

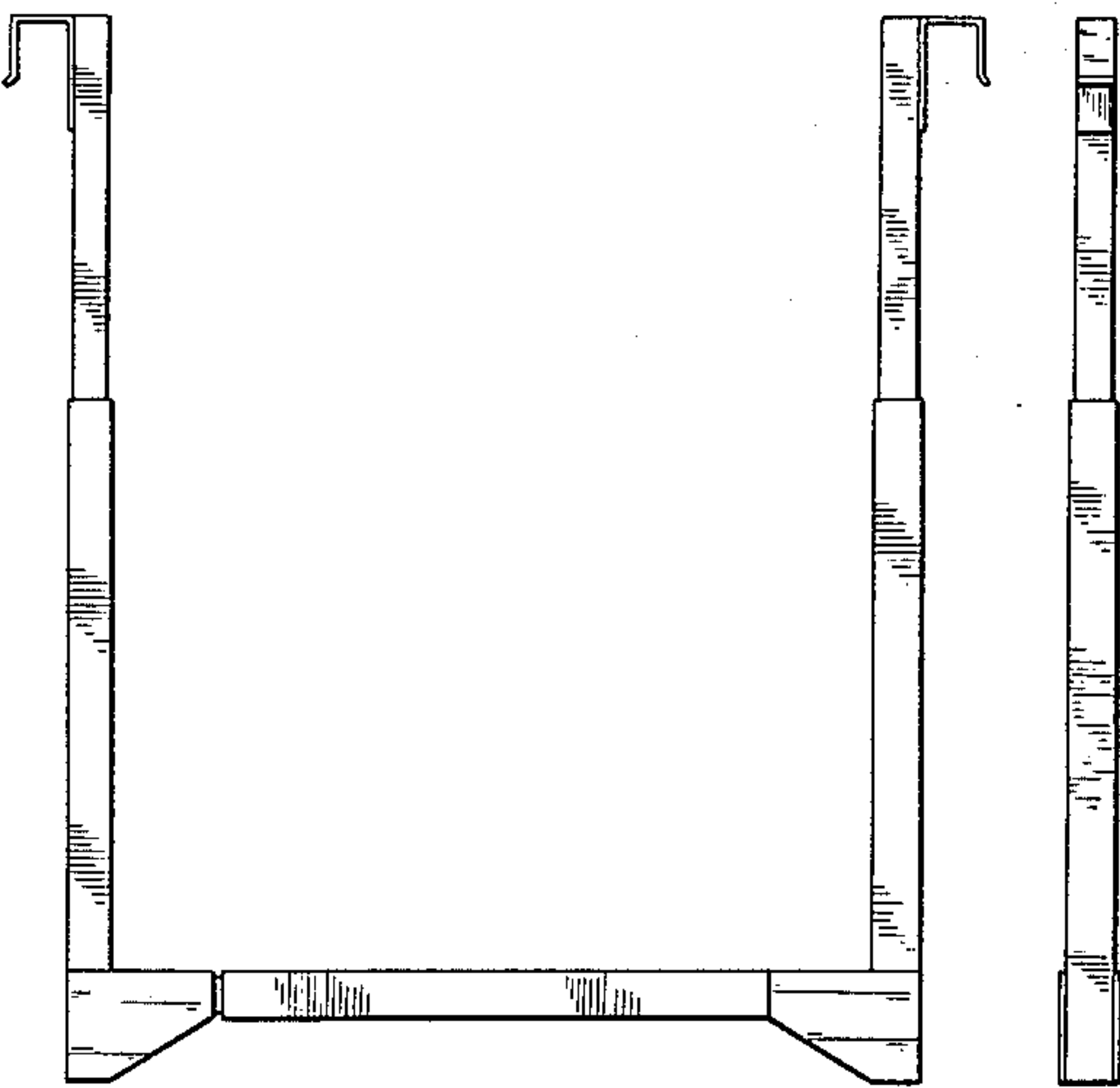

The ornamental design for a support hanger for a shelf,
substantially as shown and described.

DESCRIPTION
FIG. 1 is a front elevational view of a support hanger
for a shelf showing our new design, the rear being iden-
tical;
FIG. 2 is a side elevational view, the opposite side being
identical;
FIG. 3 is a top plan view thereof;
FIG. 4 is a bottom plan view thereof.



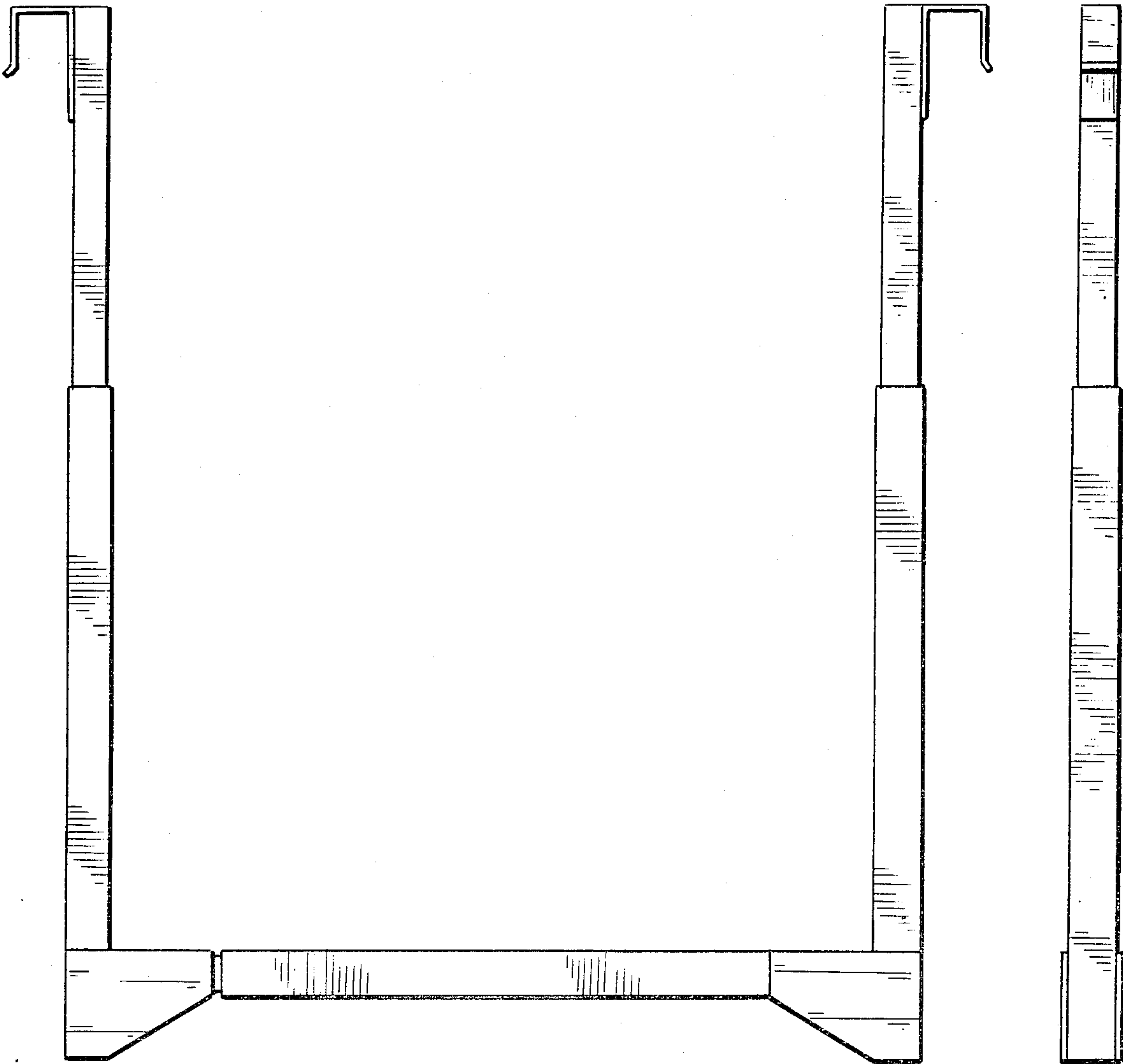

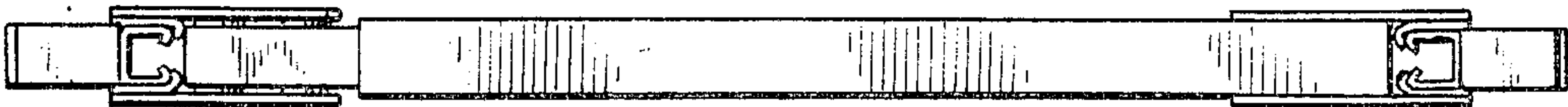

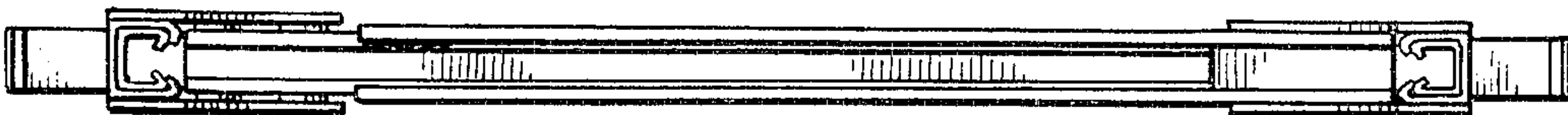
