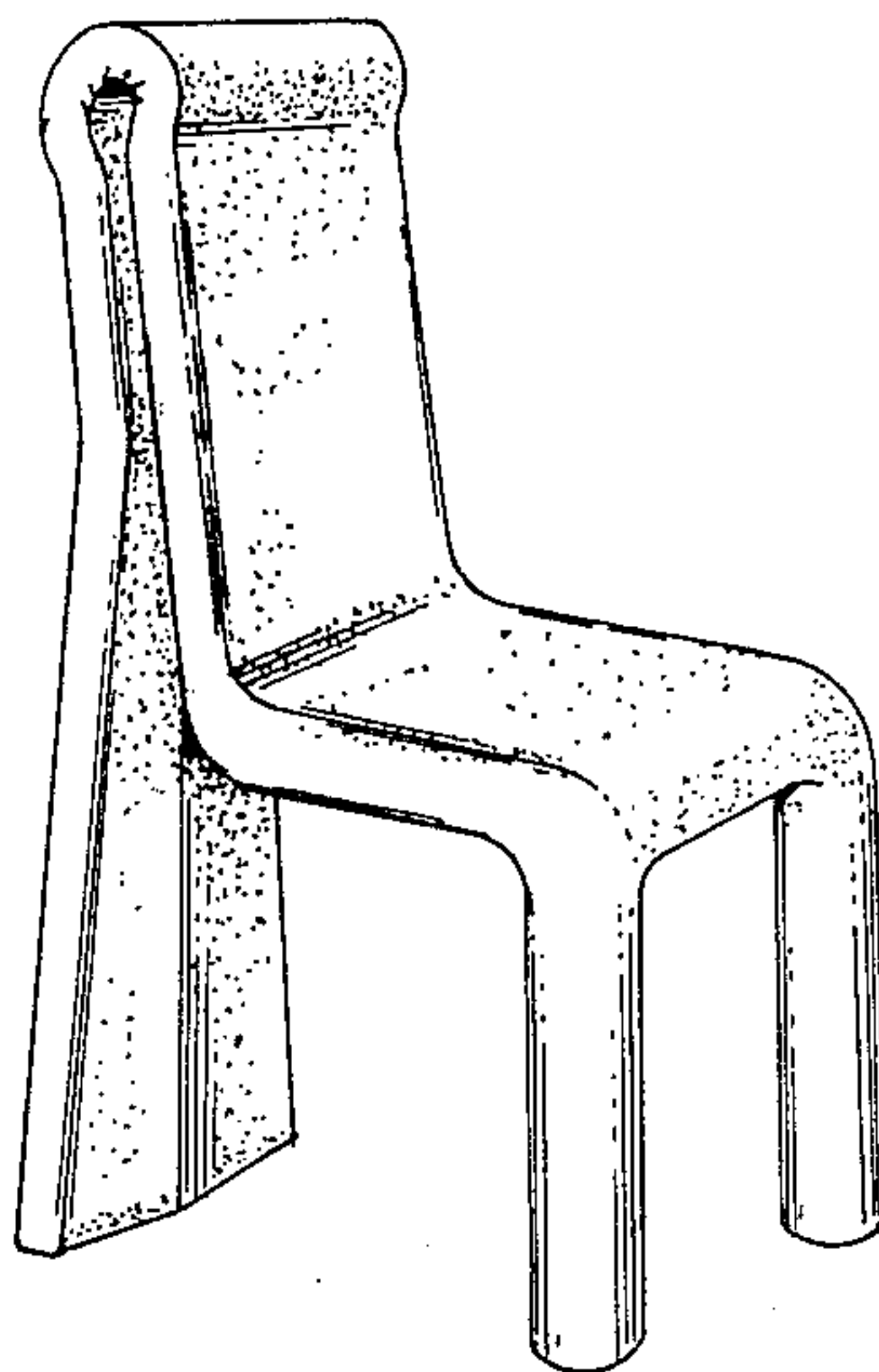

DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a side elevational view of a chair showing my design, the opposite side being a mirror image thereof; FIG. 2 is a front elevational view; FIG. 3 is a top plan view; FIG. 4 is a rear elevational view; FIG. 5 is a bottom plan view; and FIG. 6 is a front perspective view thereof.



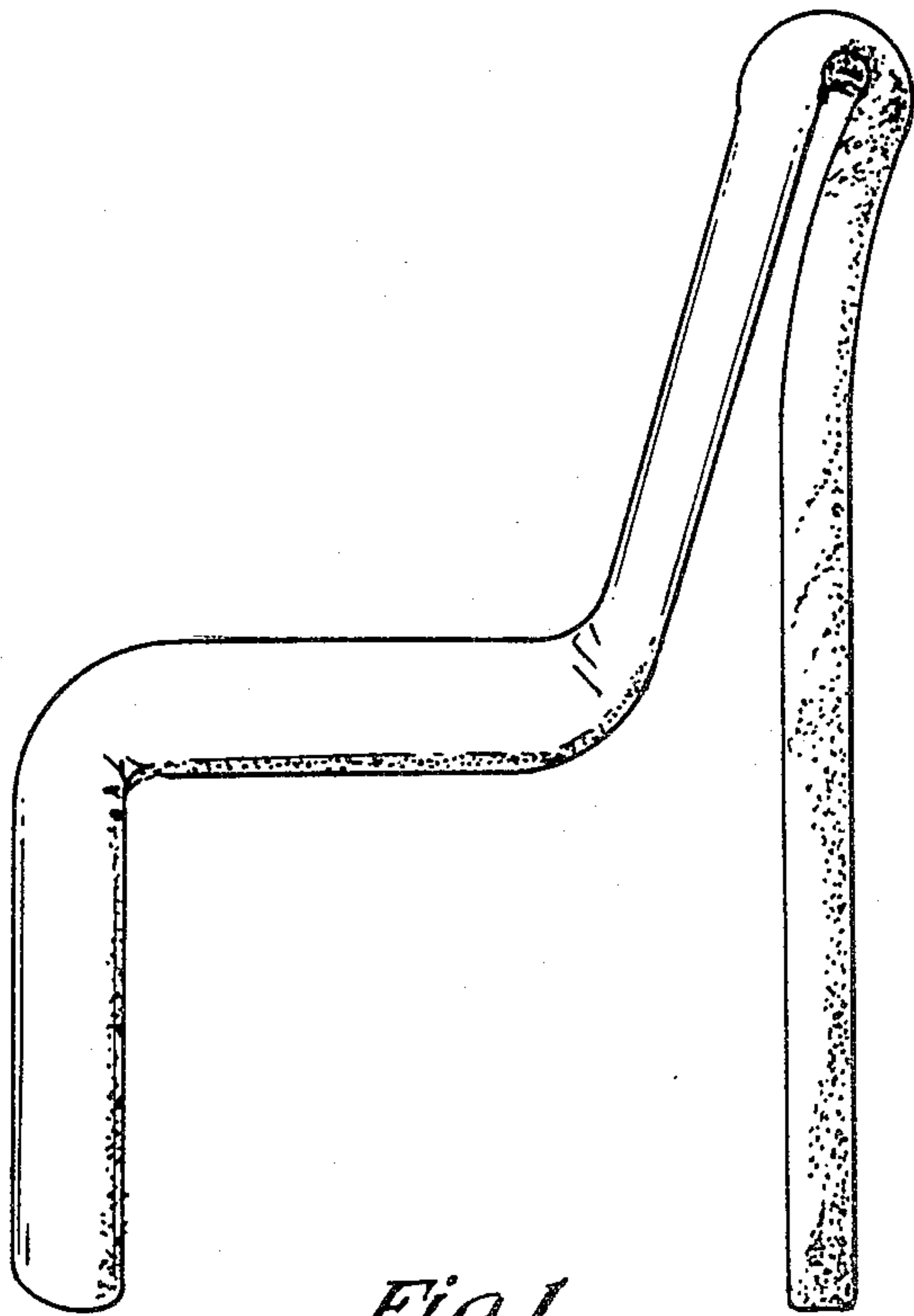

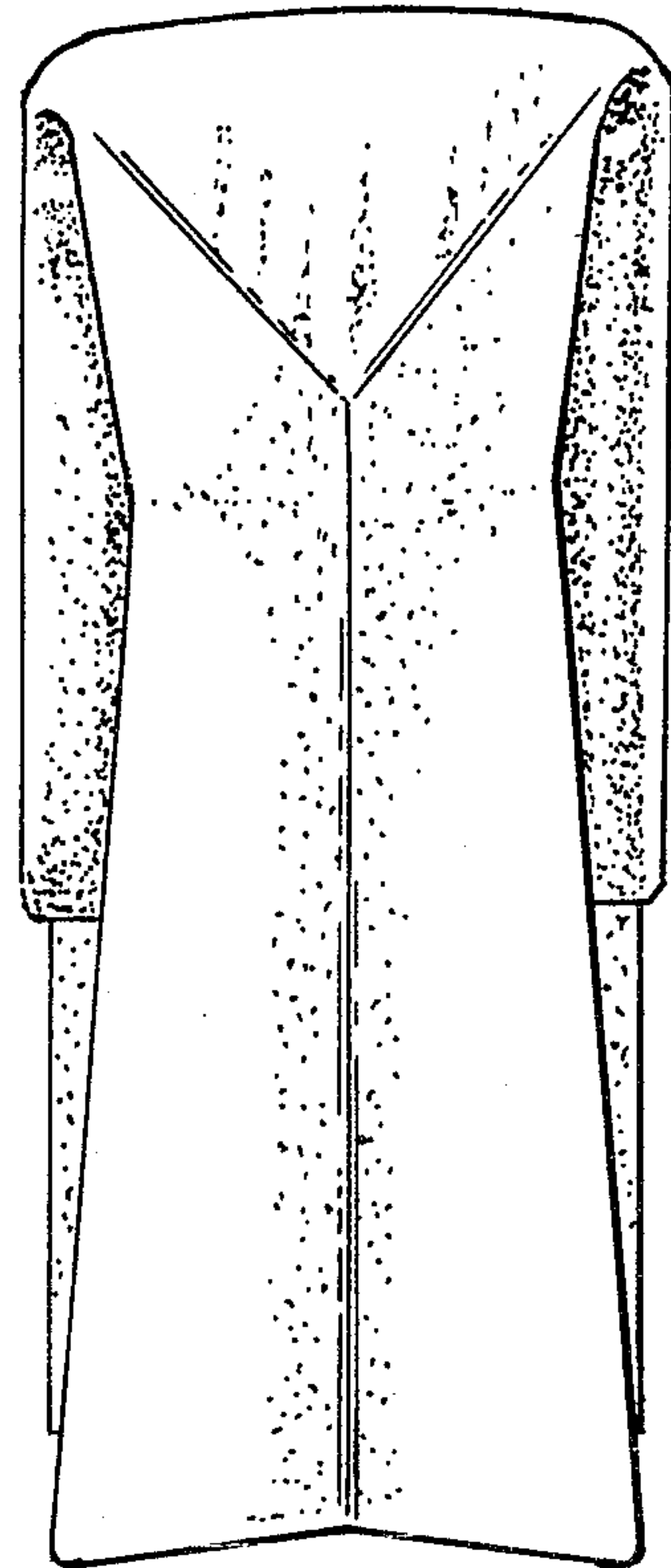

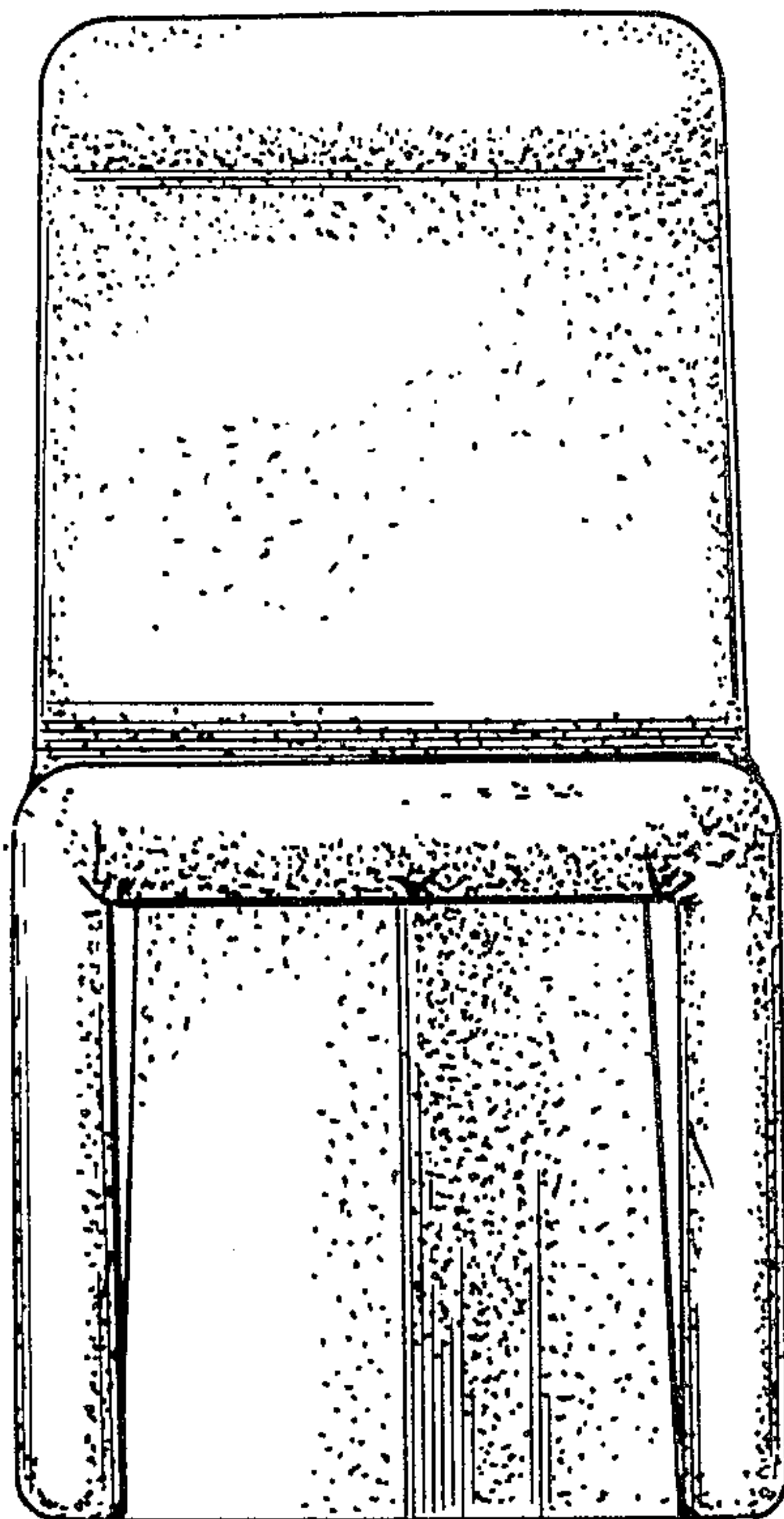

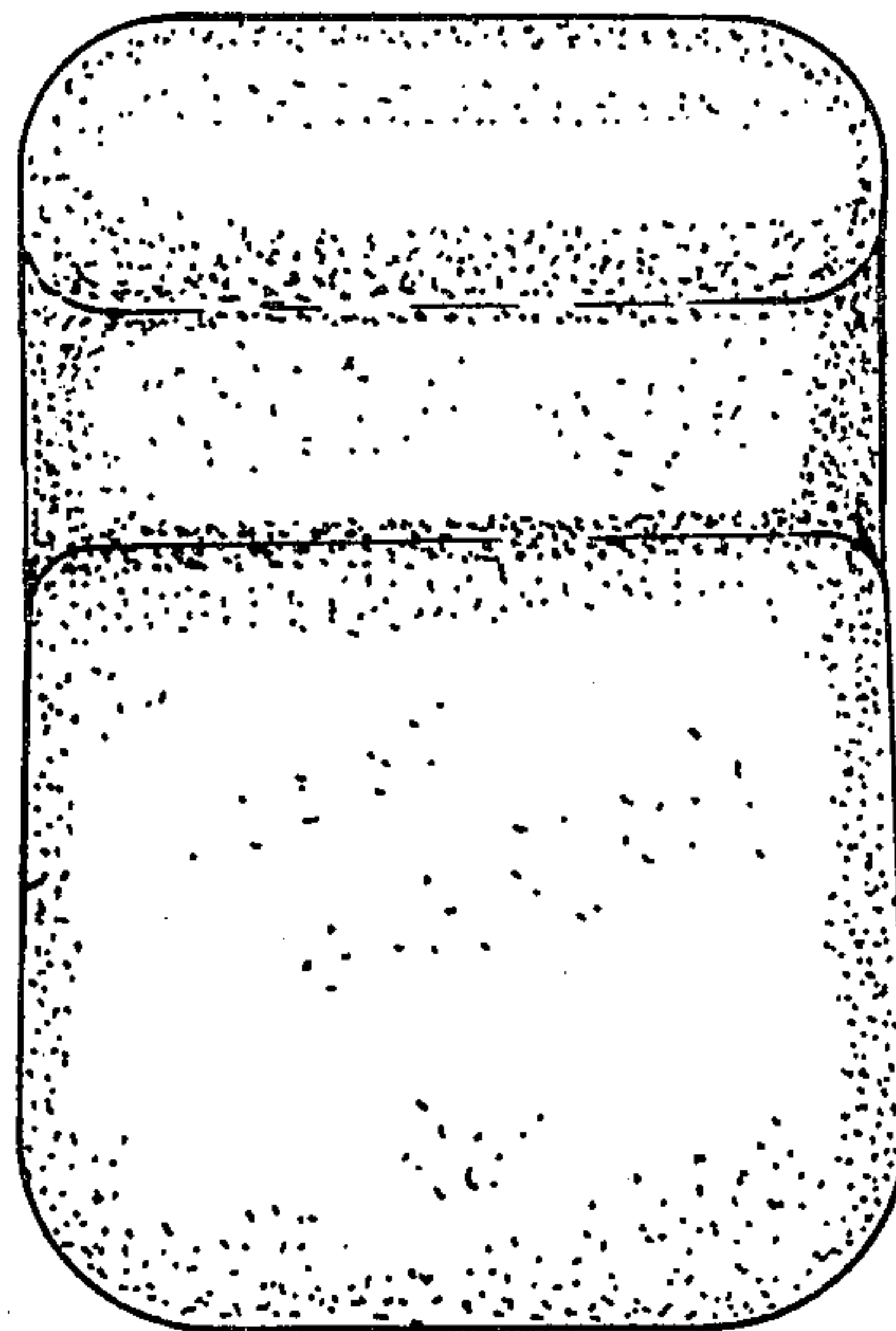

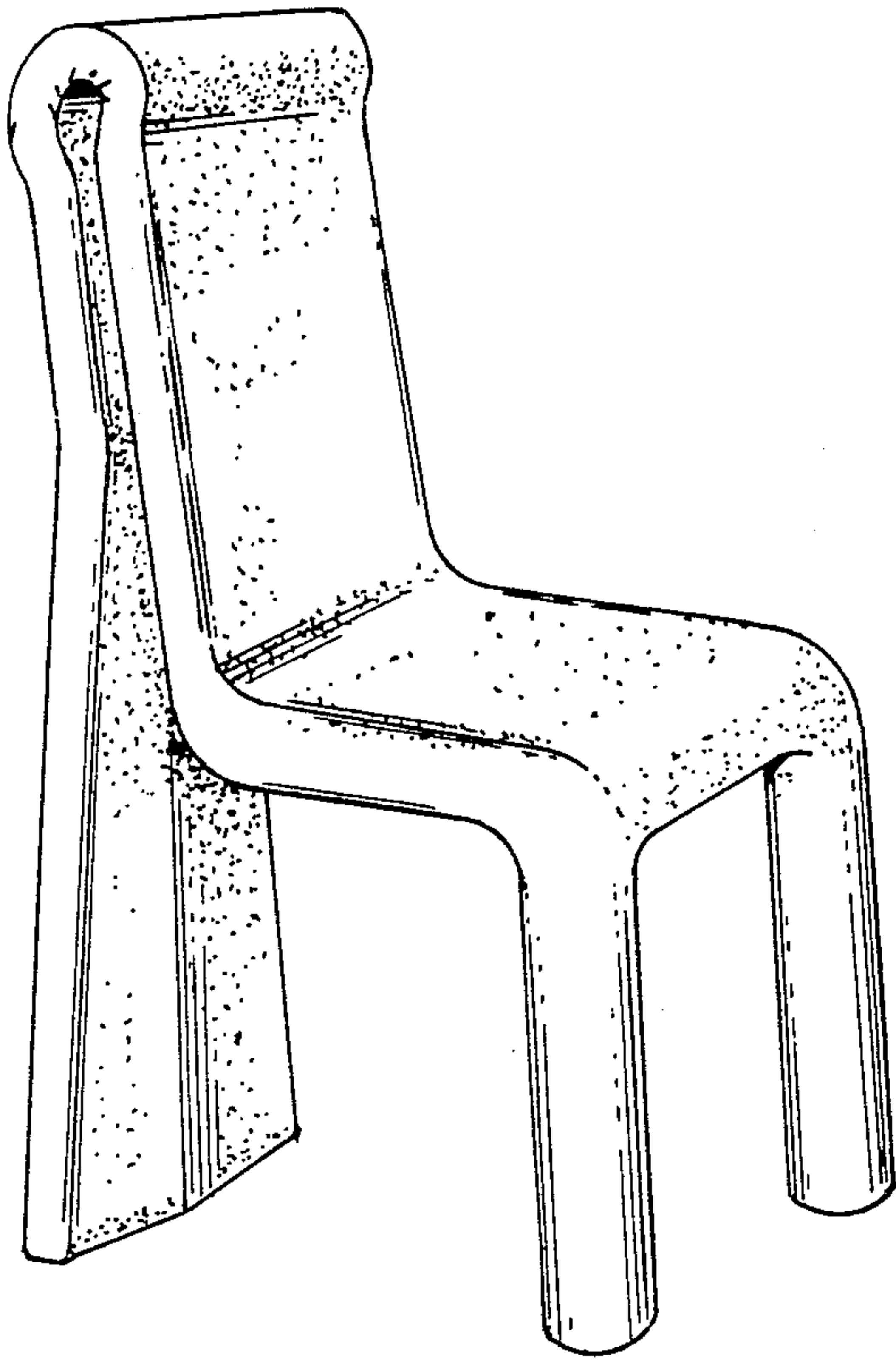

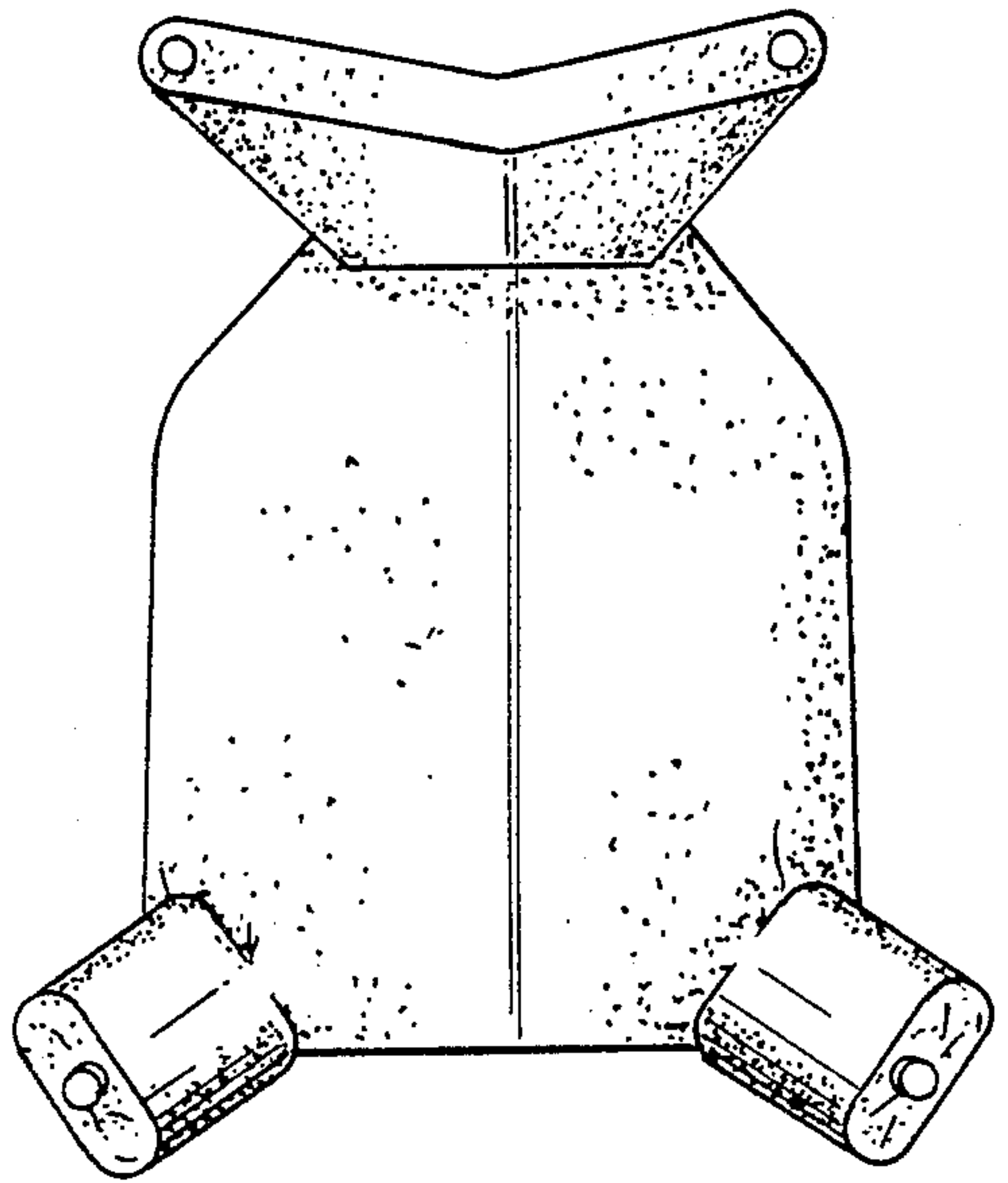
