FIG. 4 is a side elevational view thereof, as viewed from the left of FIG. 3;

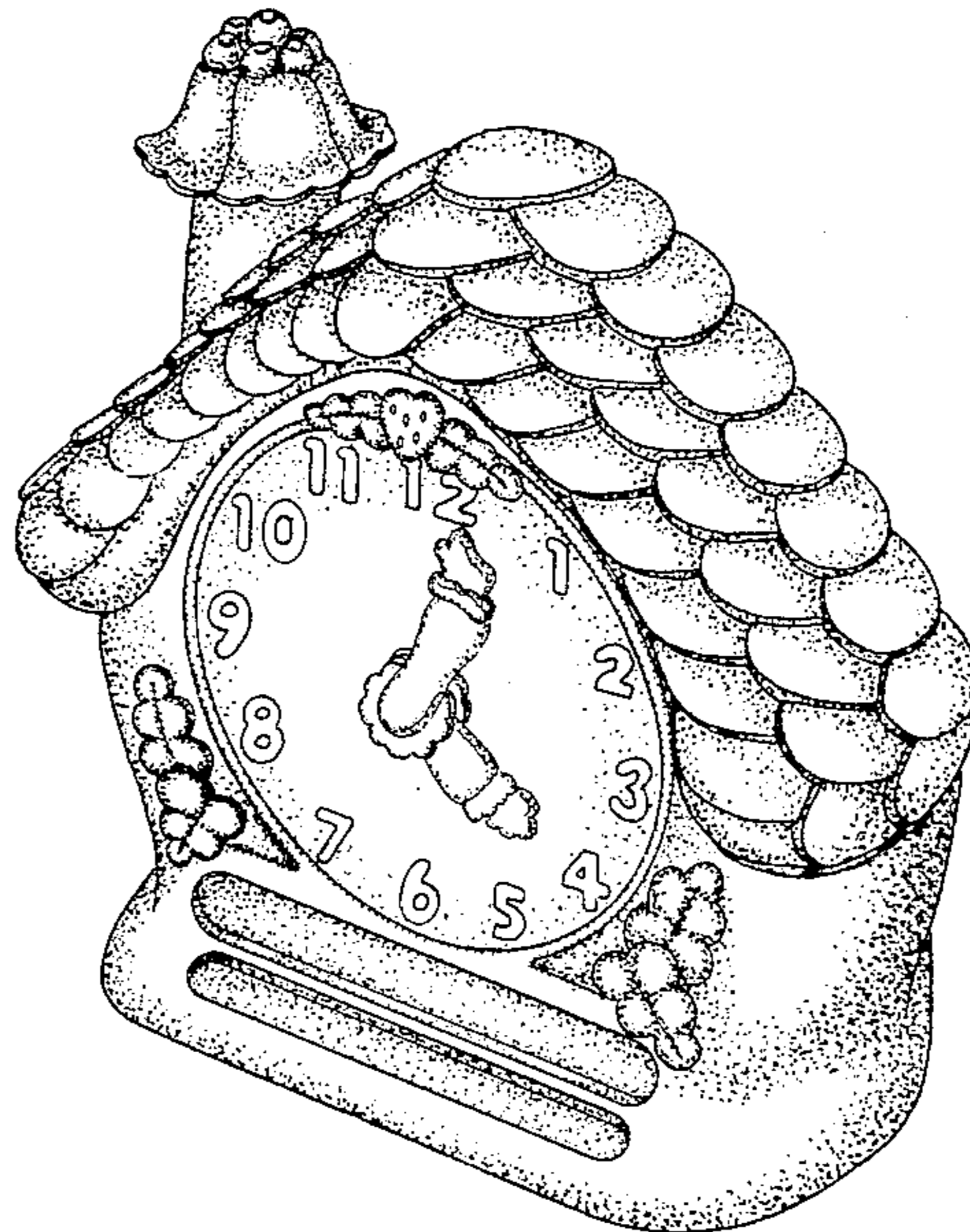
FIG. 5 is a side elevational view thereof, as viewed from the right of FIG. 3; and

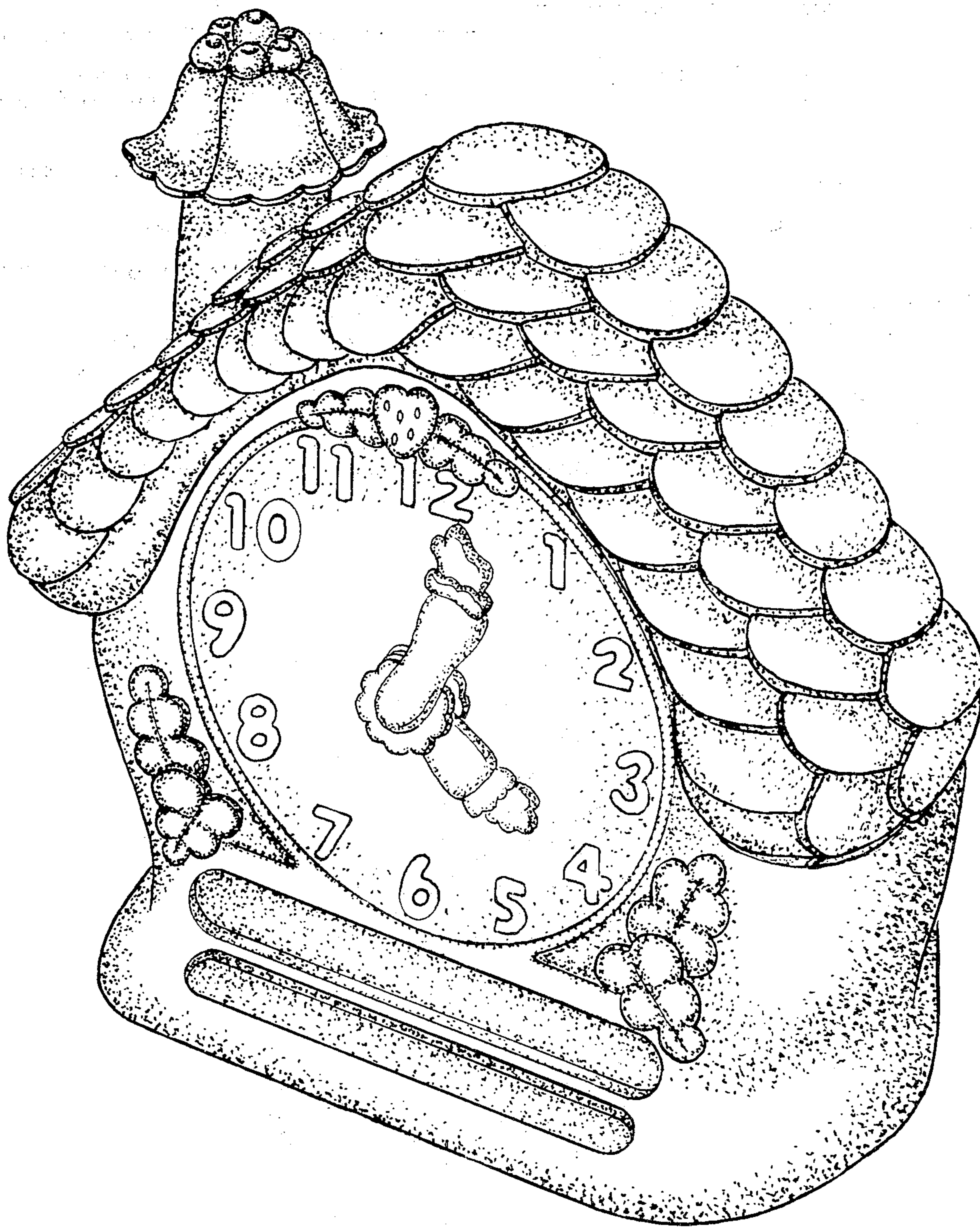

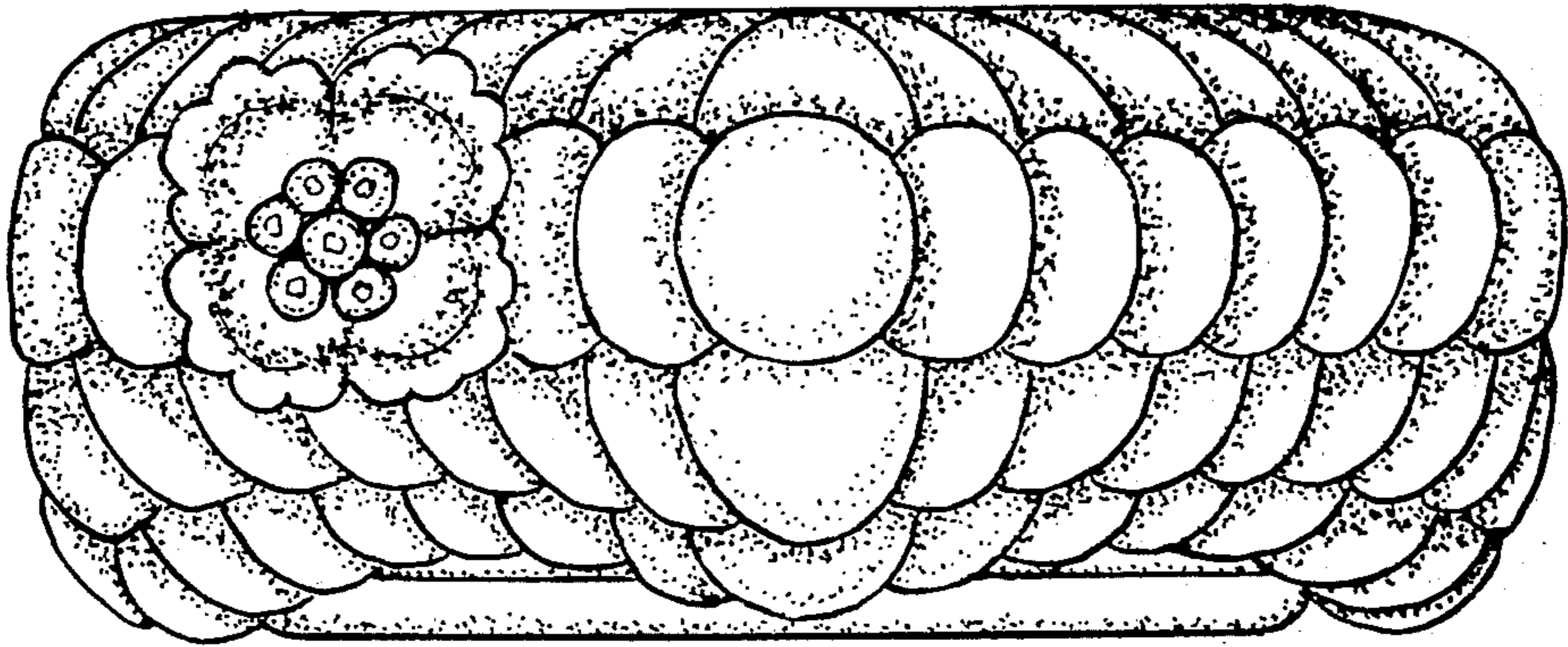

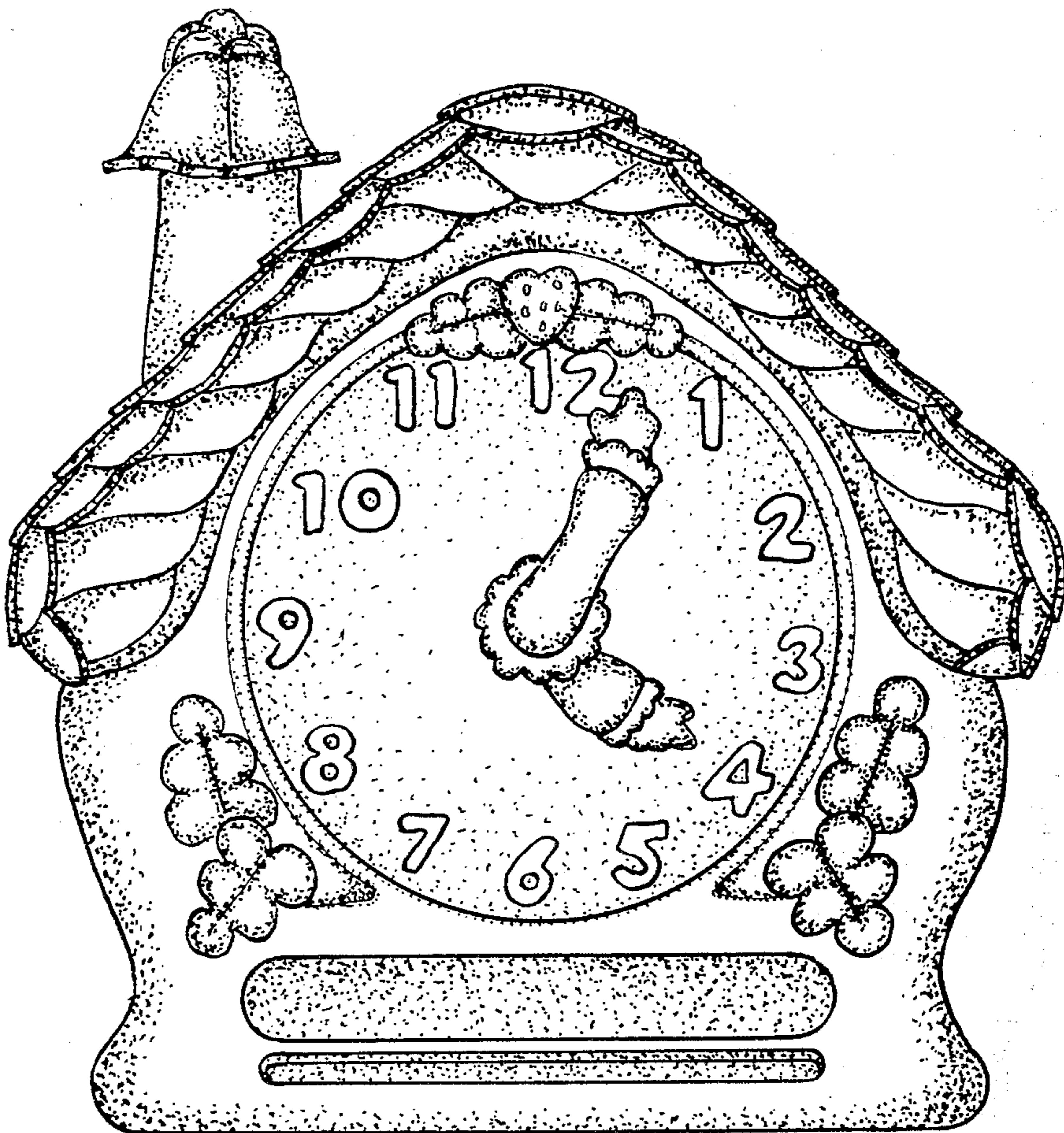

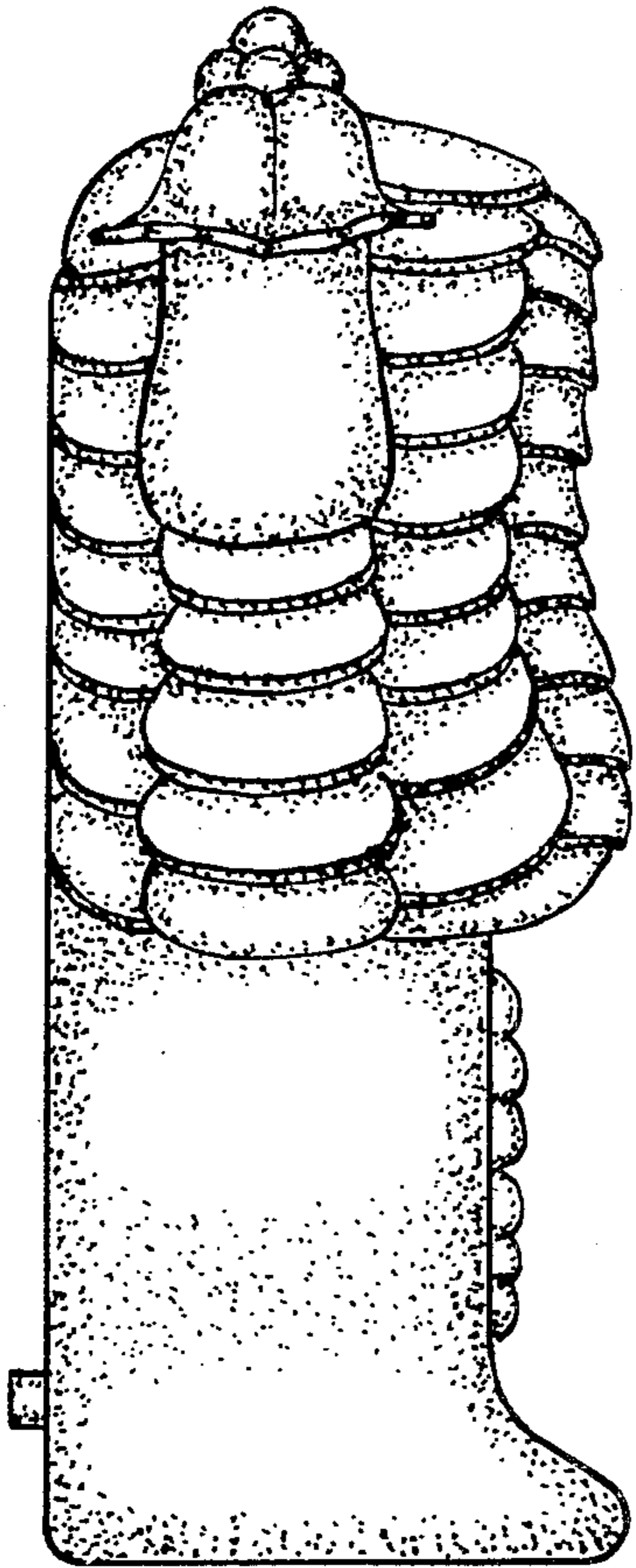

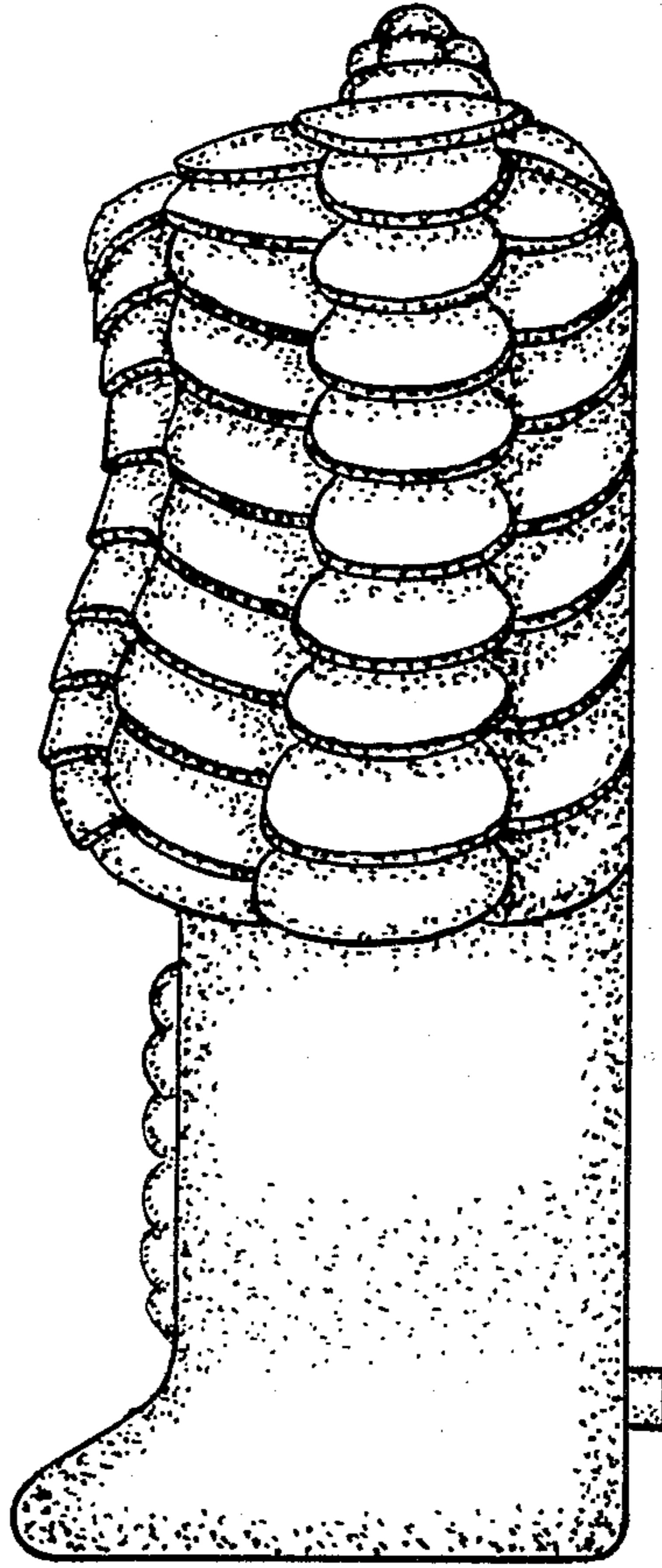

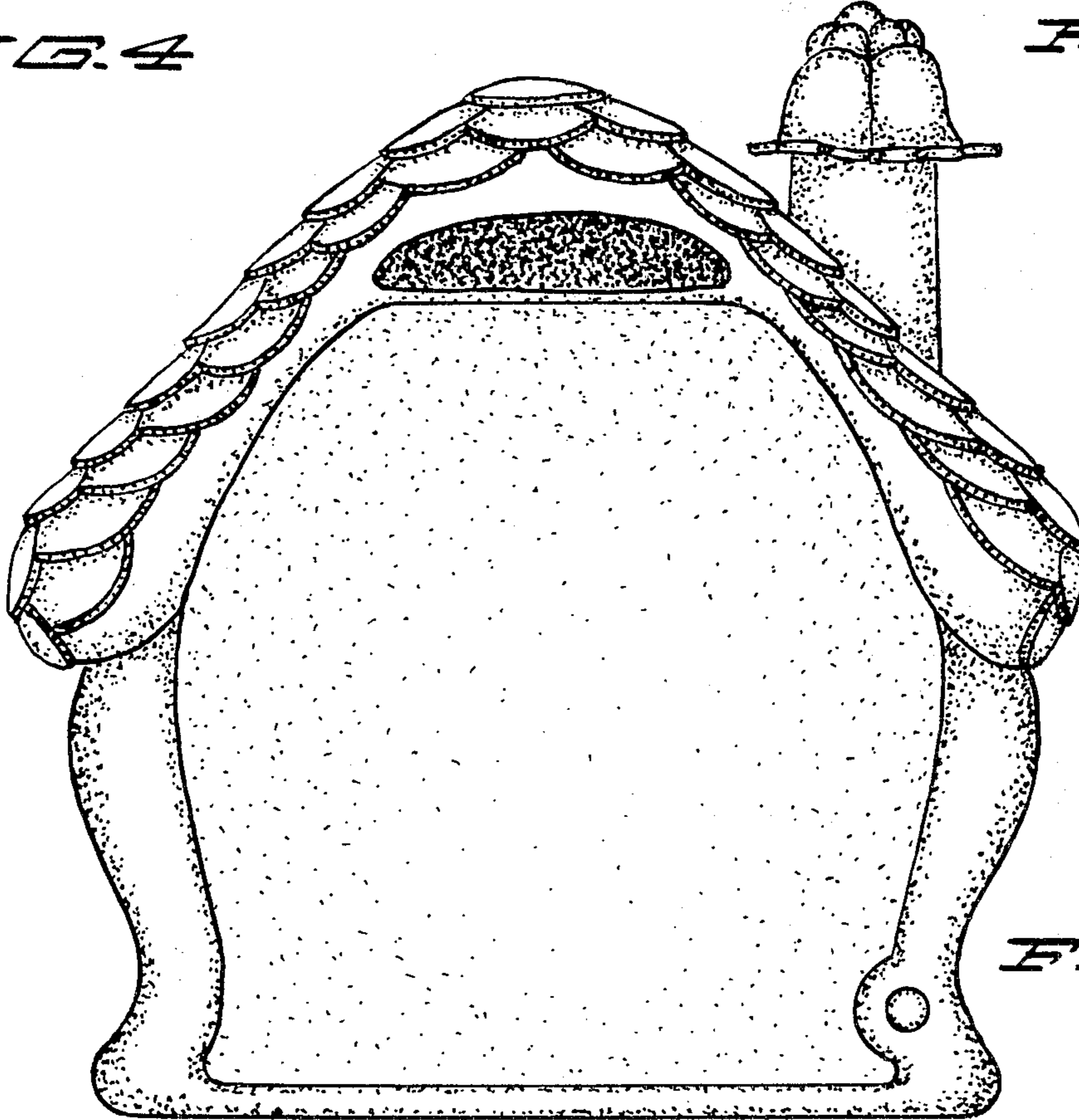
