DESCRIPTION

 FIG. 14 is a rear elevational view thereof.

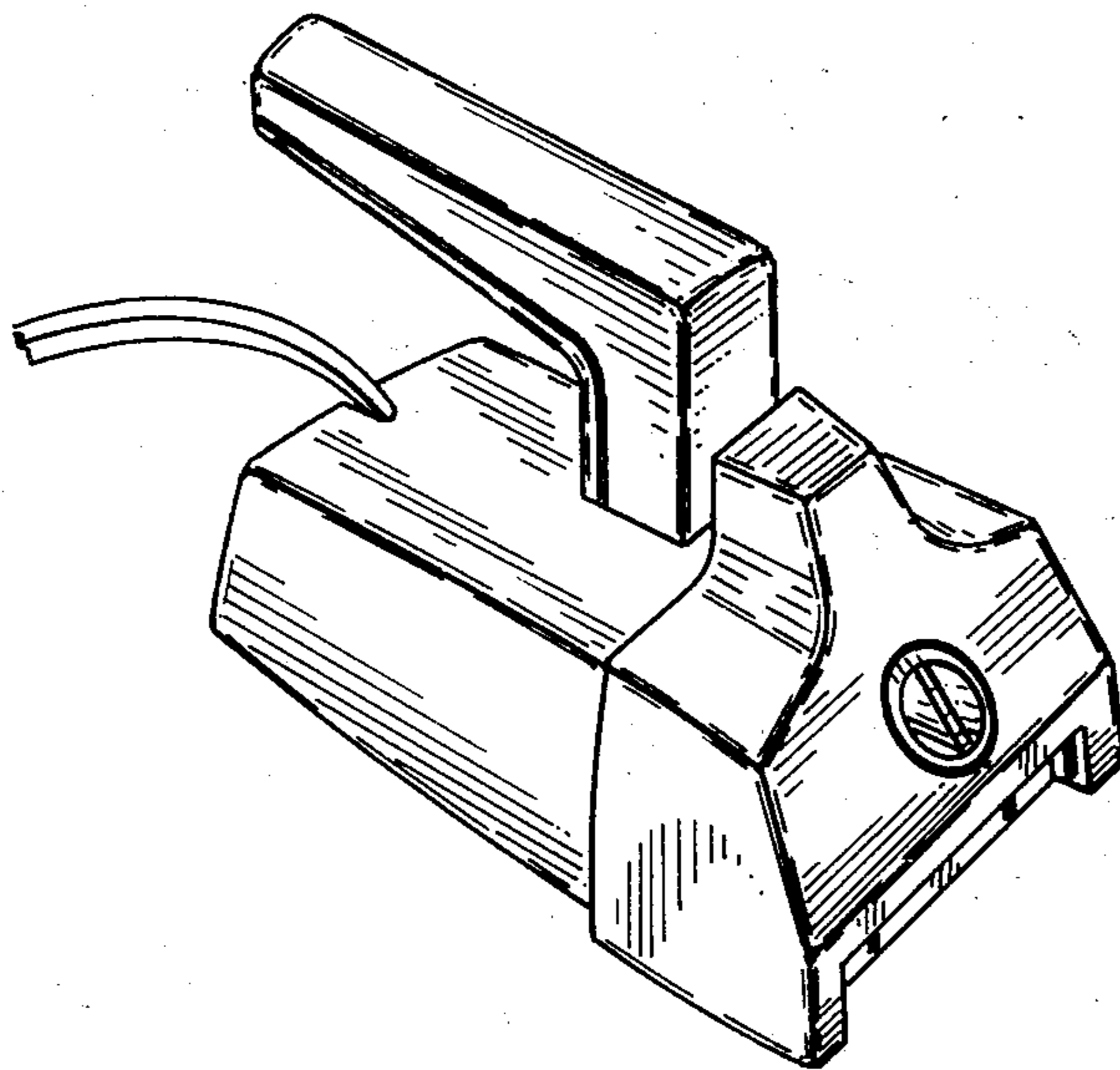

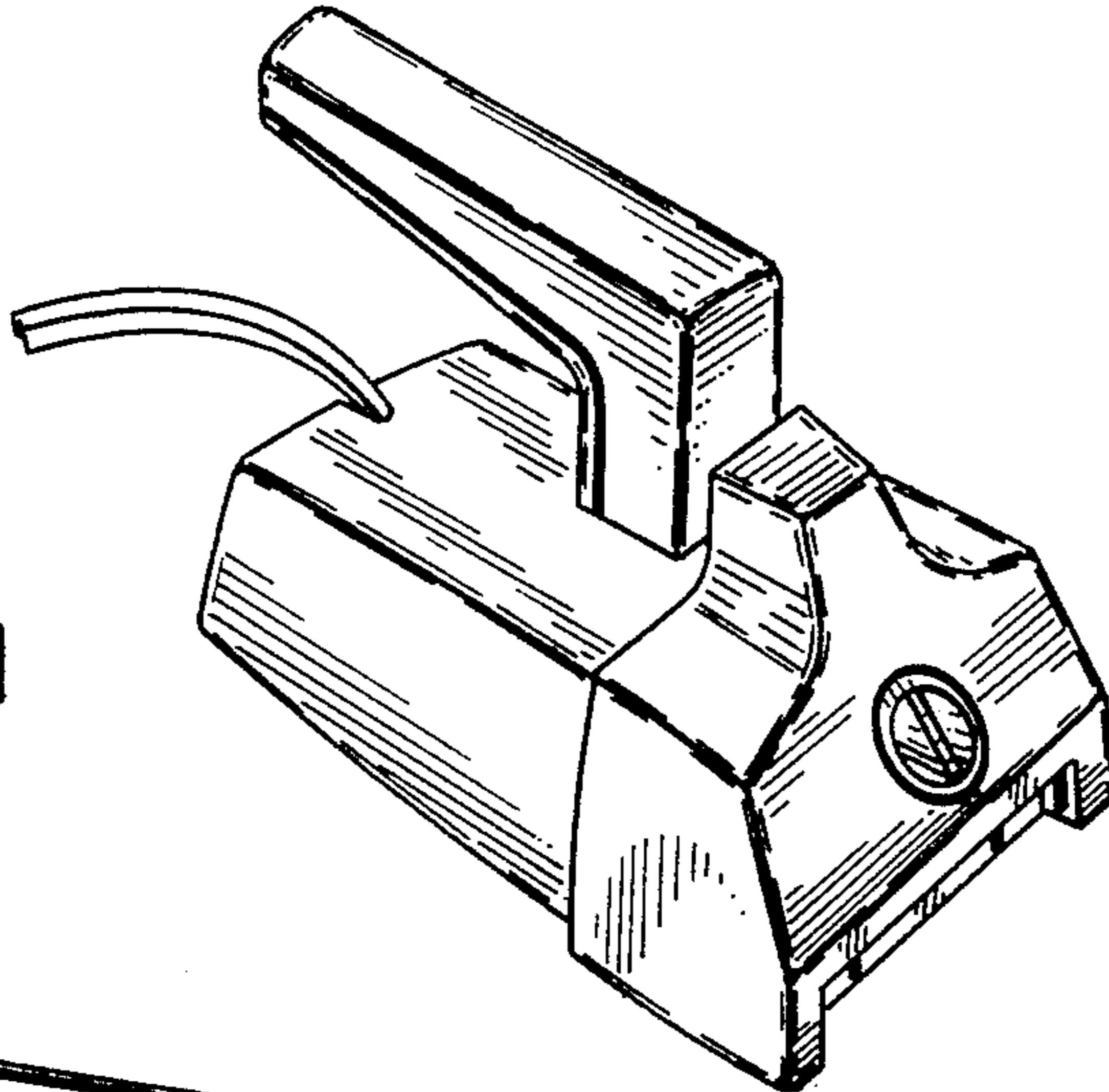

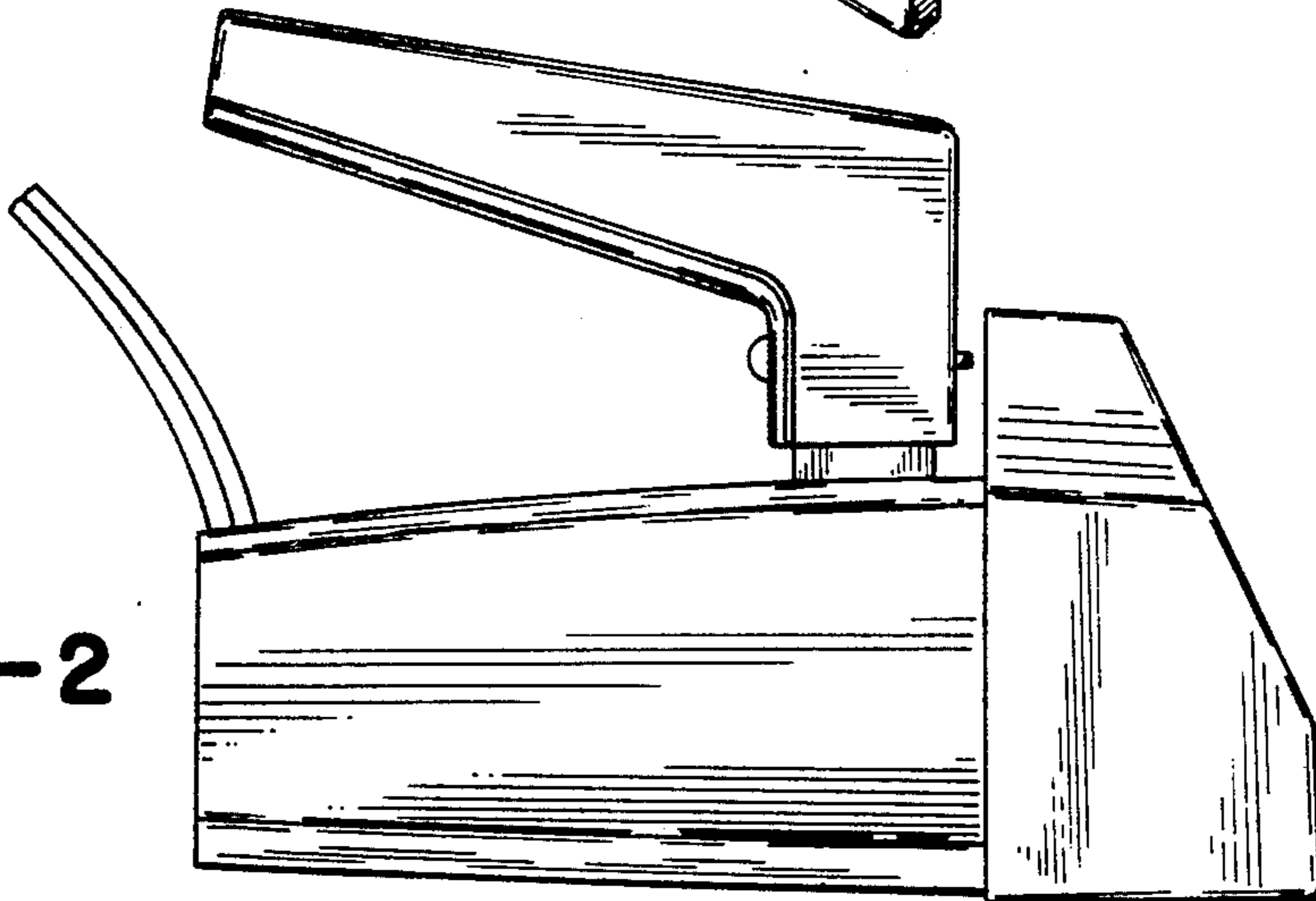
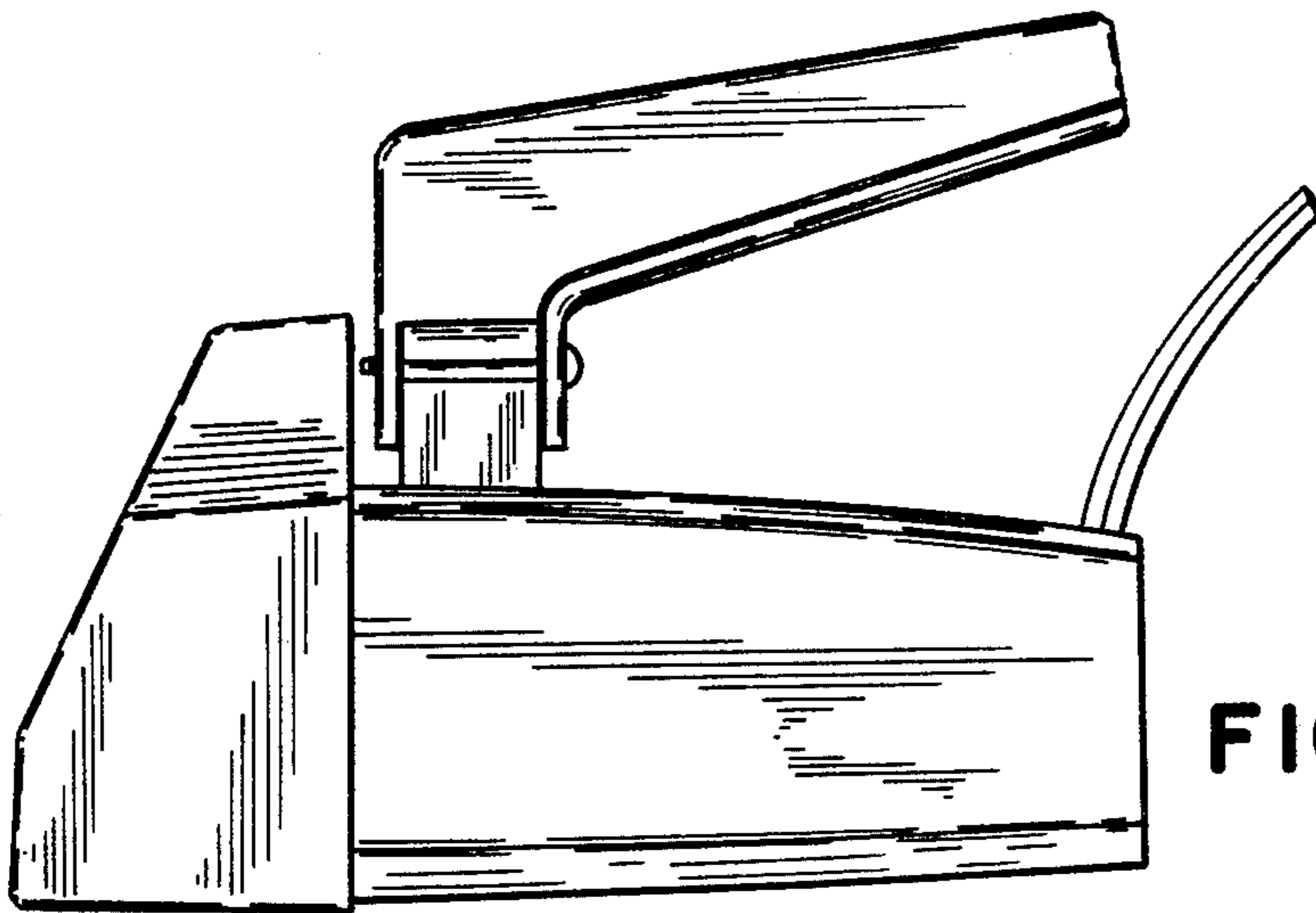

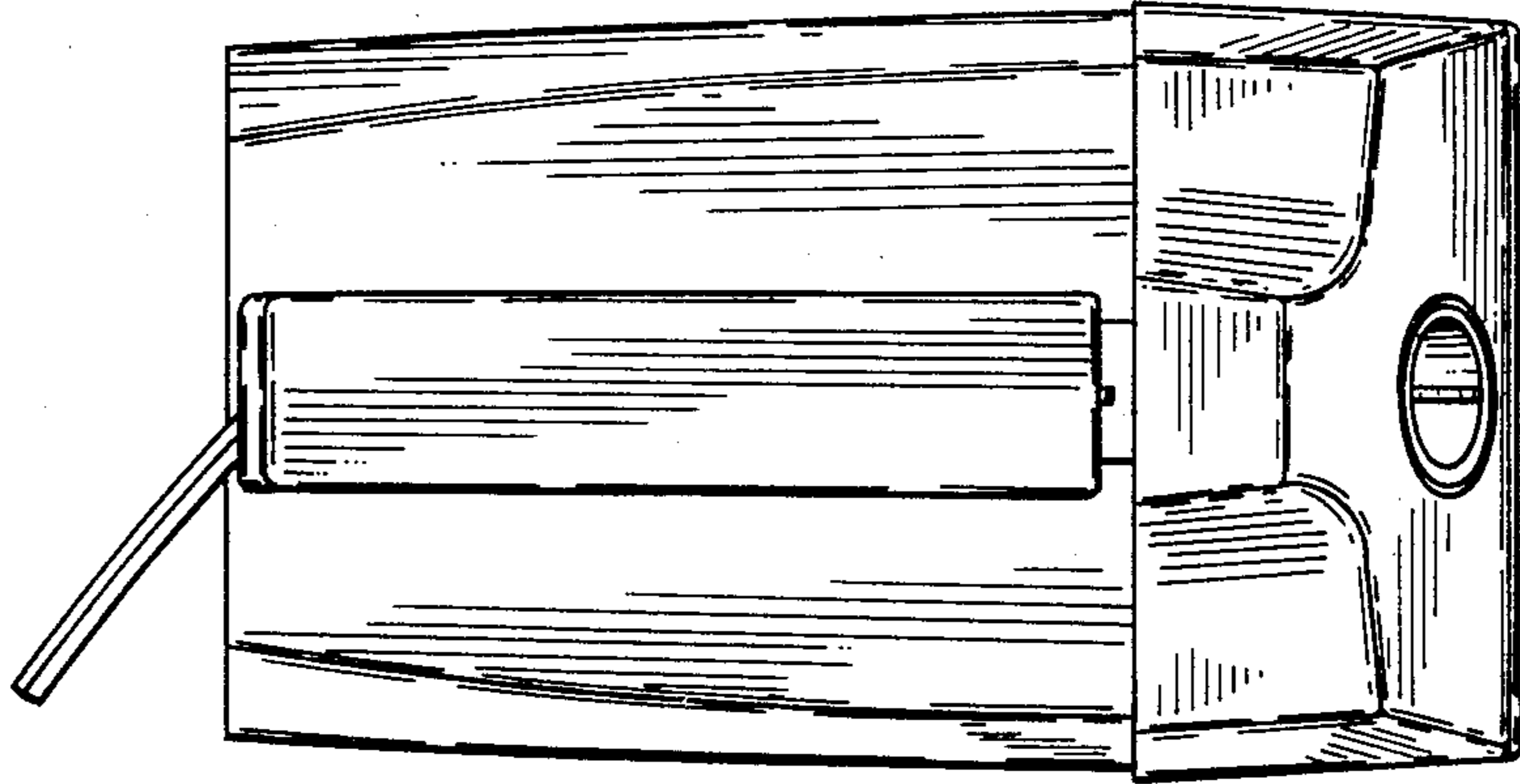

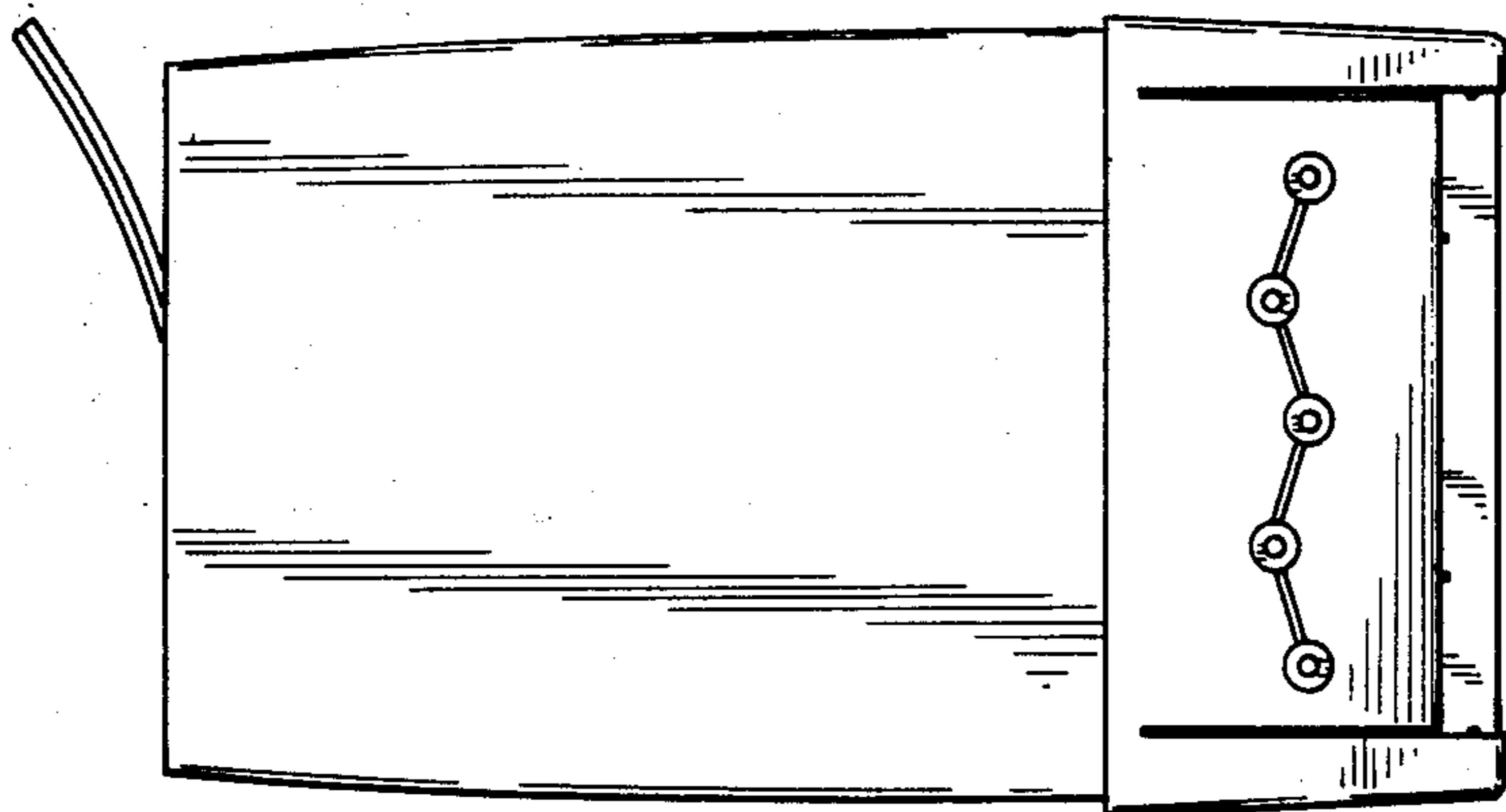

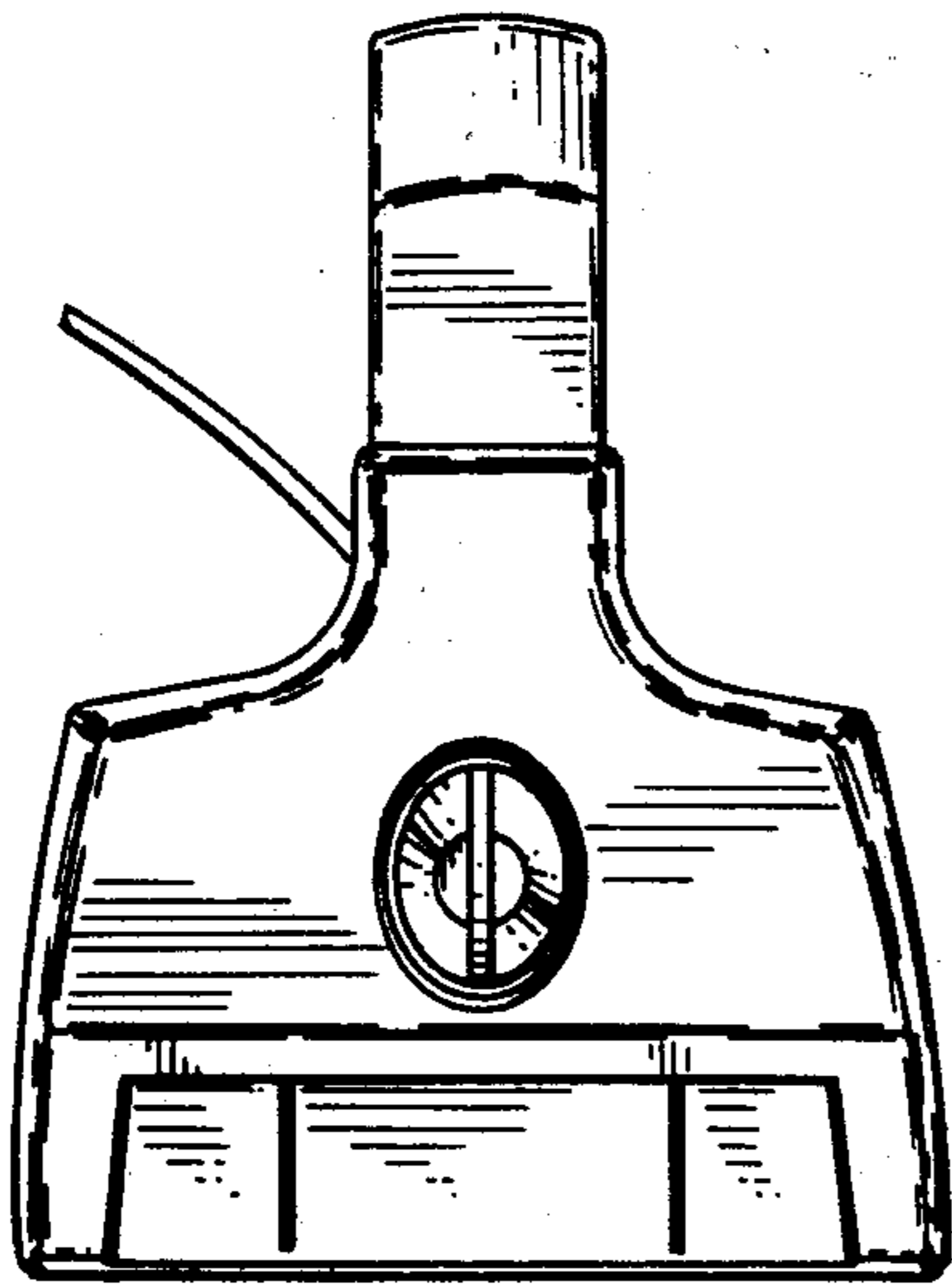

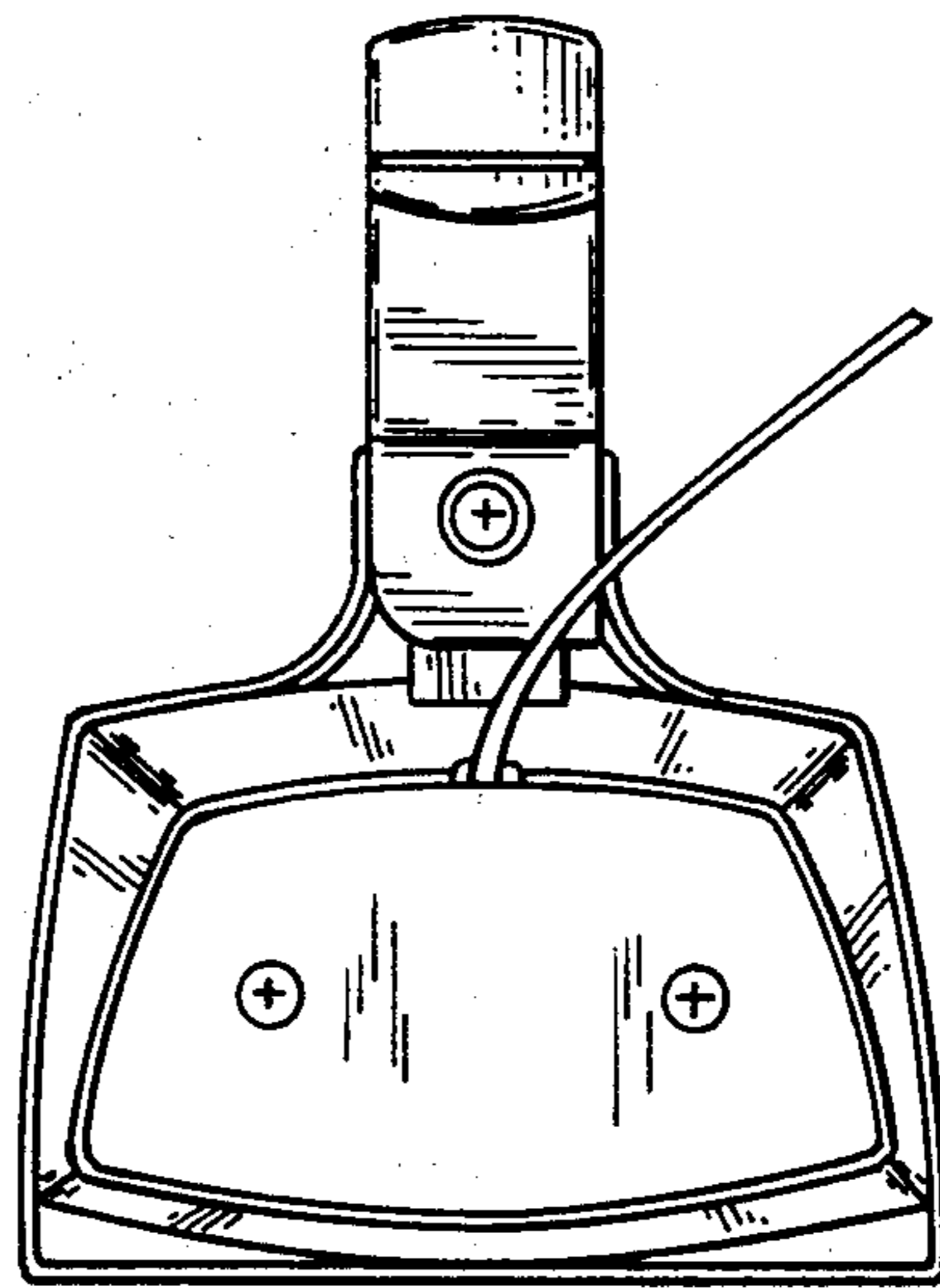

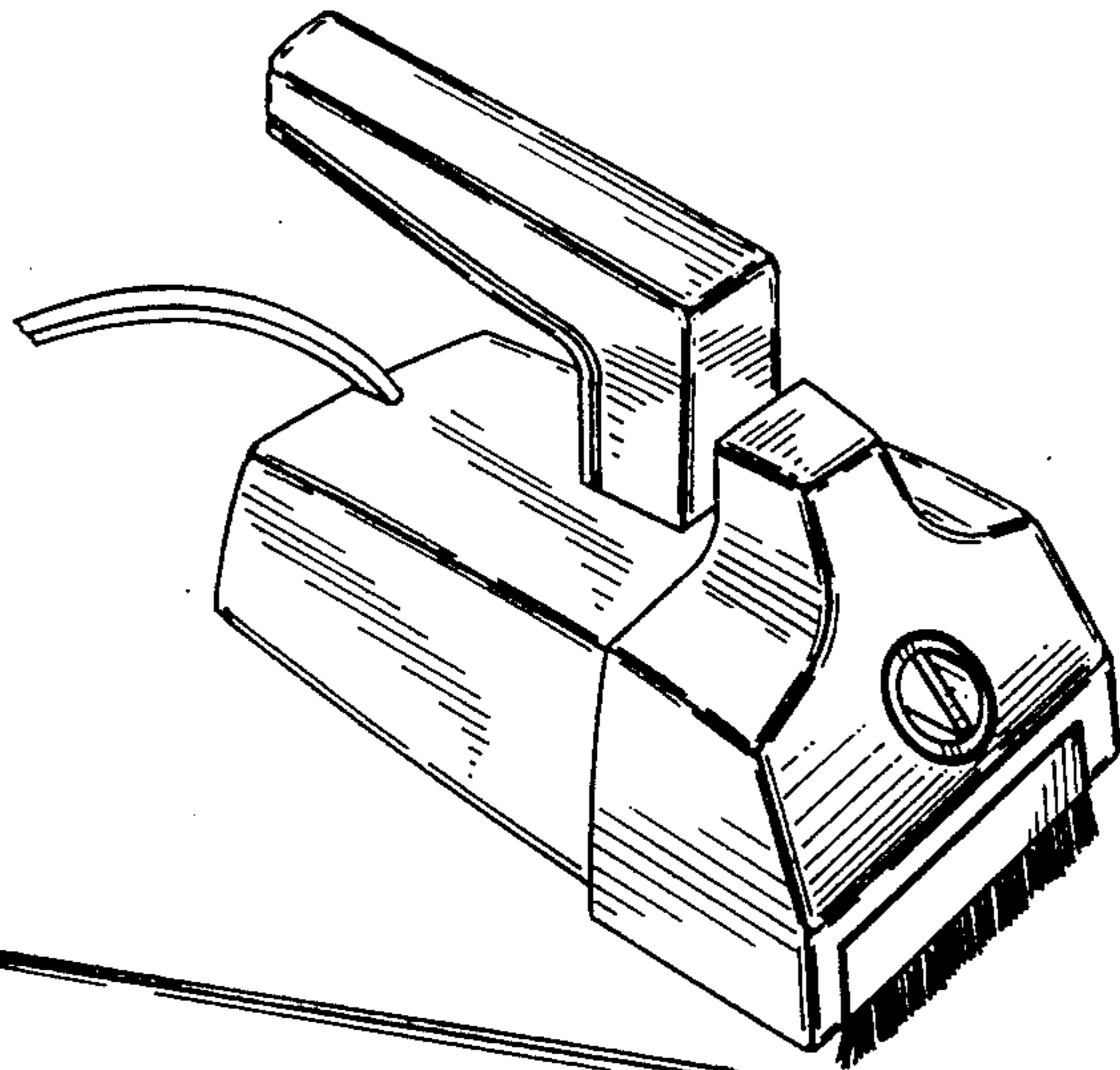

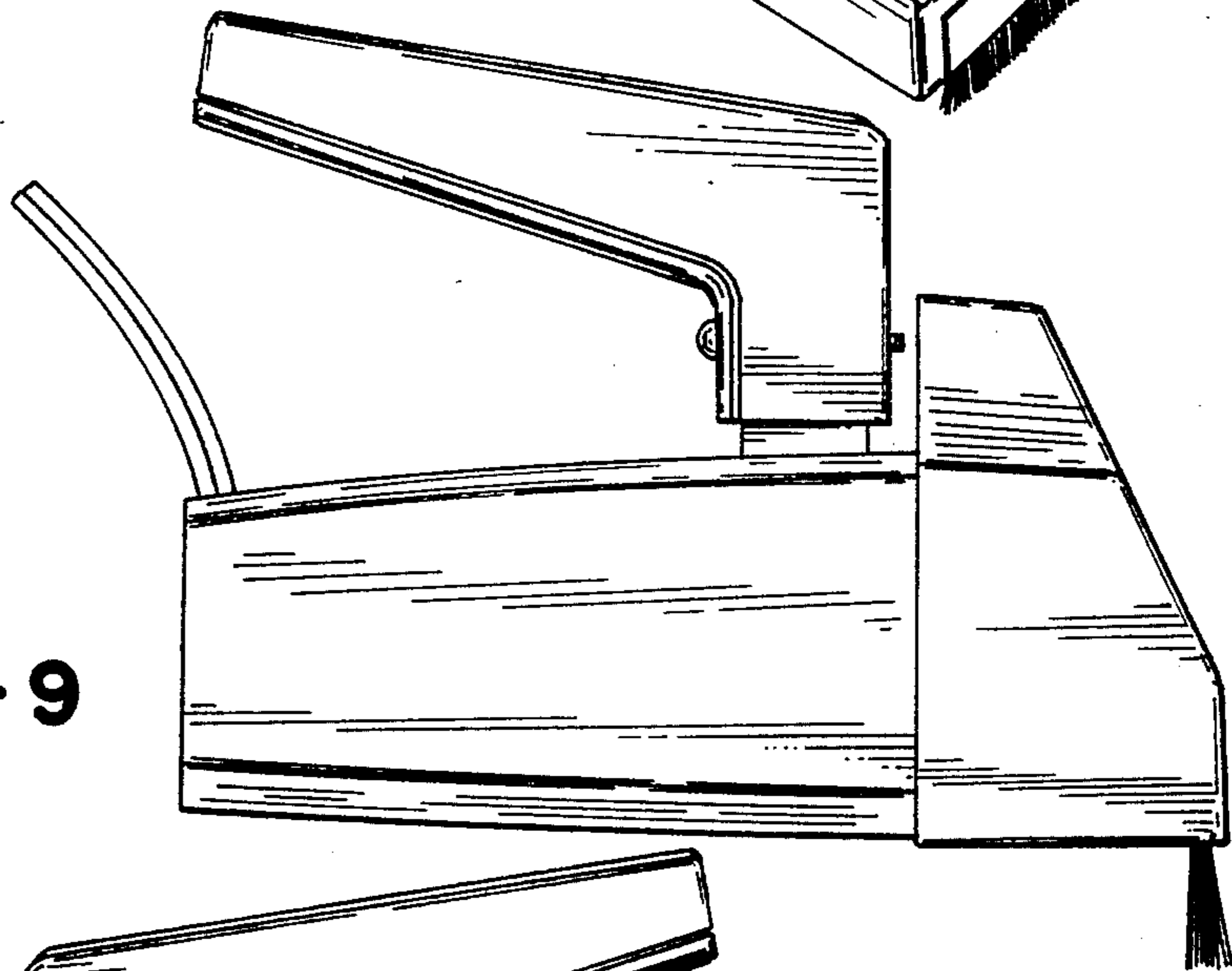
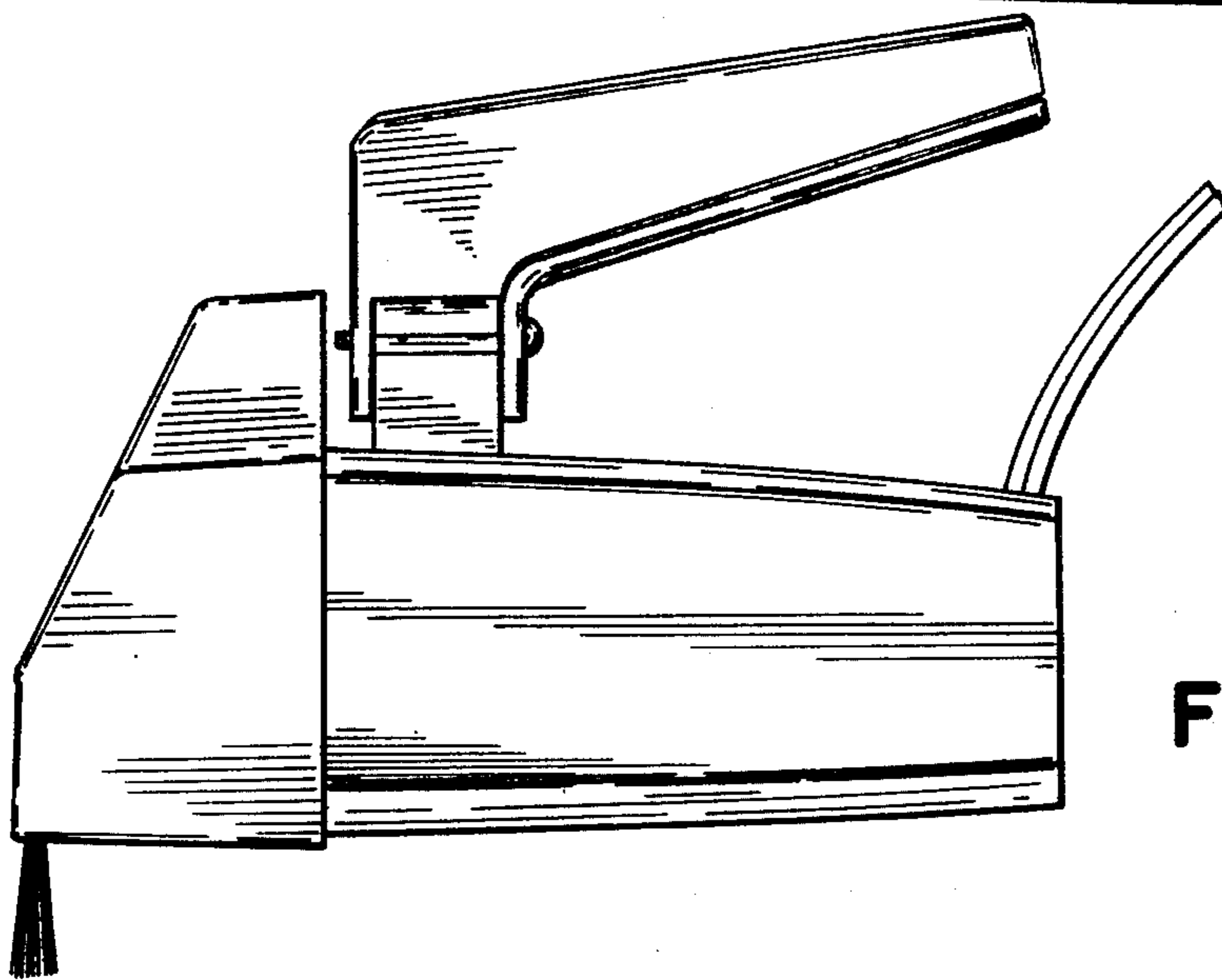

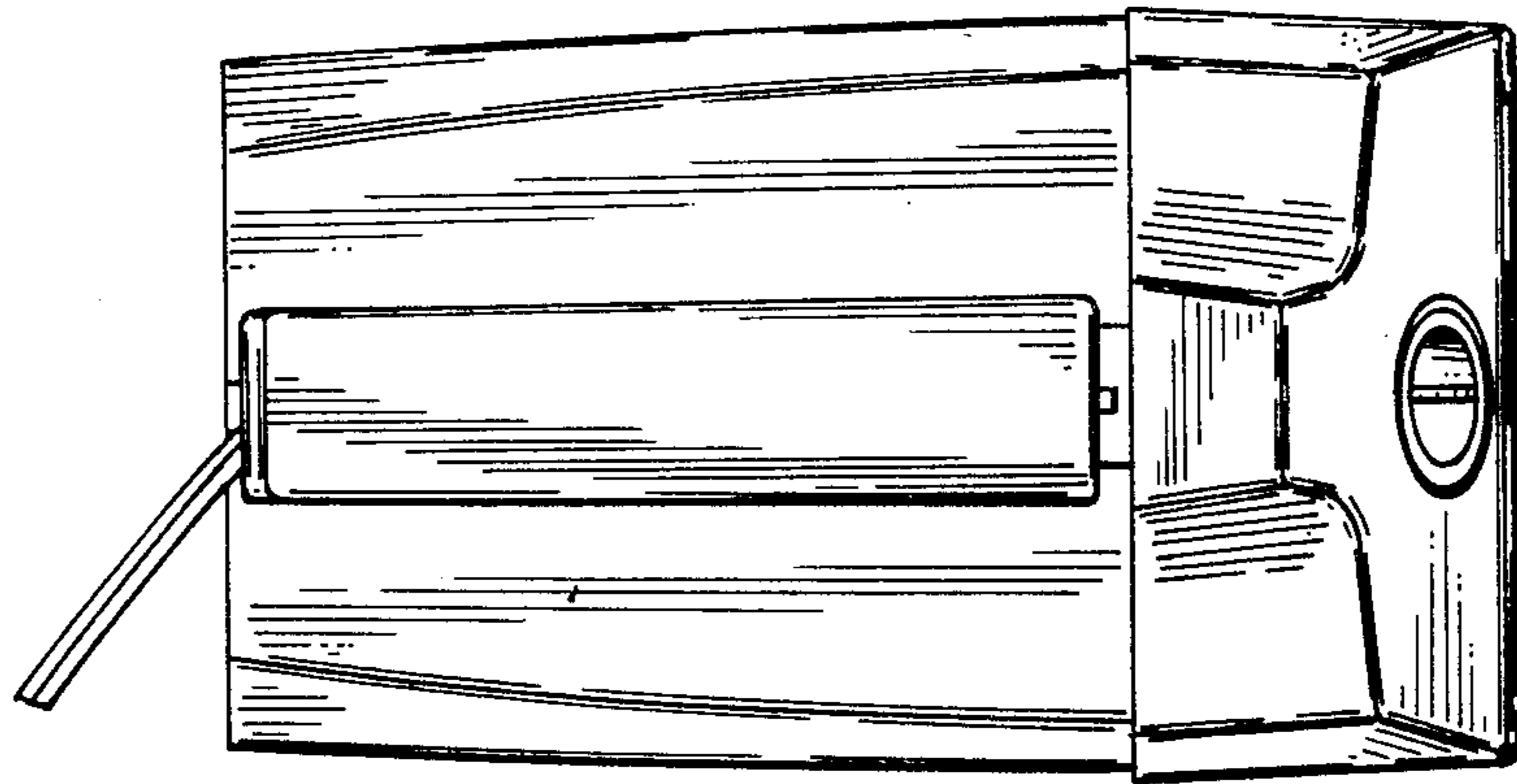

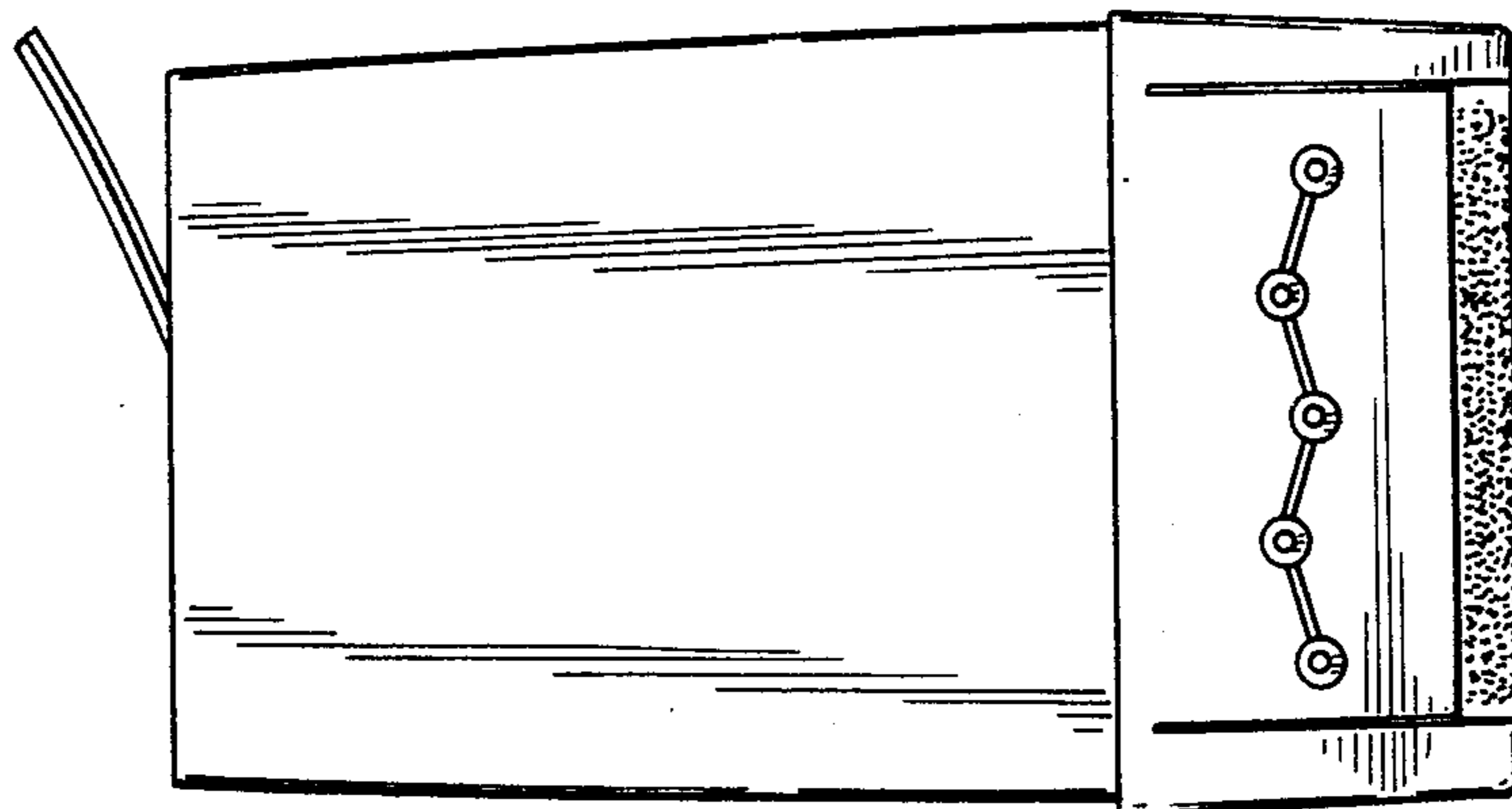

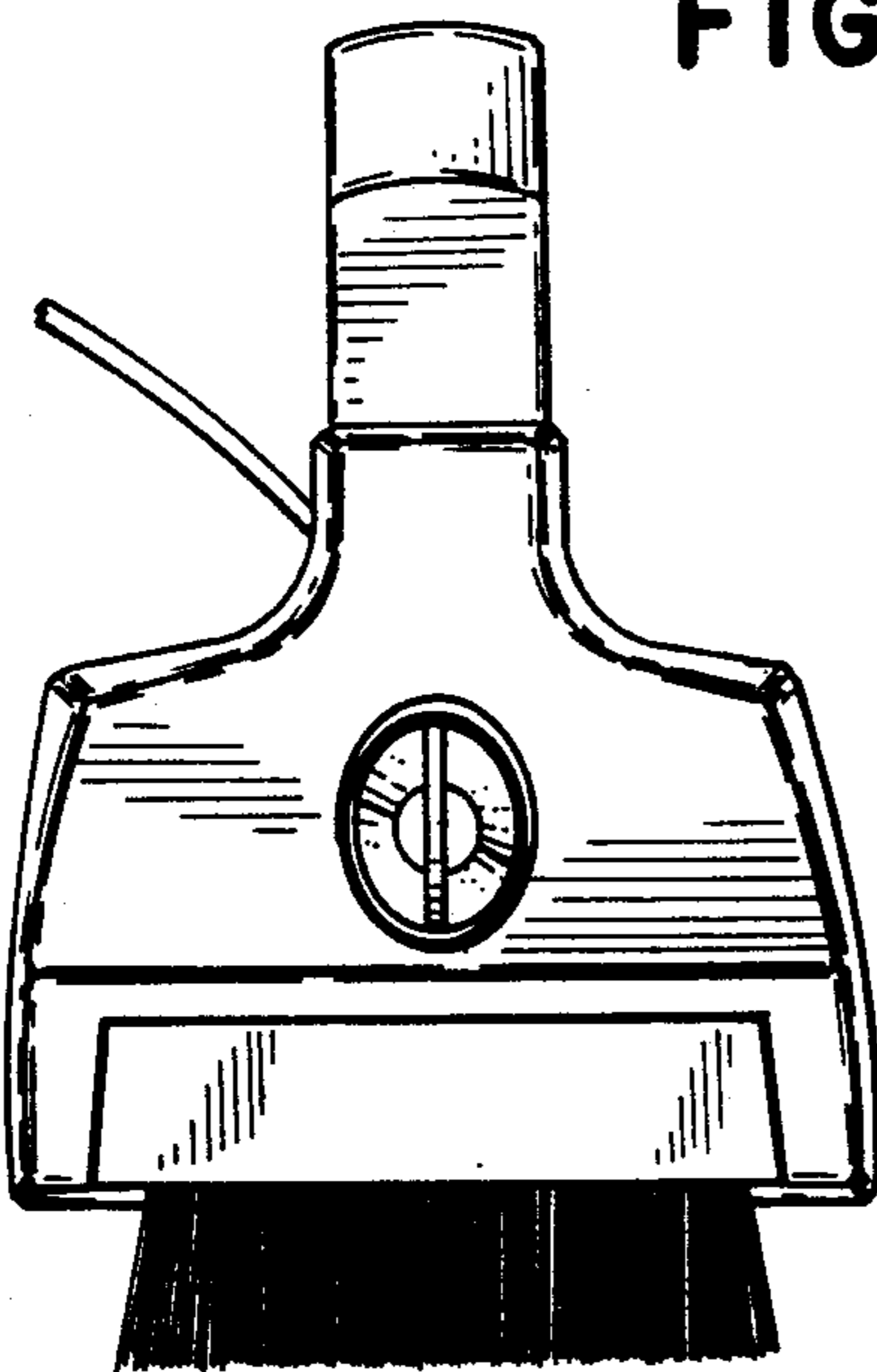

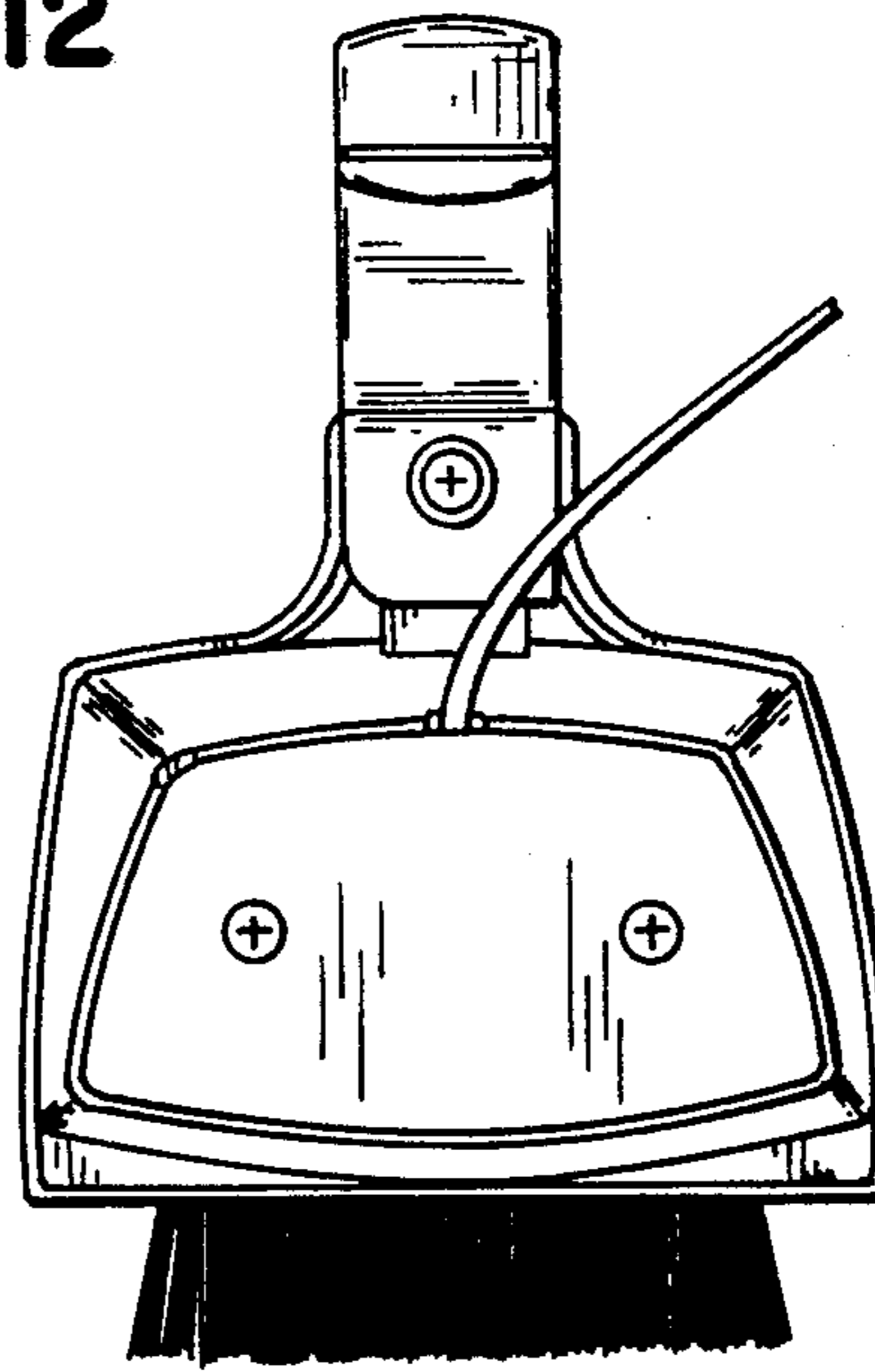
