FIG. 1 is a perspective view taken from the top and one side of a faucet handle showing my new design; and, FIG. 2 is a top plan view thereof.

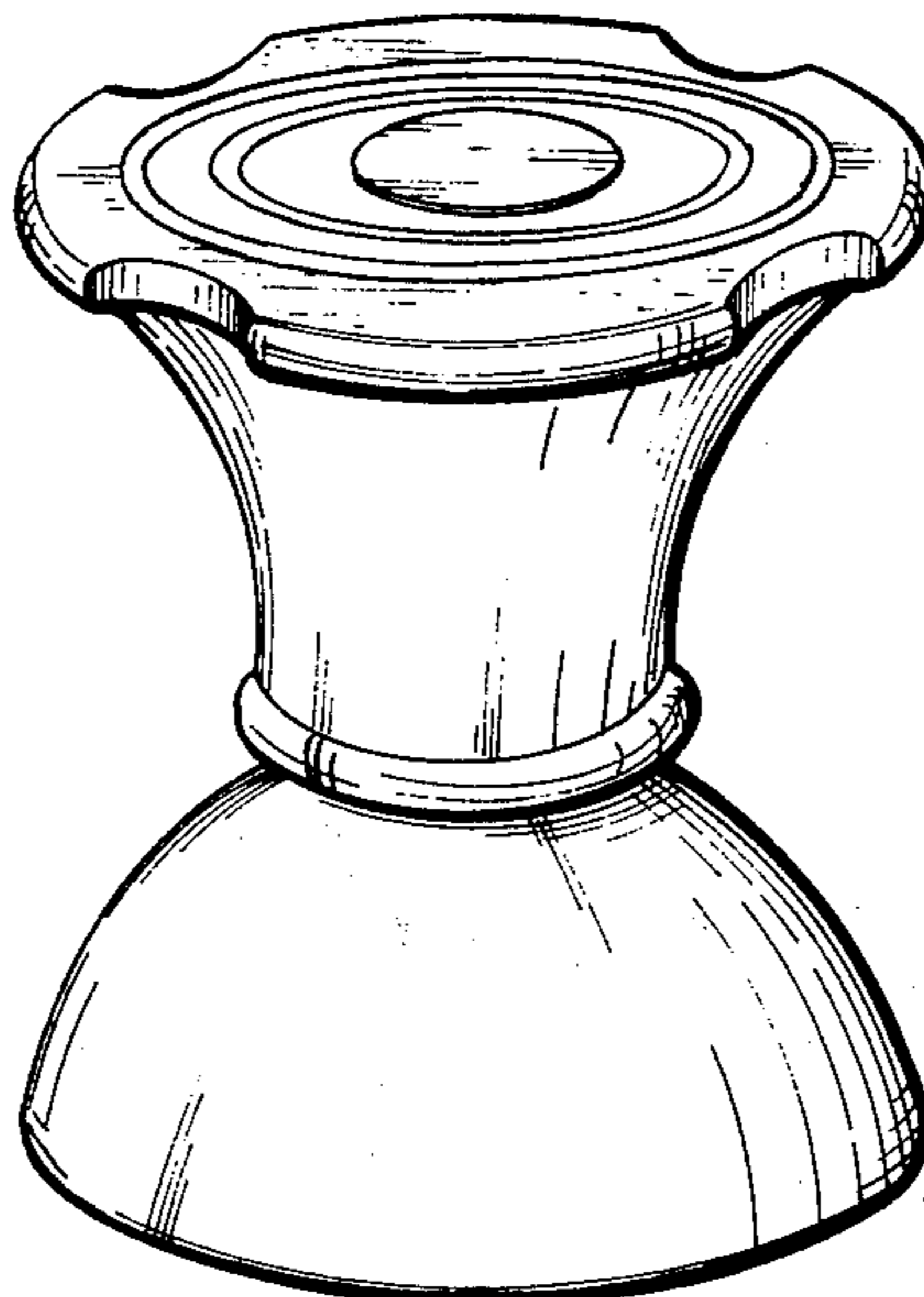

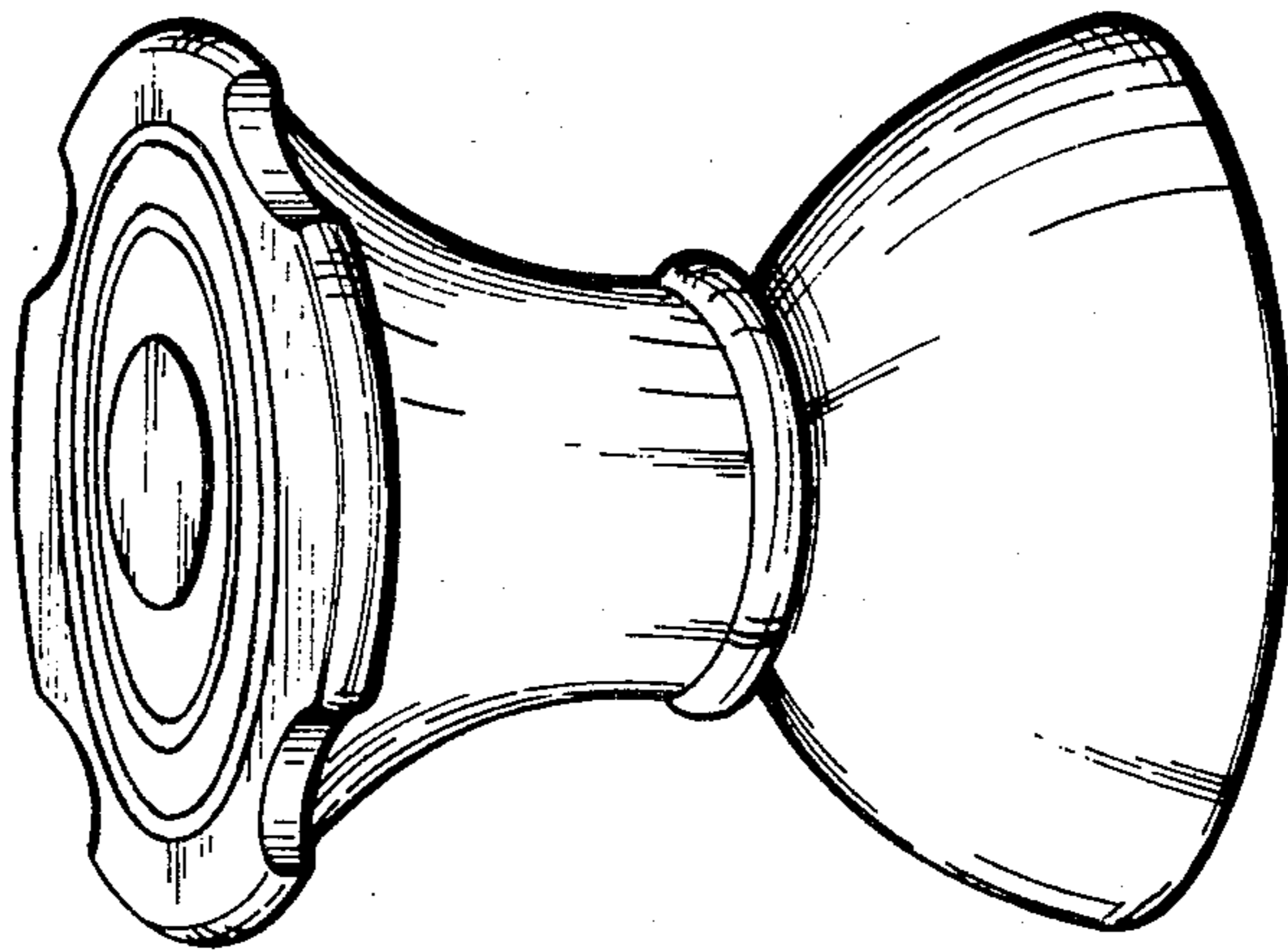
