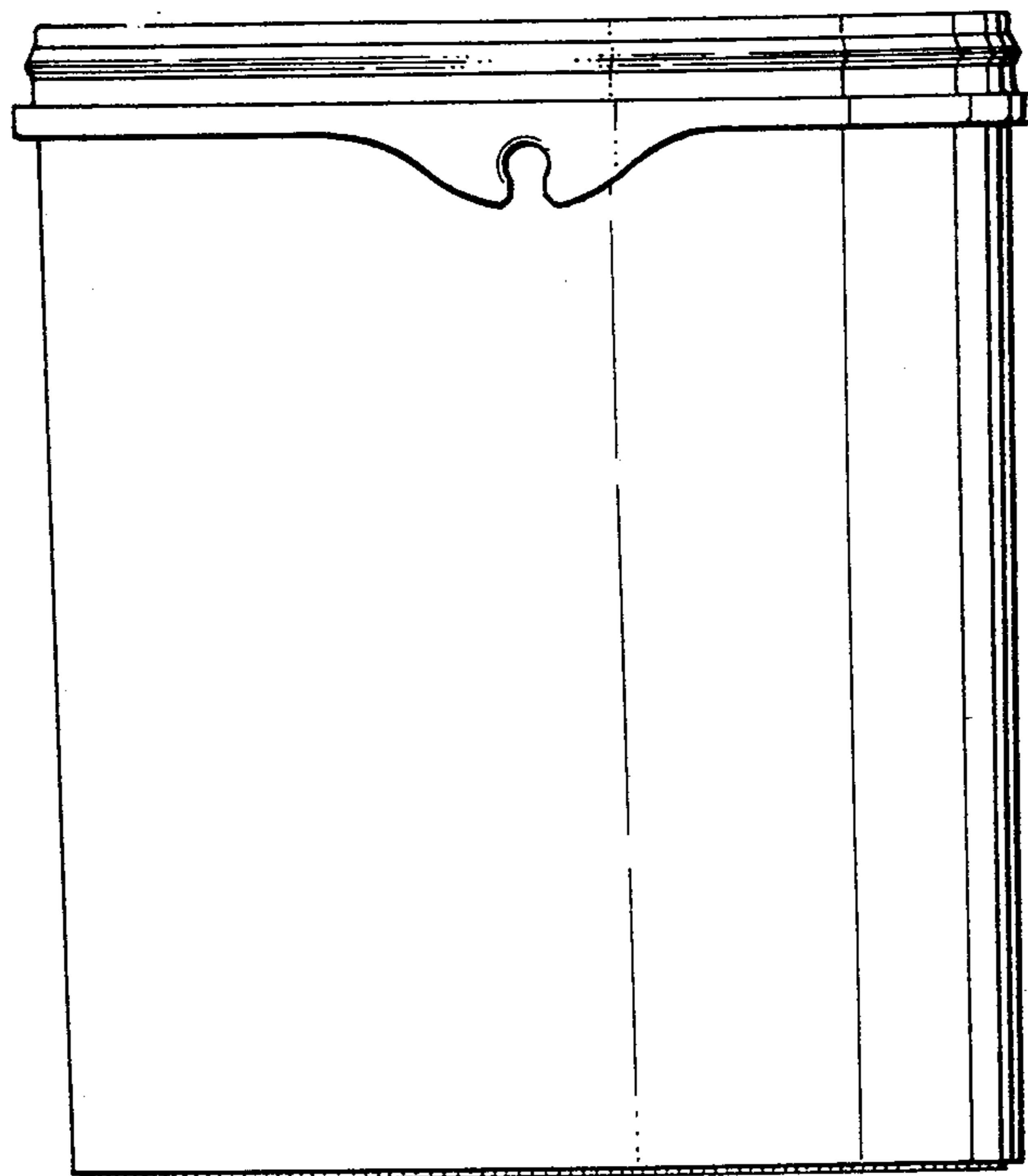

[57] CLAIM

The ornamental design for a container for liquids, substantially as shown and described.

DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is an elevational view of a container for liquids showing my new design, the opposite side being the same in appearance;
 FIG. 2 is an elevational view looking from the right of FIG. 1, the opposite side being the same in appearance;
 FIG. 3 is a vertical sectional view taken on the line 3—3 of FIG. 4;
 FIG. 4 is a top plan view;
 FIG. 5 is a bottom plan view;
 FIG. 6 is a fragmentary, enlarged sectional view taken on the line 6—6 of FIG. 4; and
 FIG. 7 is a fragmentary, enlarged sectional view taken on the line 7—7 of FIG. 4.



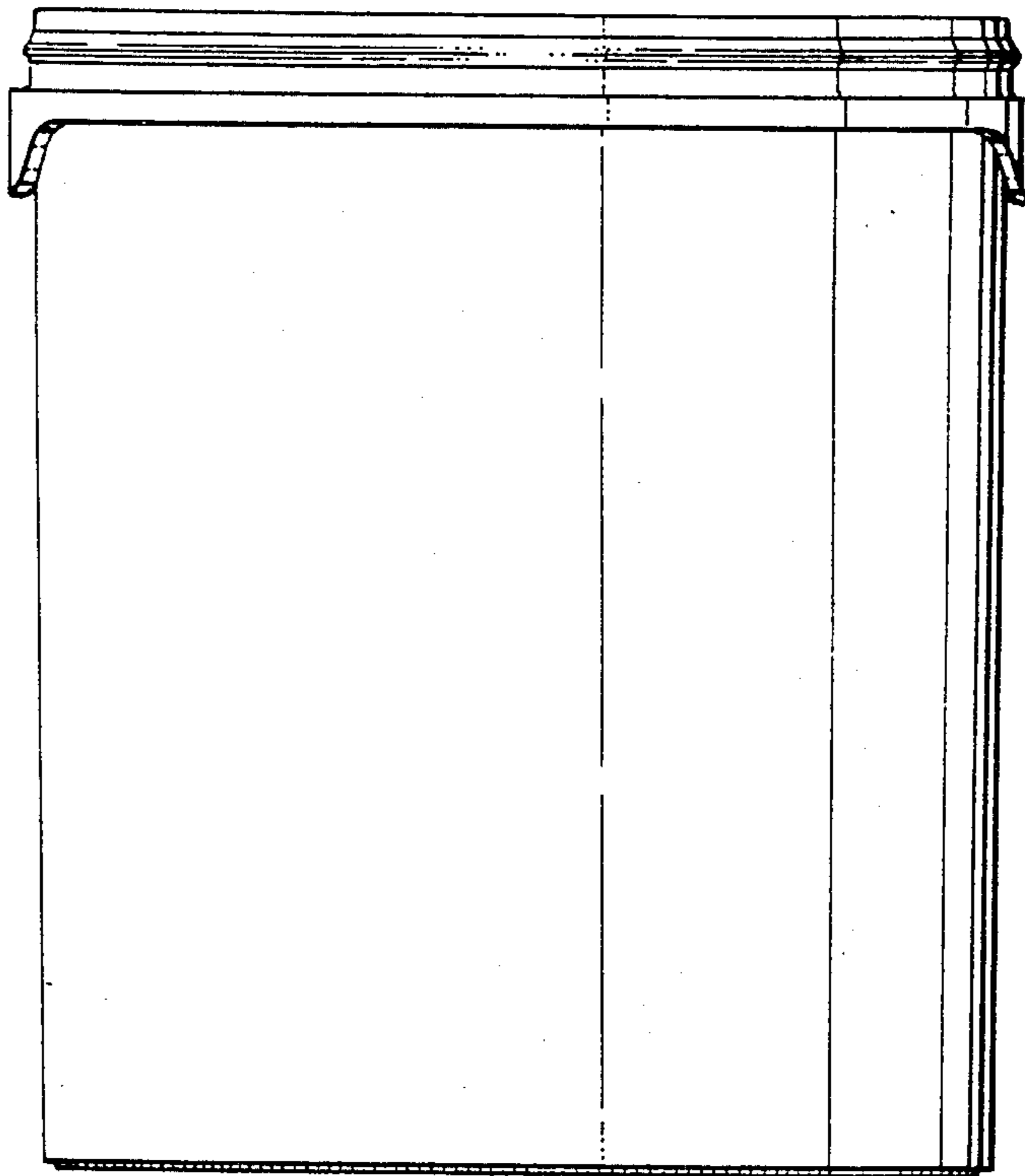

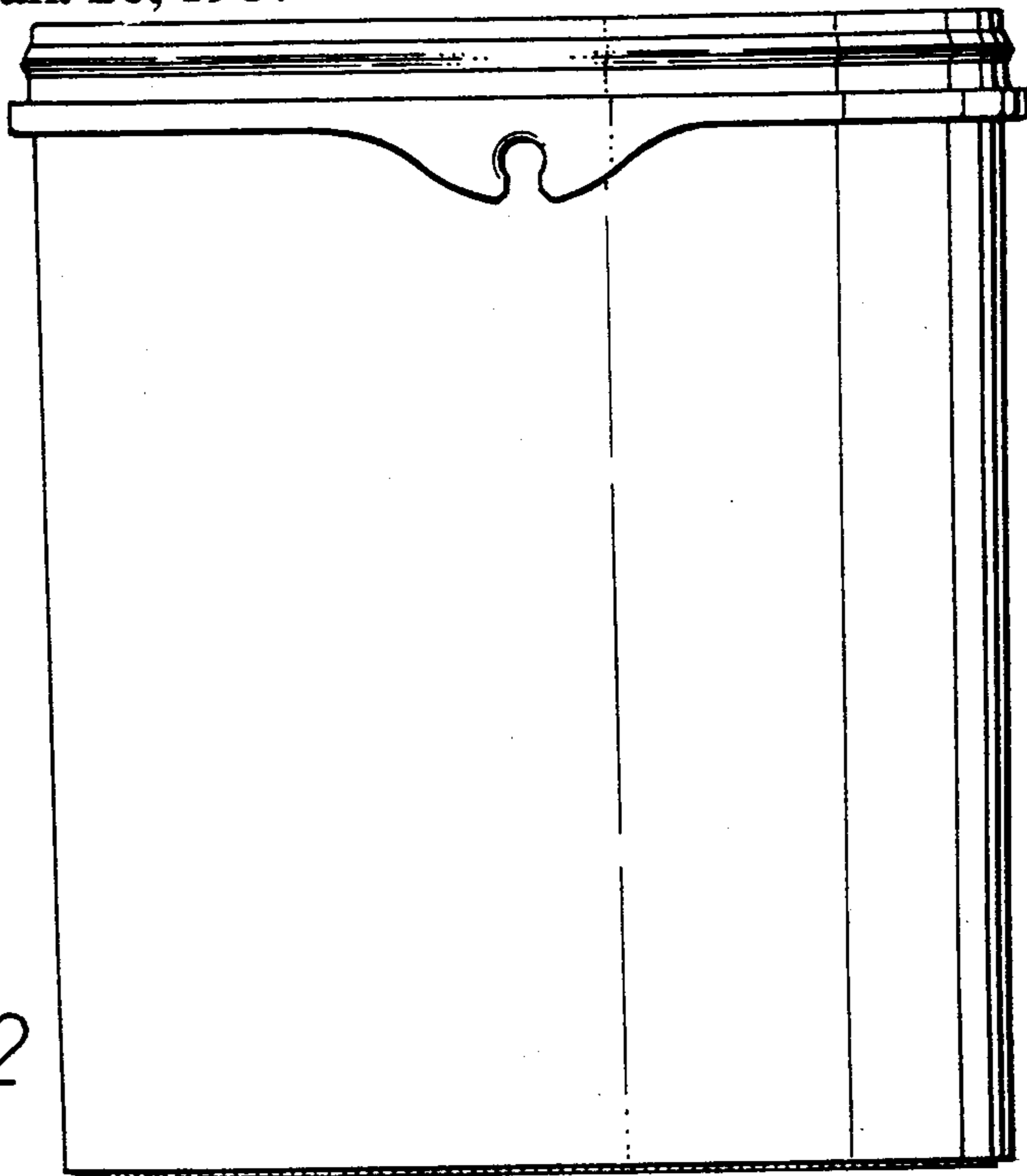

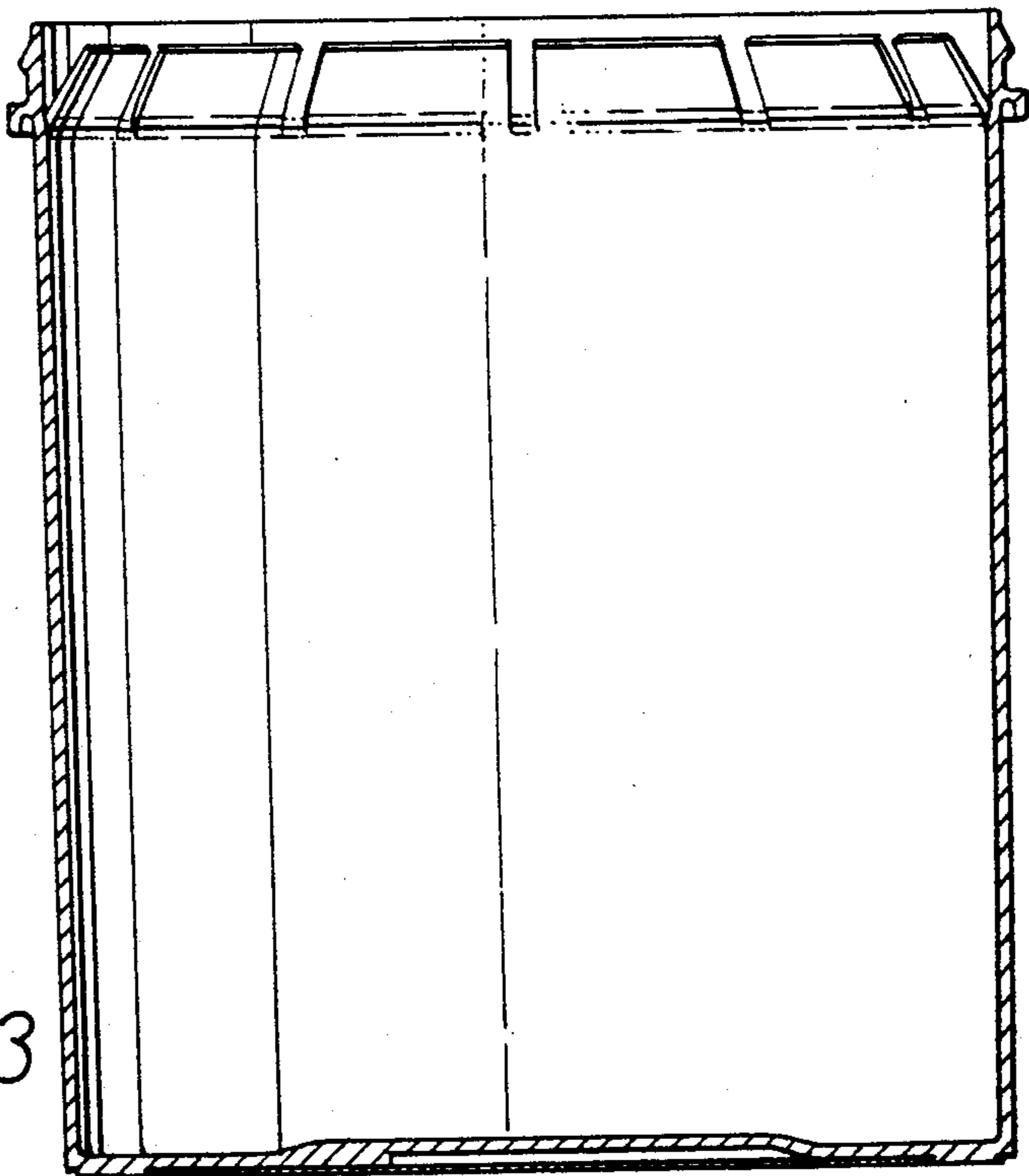

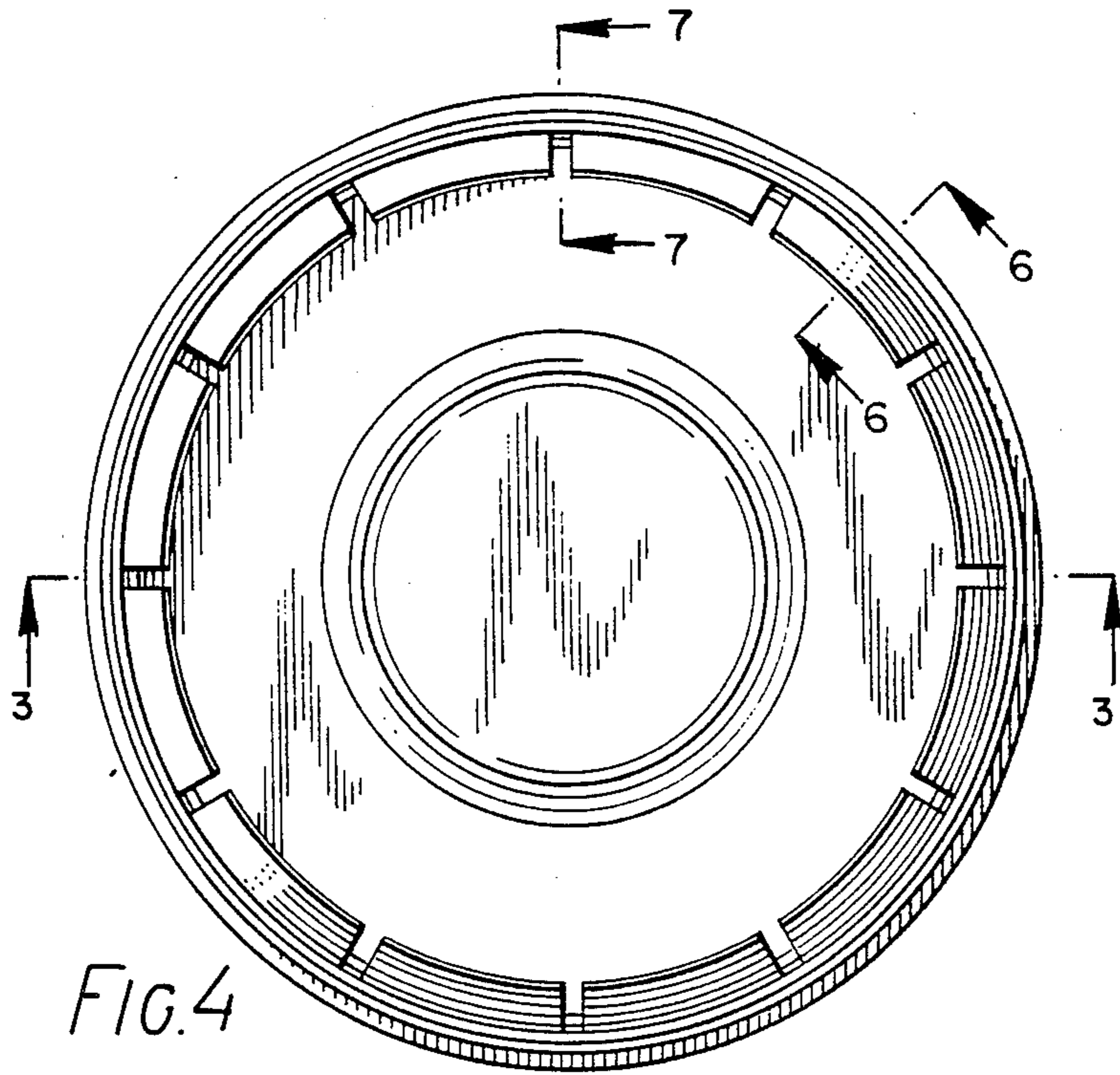

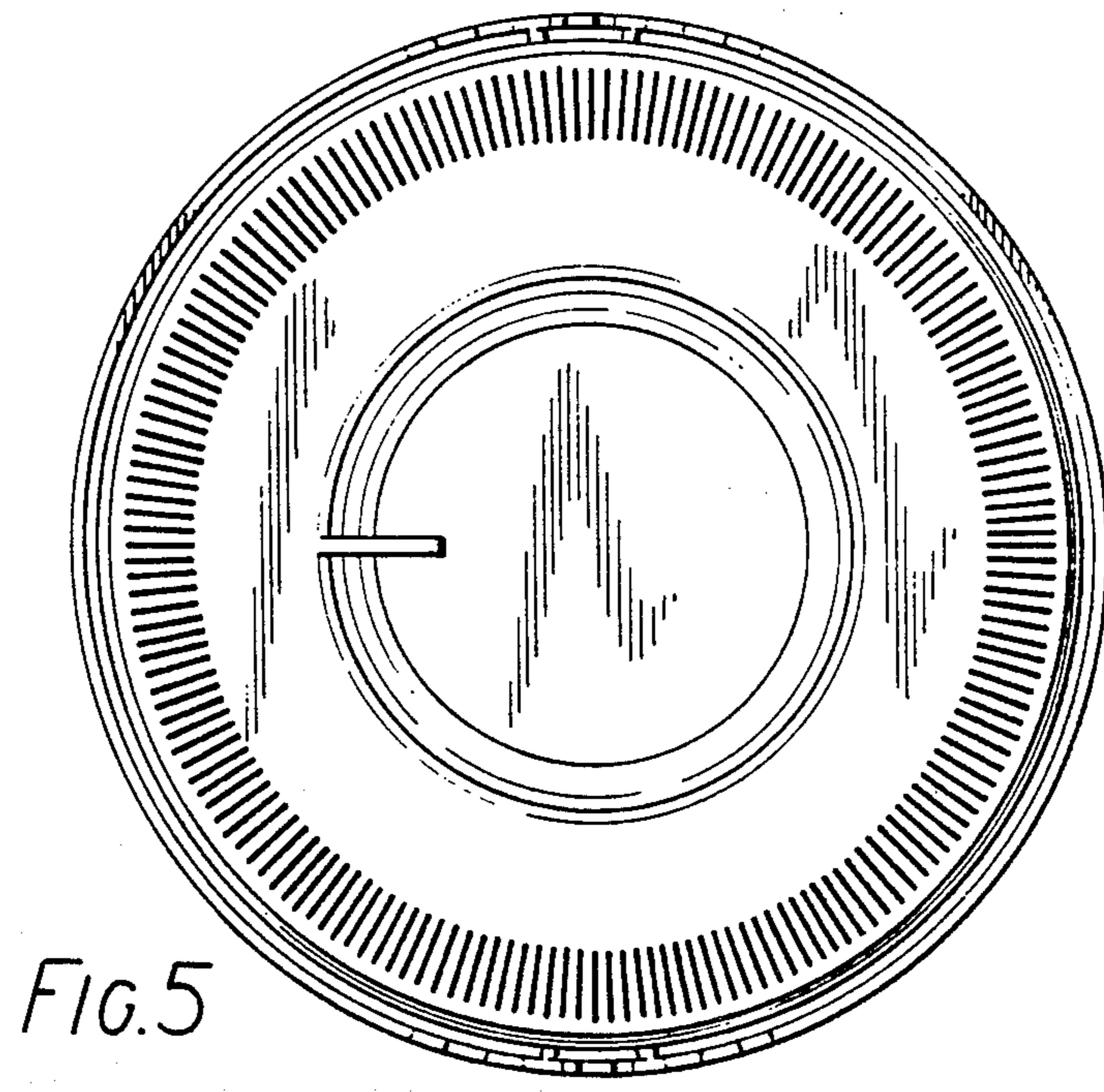

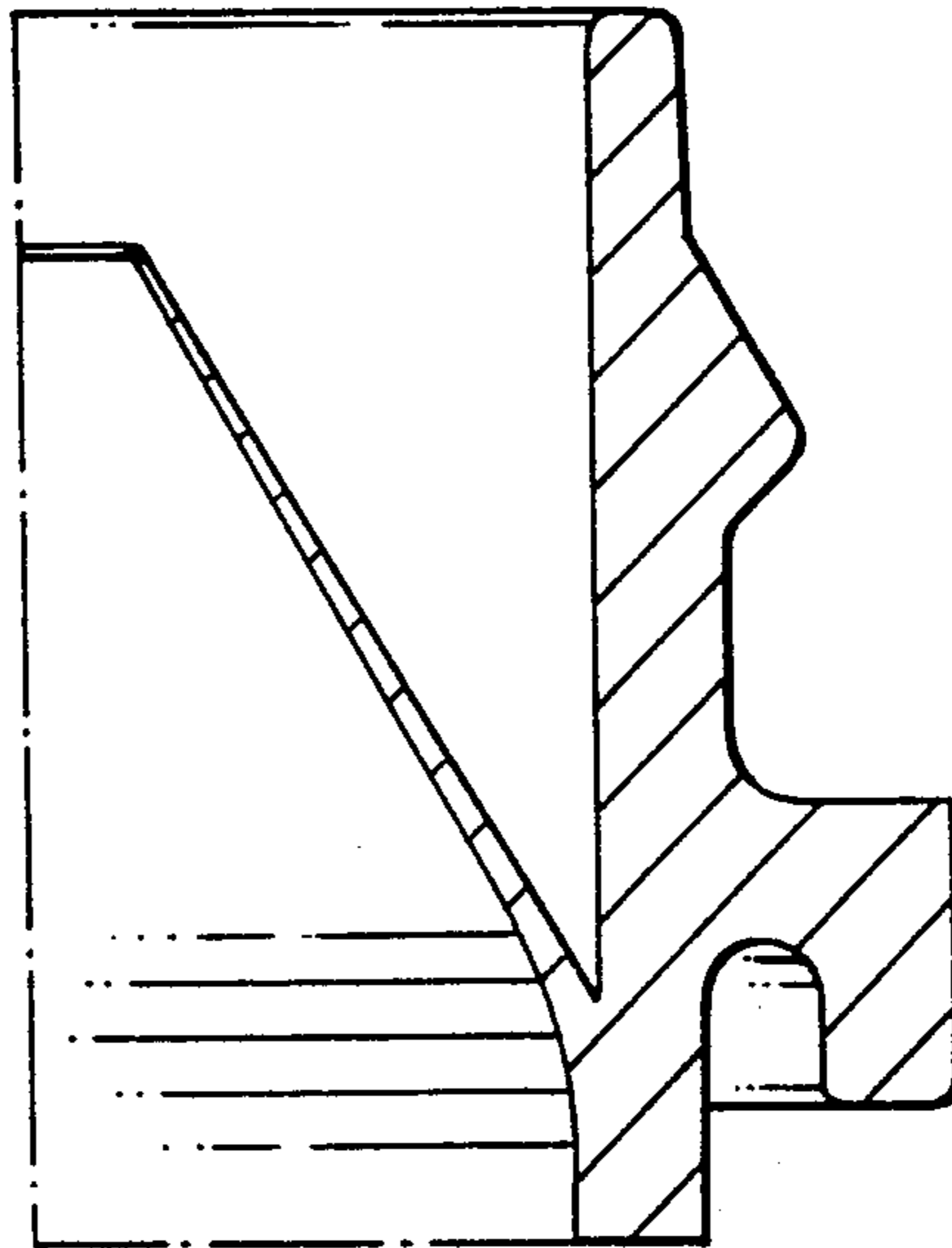
