The ornamental design for the combined toy puzzle and
puzzle pieces therefor, as shown and described.

DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a top plan view of a combined toy puzzle and
puzzle pieces therefor showing my new design;
FIG. 2 is a front elevational view thereof, the side oppo-
site being substantially a mirror image;
FIG. 3 is an end elevational view thereof, the end oppo-
site being substantially a mirror image; and,
FIG. 4 is a cross-sectional view thereof taken along line
4—4 in FIG. 1.

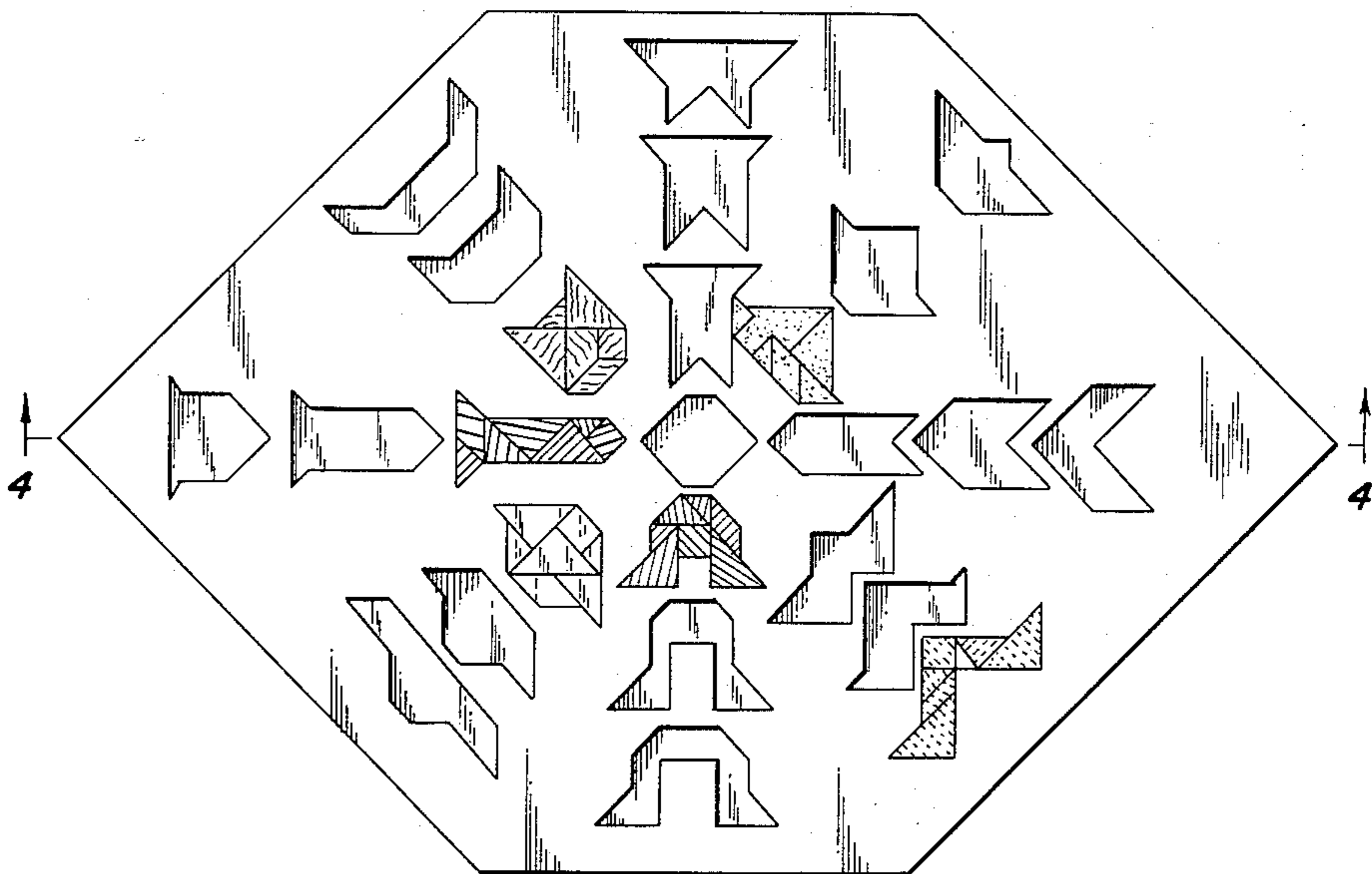
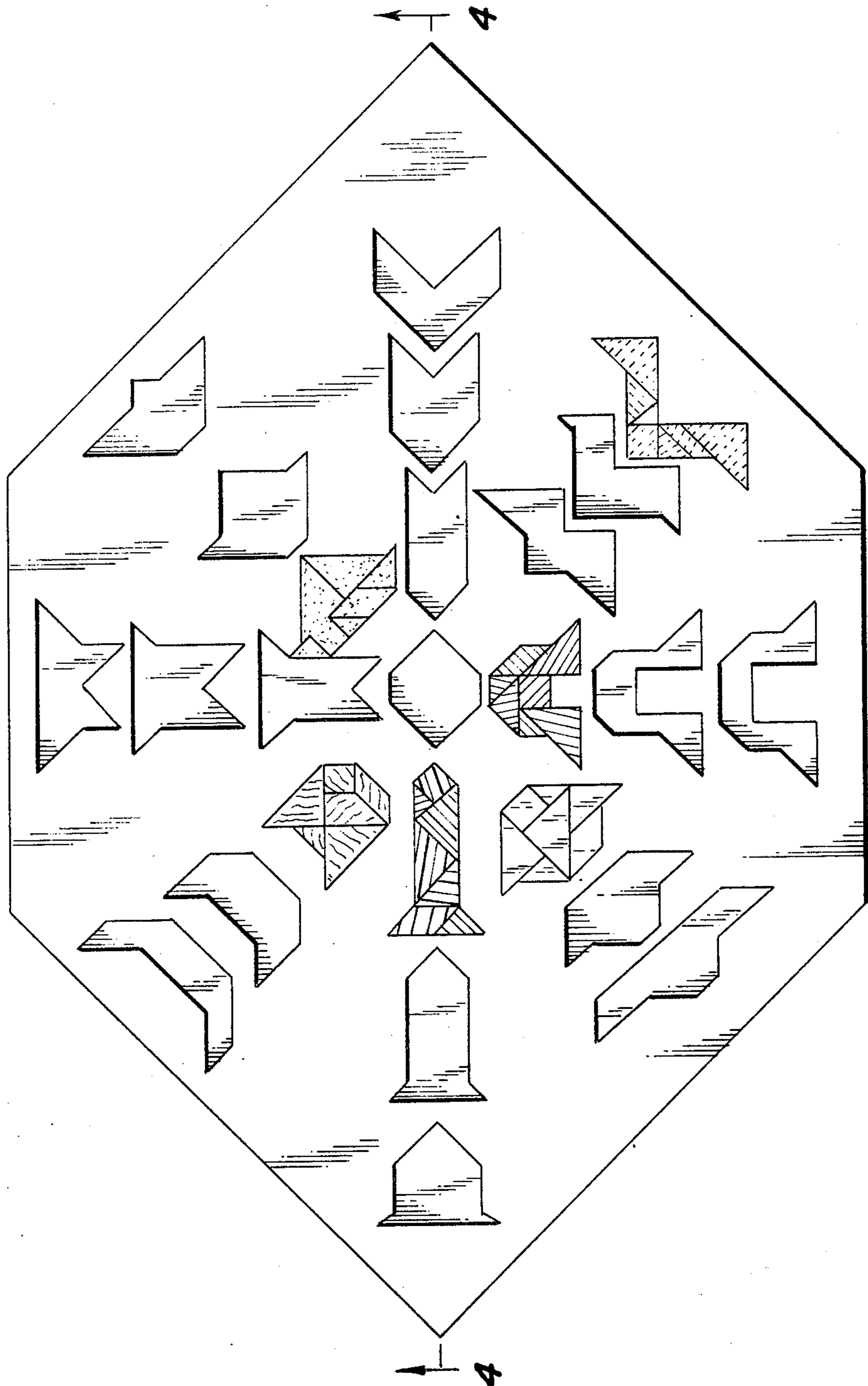
