FIG. 2 is a top plan view thereof on a reduced scale, as taken in the direction of arrow 2 in FIG. 1;

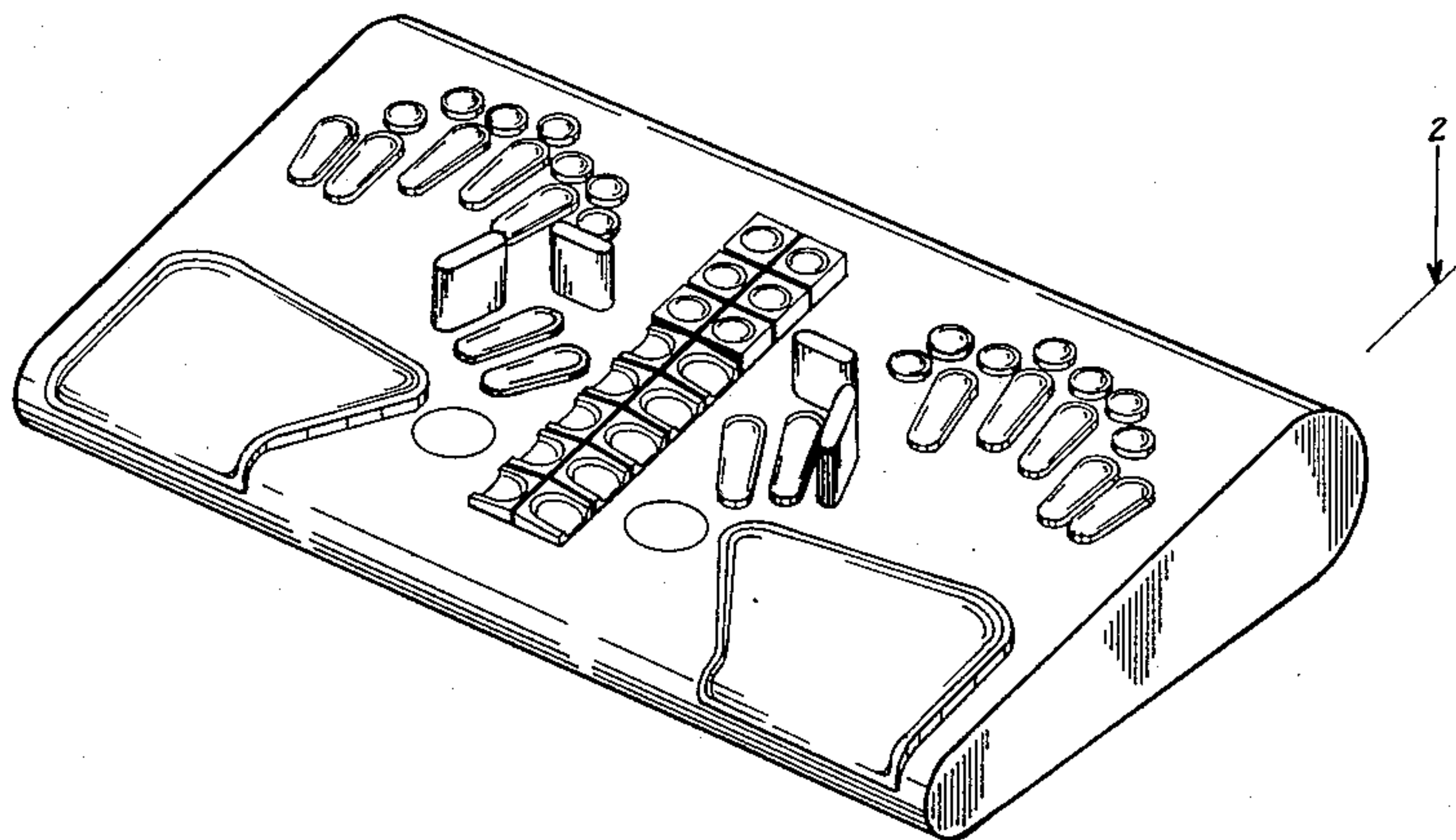
FIG. 3 is a bottom plan view thereof;

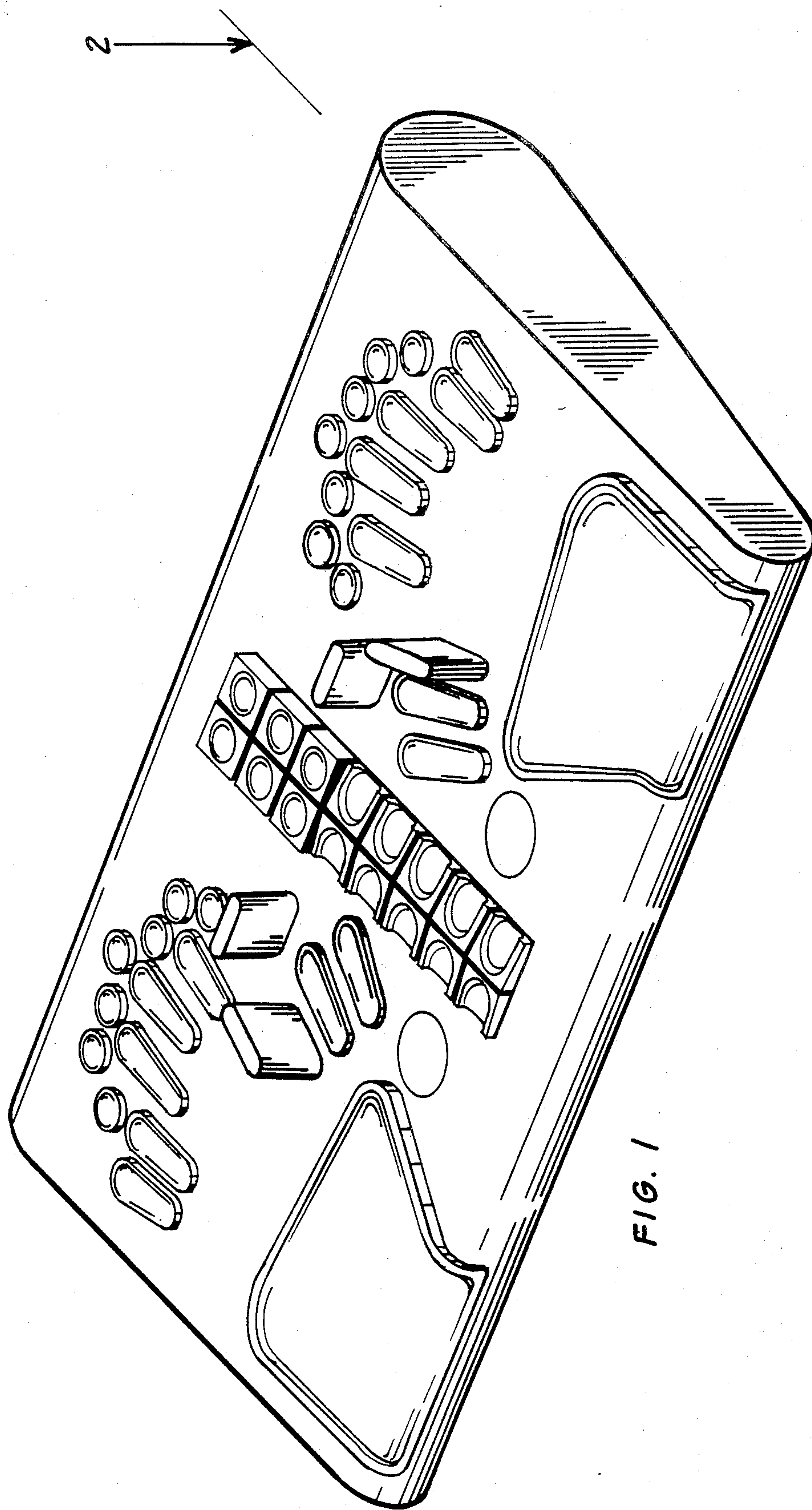
FIG. 4 is a right side elevational view thereof on a reduced scale;

FIG. 7 is a rear elevational view thereof on a reduced scale as taken in the direction of arrow 7 in FIG. 4.





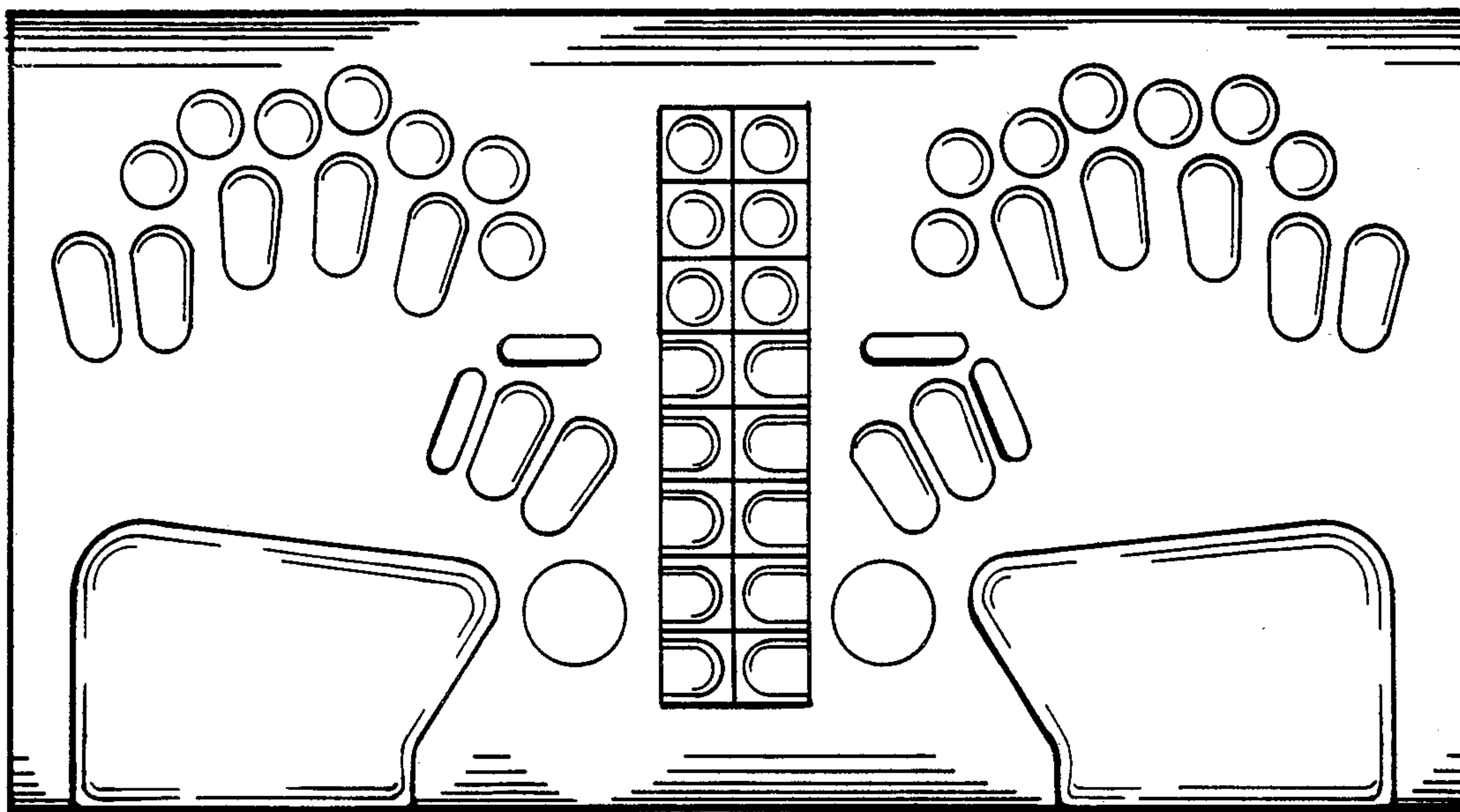

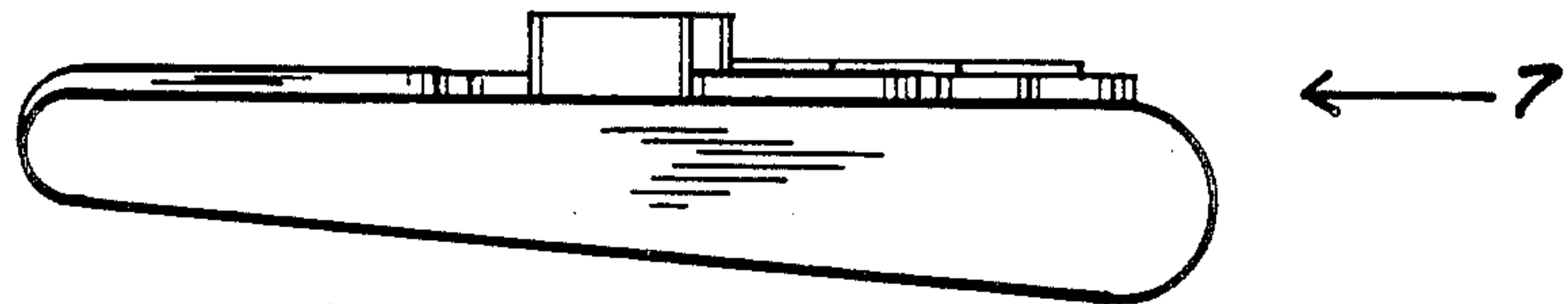

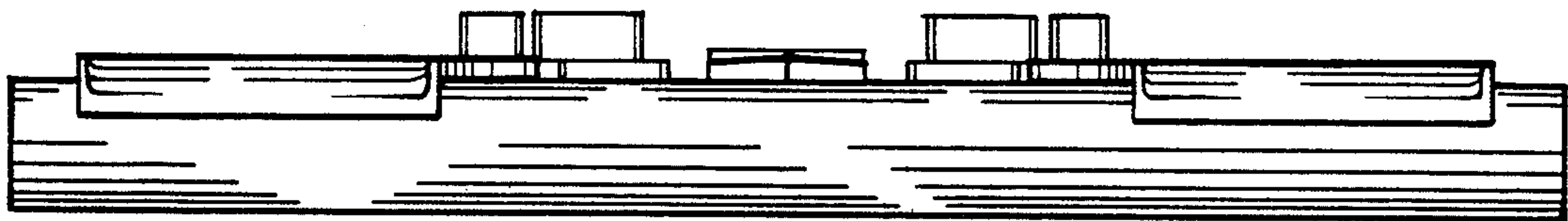
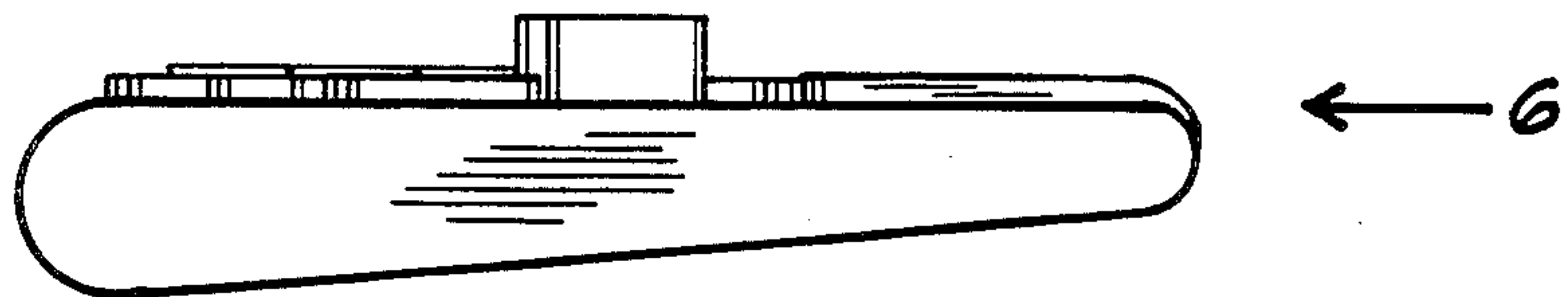

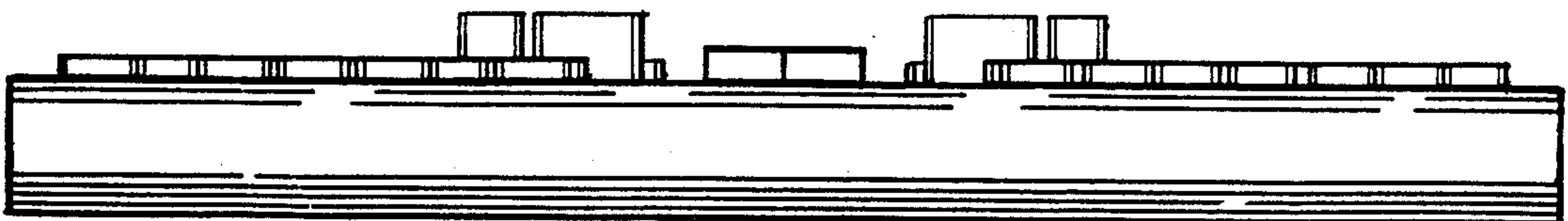
