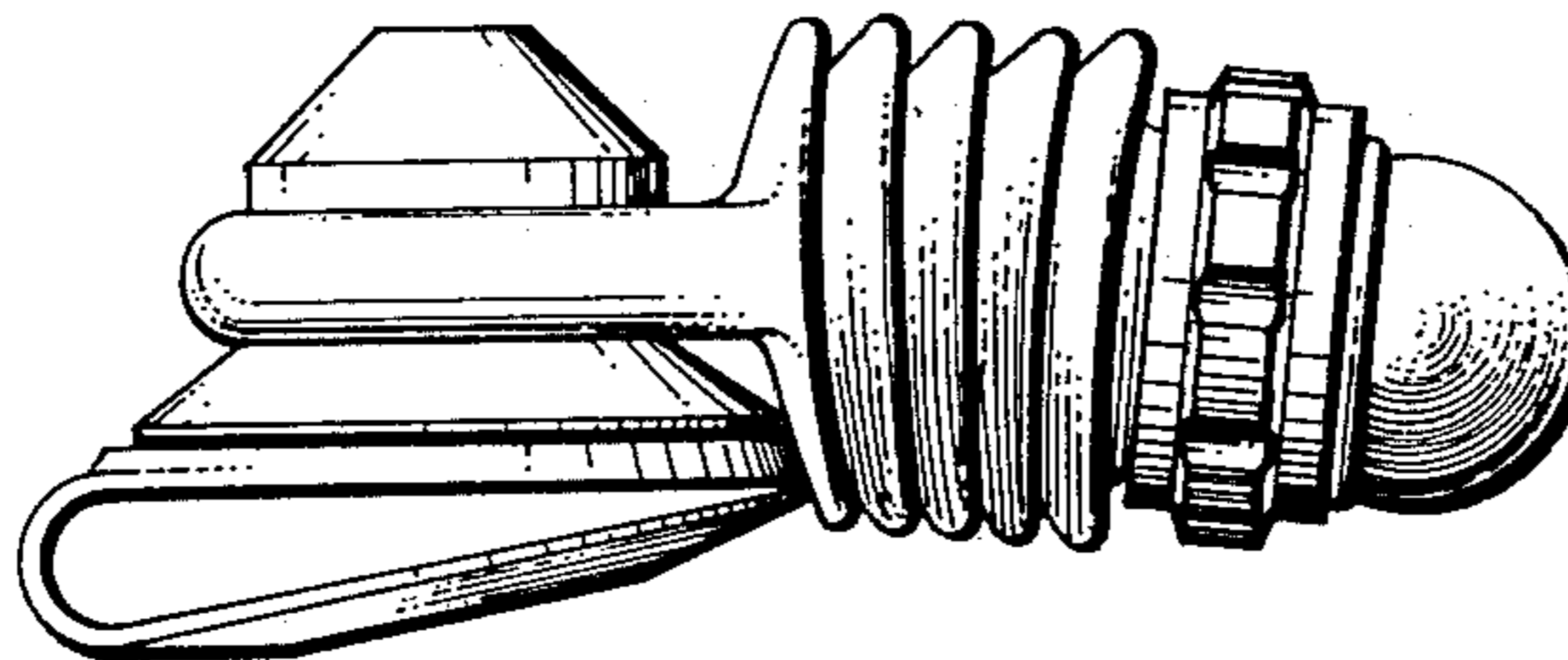
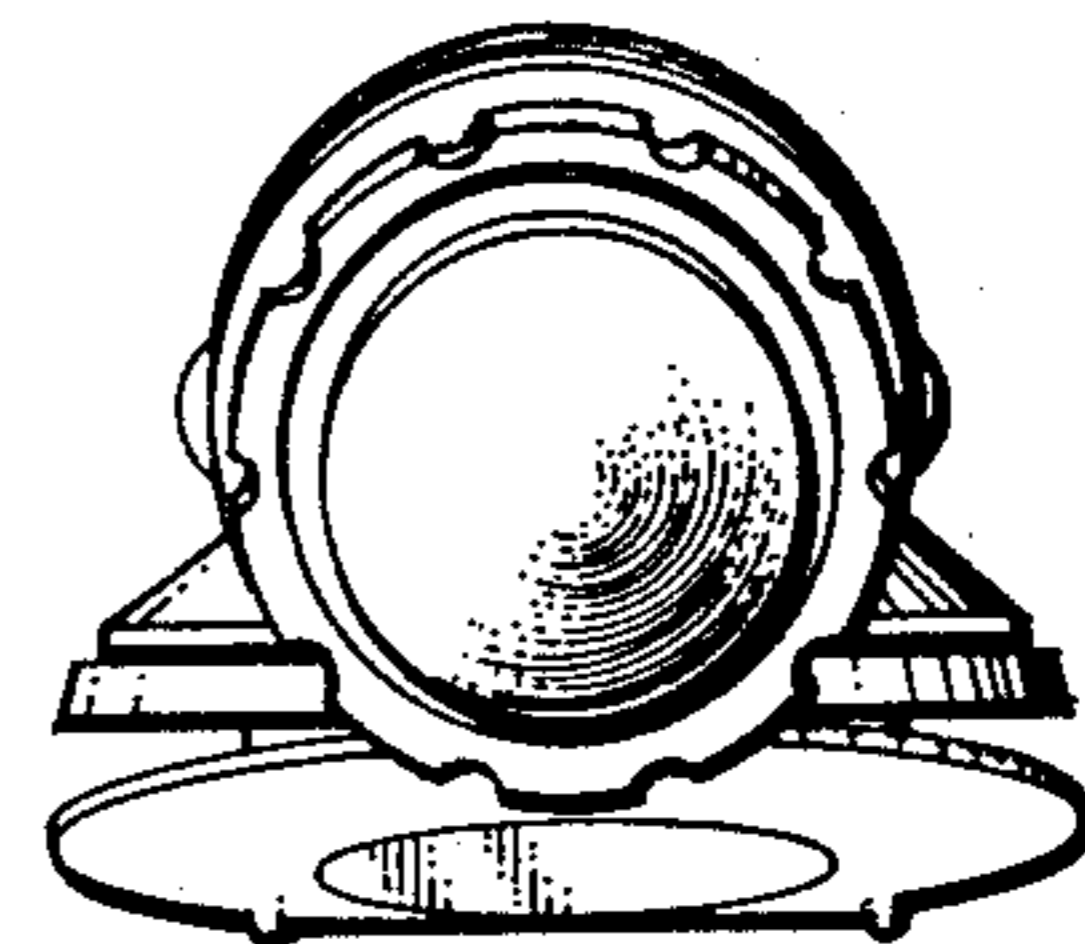
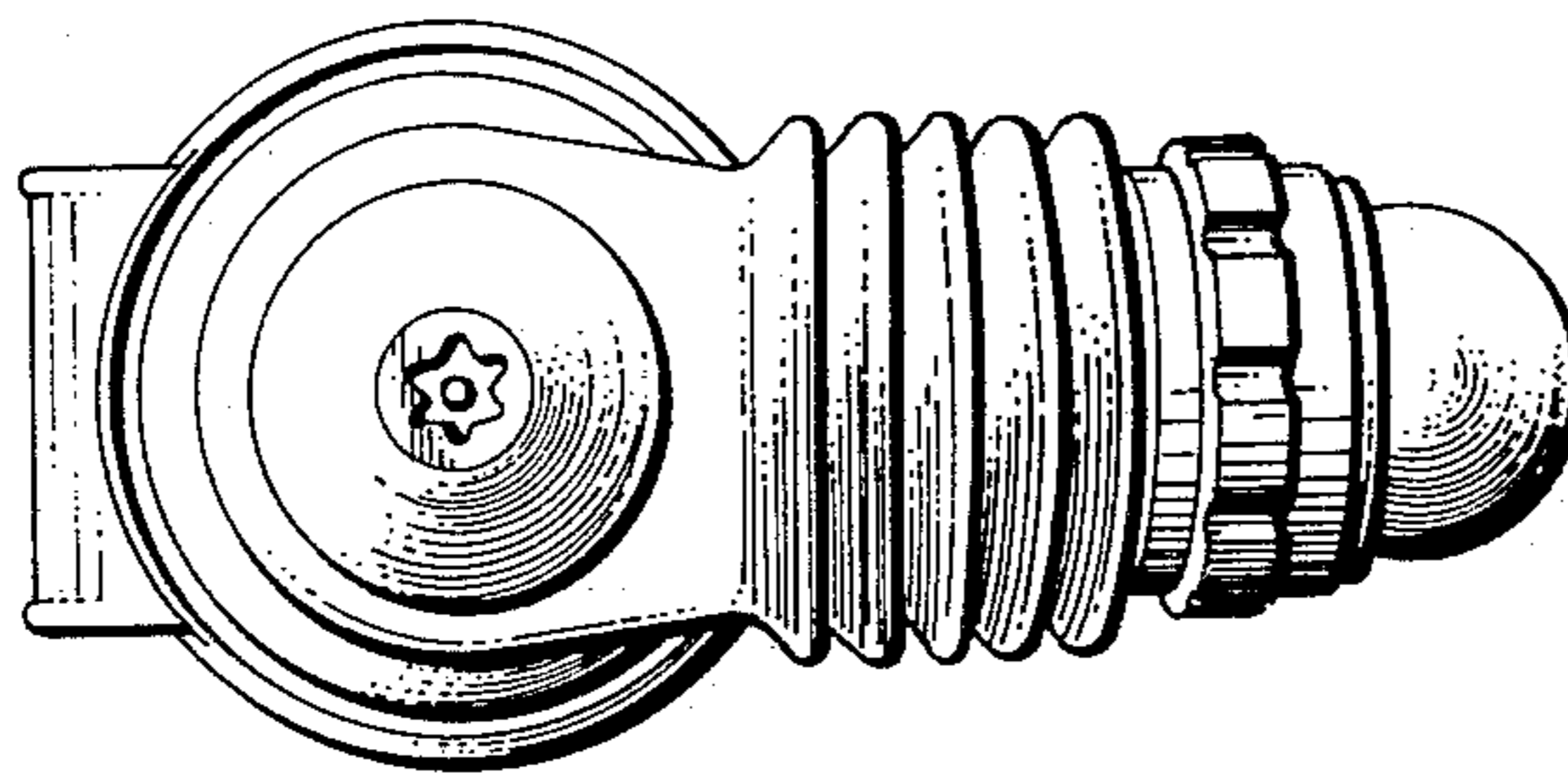

[57] CLAIM

The ornamental design for a clip connector for wind-screen extensions or the like, substantially as shown.

DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a top plan view of a clip connector for wind-screen extensions or the like showing my new design; FIG. 2 is a left side elevation thereof, the right side being a mirror image; FIG. 3 is a bottom plan view thereof; FIG. 4 is a front elevation thereof; and, FIG. 5 is a rear elevation thereof.



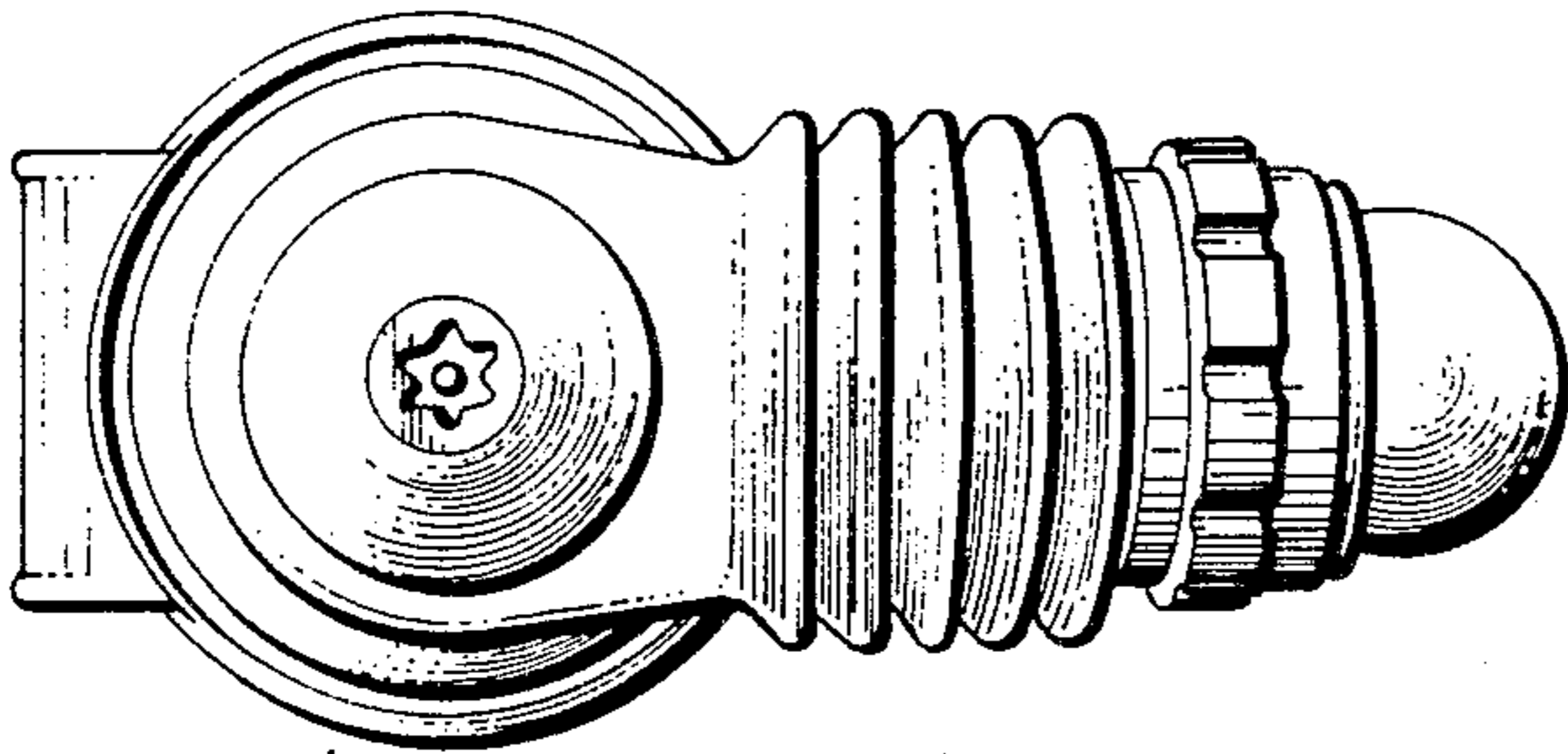

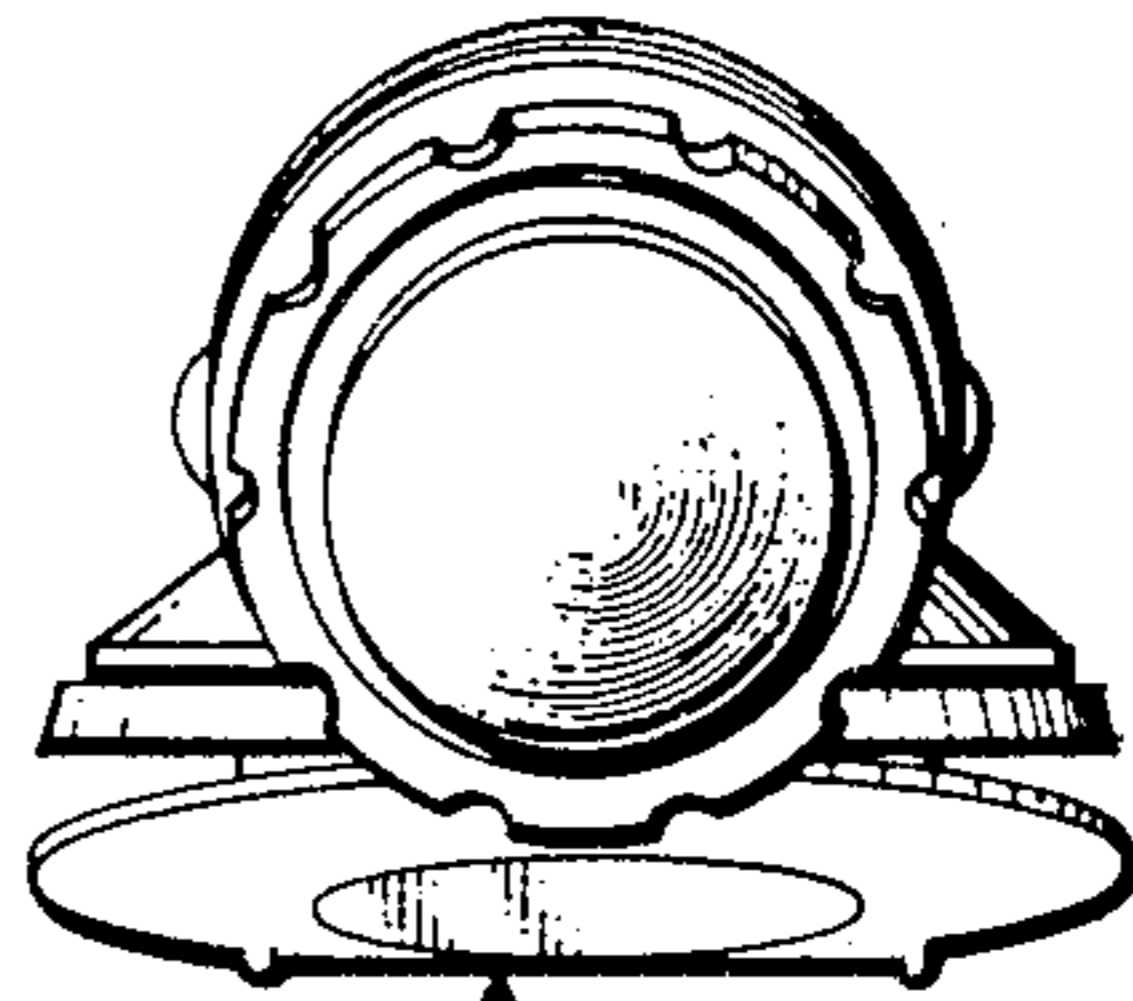

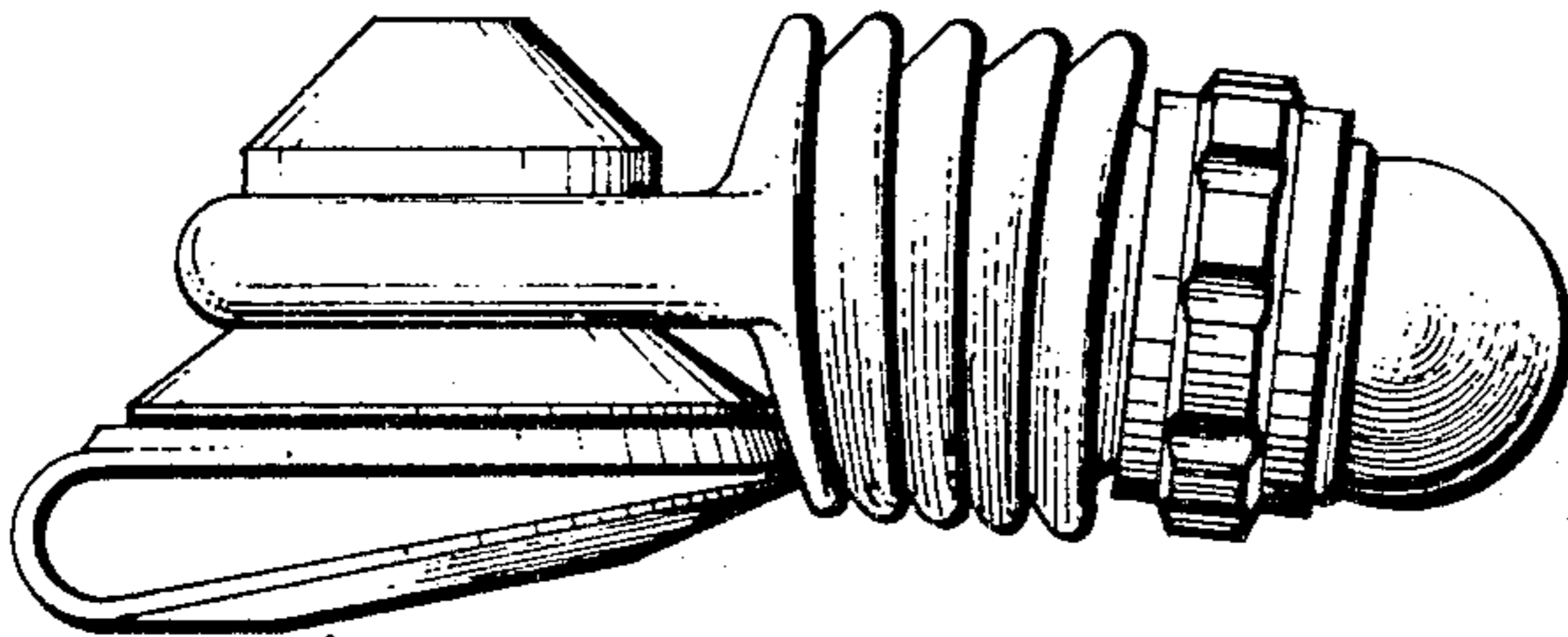

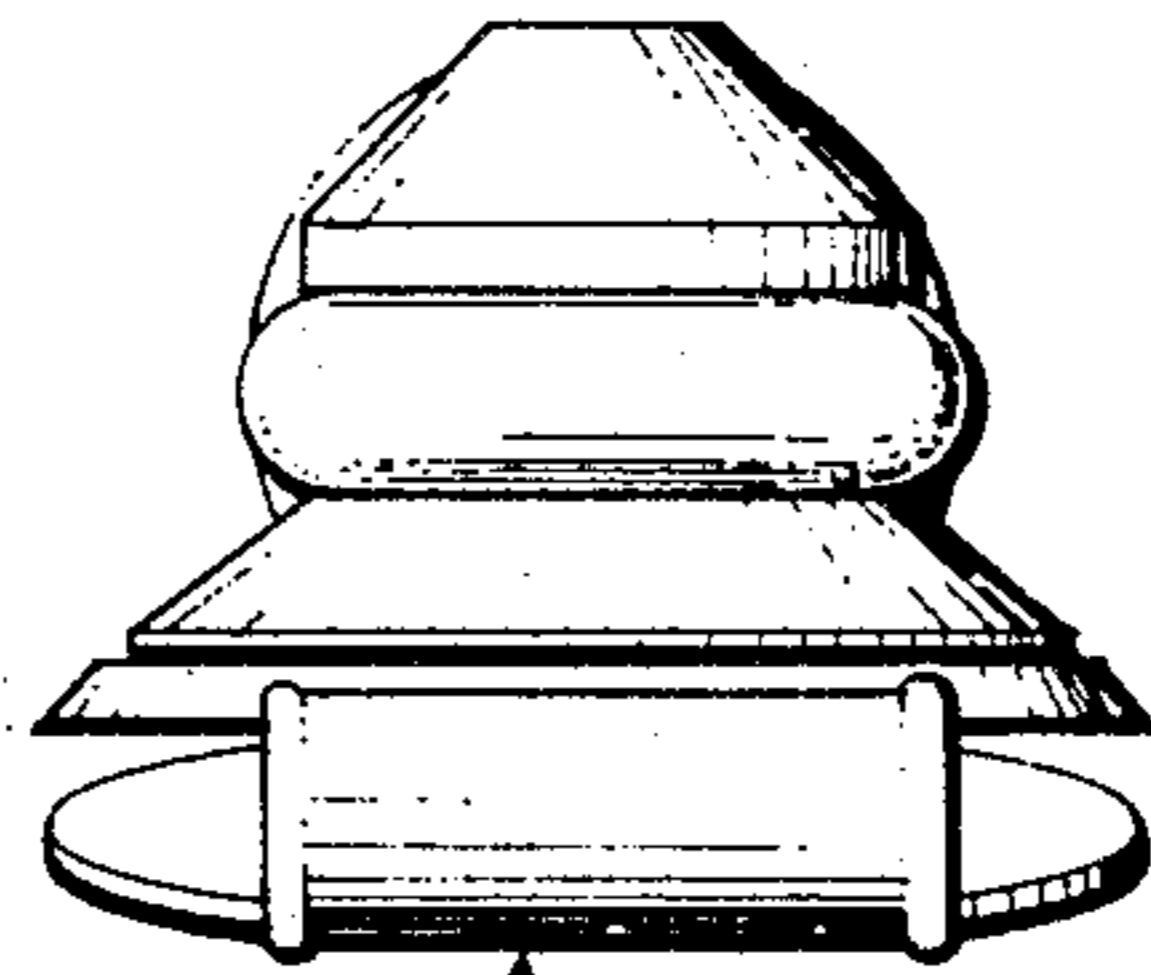

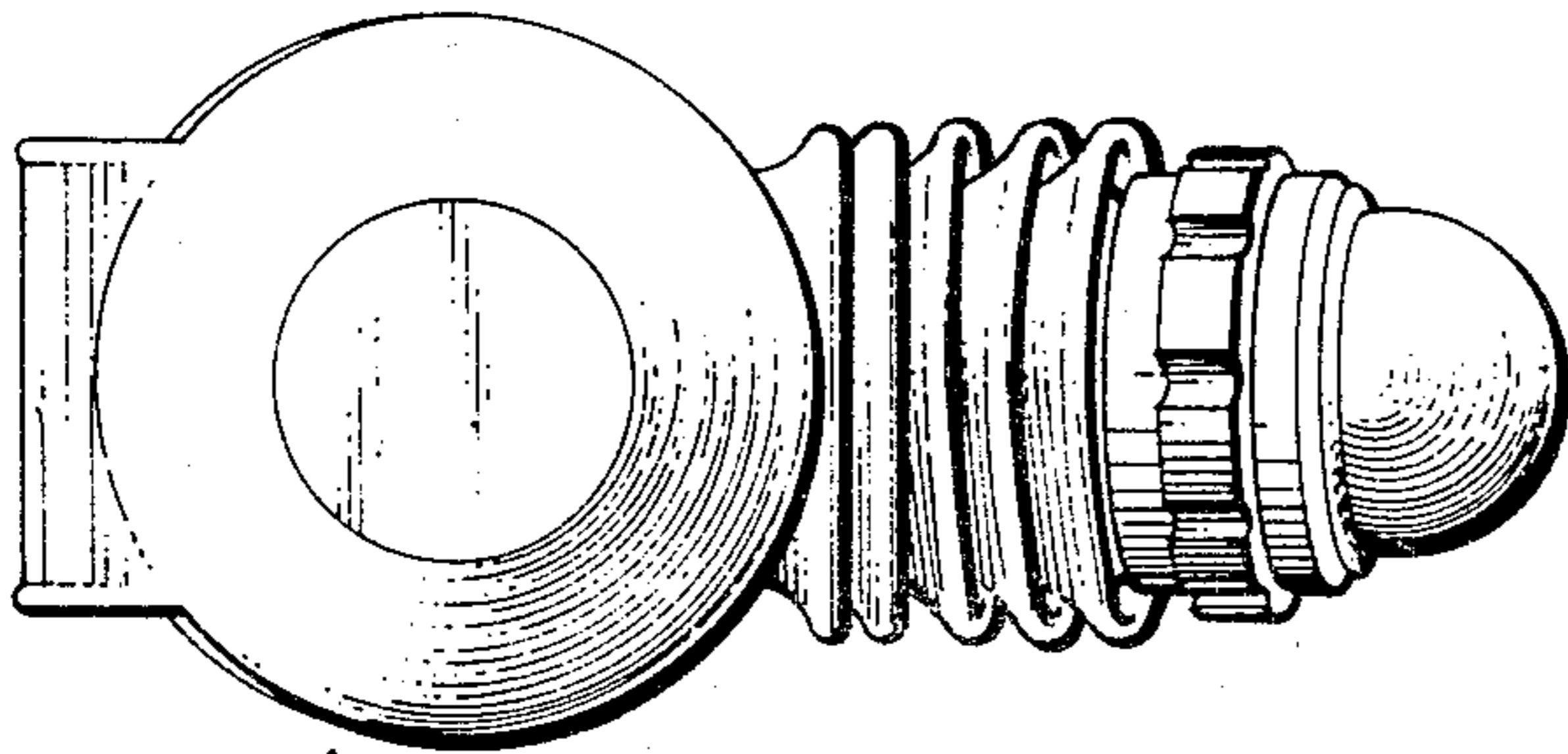
