The ornamental design for a chaise lounge, as shown.

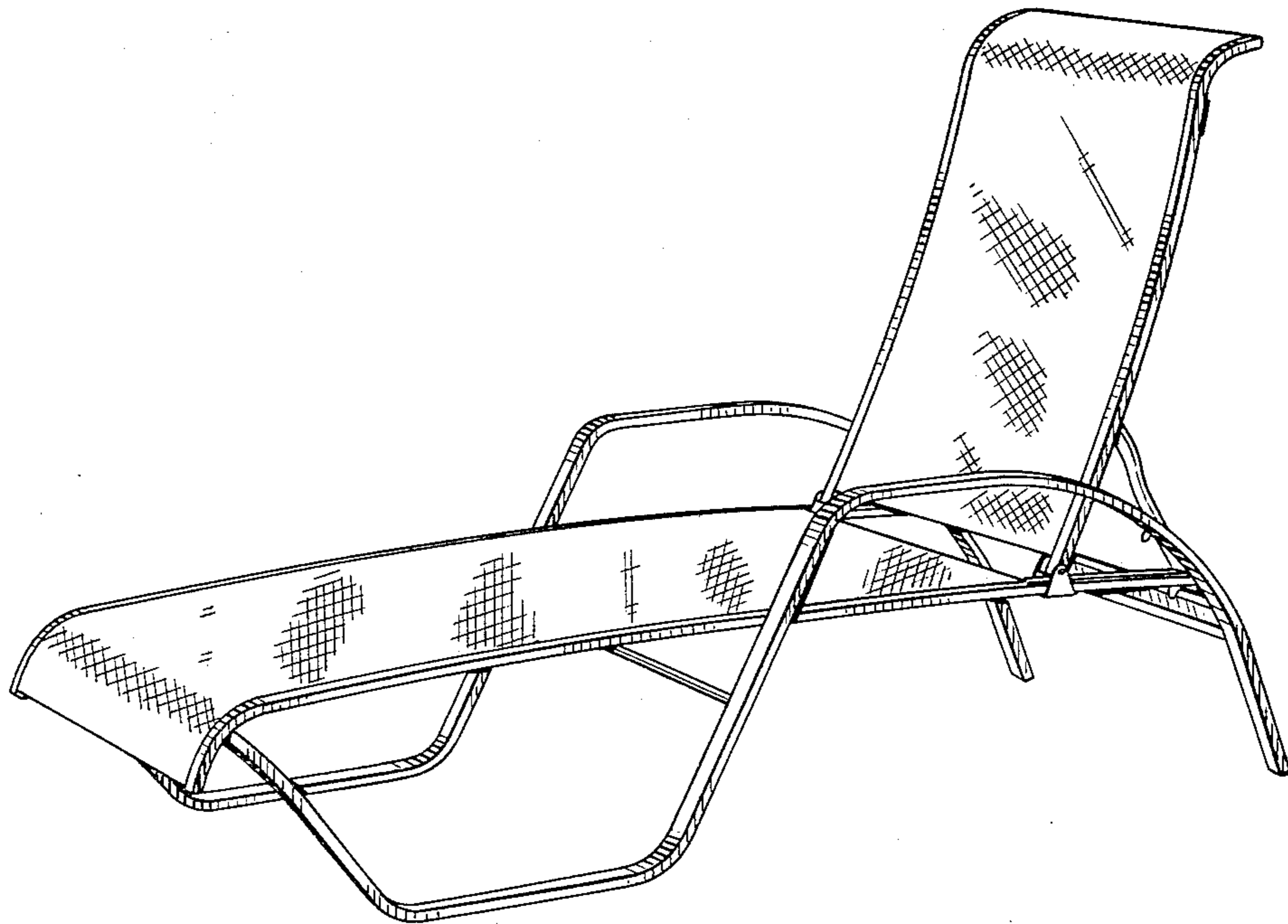
DESCRIPTION

FIG. 4 illustrates a rear view of the outdoor chaise of FIG. 1.



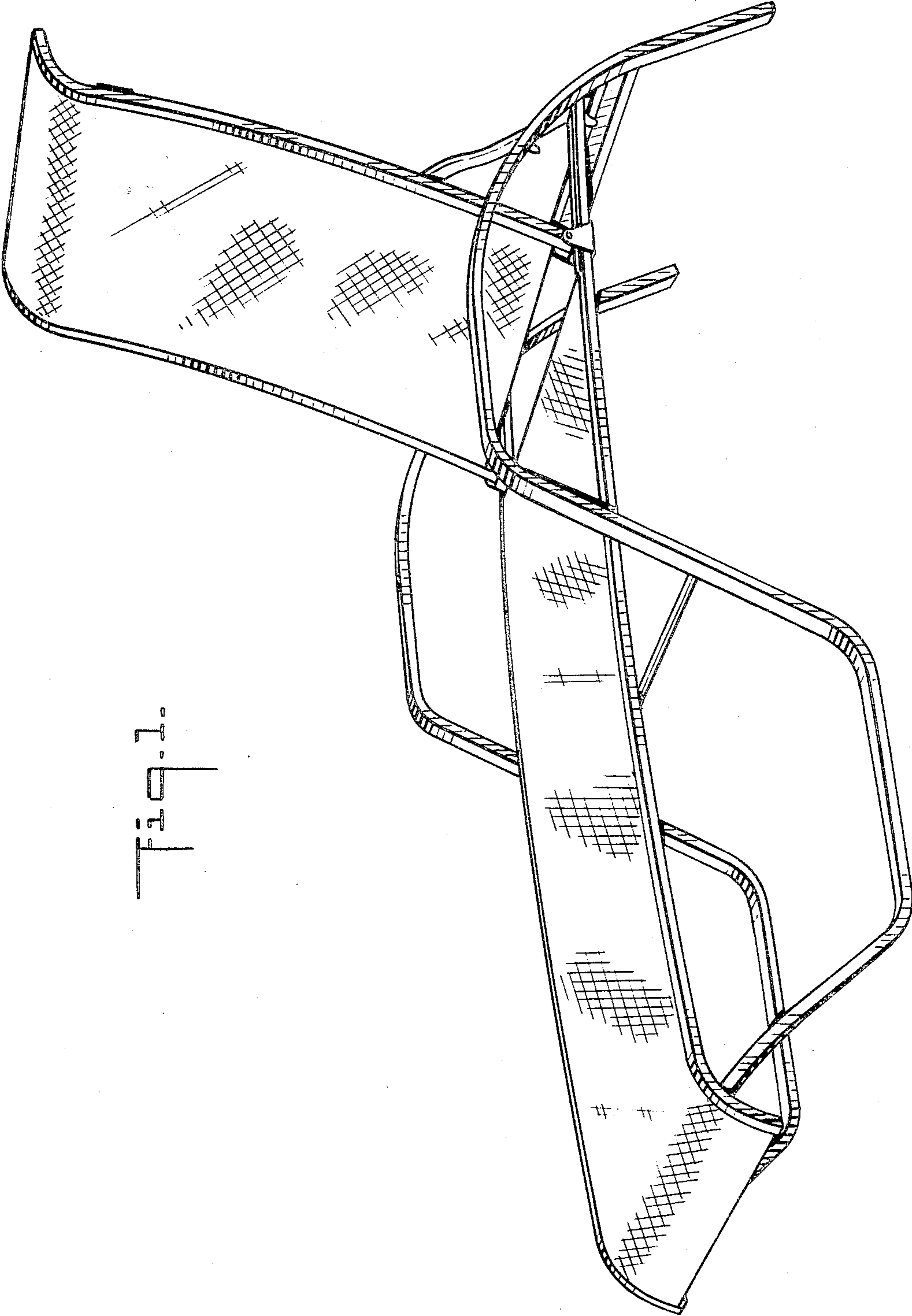

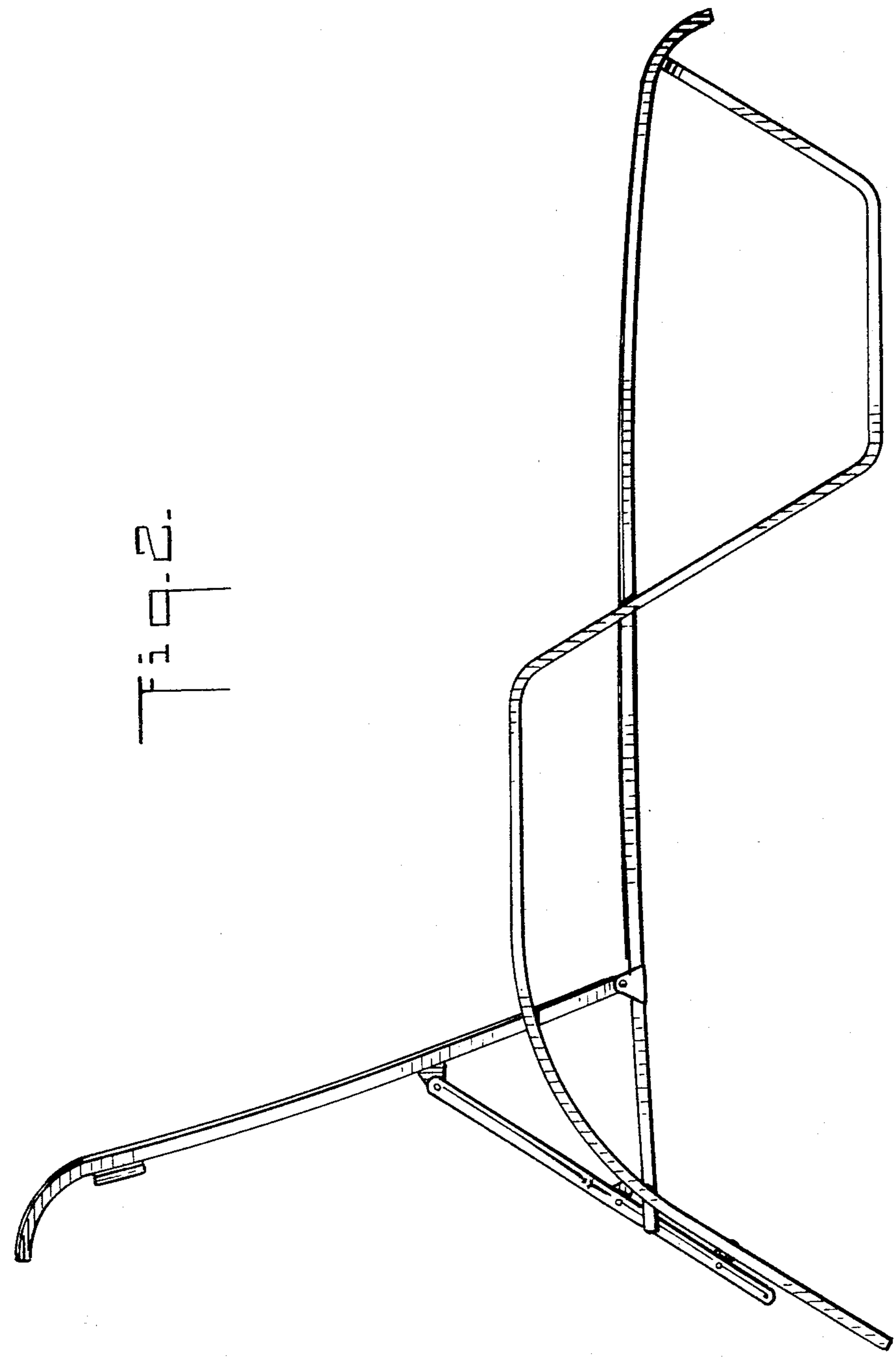

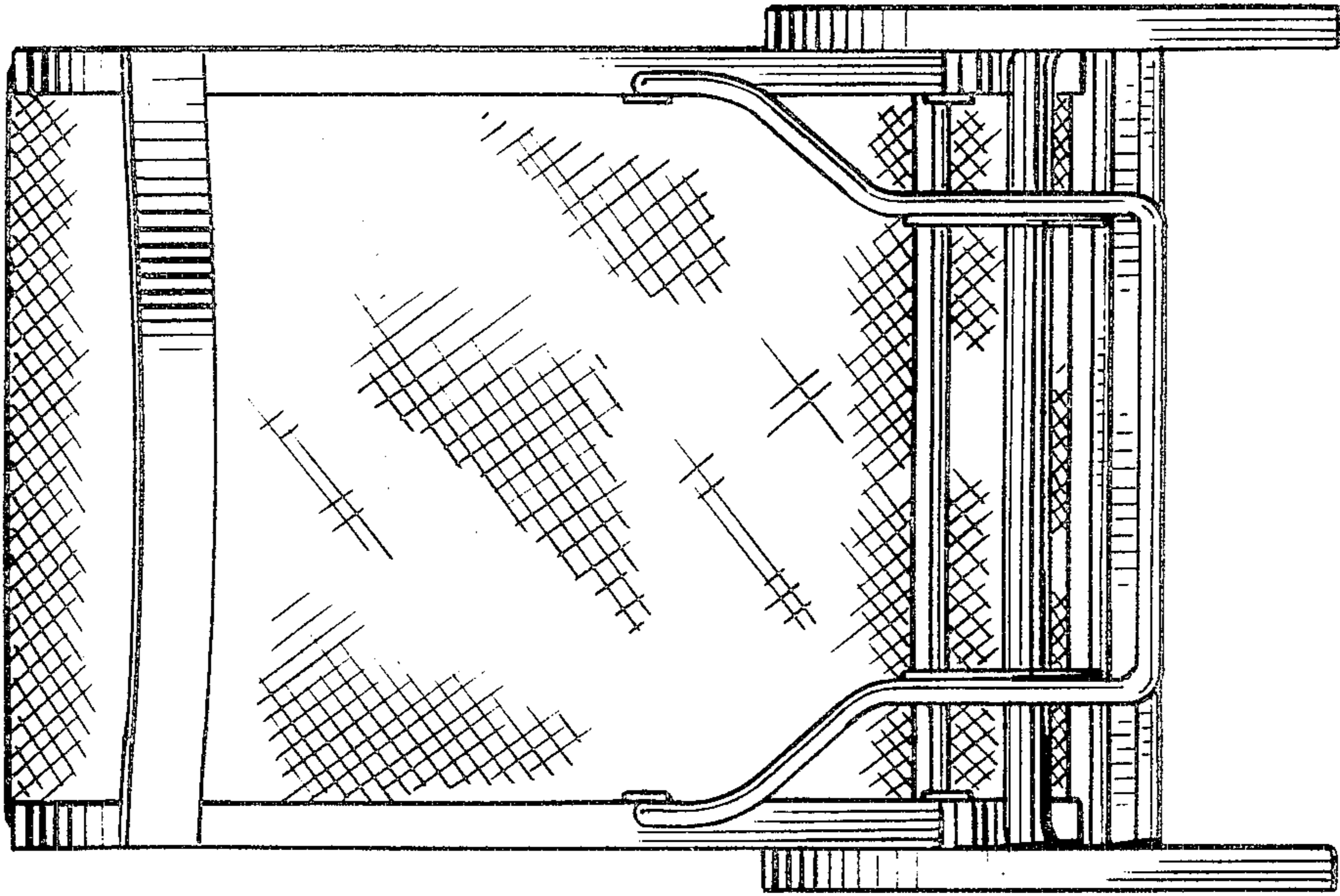
