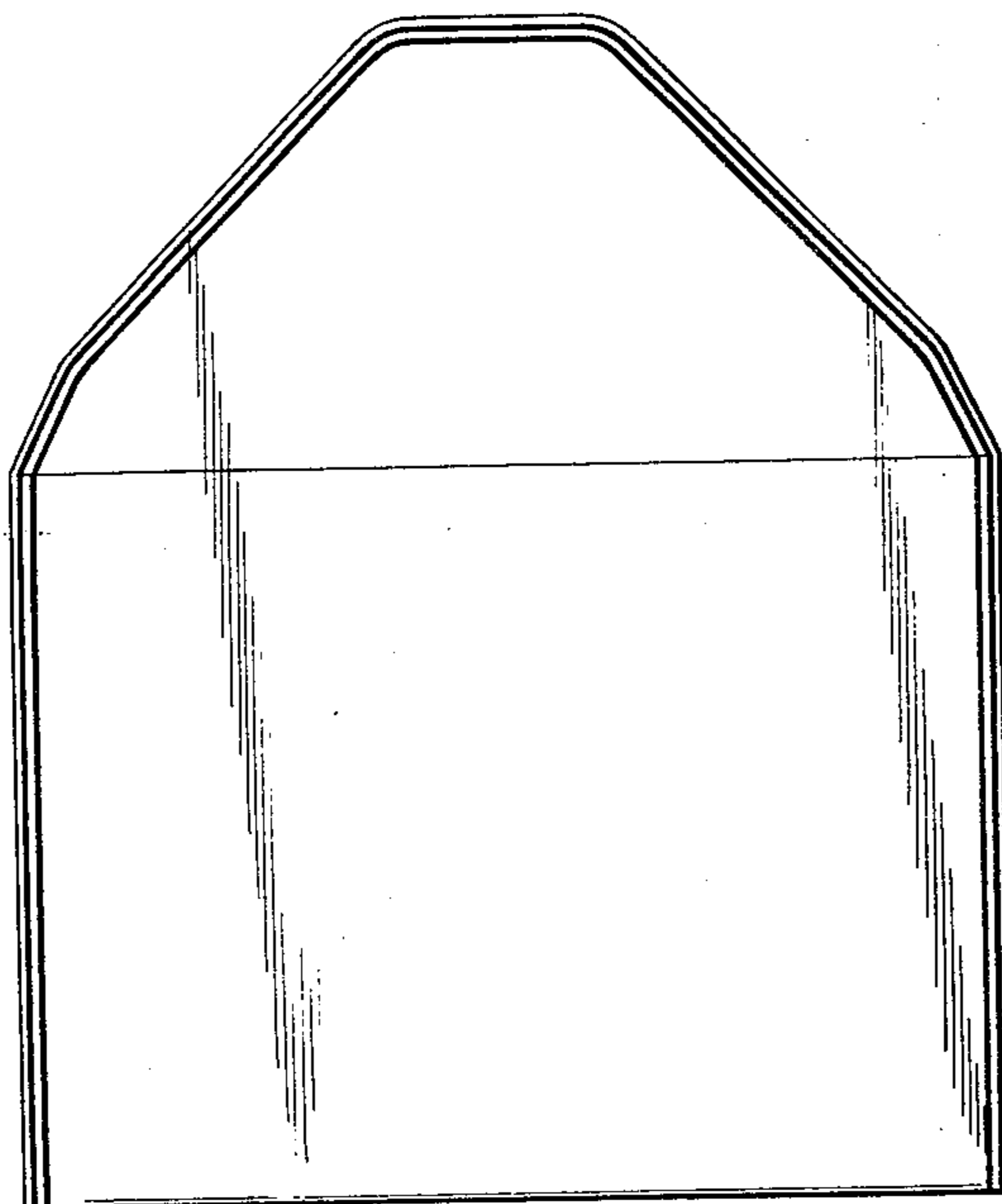

[57] **CLAIM**

The ornamental design for an envelope, as shown and described.

DESCRIPTION

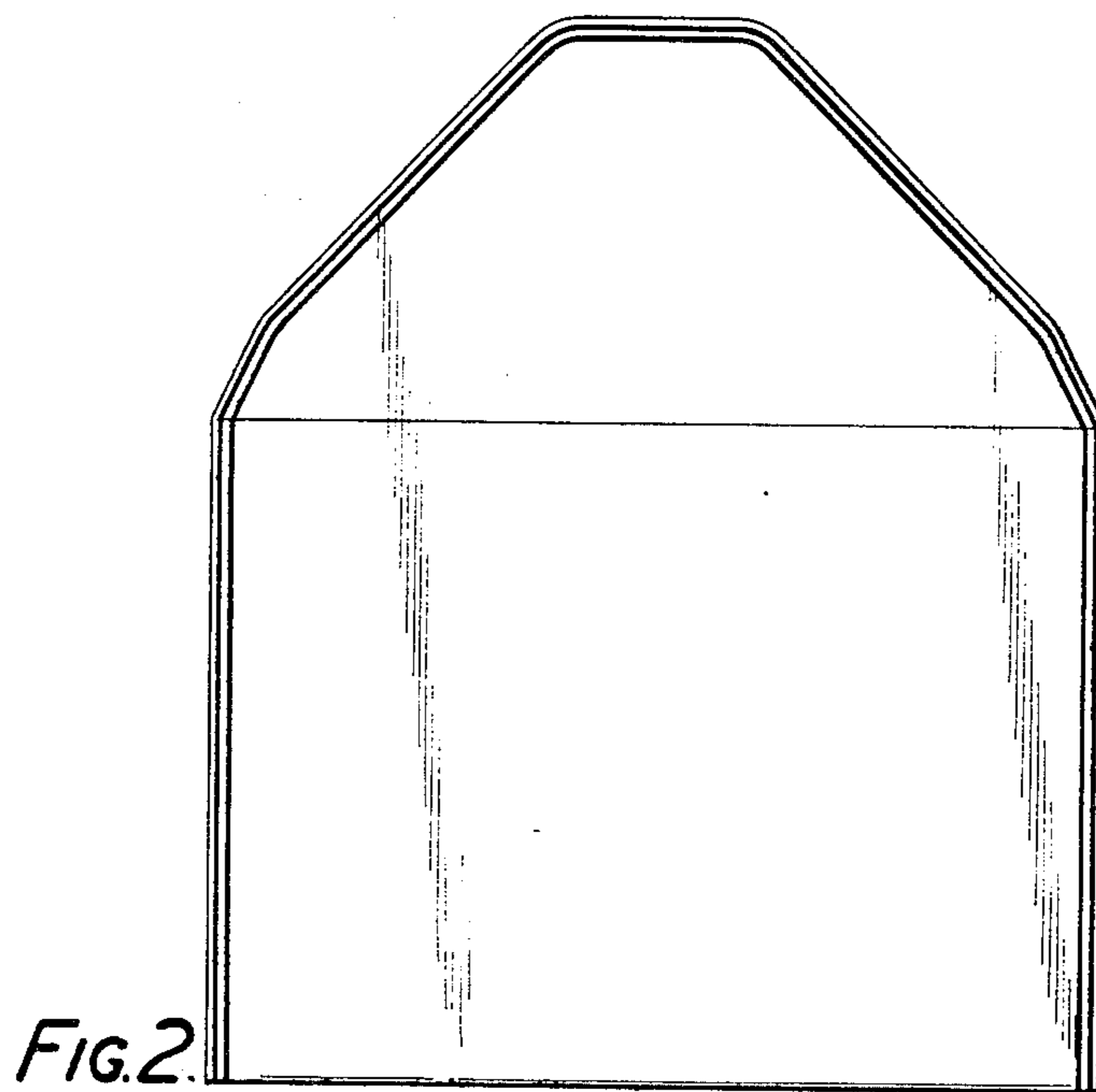
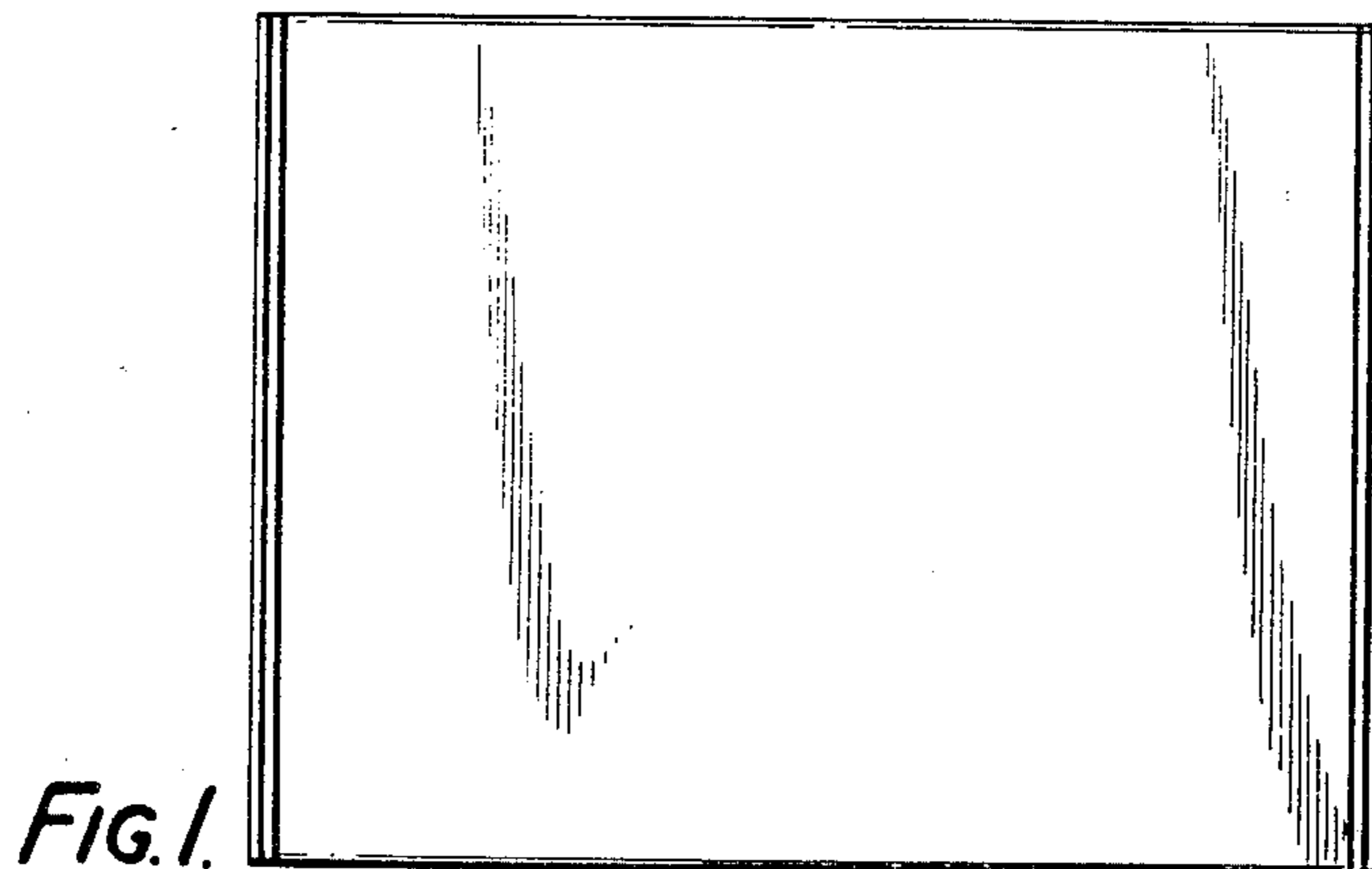


FIG. 3. _____

FIG. 1 is a front elevational view of an envelope showing my new design, with the flap in a closed position; FIG. 2 is a front elevational view thereof, with the flap in an open position; FIG. 3 is a top plan view thereof, the bottom plan view being a mirror image thereof; FIG. 4 is a rear elevational view thereof, with the flap in a closed position; and FIG. 5 is a rear elevational view thereof, with the flap in an open position.

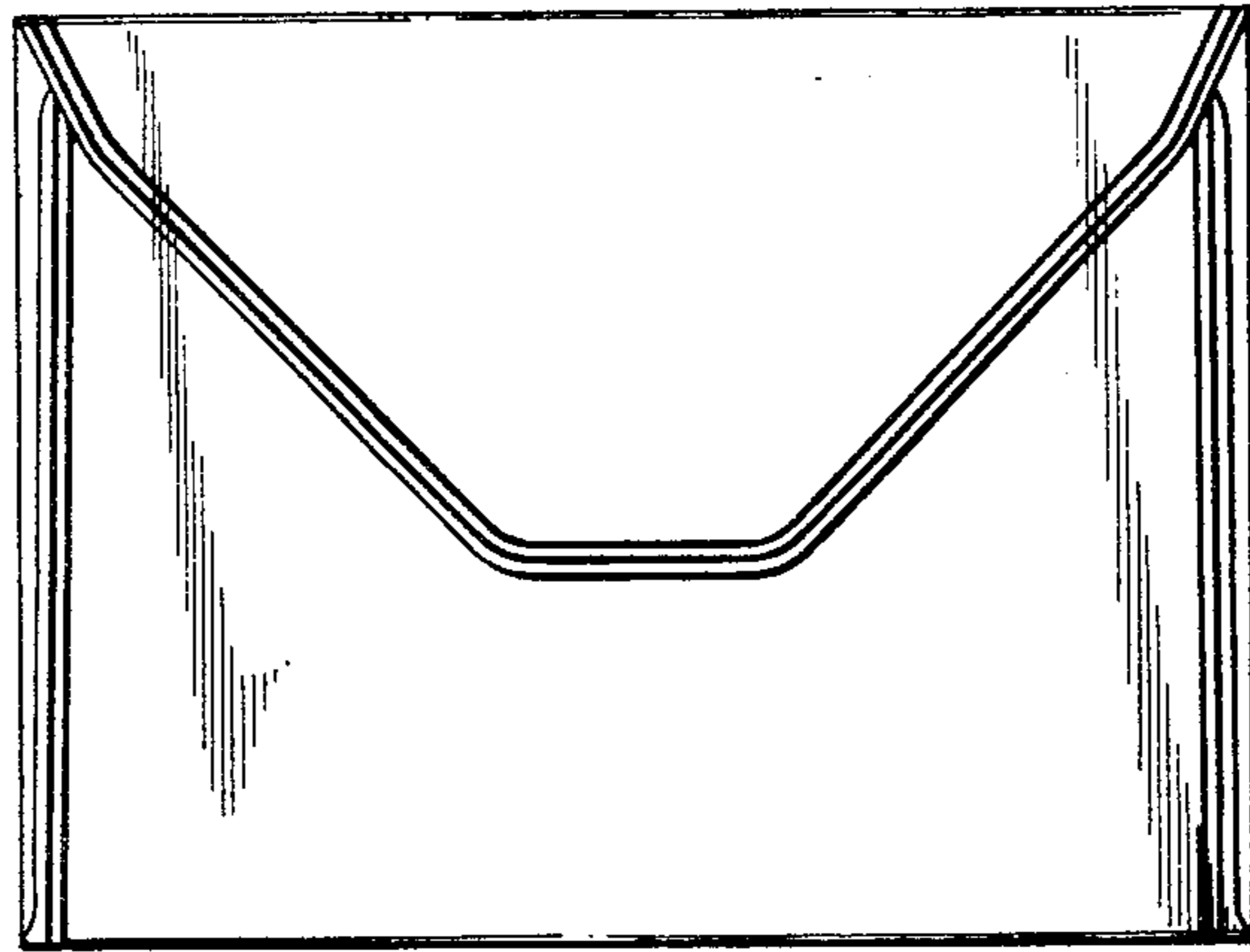

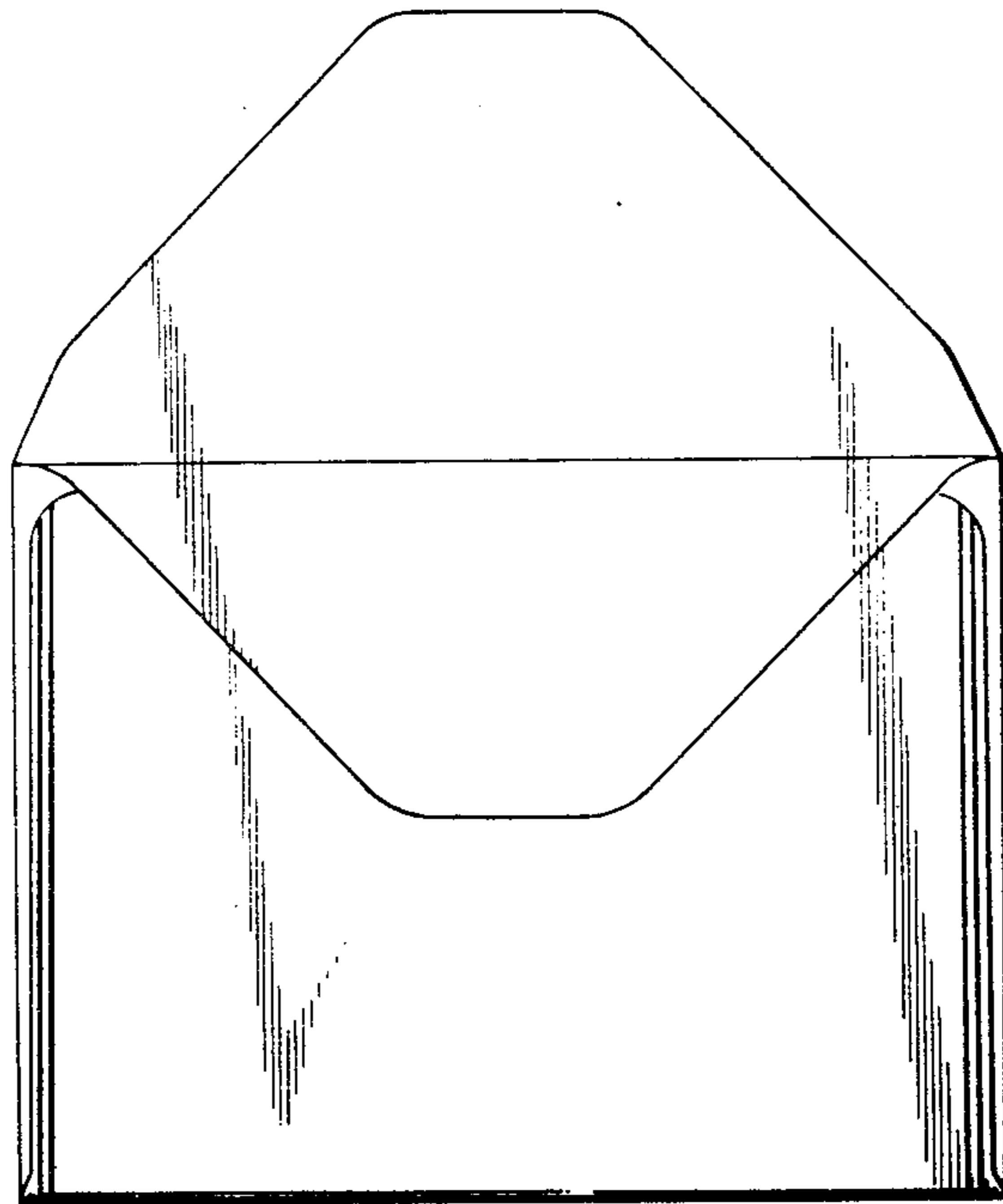
