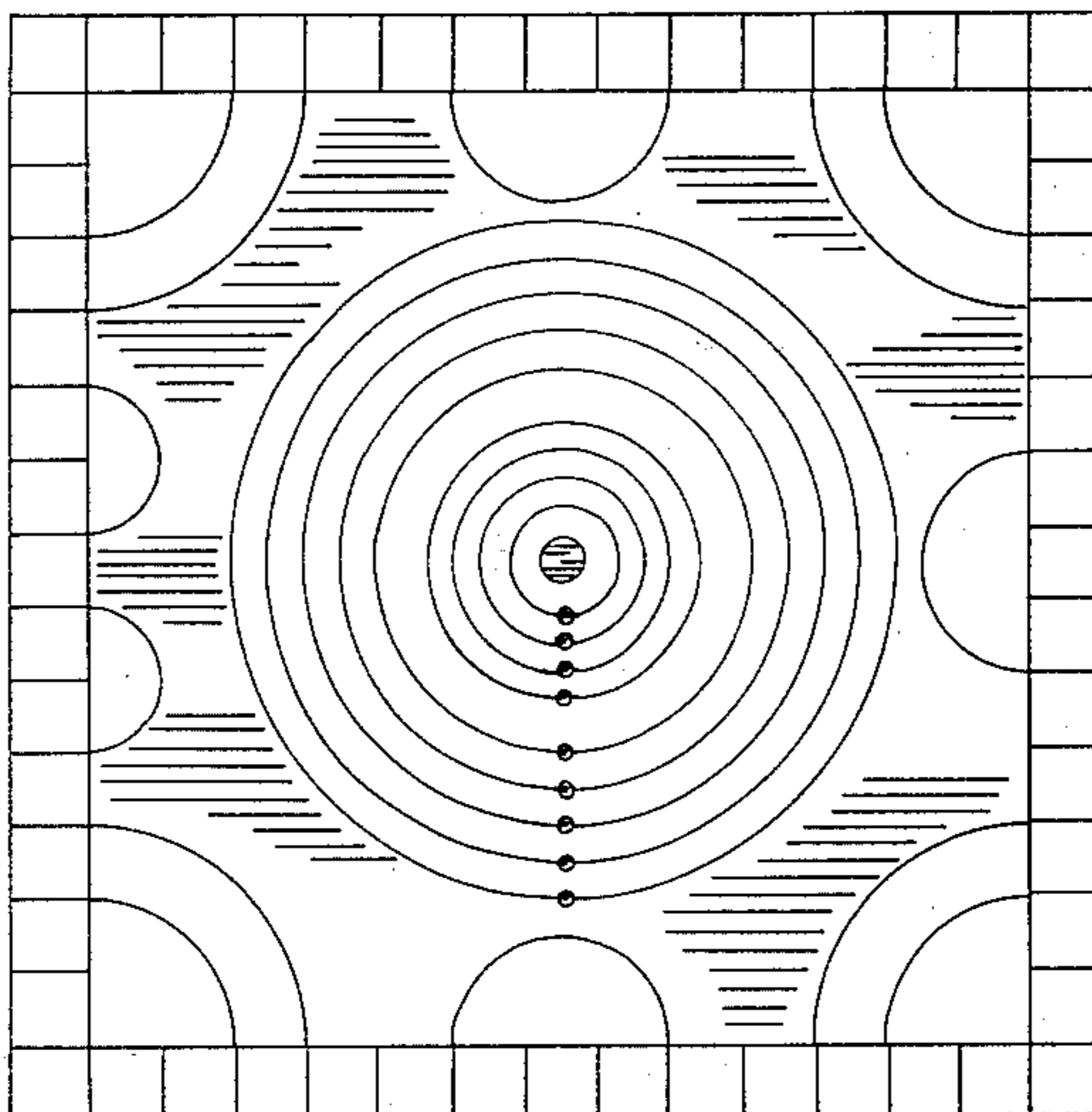
[57] **CLAIM**

The board is flat and is of conventional thickness.



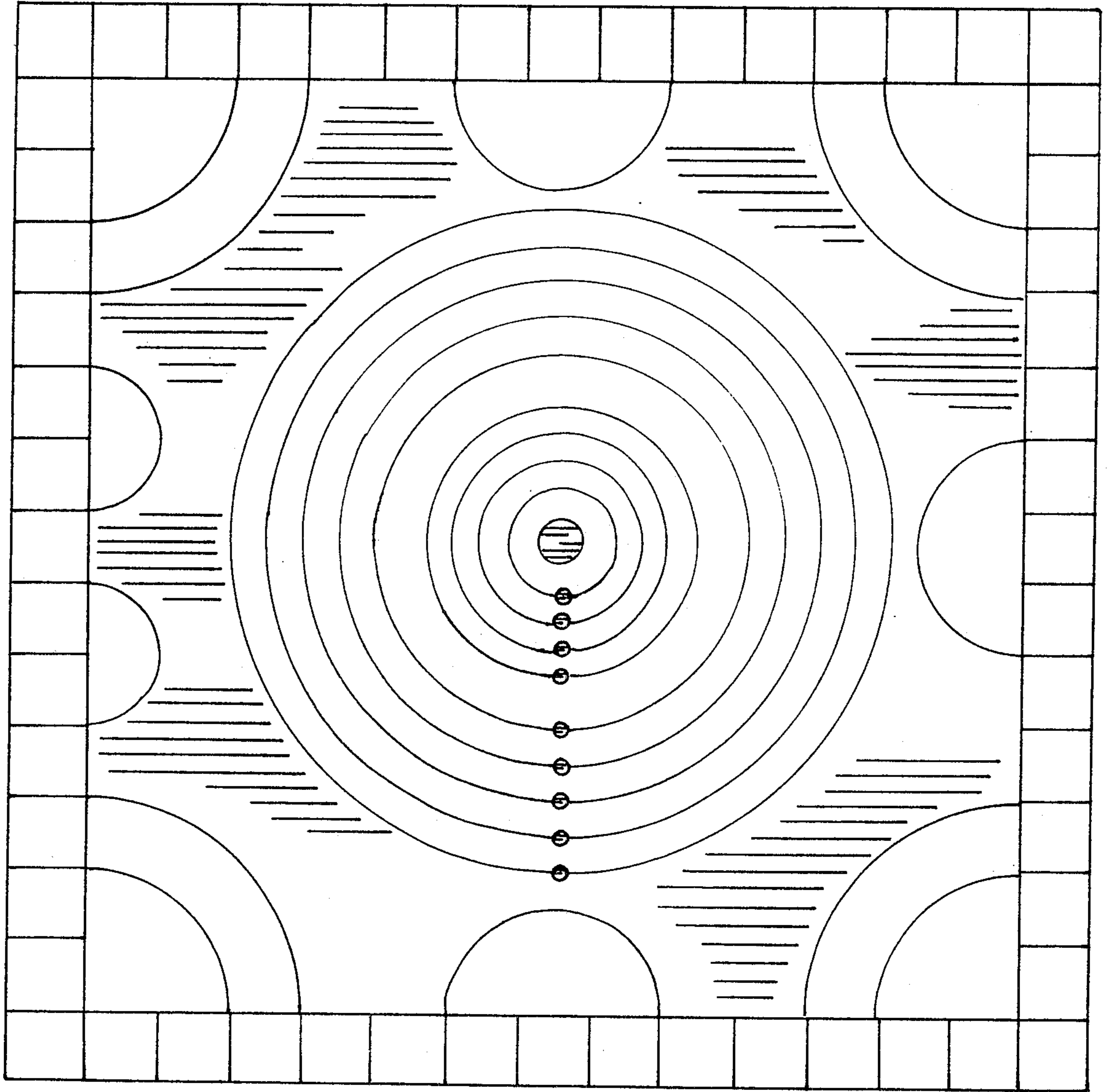
