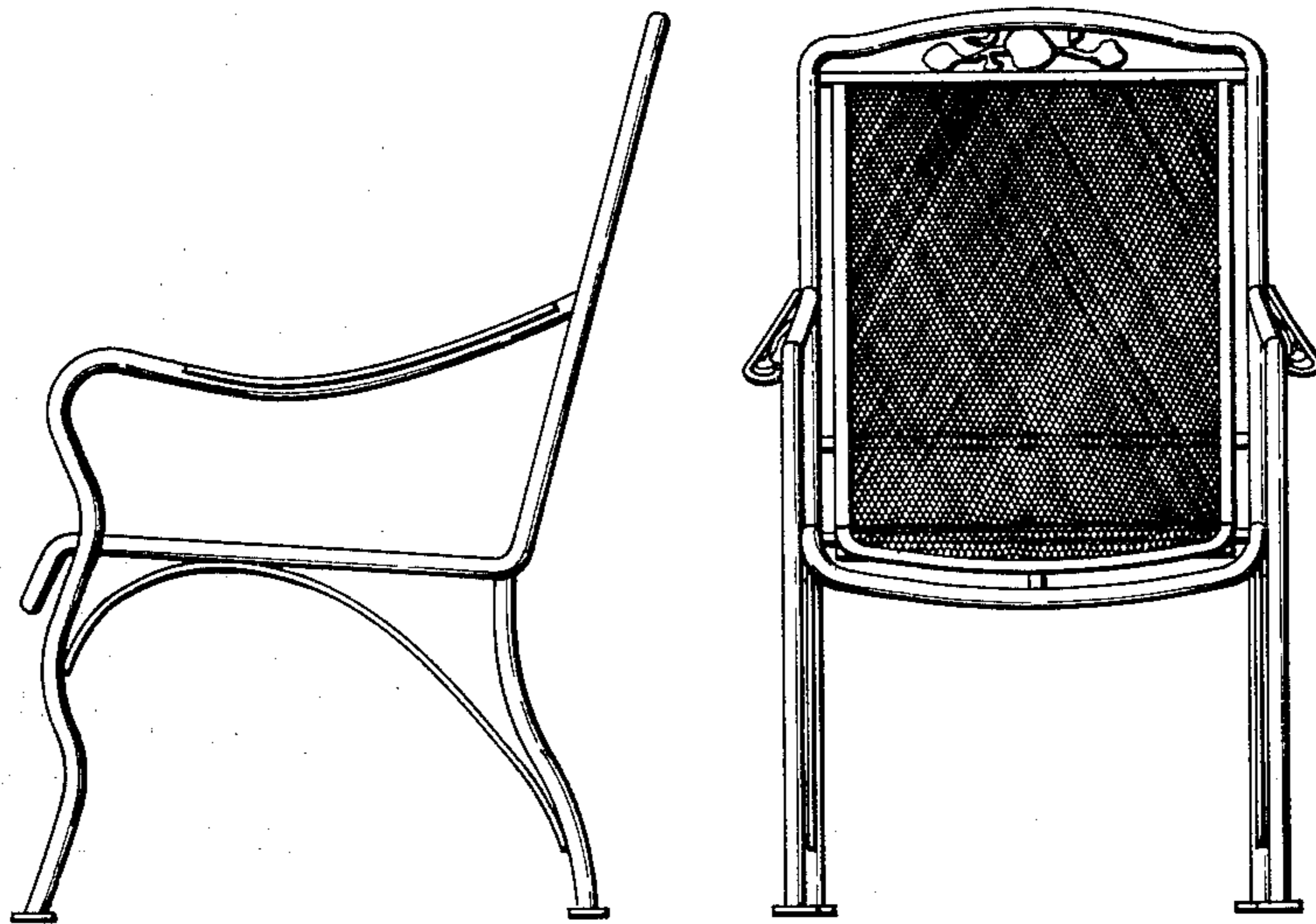

DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a left side elevational view of a chair embodying my new design;  
 FIG. 2 is a front elevational view thereof;  
 FIG. 3 is a rear elevational view thereof;  
 FIG. 4 is a top plan view thereof, and  
 FIG. 5 is a bottom plan view thereof.  
 The side opposite that which is illustrated in FIG. 1 is a mirror image of FIG. 1.



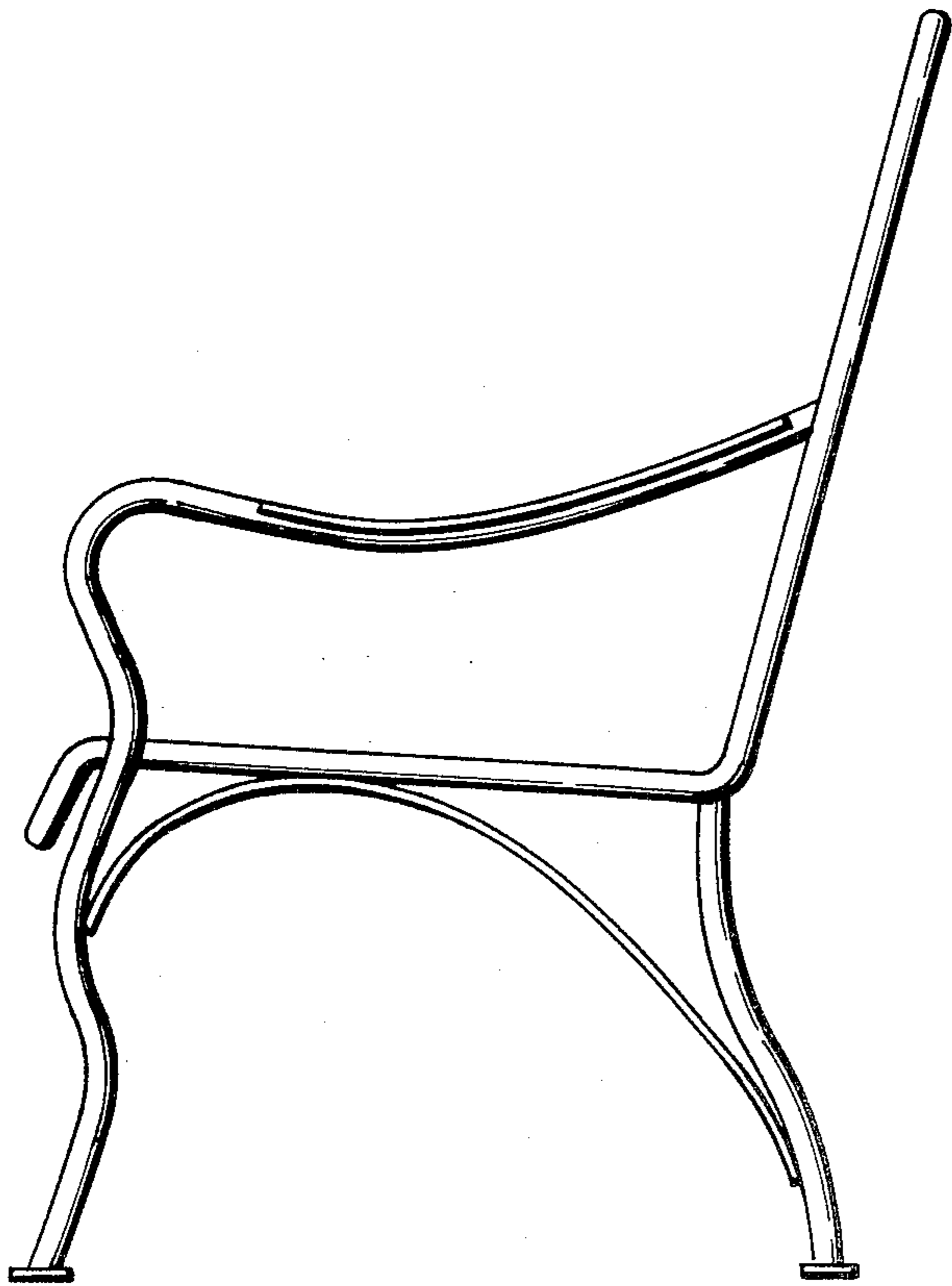

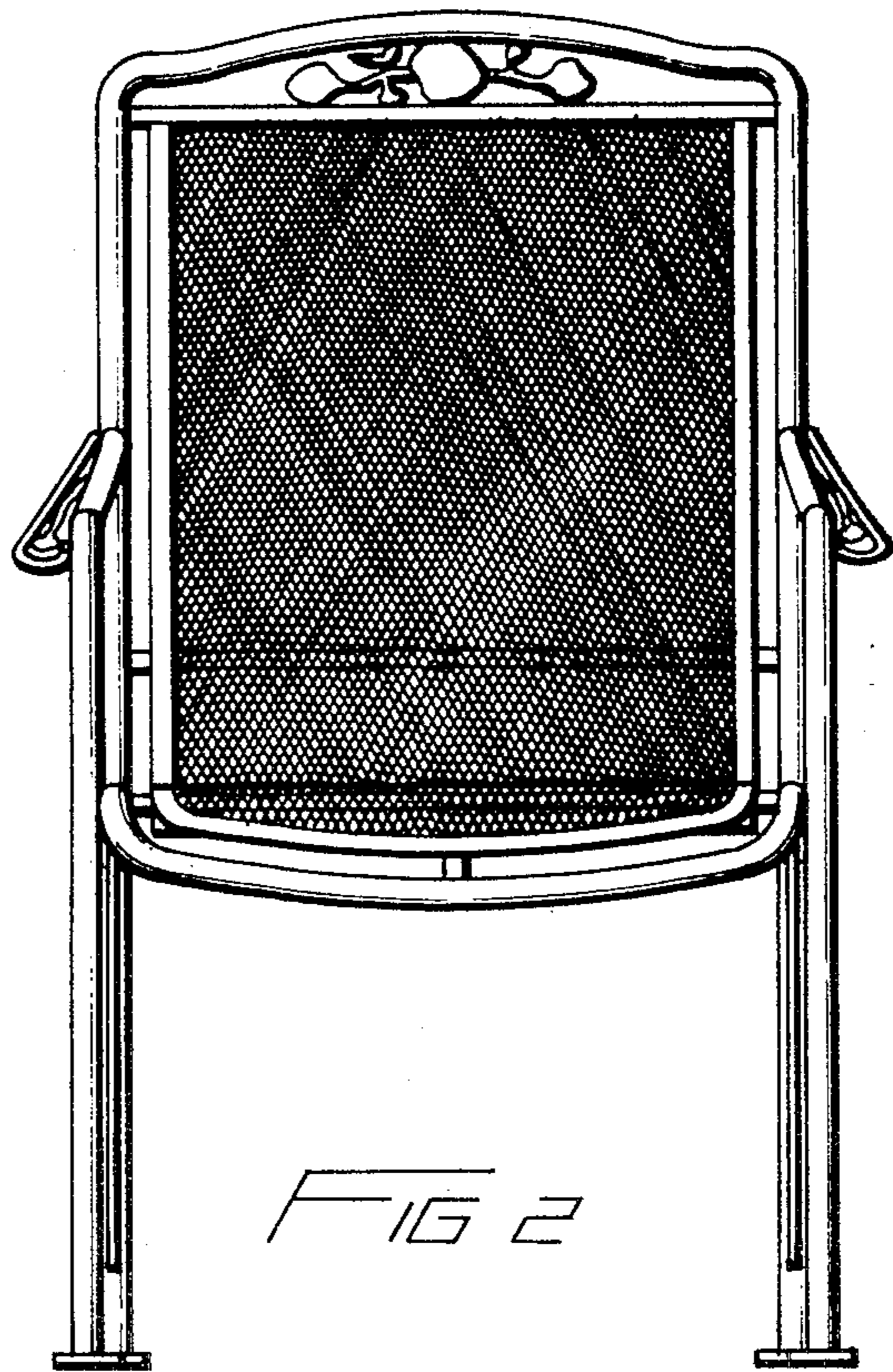

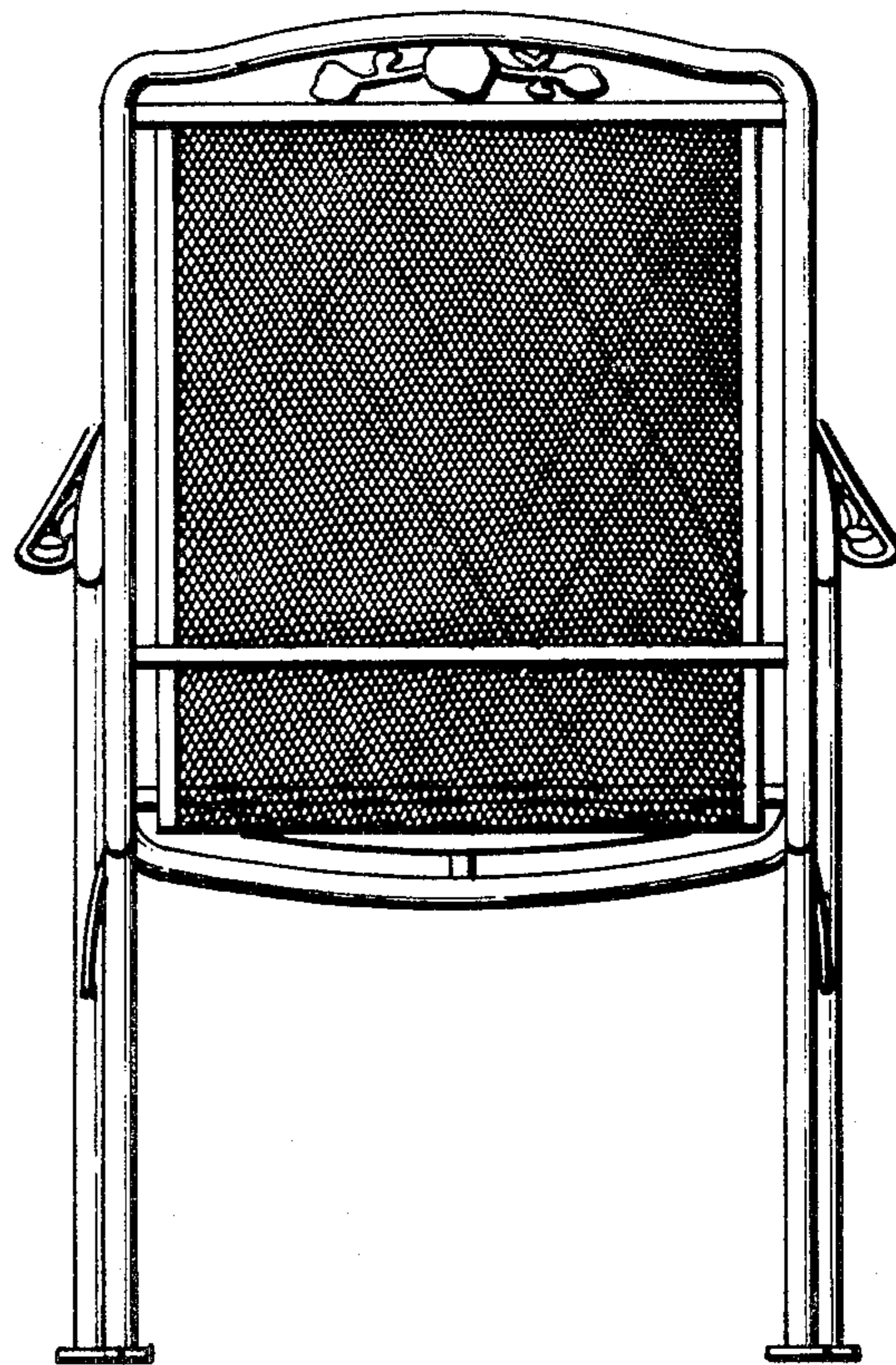

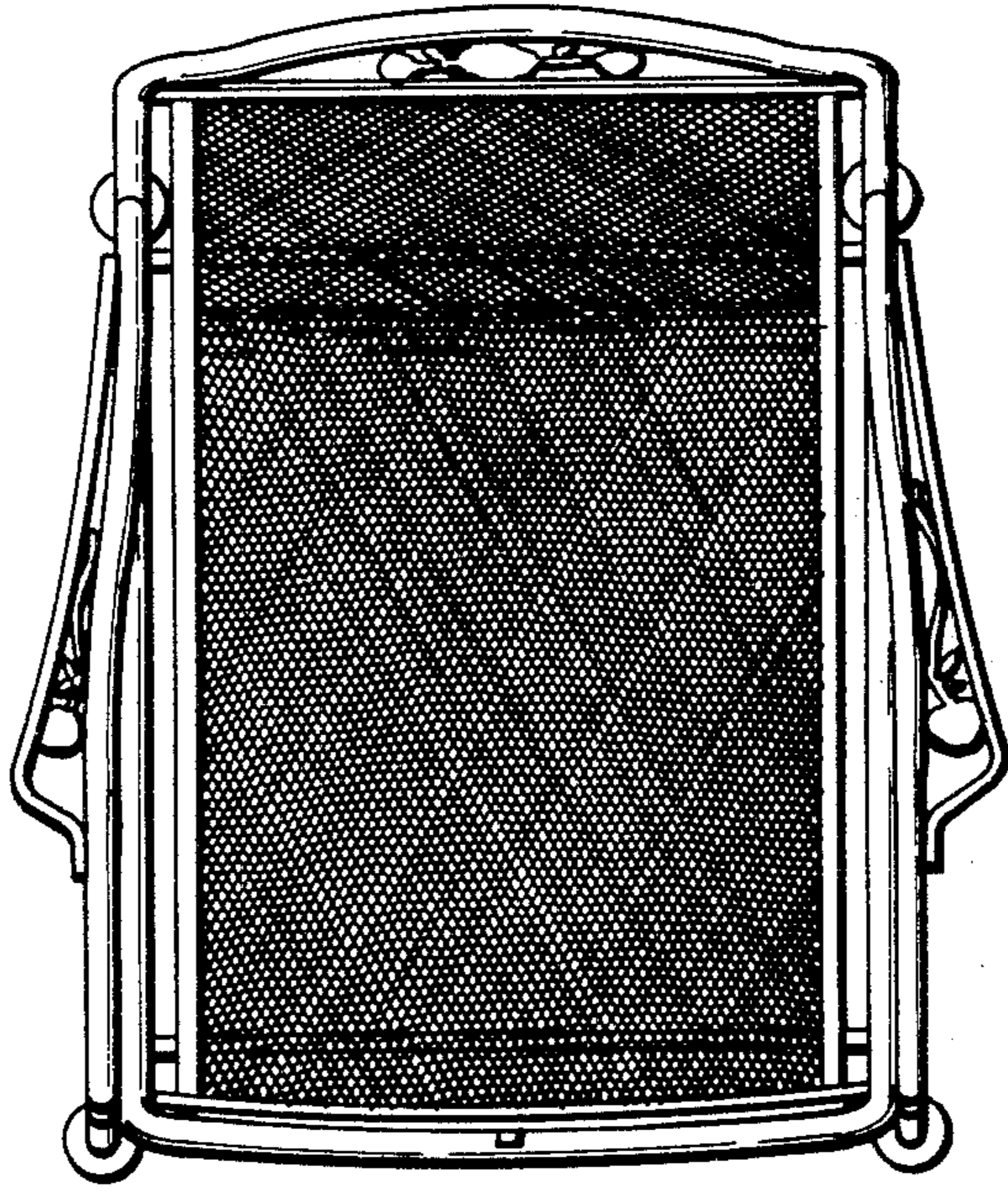
