FIG. 1 is a bottom, front and right side perspective view of a wall mounted factory data collection terminal or similar article showing our new design.

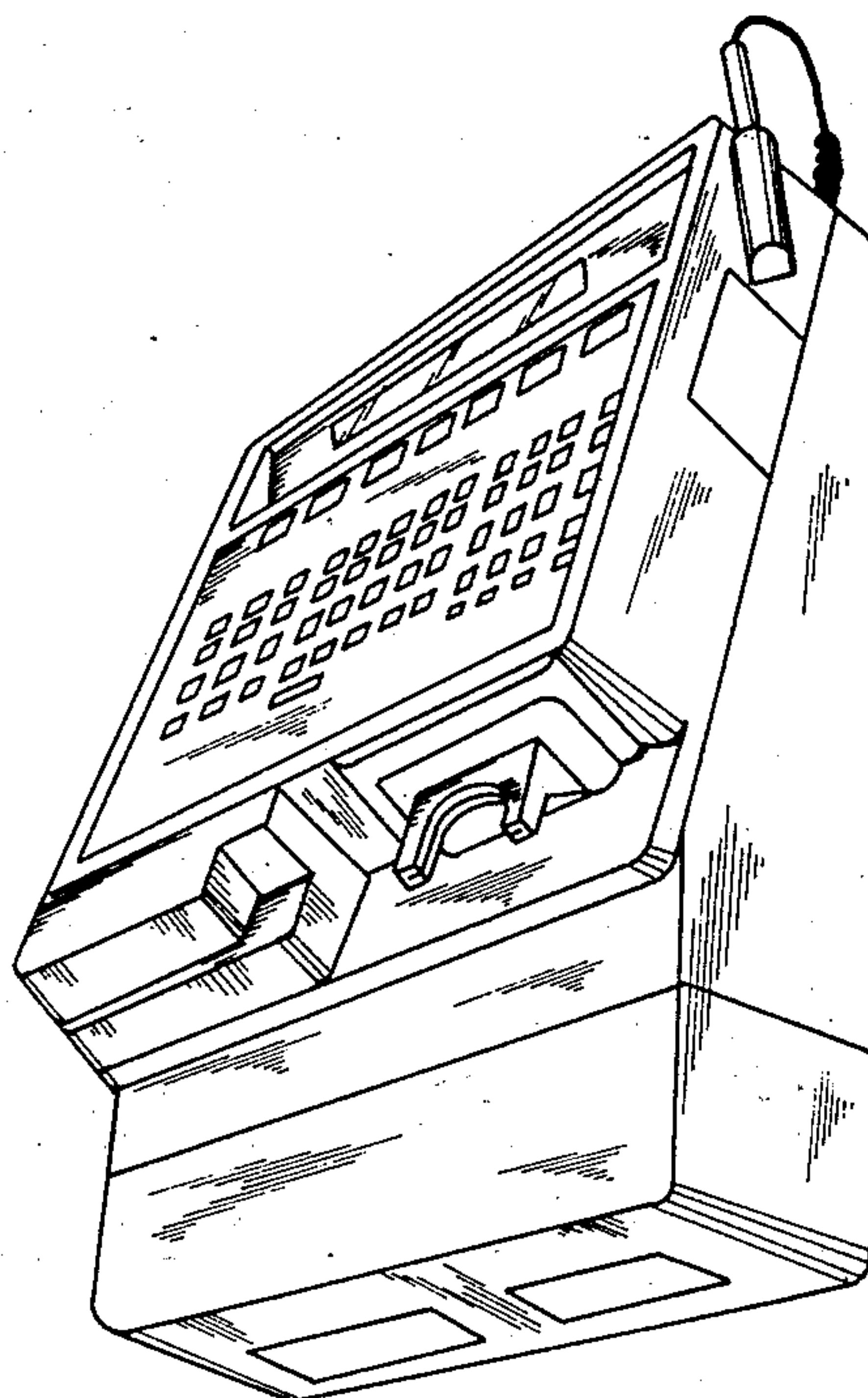
FIG. 2 is an enlarged right side elevational view thereof;

The wall and mounting bracket are shown in broken lines in FIGS. 2 and 4 for illustrative purposes only.



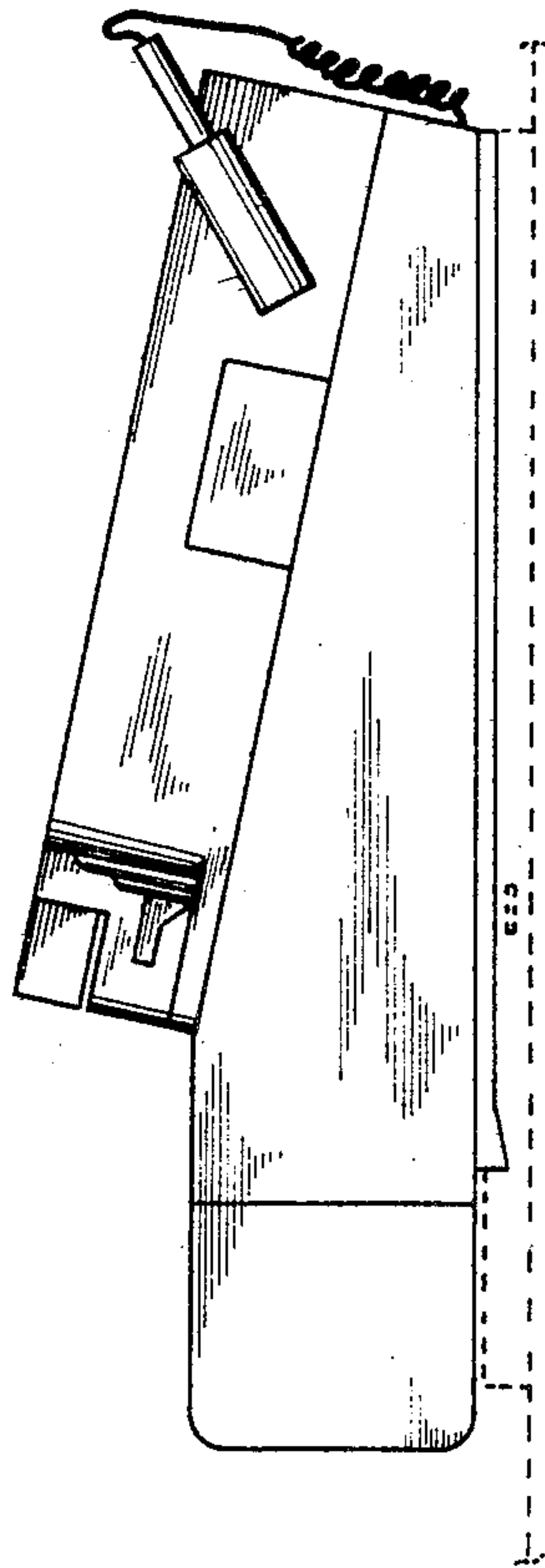

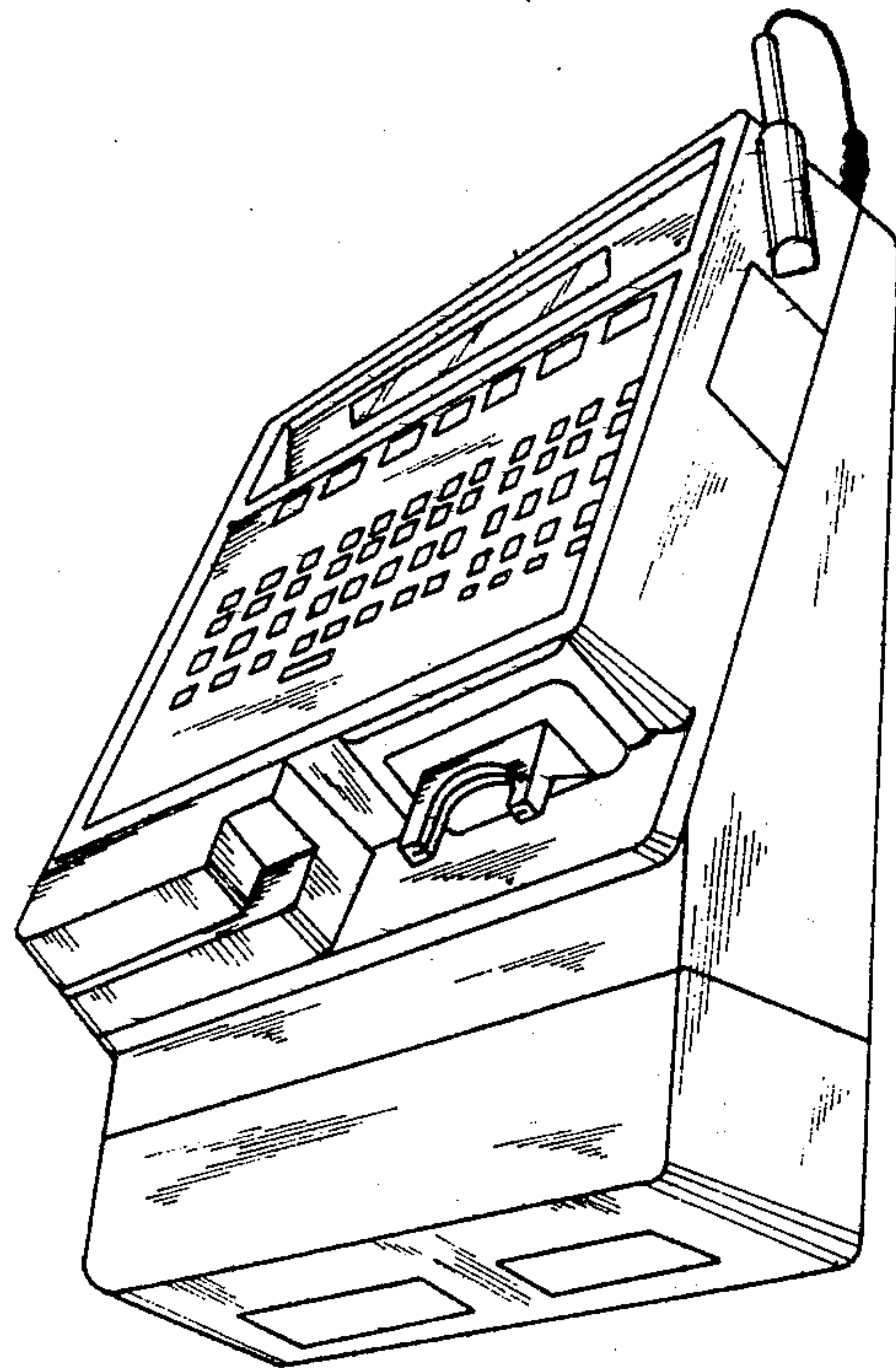

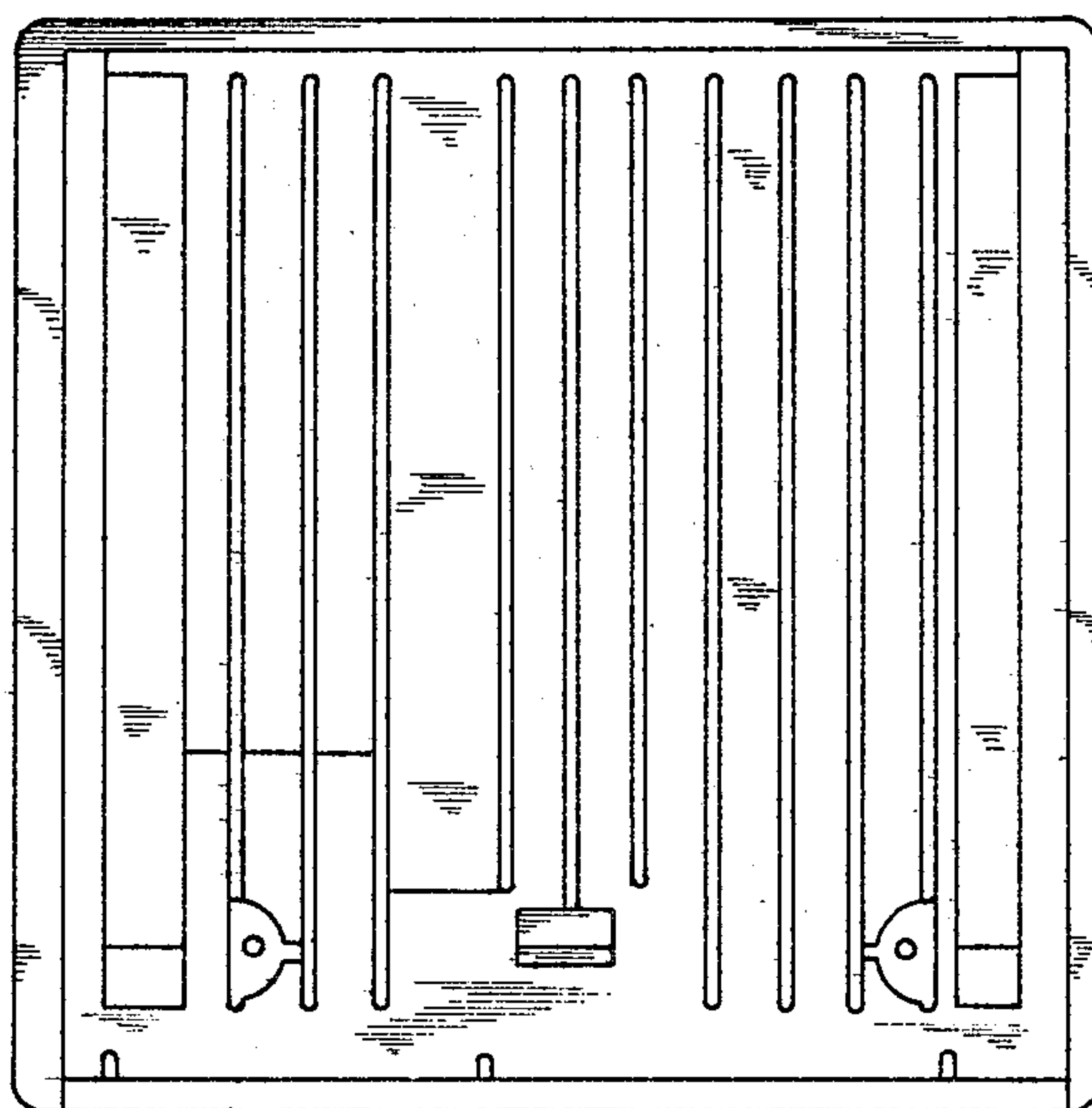

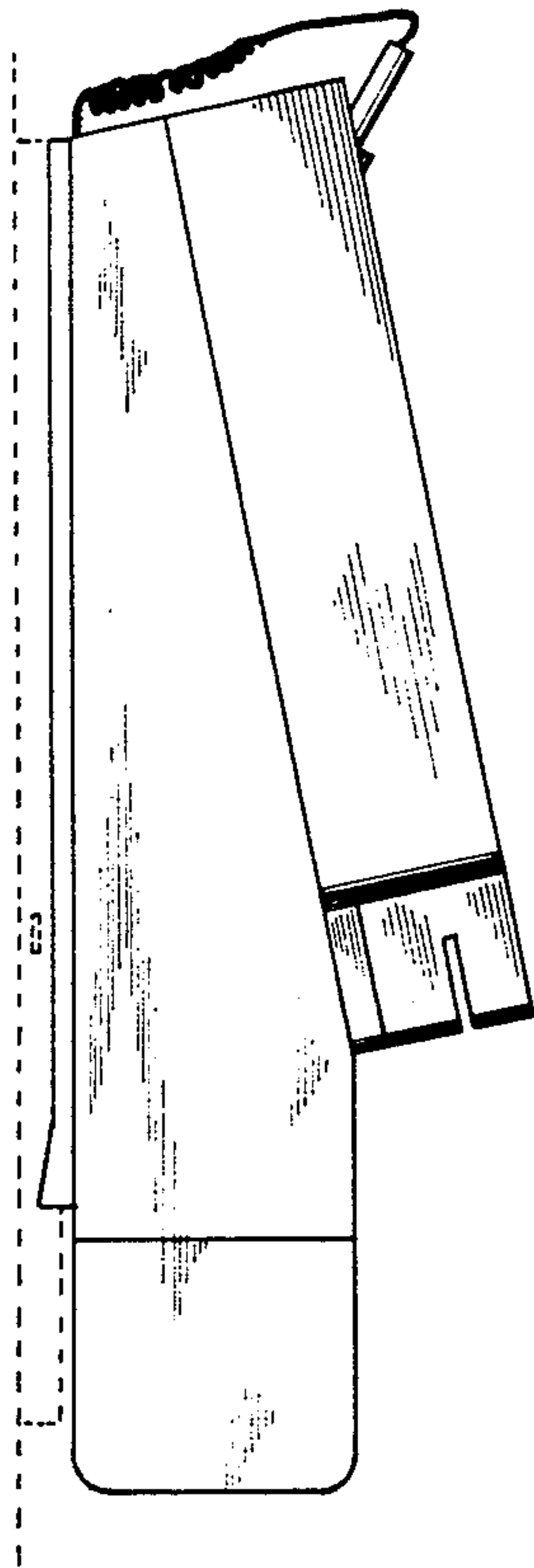

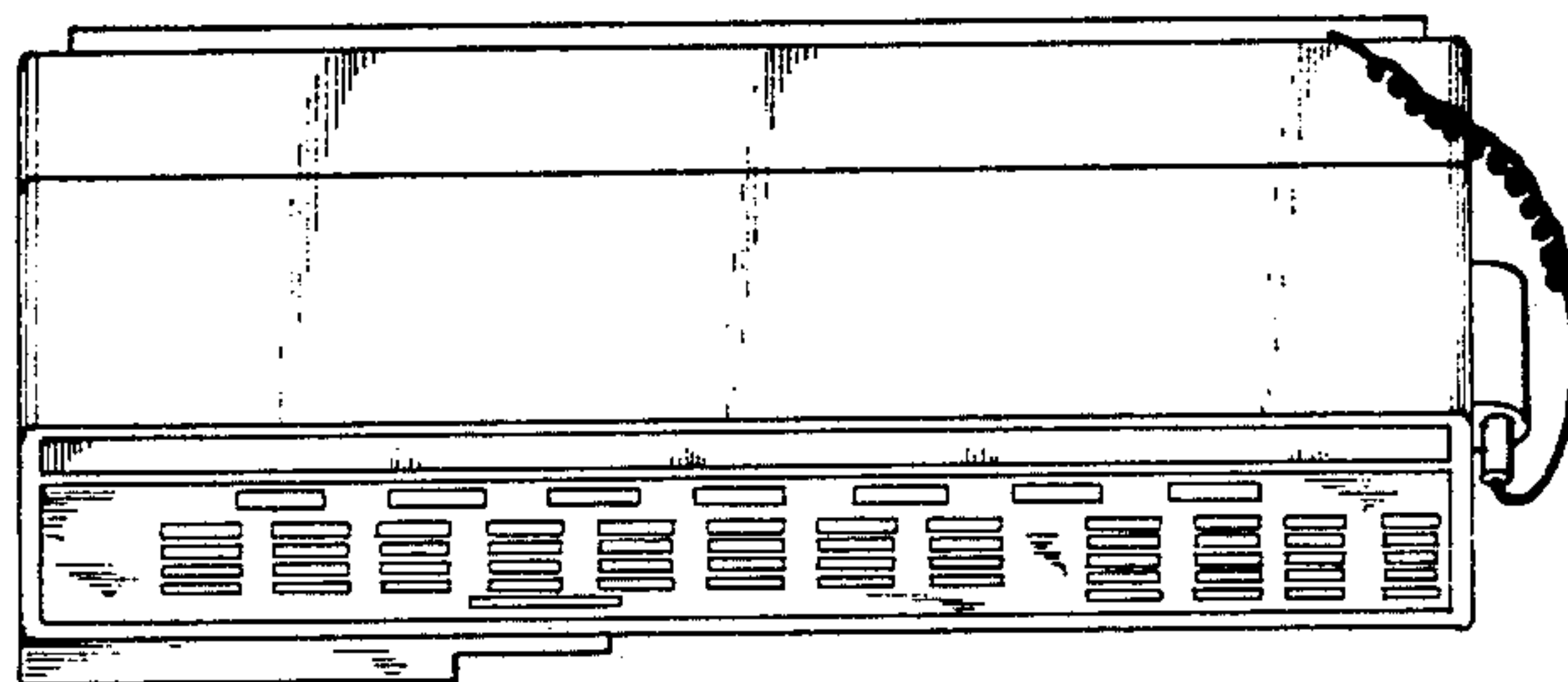
