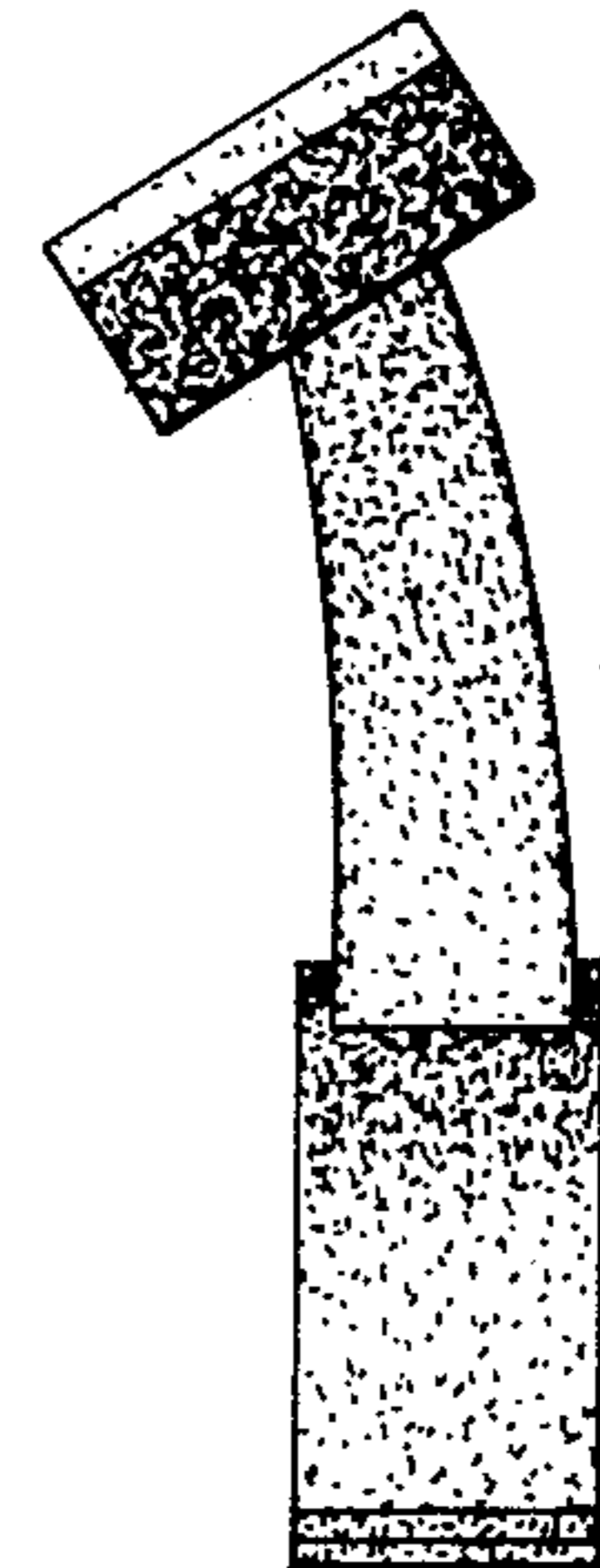
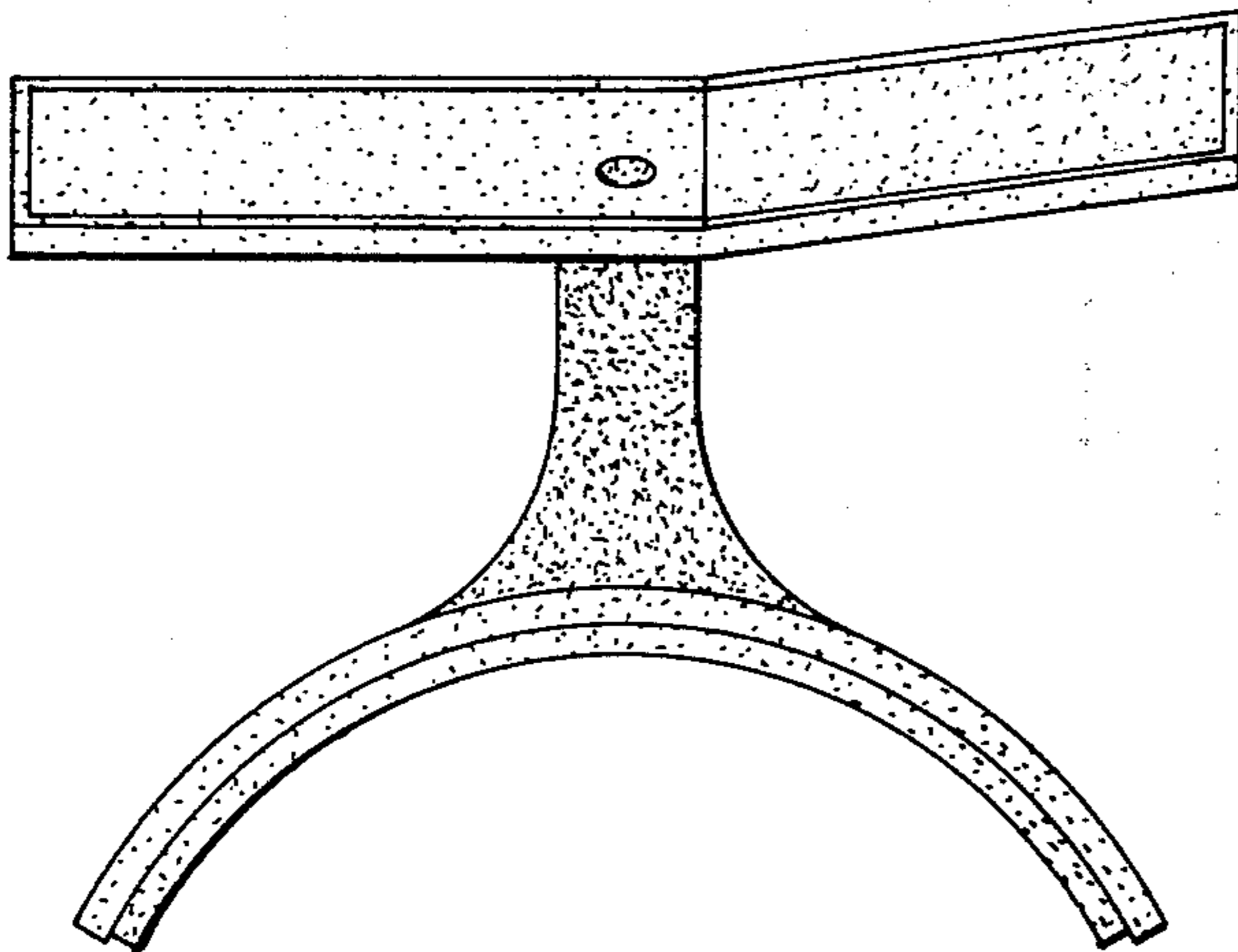

The ornamental design for a telephone handset shoulder rest, as shown and described.

DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a side elevational view of a telephone handset shoulder rest showing my new design.
FIG. 2 is a right hand elevational view.
FIG. 3 is a left hand elevational view.
FIG. 4 is a top plan view.
FIG. 5 is a bottom plan view.
FIG. 6 is a side elevational view as seen from the side opposite that shown in FIG. 1.



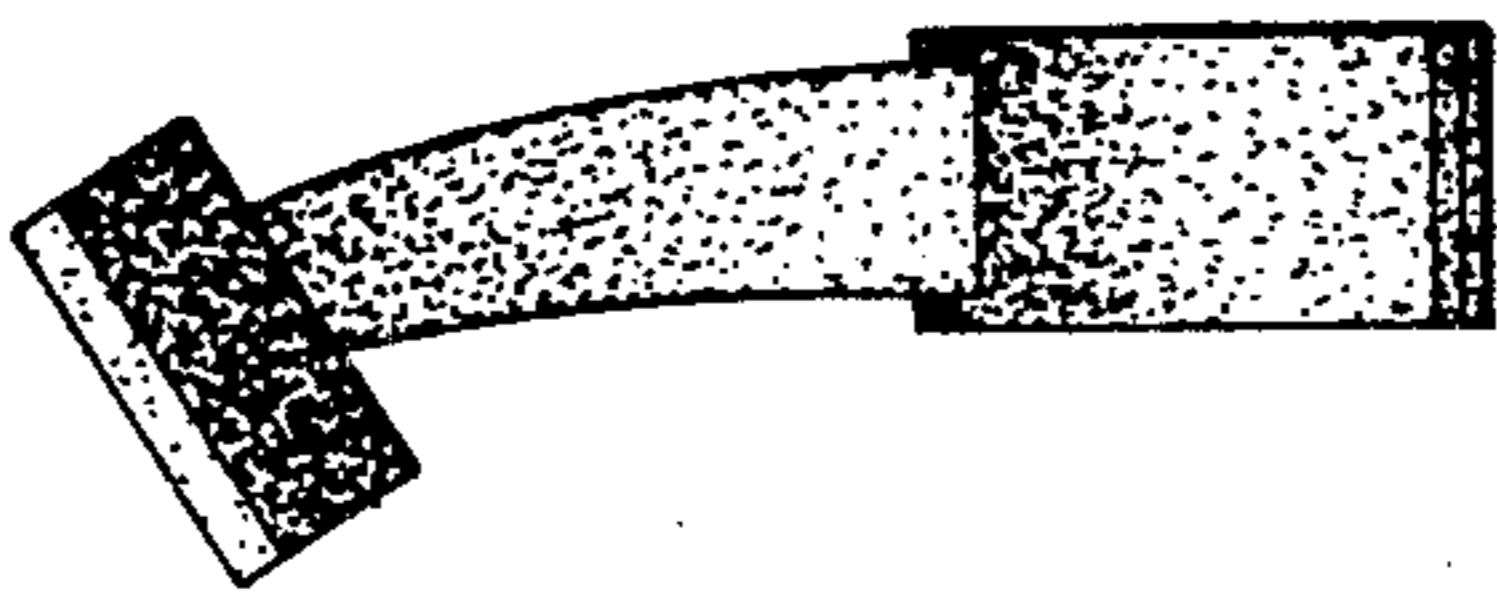

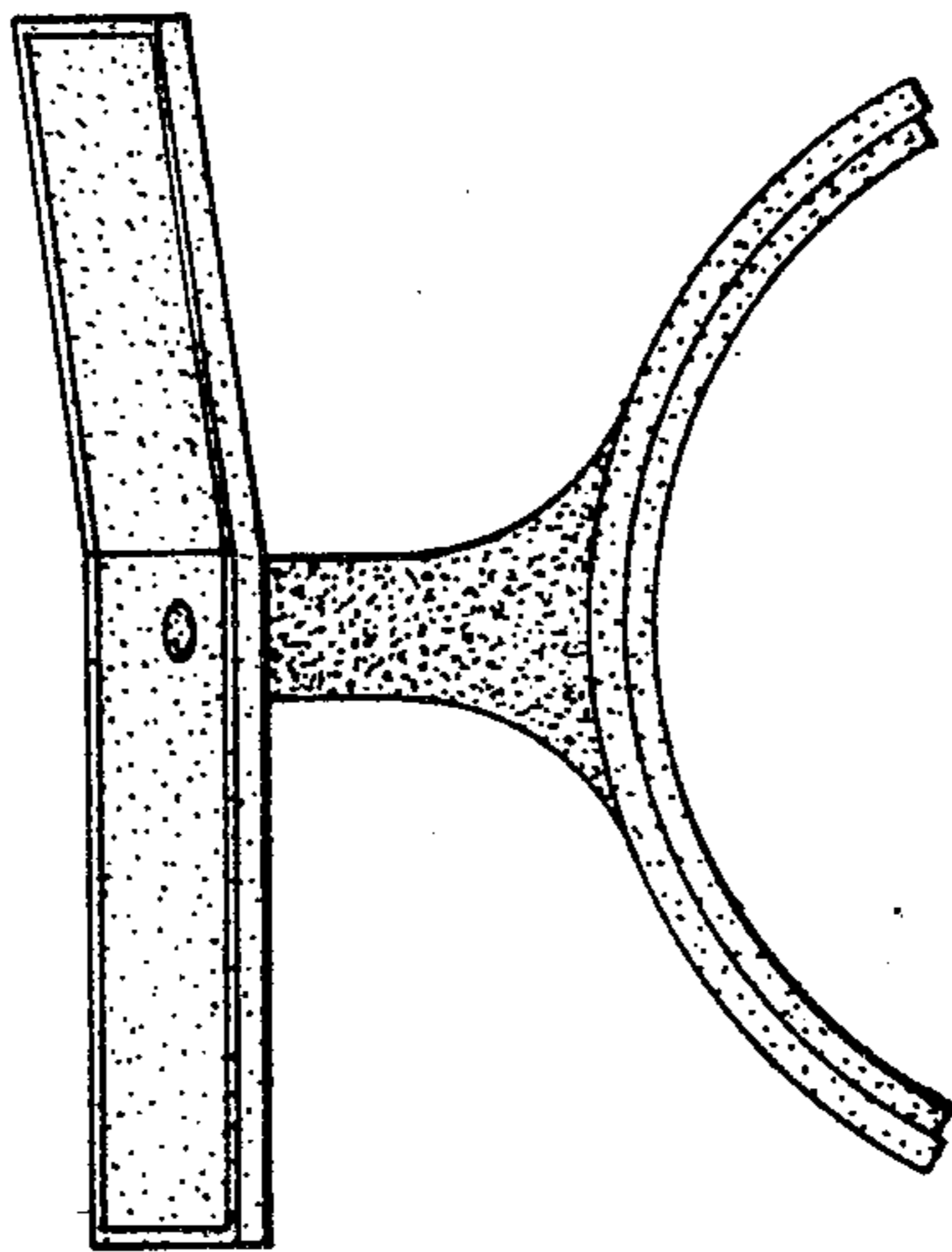

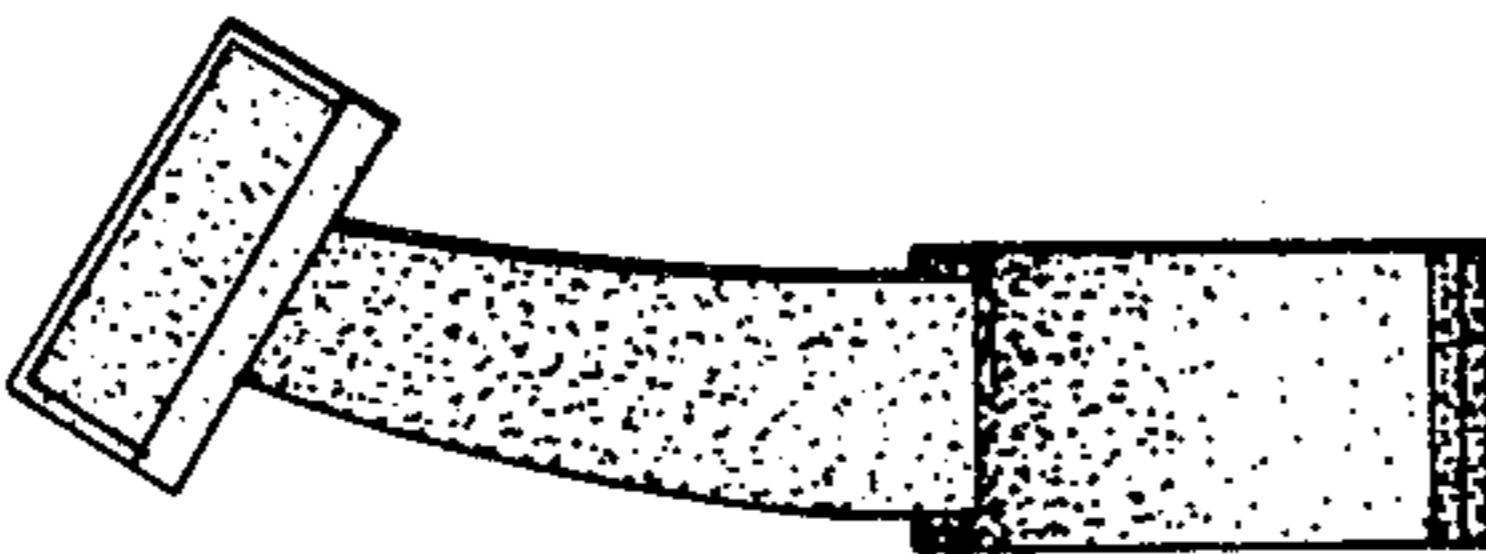

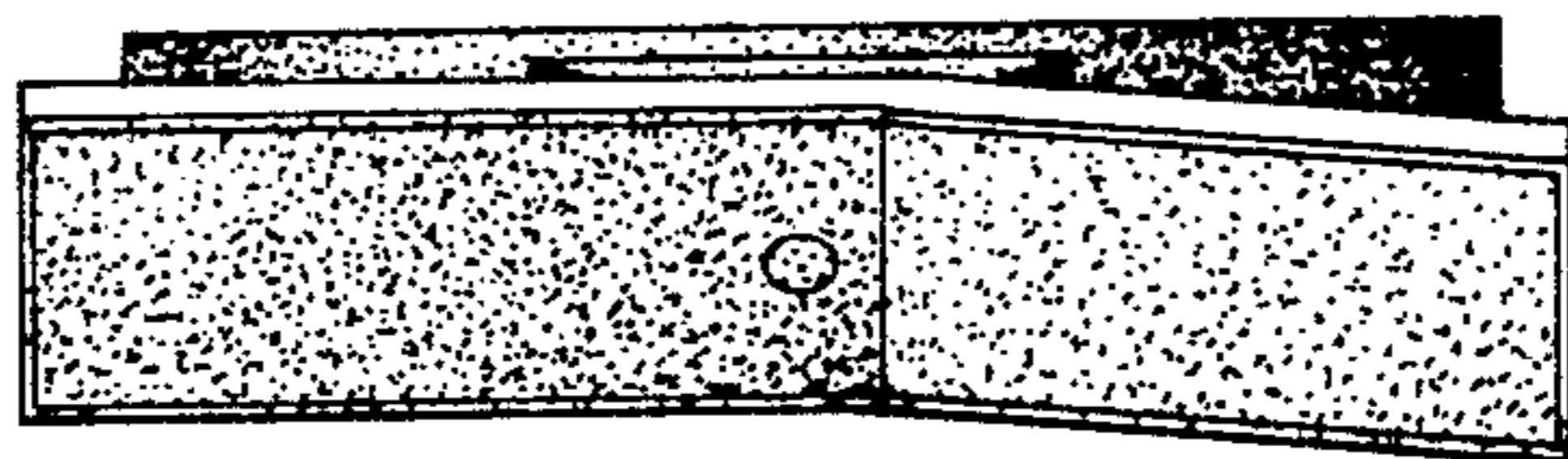

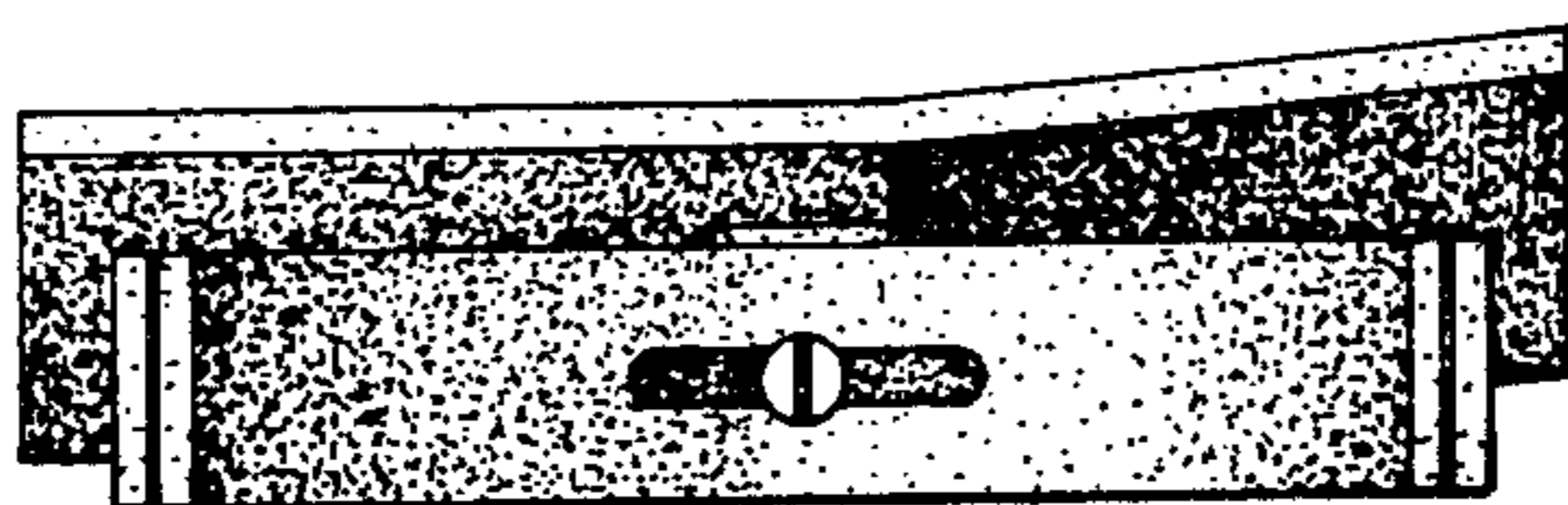

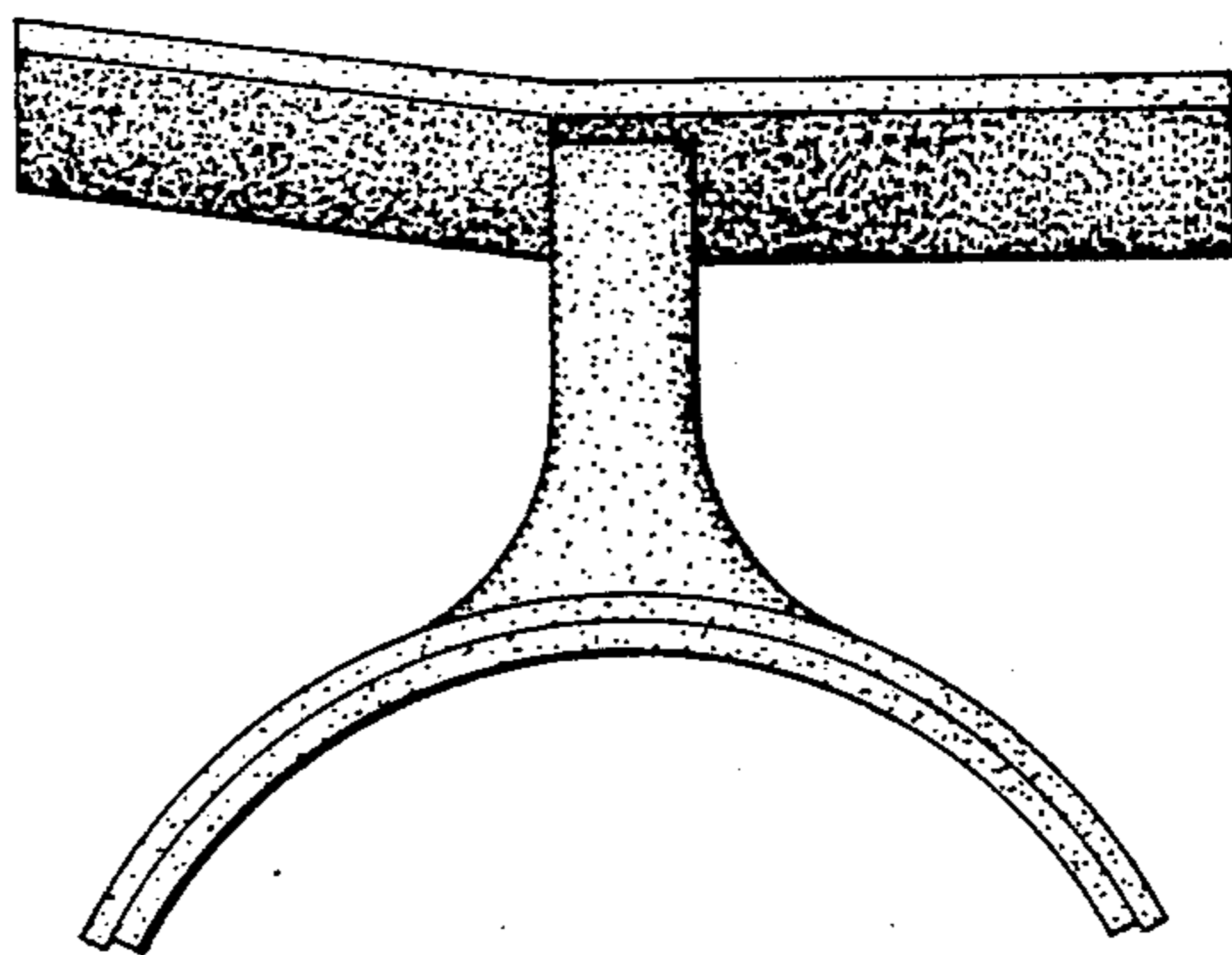
