FIG. 6 is a top plan view thereof broken away to indicate indeterminate length.

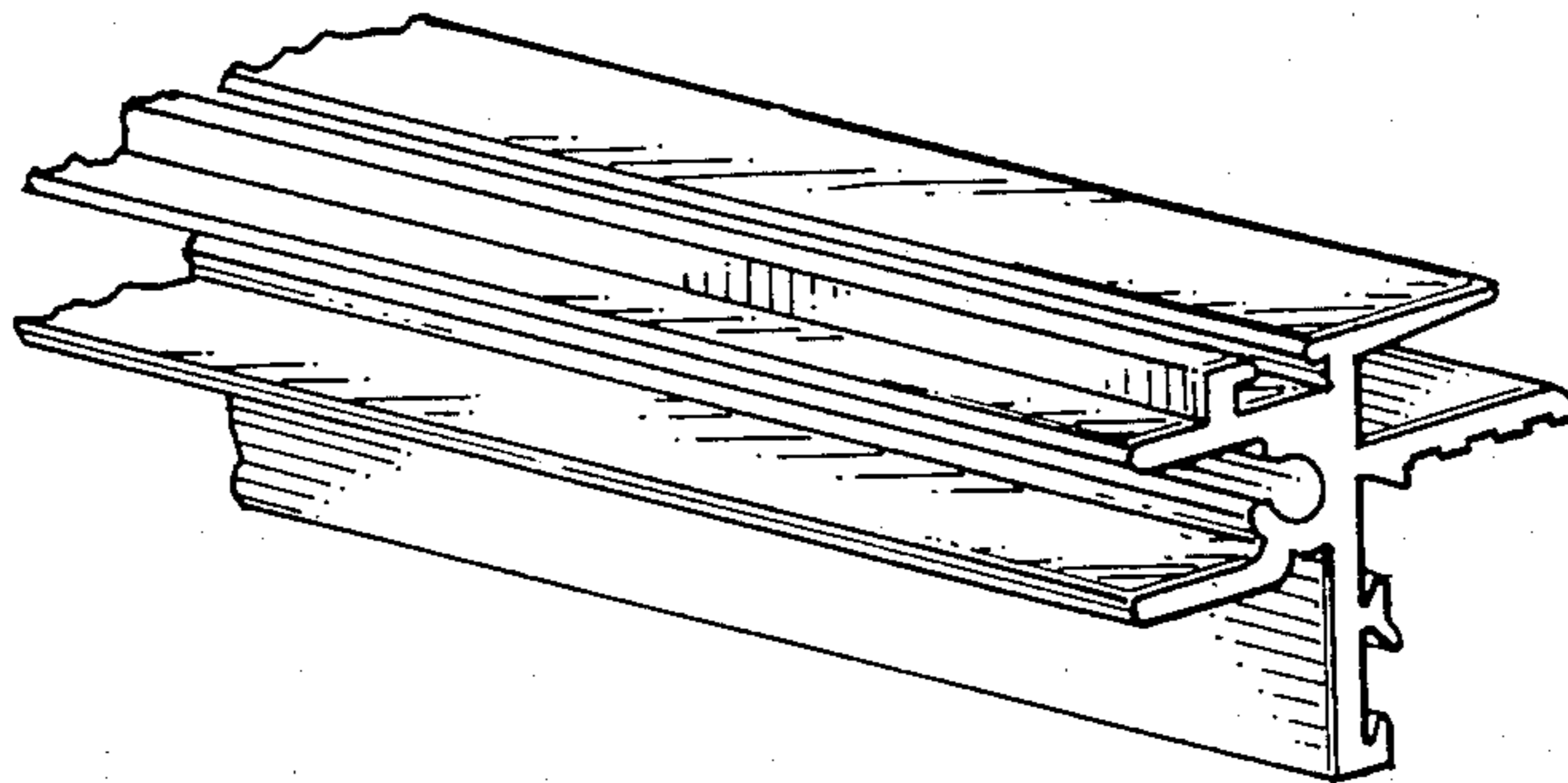

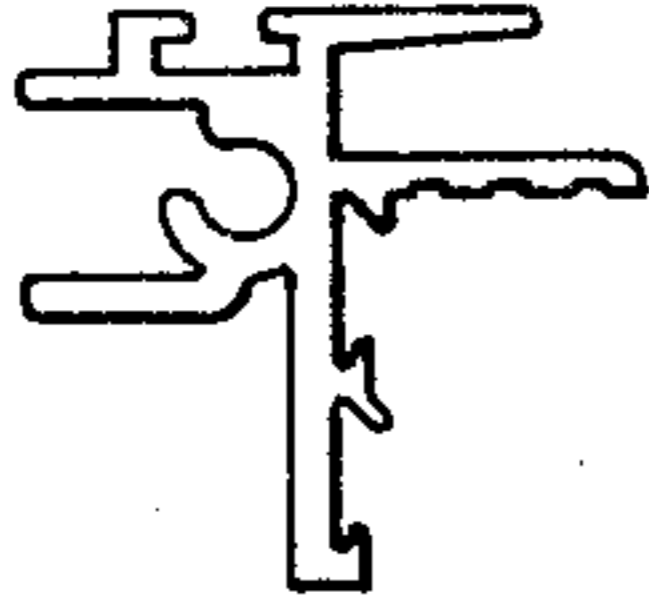

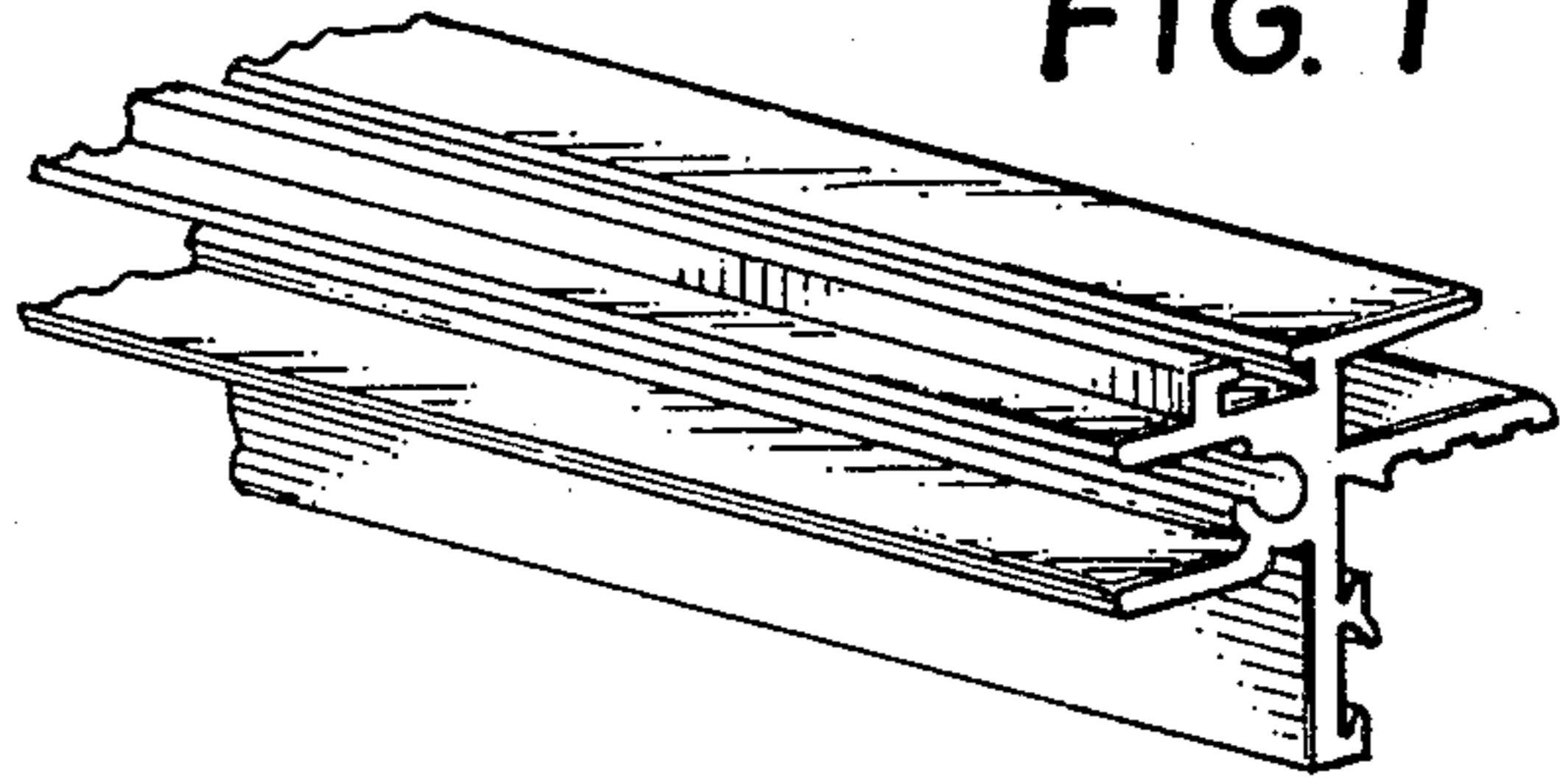

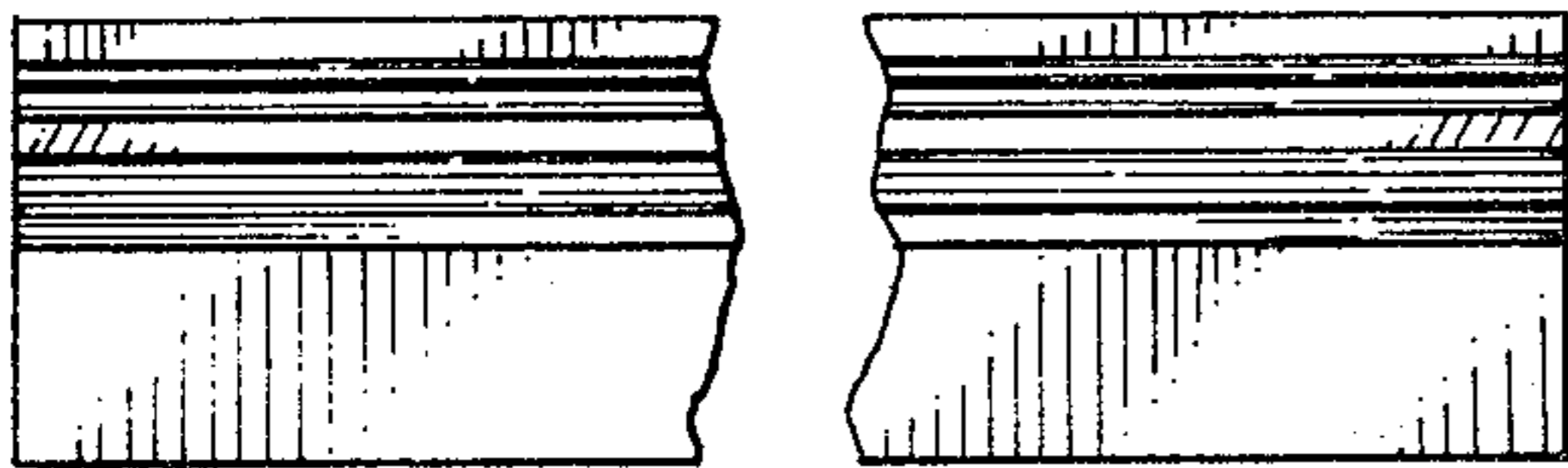

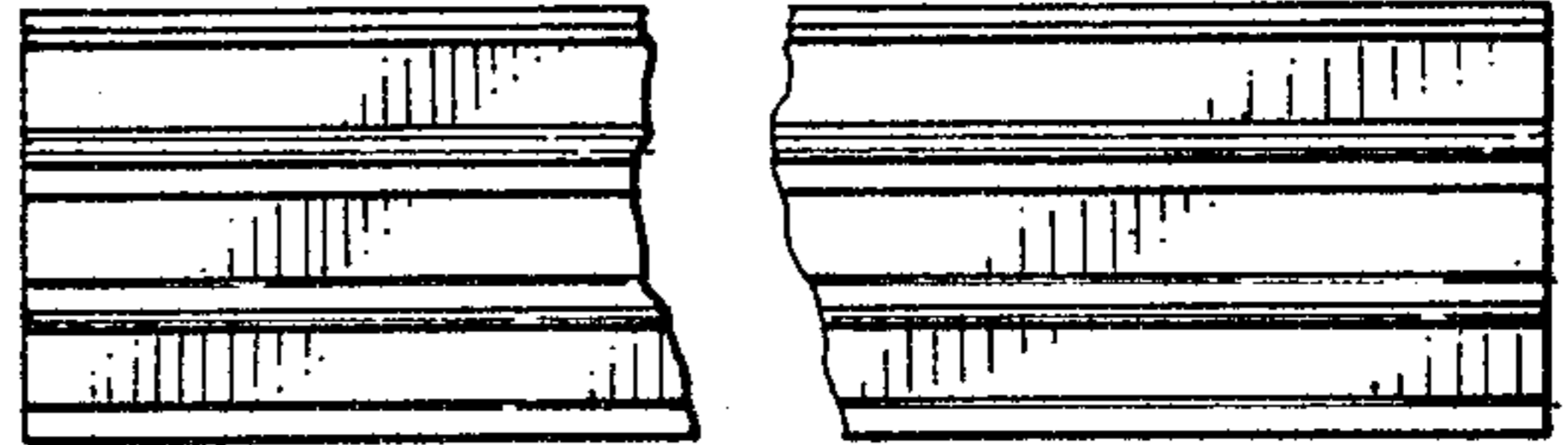

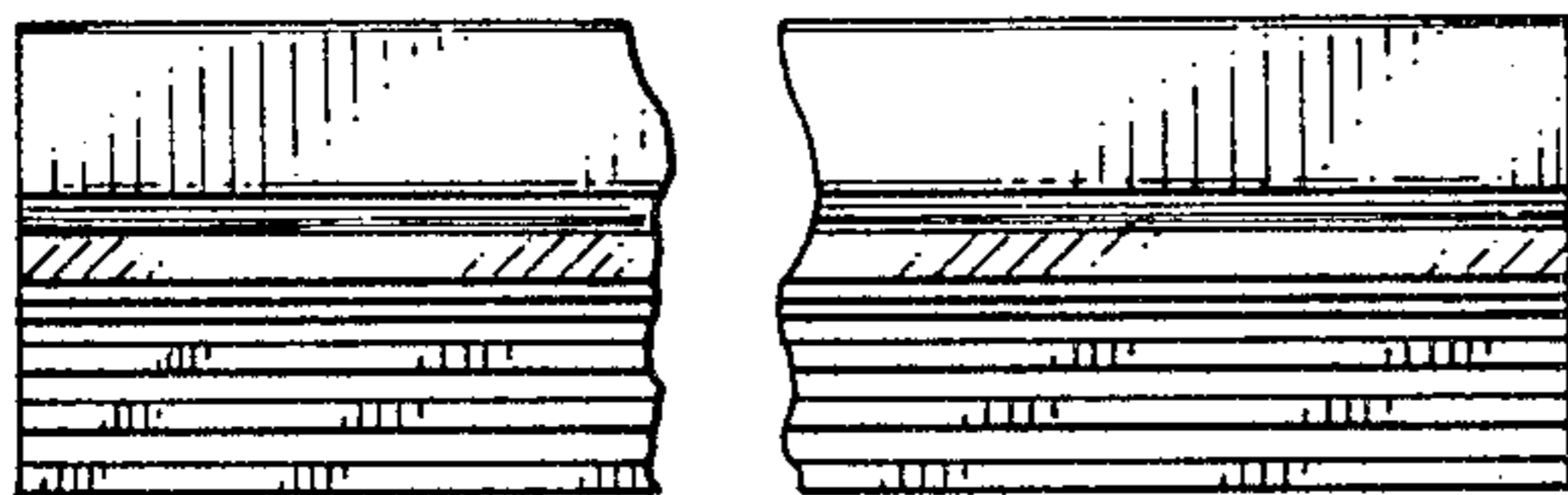
