FIG. 1 is a perspective view of a hip abduction pillow, embodying my present invention;


FIG. 2 is a top plan view thereof;


FIG. 3 is a front elevational view thereof;

FIG. 4 is a right side elevational view thereof (left side being a mirror image);


FIG. 5 is a rear elevational view thereof; and

FIG. 6 is a bottom plan view thereof.






