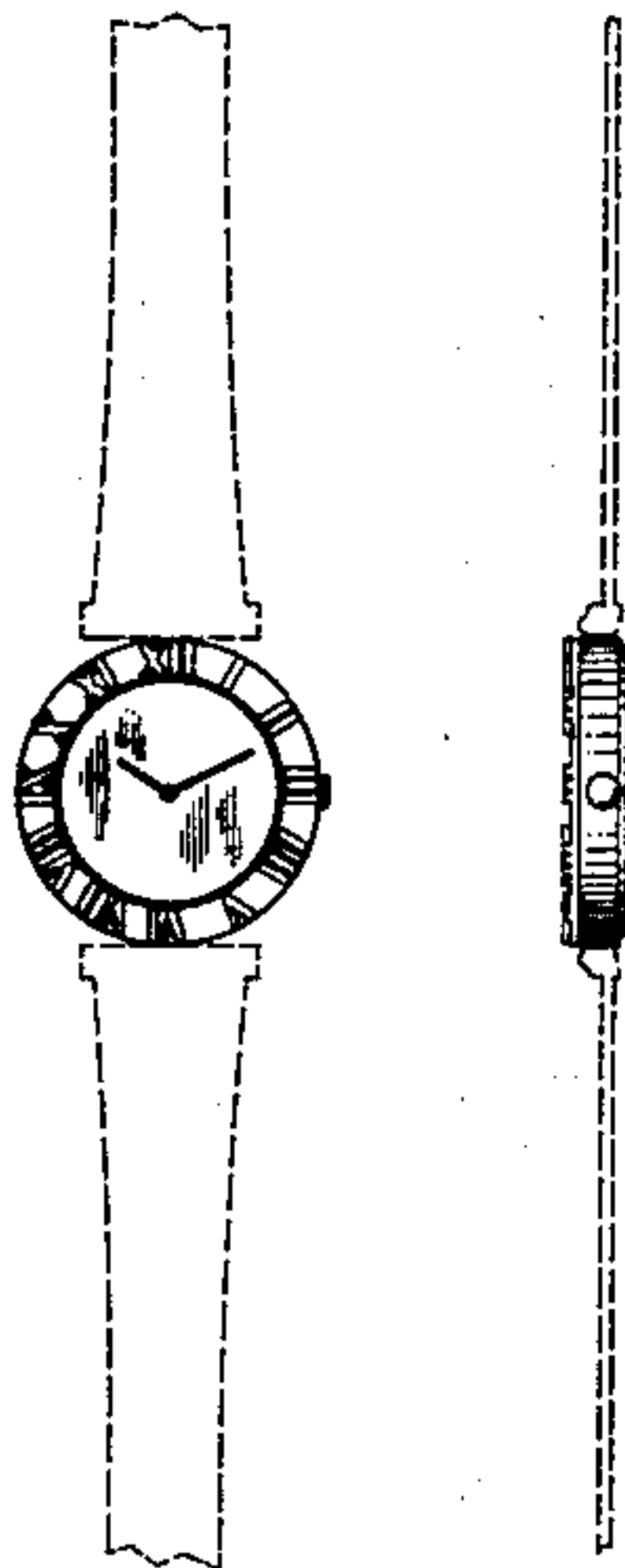

DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a top plan view of a wrist watch case showing
my new design;
FIG. 2 is a right side elevational view thereof;
FIG. 3 is a left side elevational view thereof; and
FIG. 4 is a rear elevational view thereof.

design.



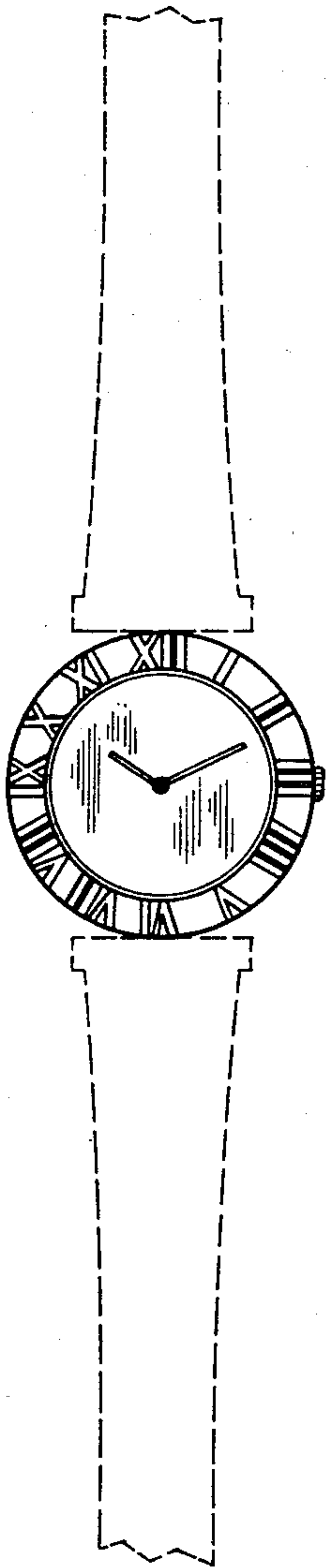

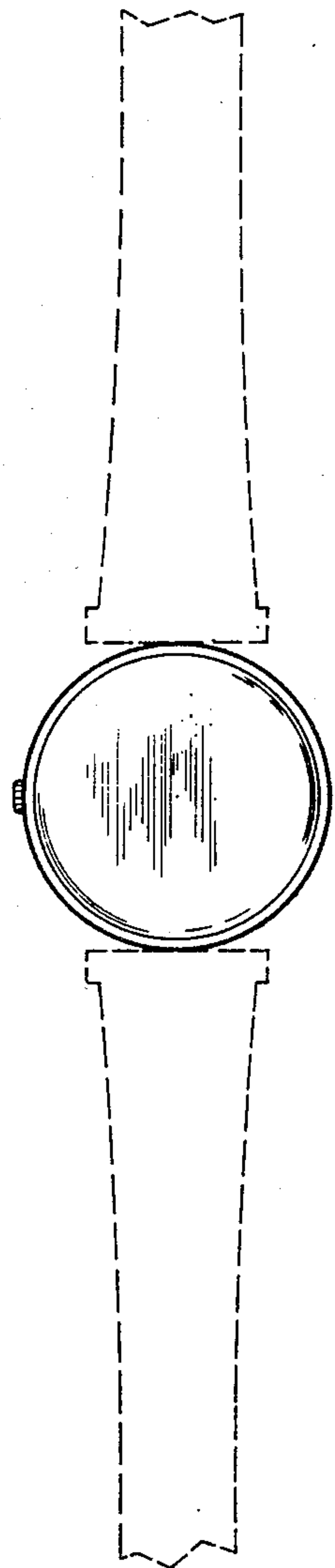
