[57] CLAIM

The ornamental design for a packaging container for a bottle or the like, as shown and described.

DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a perspective view of a packaging container for a bottle or the like showing our new design; FIG. 2 is a side elevational view, the opposite side being a mirror image thereof; FIG. 3 is a rear elevational view; FIG. 4 is a top plan view; FIG. 5 is a front elevational view; FIG. 6 is a bottom plan view; FIG. 7 is a top perspective view; and FIG. 8 is another top perspective view. The broken lines showing a bottle and tubes in FIGS. 7 and 8 are for the purpose of illustrating environmental use only.

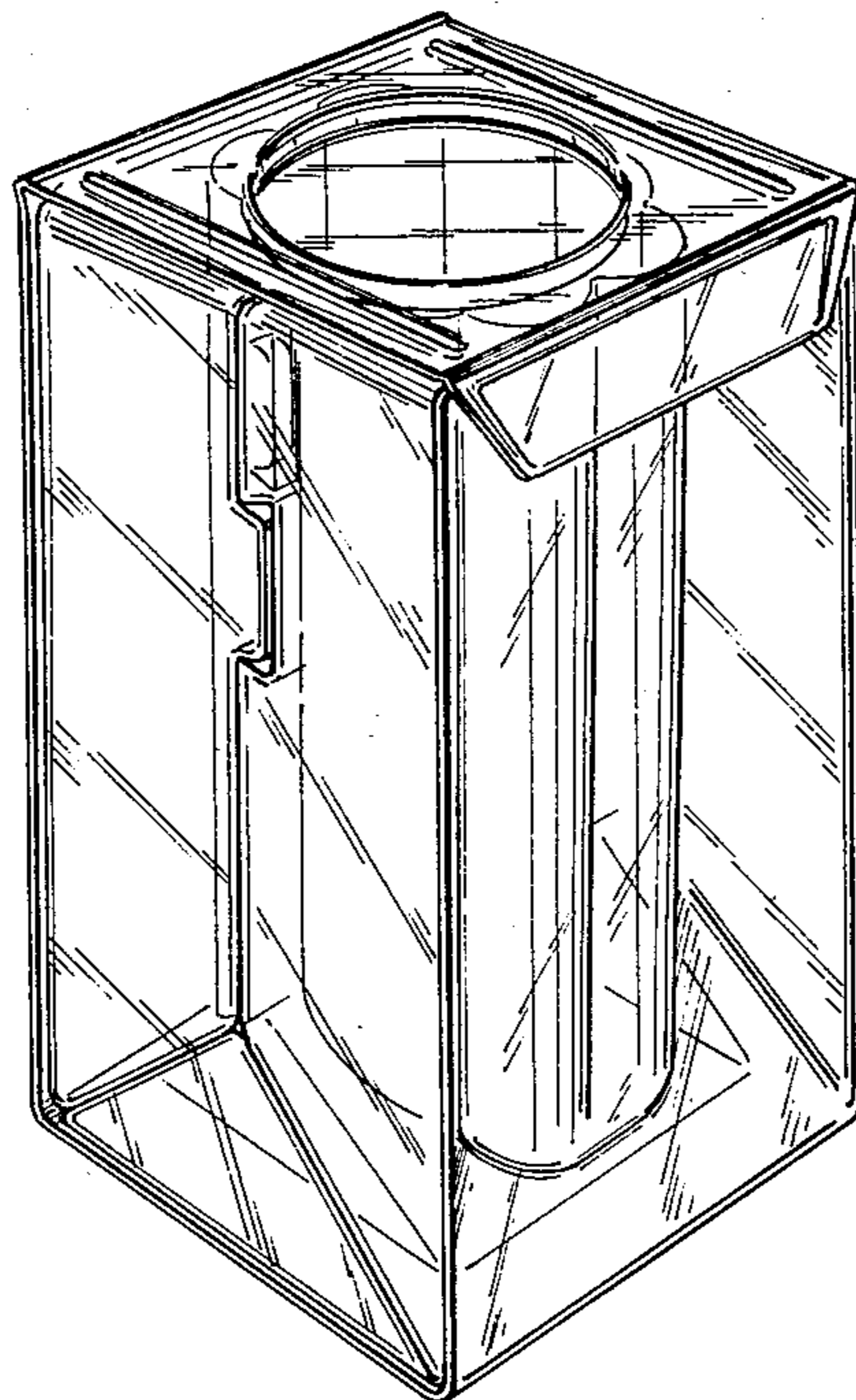

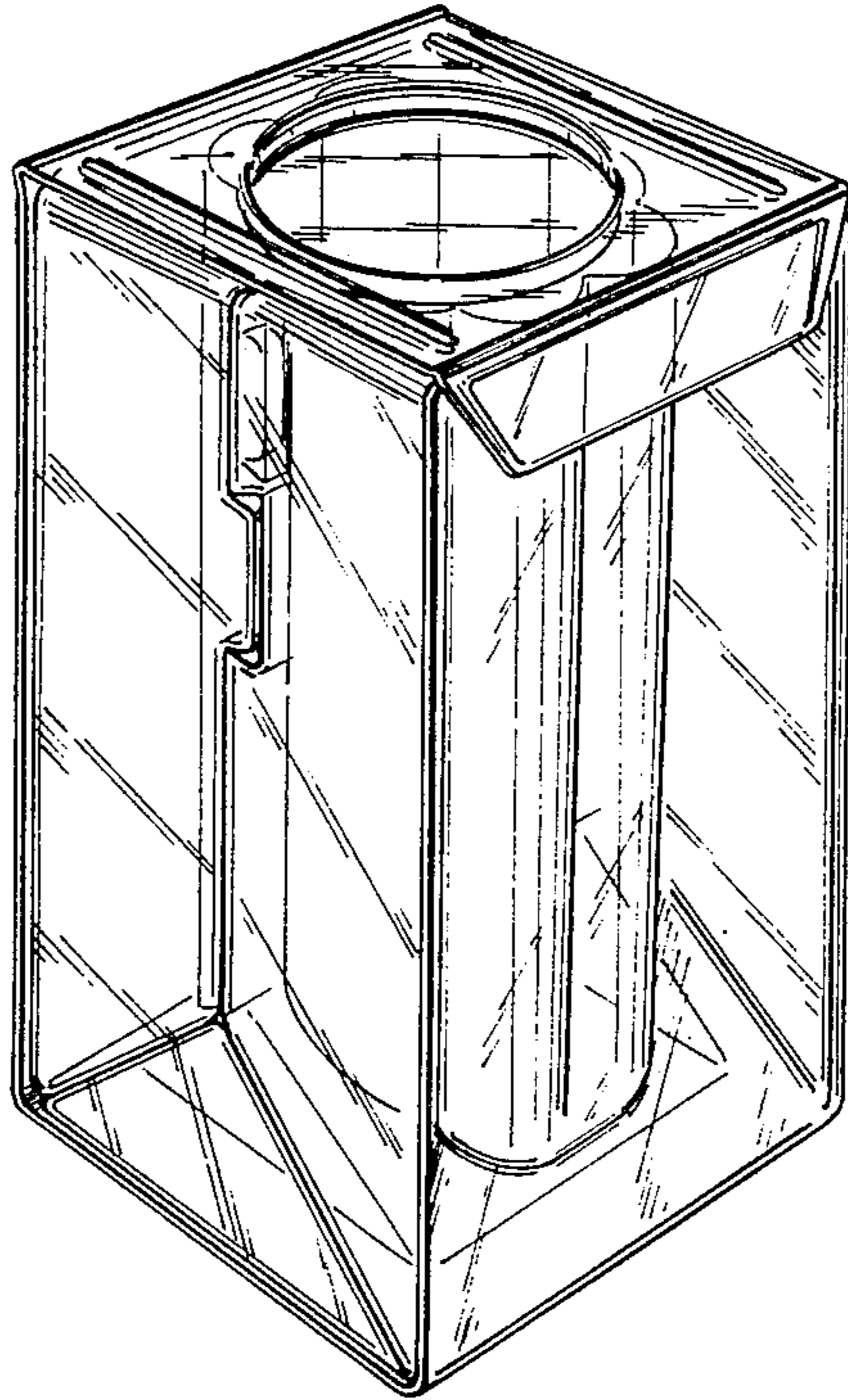

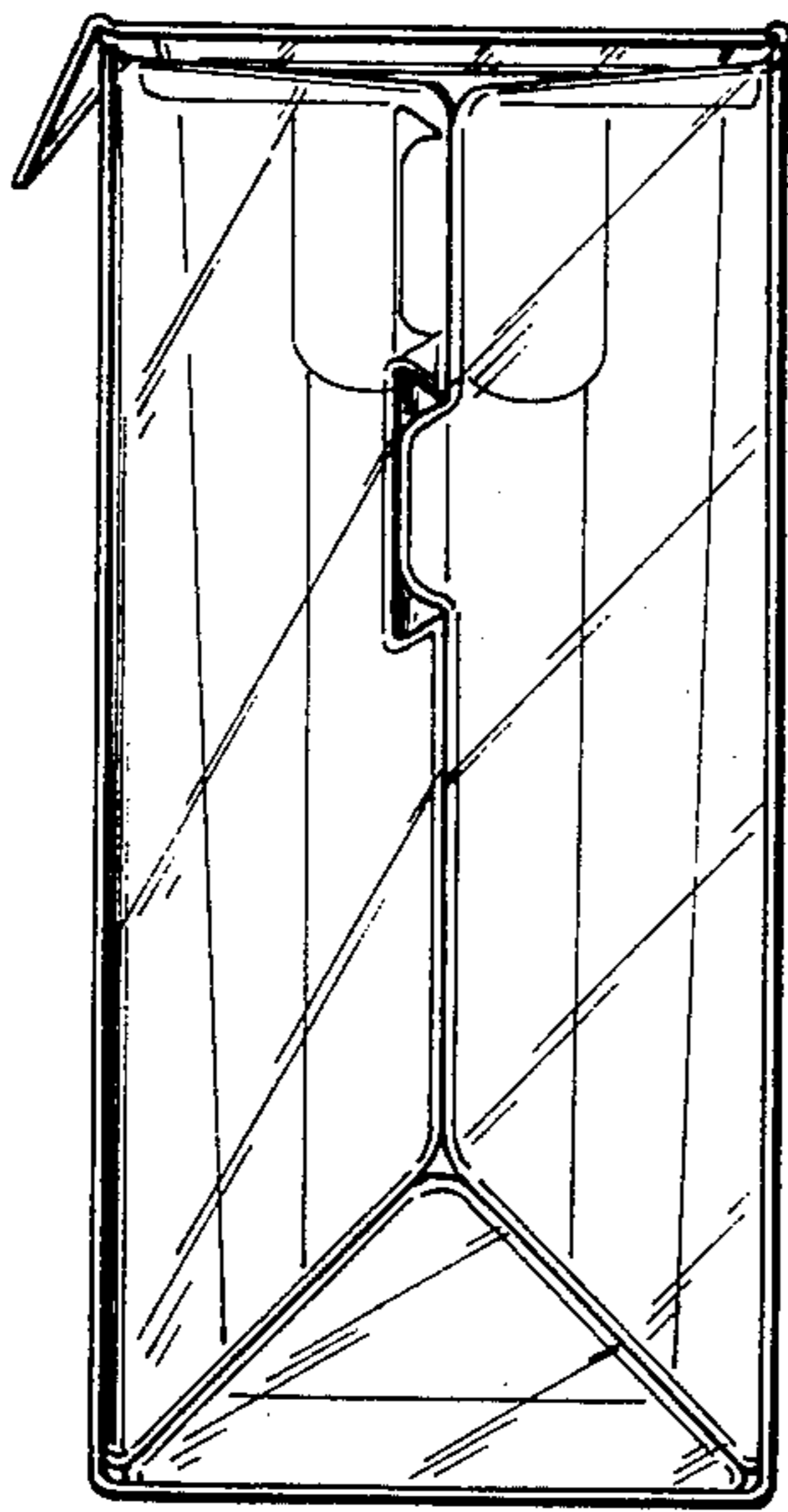

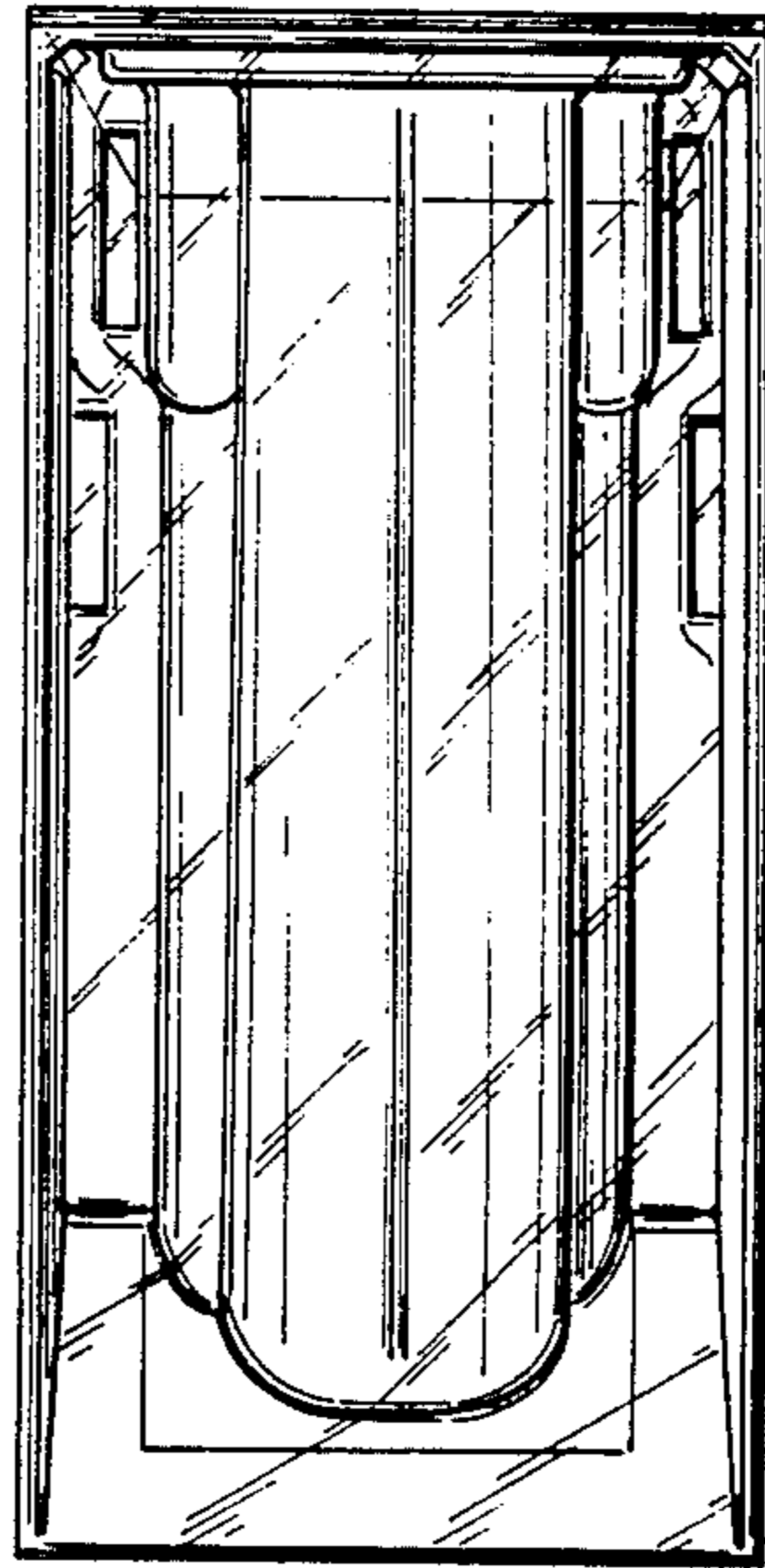

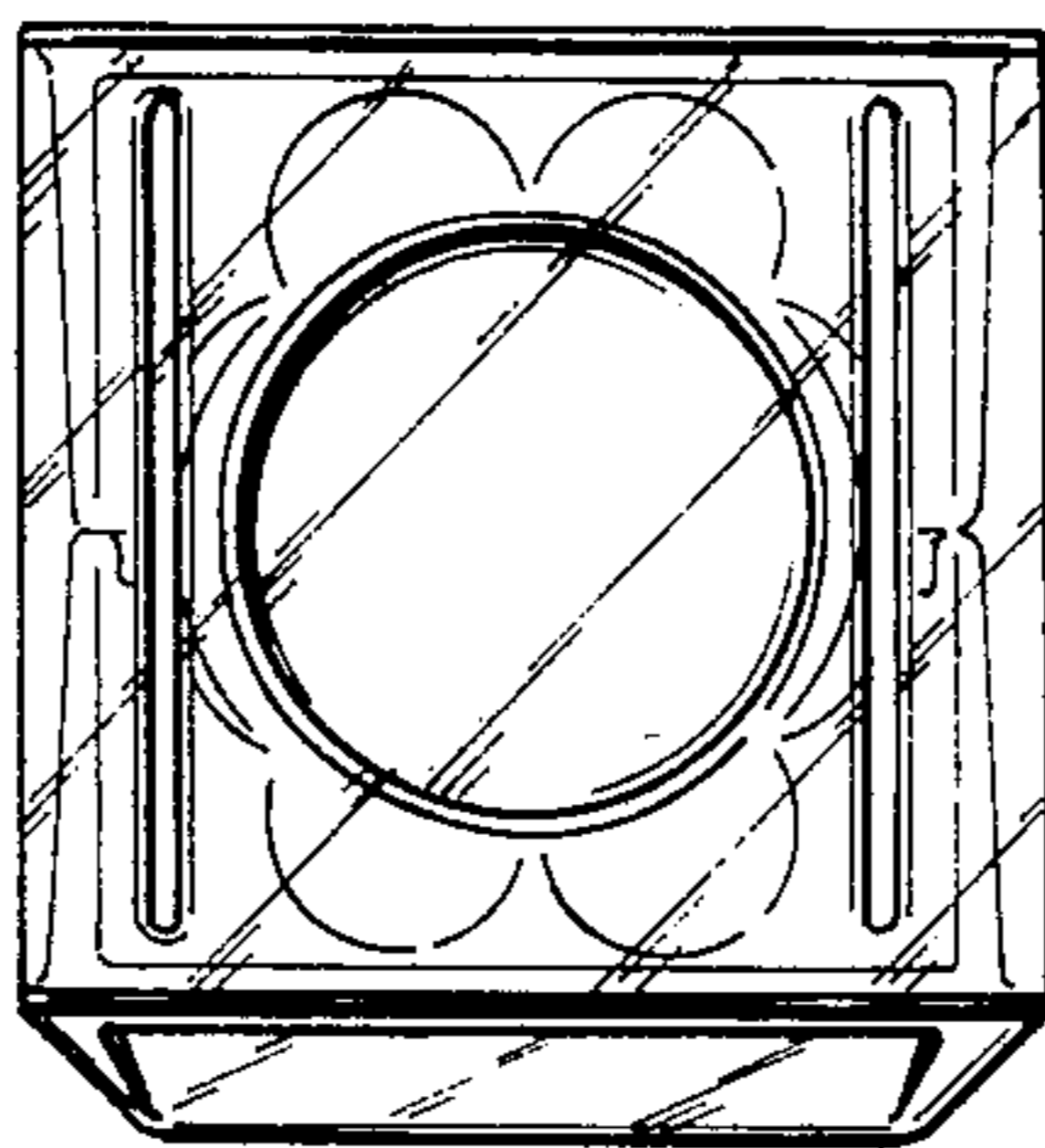

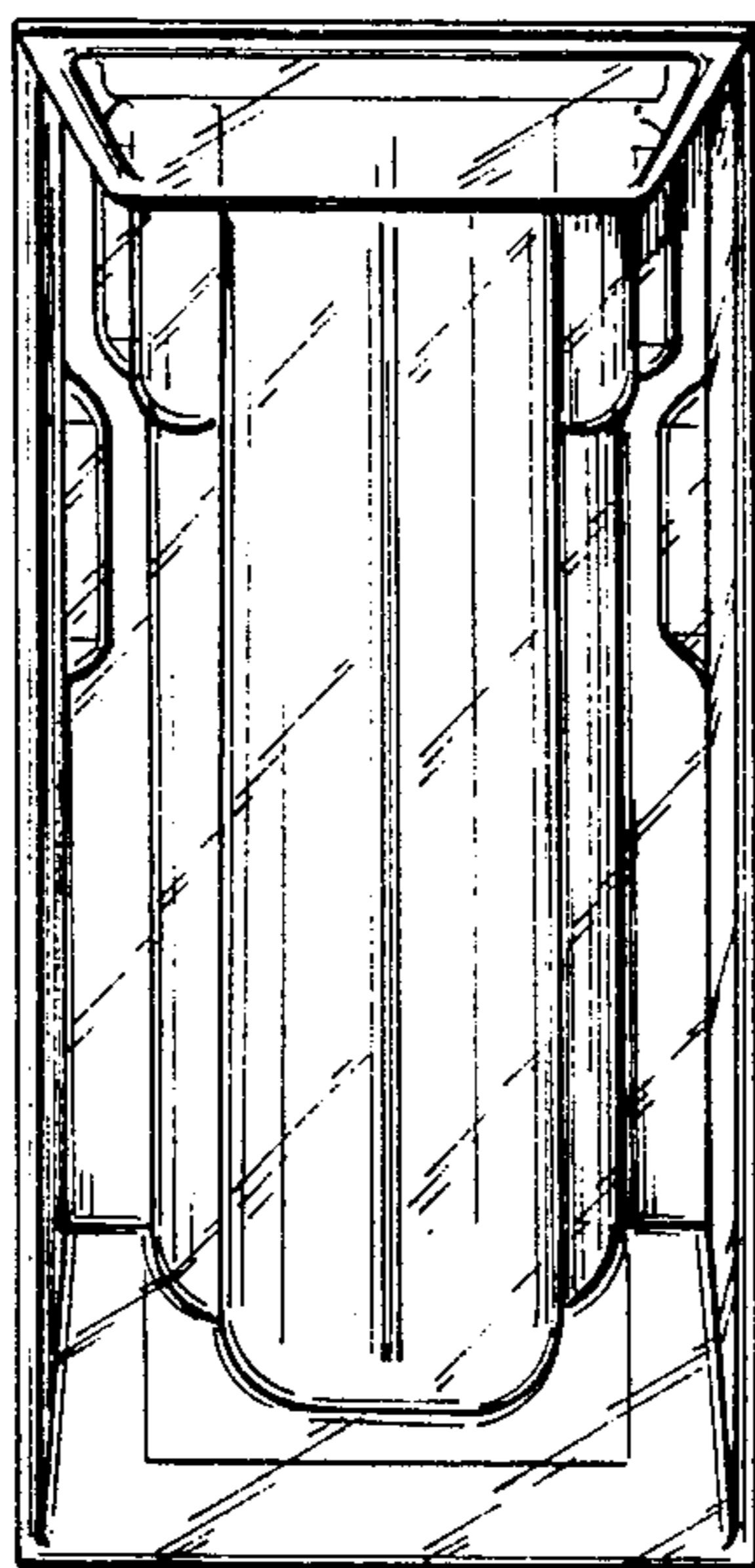

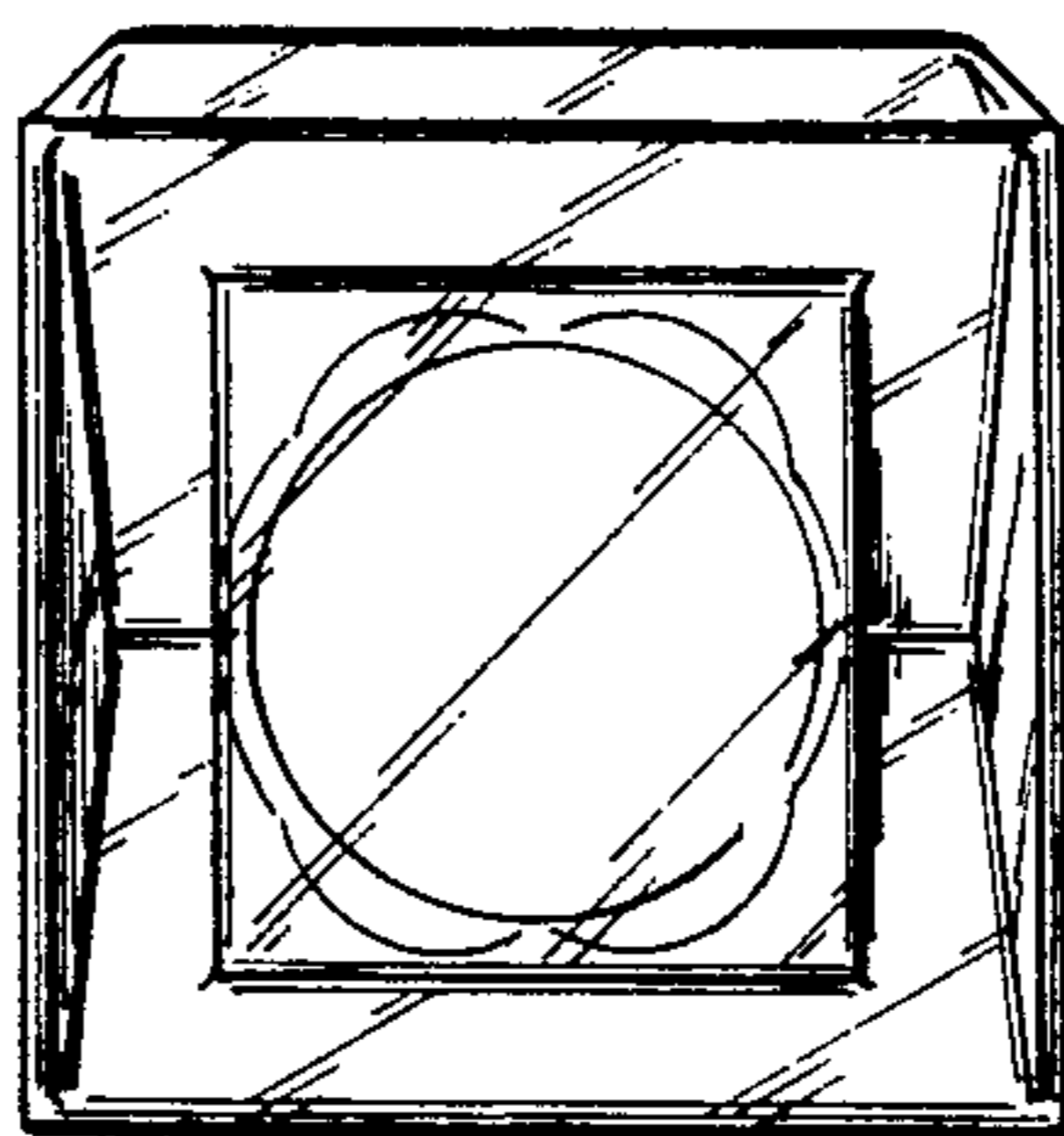

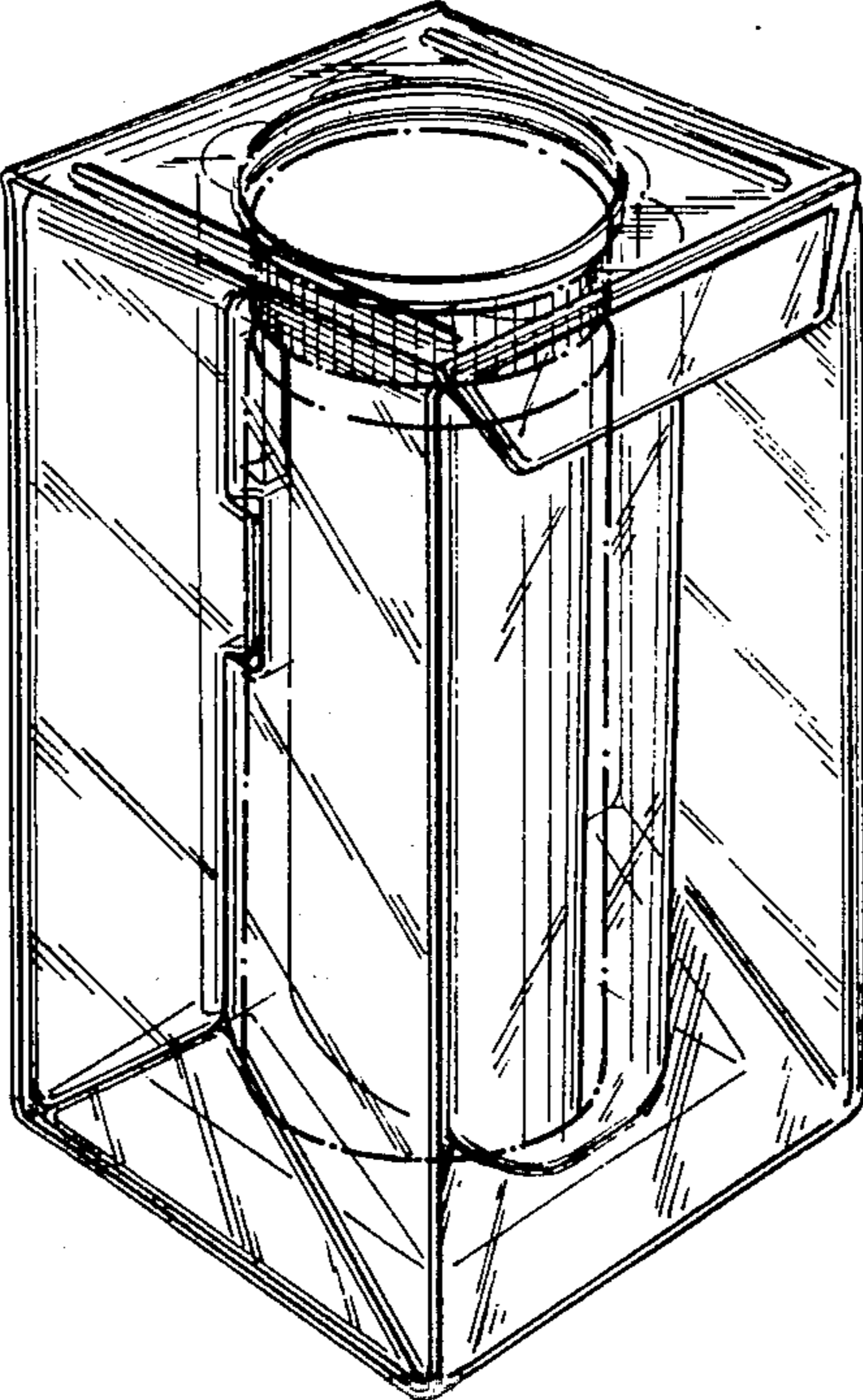
