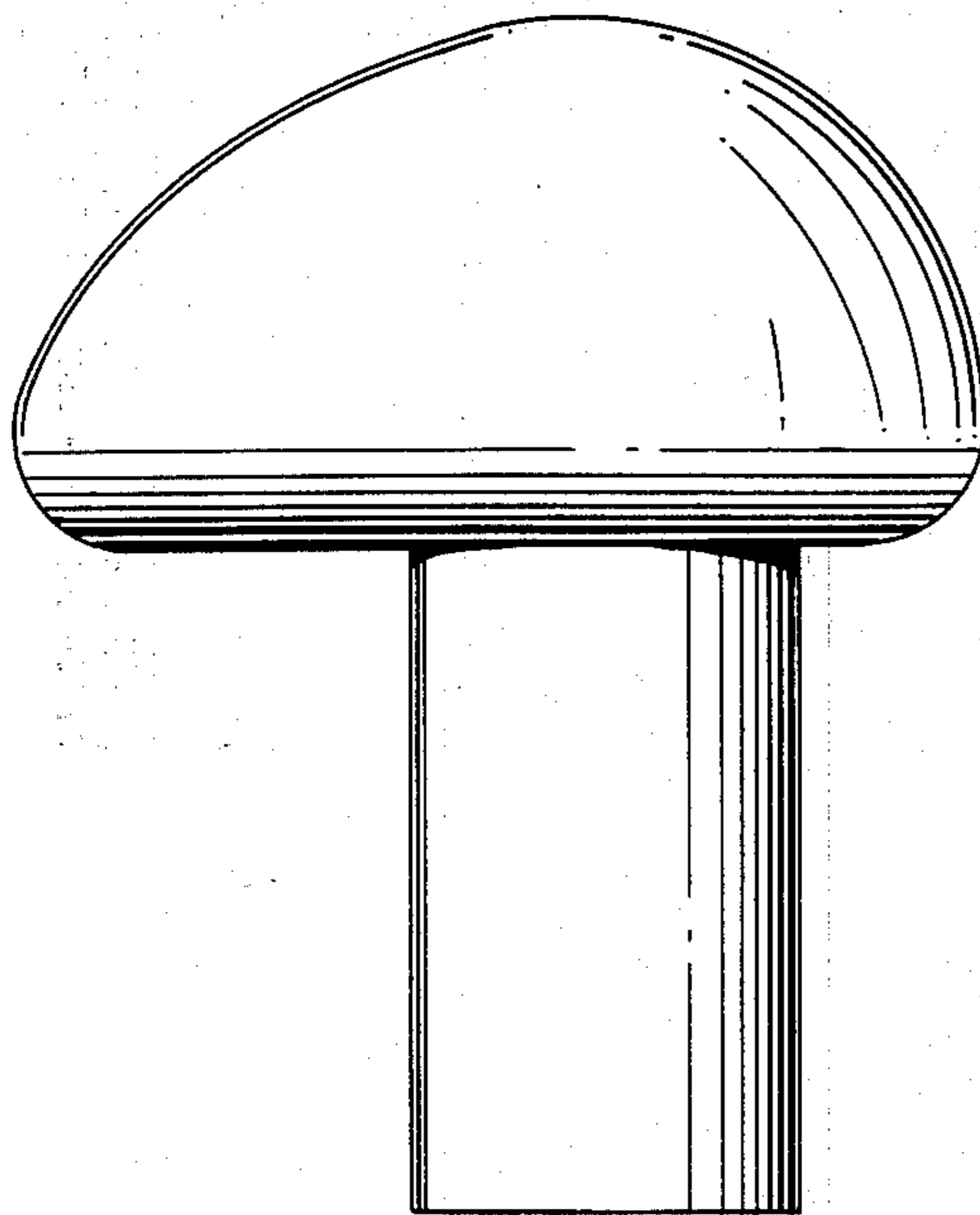

The ornamental design for a partial ossicular replacement prosthesis, as shown.

DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a top plan view of a partial ossicular replacement prosthesis showing my new design;
FIG. 2 is a bottom plan view thereof;
FIG. 3 is a front elevational view thereof;
FIG. 4 is a side elevational view thereof; and
FIG. 5 is a side elevational view thereof, from that opposite FIG. 4.



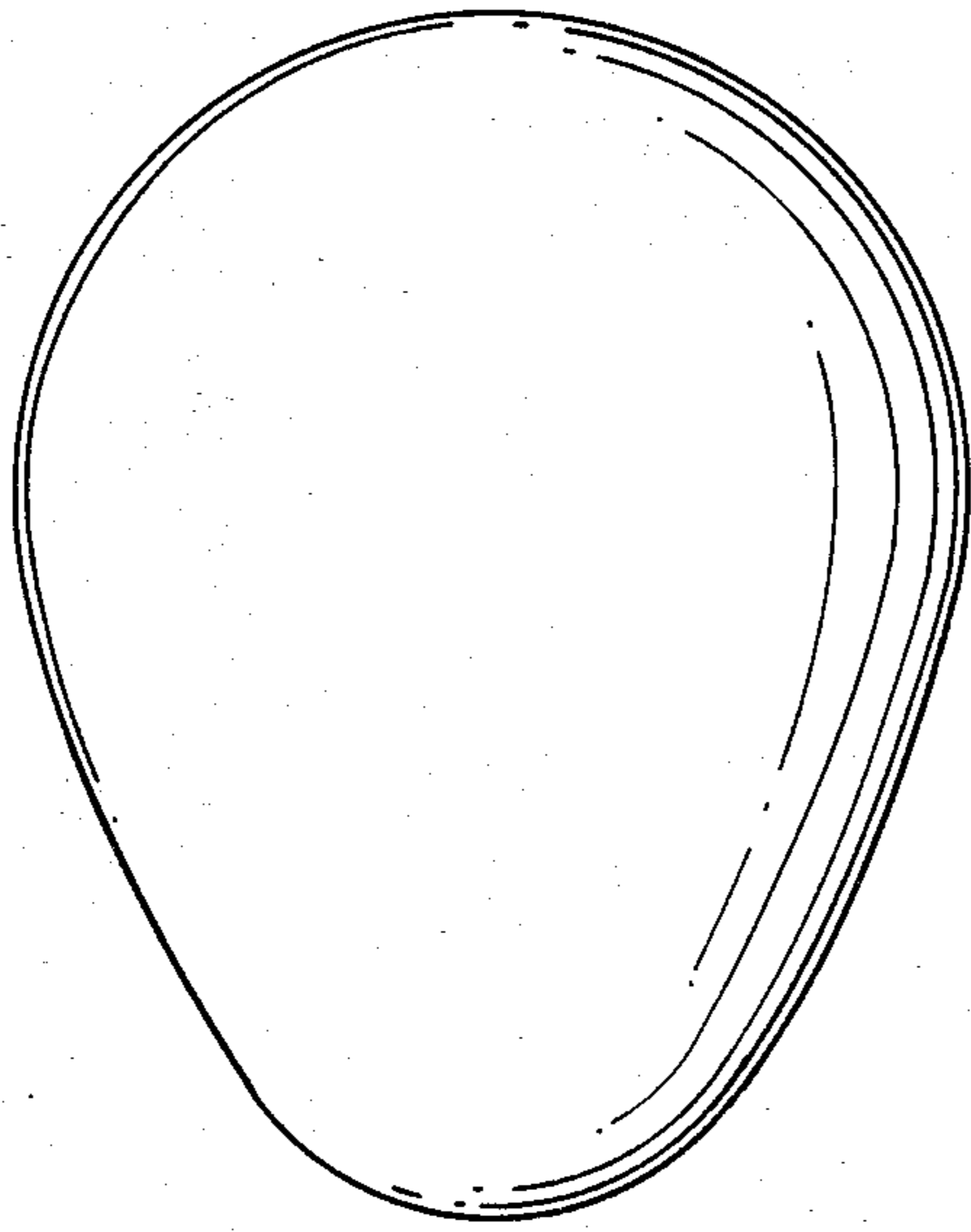

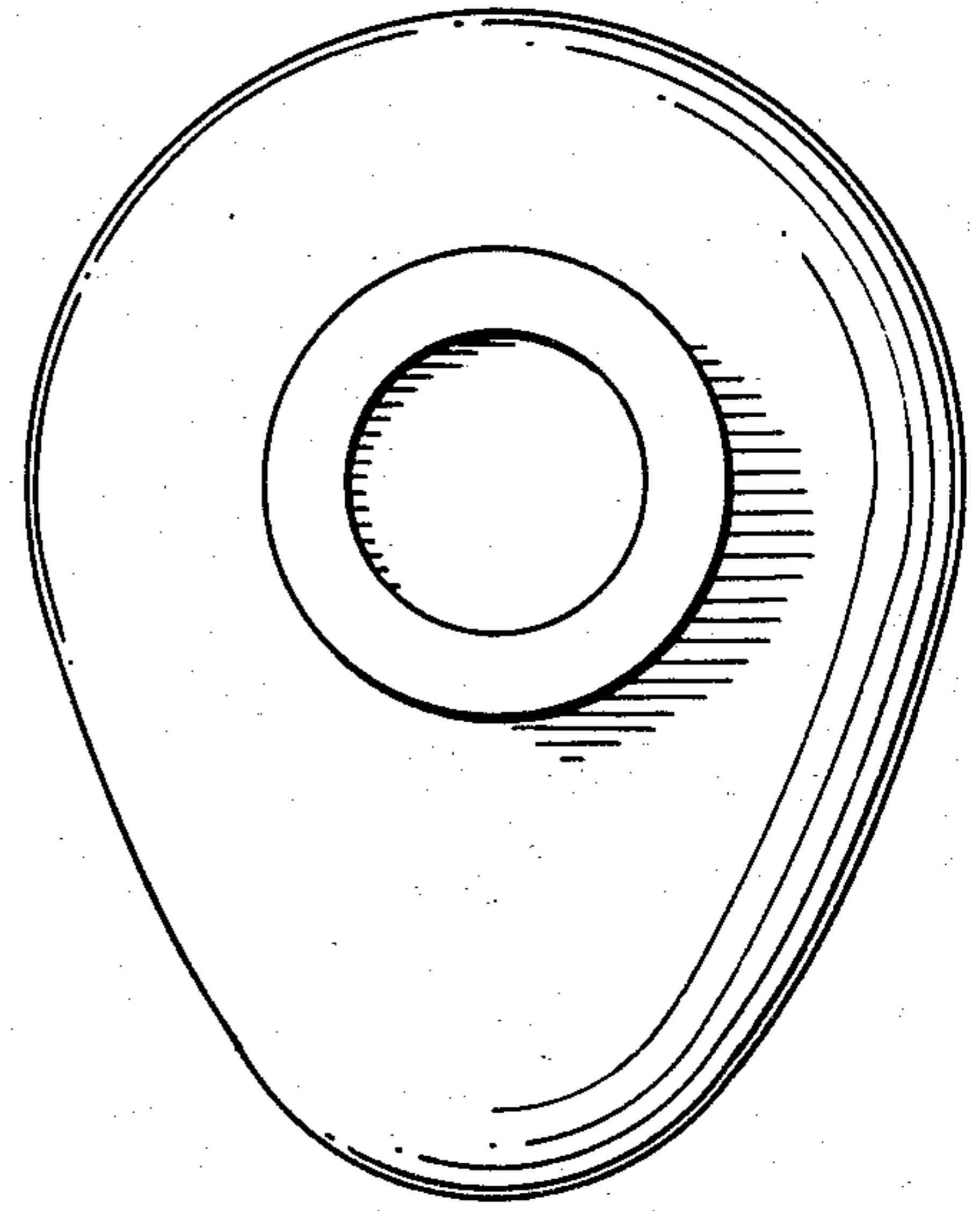

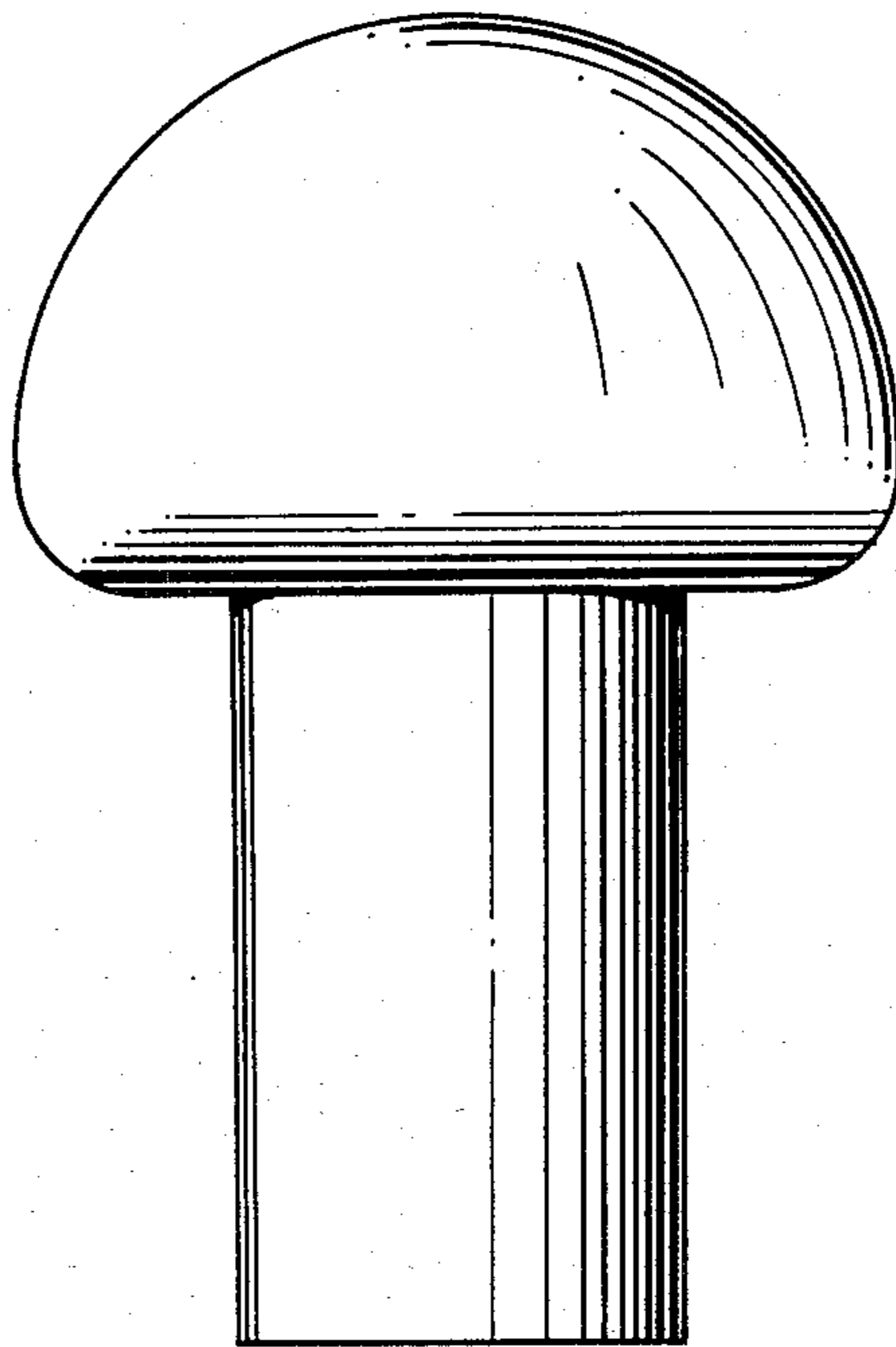

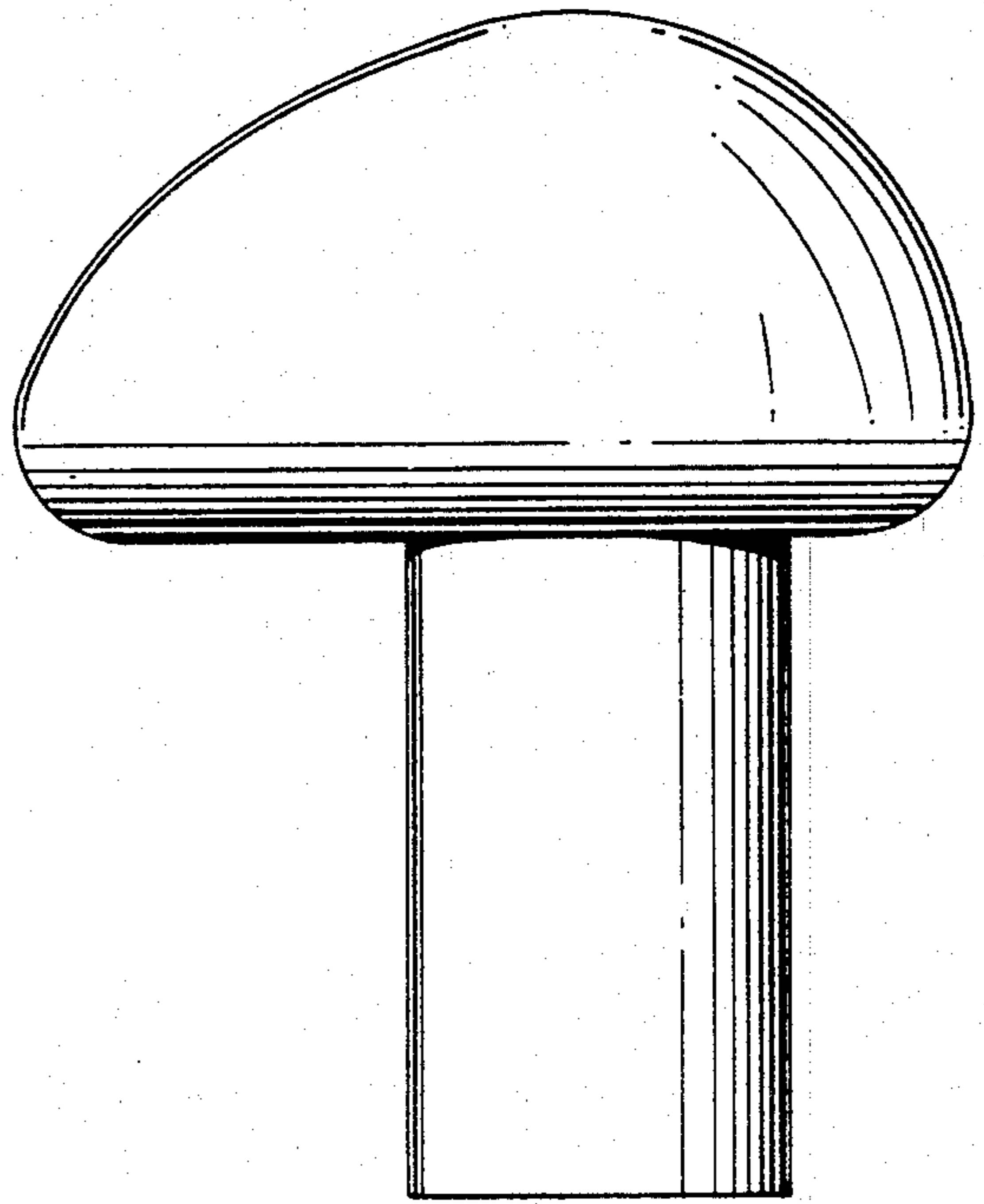

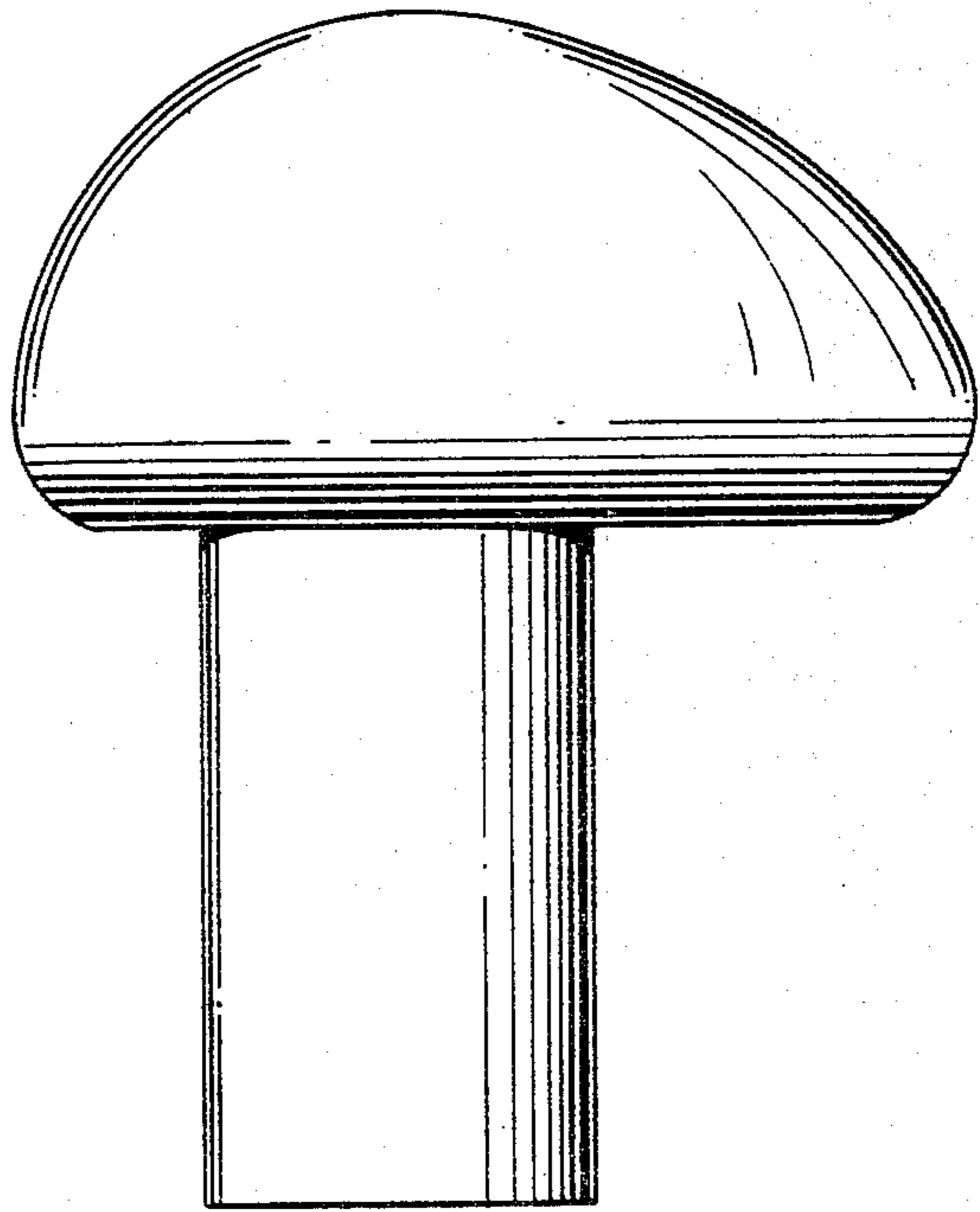
