The ornamental design for a cordial goblet, as shown and described.

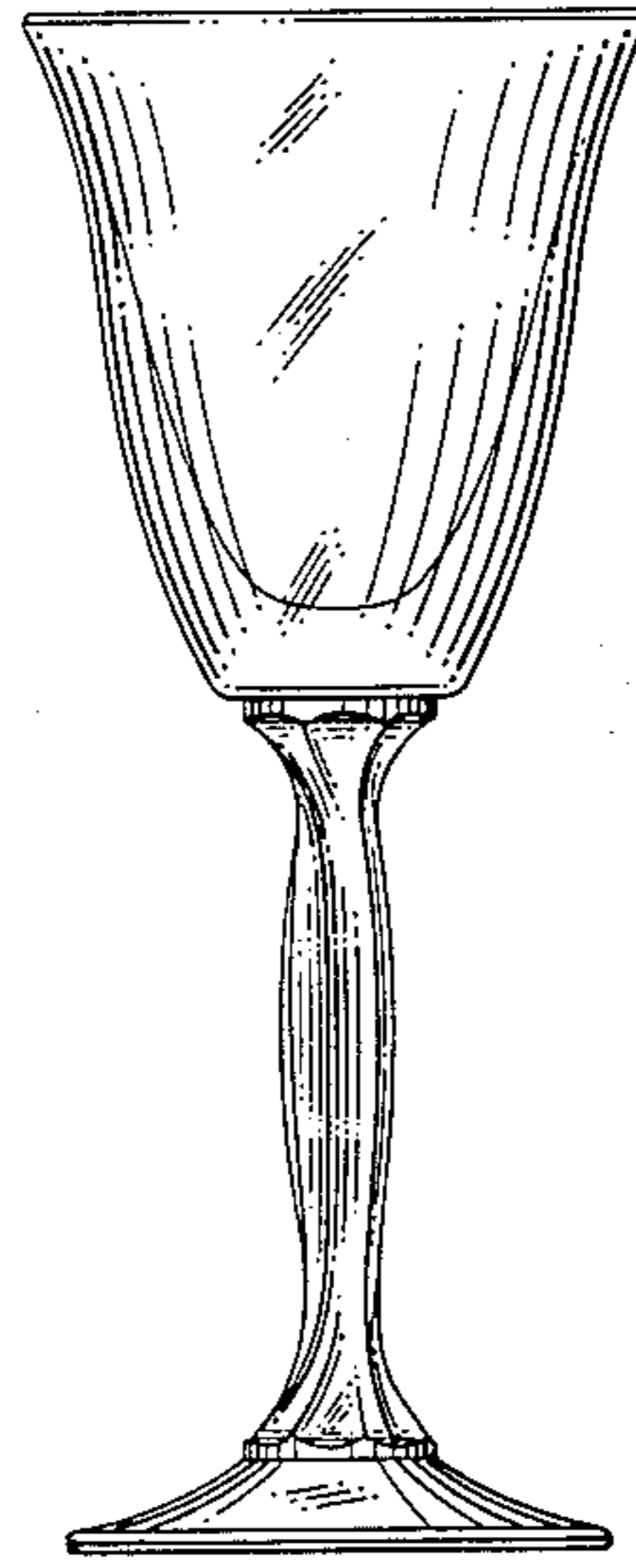
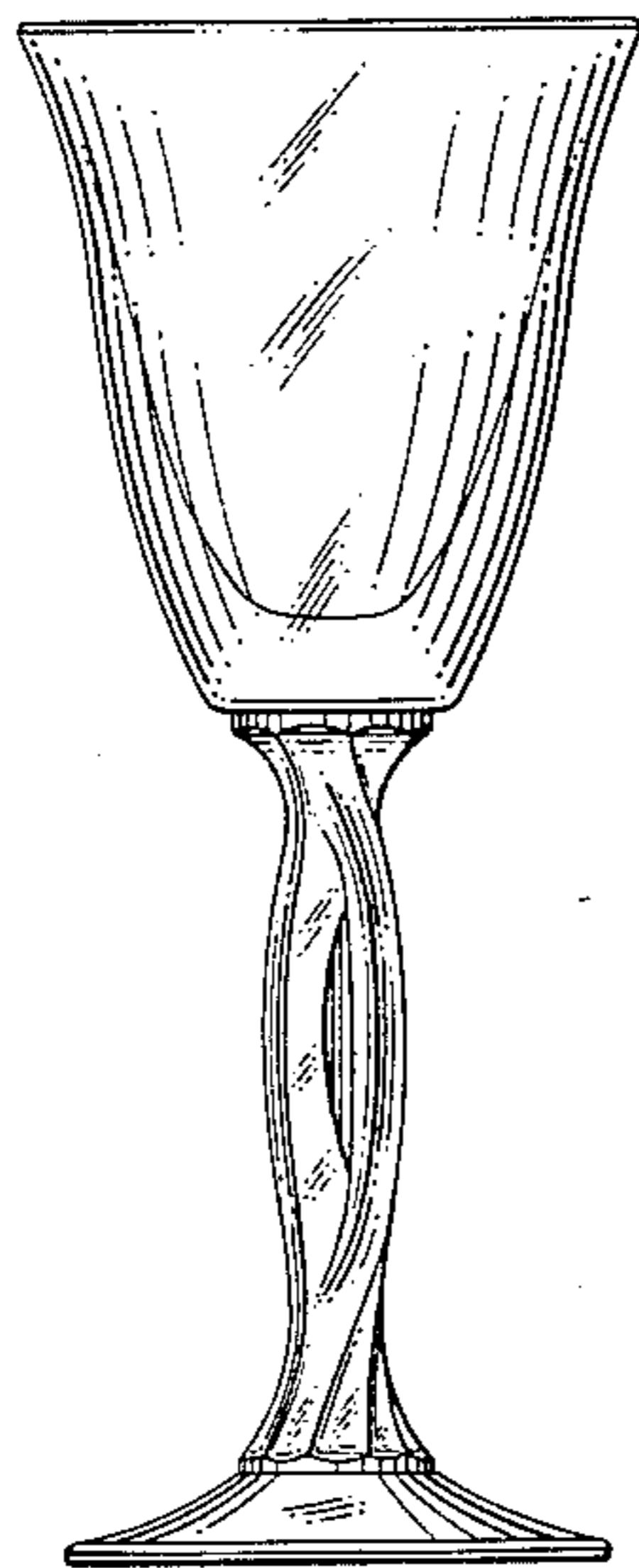
DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a front elevational view of a cordial goblet showing my new design, the rear elevational view being identical;

FIG. 2 is a right side elevational view thereof, the left side elevational view being identical;

FIG. 3 is a top plan view thereof; and

FIG. 4 is a bottom plan view thereof.



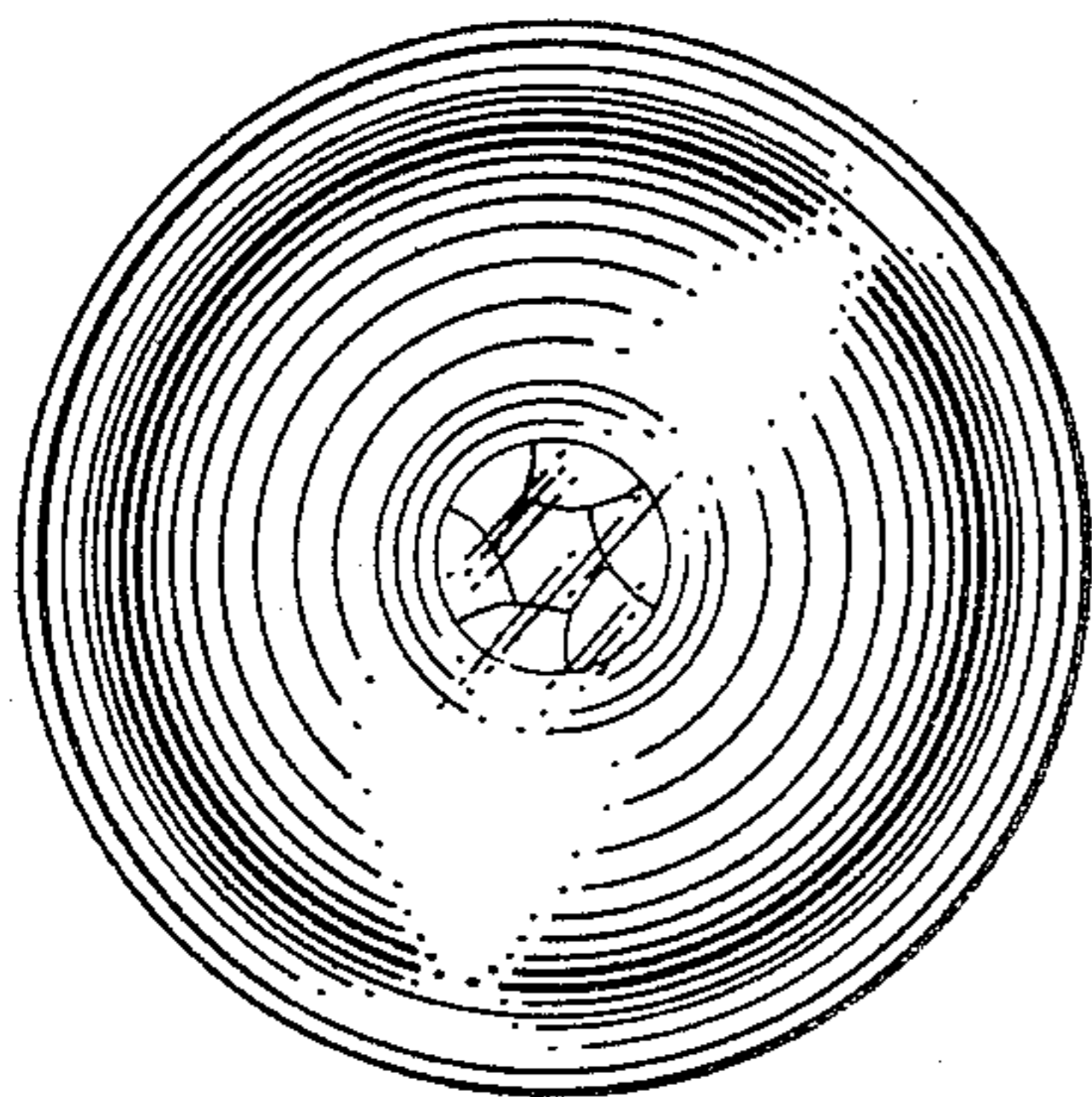

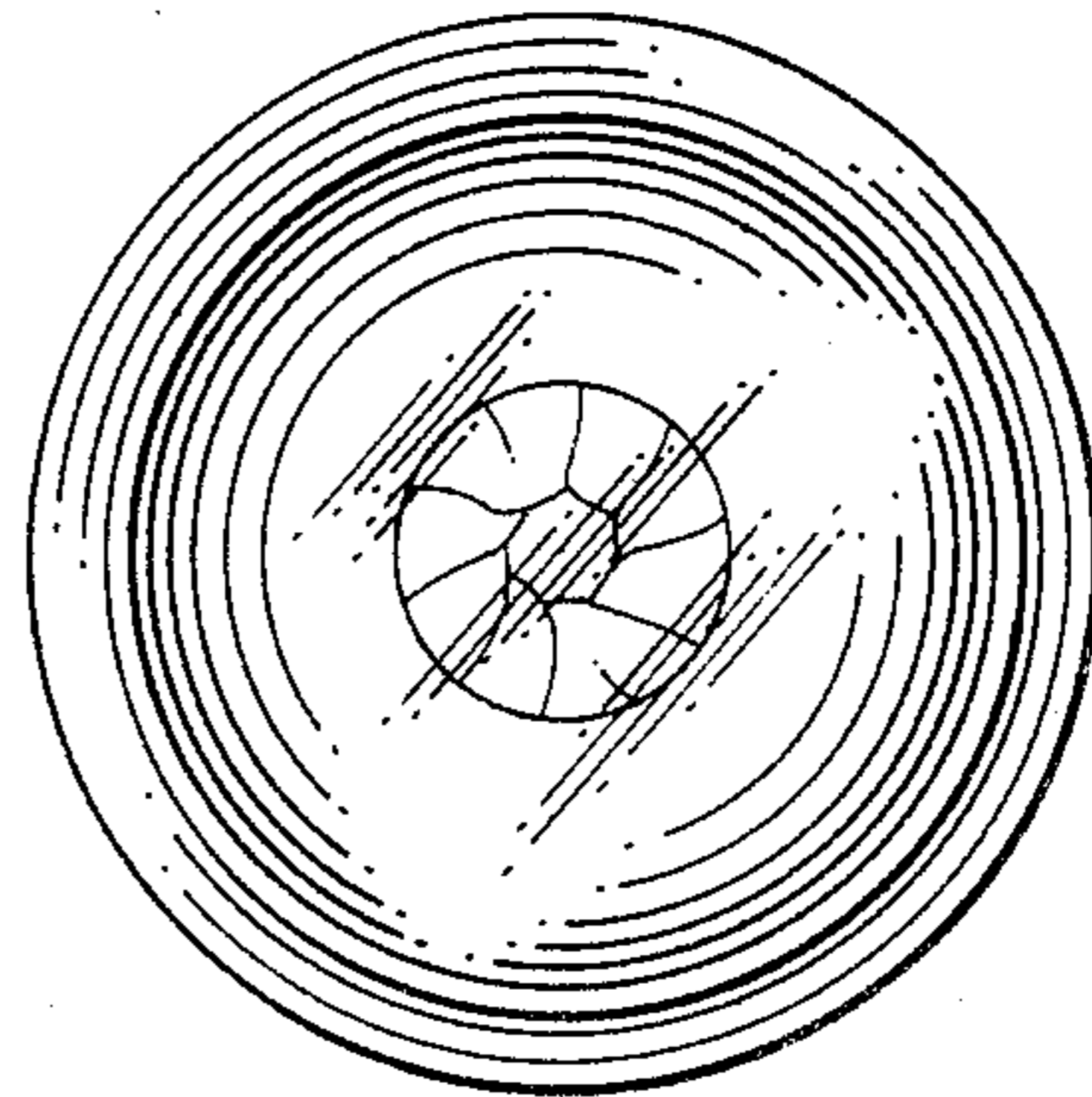

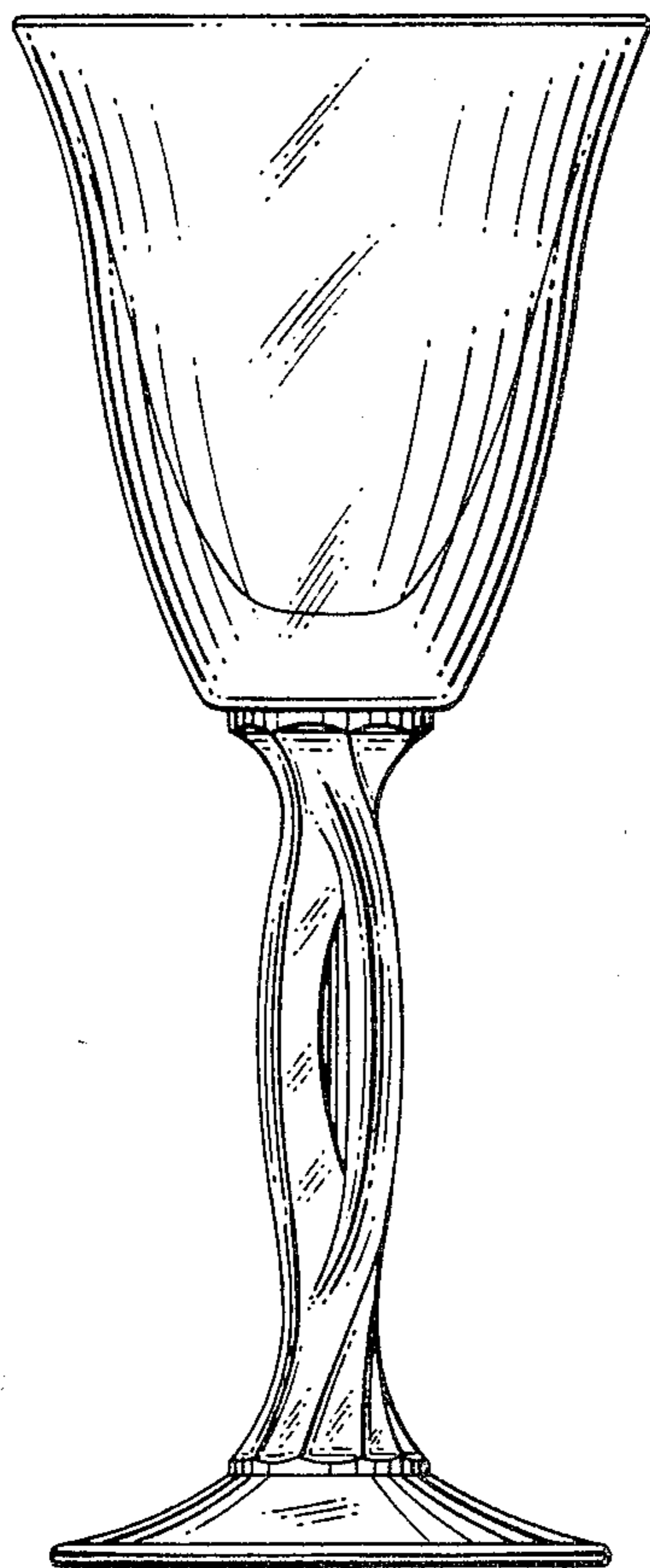

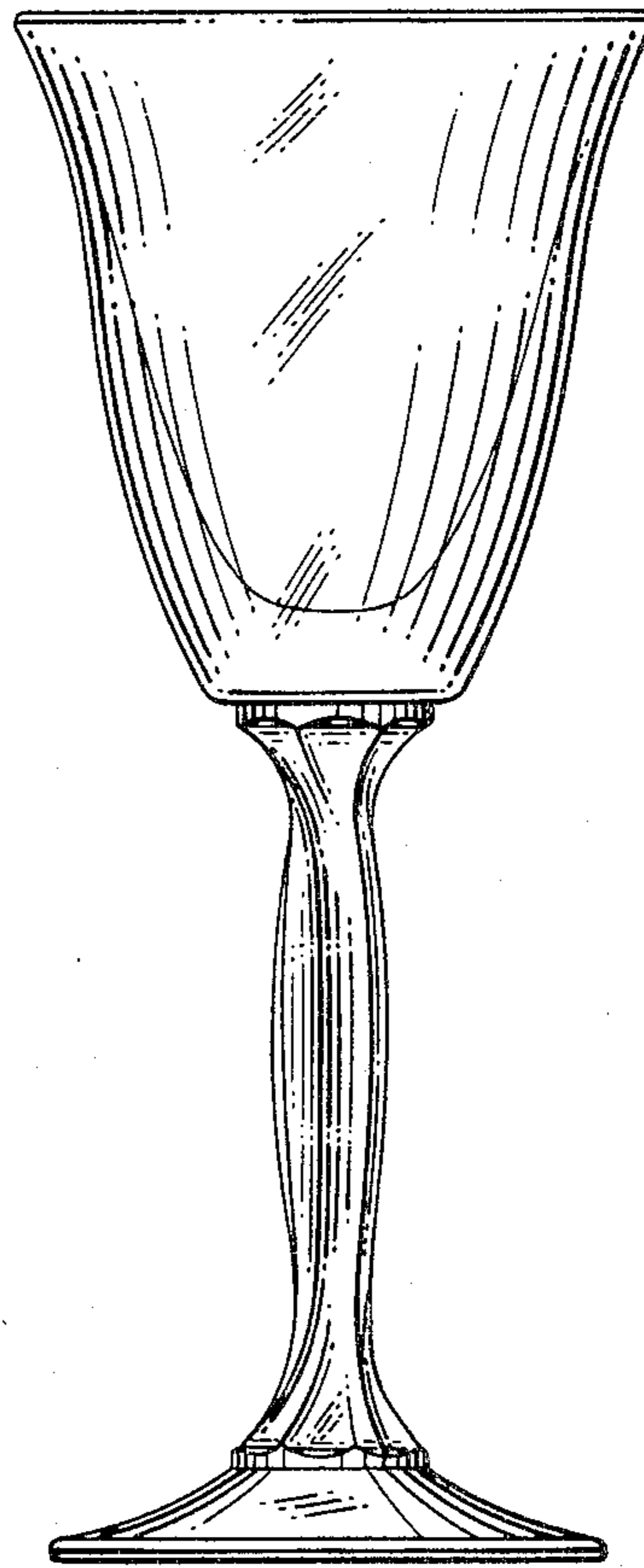
