FIG. 14 is a top plan view thereof;

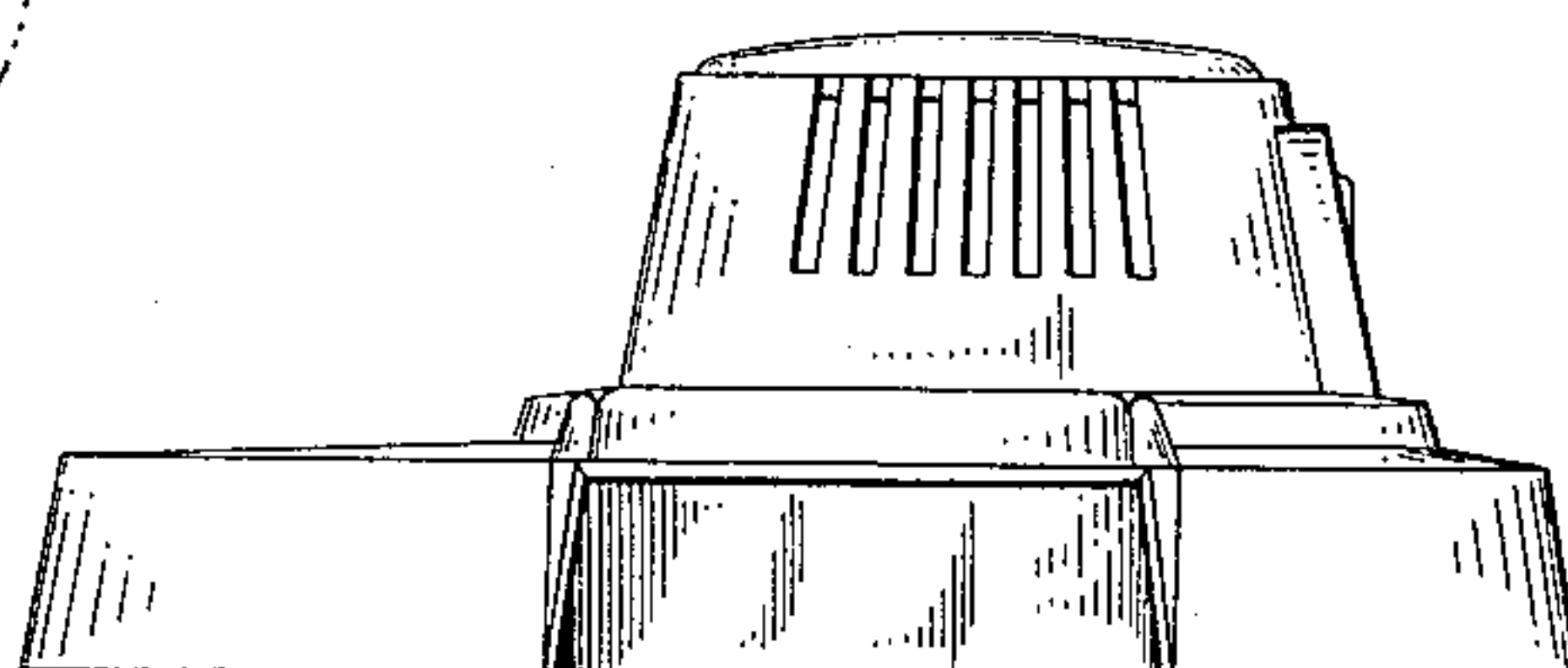
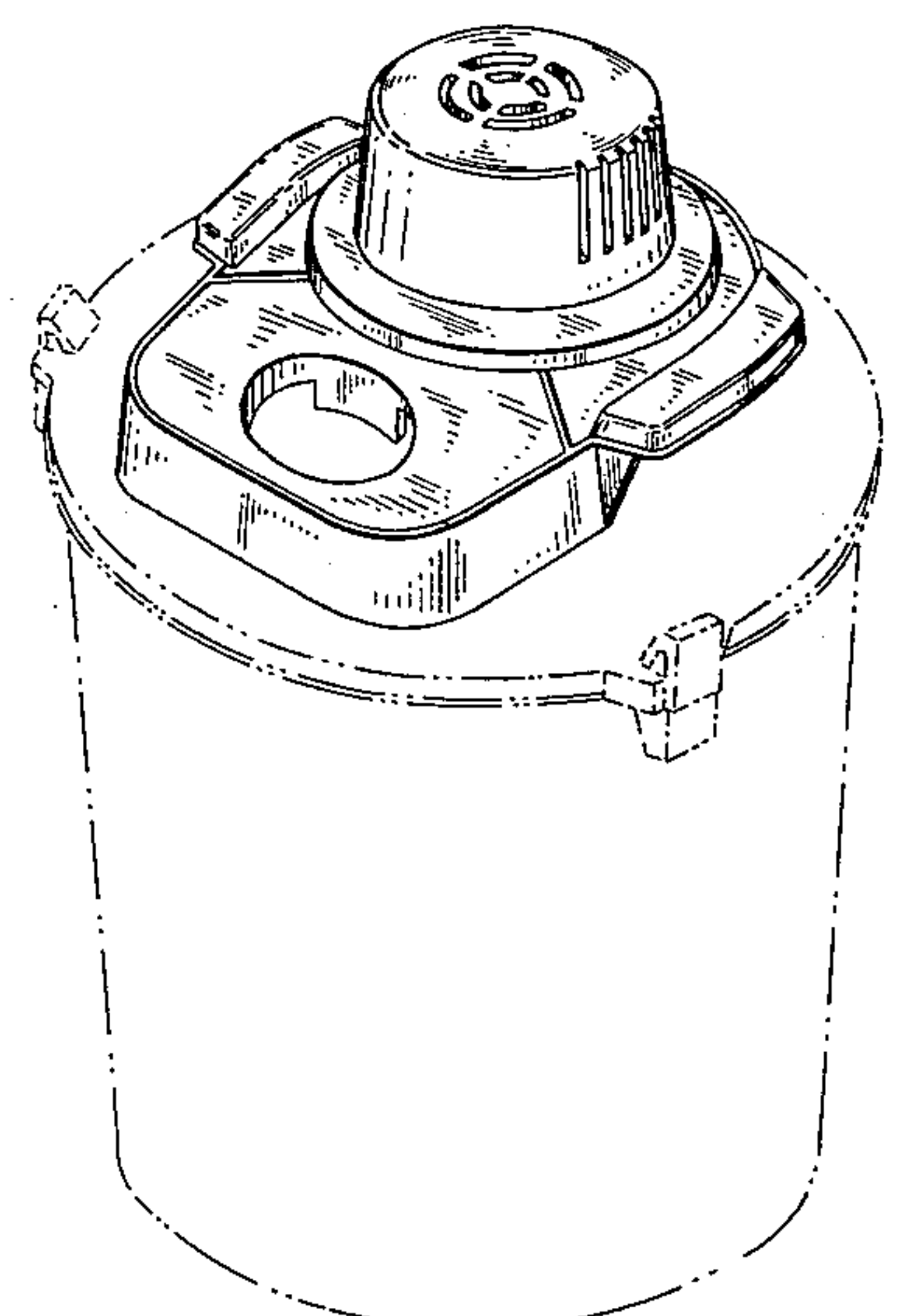
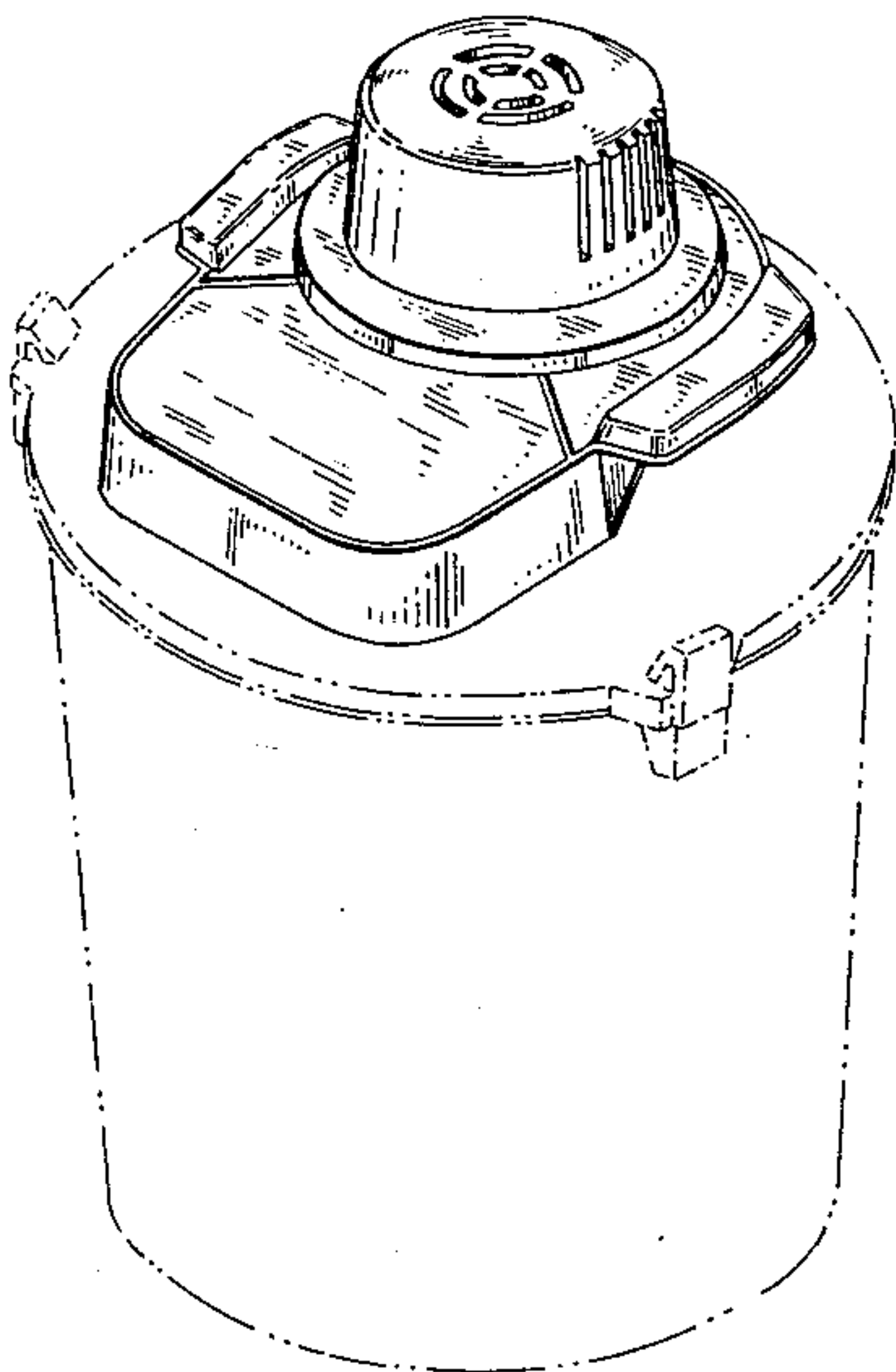
FIG. 15 is a front elevational view thereof;

purposes only and form no part of the claimed design.



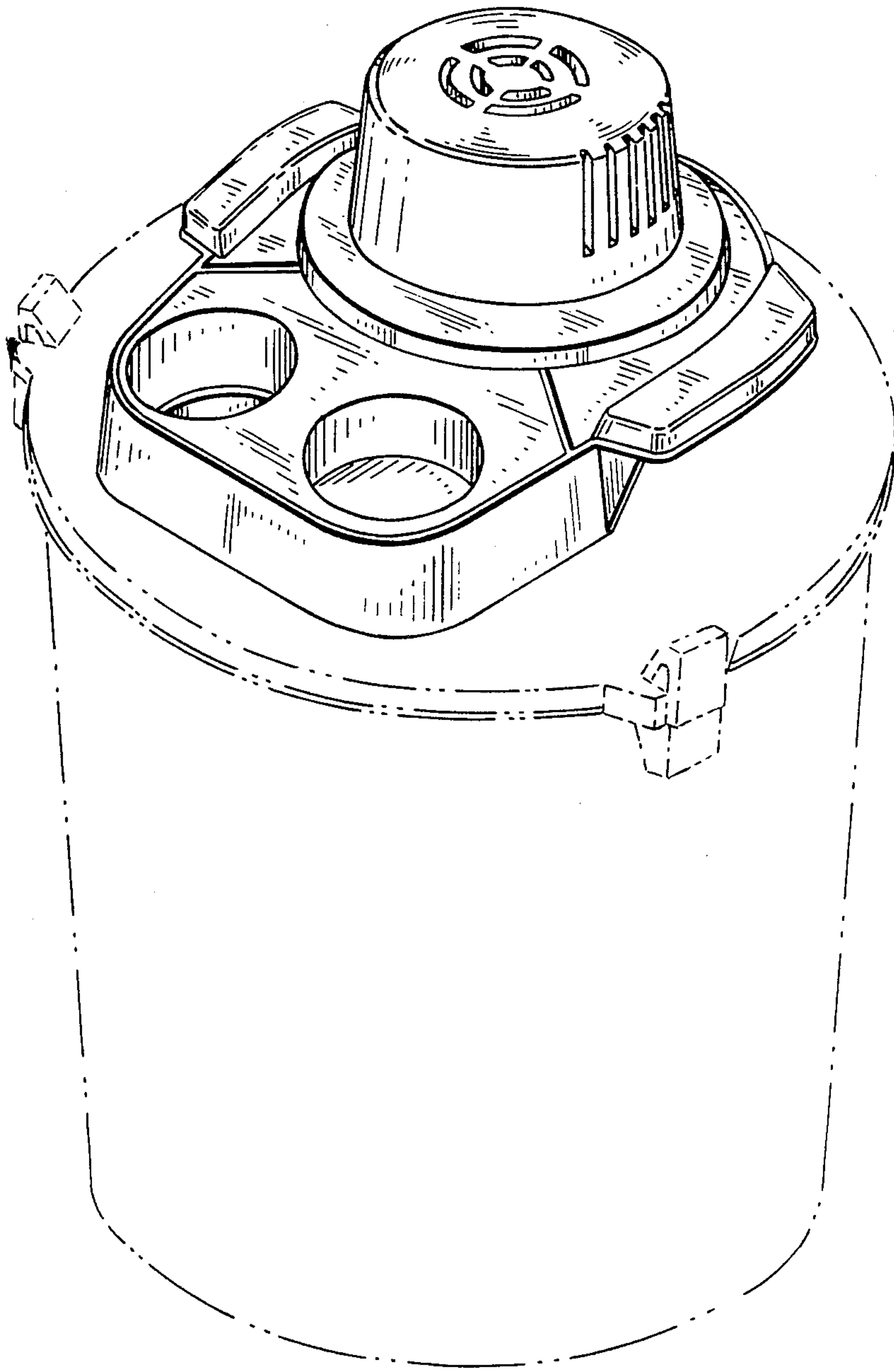
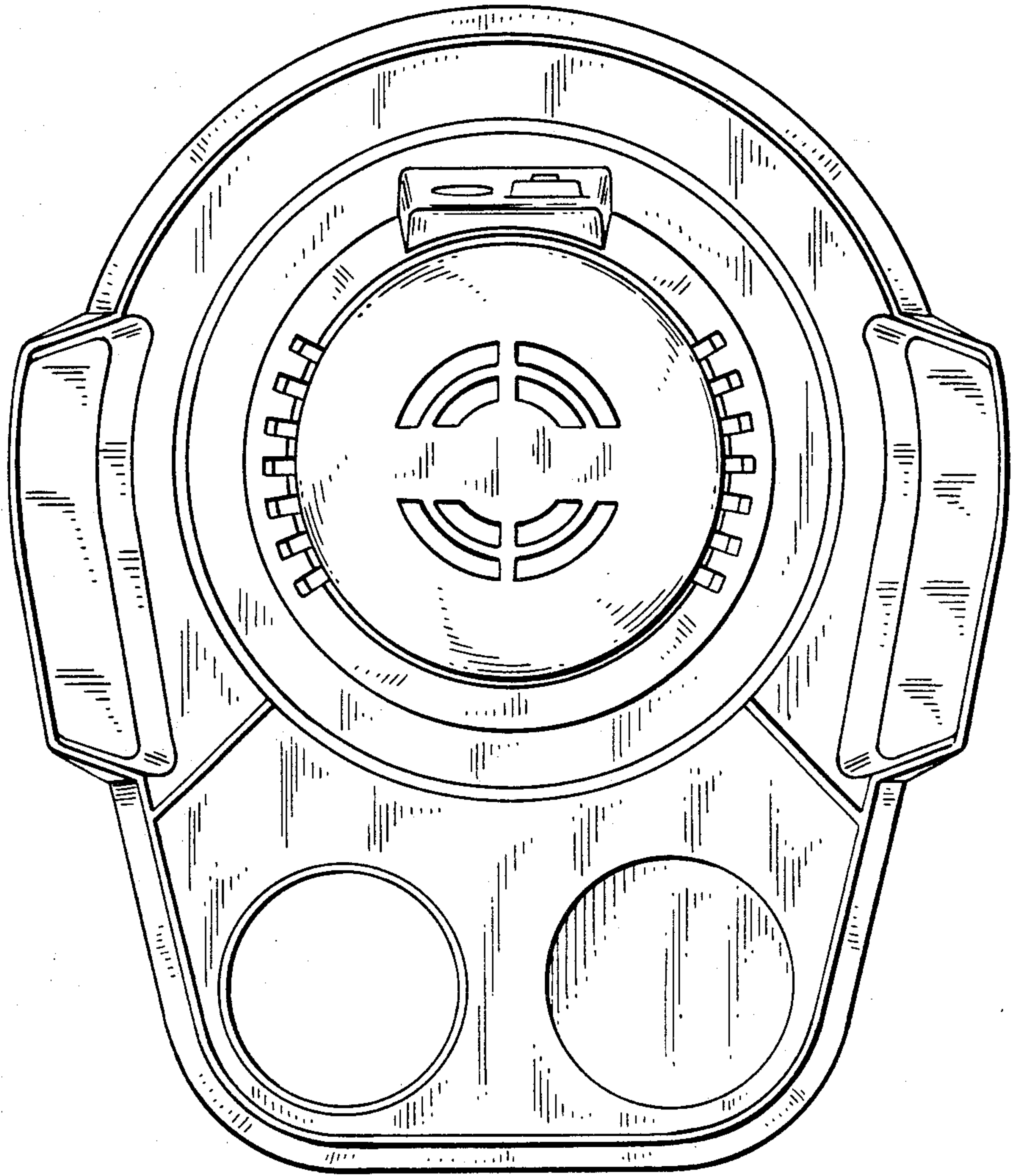

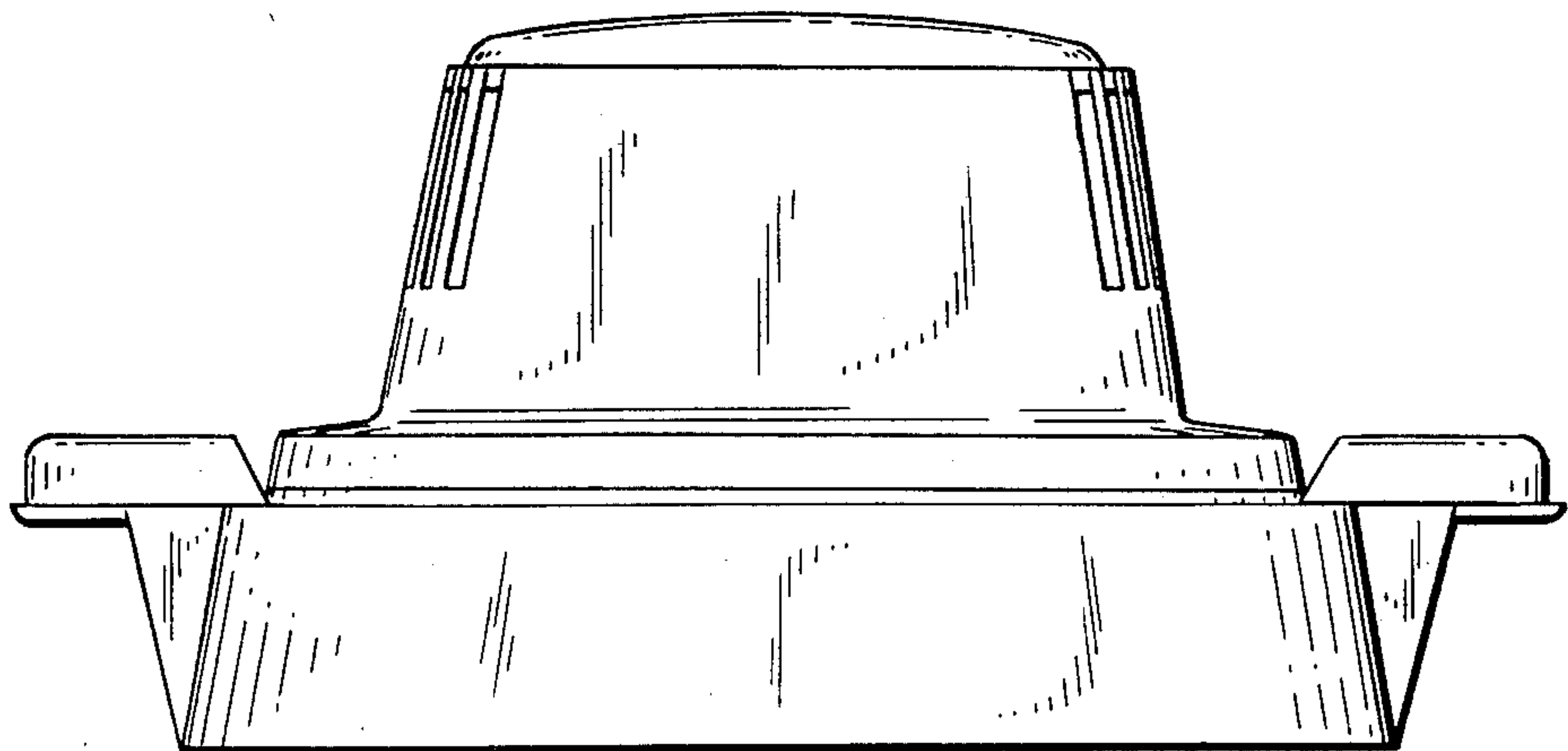

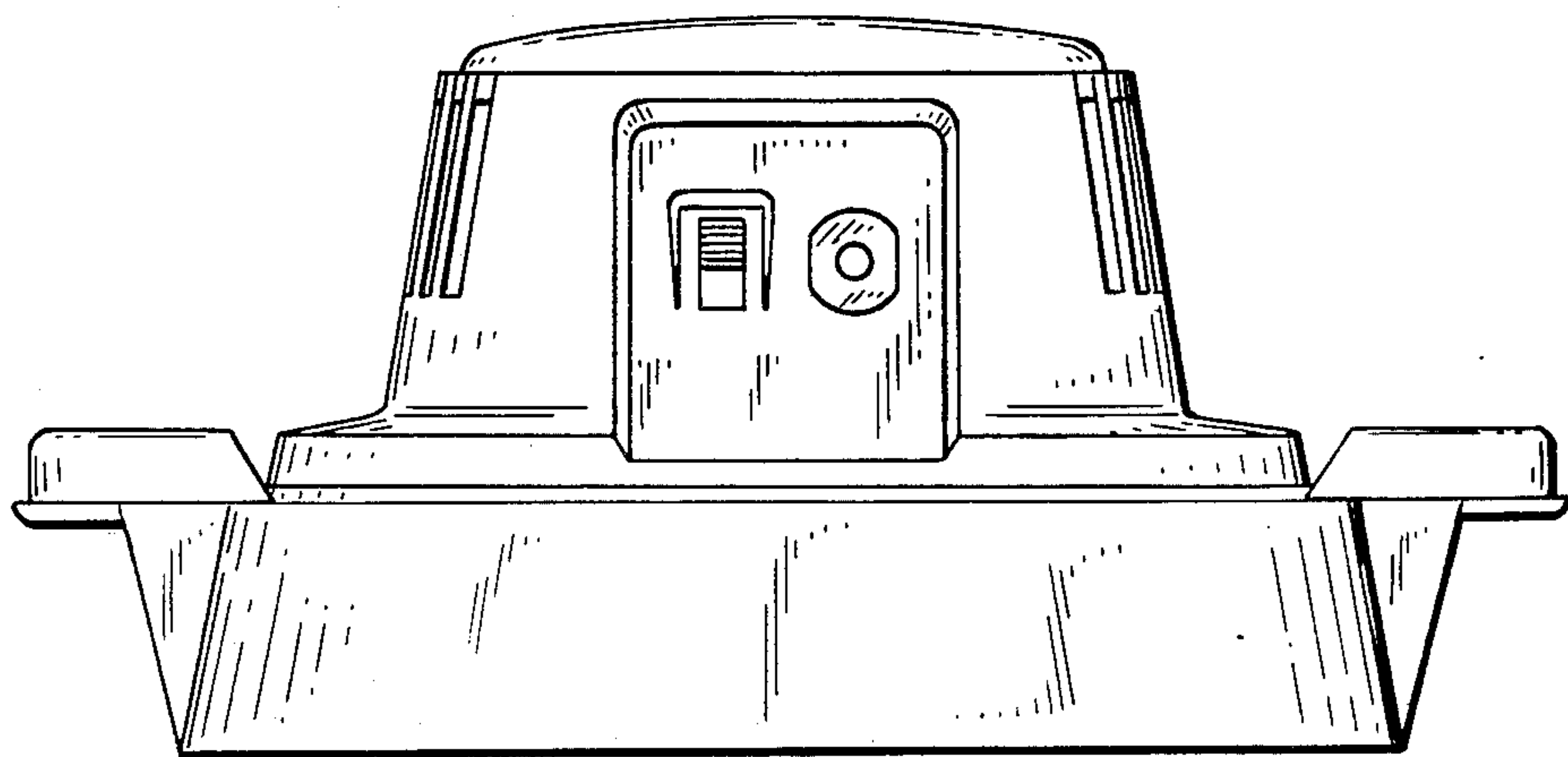

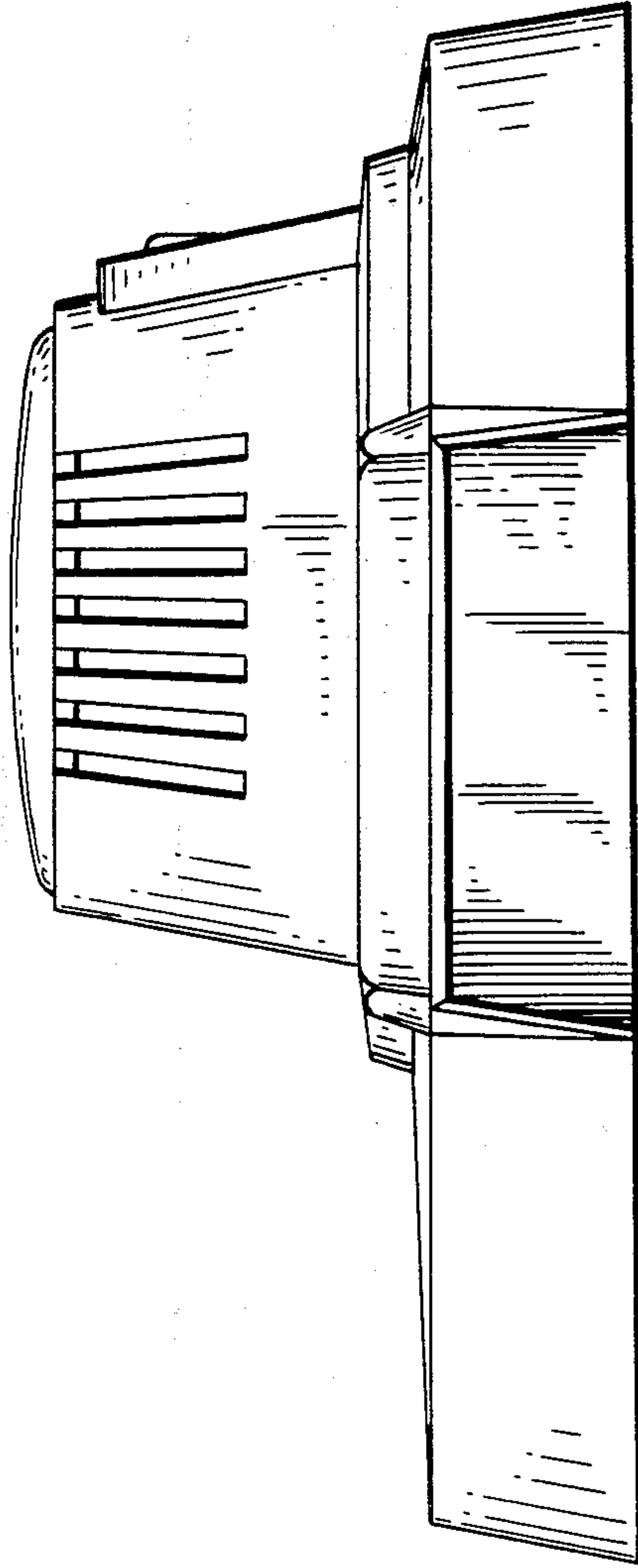

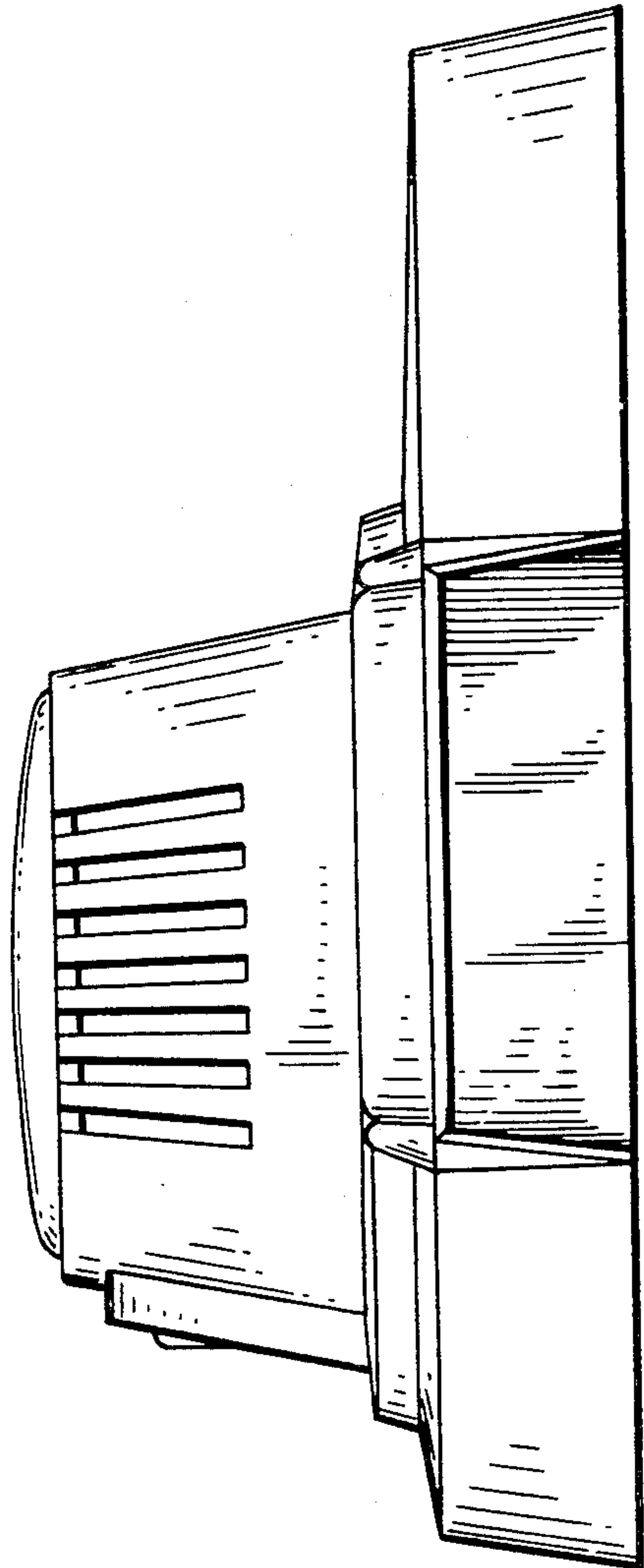

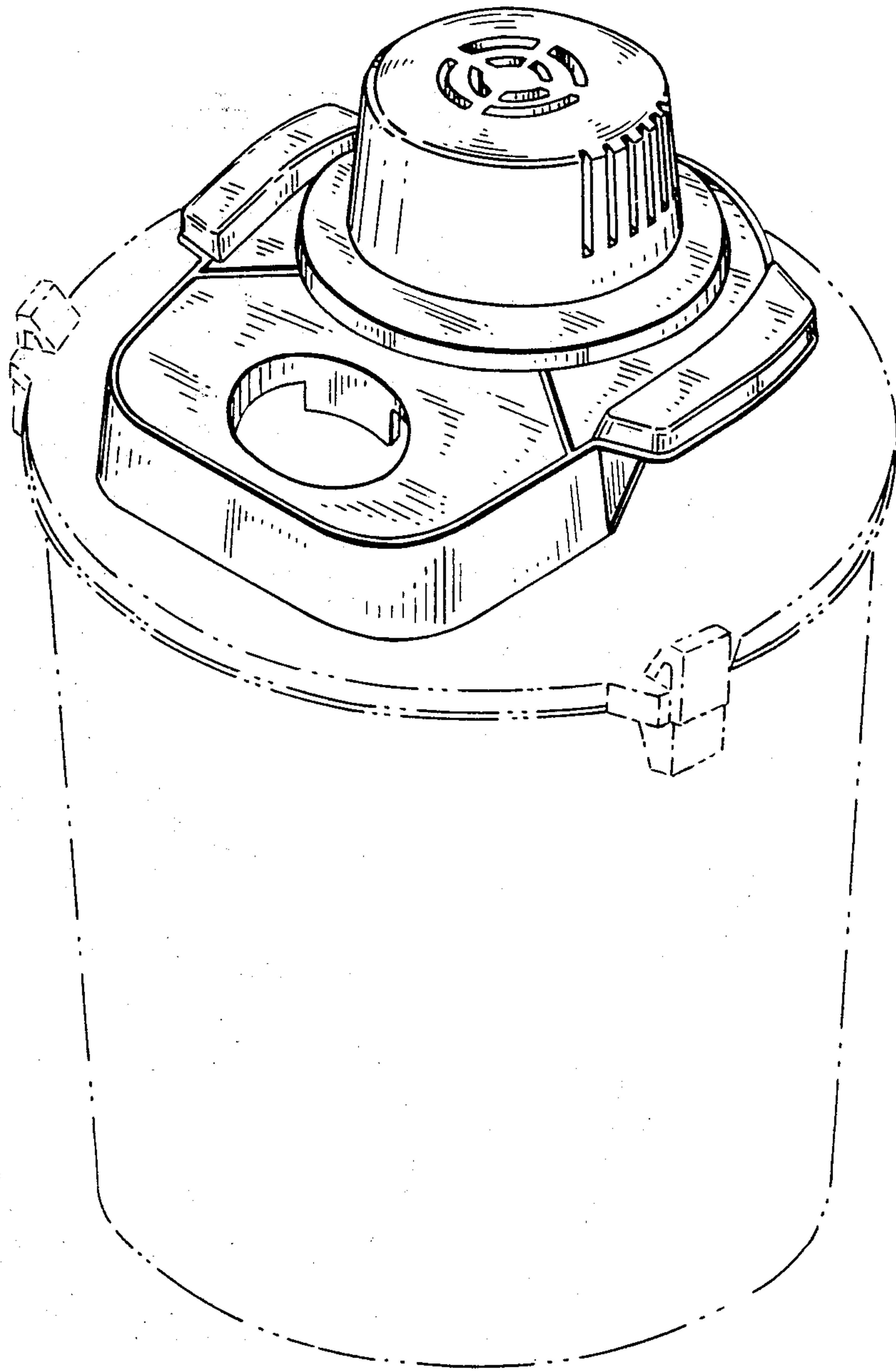
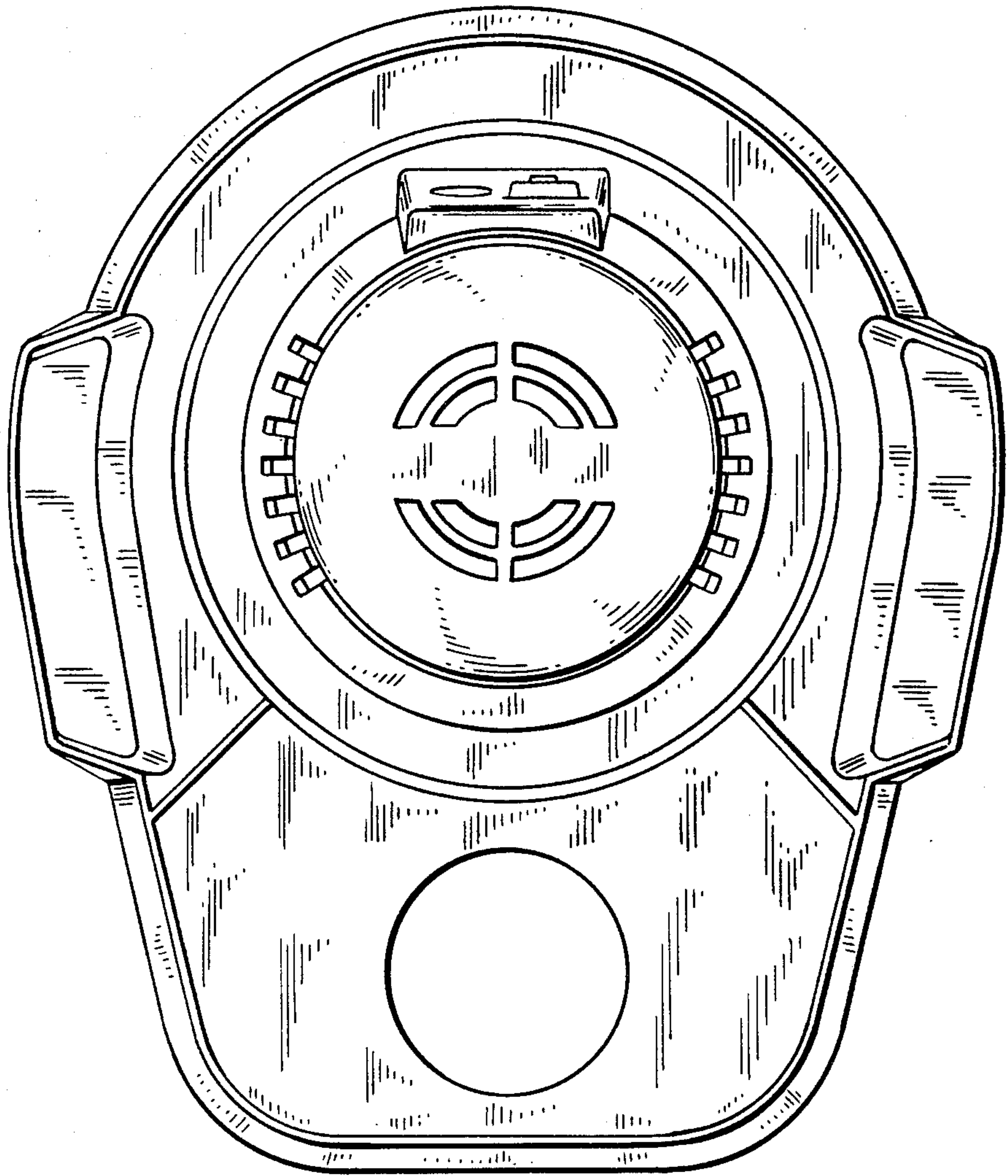

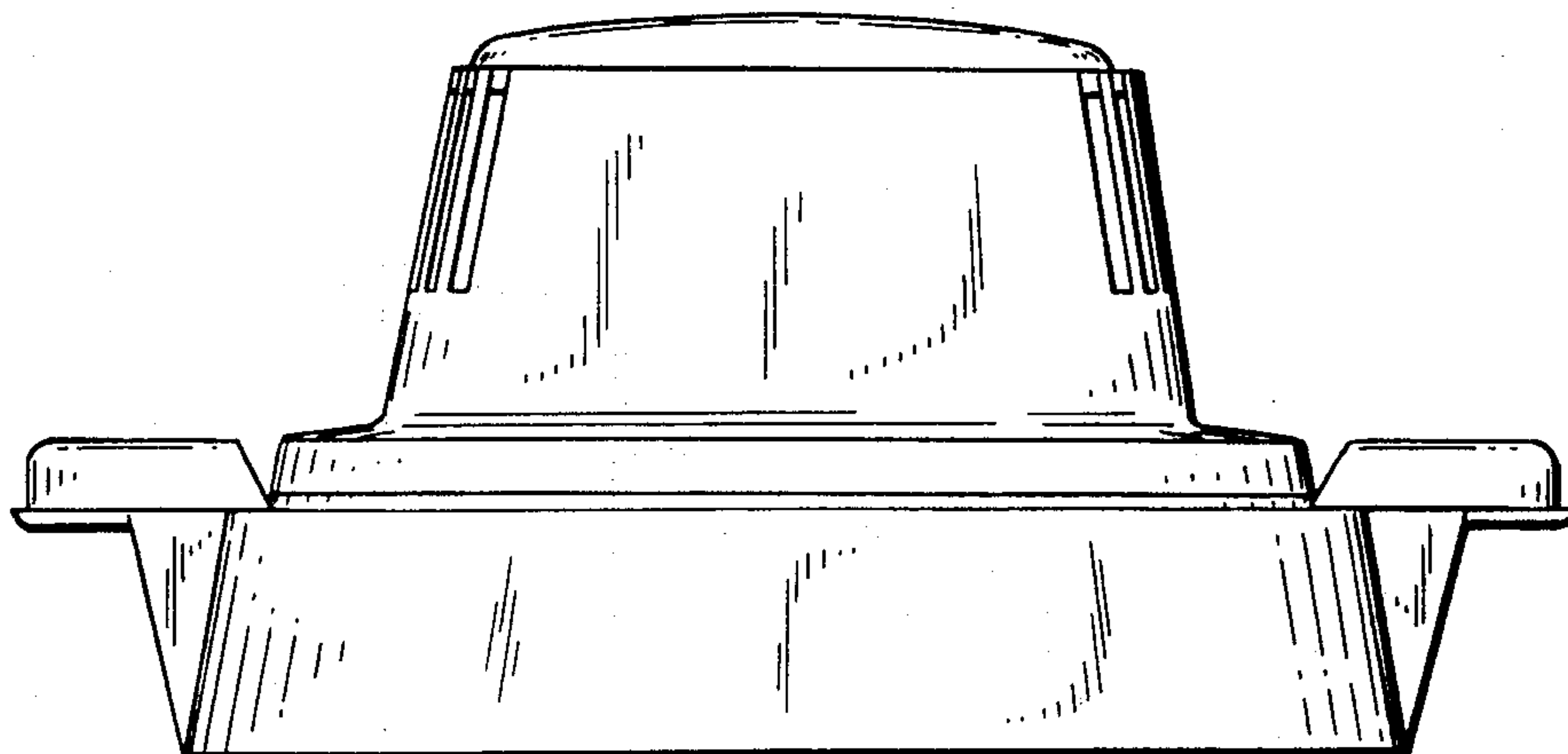

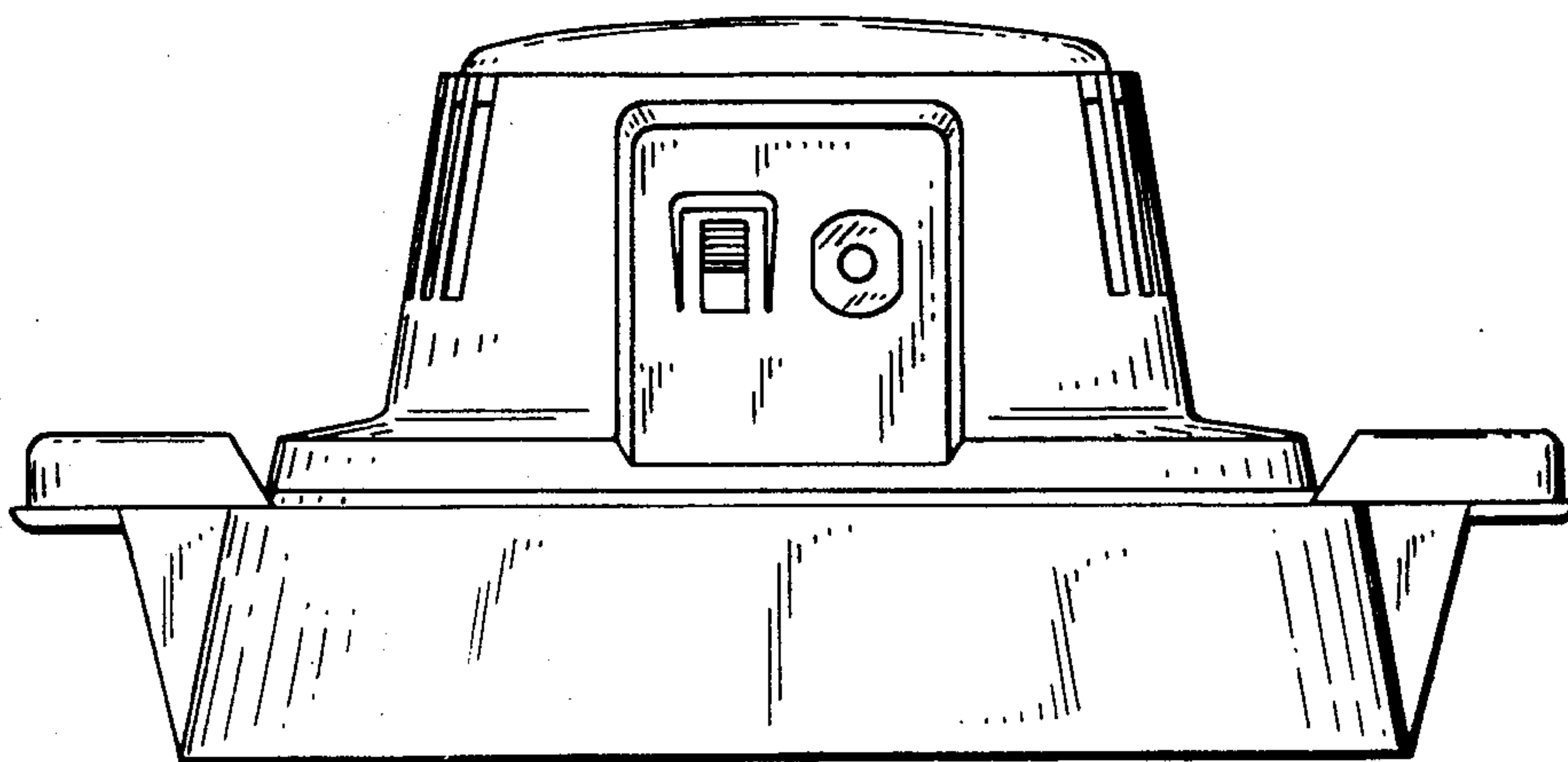

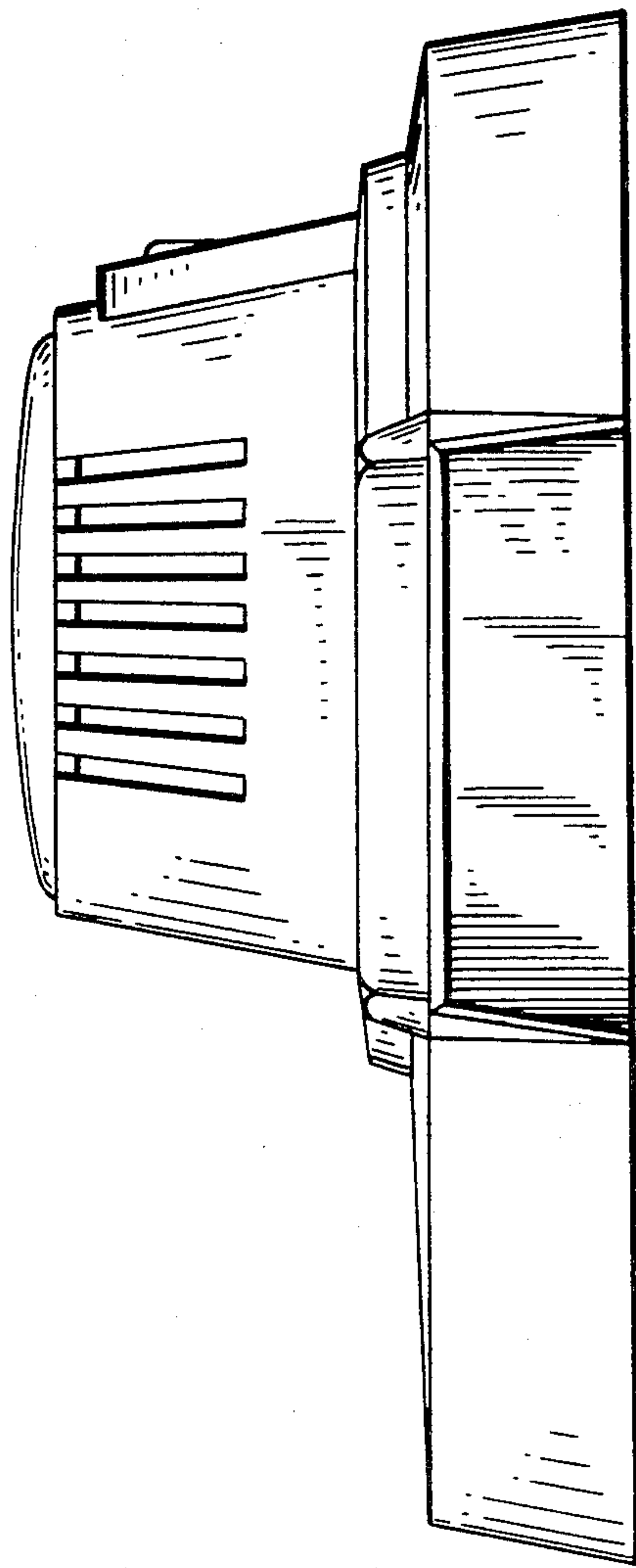

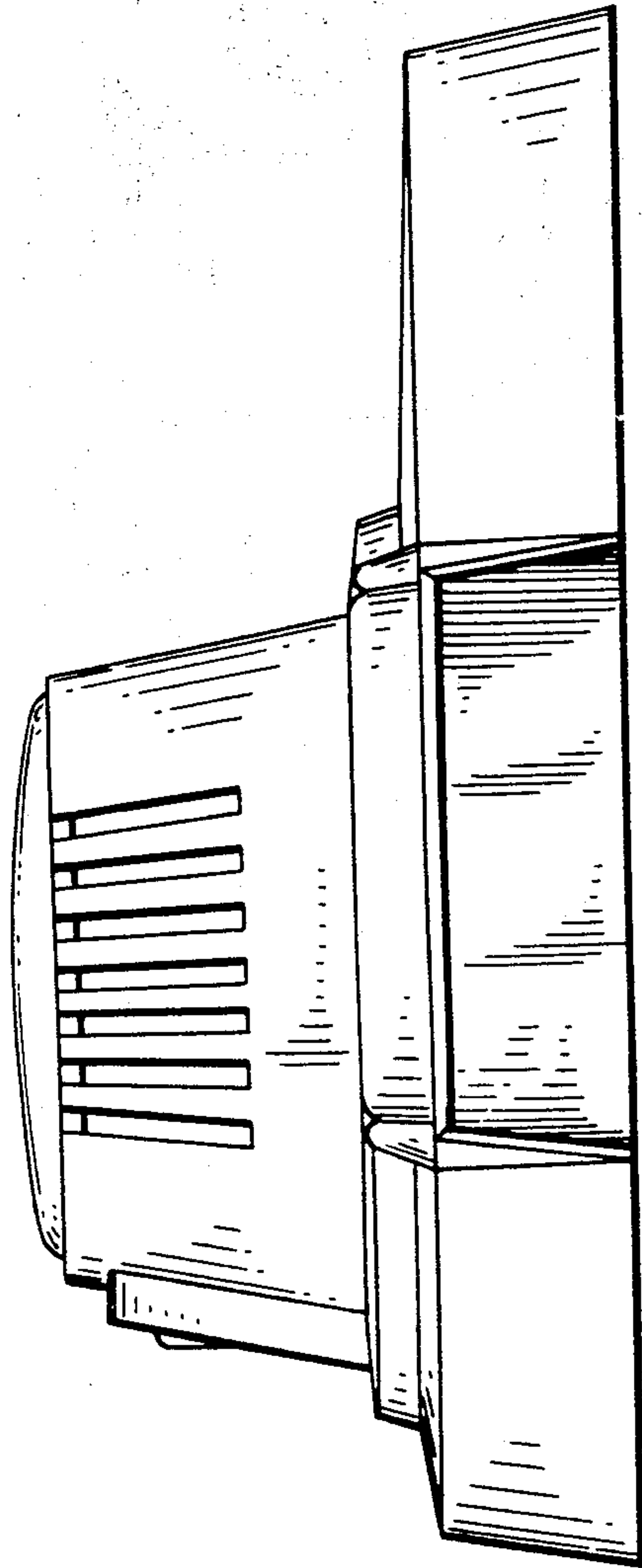

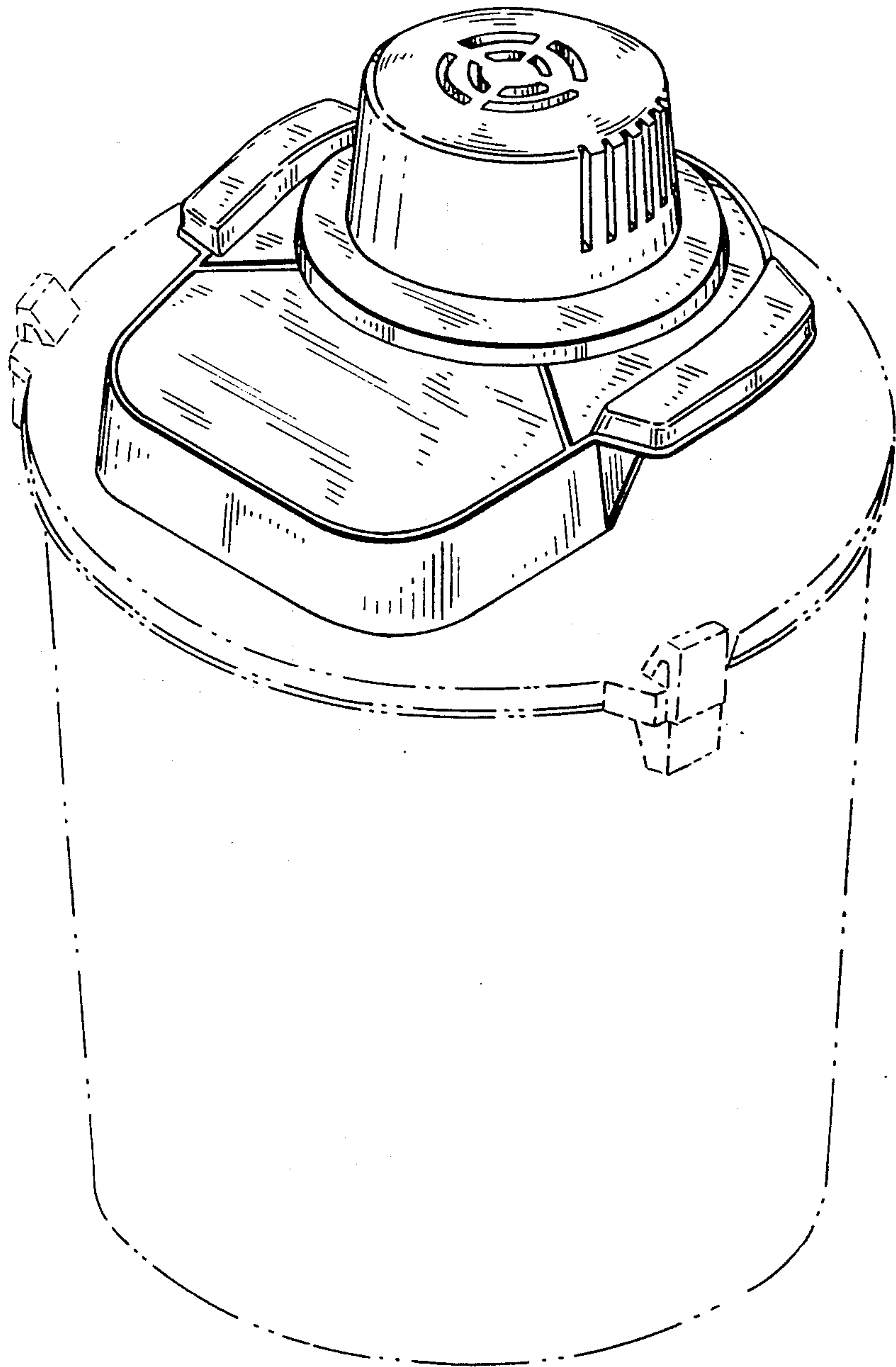
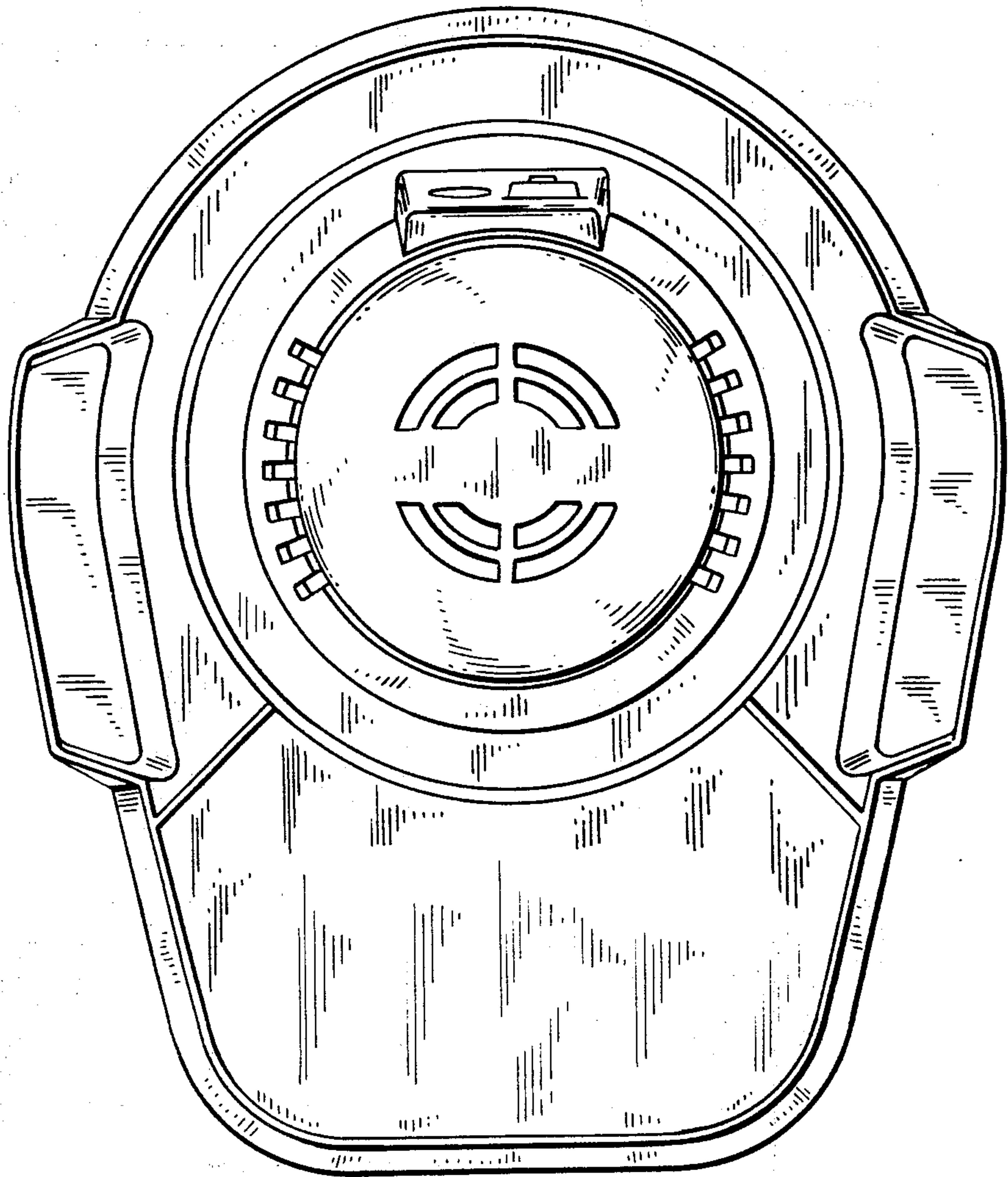

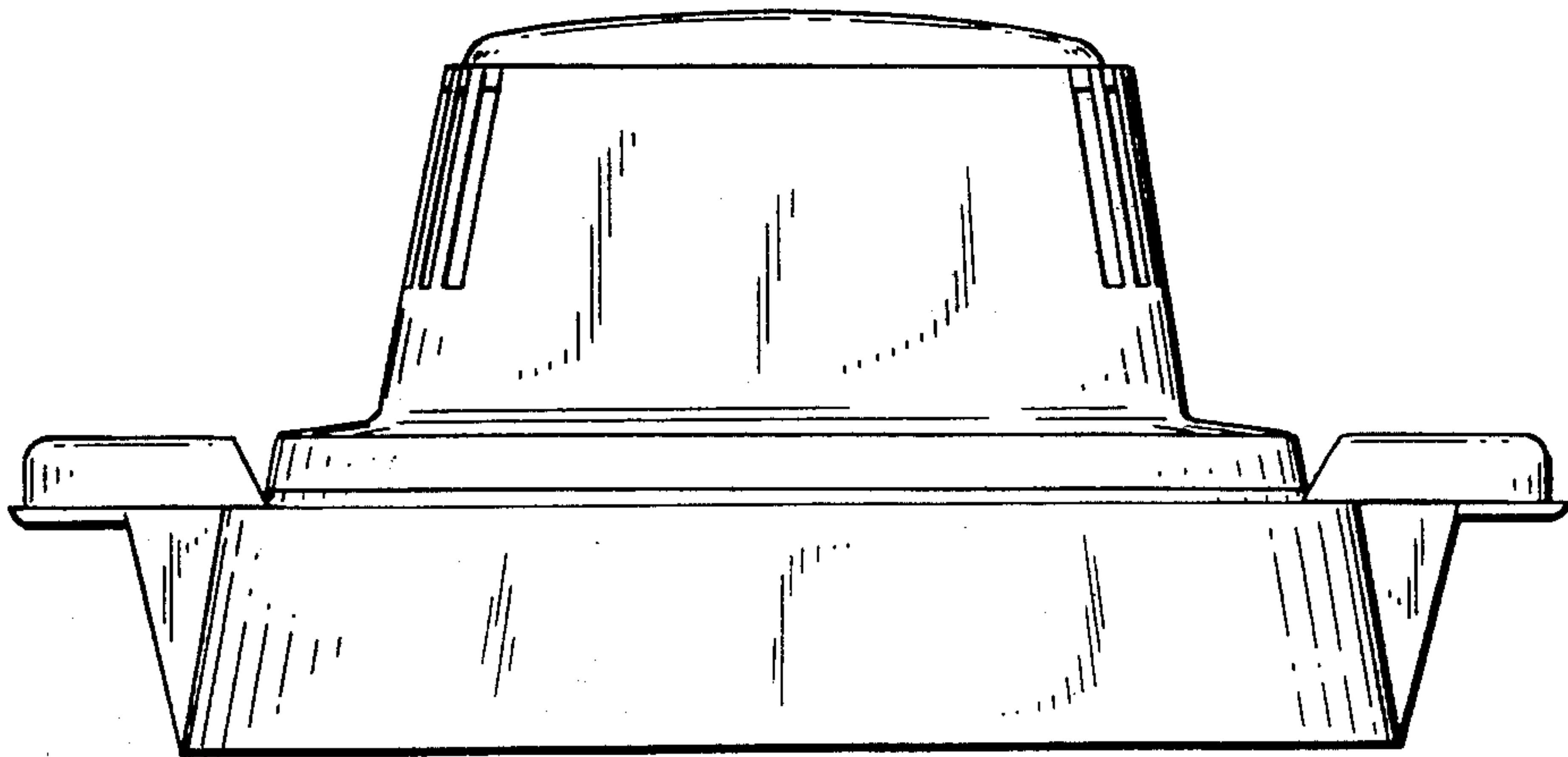

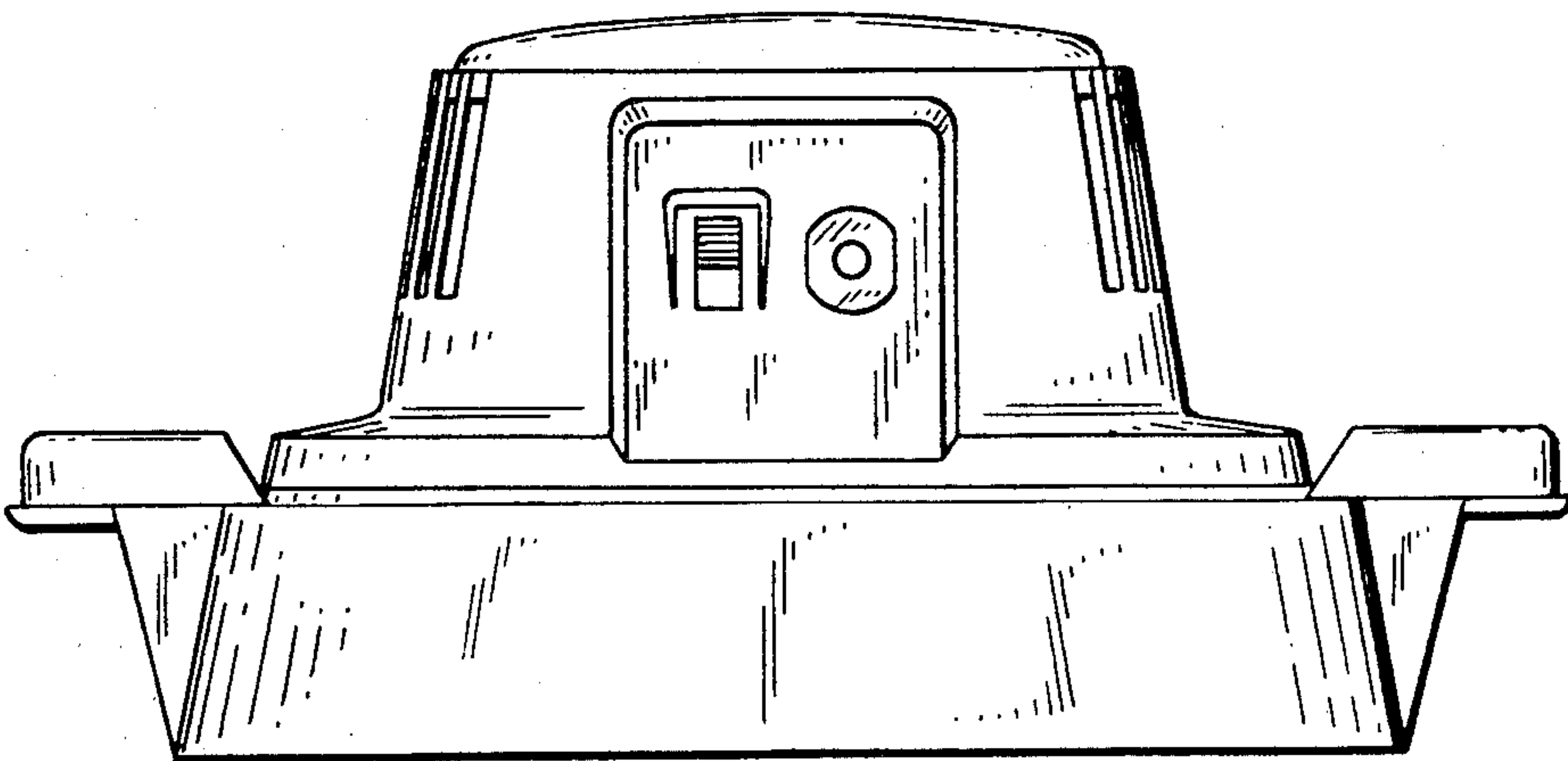

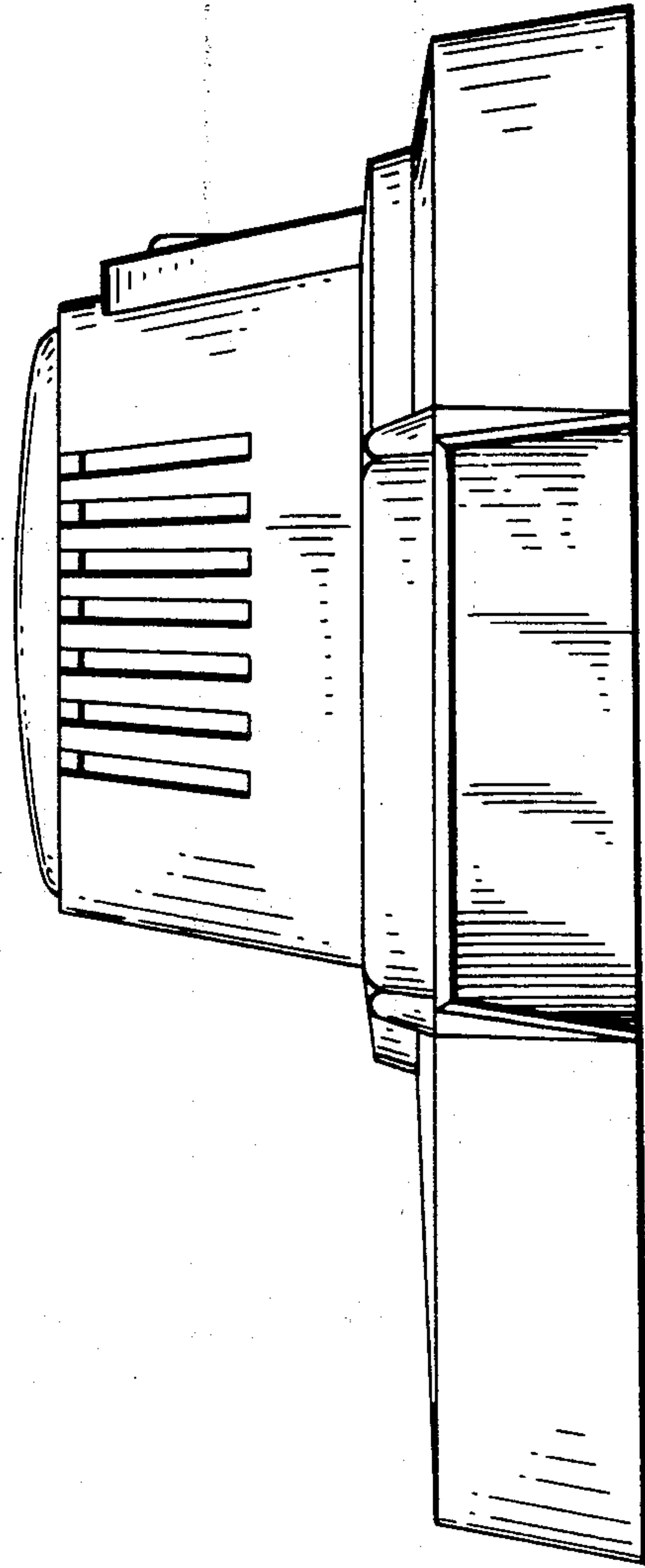

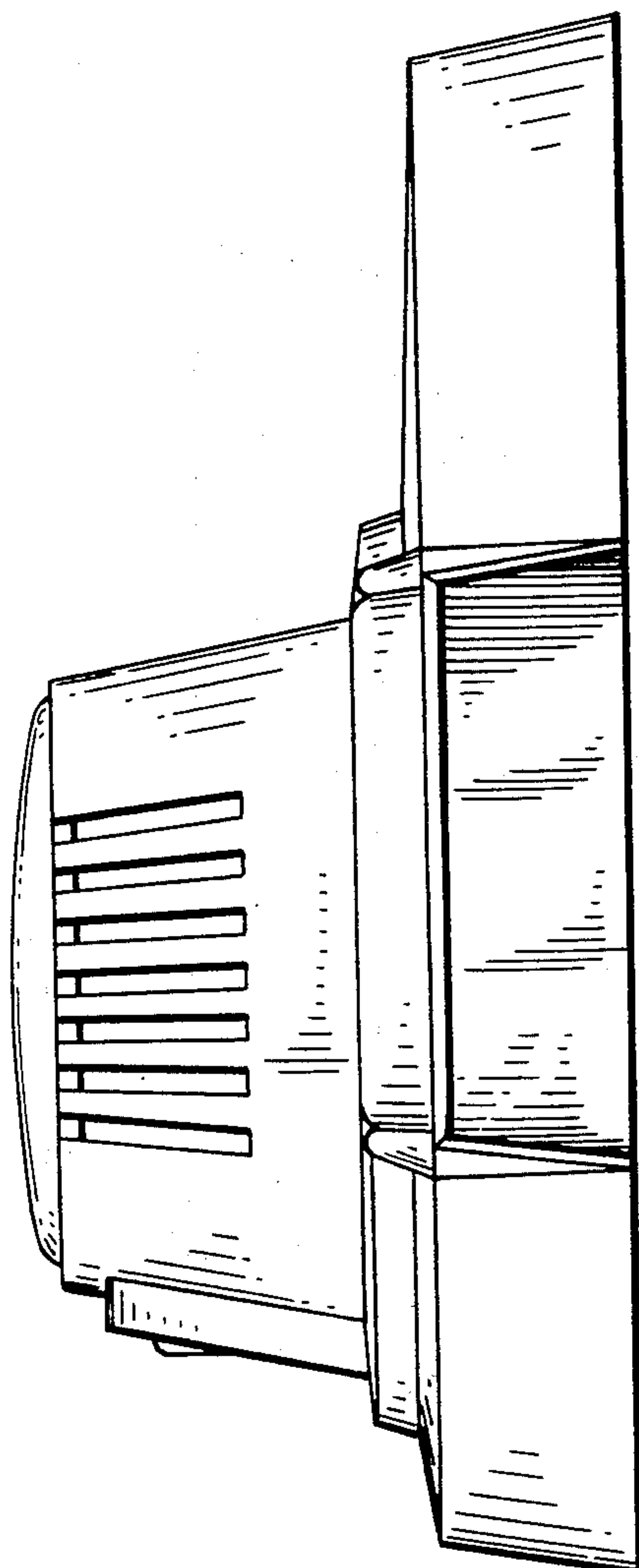
