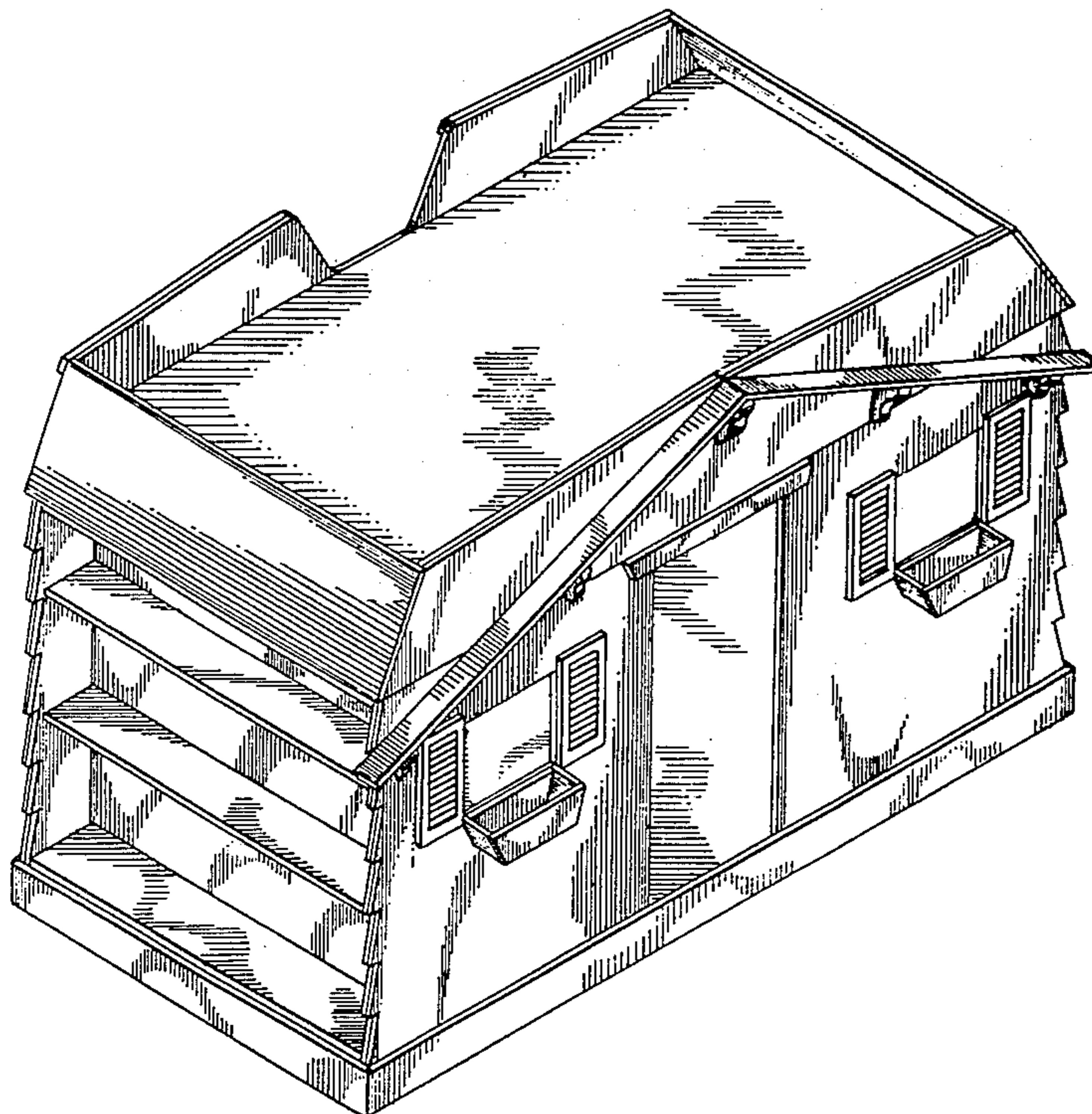
DESCRIPTION

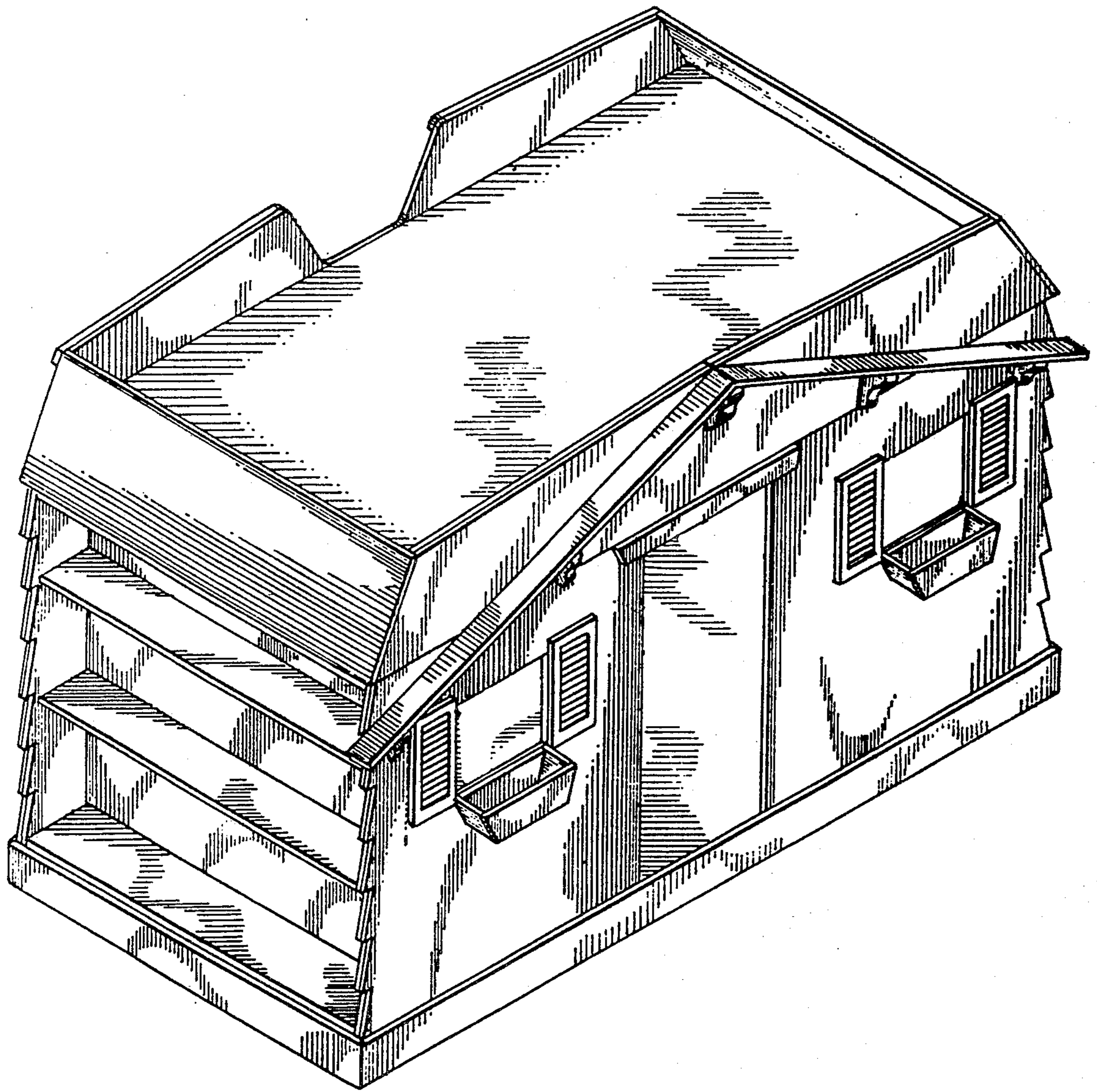

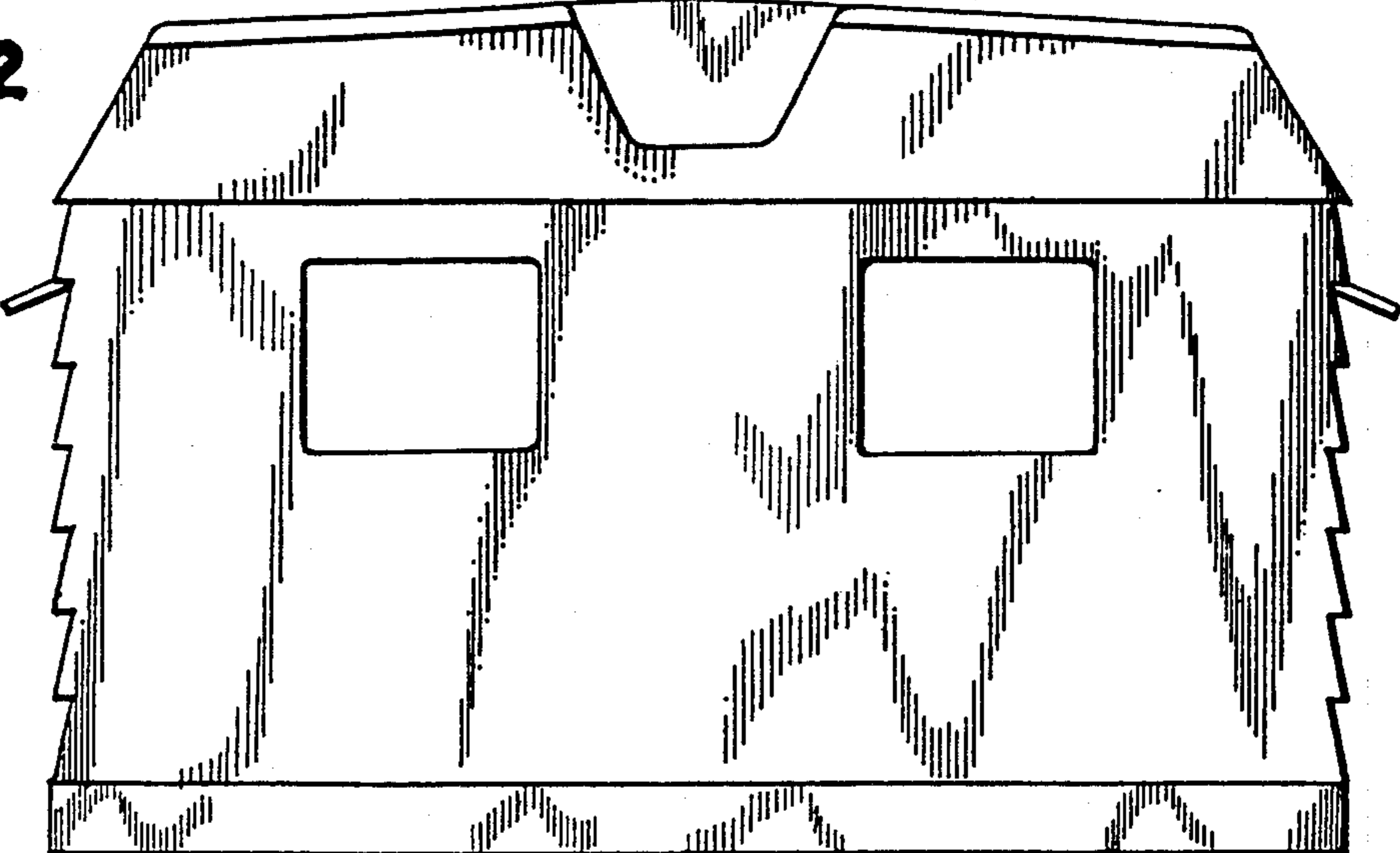

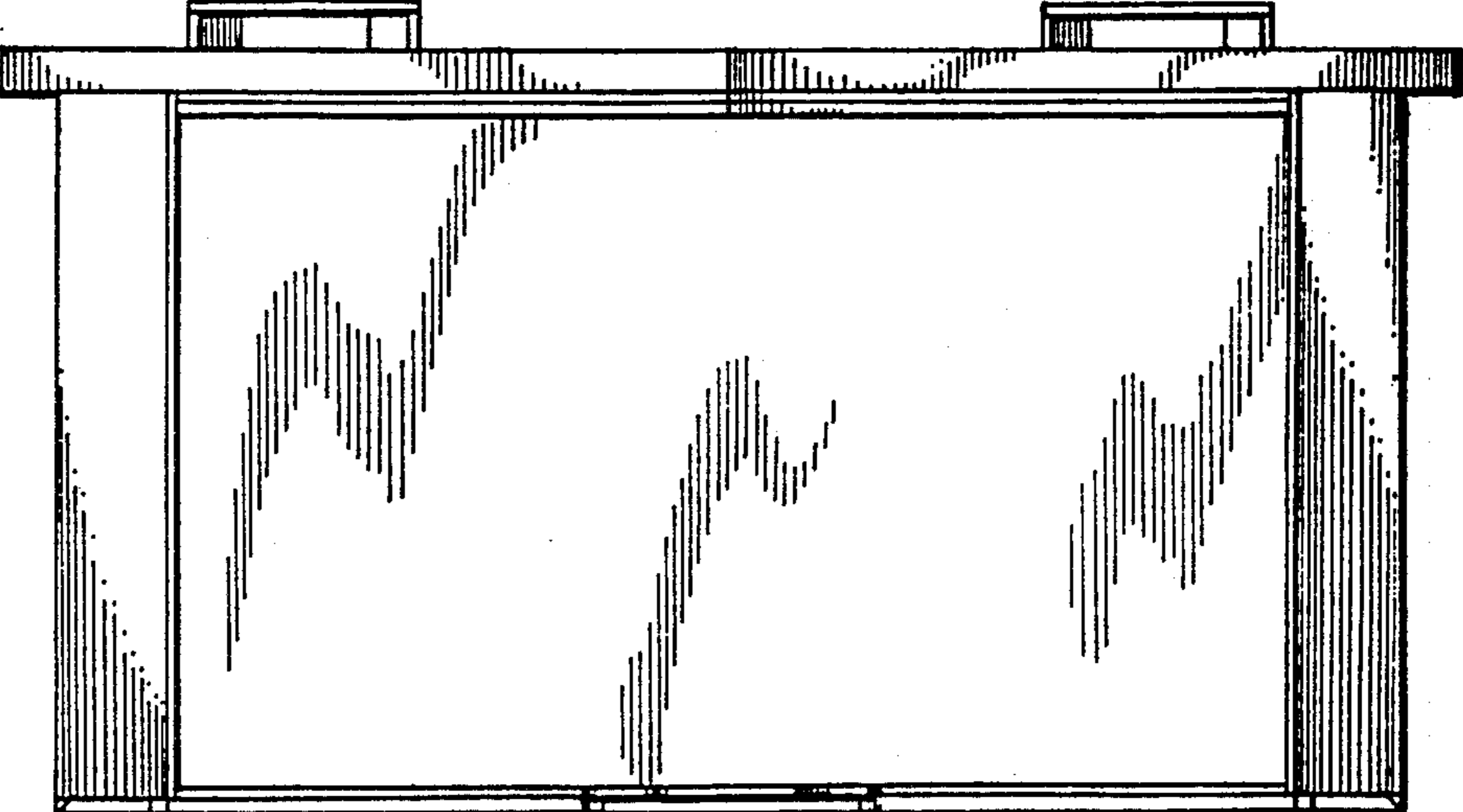
