DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a left side elevational view of an athletic shoe sole showing my new design, the broken line showing of a shoe is environmental only and forms no part of the claimed design;

FIG. 2 is a bottom plan view thereof;

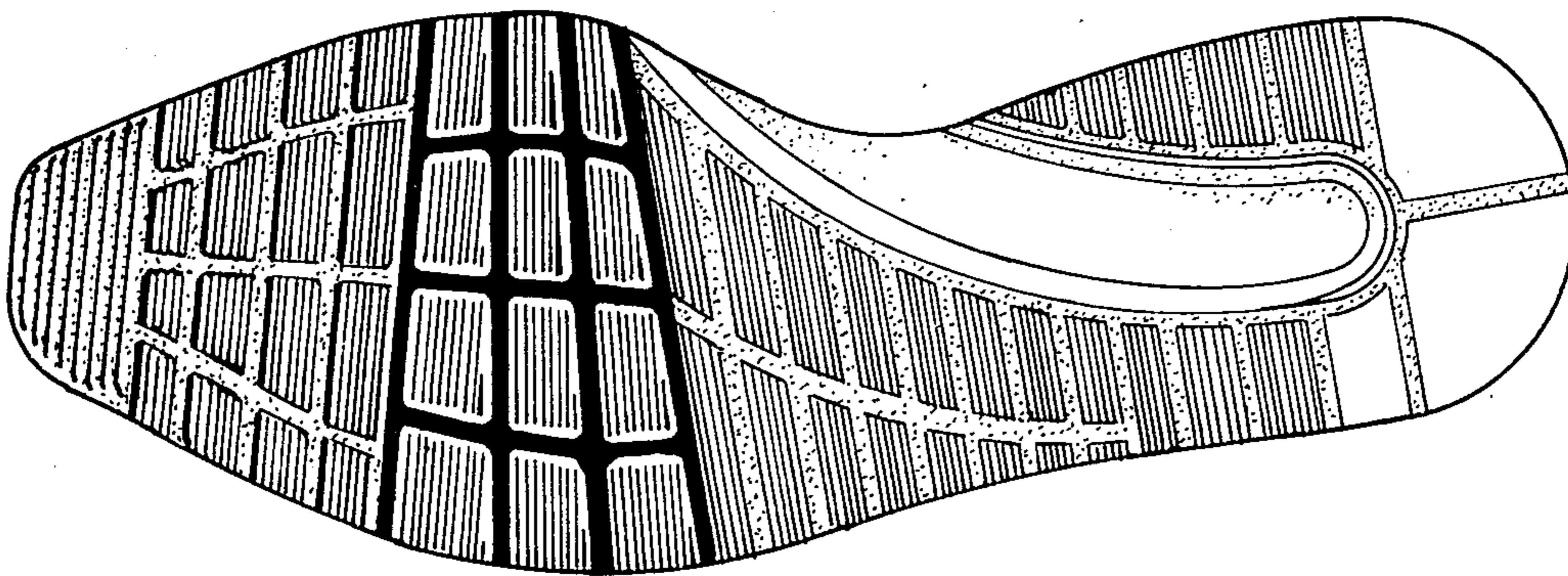
FIG. 3 is an inverted left side elevational view thereof;

FIG. 7 is a rear elevational view thereof.



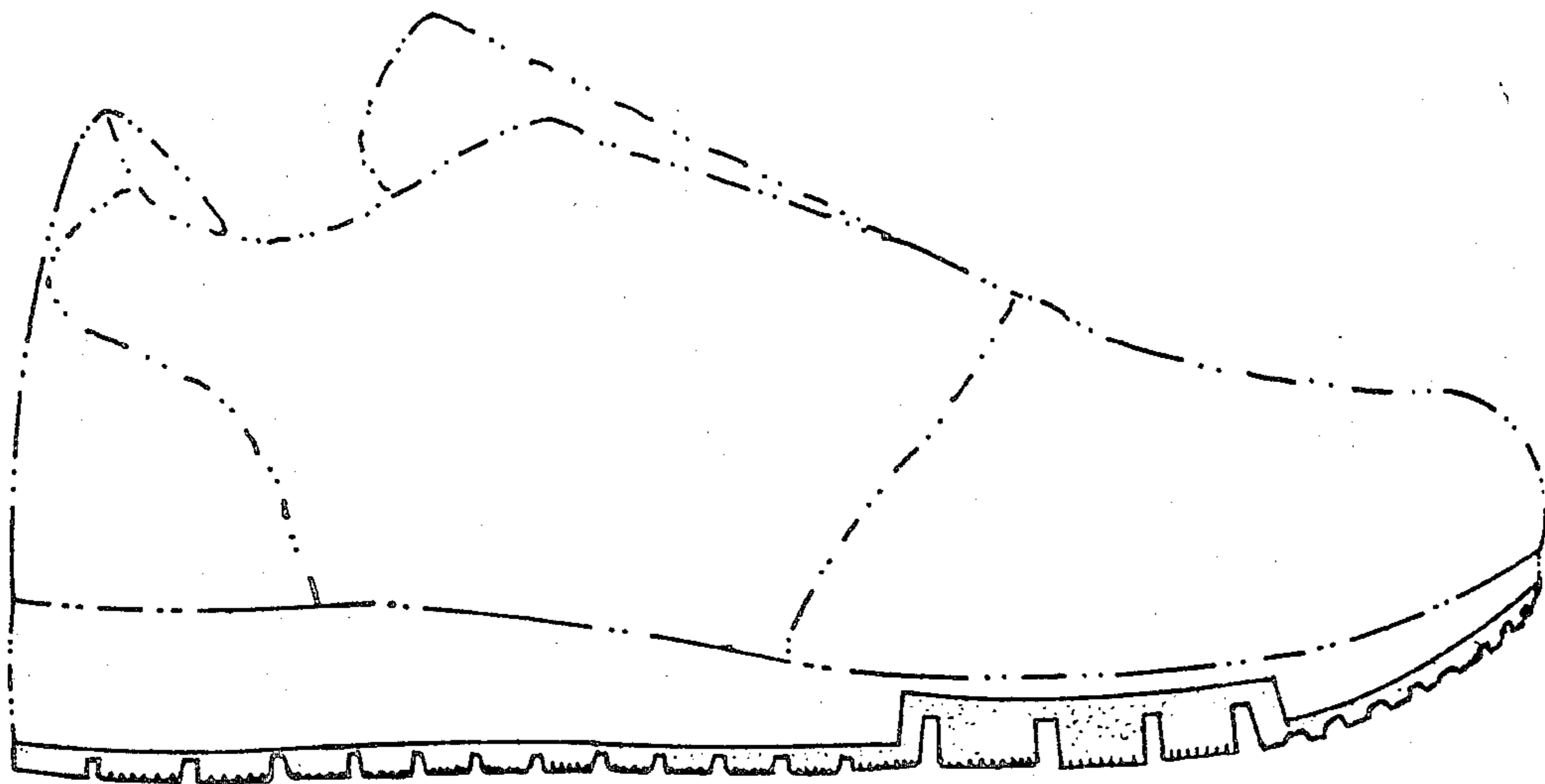

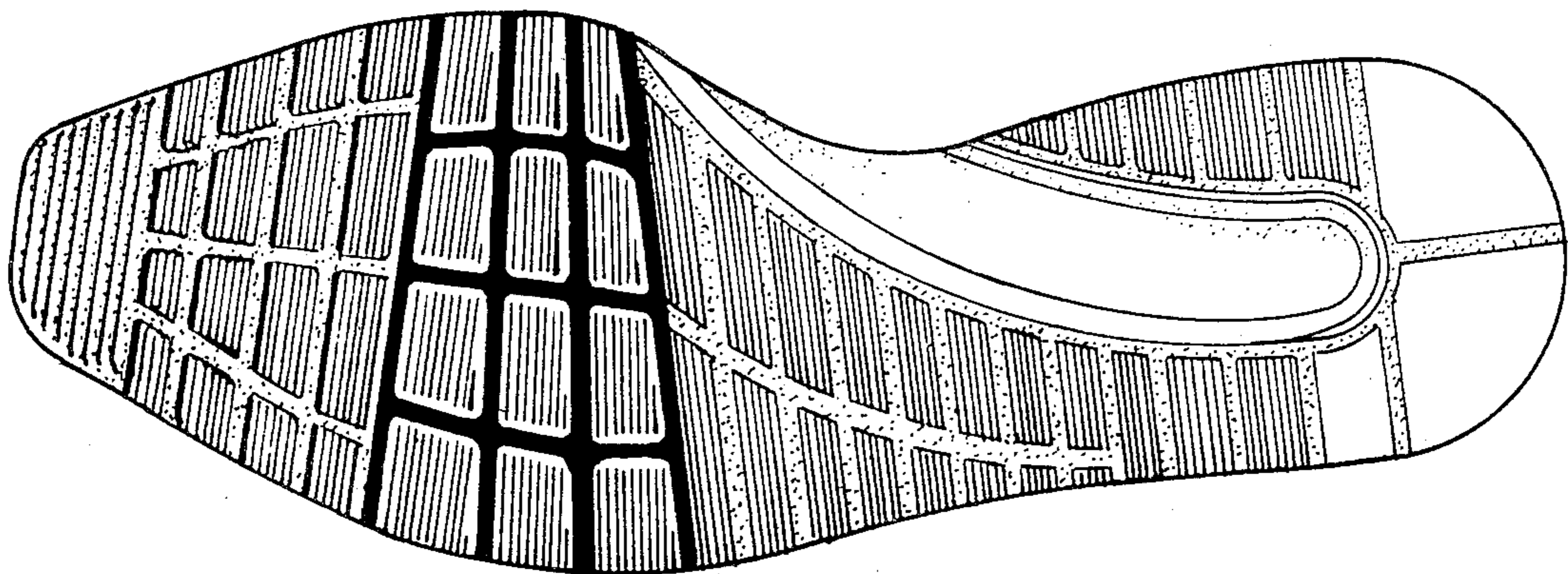

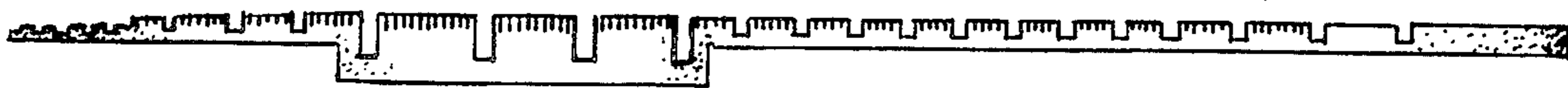

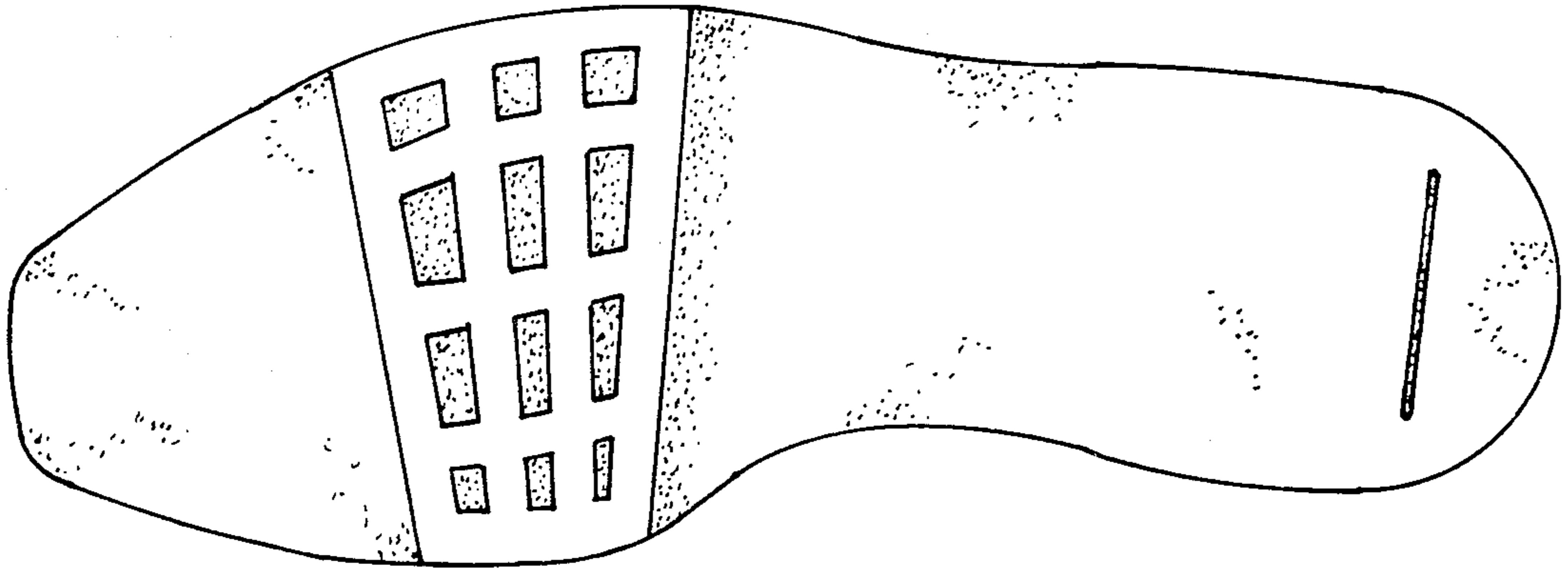

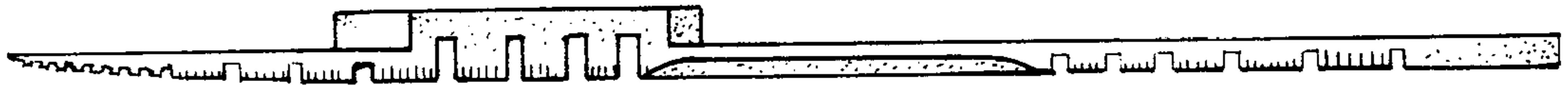

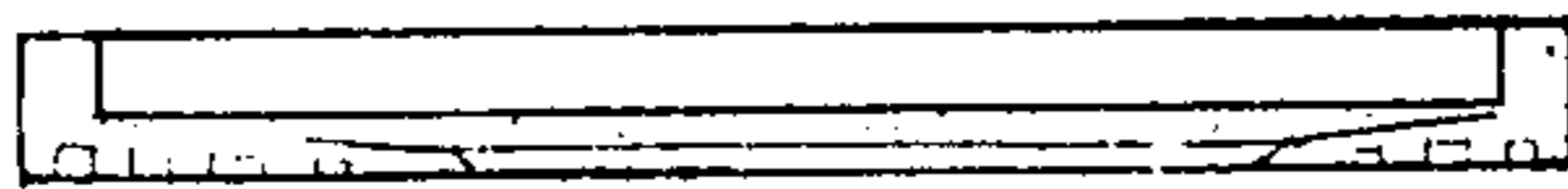
