 FIG. 3 is a bottom and left rear perspective view thereof.

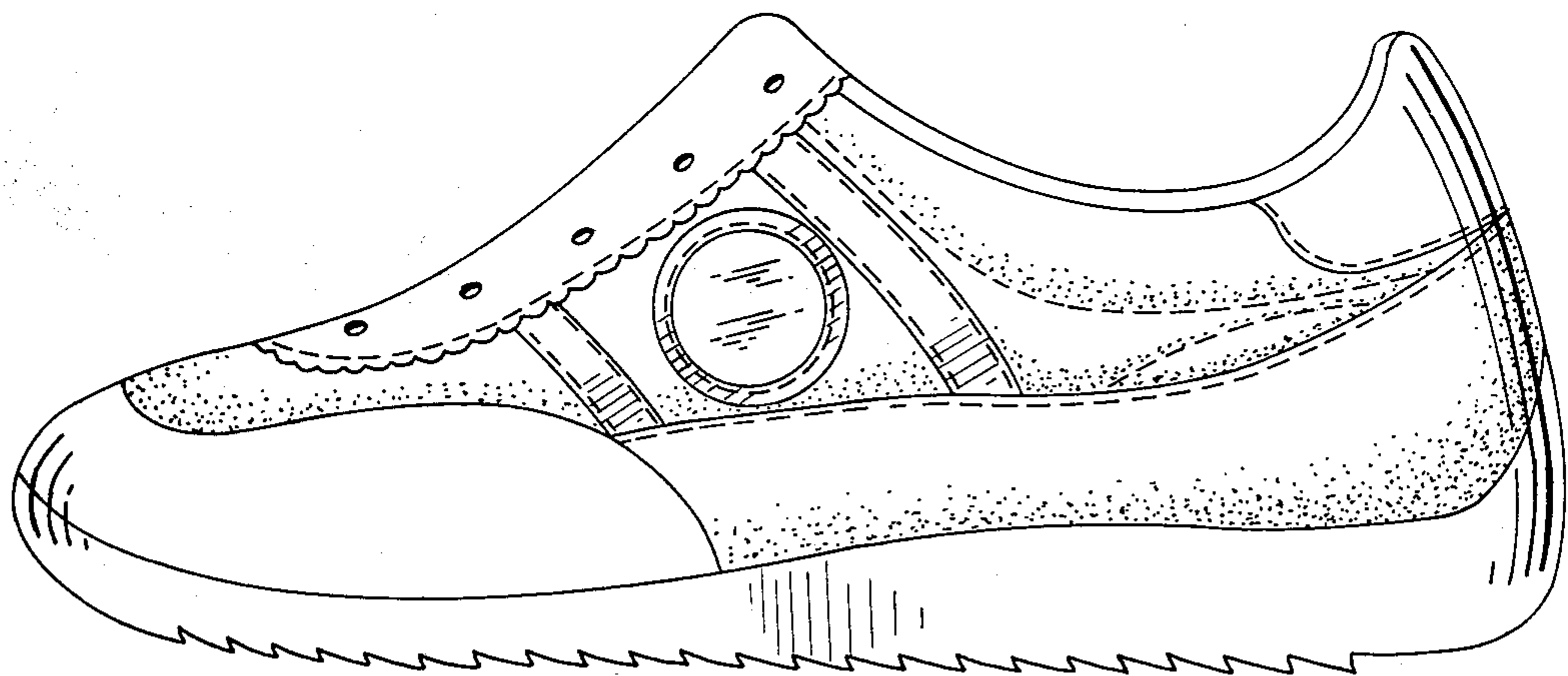

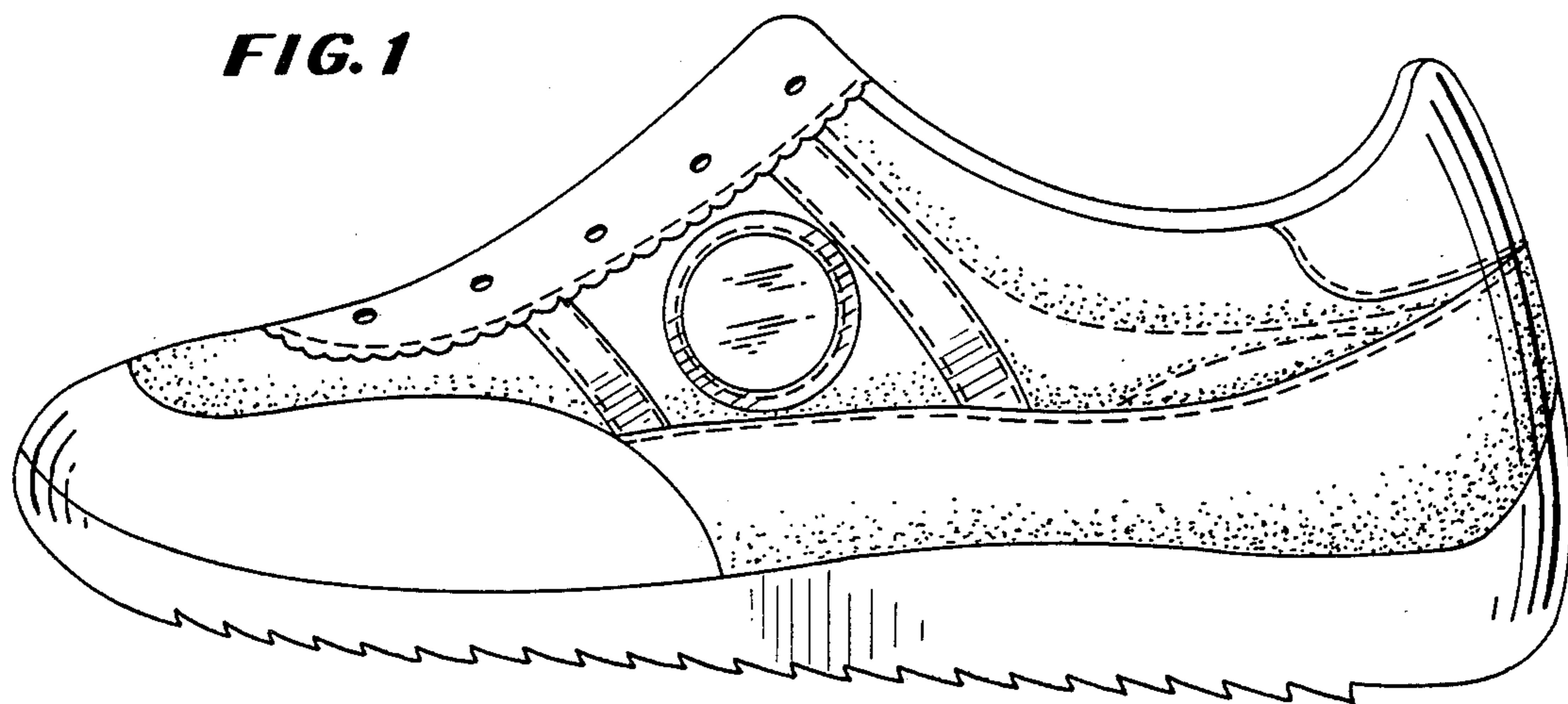

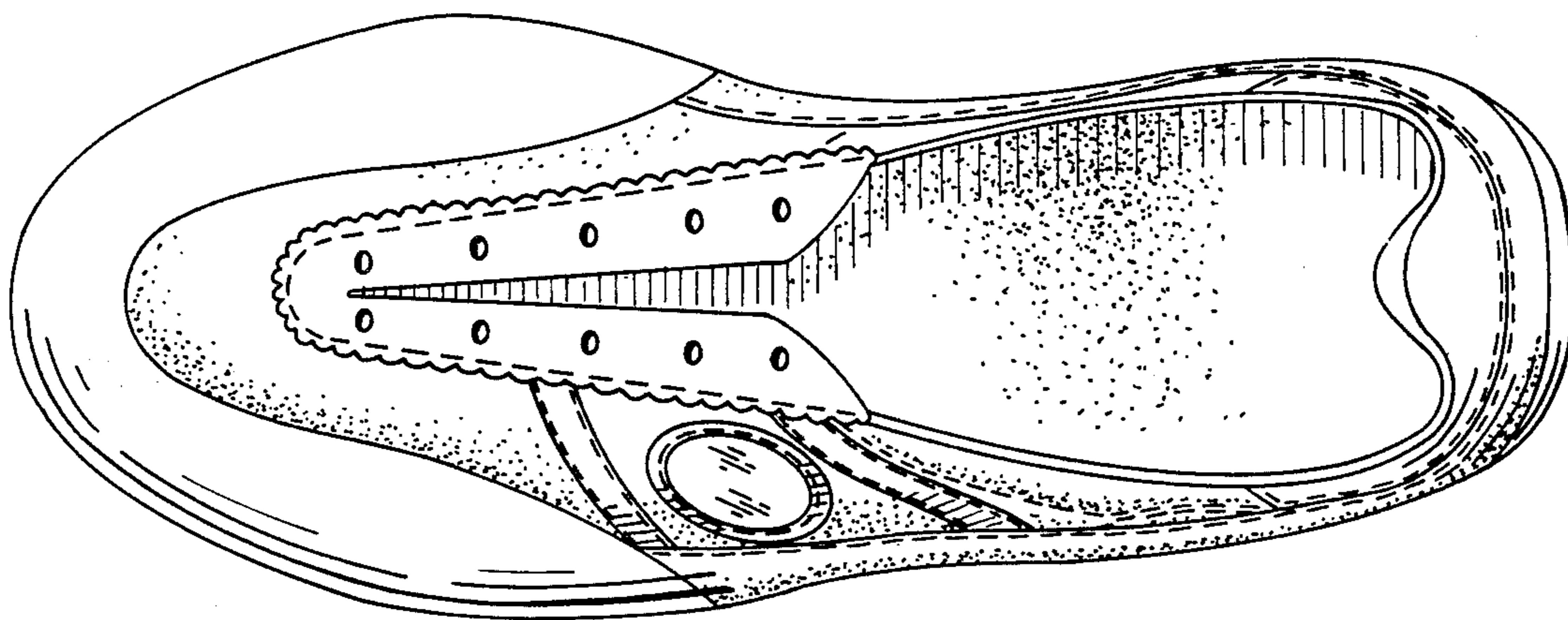
