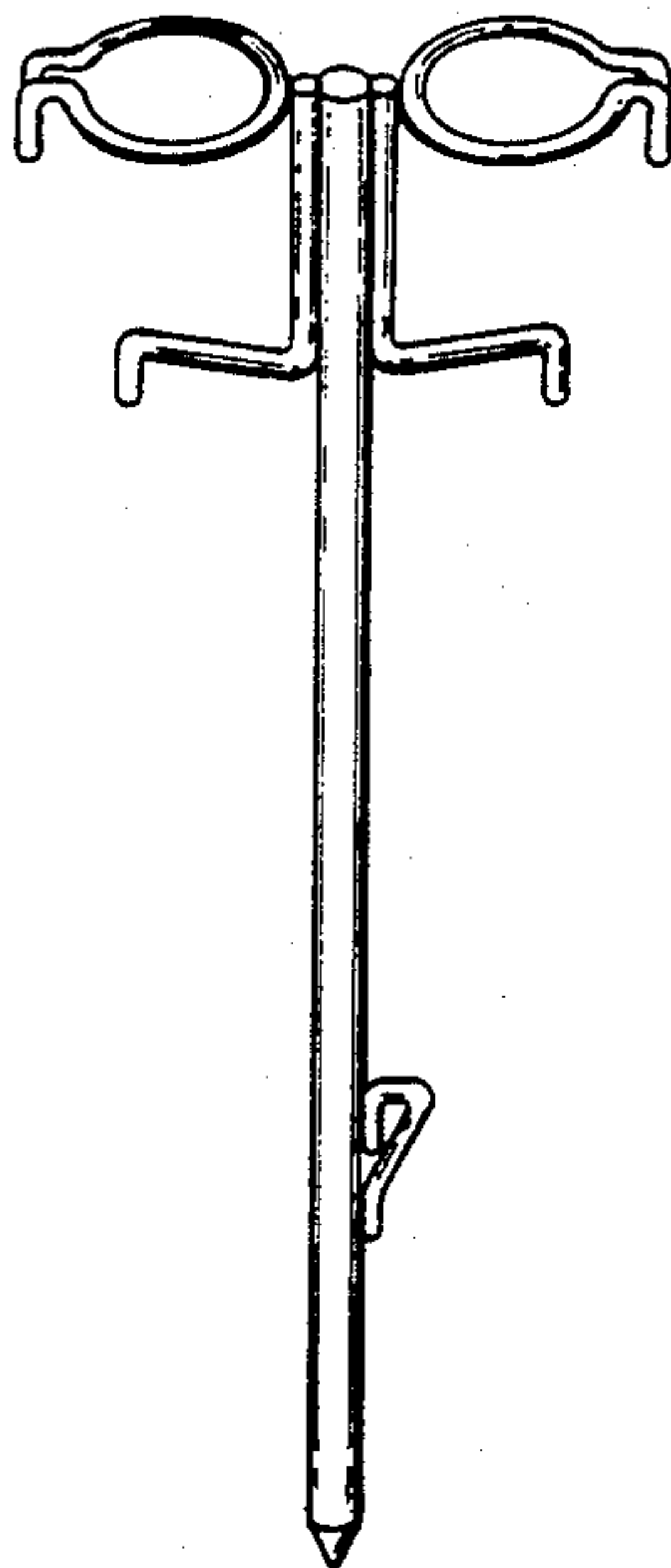

FIG. 6 is a side elevation view thereof as seen from the left in FIG. 4.



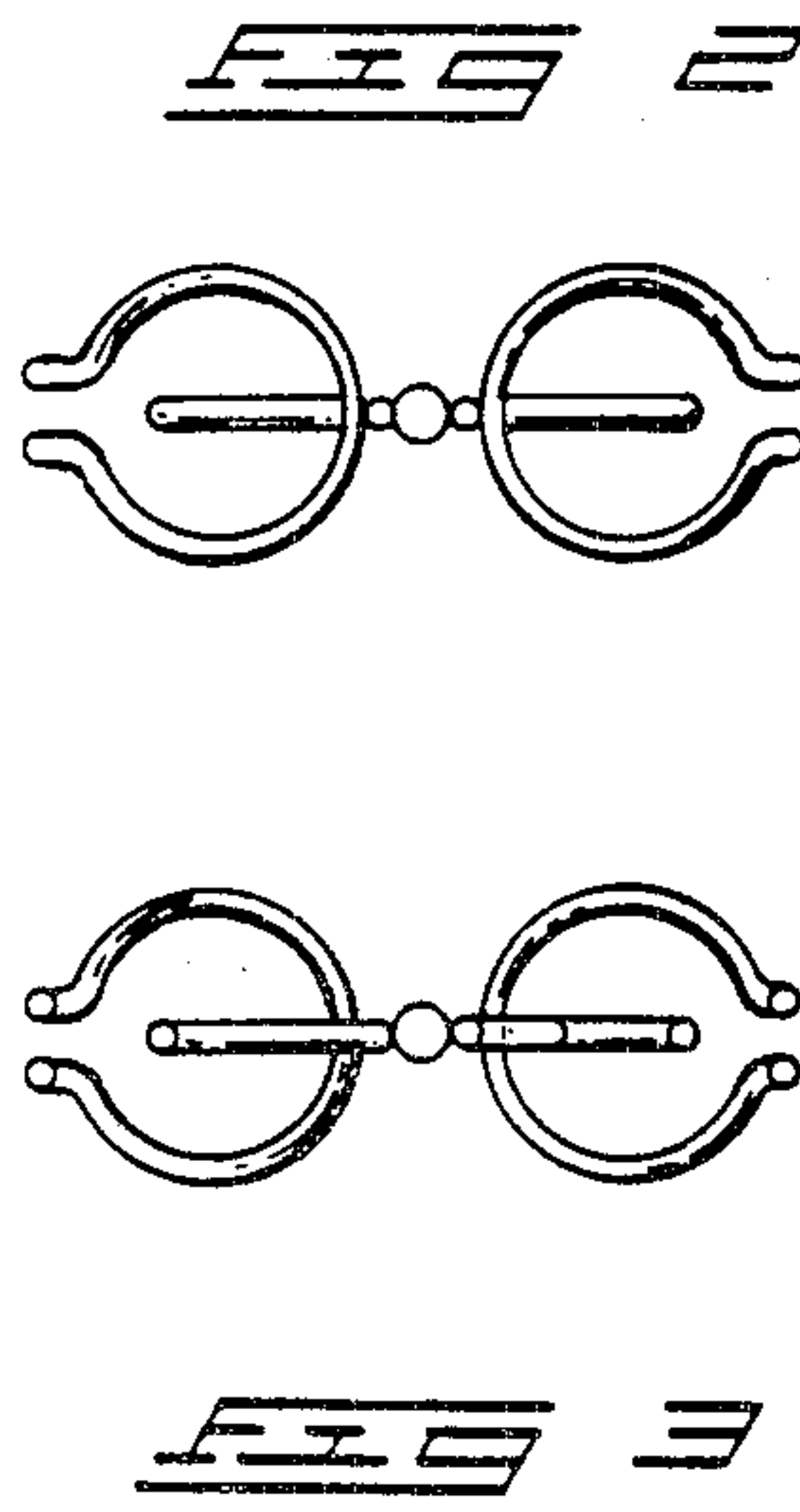
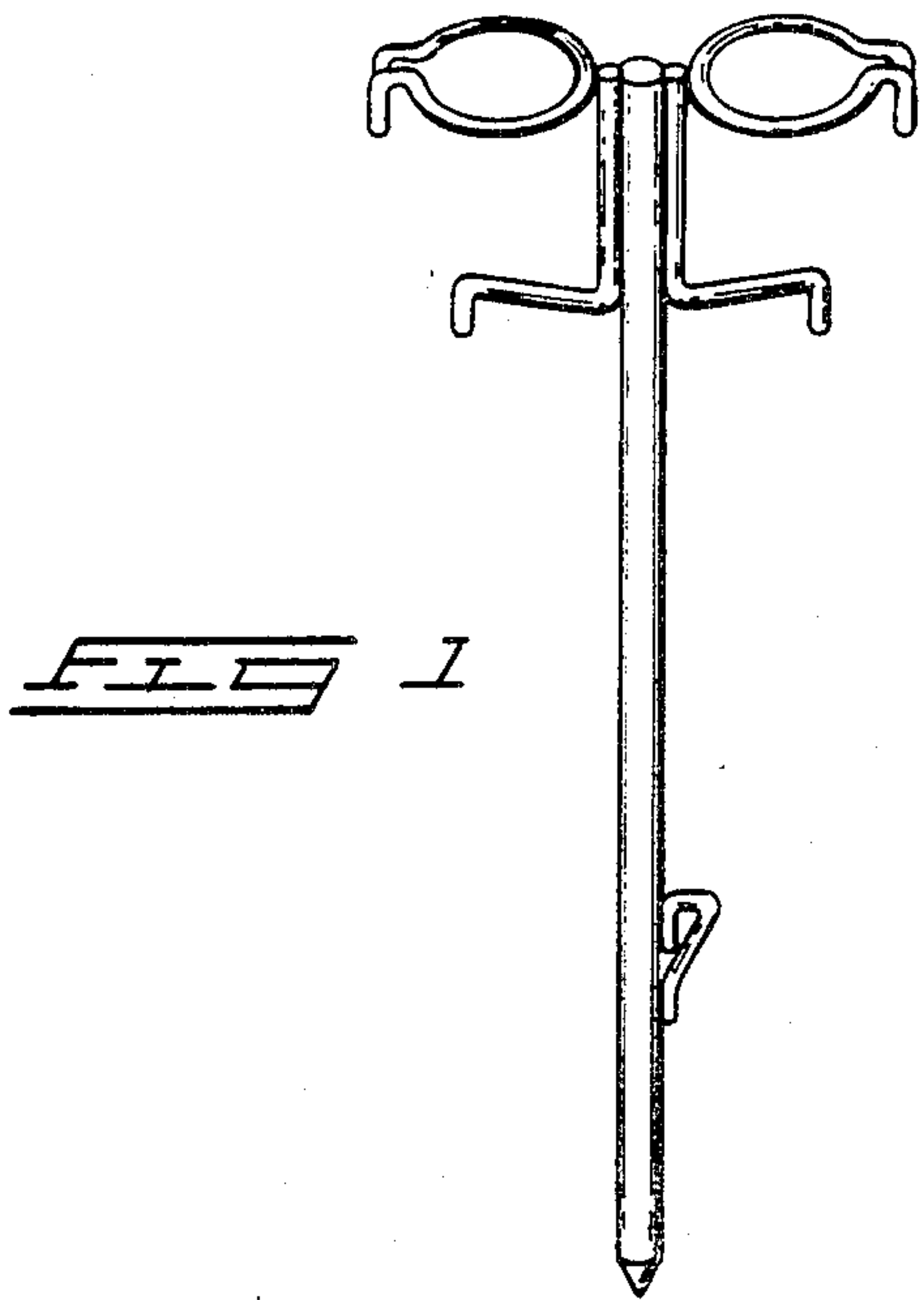
