[57] CLAIM

The ornamental design for an electronic copying machine, substantially as shown and described.

DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a top, front and right side perspective view of an electronic copying machine showing our new design;

FIG. 2 is a front elevational view thereof;

FIG. 3 is a right side elevational view thereof;

FIG. 4 is a top plan view thereof;

FIG. 5 is a left side elevational view thereof;

FIG. 6 is a rear elevational view thereof;

FIG. 7 is a perspective view of FIG. 1 with the cover in an open position; and

FIG. 8 is an enlarged fragmentary perspective view of the upper front portion of the machine.

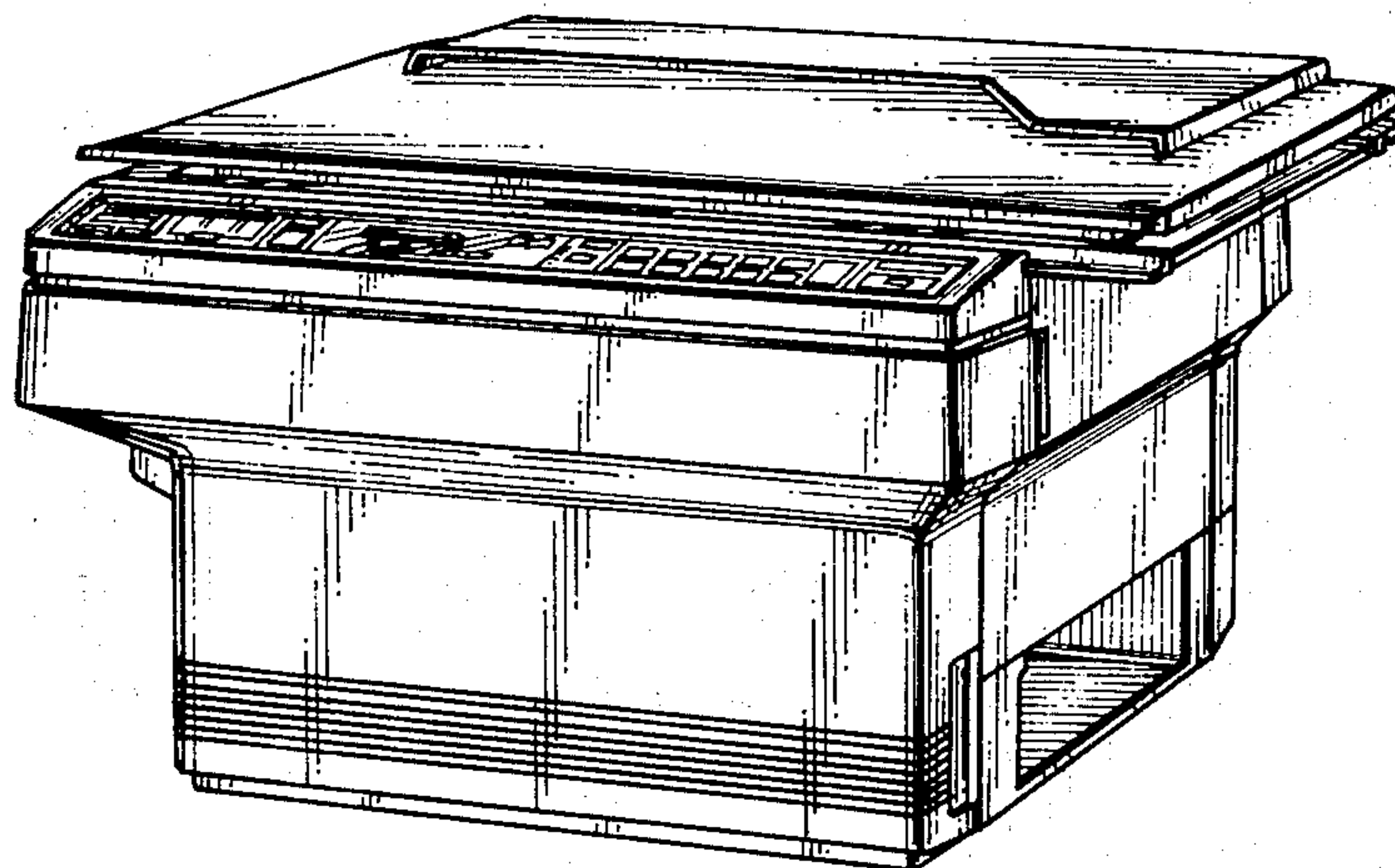

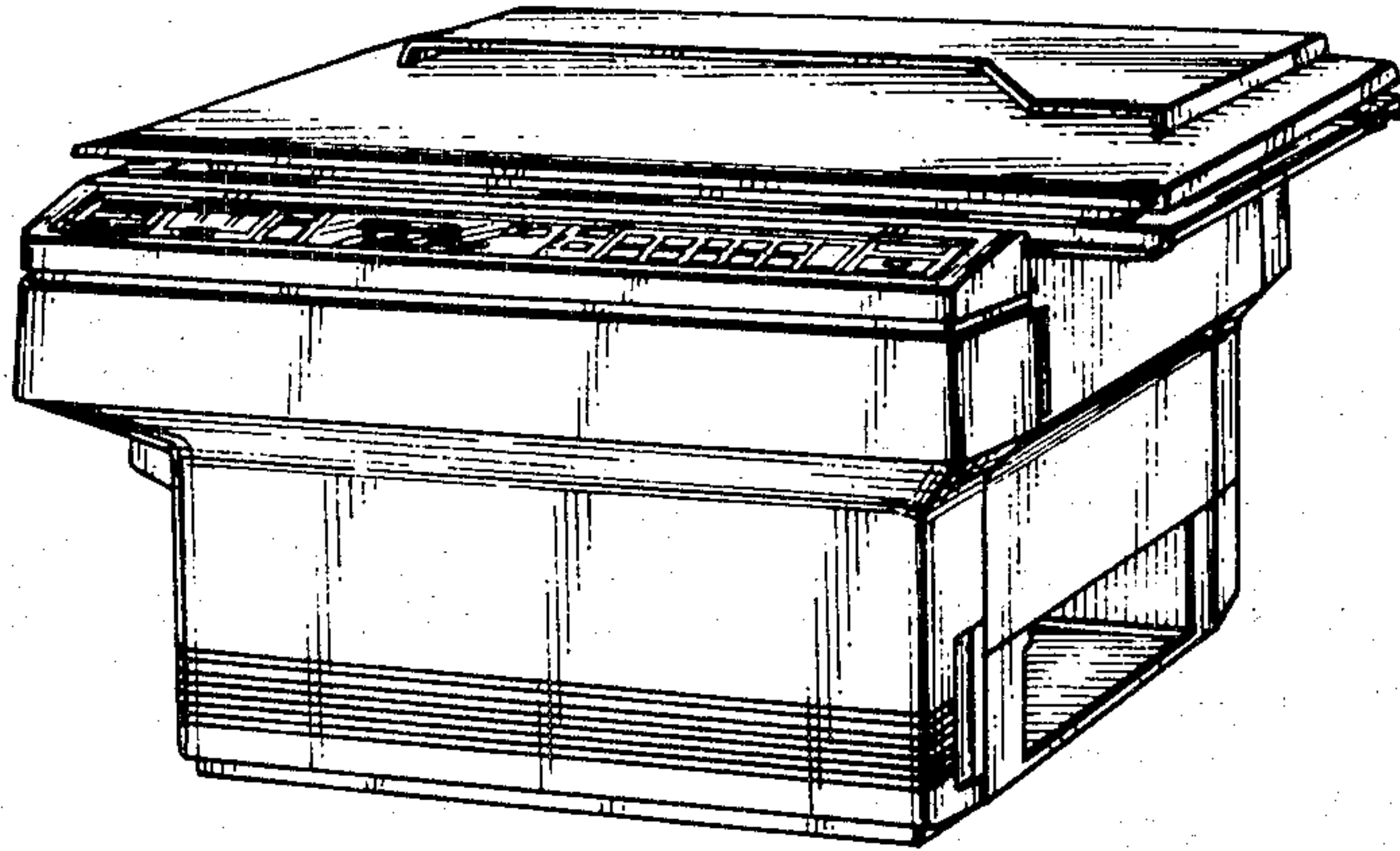

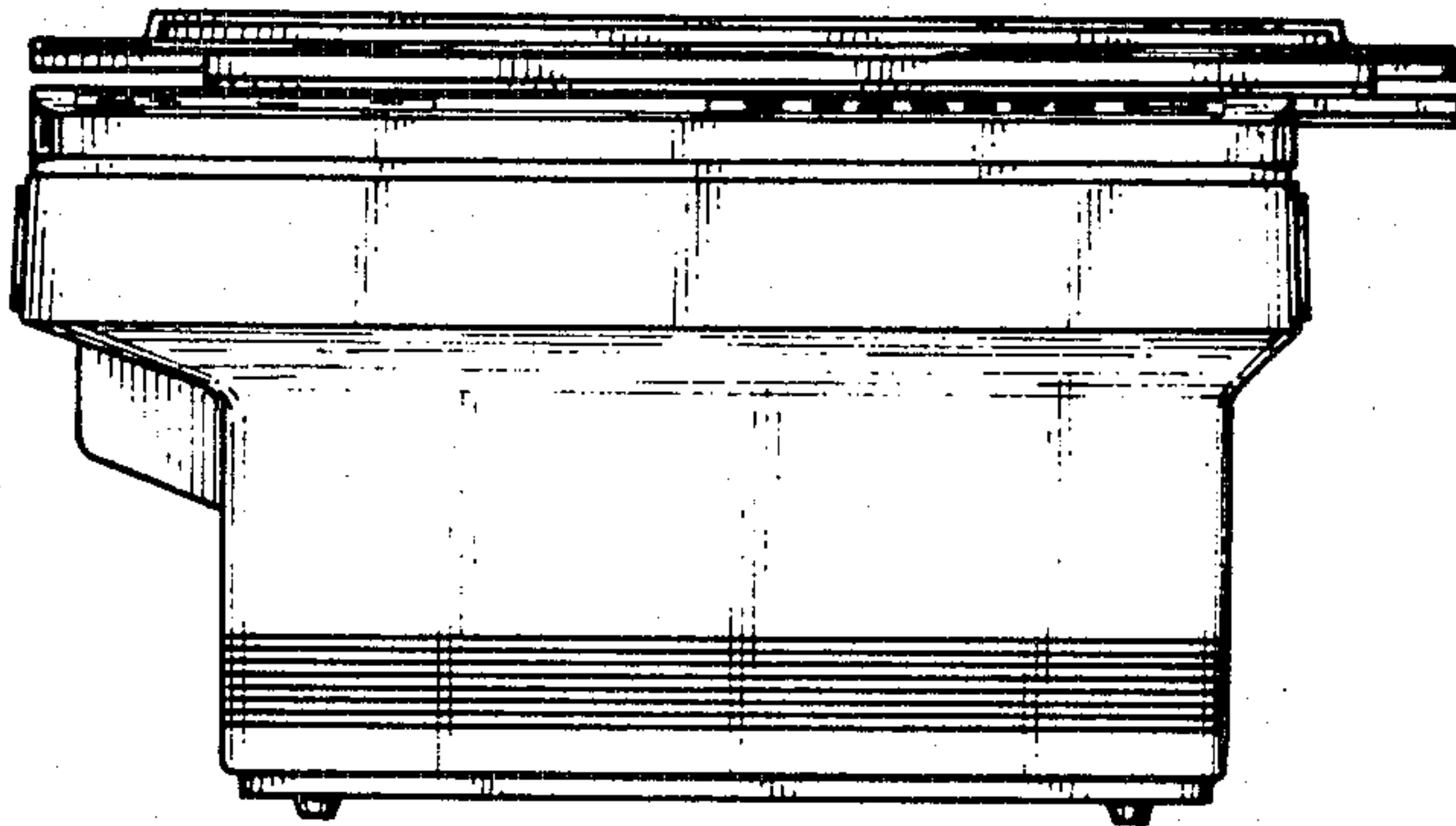

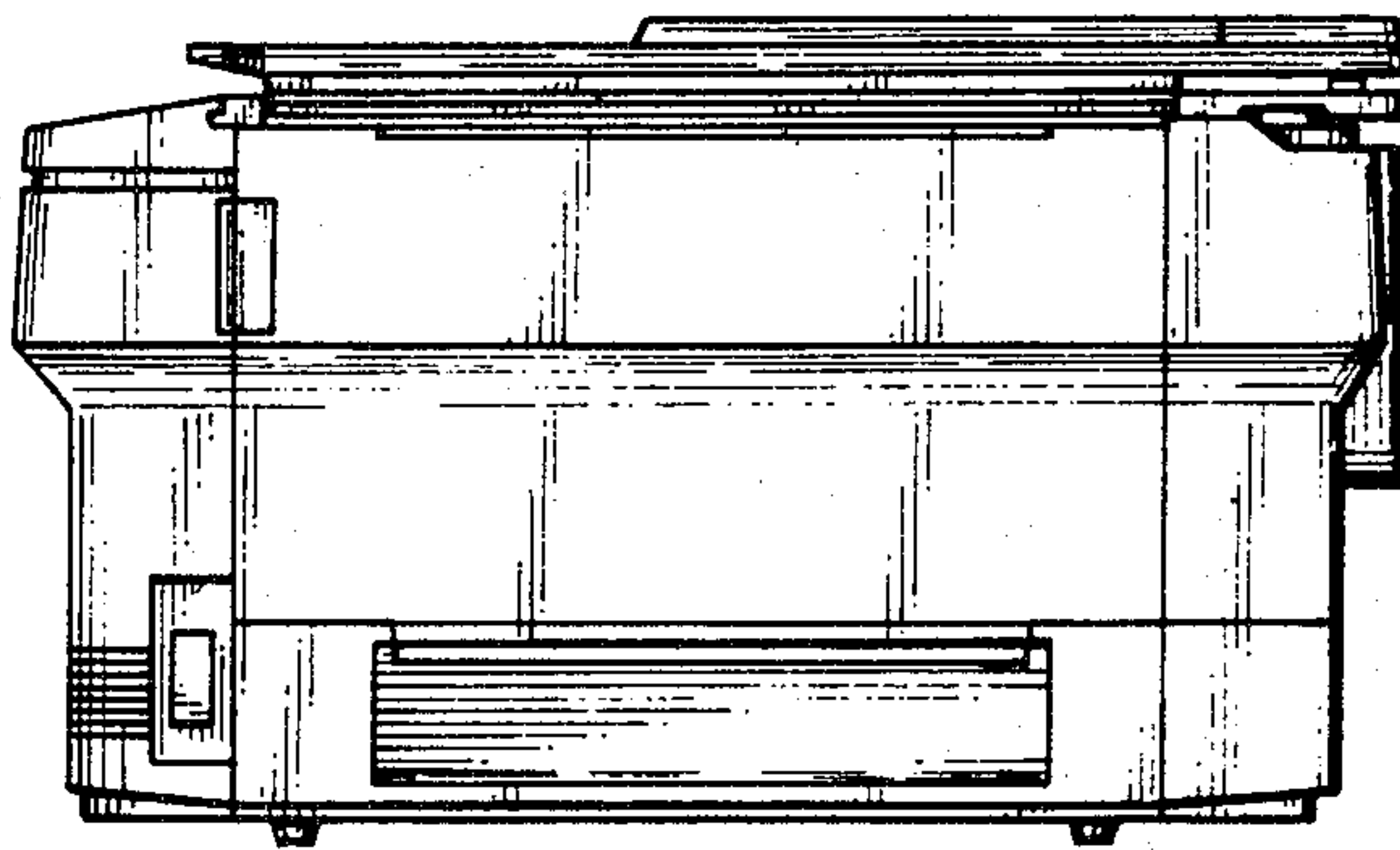

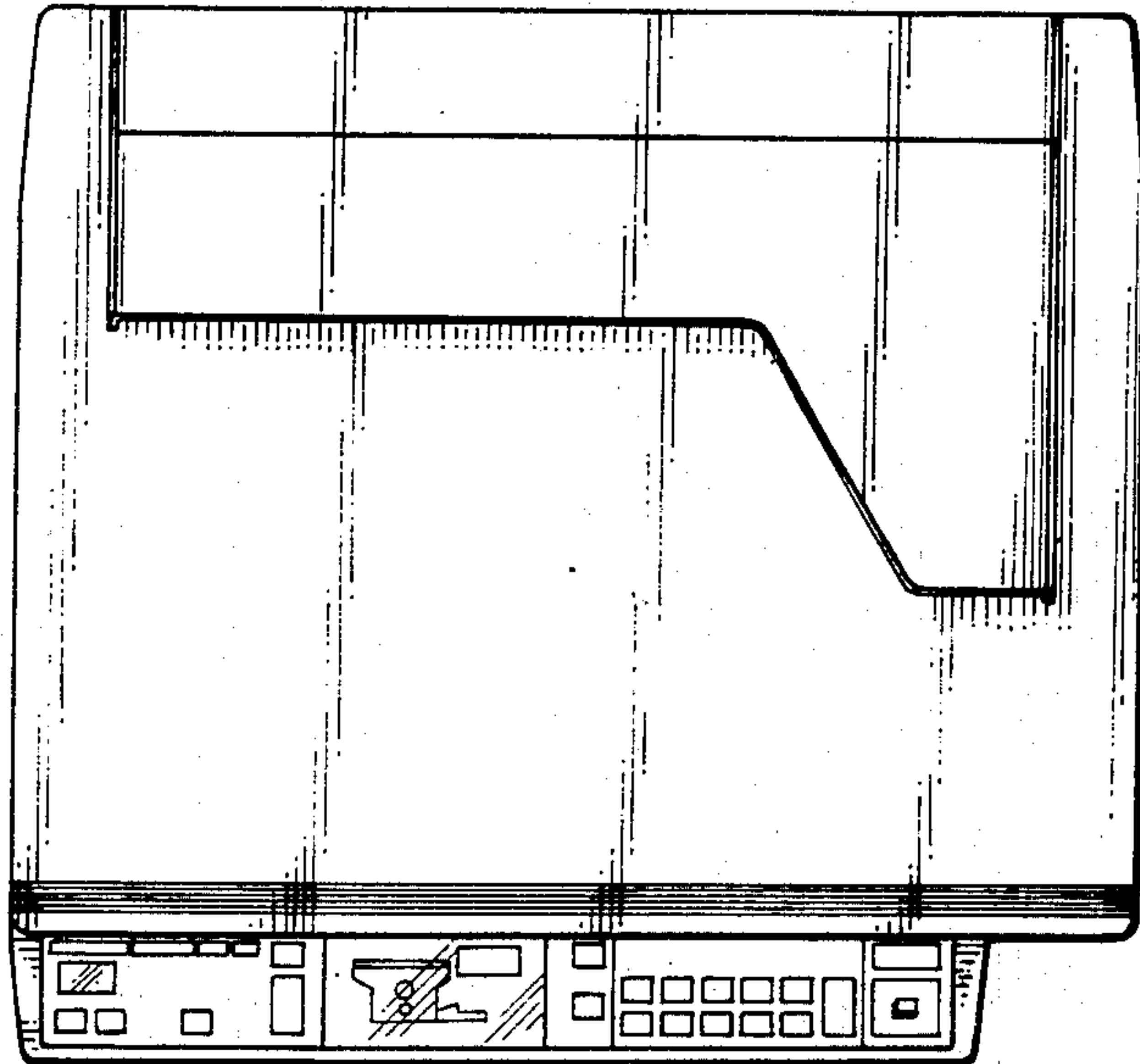

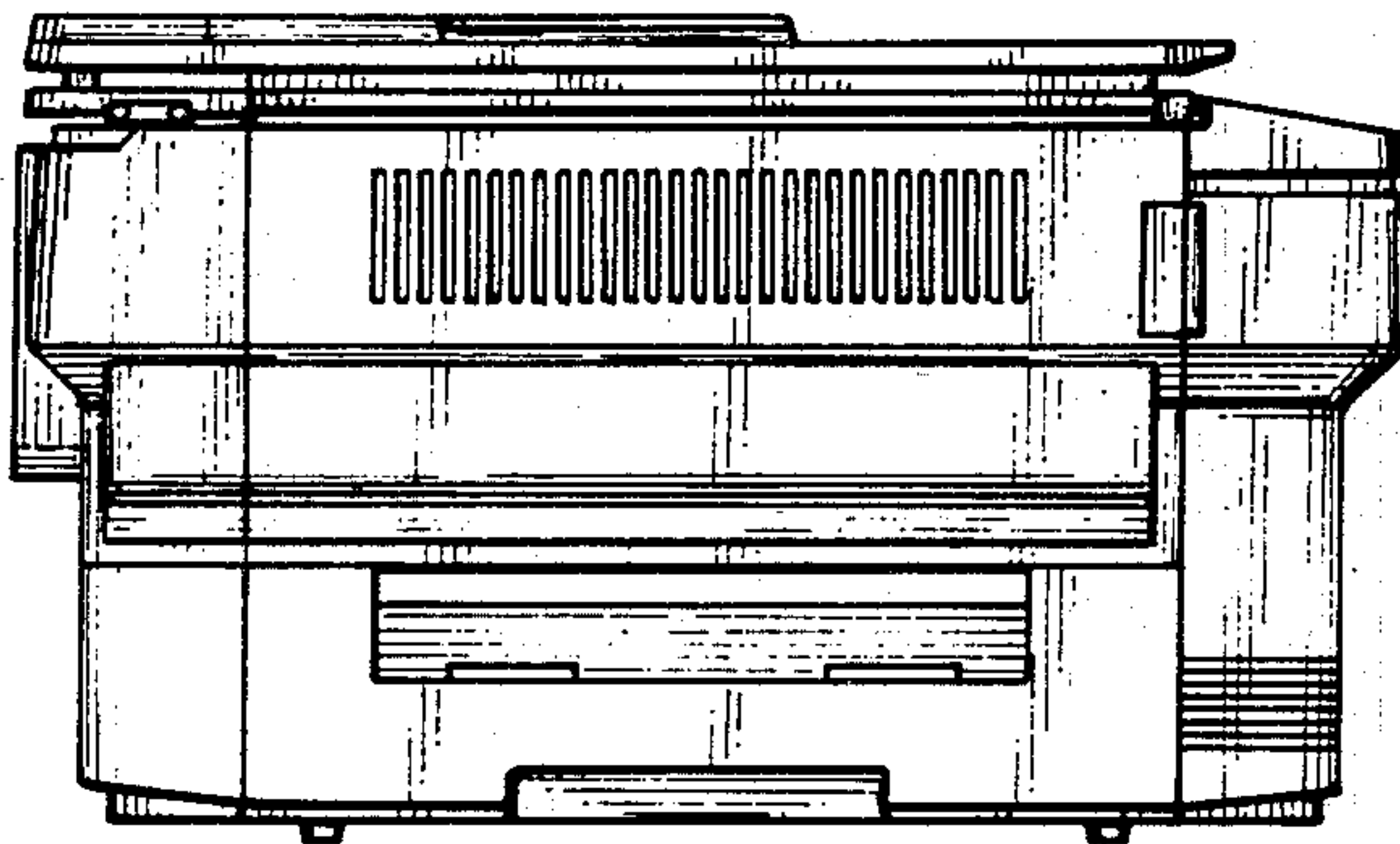

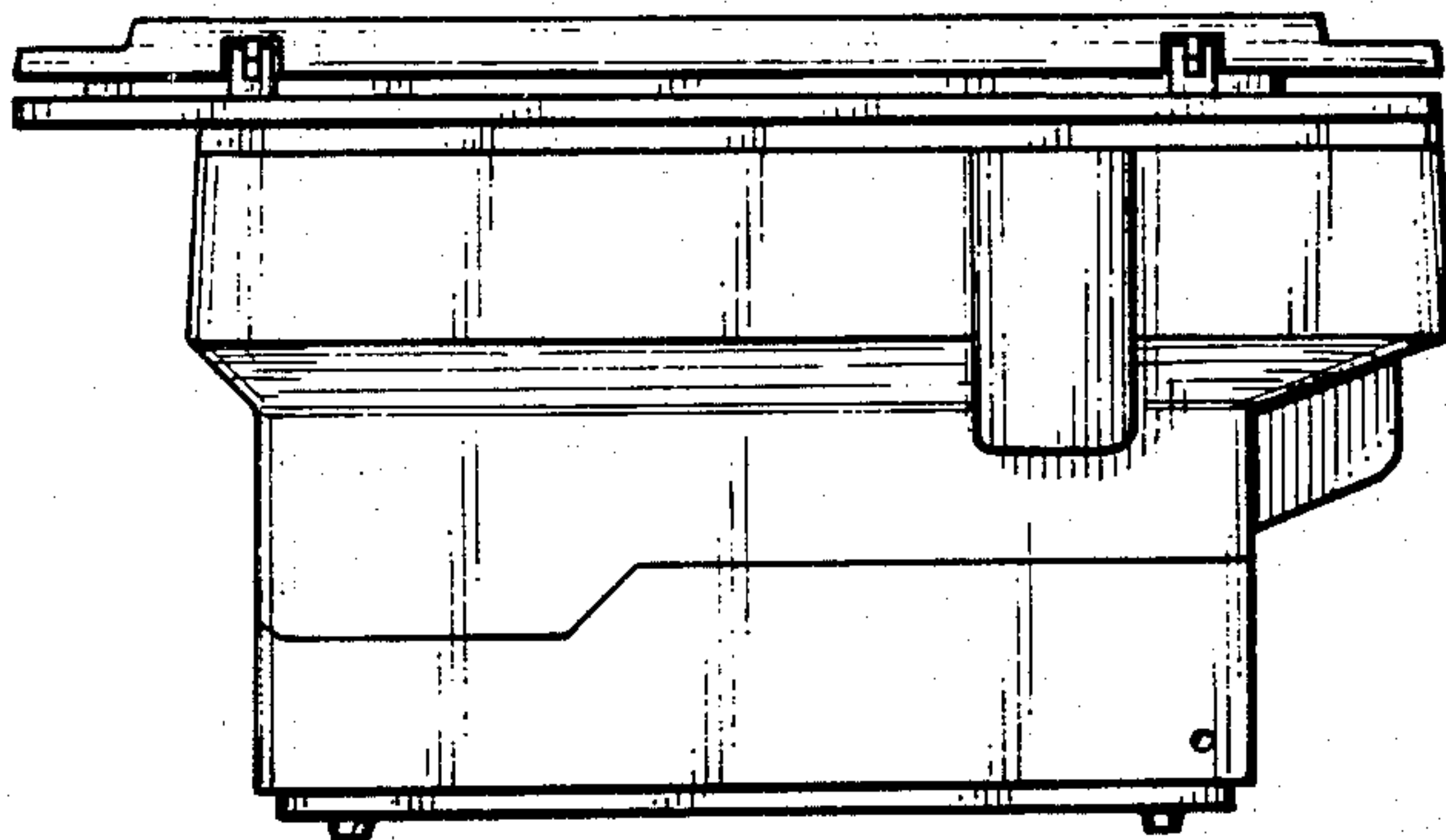

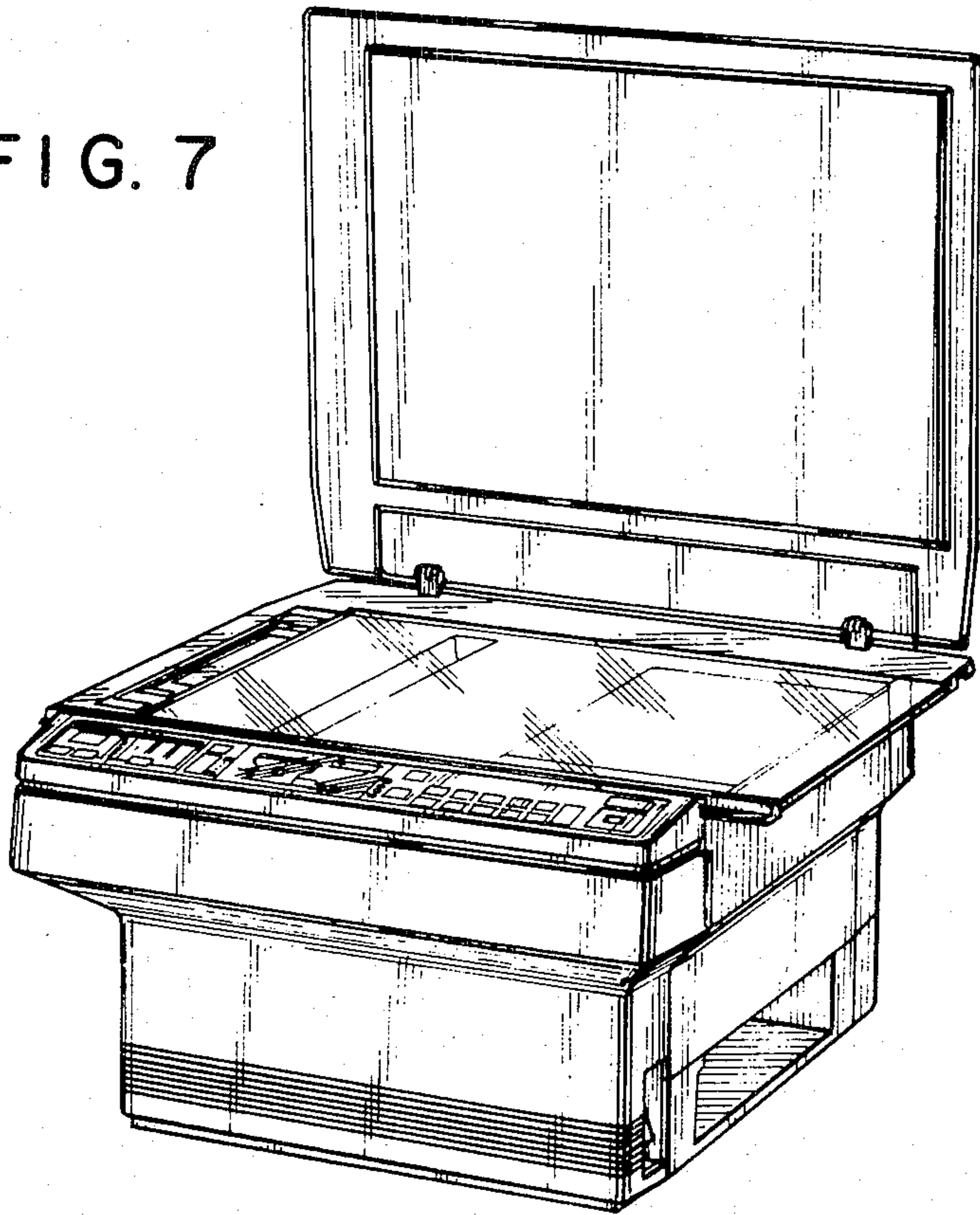
