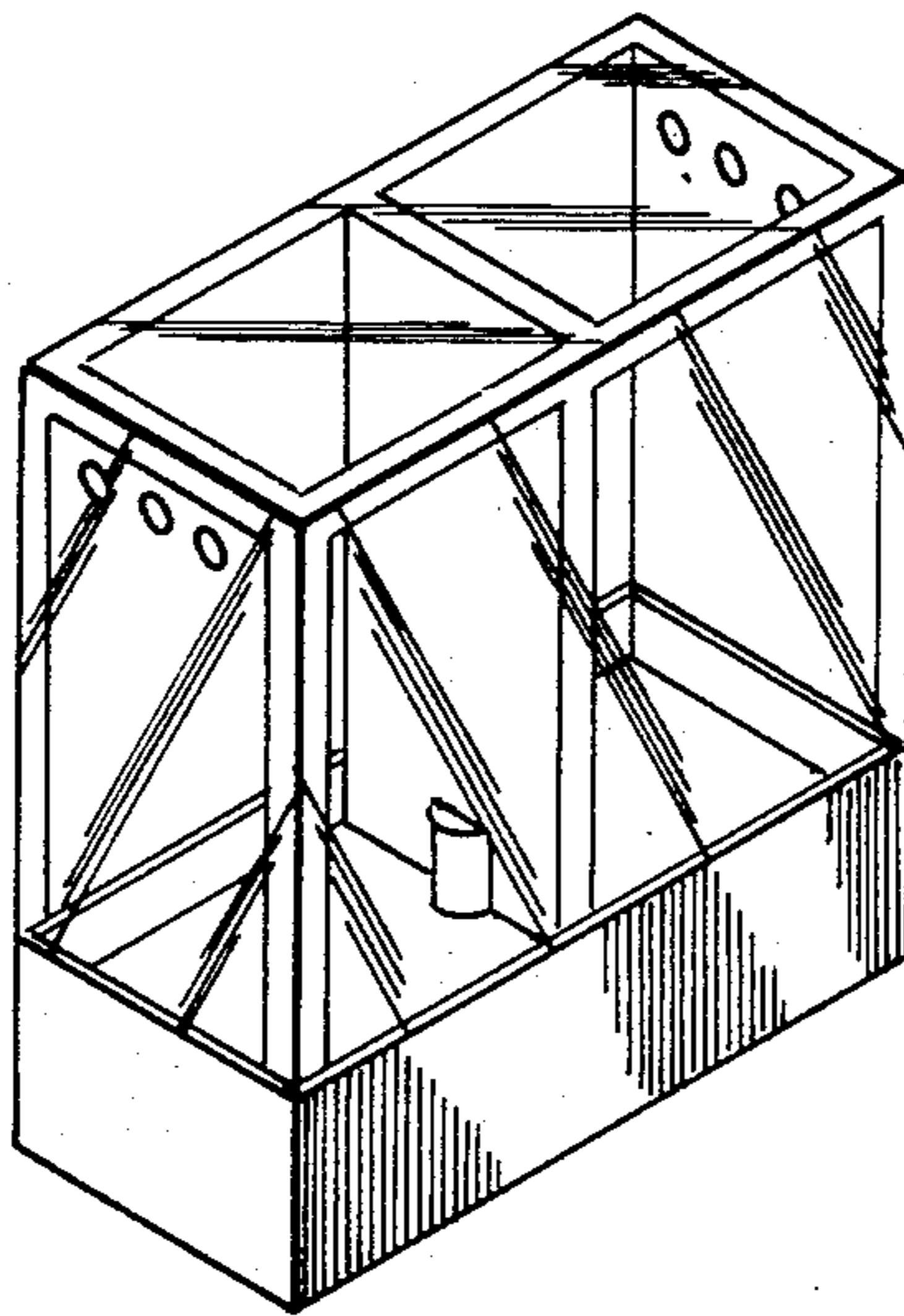

The ornamental design for a two-compartment condiment dispenser, as shown and described.

DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a top plan view of a two-compartment condiment dispenser showing my new design; FIG. 2 is a side-elevational view thereof; FIG. 3 is an end-elevational view thereof; FIG. 4 is a bottom plan view thereof; and FIG. 5 is a perspective view thereof. The side opposite that shown in FIG. 3 is identical thereto. The side opposite that shown in FIG. 2 is identical thereto.



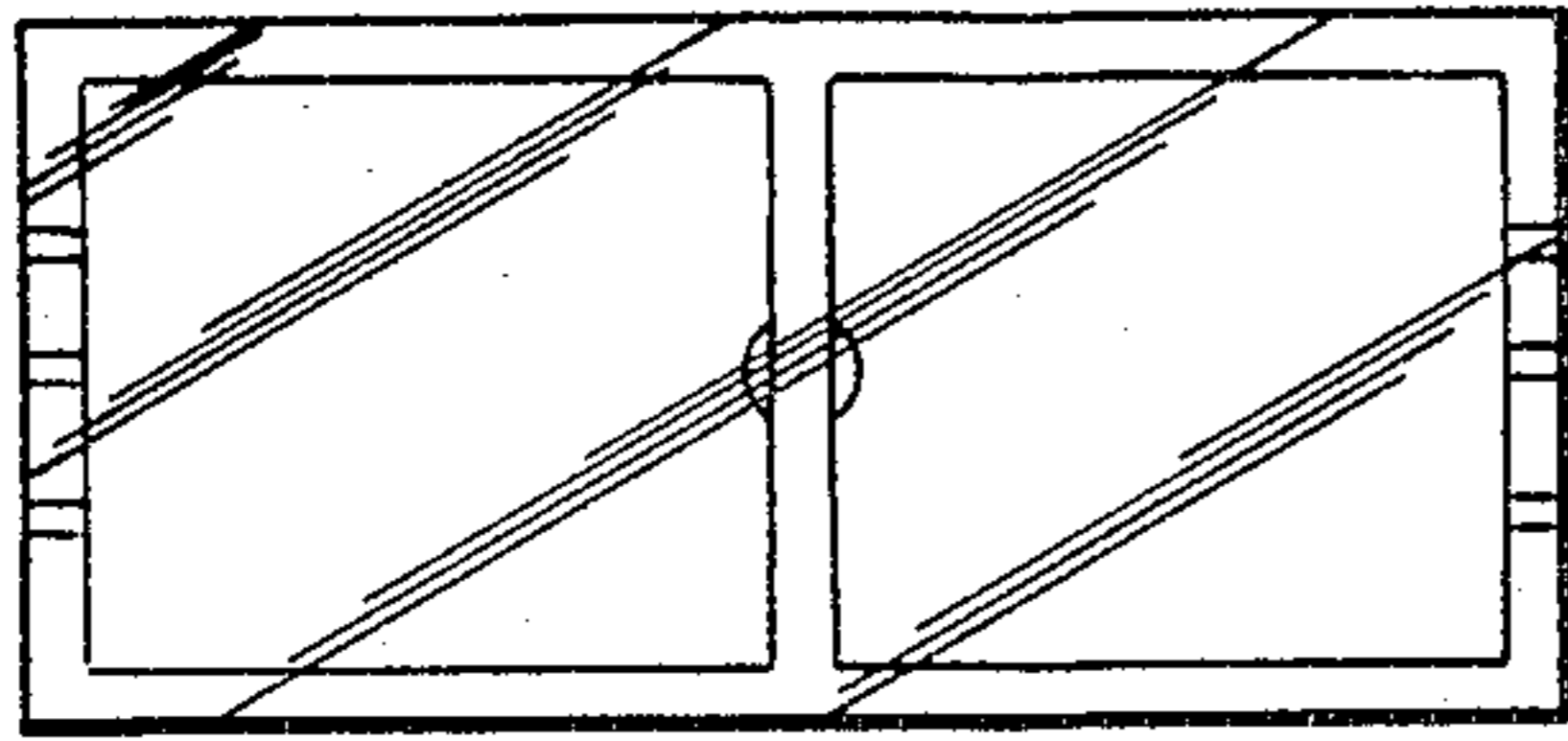

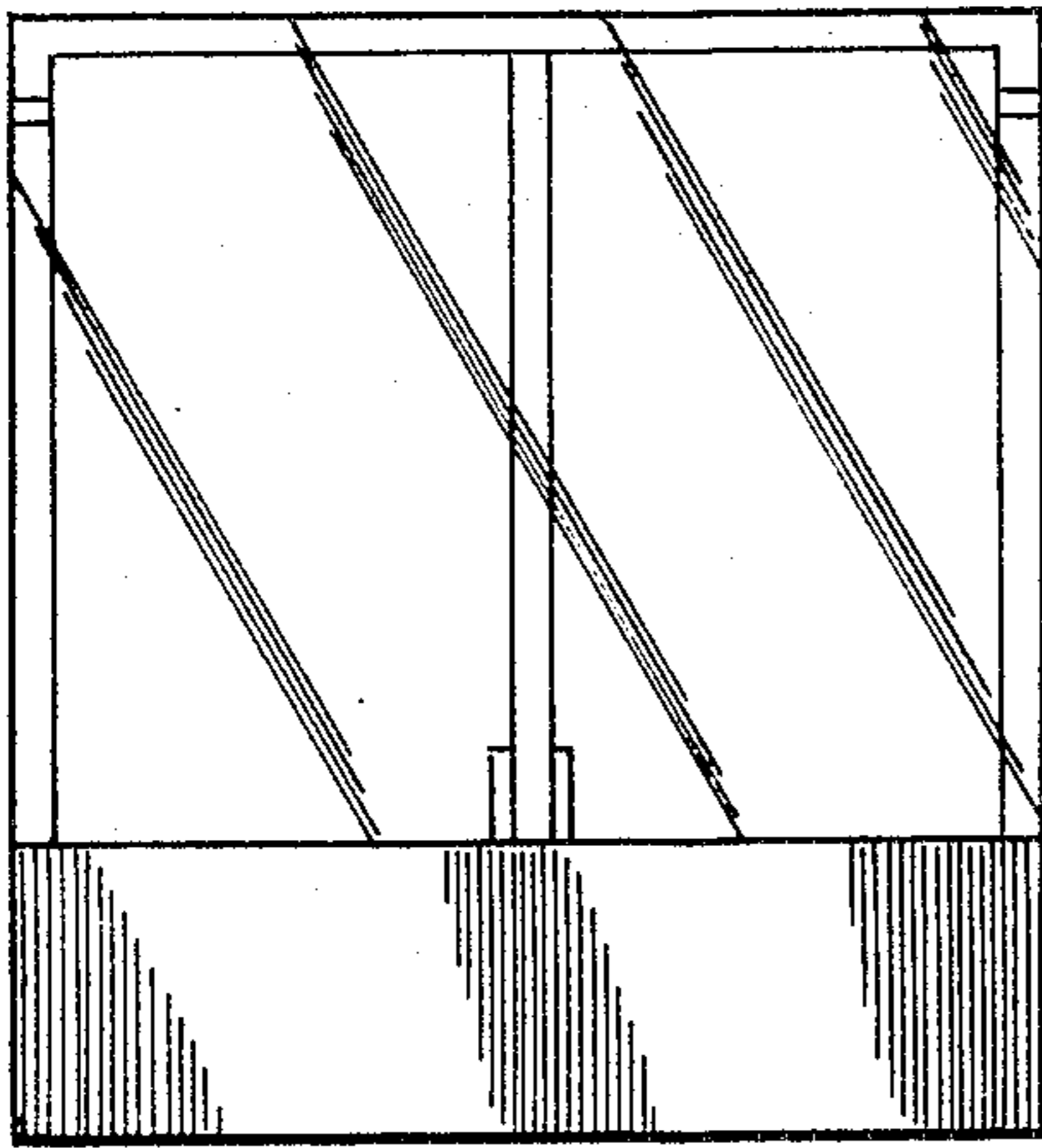

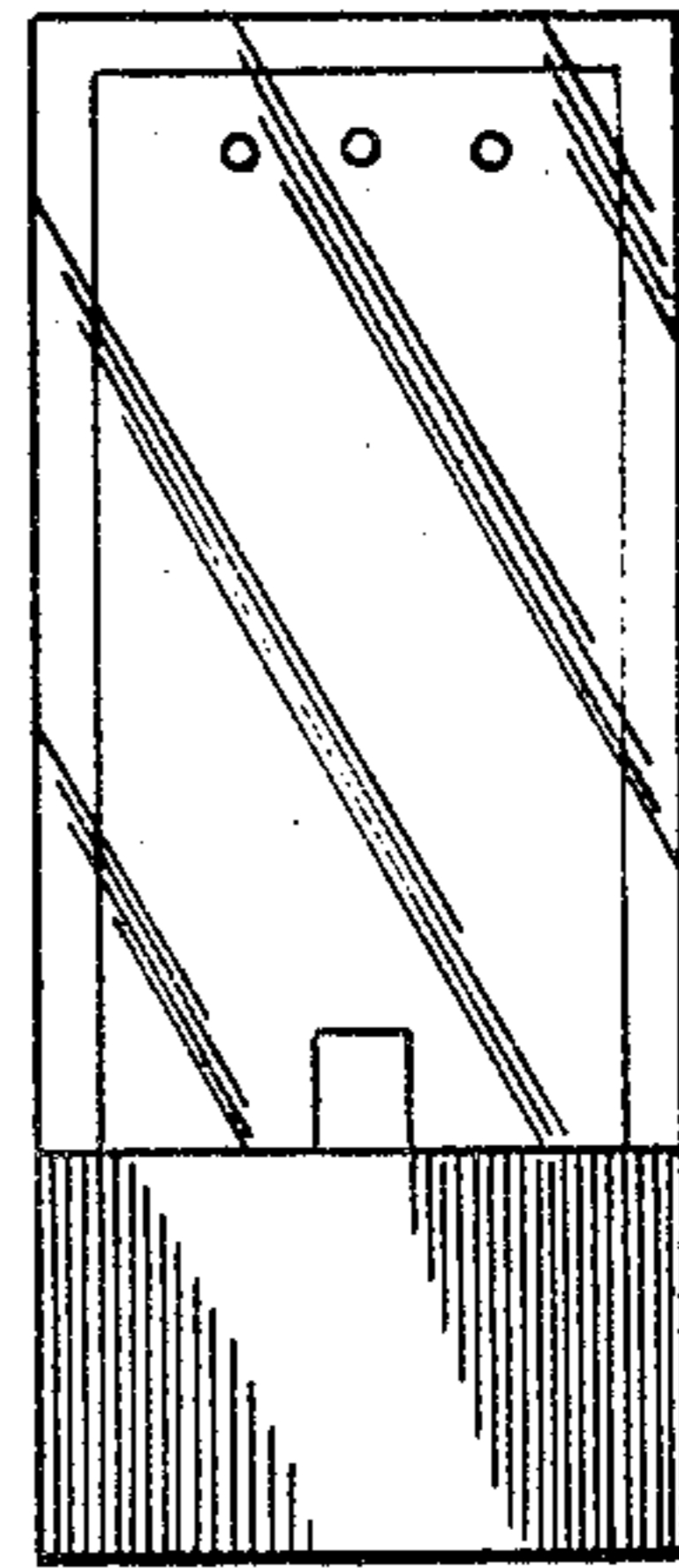

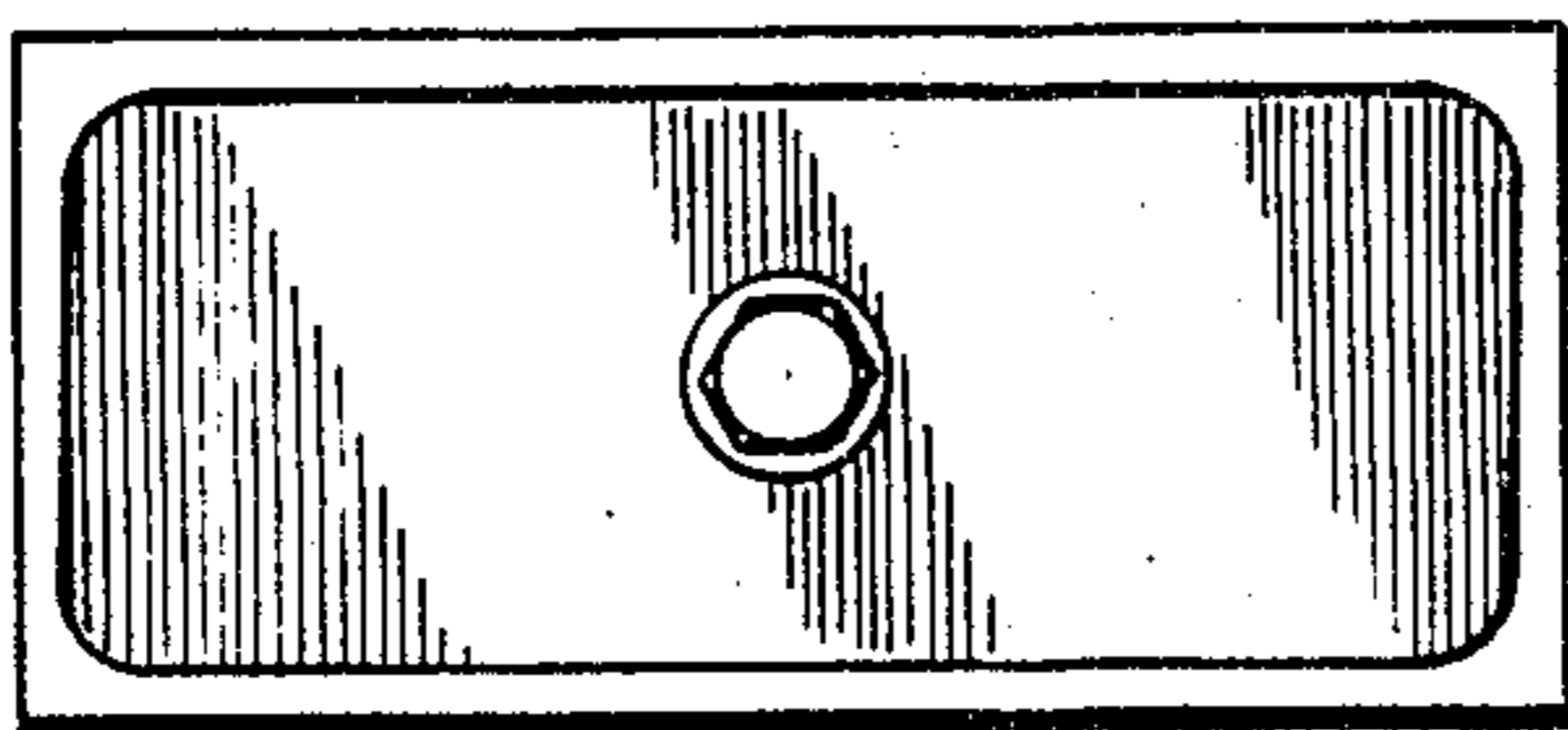

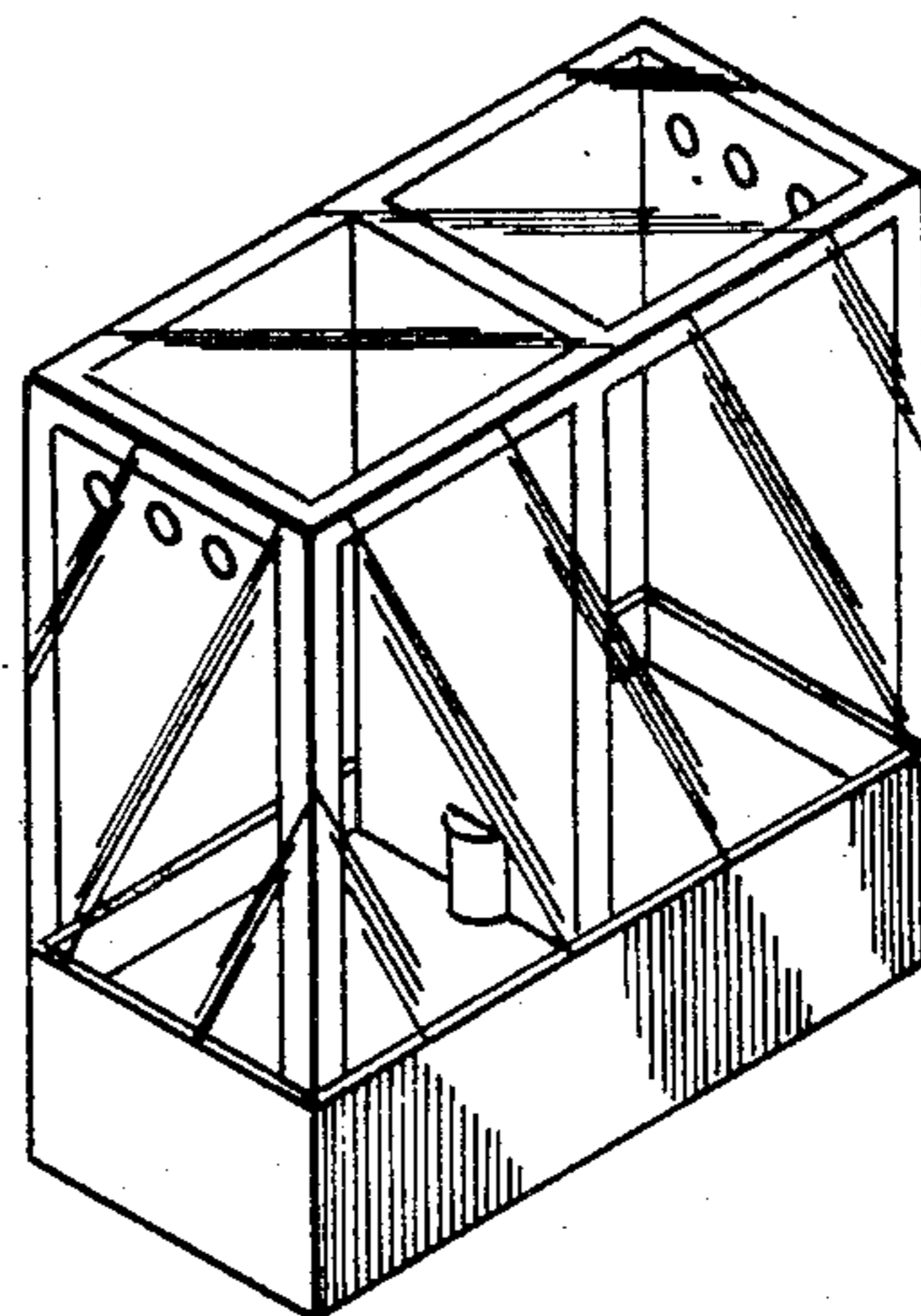
