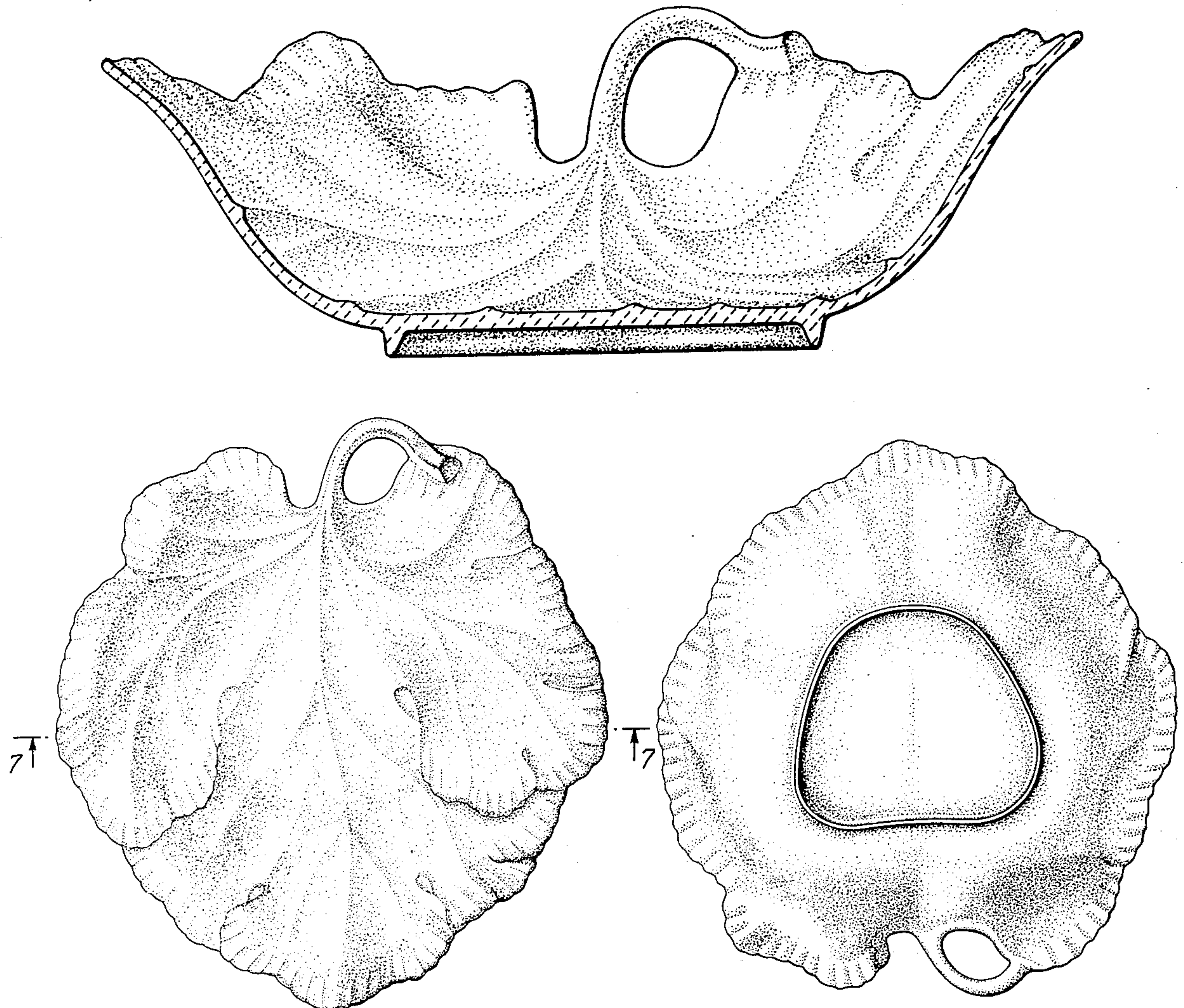

The ornamental design for a snack bowl, as shown and described.

DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a top plan view of a snack bowl showing my new design;
FIG. 2 is a bottom plan view thereof;
FIG. 3 is a front elevational view of the snack bowl shown in FIG. 1;
FIG. 4 is a rear elevational view thereof;
FIG. 5 is a right side elevational view thereof;
FIG. 6 is a left side elevational view thereof; and
FIG. 7 is a sectional view as taken along the line 7—7 in FIG. 1.



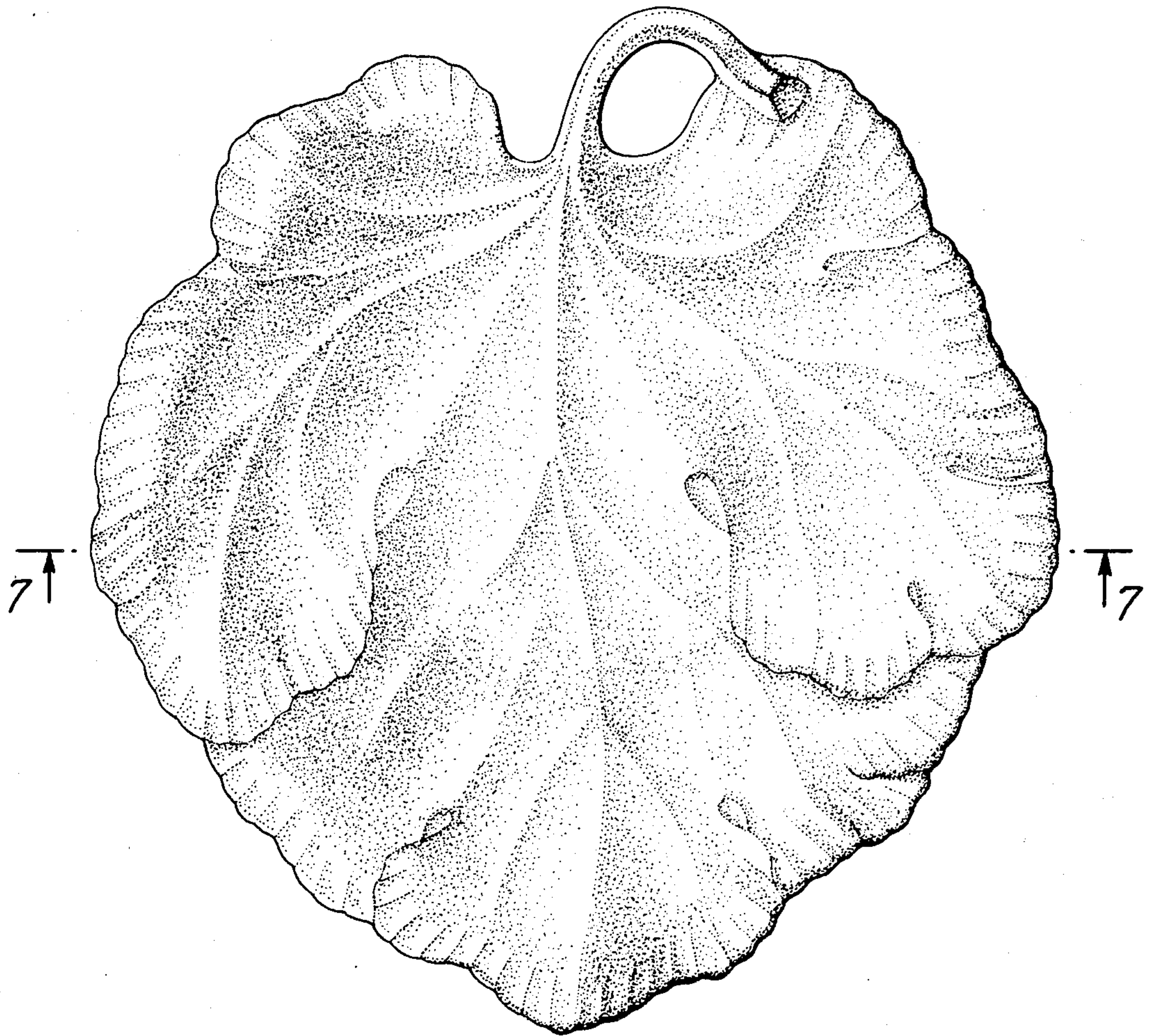

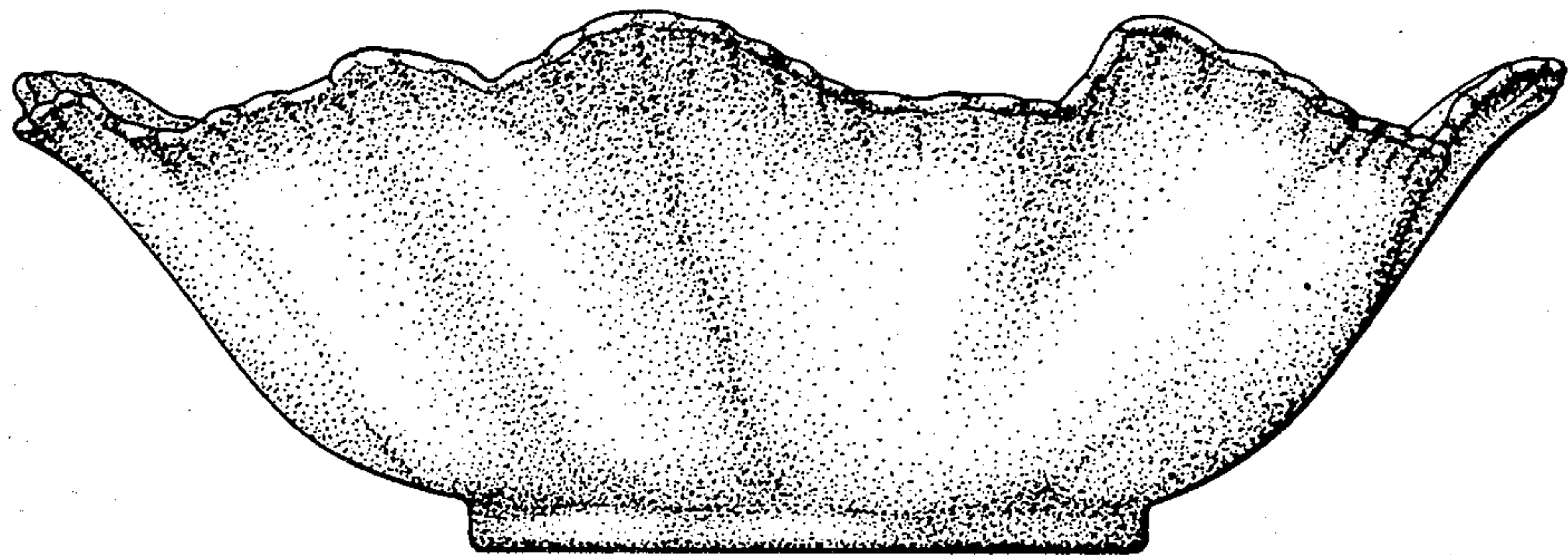

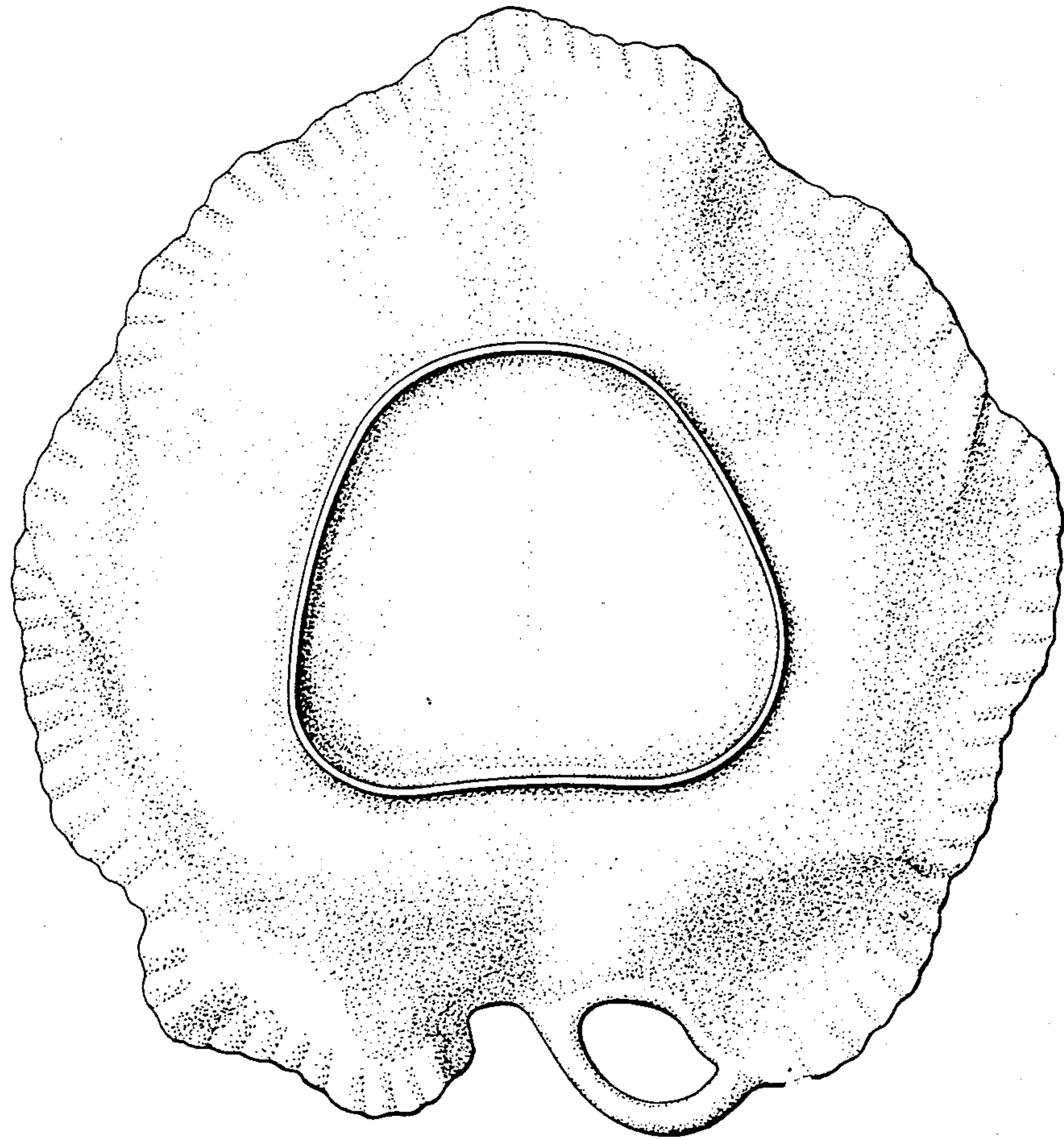

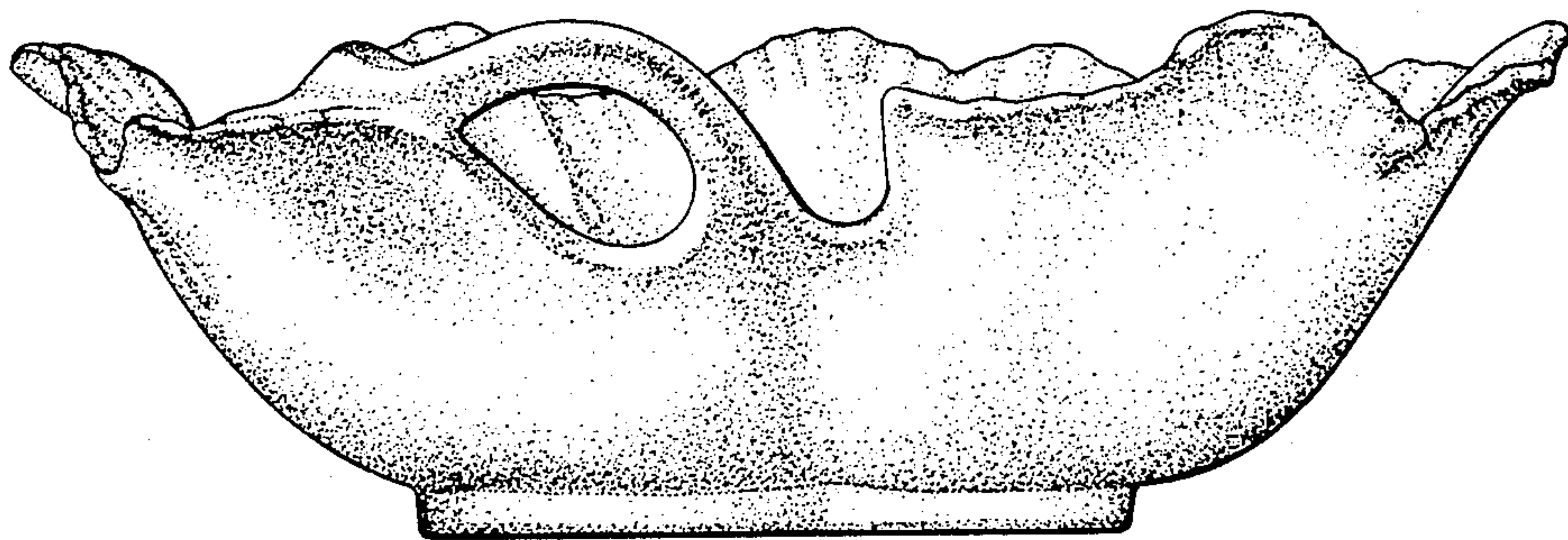

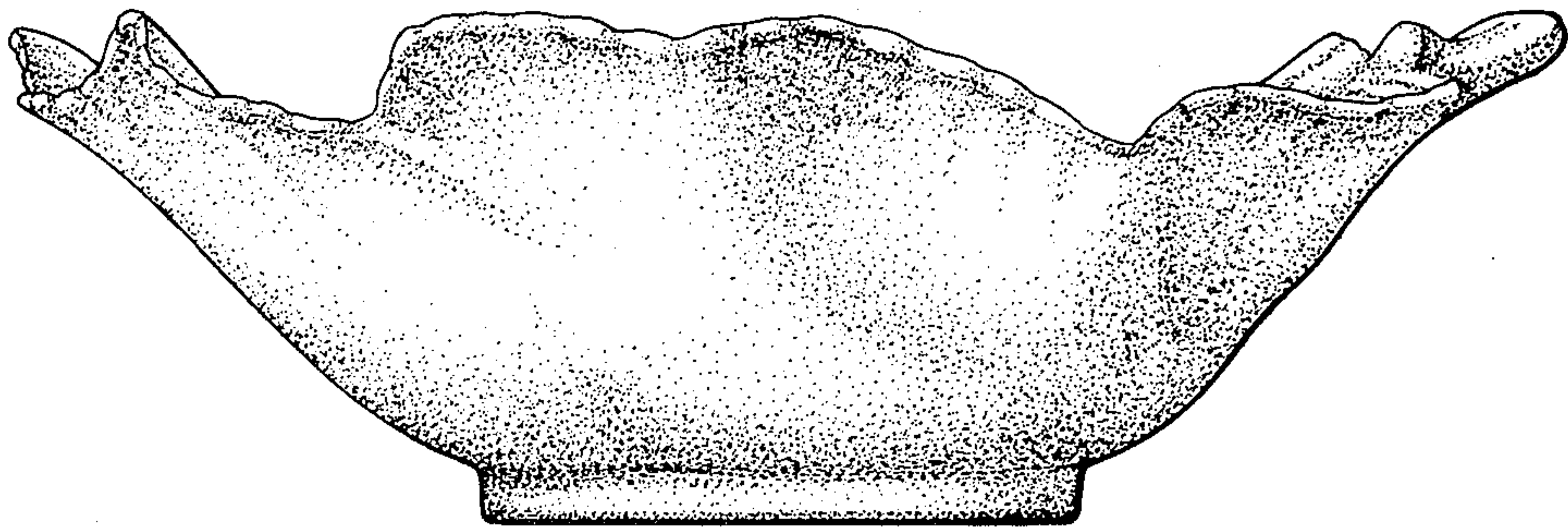

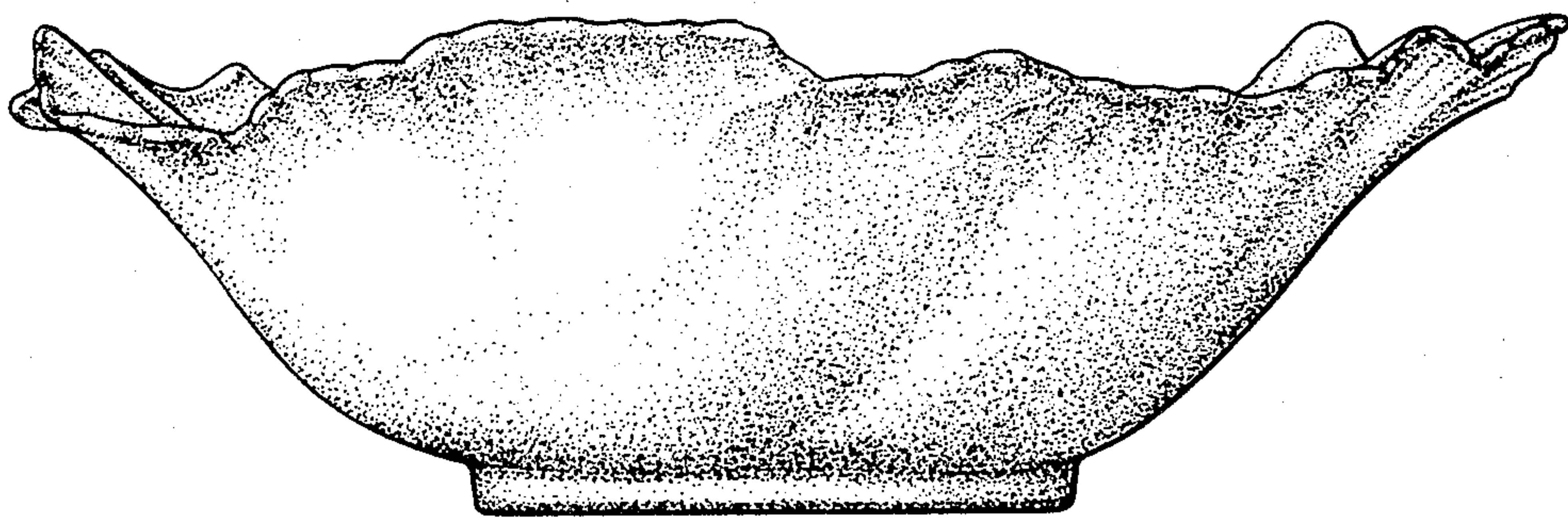

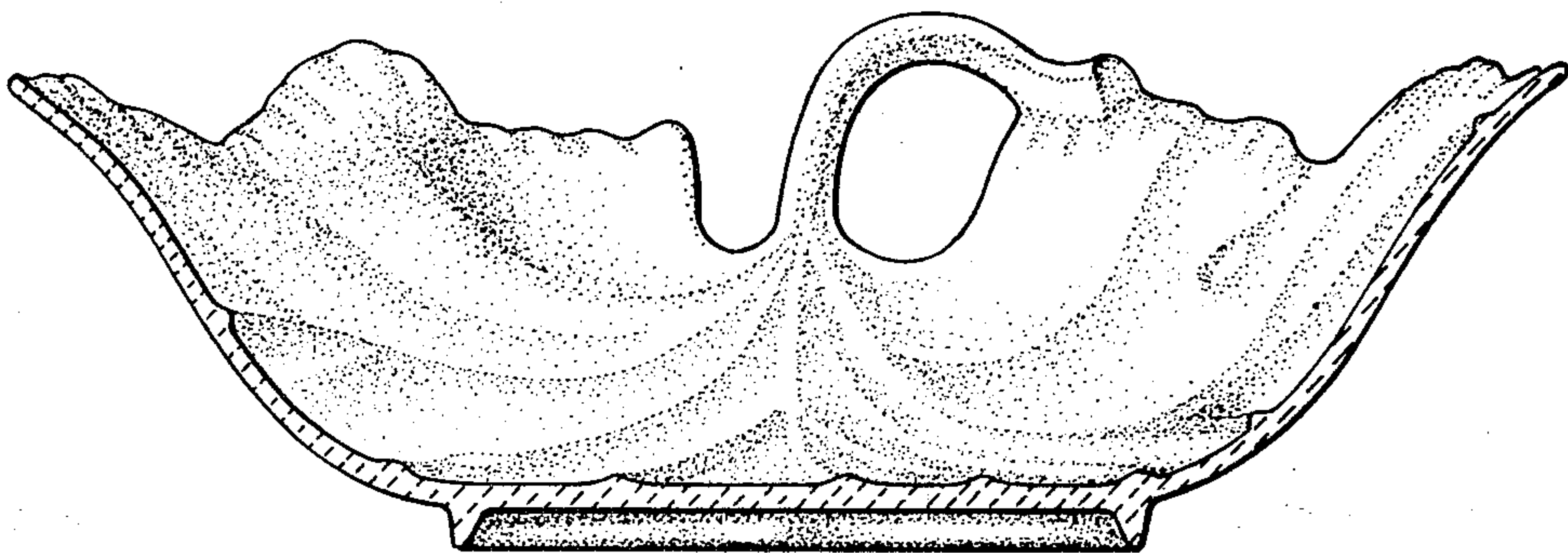
