FIG. 3 is a left end elevational view, the right end being a mirror image thereof.

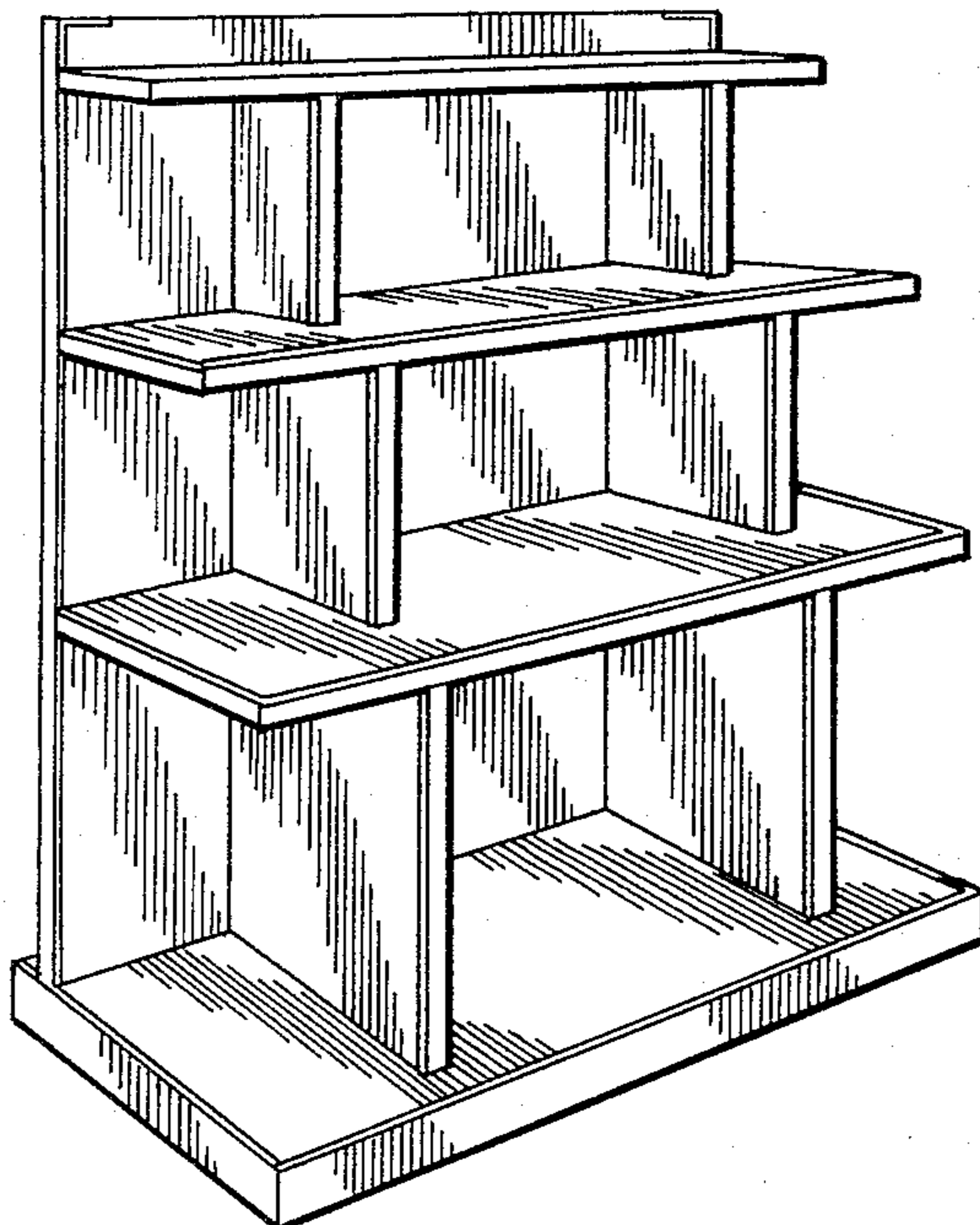
FIG. 4 is a top plan view thereof; and

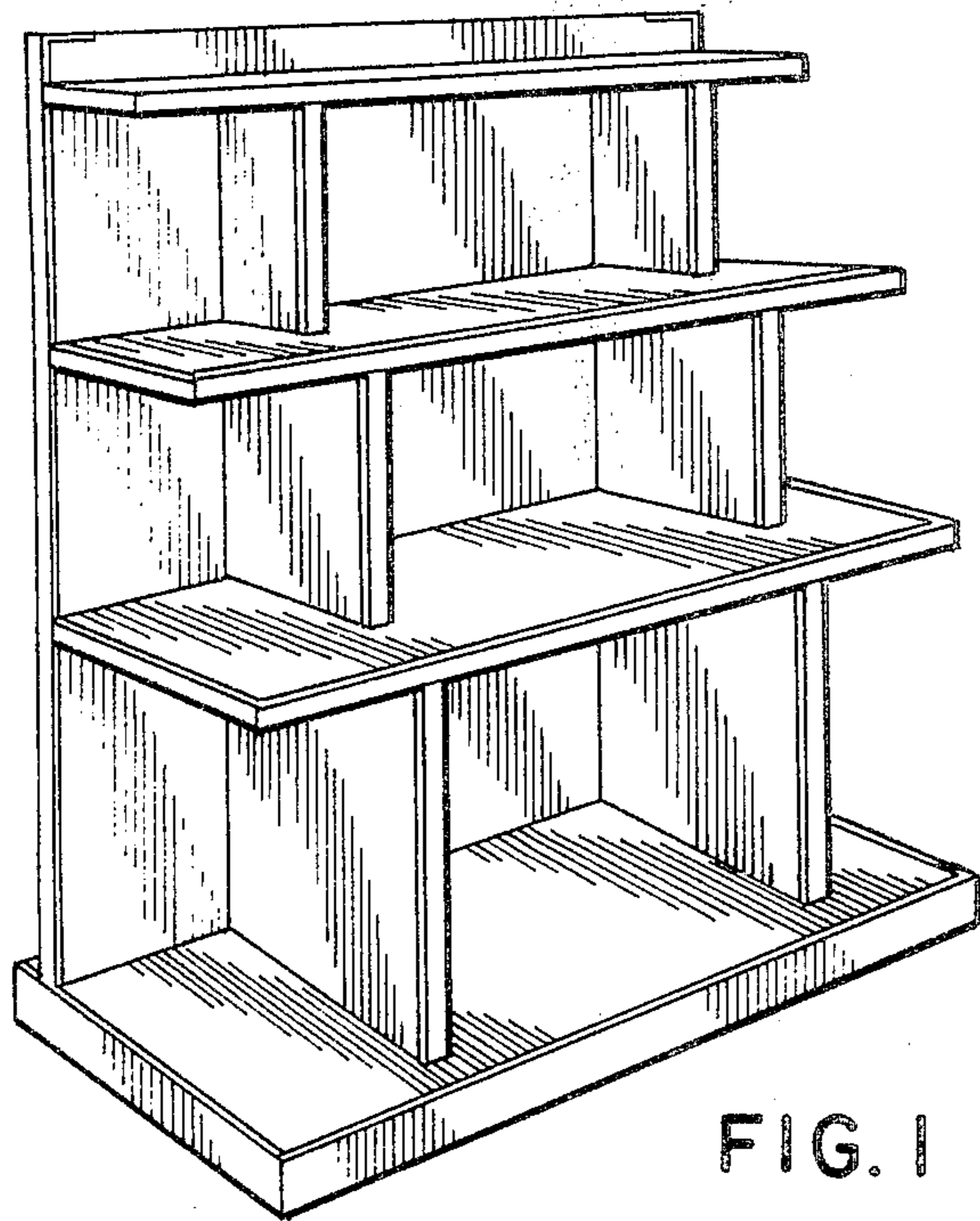

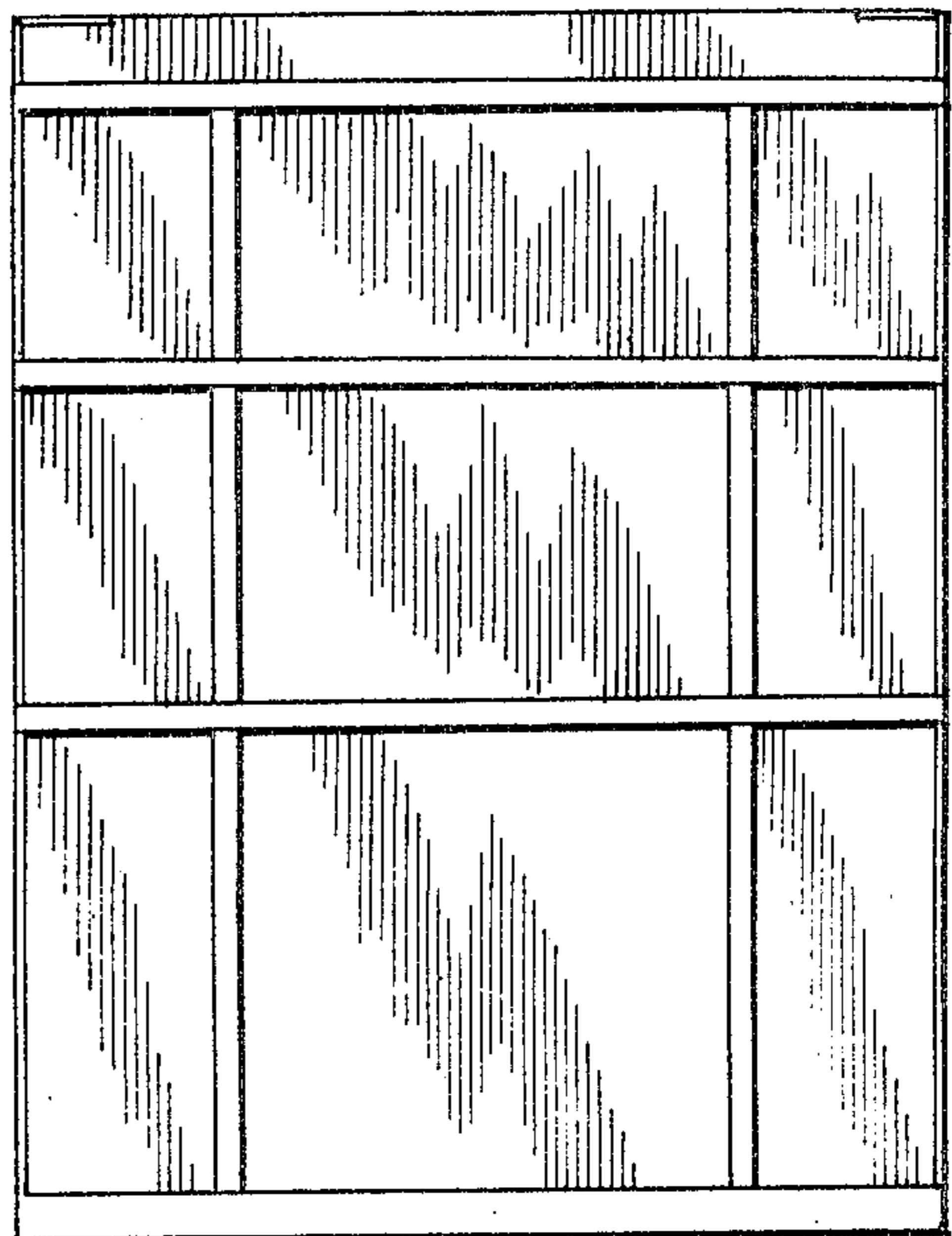

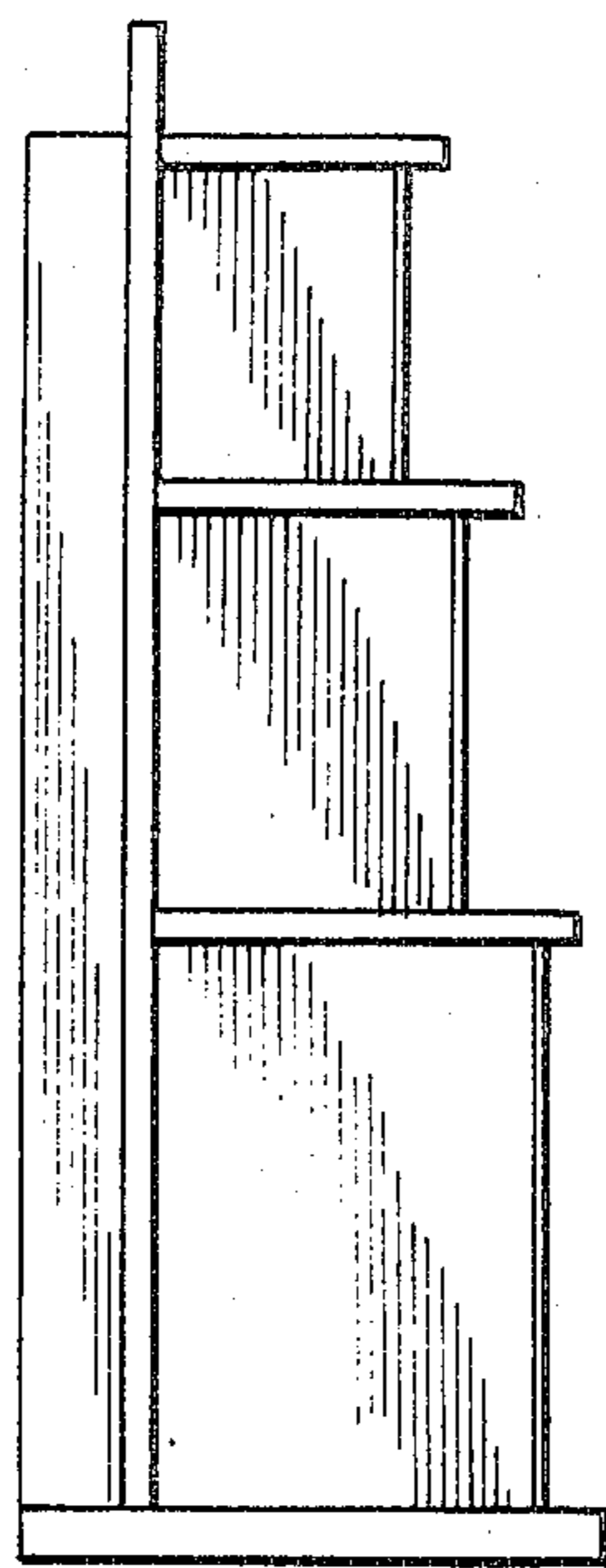

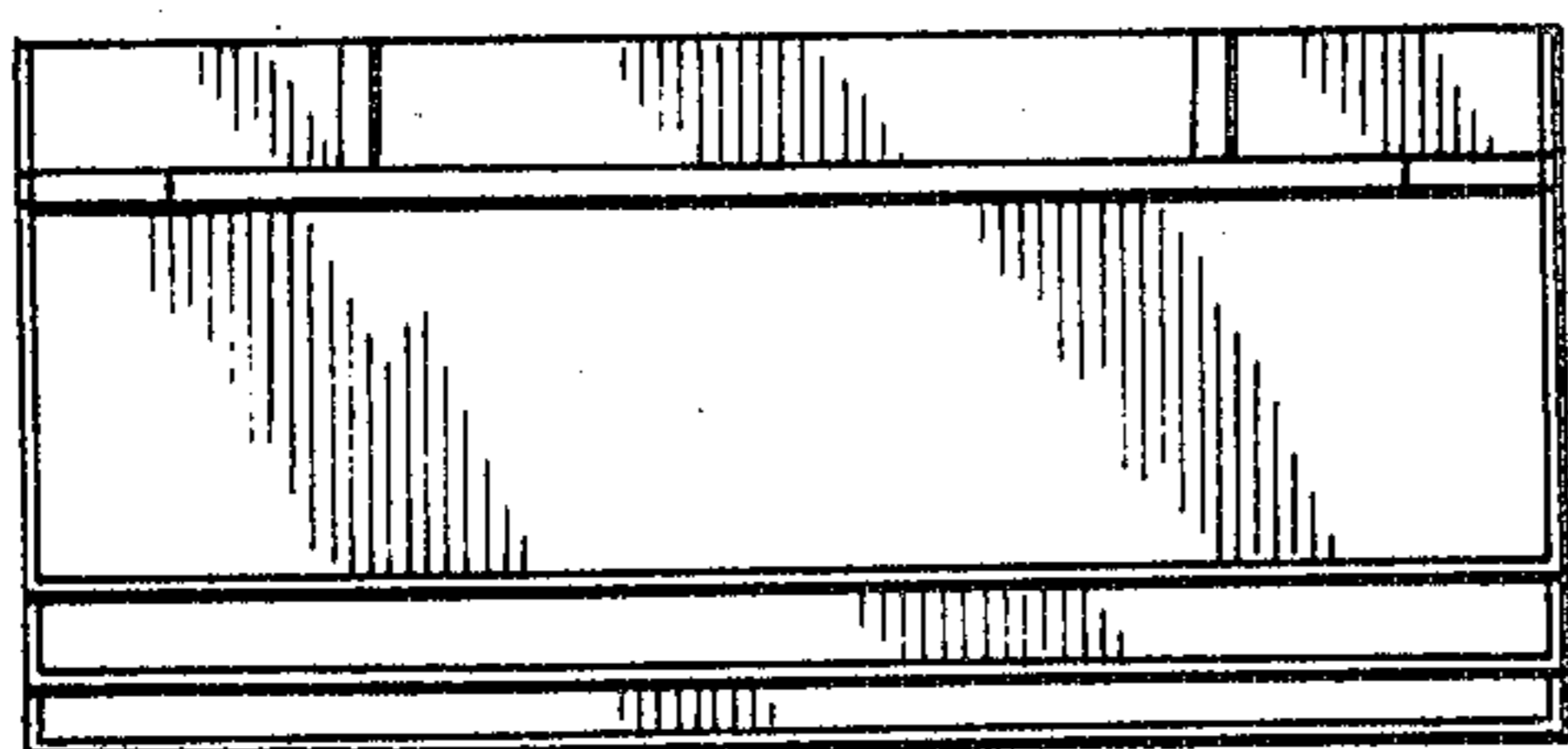

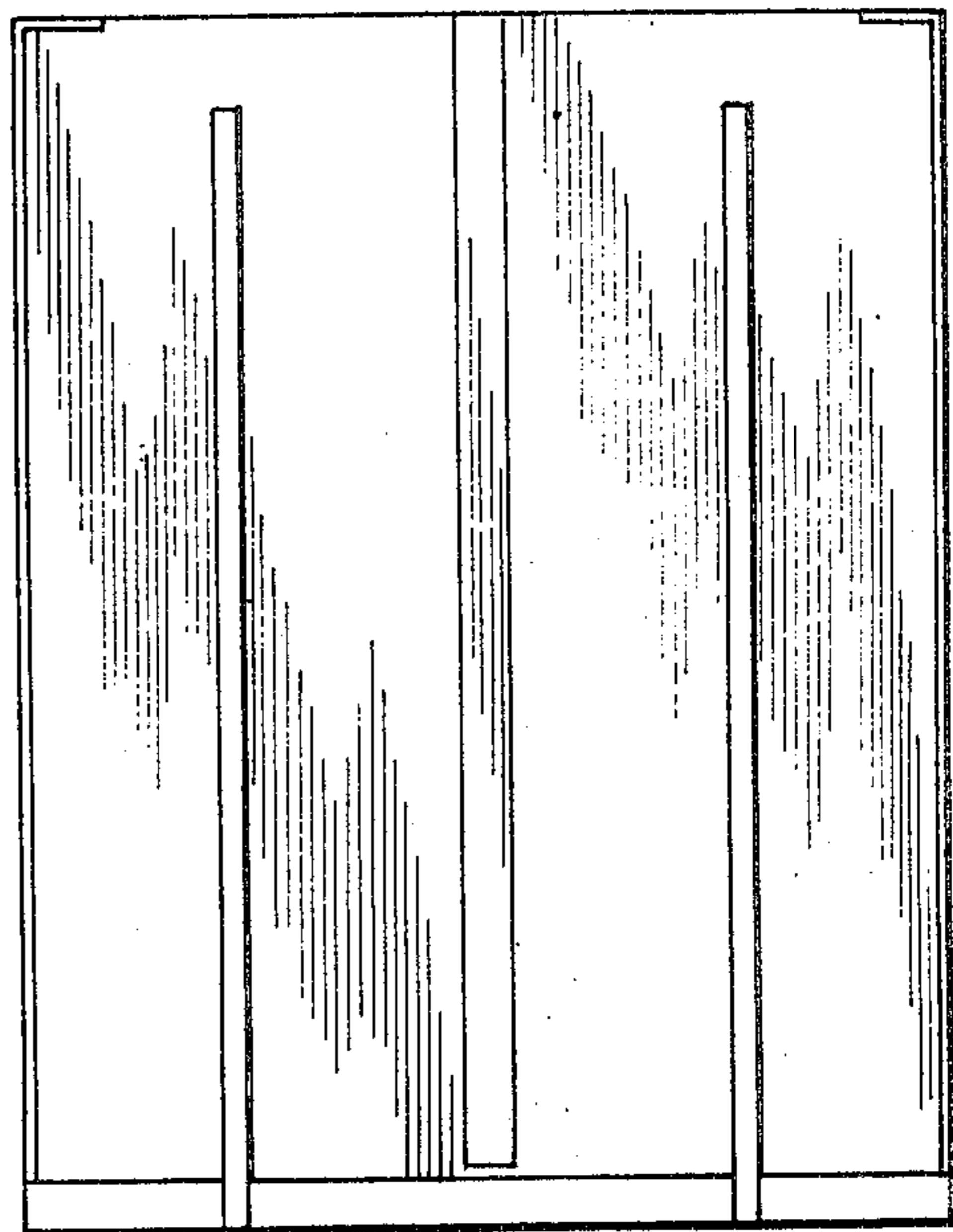
