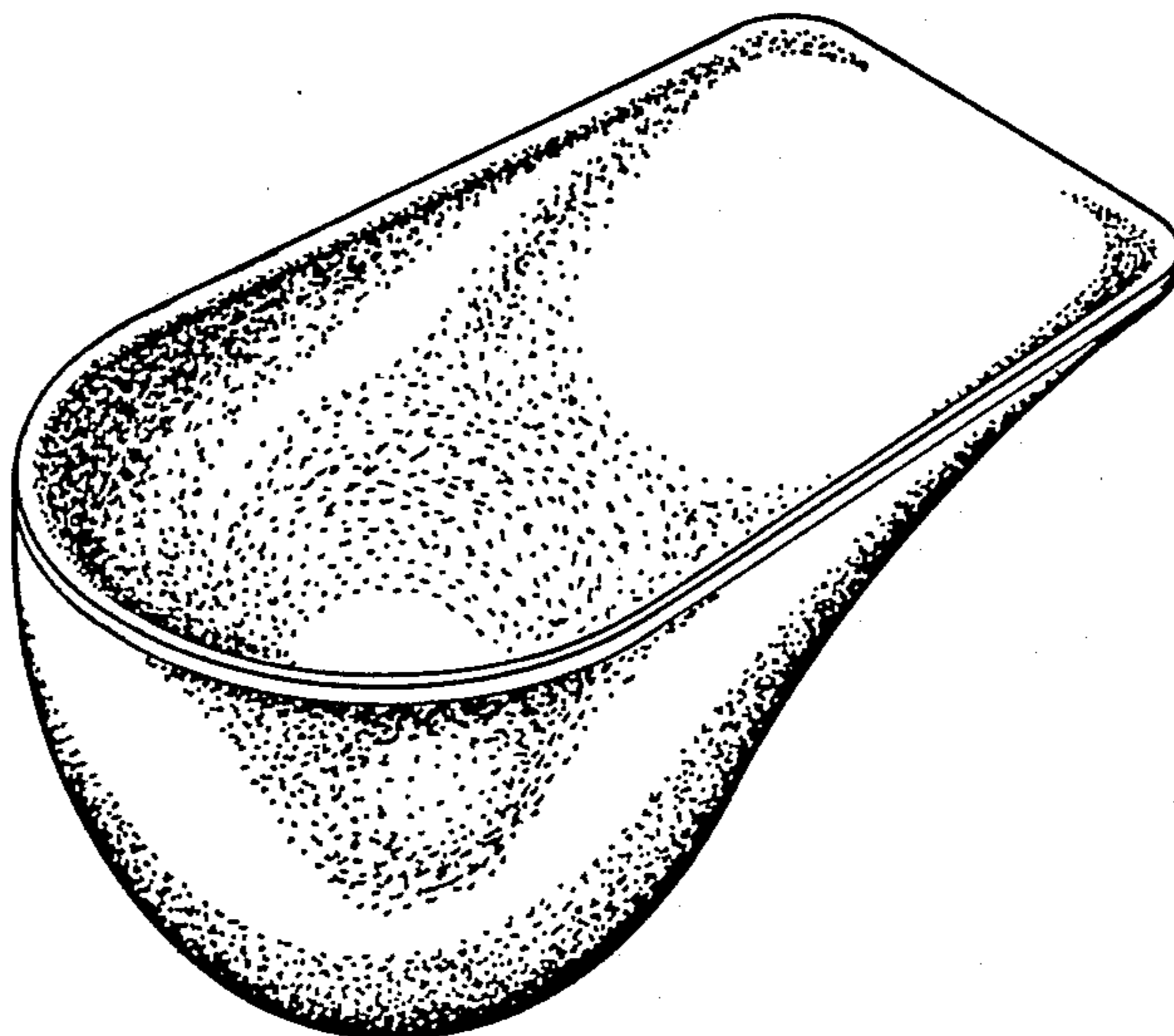

DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a perspective view of a heel cushion showing my new design;
 FIG. 2 is a right side elevational view thereof;
 FIG. 3 is a top plan view thereof; and
 FIG. 4 is a rear elevational view thereof; and
 FIG. 5 is a bottom plan view thereof.
 In the various figures of the drawing, the various stippling and hatching is intended as surface shading only and does not connote color.



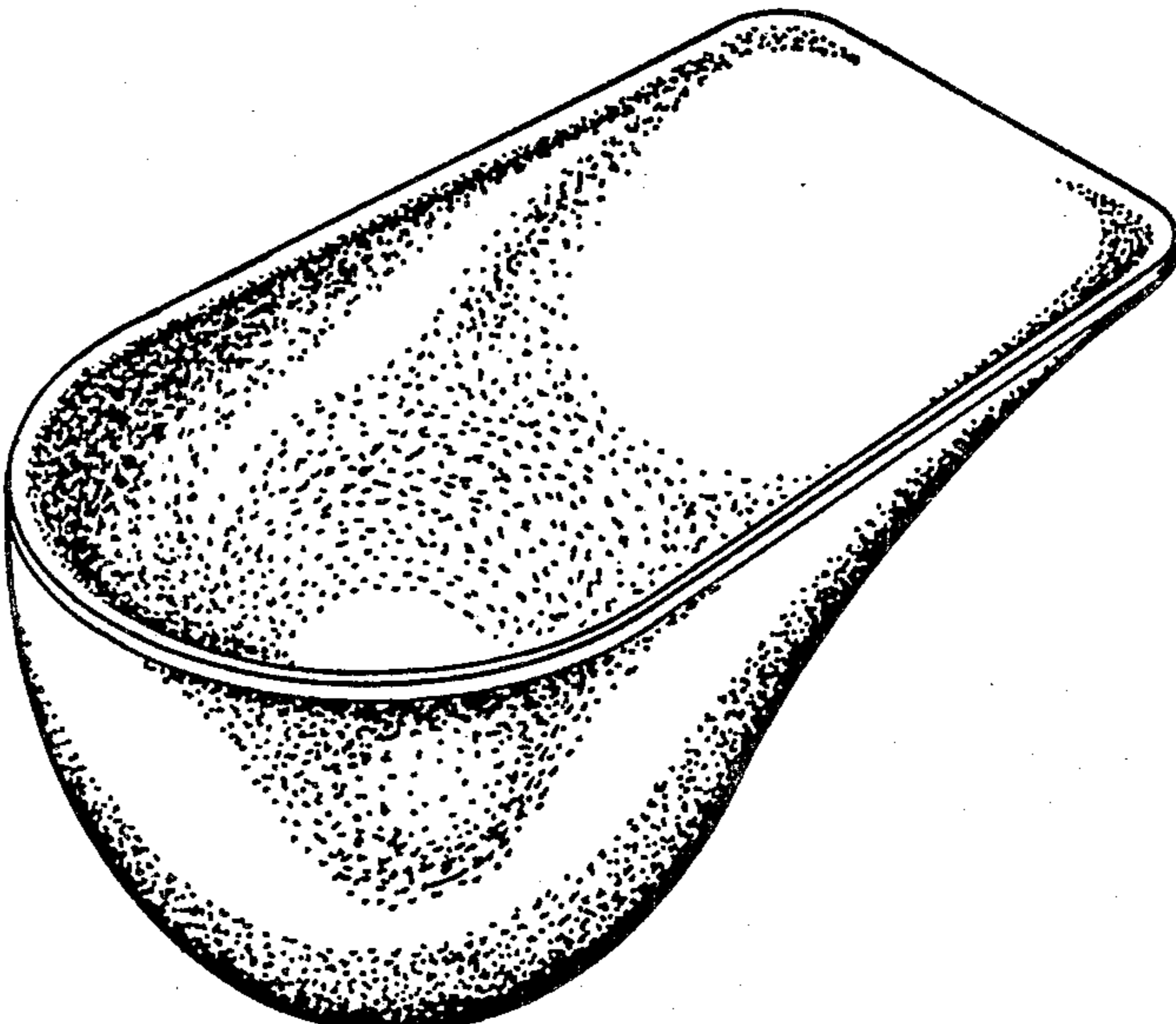

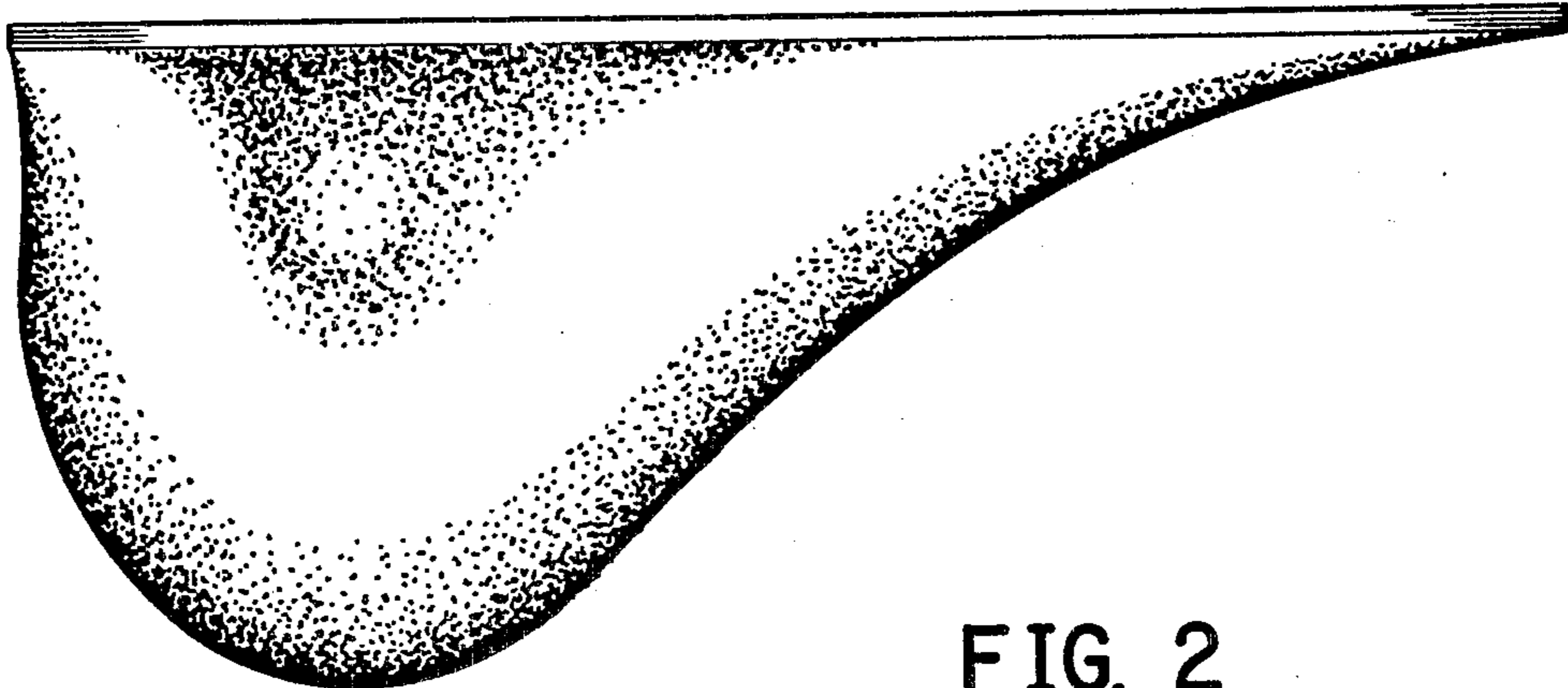

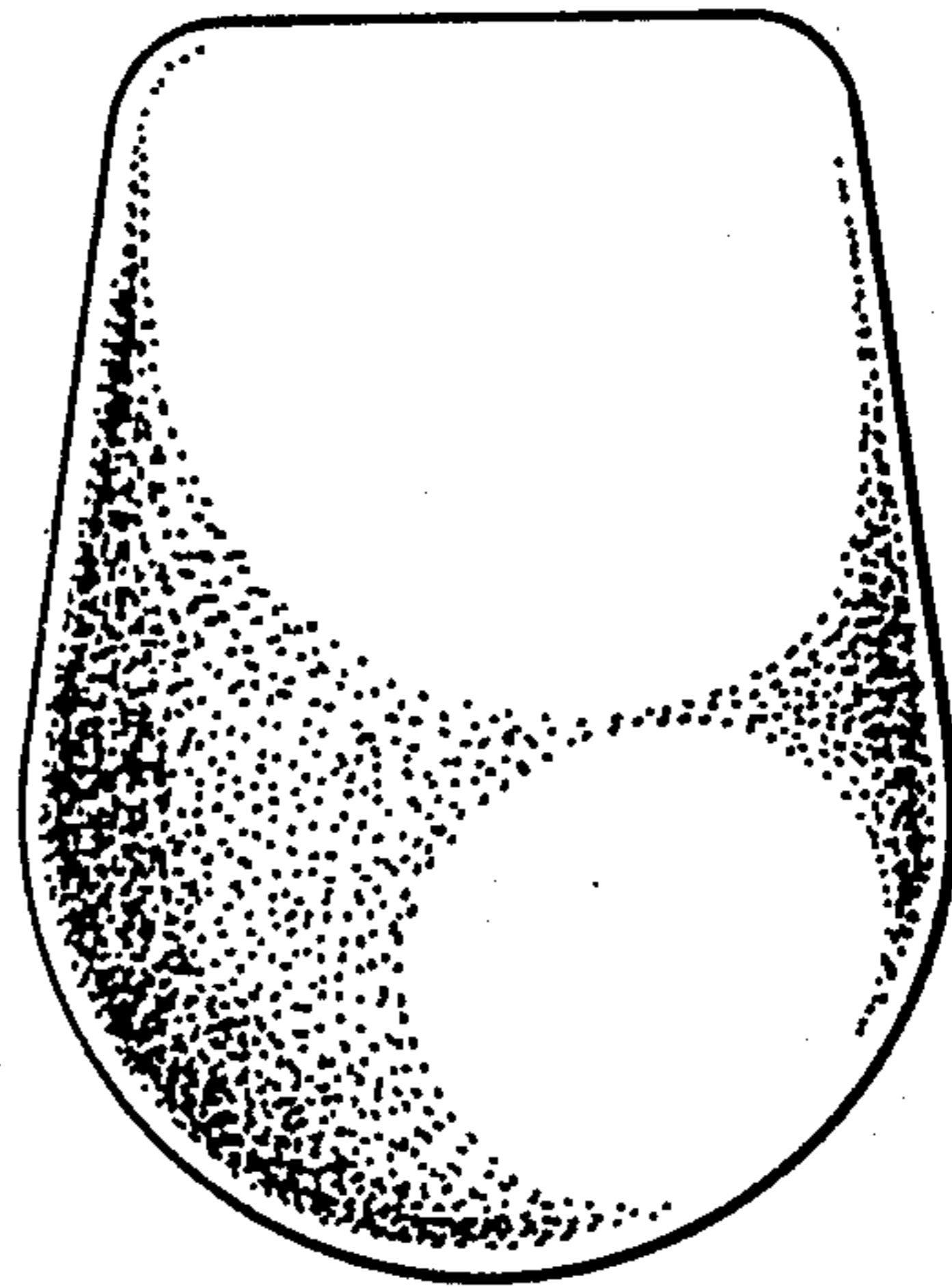

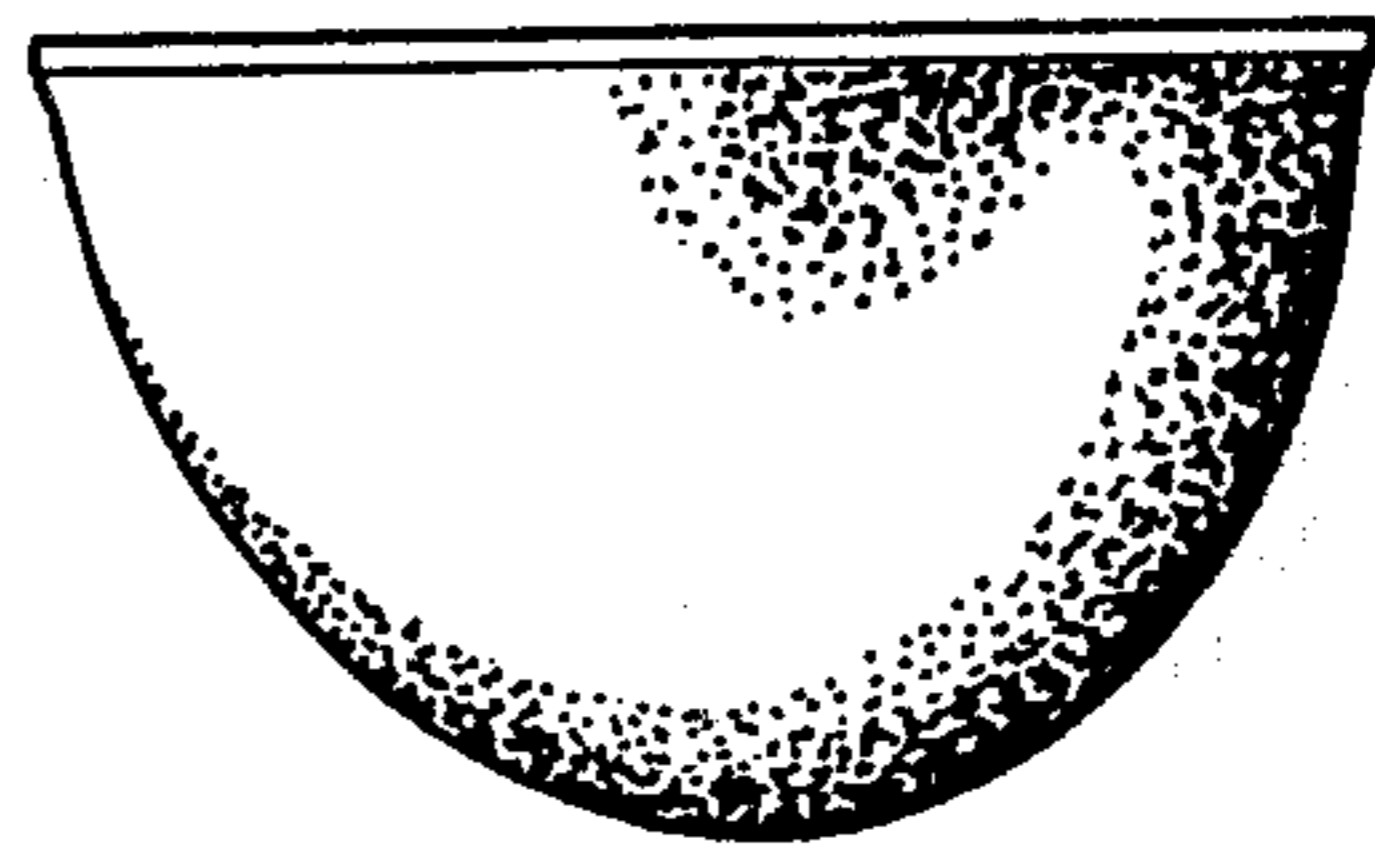
