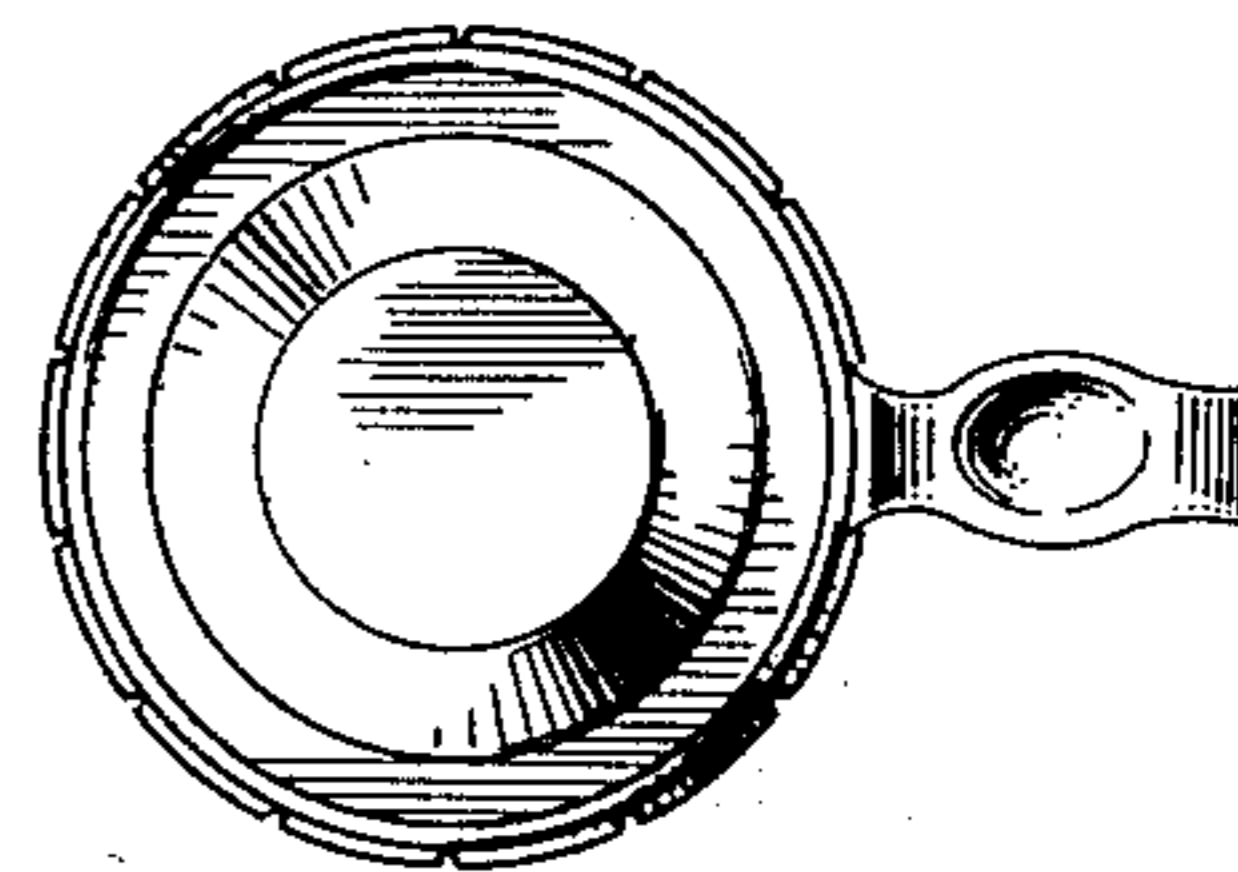
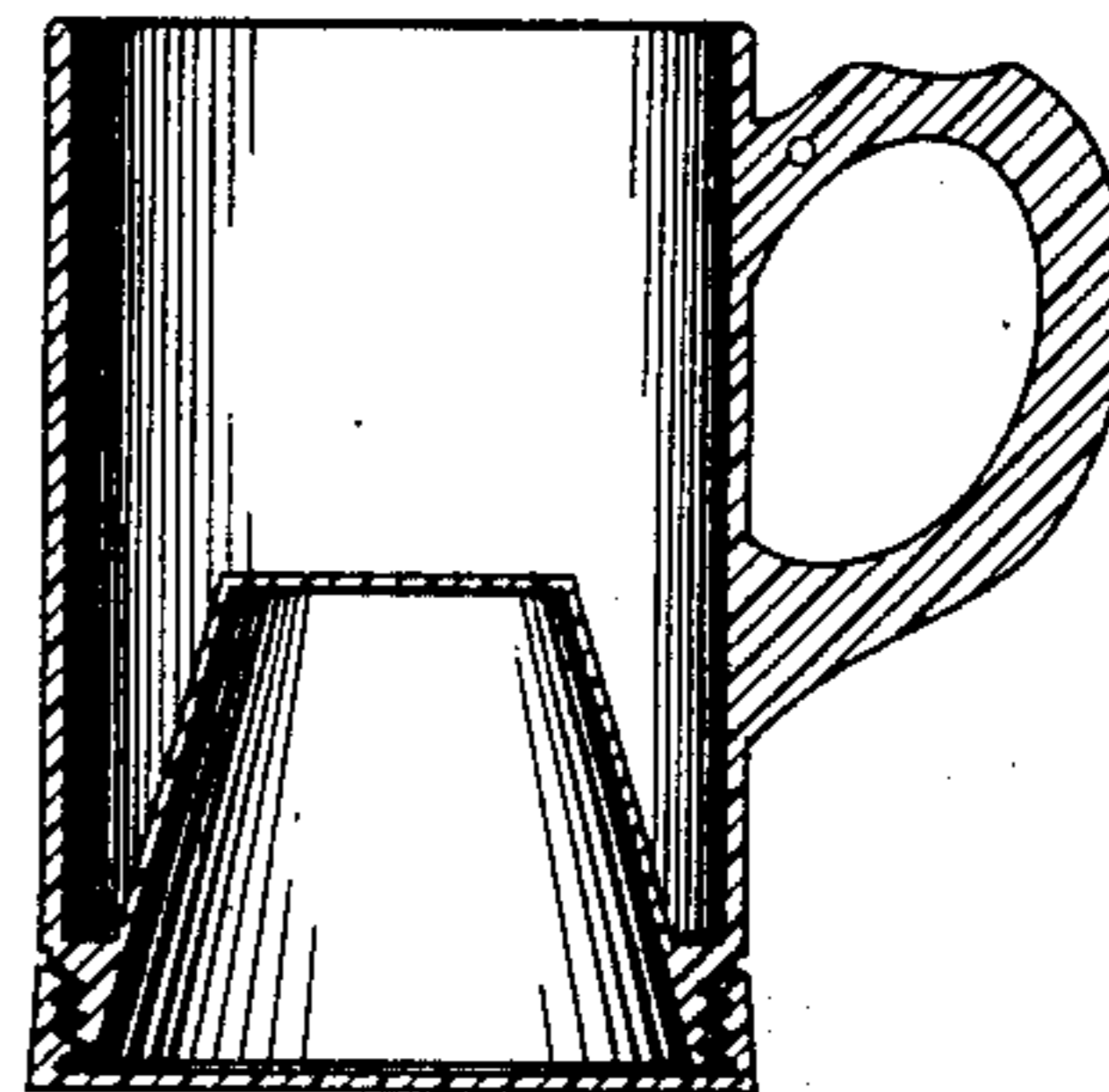
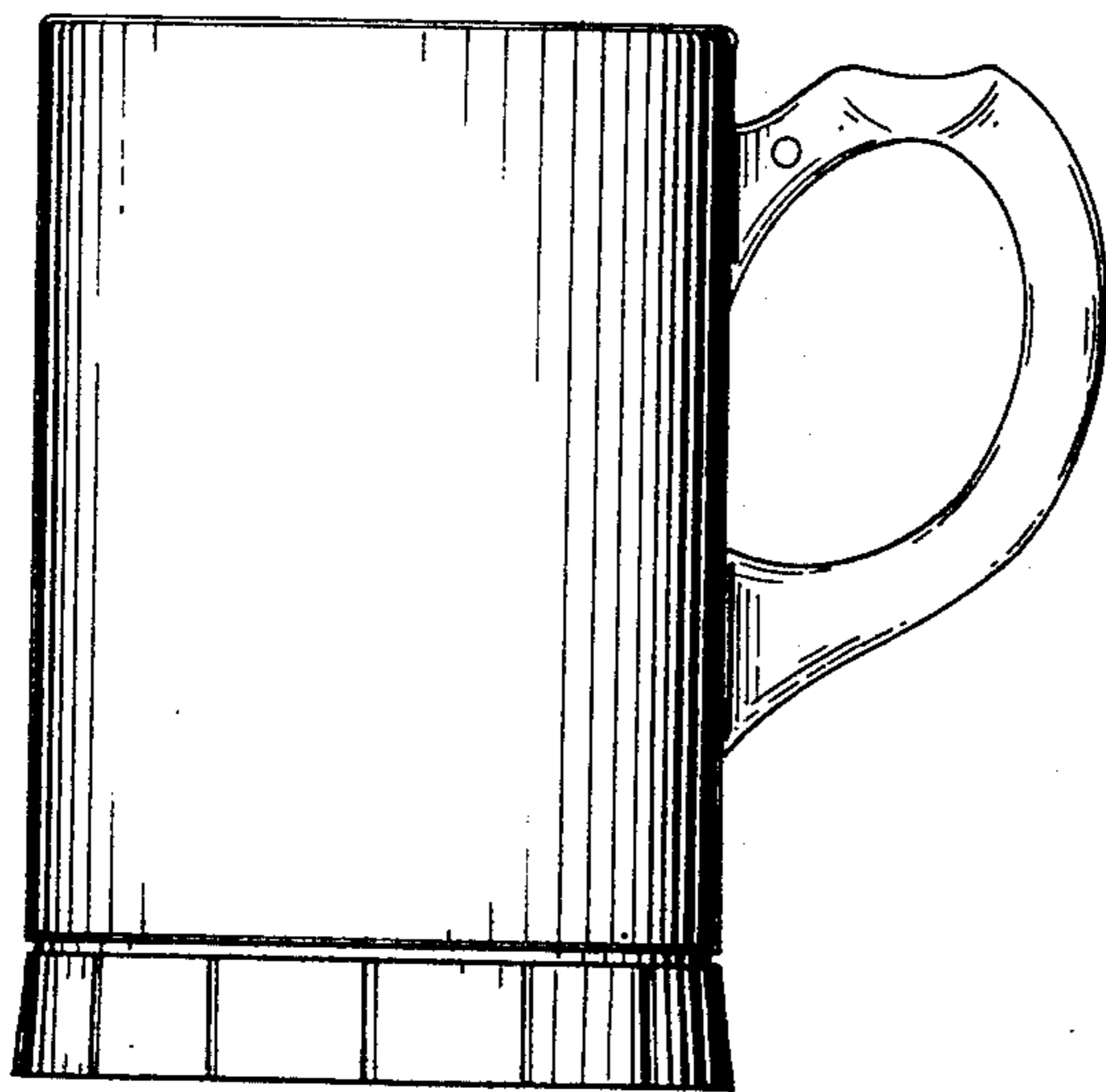

DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a top perspective view of a beverage mug showing my new design;
 FIG. 2 is a side elevational view thereof, the side opposite being a mirror image;
 FIG. 3 is a rear elevational view thereof;
 FIG. 4 is a sectional view thereof taken generally along line 4—4 of FIG. 3;
 FIG. 5 is a front elevational view thereof;
 FIG. 6 is a top plan view thereof; and,
 FIG. 7 is a bottom plan view thereof.



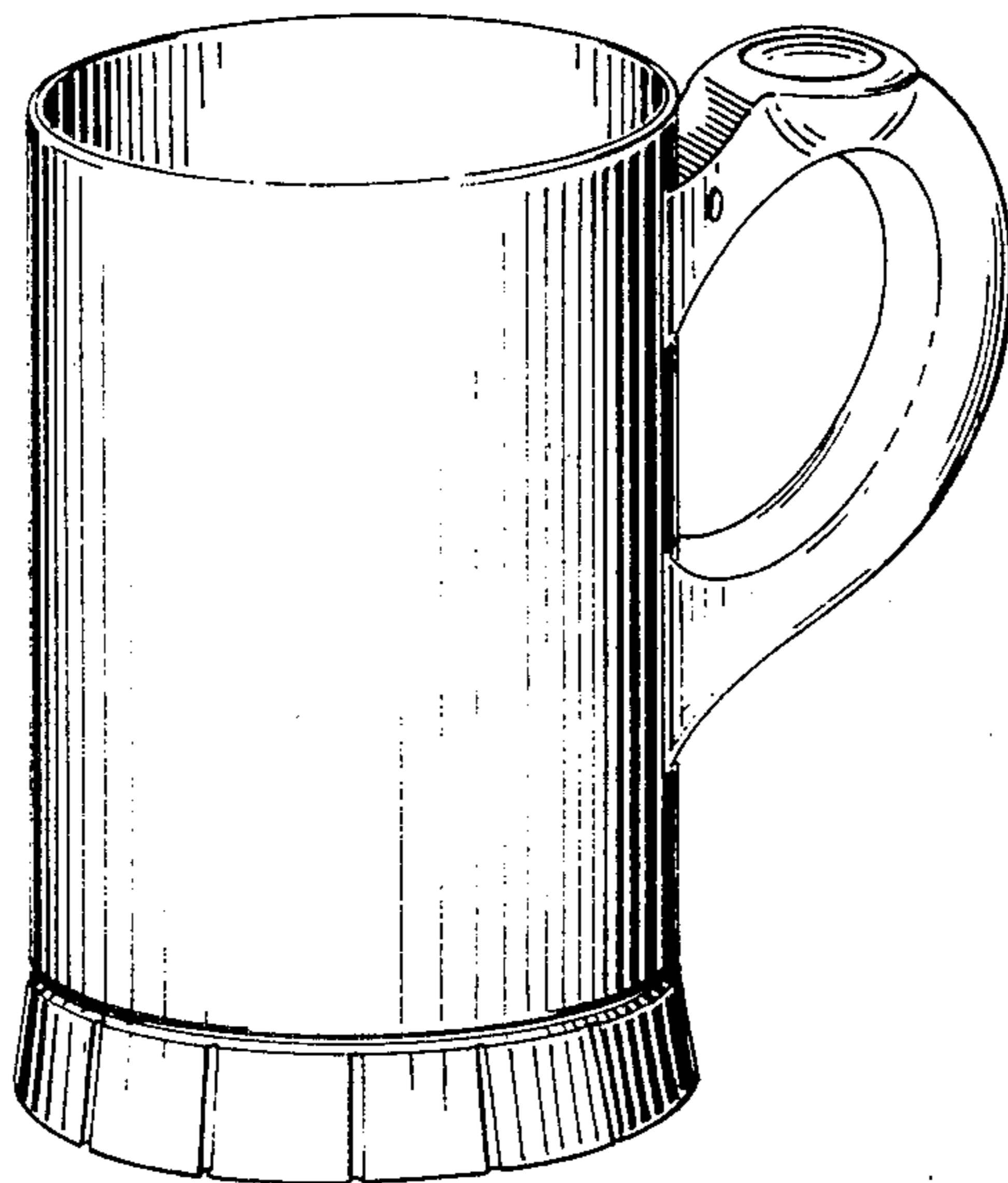

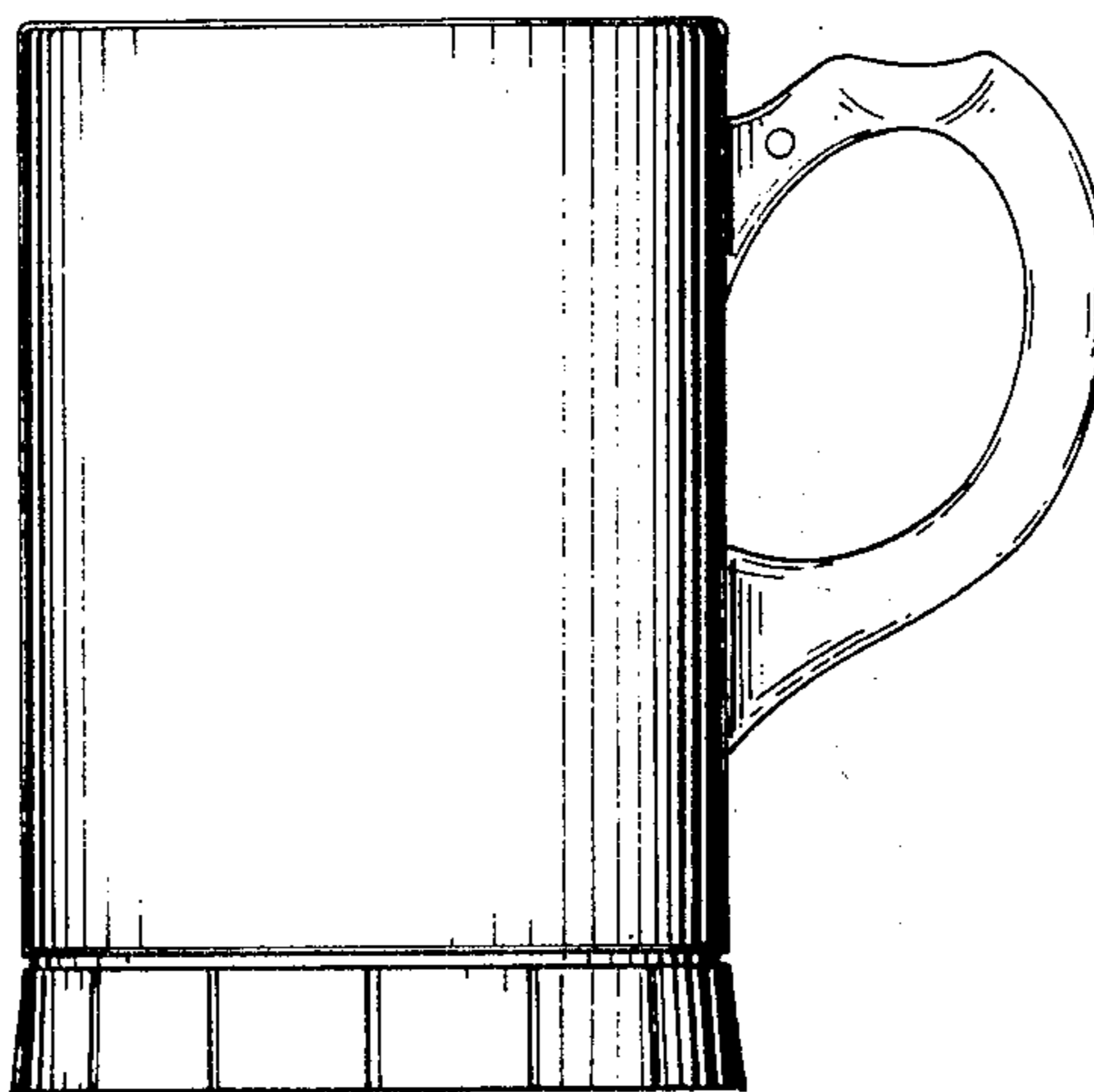
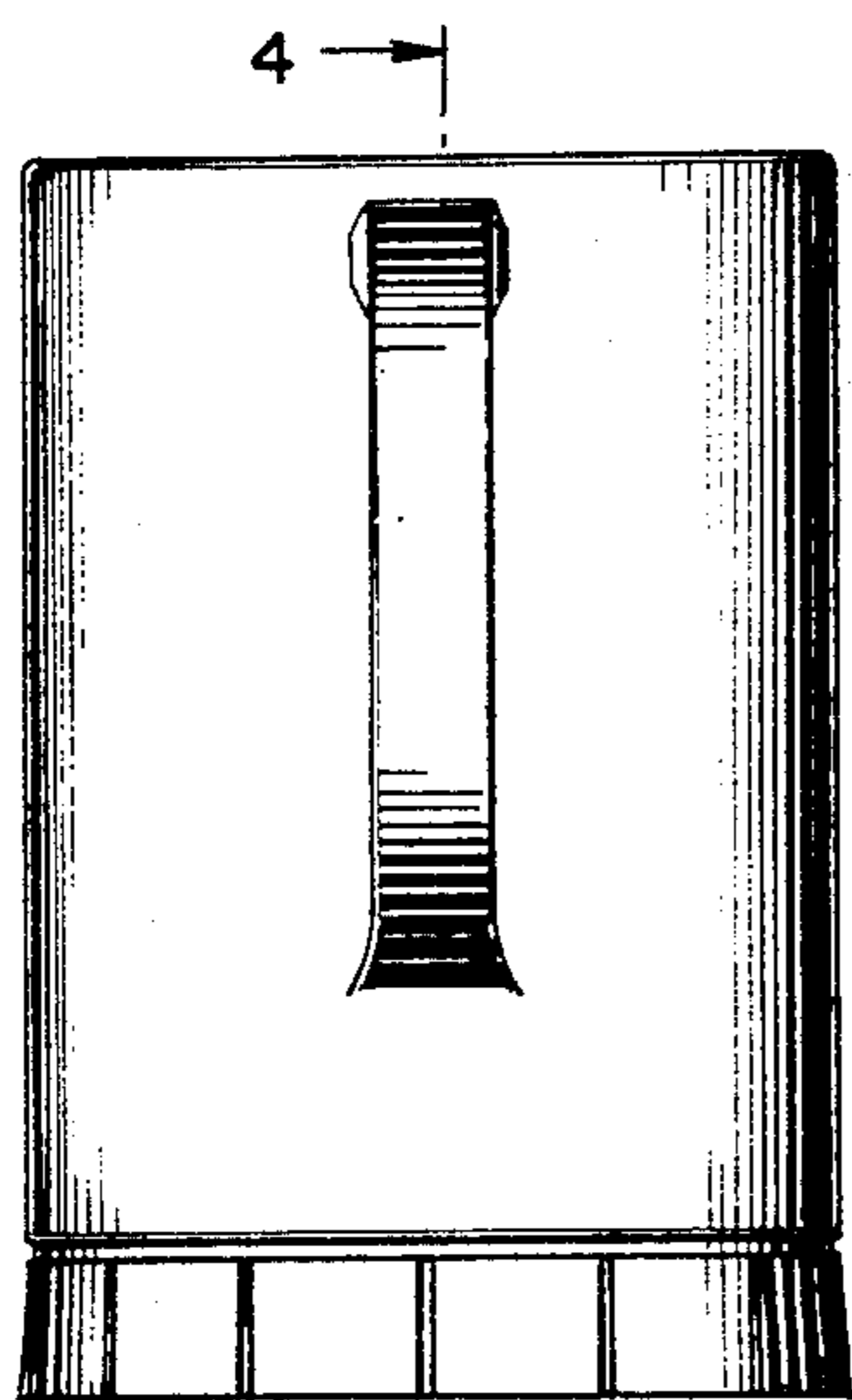

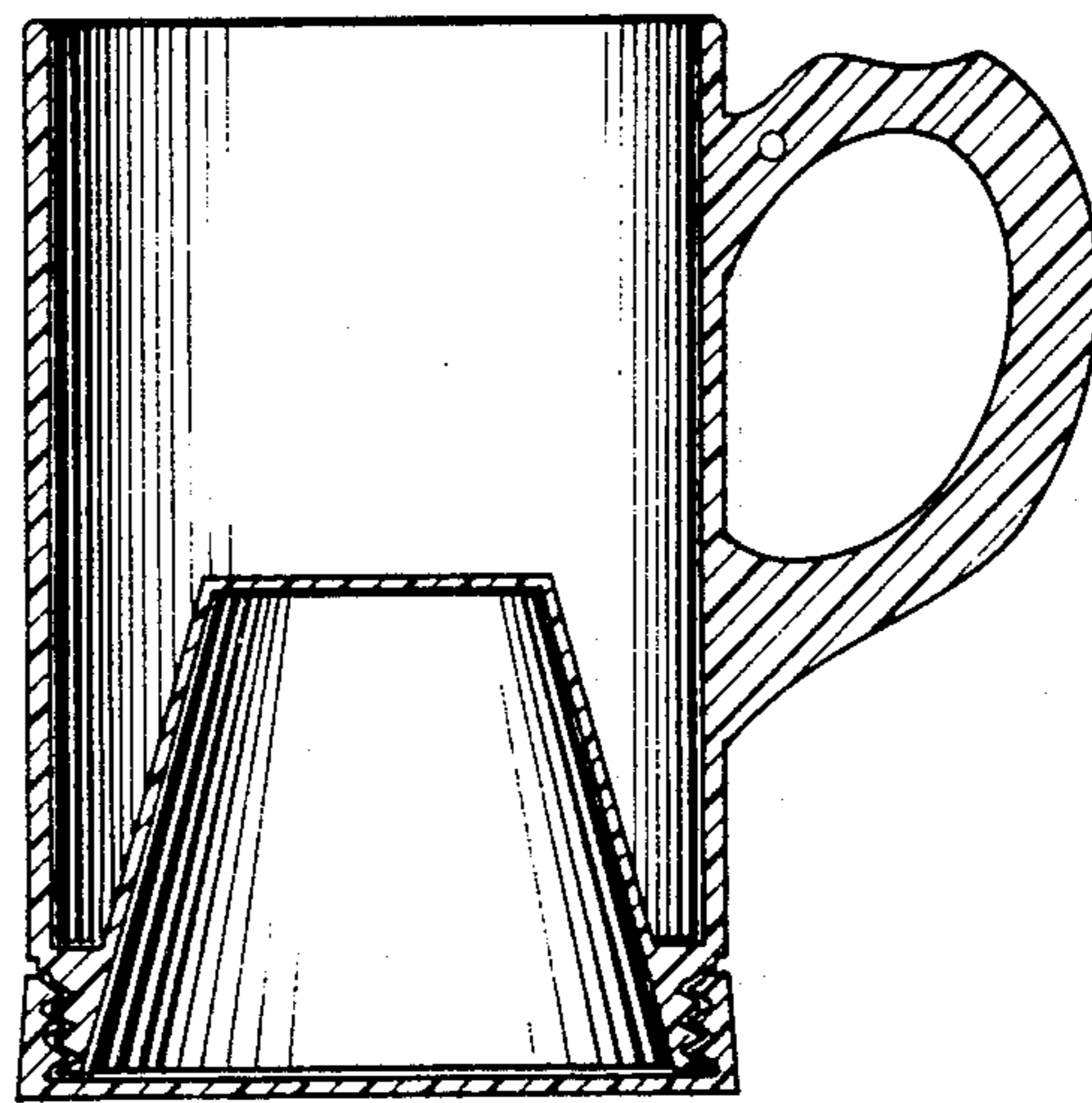

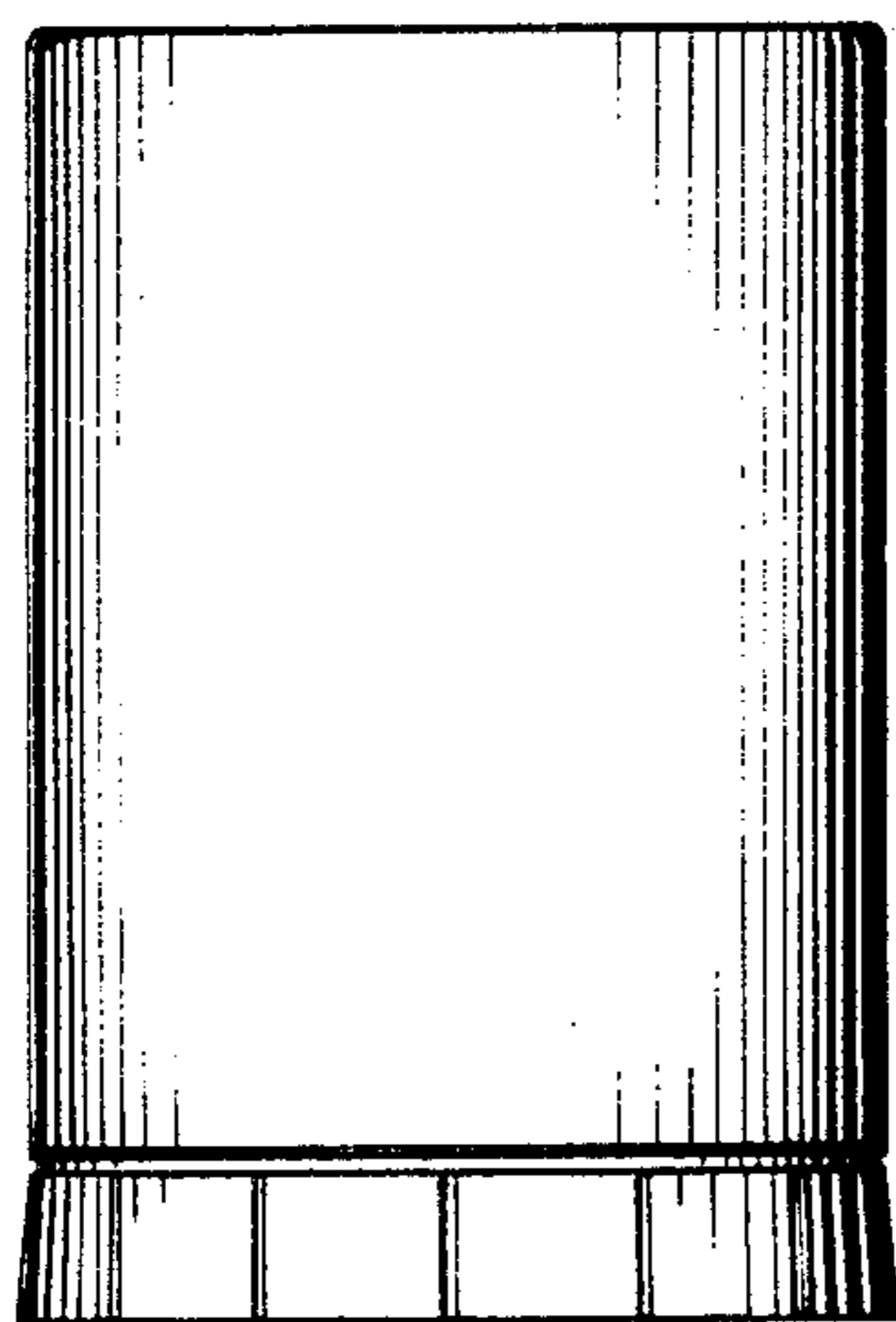

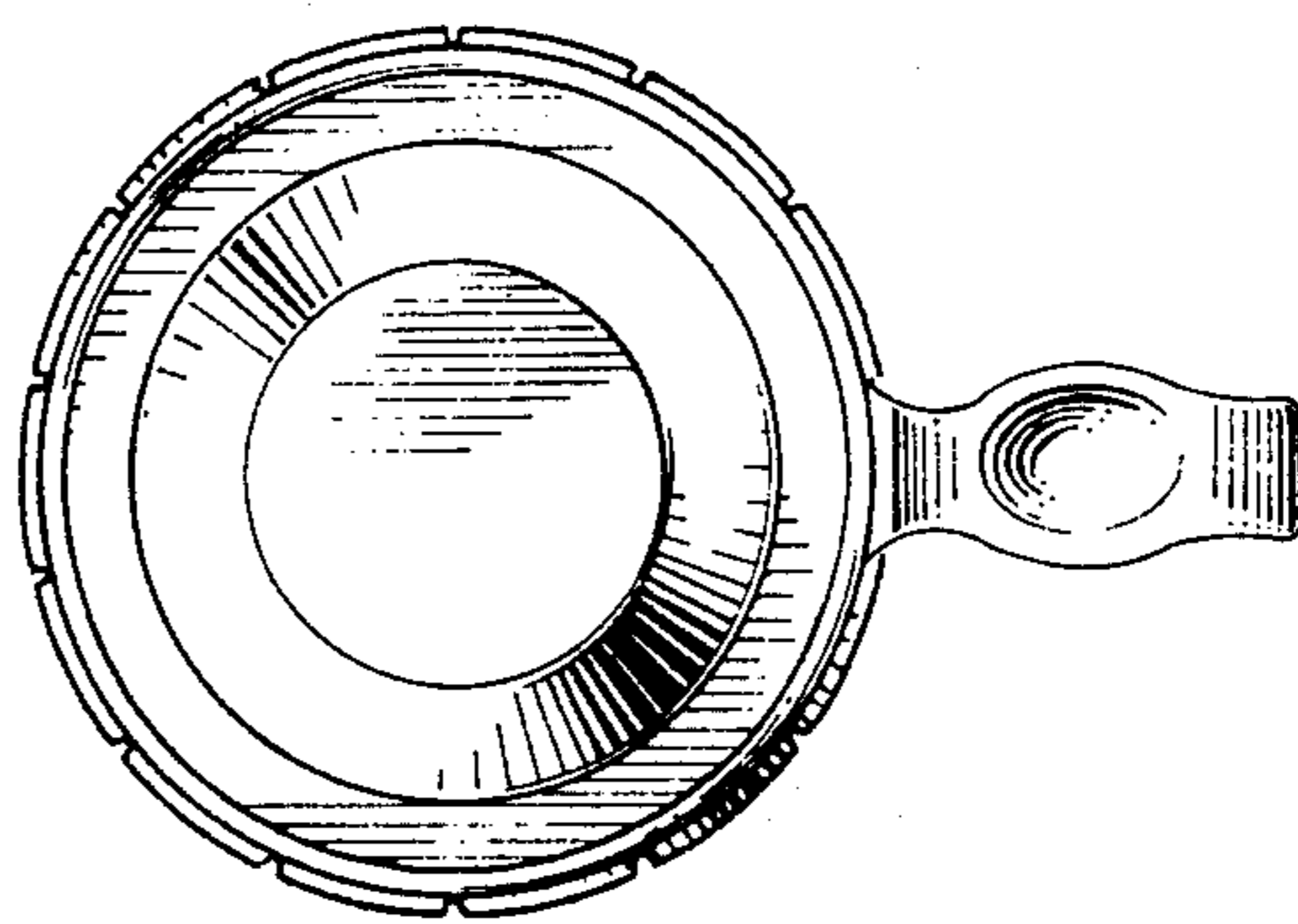

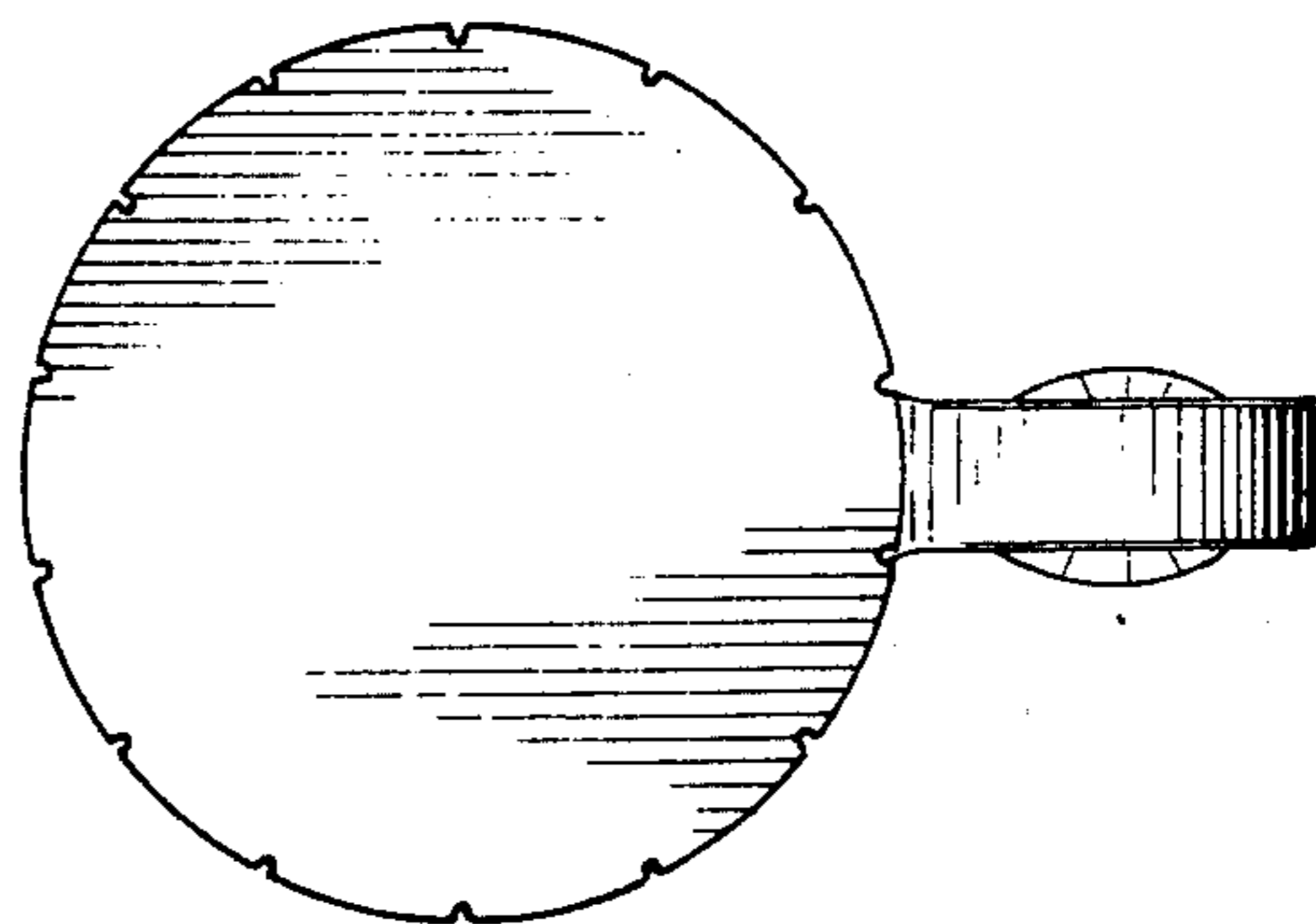
