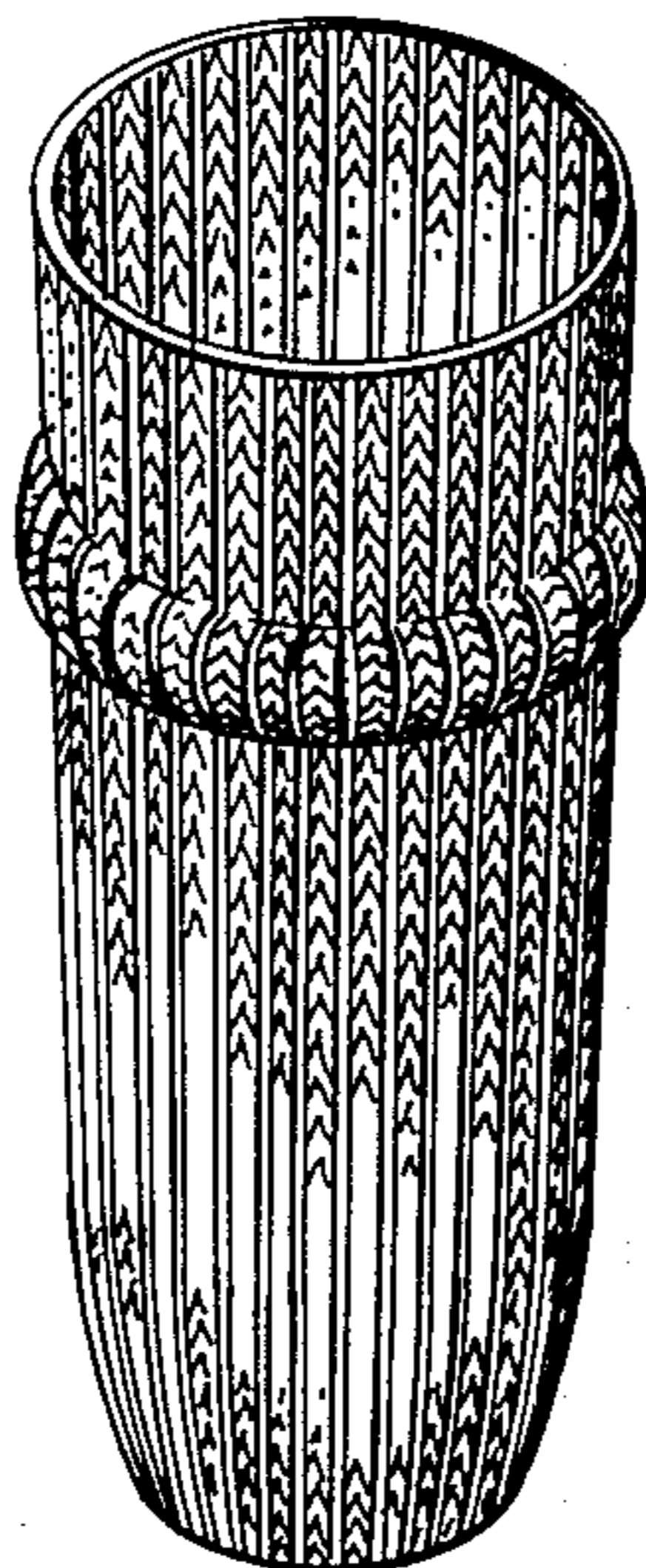

The ornamental design for knit tubular cover for beverage container, substantially as shown.

DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a side elevation of a knit tubular cover for beverage container showing our new design; FIG. 2 is a top, front perspective view thereof; and FIG. 3 is a bottom, rear perspective view thereof.



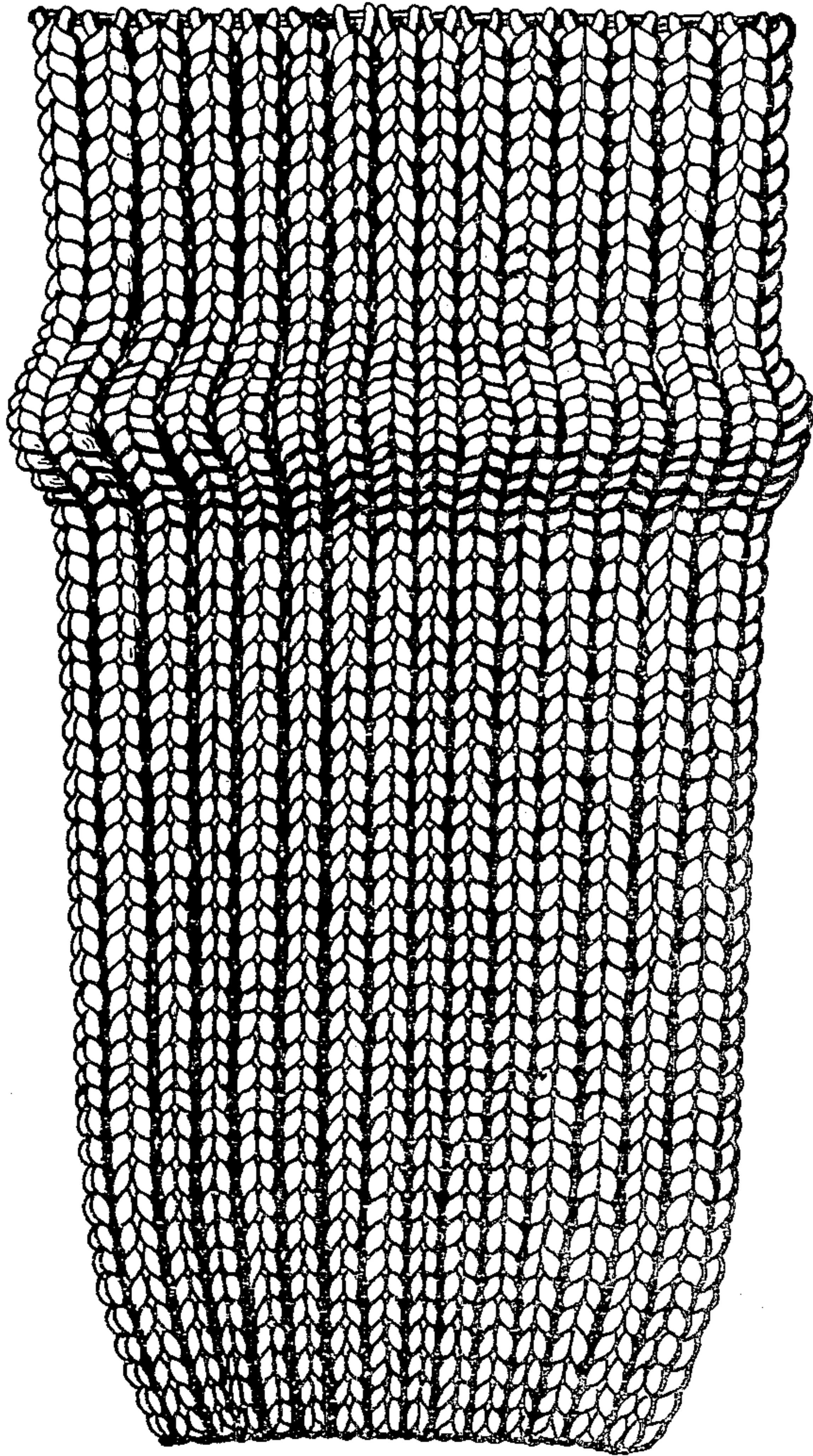

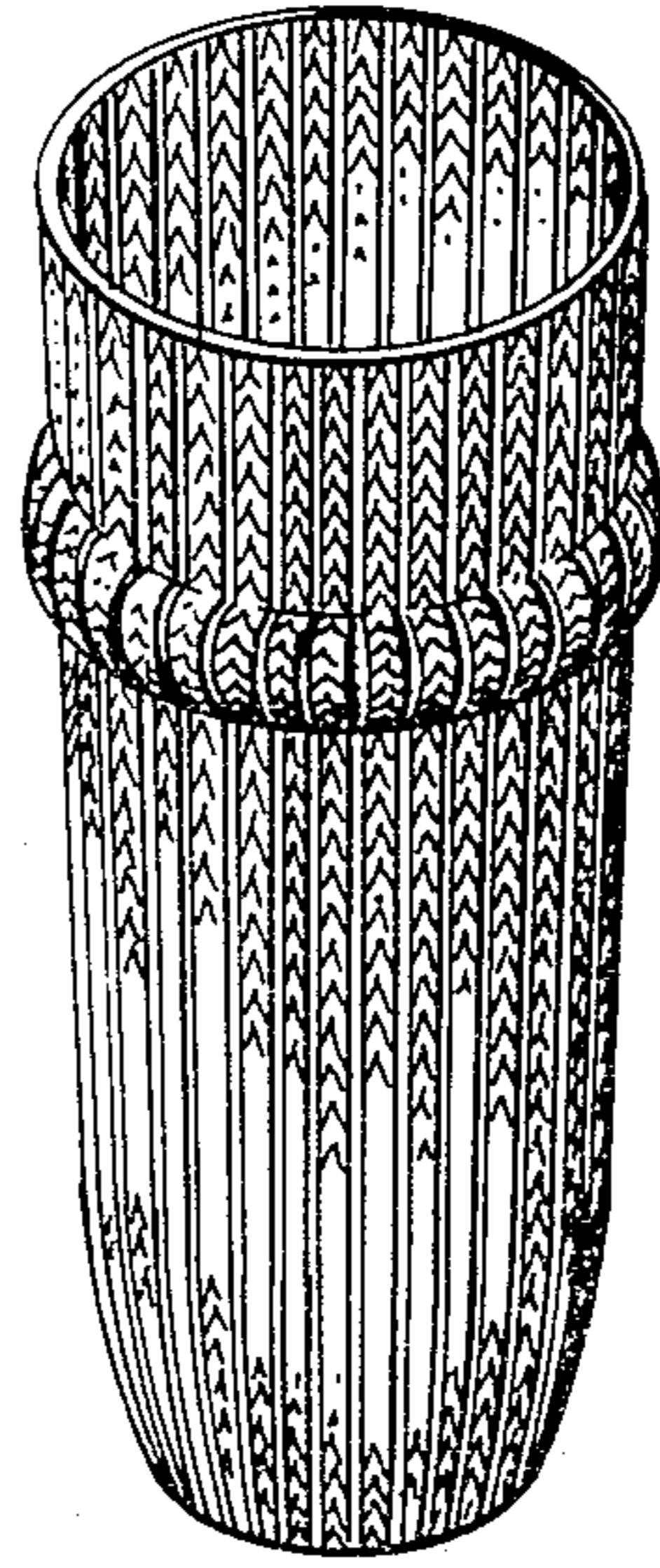

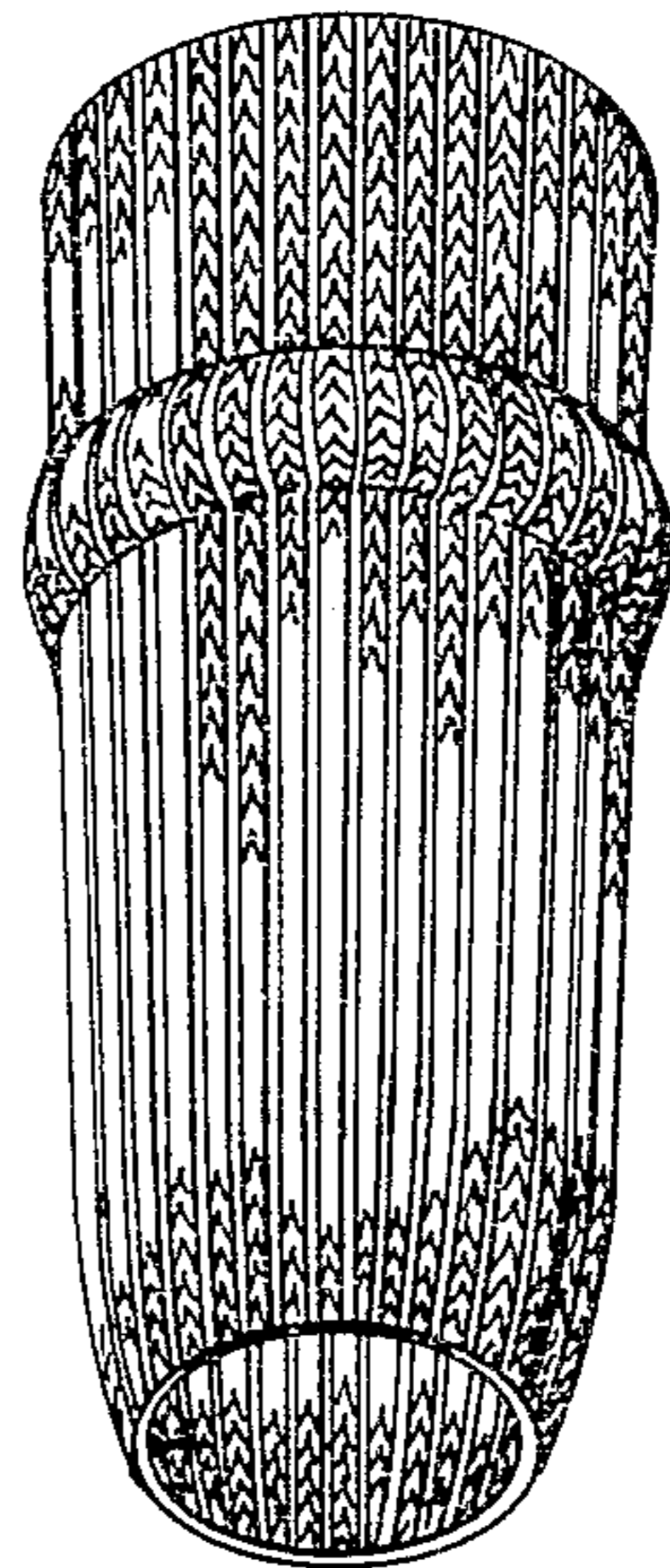
