FIG. 3 is a rear elevational view thereof; and

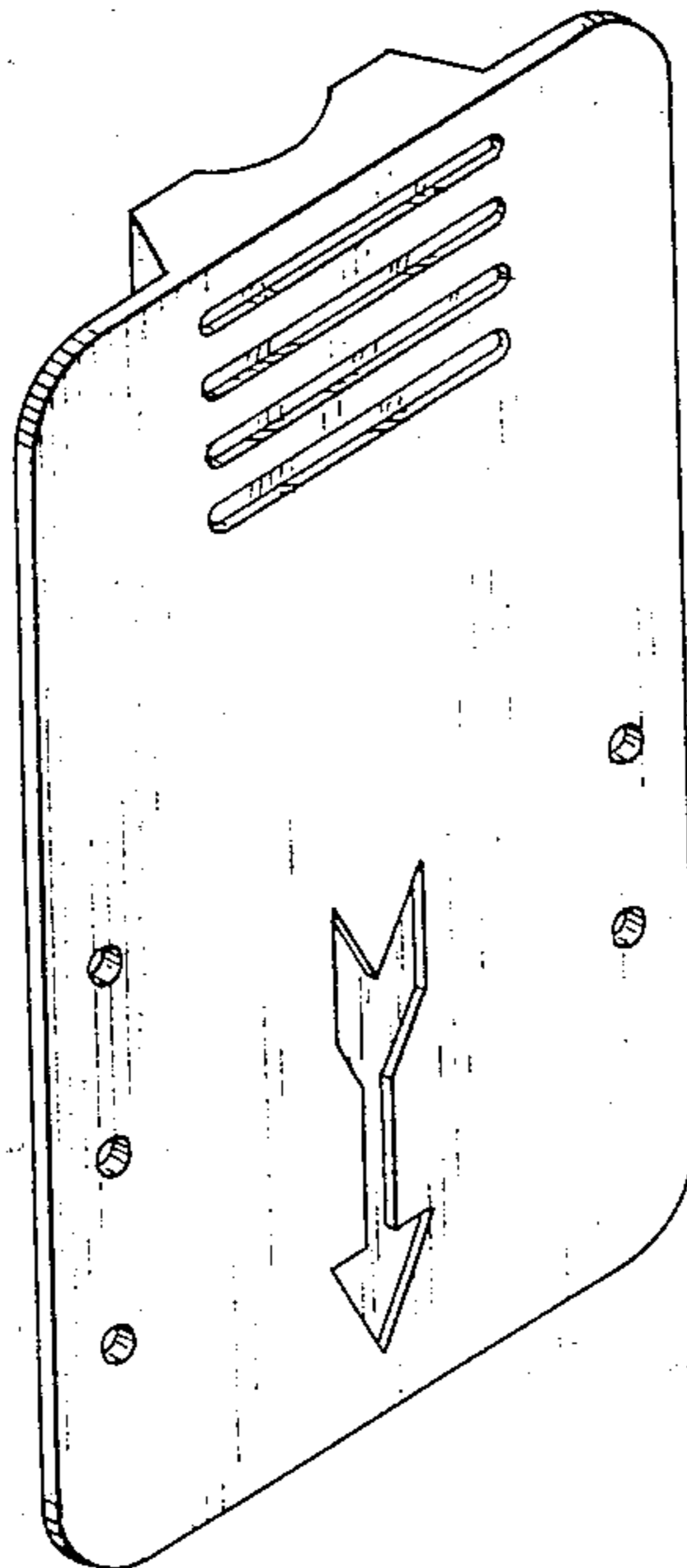
FIG. 4 is a bottom plan view thereof.

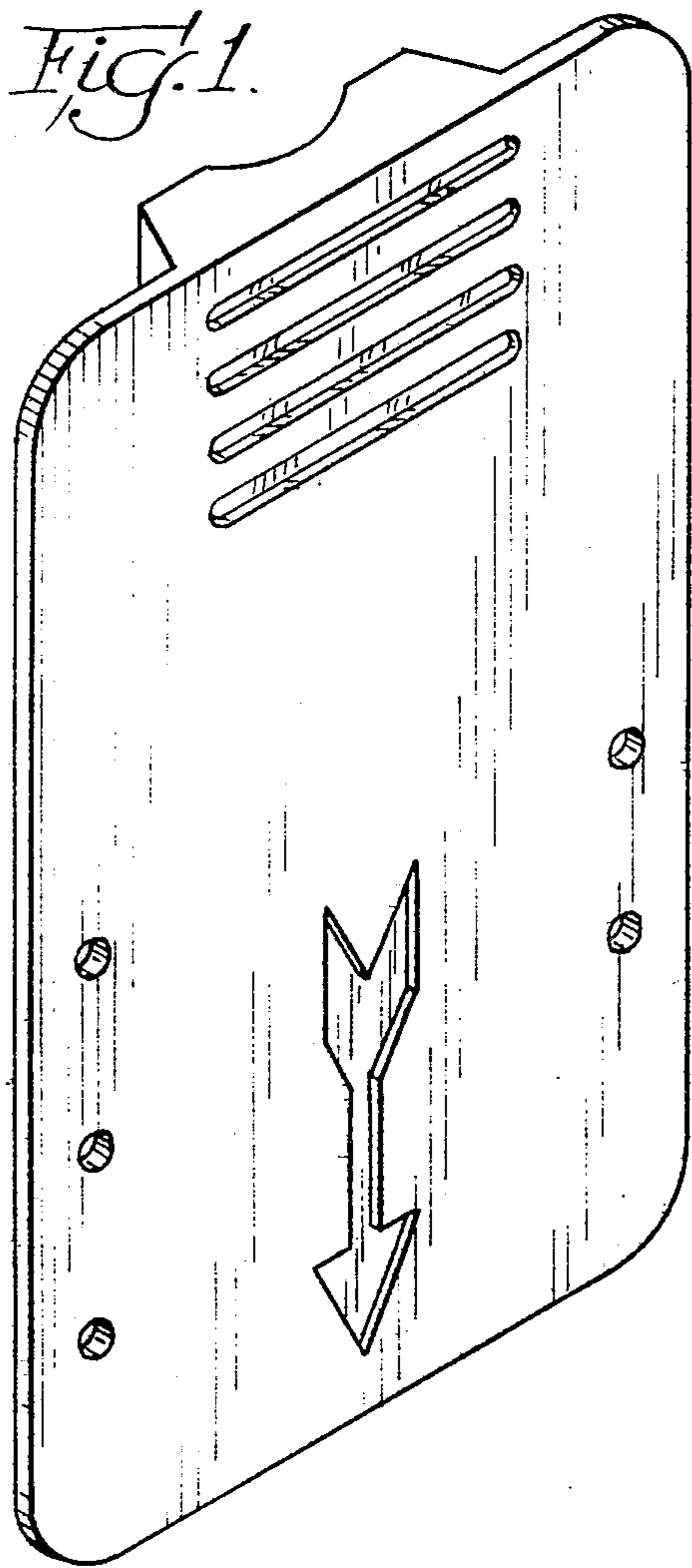

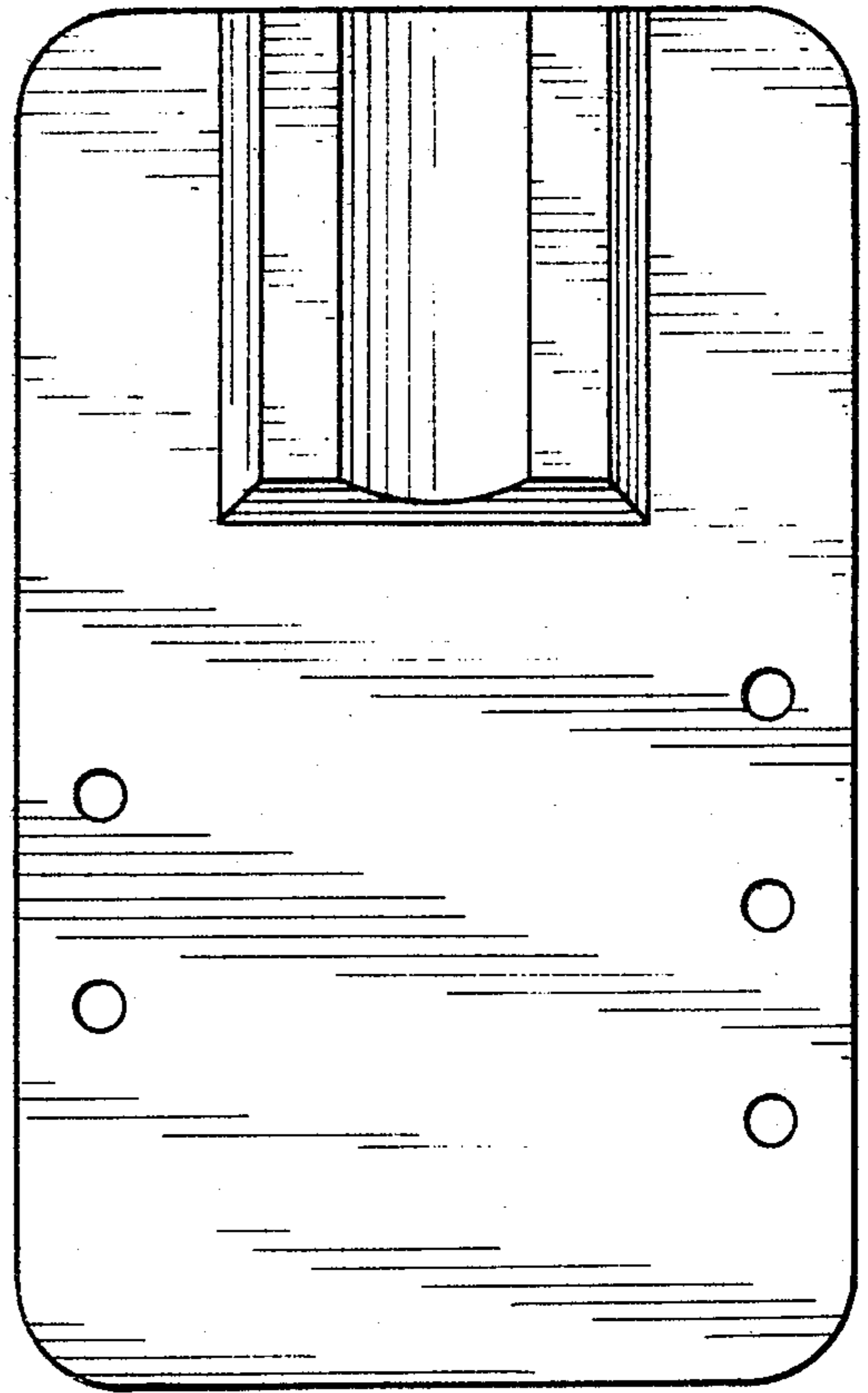
