FIG. 1 is a side elevational view of a hearing aid showing my new design;

FIG. 5 is a bottom plan view thereof.

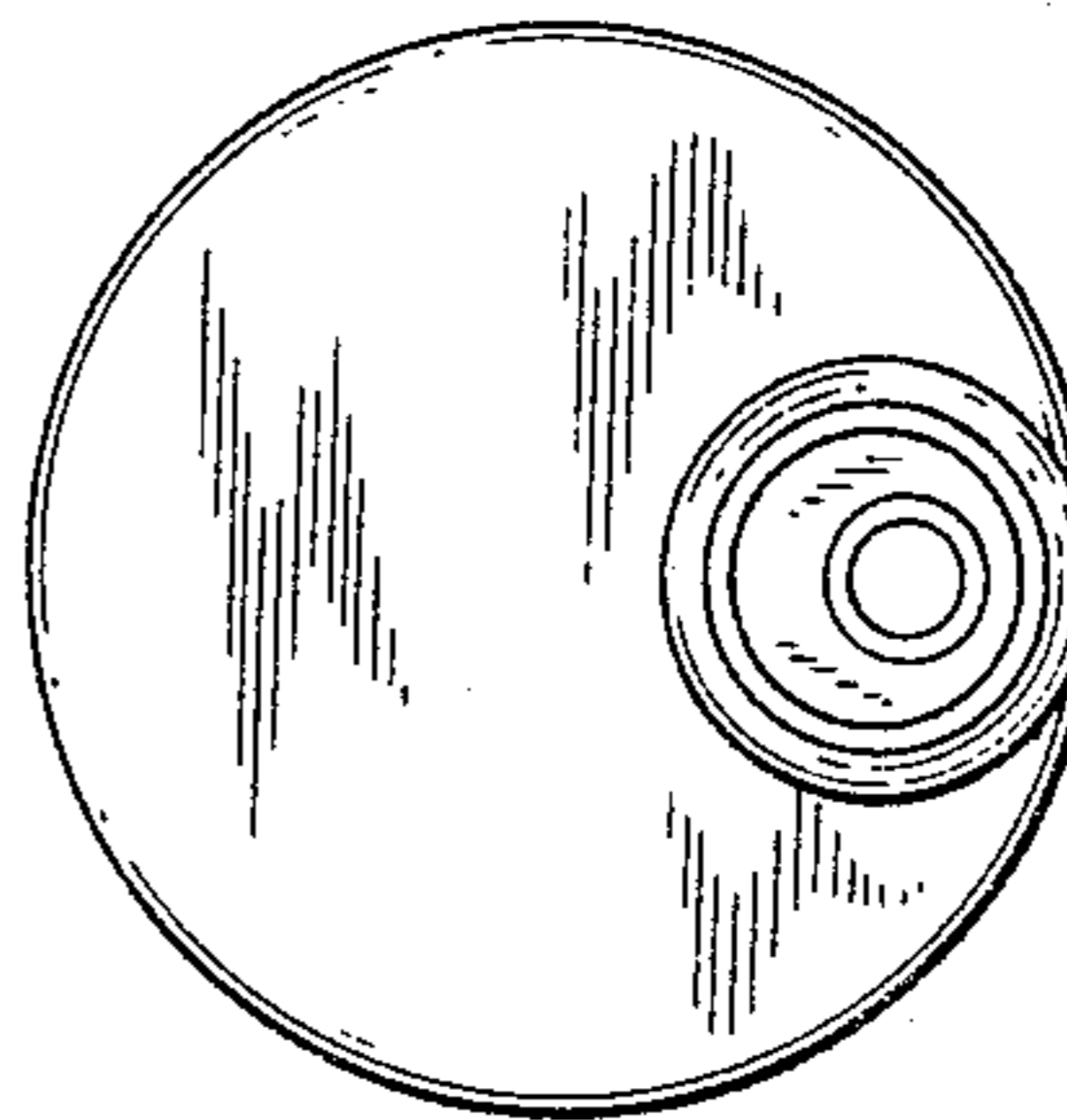
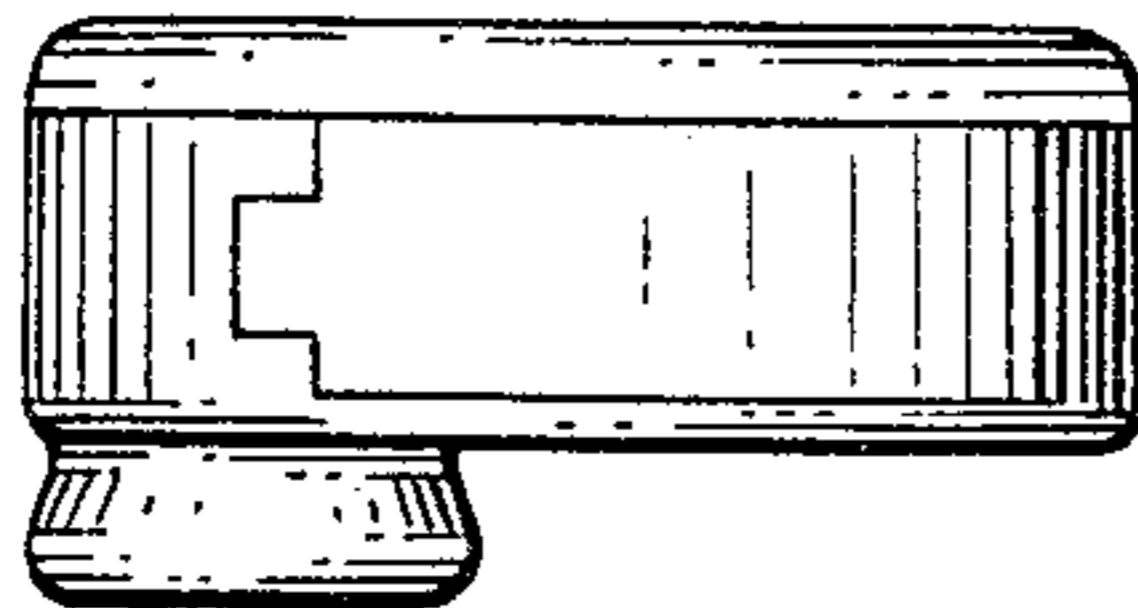

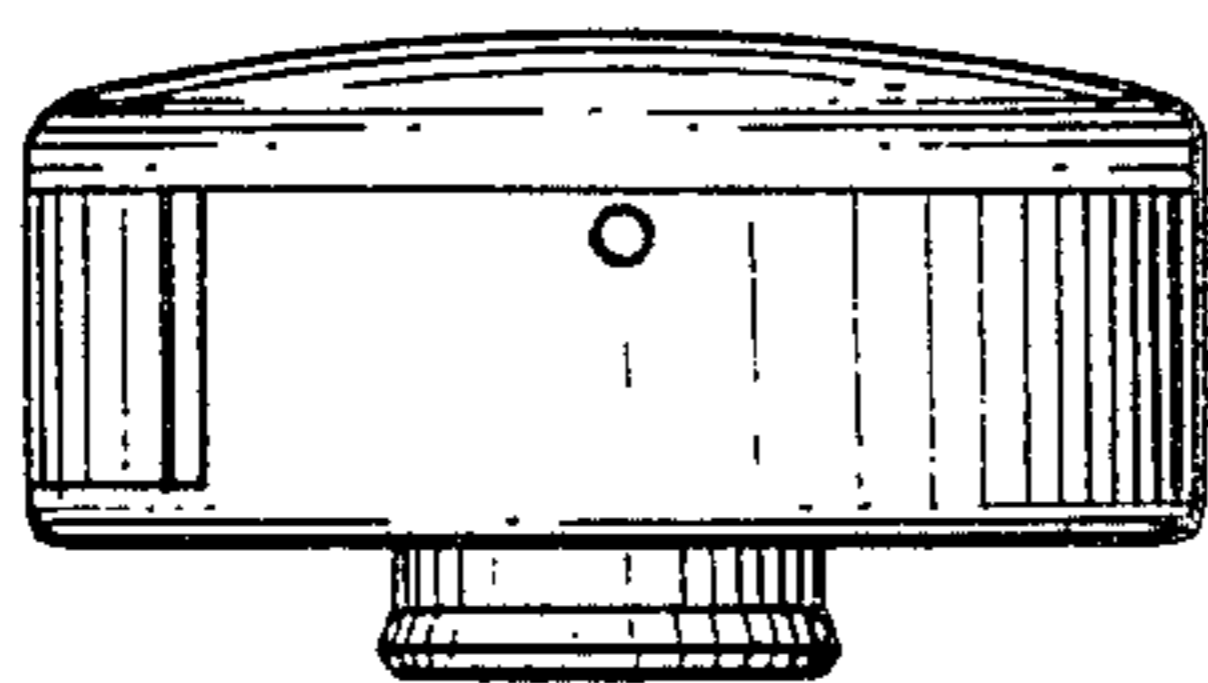

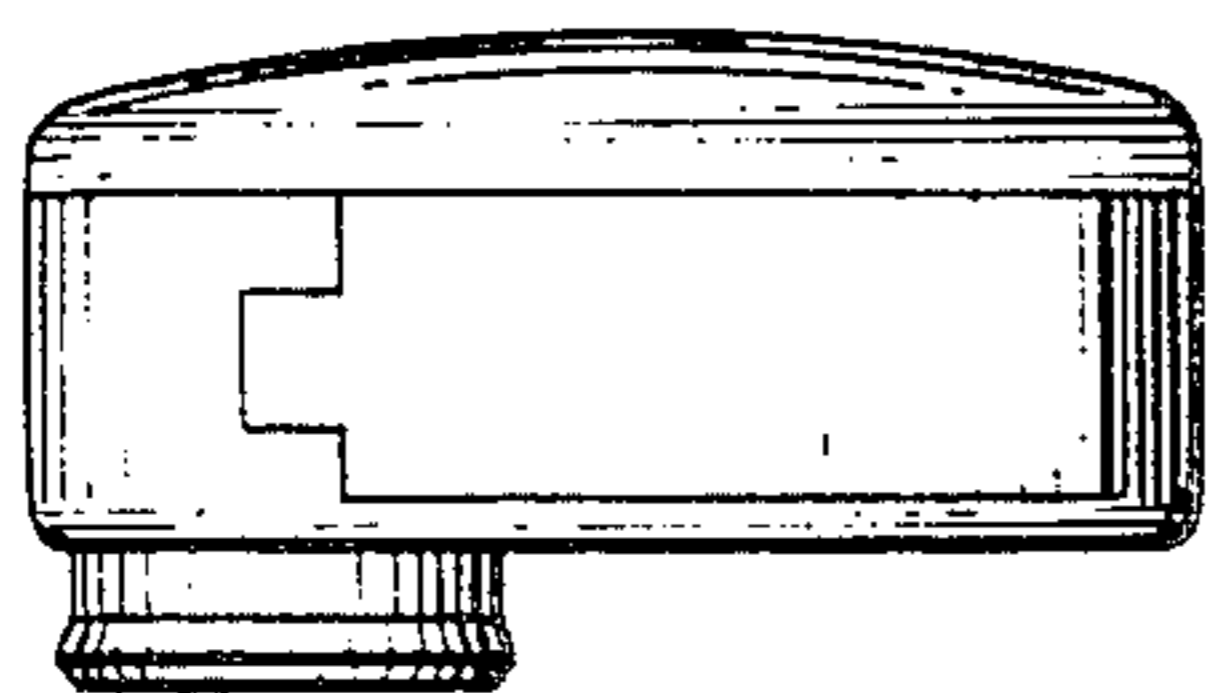

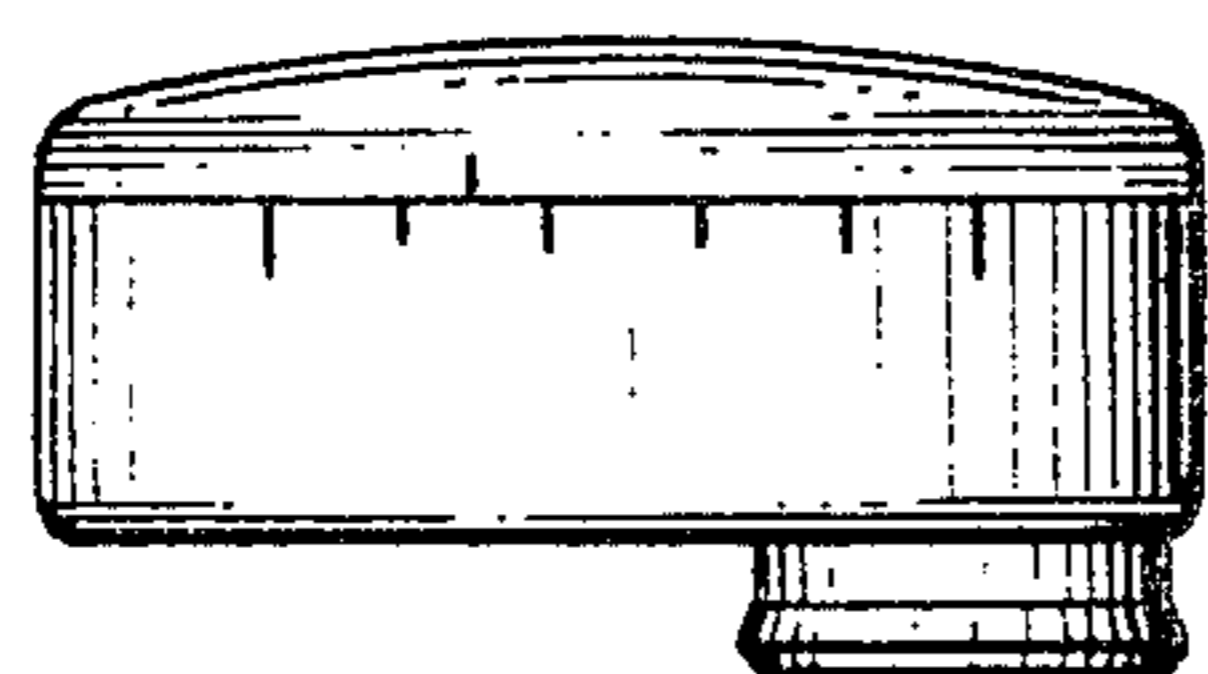

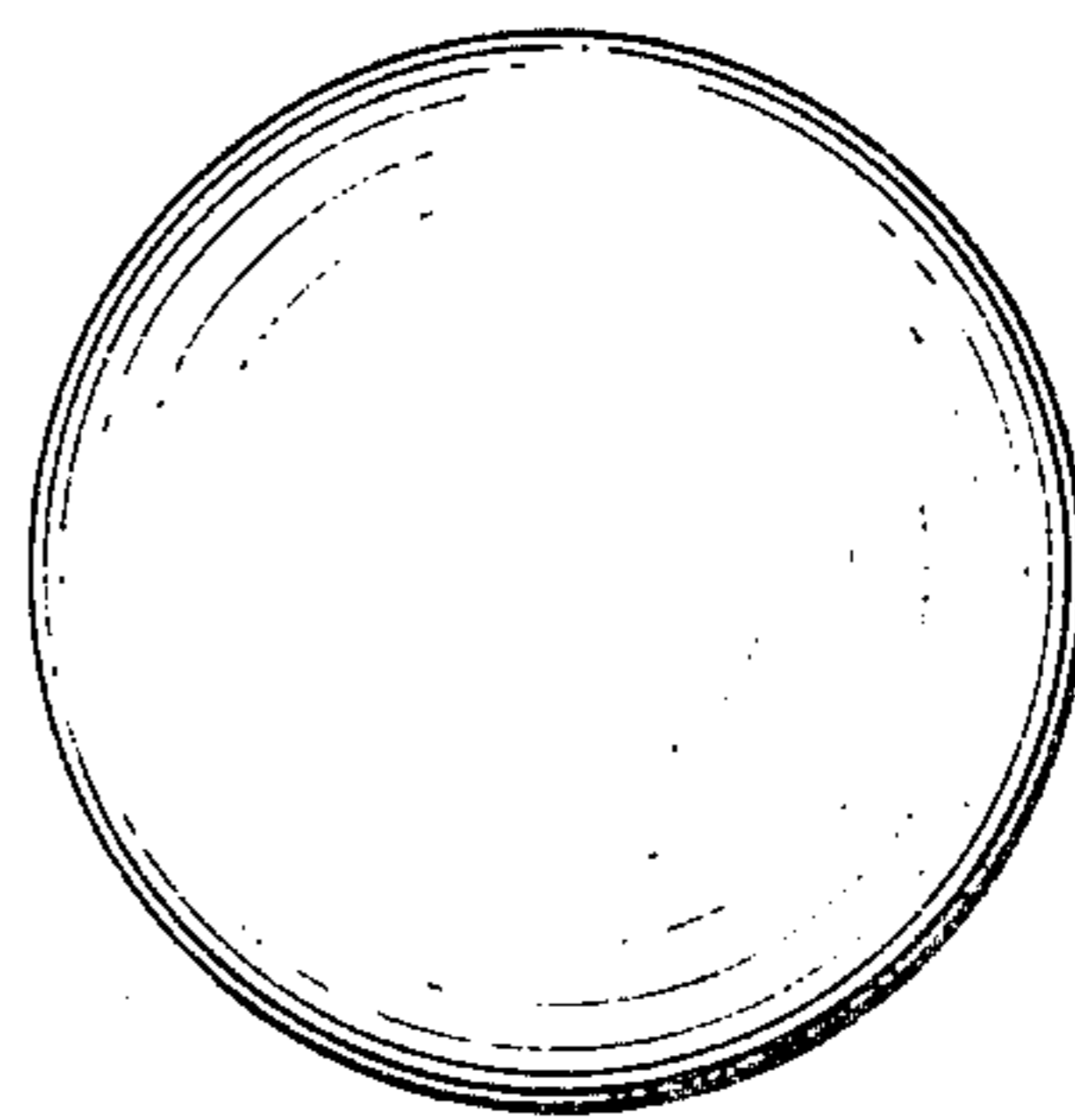
