The ornamental design for a watchband, substantially as shown and described.

DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a top perspective view of a watchstrap showing our new design;
 FIG. 2 is a bottom perspective view;
 FIG. 3 is a side elevational view, the opposite side being a mirror image;
 FIG. 4 is an end elevational view taken on line 4—4 of FIG. 3; and
 FIG. 5 is a sectional view taken on line 5—5 of FIG. 3. The broken line showing of a watch in FIG. 1 is for illustrative purposes only and forms no part of the claimed design.

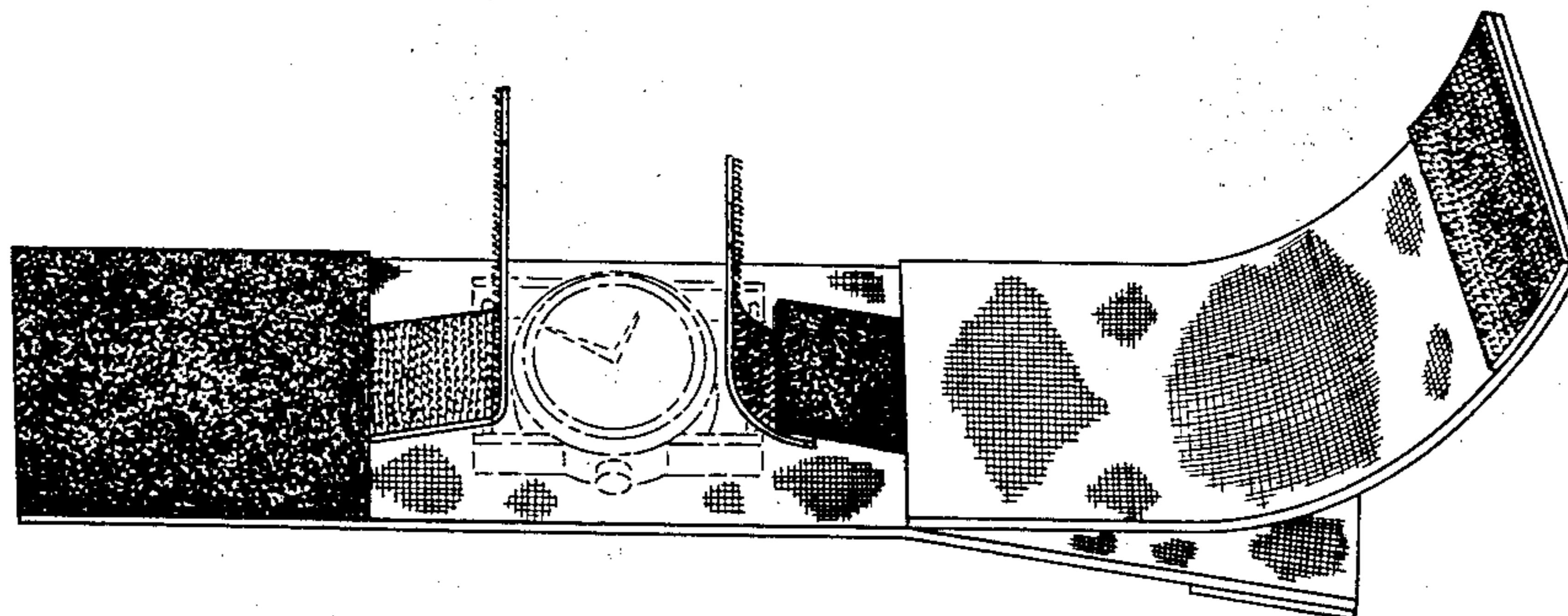

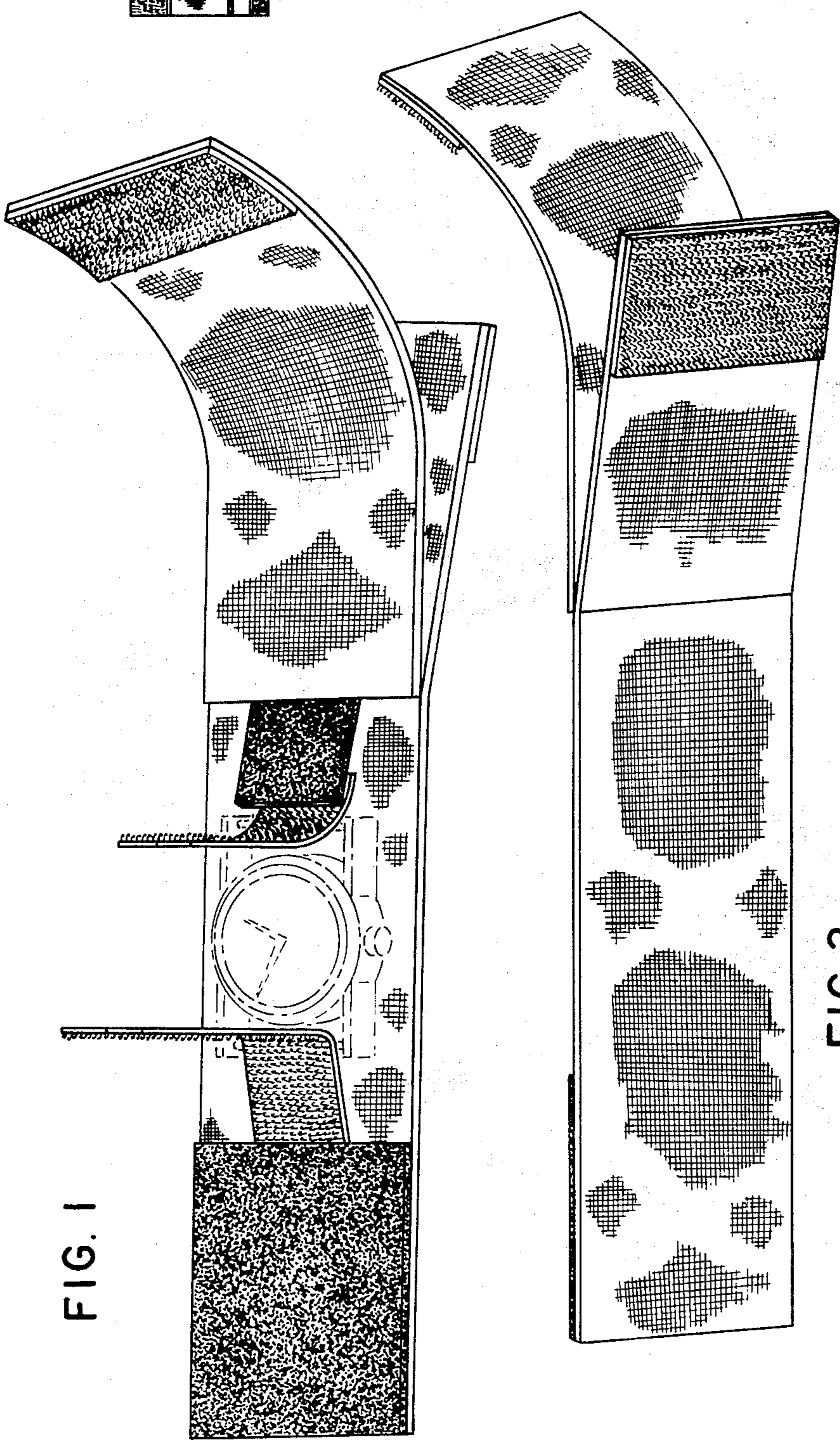

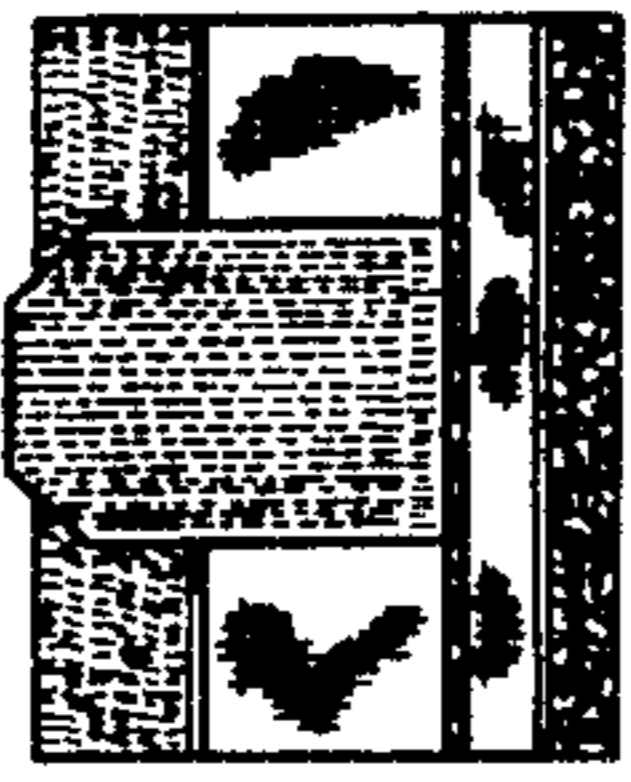

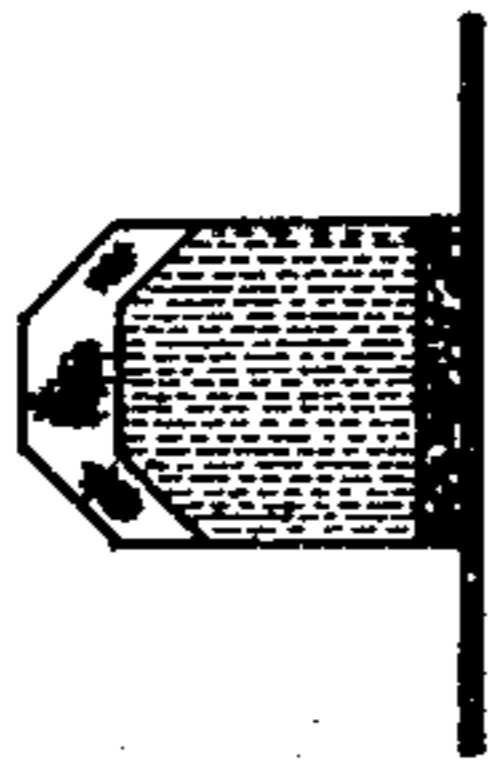

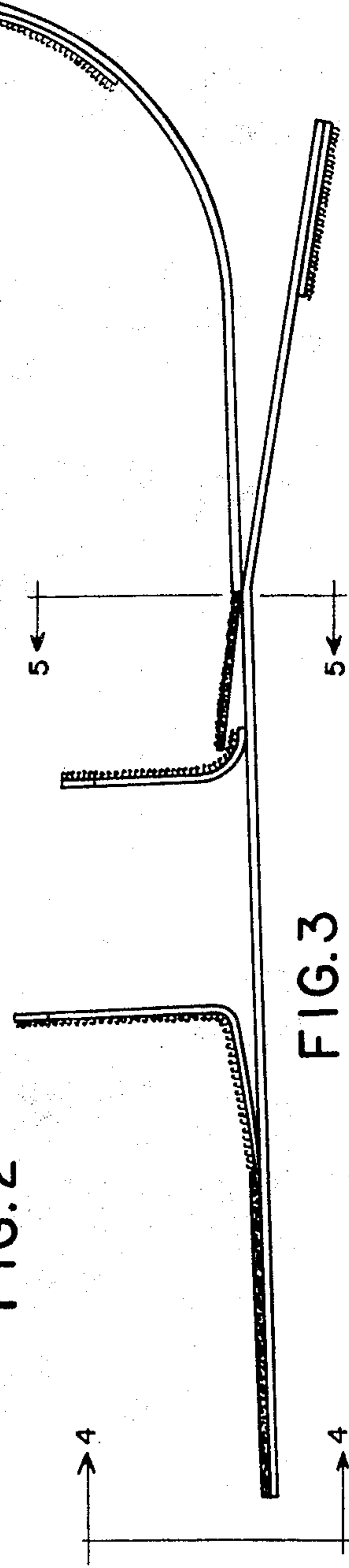
