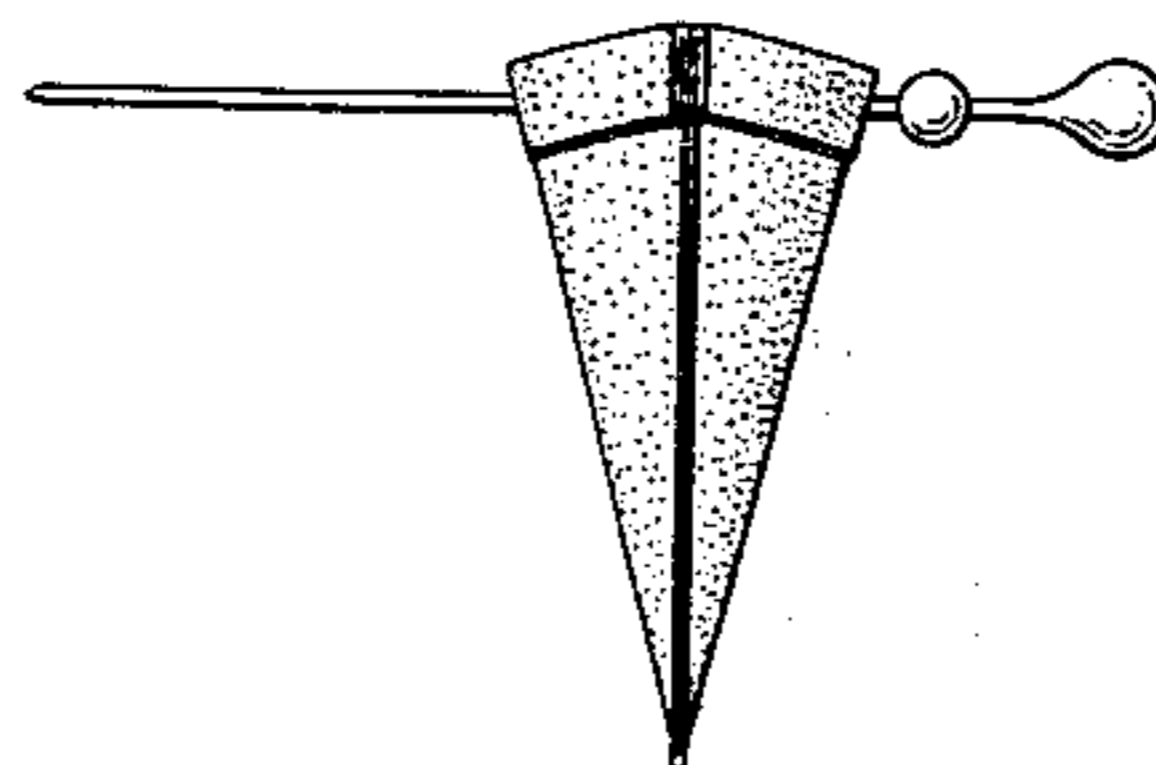
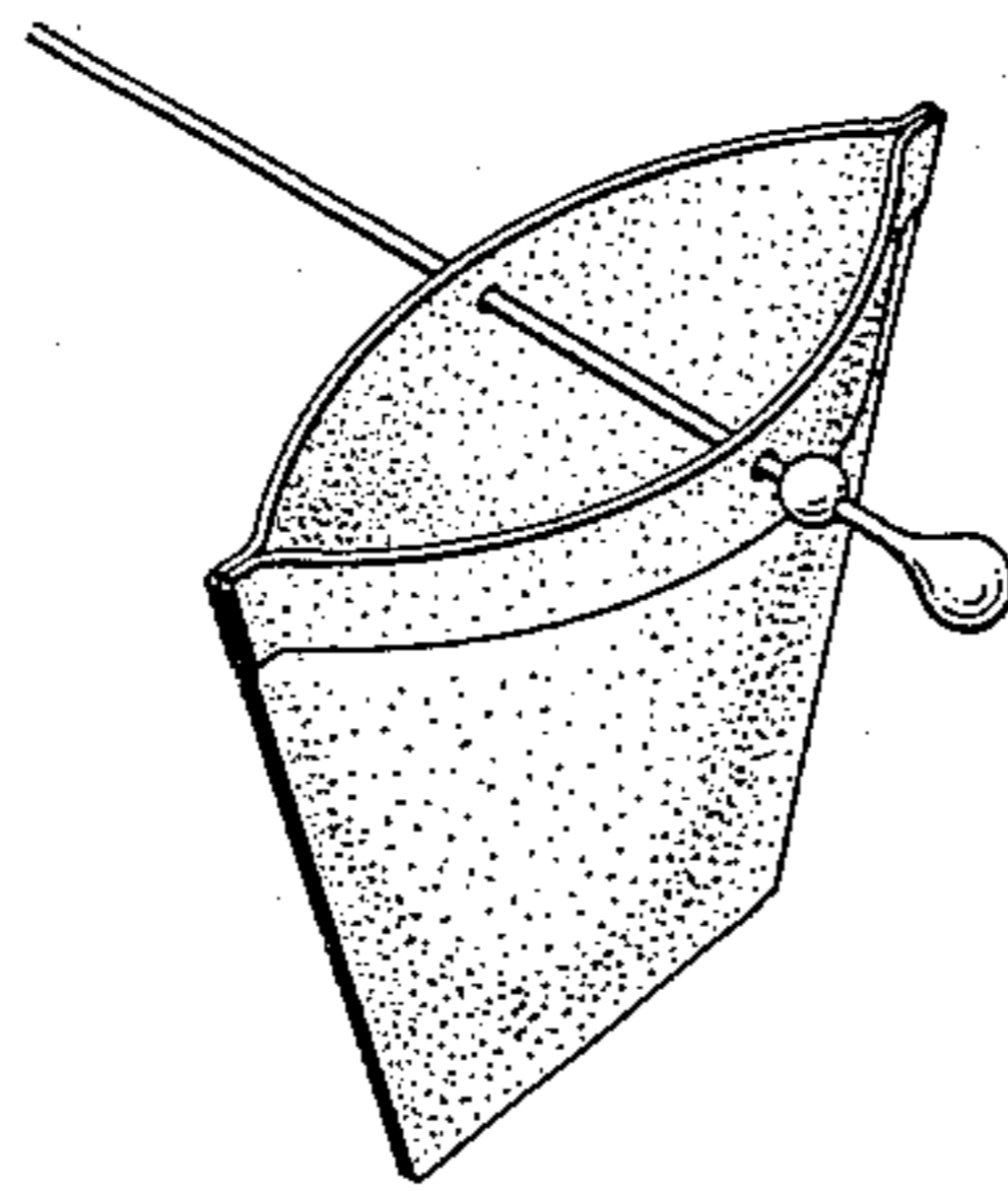

[57] CLAIM

The ornamental design for a cup-mounted disposable coffee or tea filter, substantially as shown and described.

DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a top front perspective view of a cup-mounted disposable coffee or tea filter showing my new design; FIG. 2 is a bottom rear perspective view thereof; and FIG. 3 is a left side elevational view thereof, the right side is a mirror image thereof.



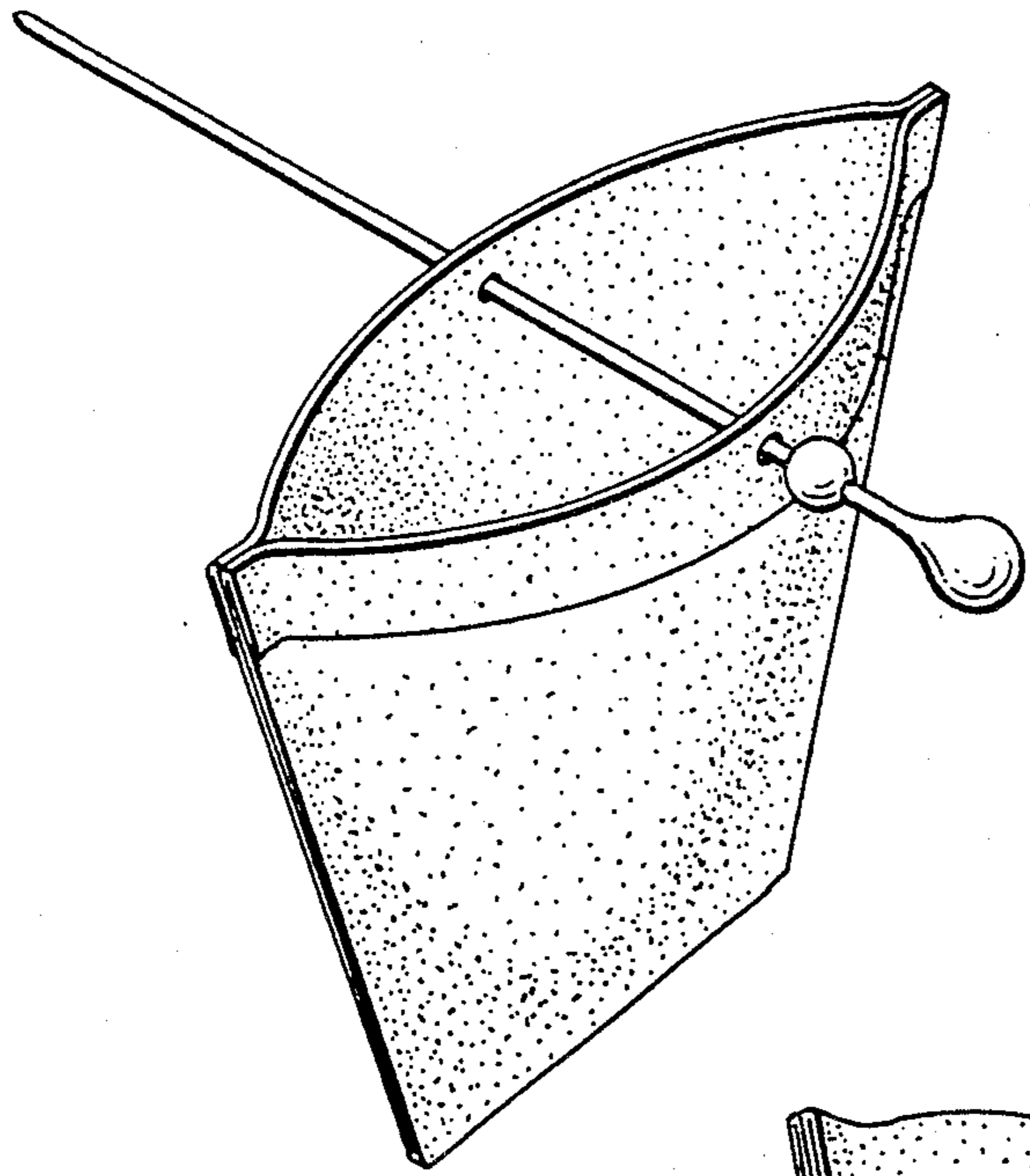

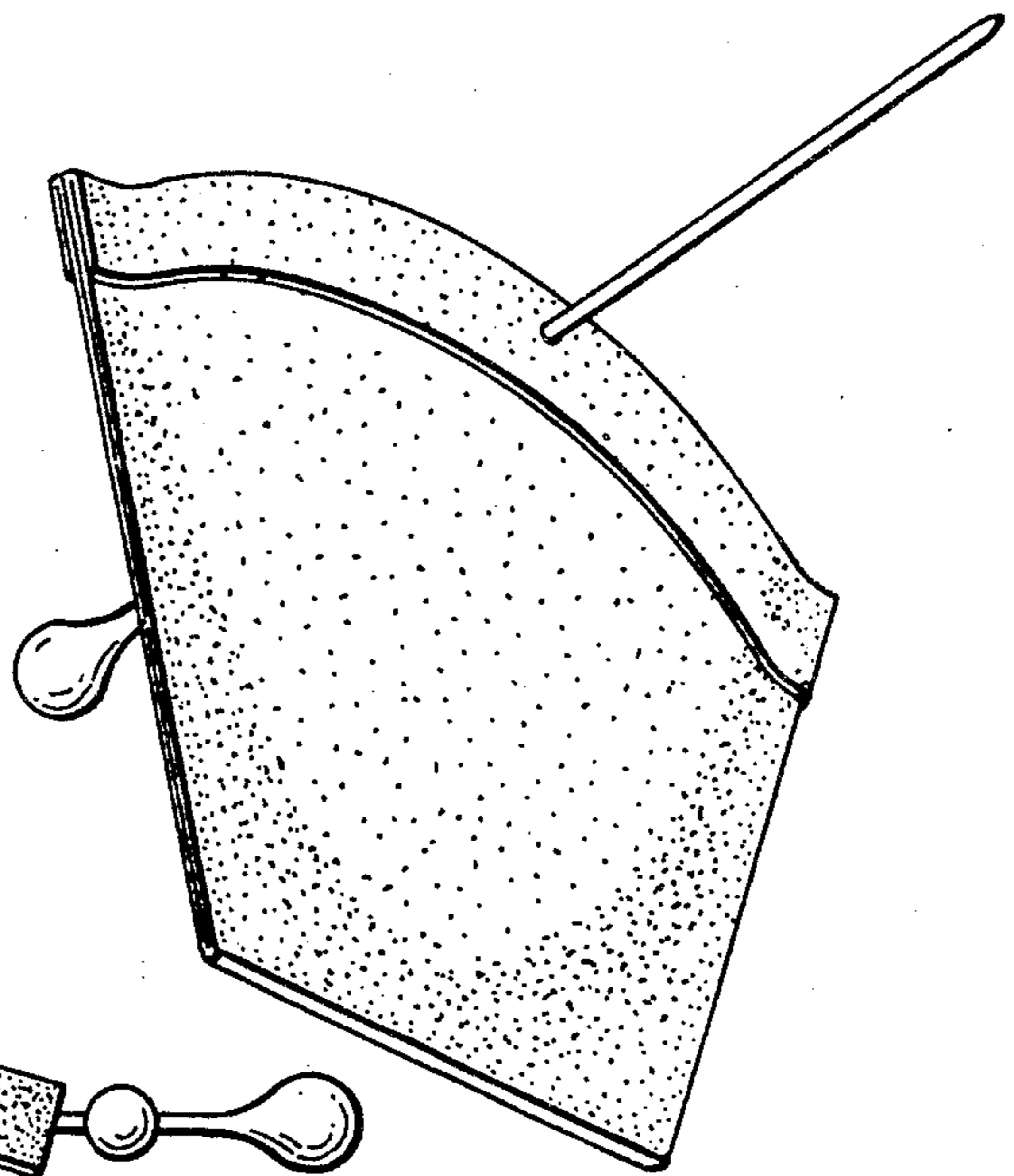

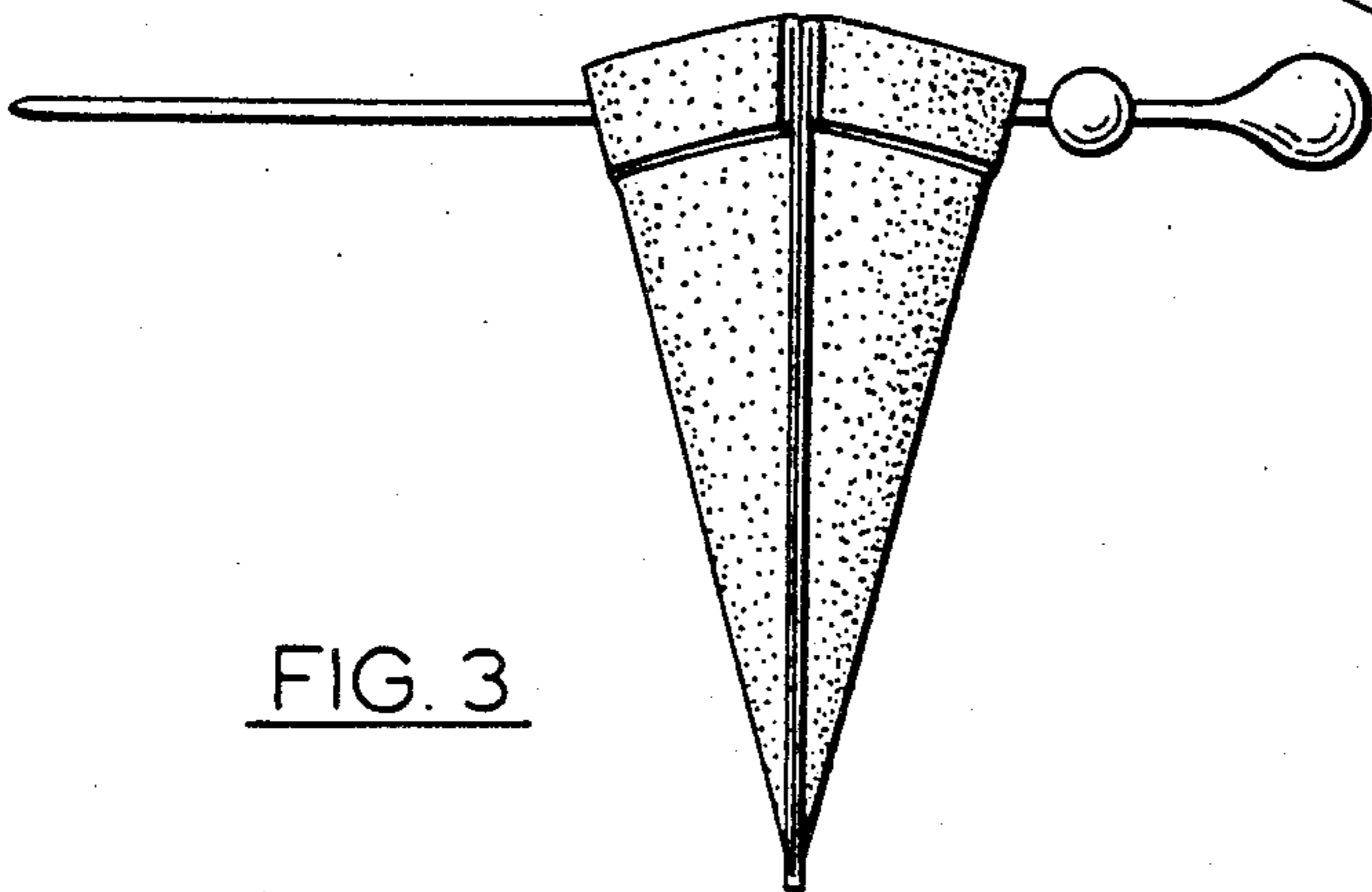
