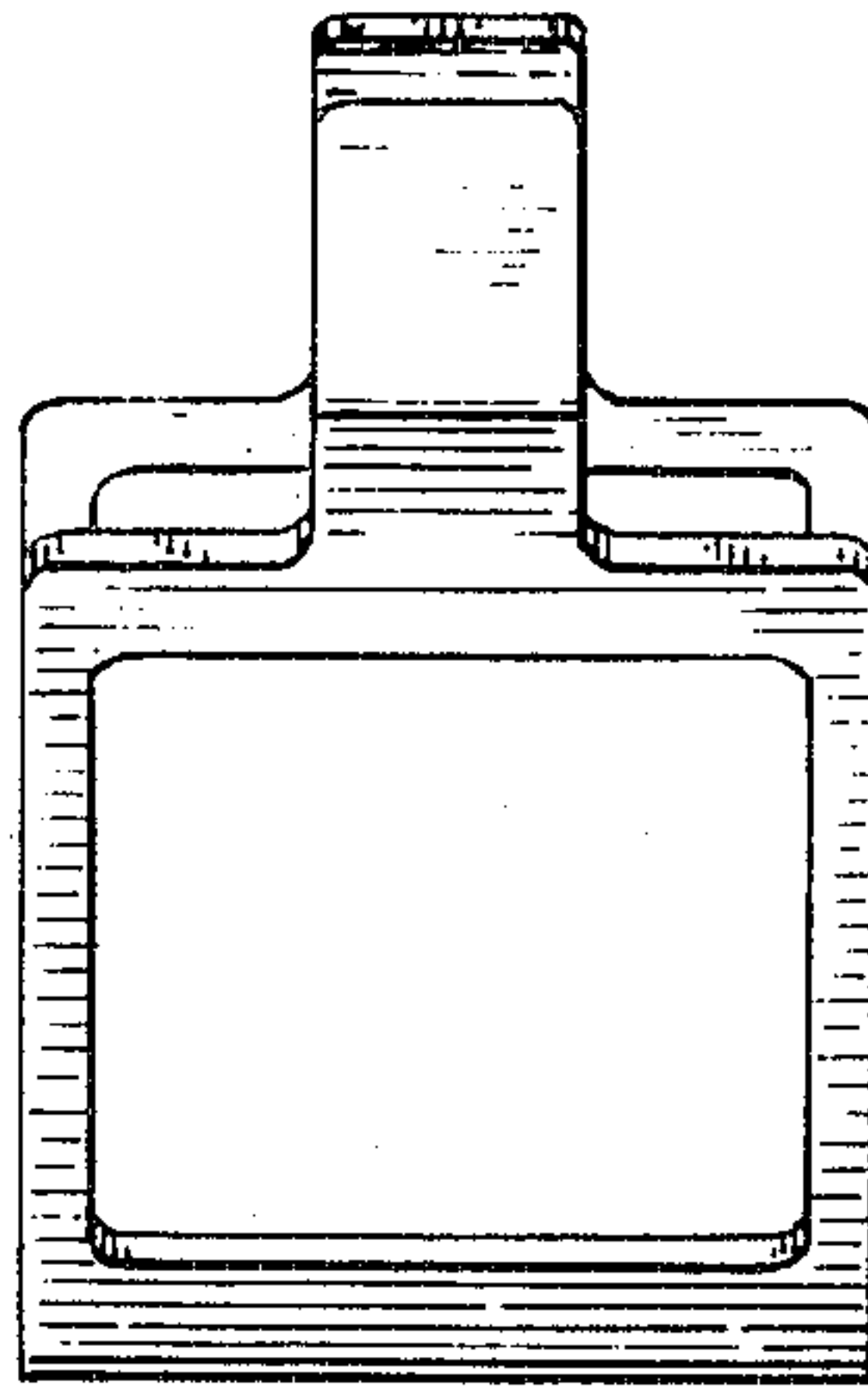

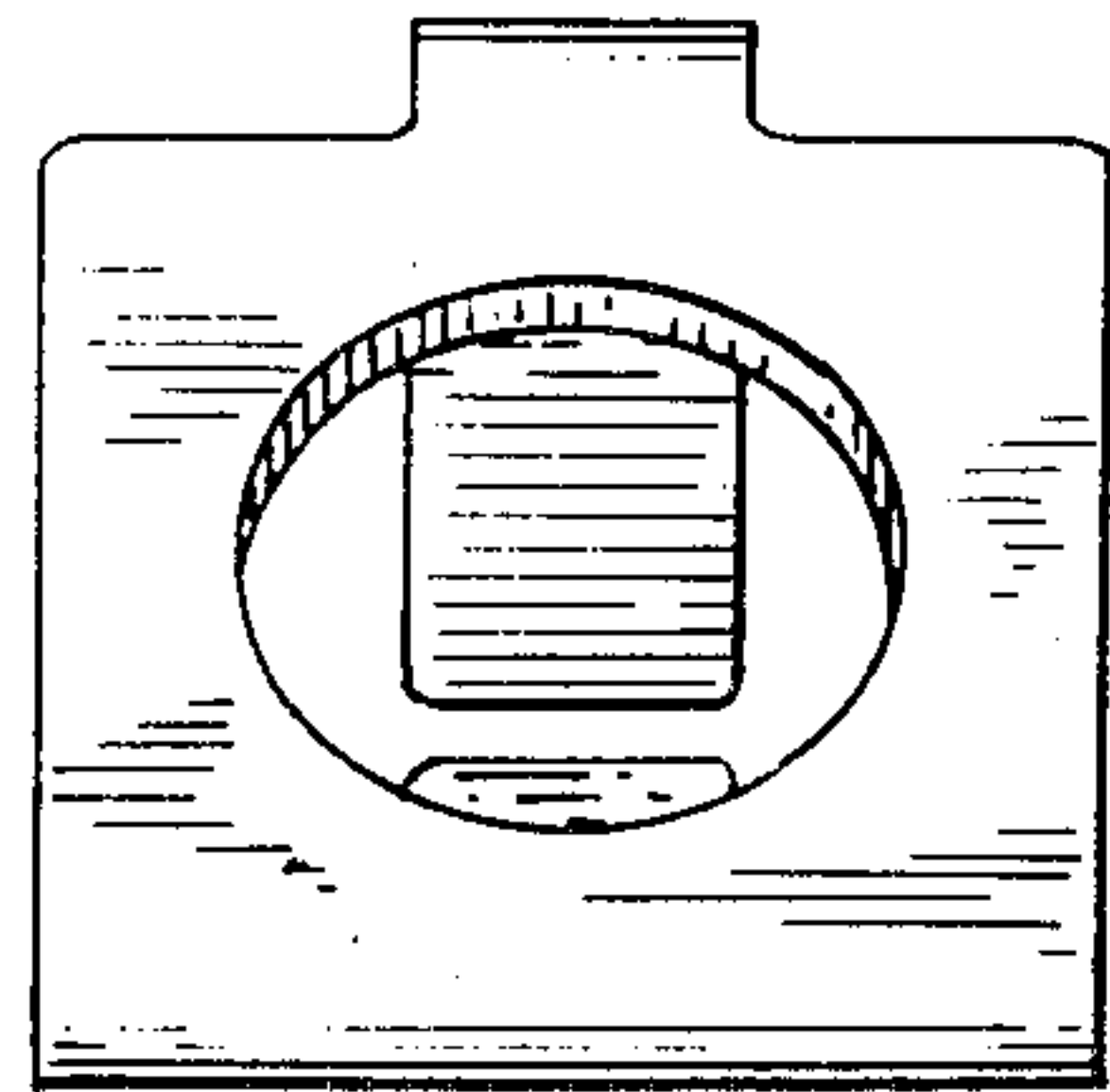

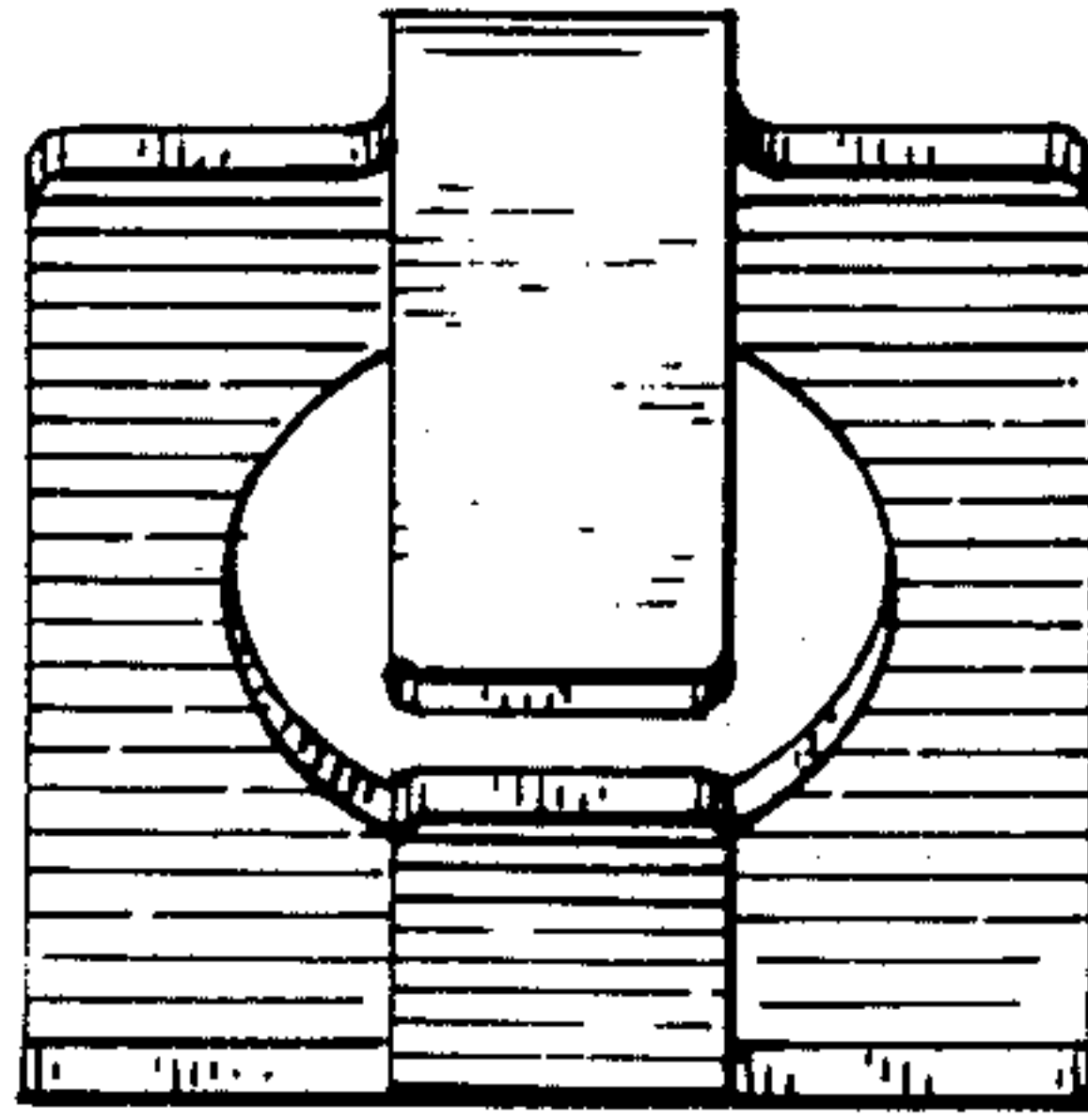

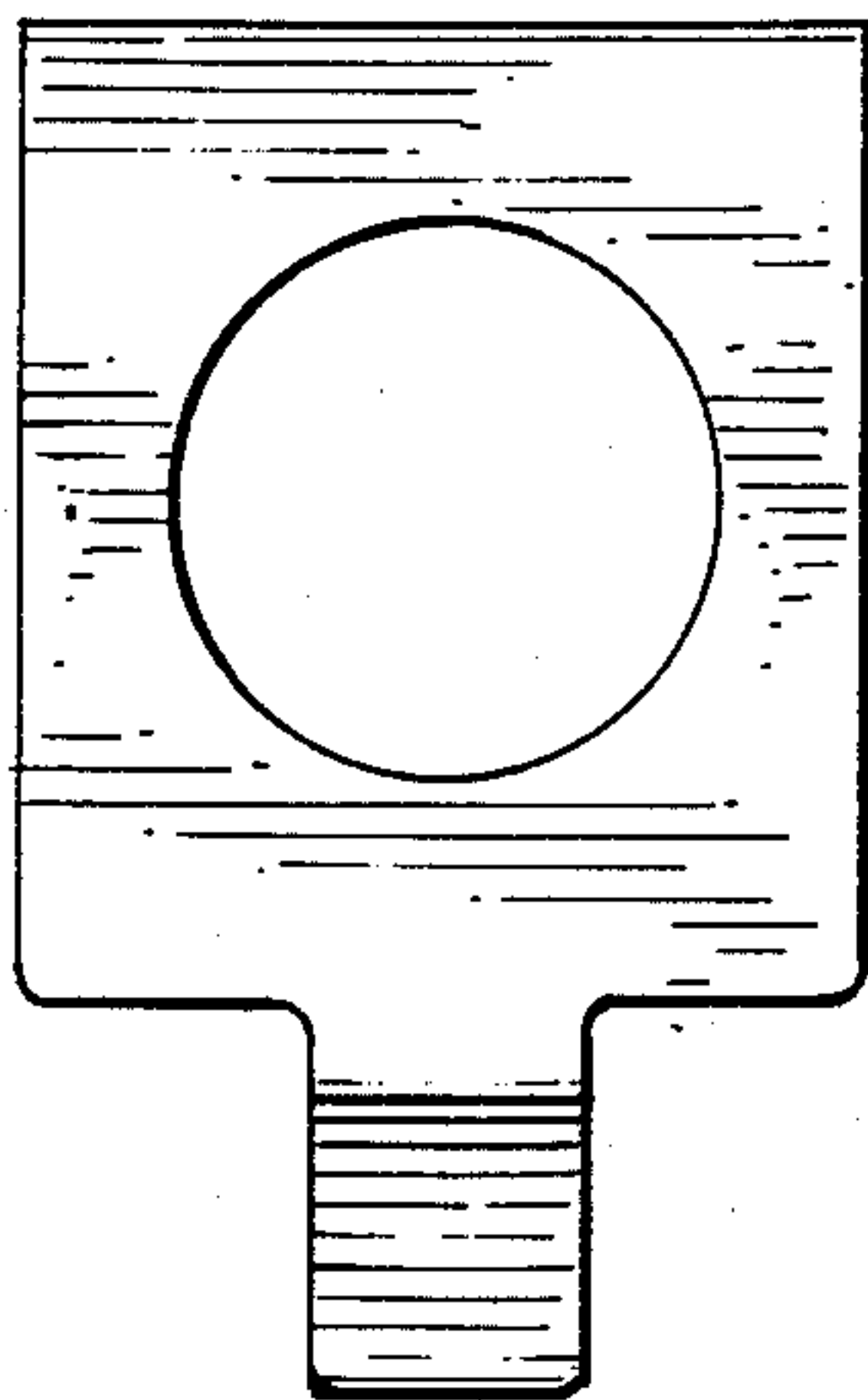

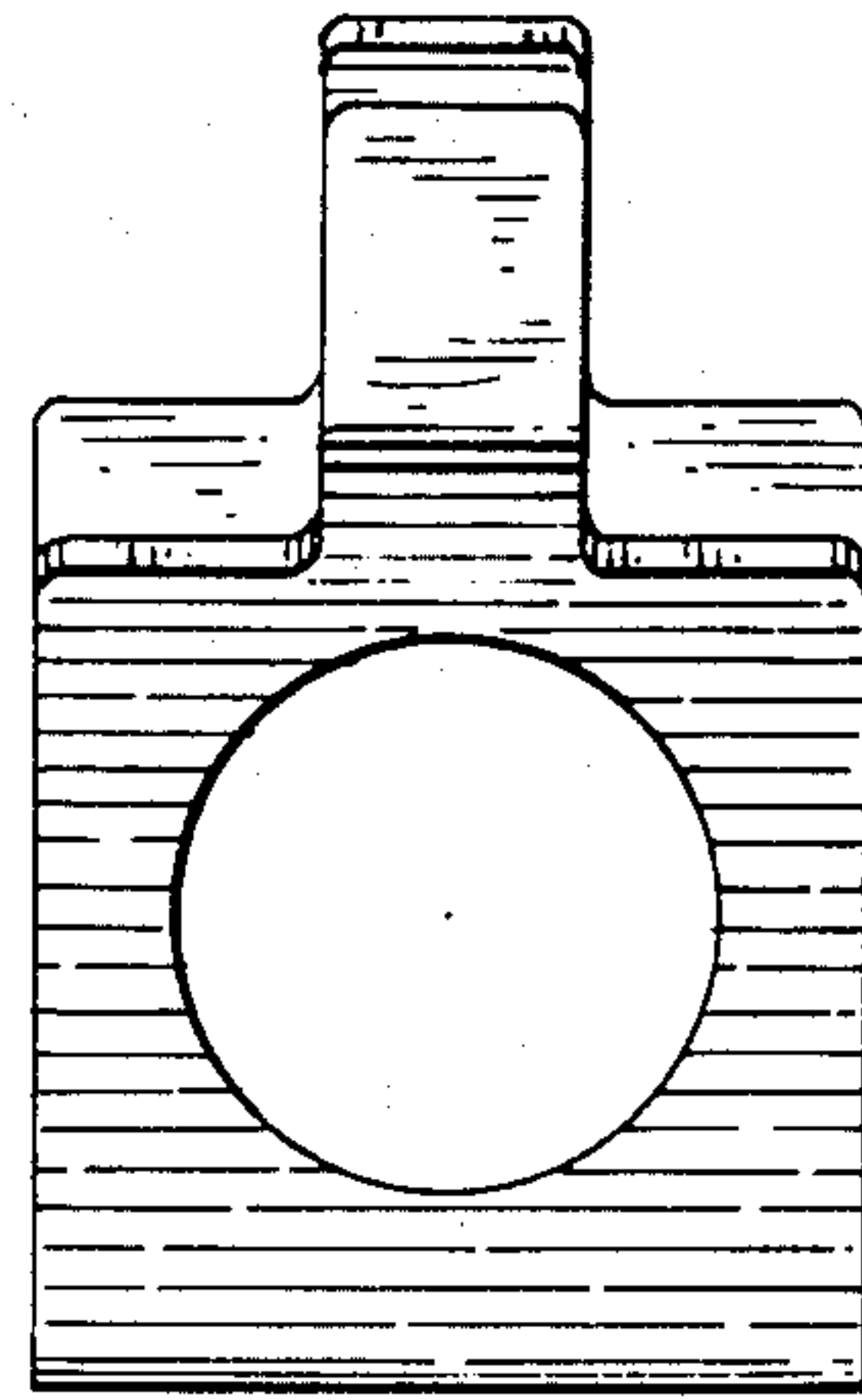
