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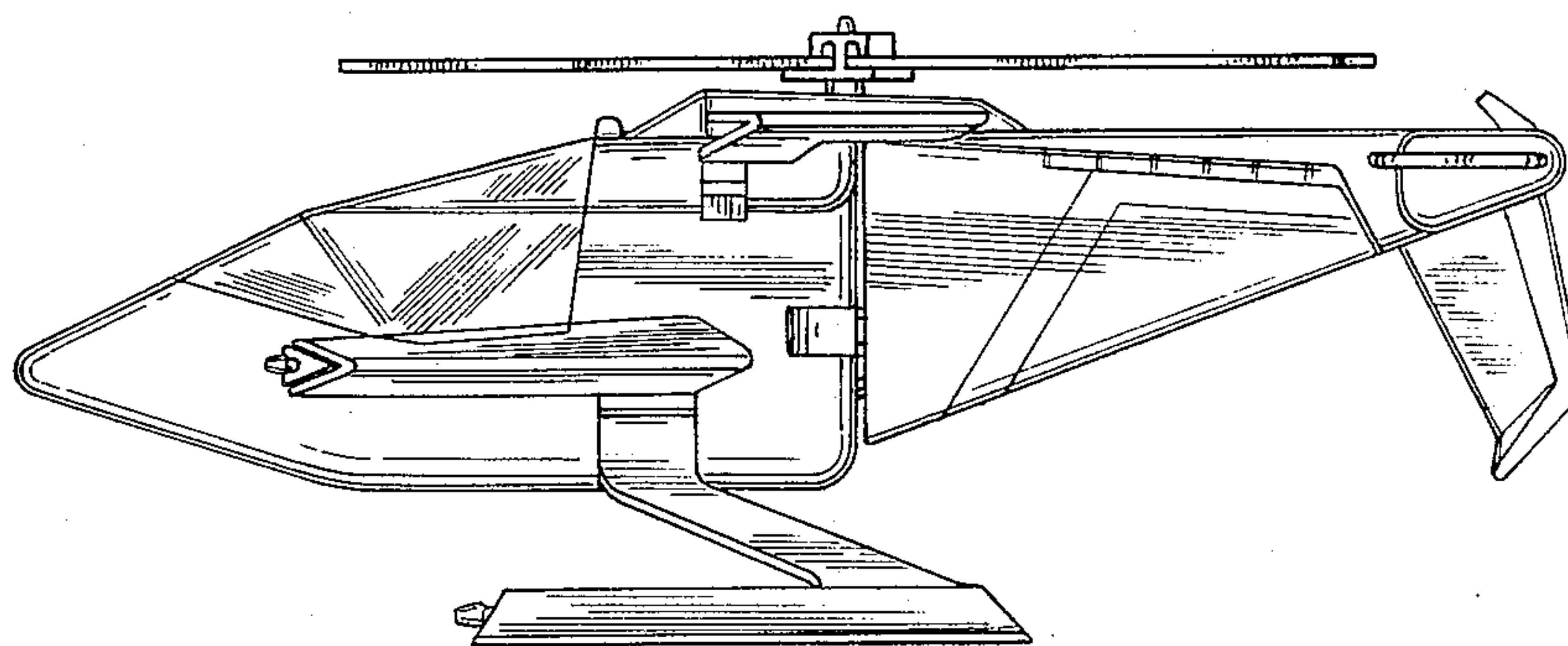

DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a side elevational view of a toy helicopter showing our new design, the side opposite being substantially a mirror image thereof;

FIG. 5 is a rear elevational view thereof.



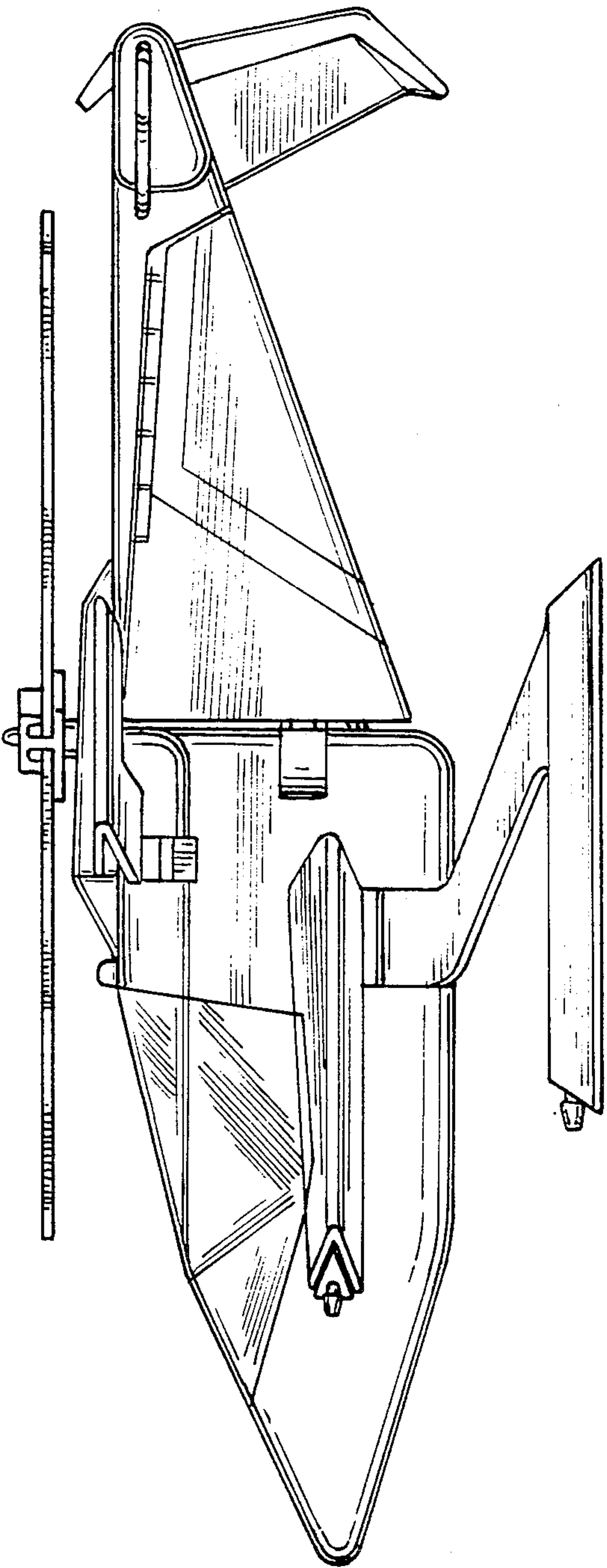

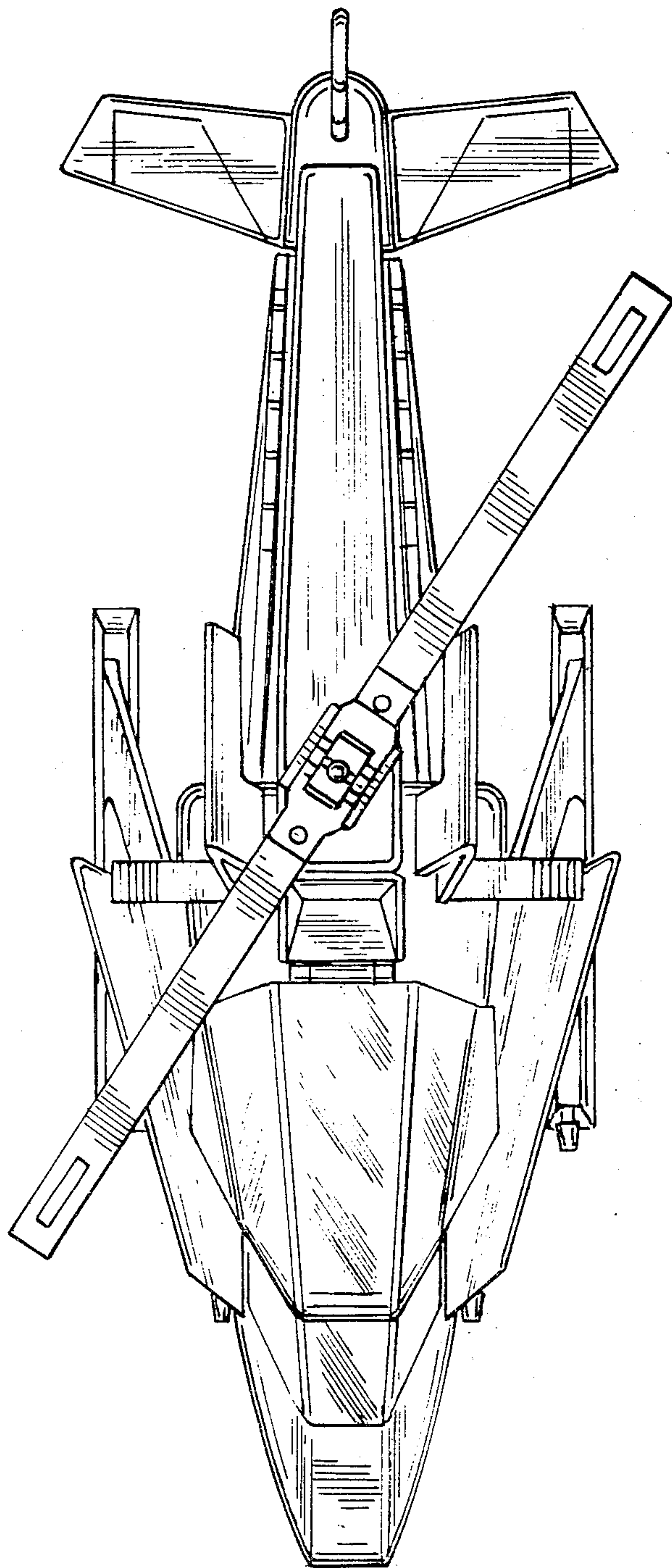

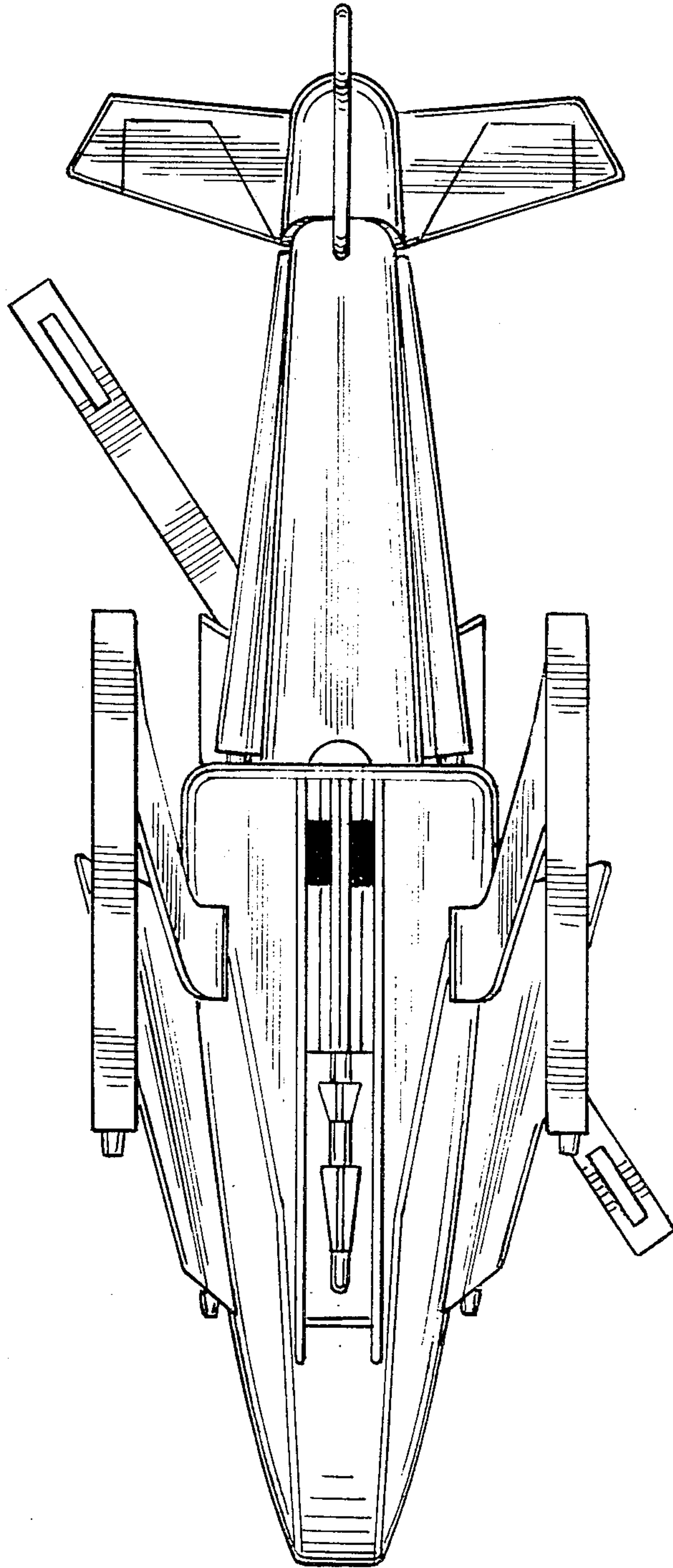

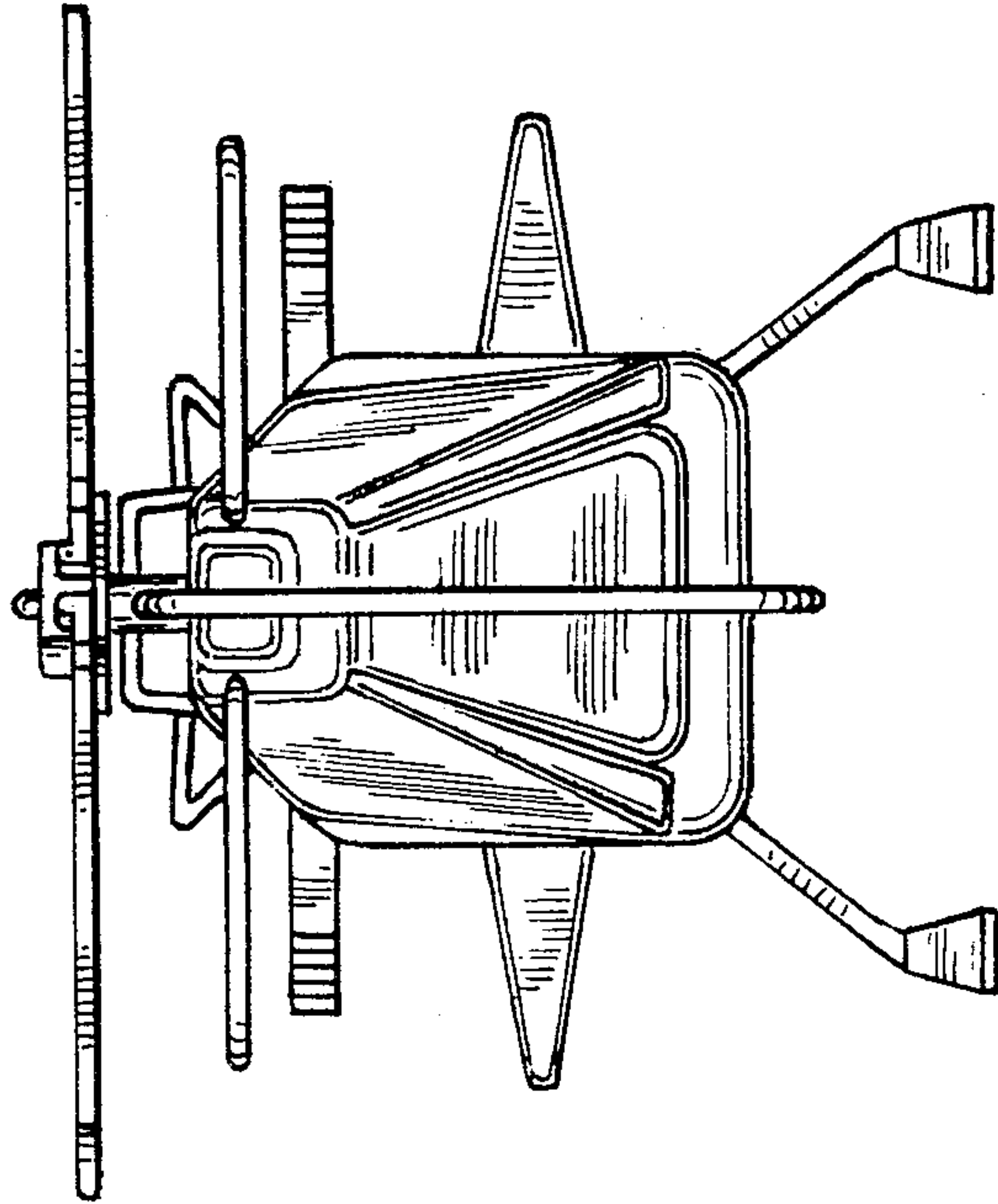

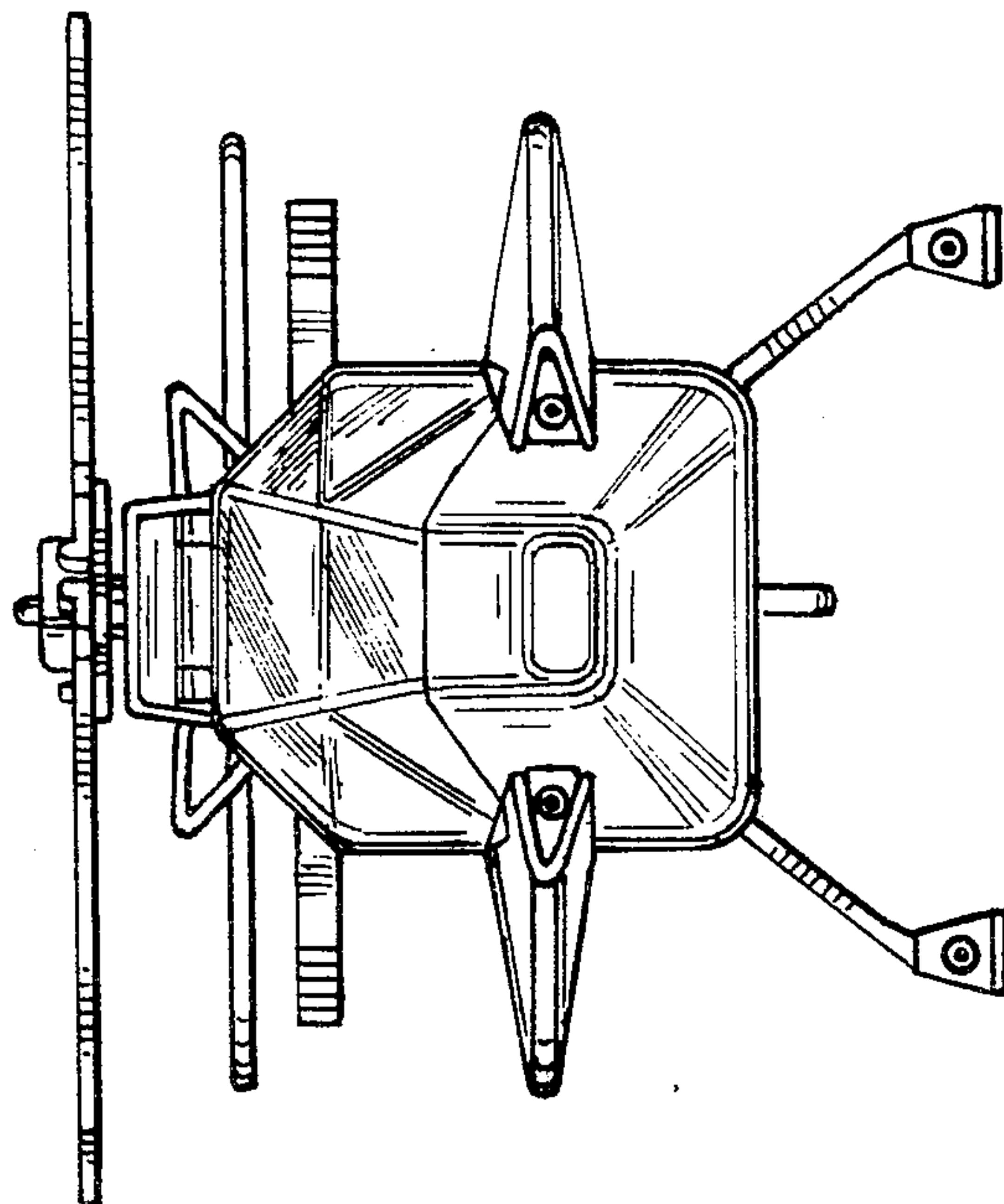
