[57] CLAIM

The ornamental design for a retriever for fallen fruit, debris or similar use, substantially as shown and described.

DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a perspective view of a retriever for fallen fruit, debris or similar use showing my new design; FIG. 2 is a side elevational view, the opposite side being identical; FIG. 3 is a top plan view thereof; and FIG. 4 is a bottom plan view thereof.
