as shown and described.

DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a top plan view of a handle for kitchen uten-
sils, showing my new design, the bottom plan view
being a mirror image thereof;
FIG. 2 is a side elevational view thereof, the opposite
side being a mirror image thereof;
FIG. 3 is a rear elevational view thereof; and
FIG. 4 is a front elevational view thereof.

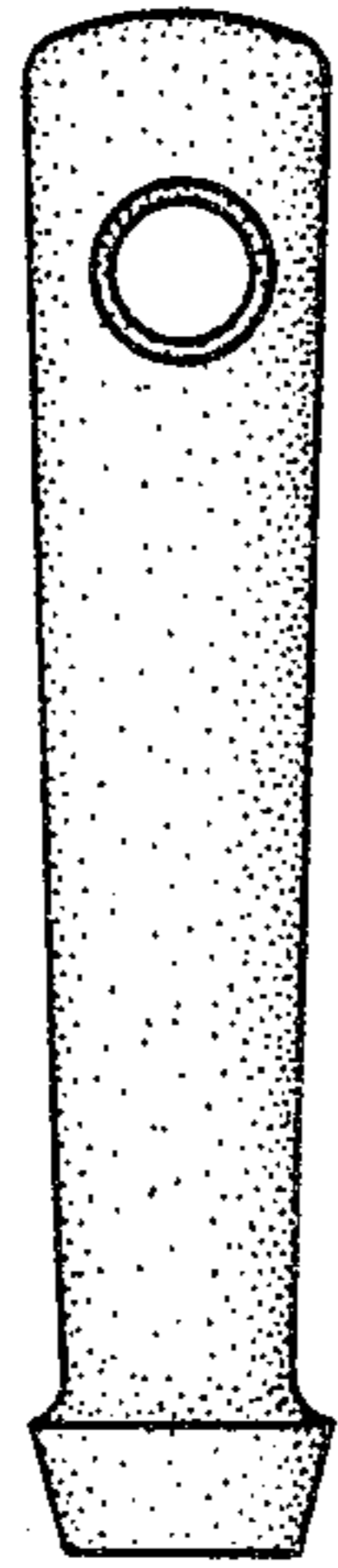

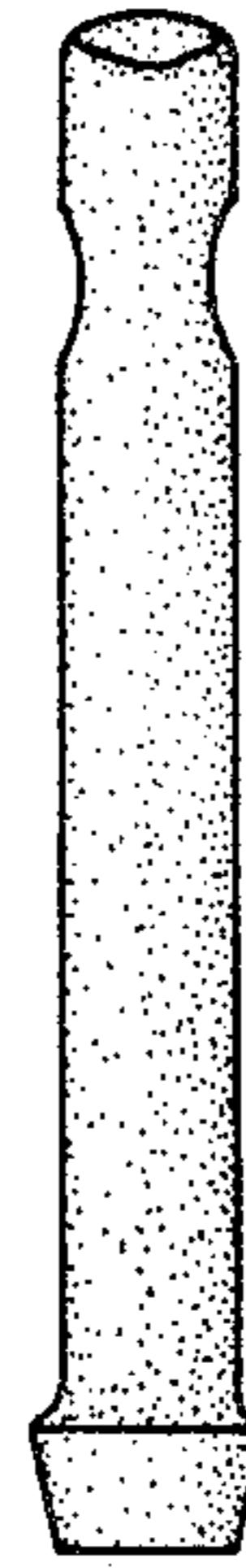
