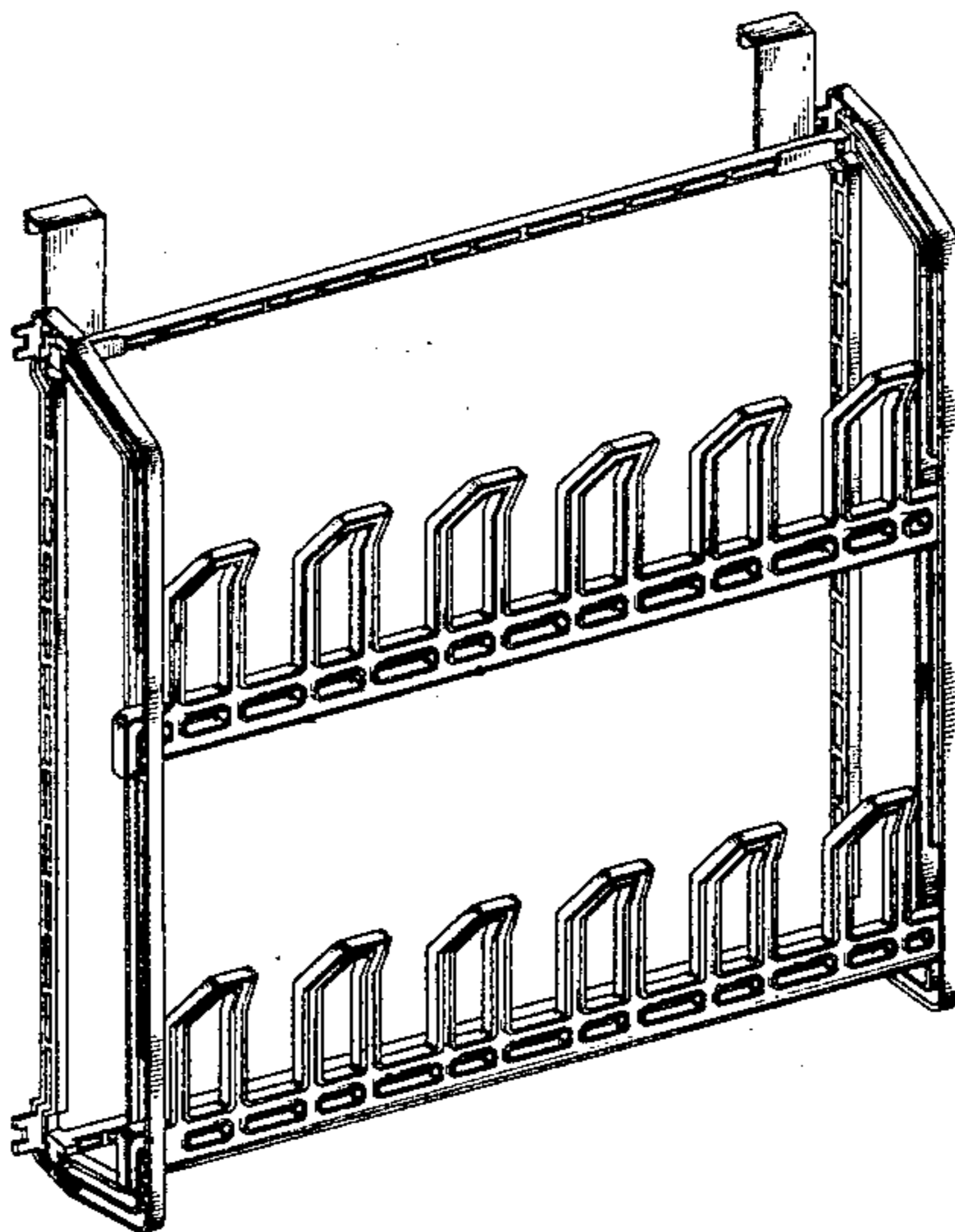
[57] CLAIM

The ornamental design of a modular door-mounted shoe rack, substantially as shown and described.

DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a front perspective view of a modular door-mounted shoe rack embodying my new design;
 FIG. 2 is an enlarged top view thereof;
 FIG. 3 is an enlarged front view thereof;
 FIG. 4 is an enlarged bottom view thereof;
 FIG. 5 is an enlarged rear view thereof;
 FIG. 6 is an enlarged left side view thereof, the side opposite being a mirror image.

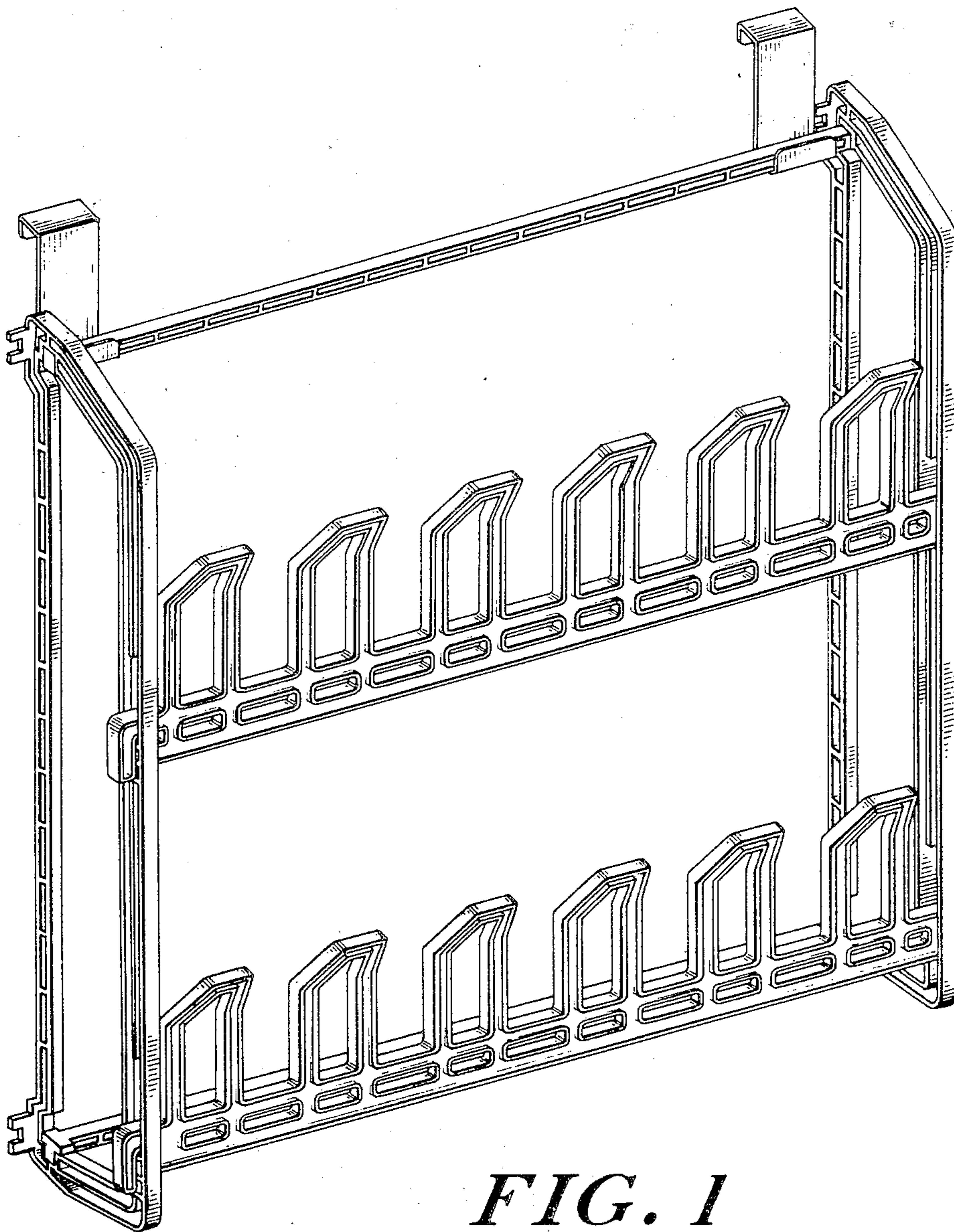

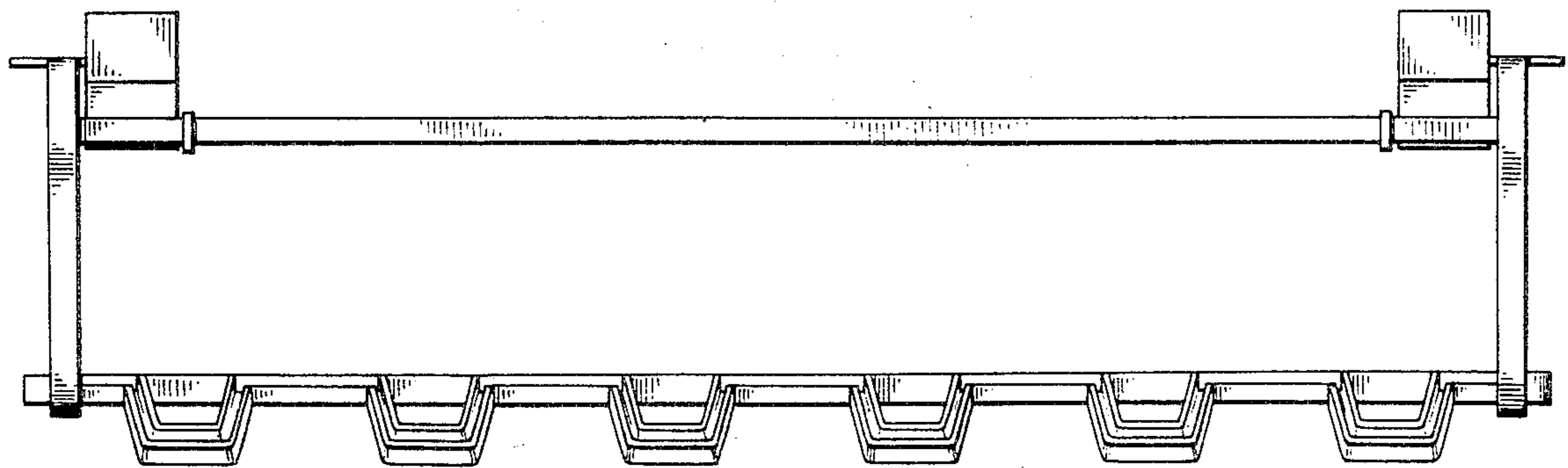

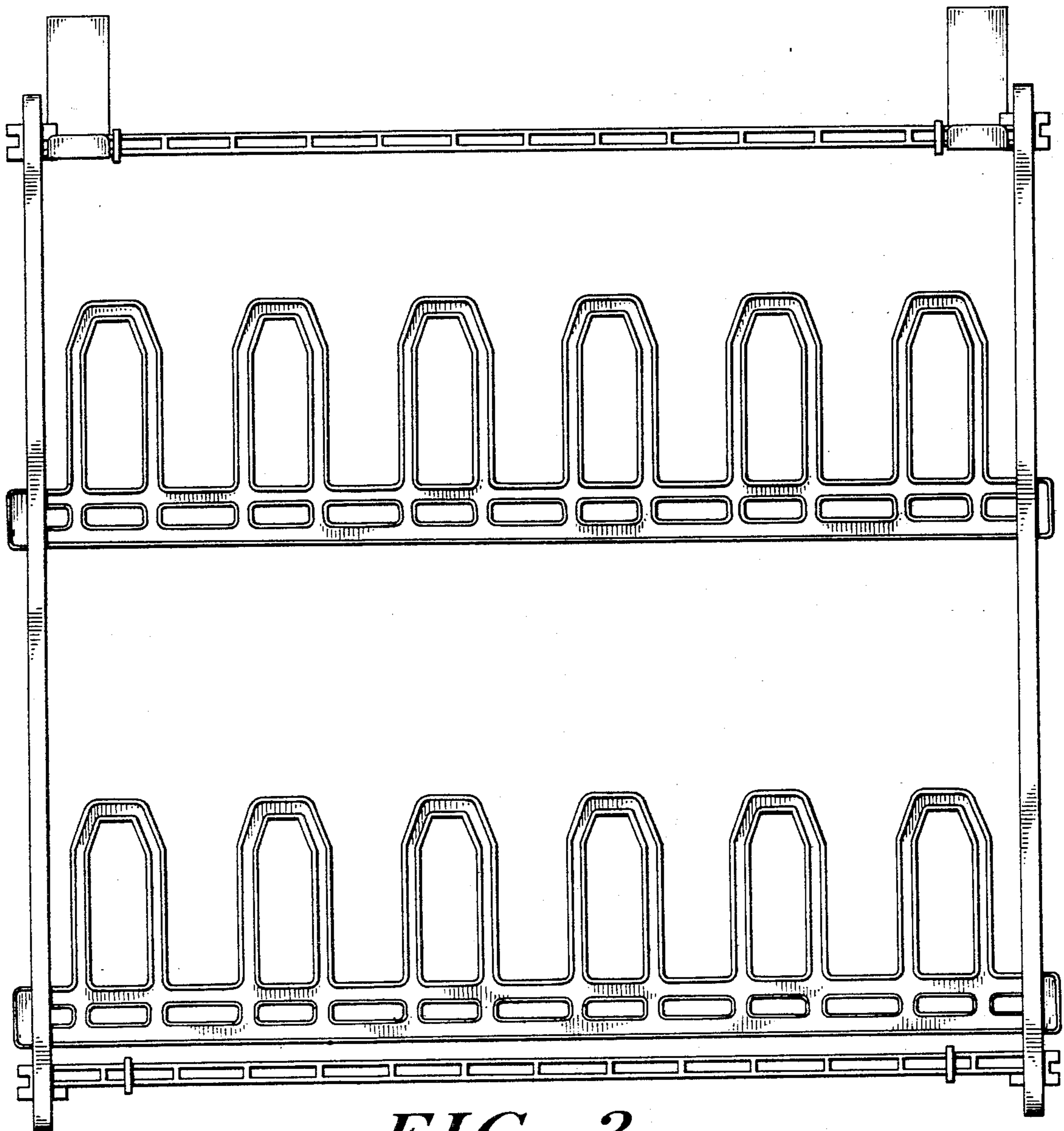

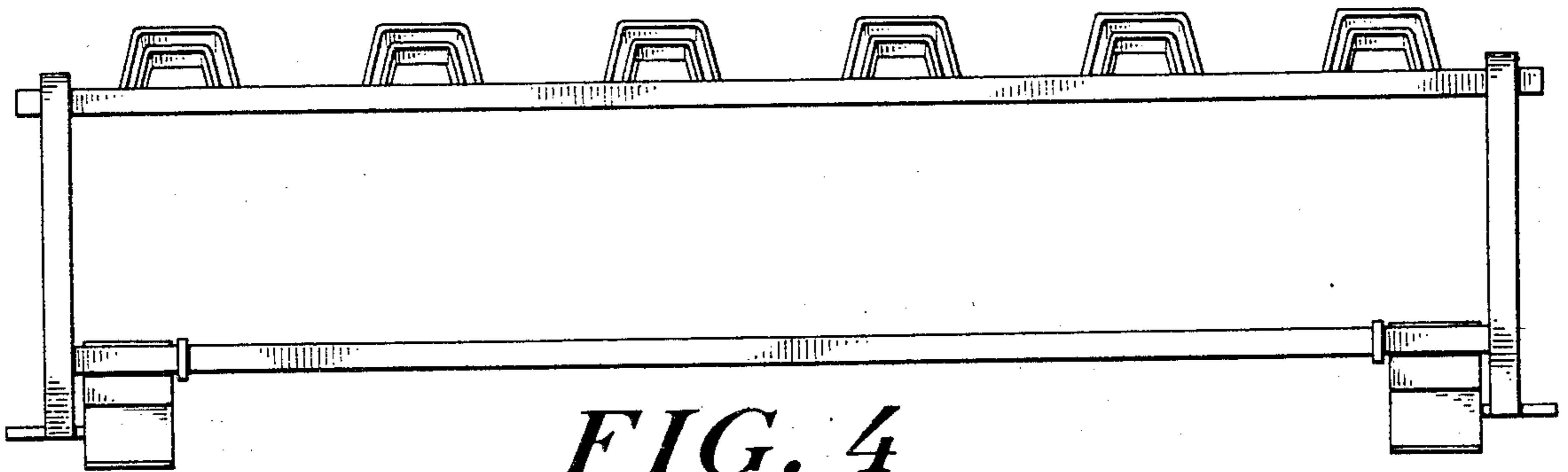

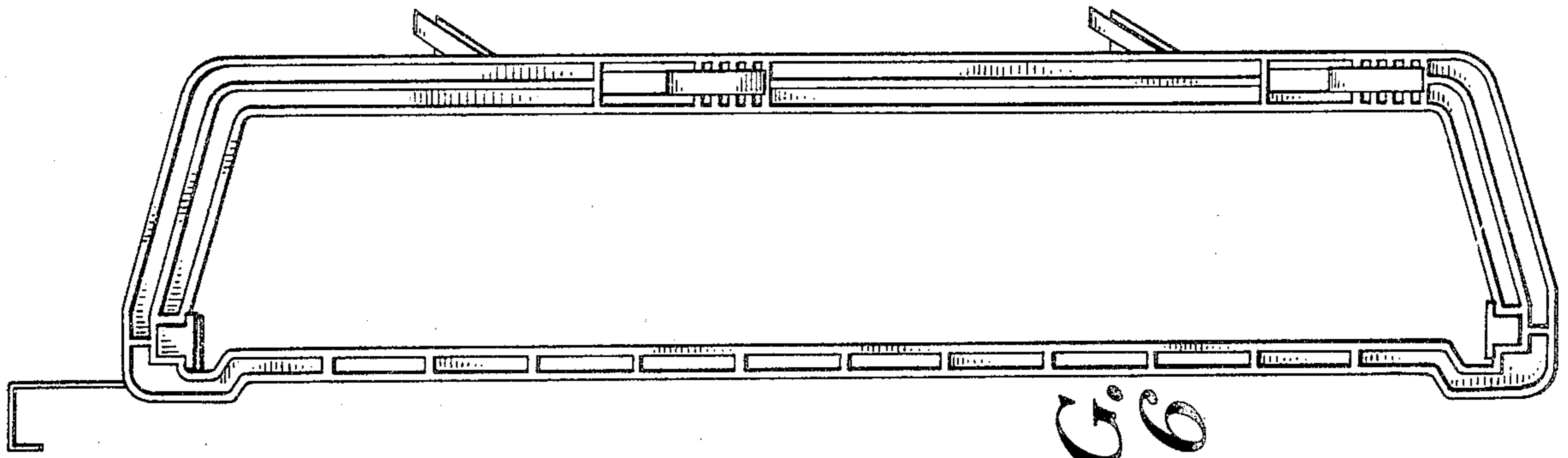

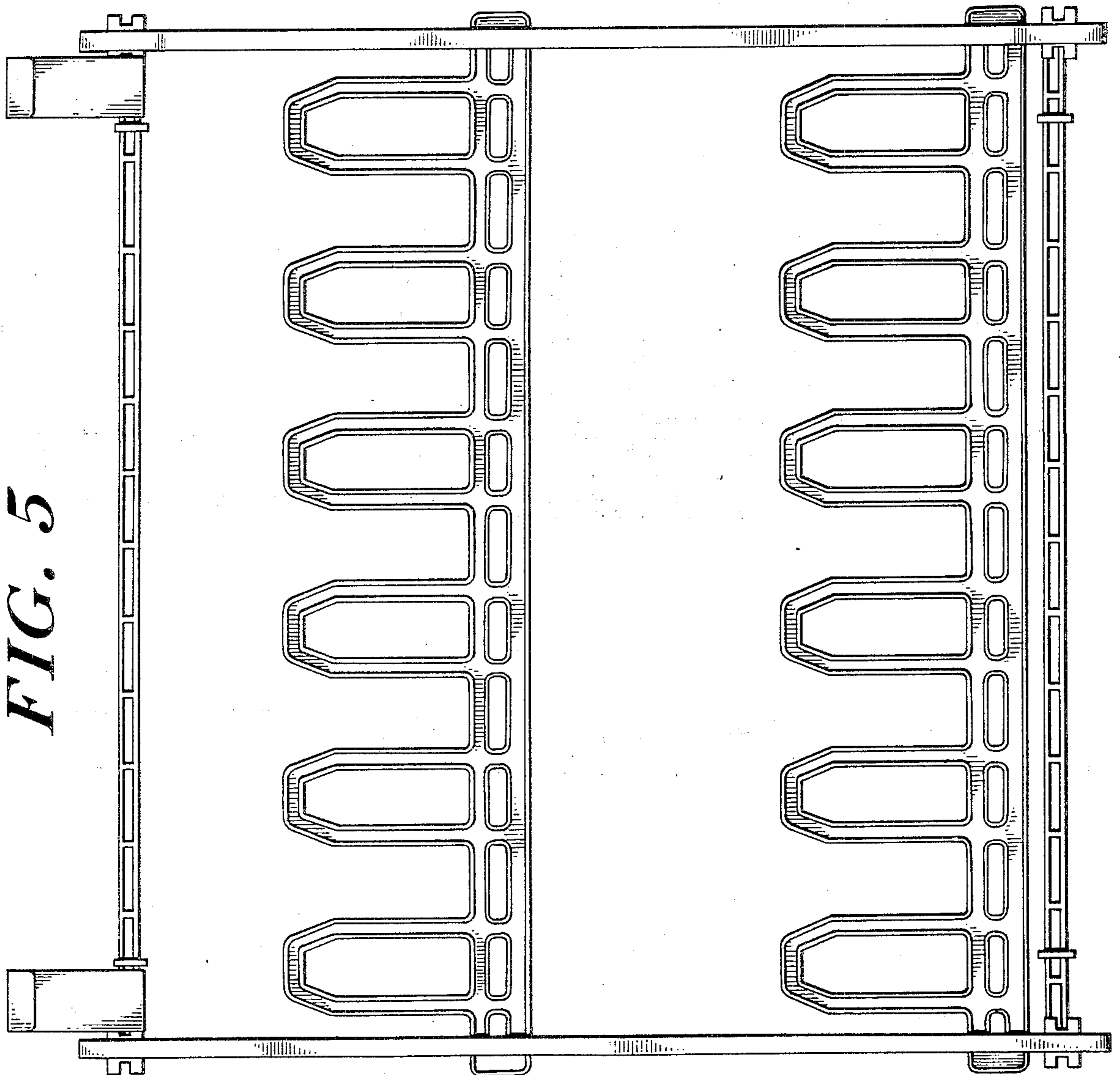
