The ornamental design for a wine goblet, as shown and described.

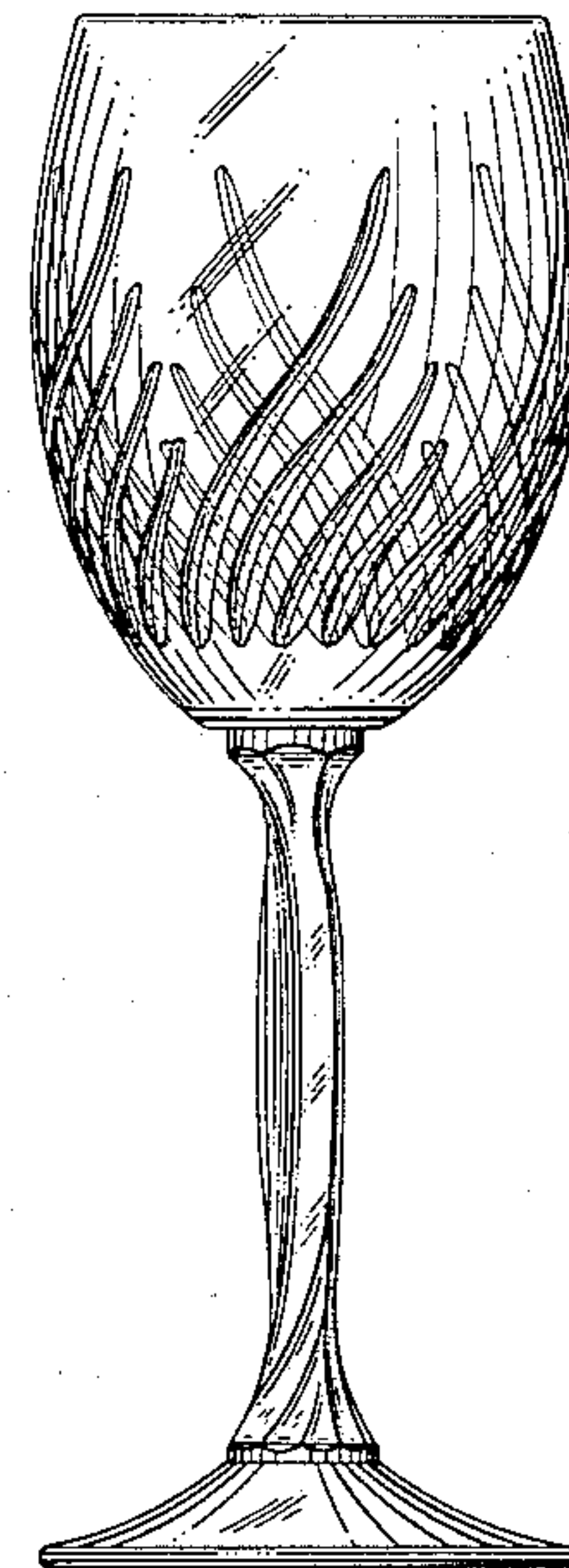
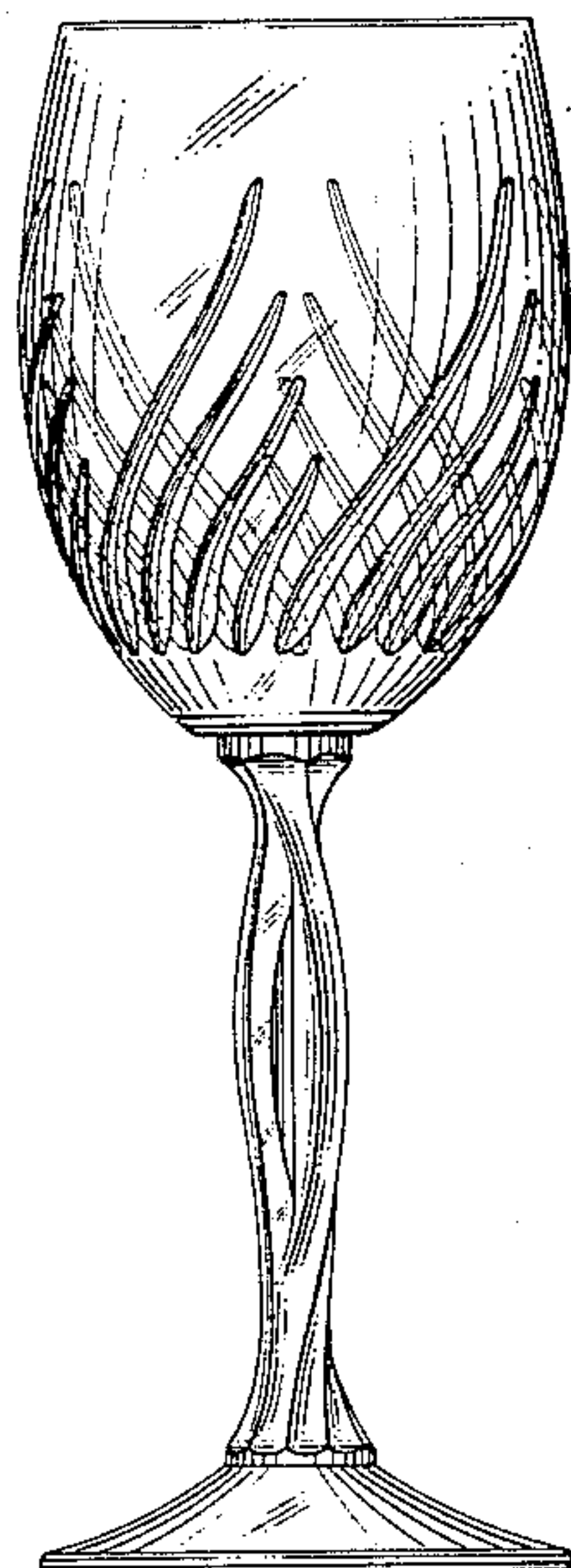
DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a front elevational view of a wine goblet showing my new design, the rear elevational view being identical;

FIG. 4 is a bottom plan view thereof.



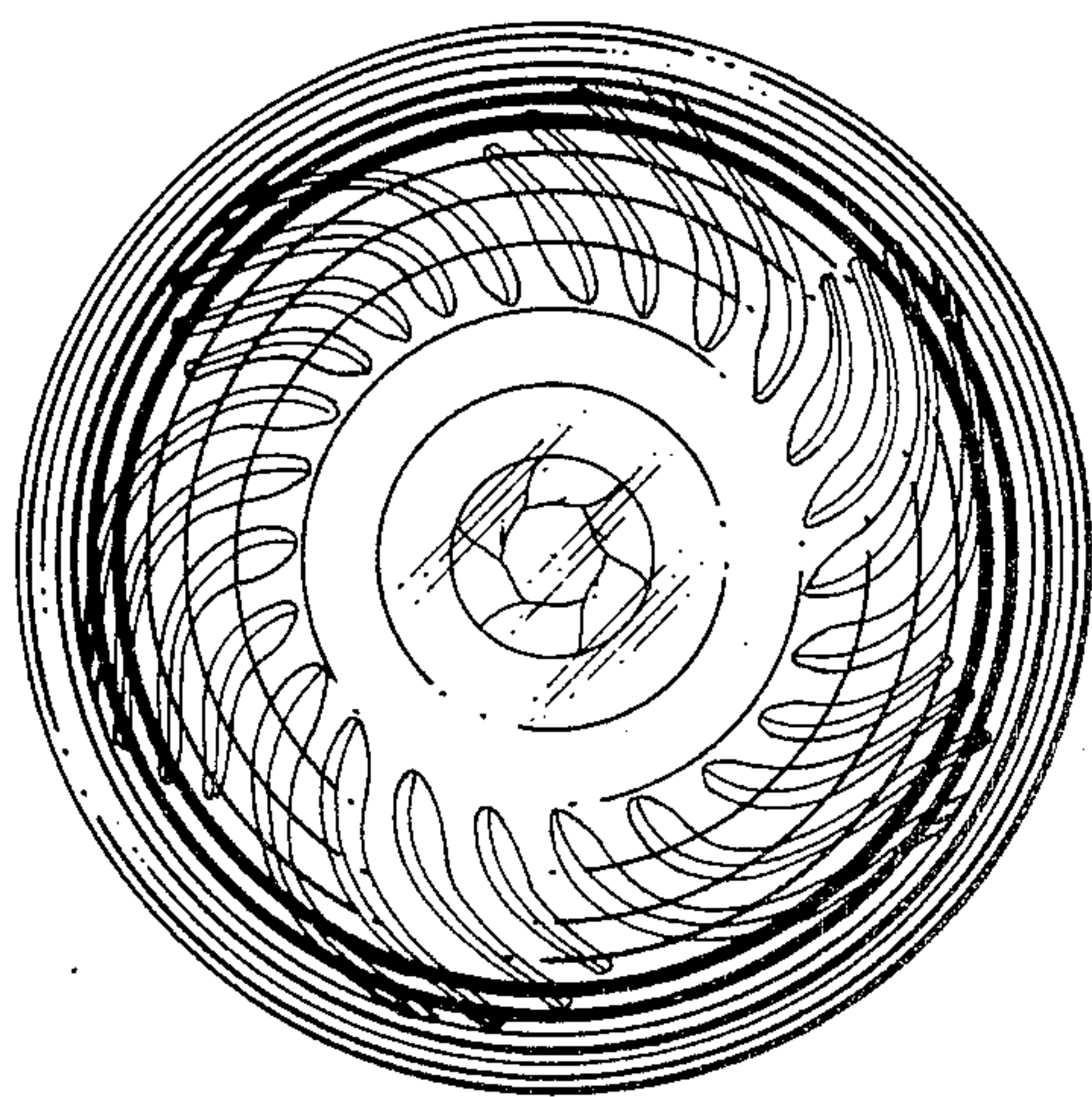

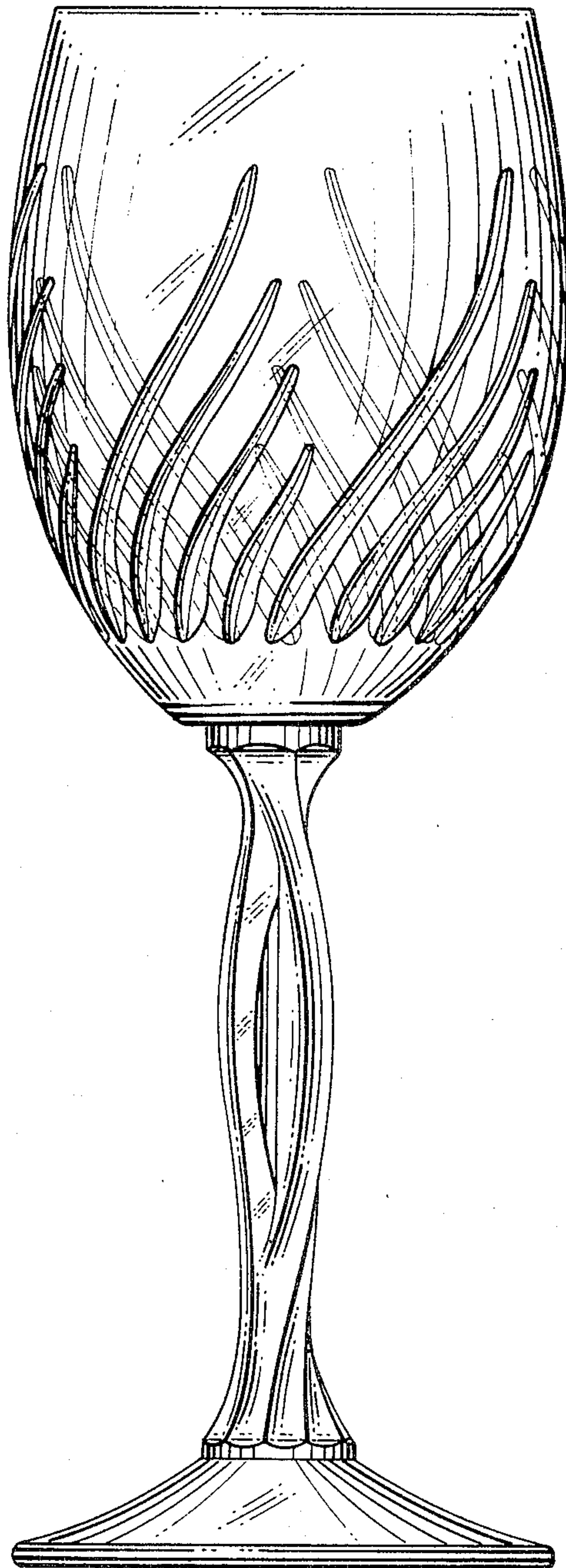

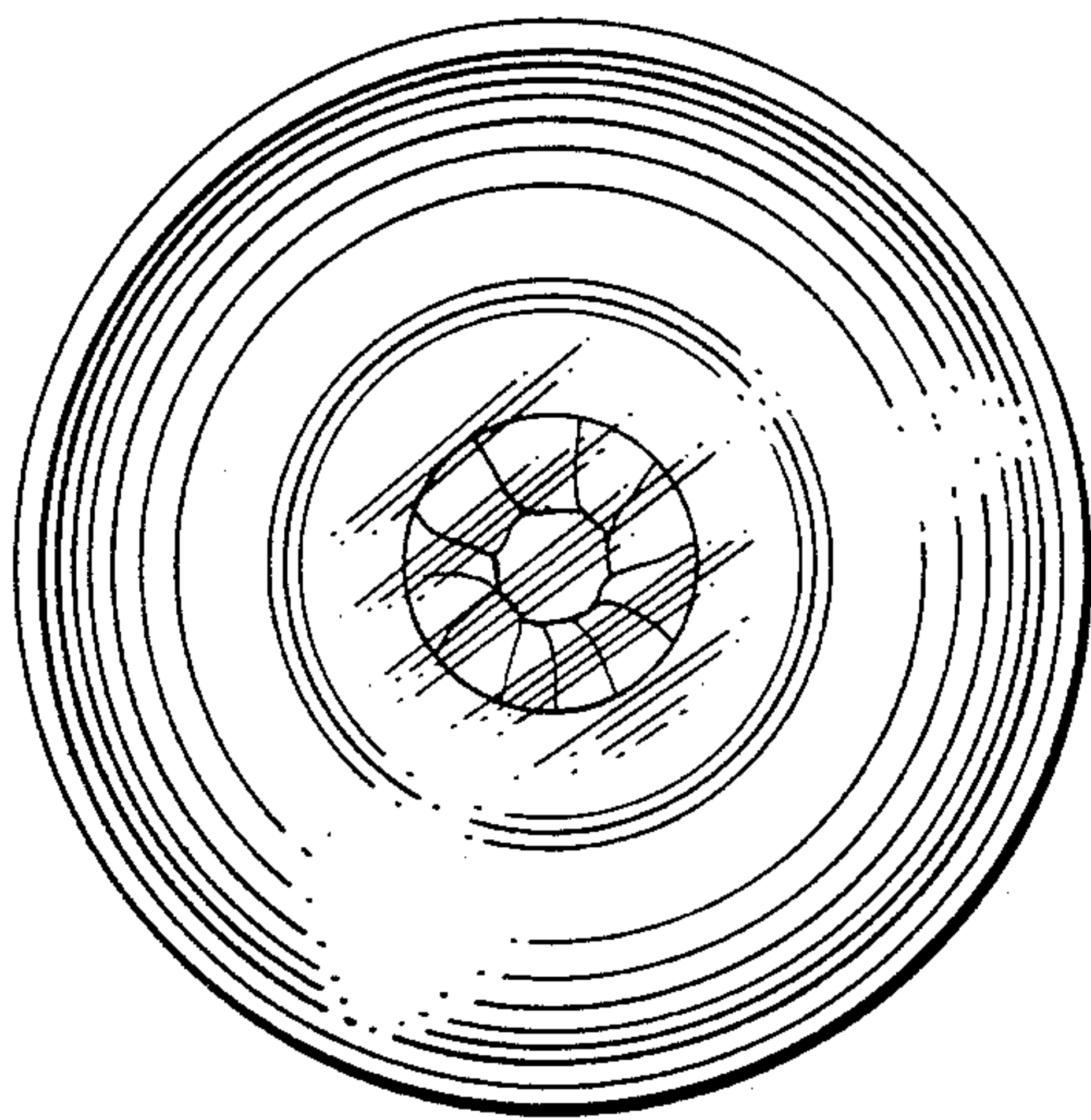

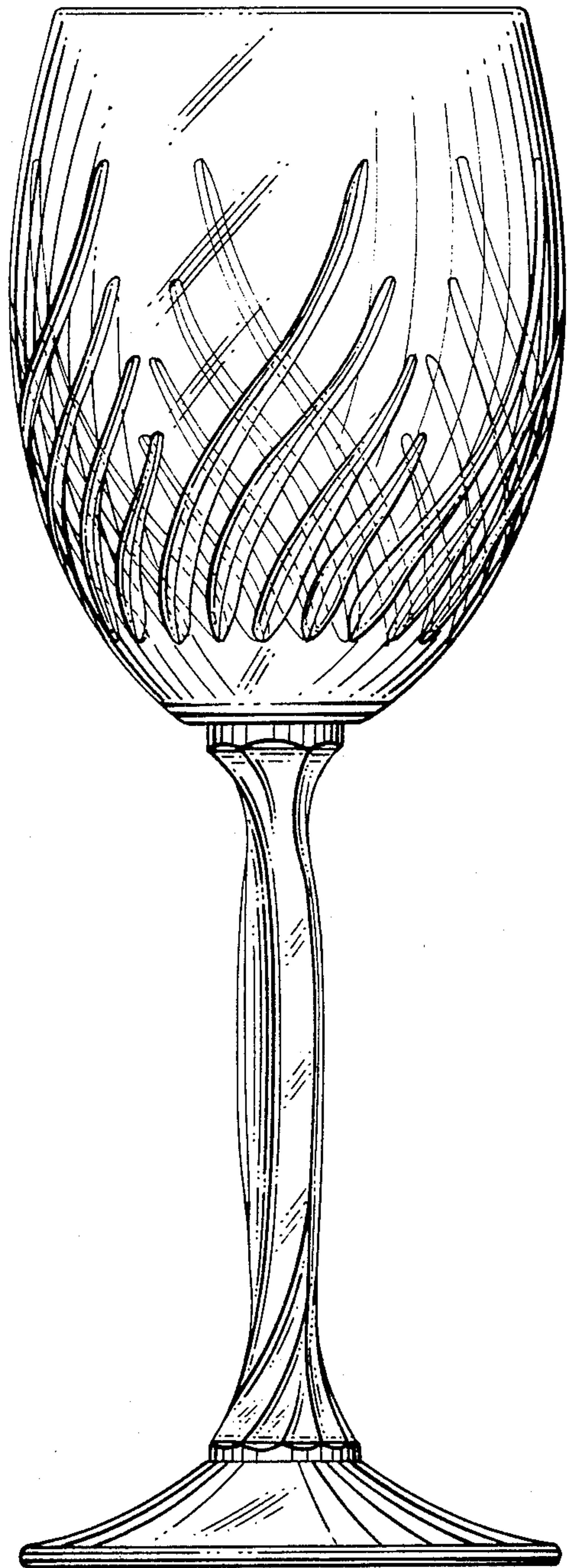
