The broken line in FIGS. 1, 7 and 13 is for illustrative purposes only and forms no part of the claimed design.

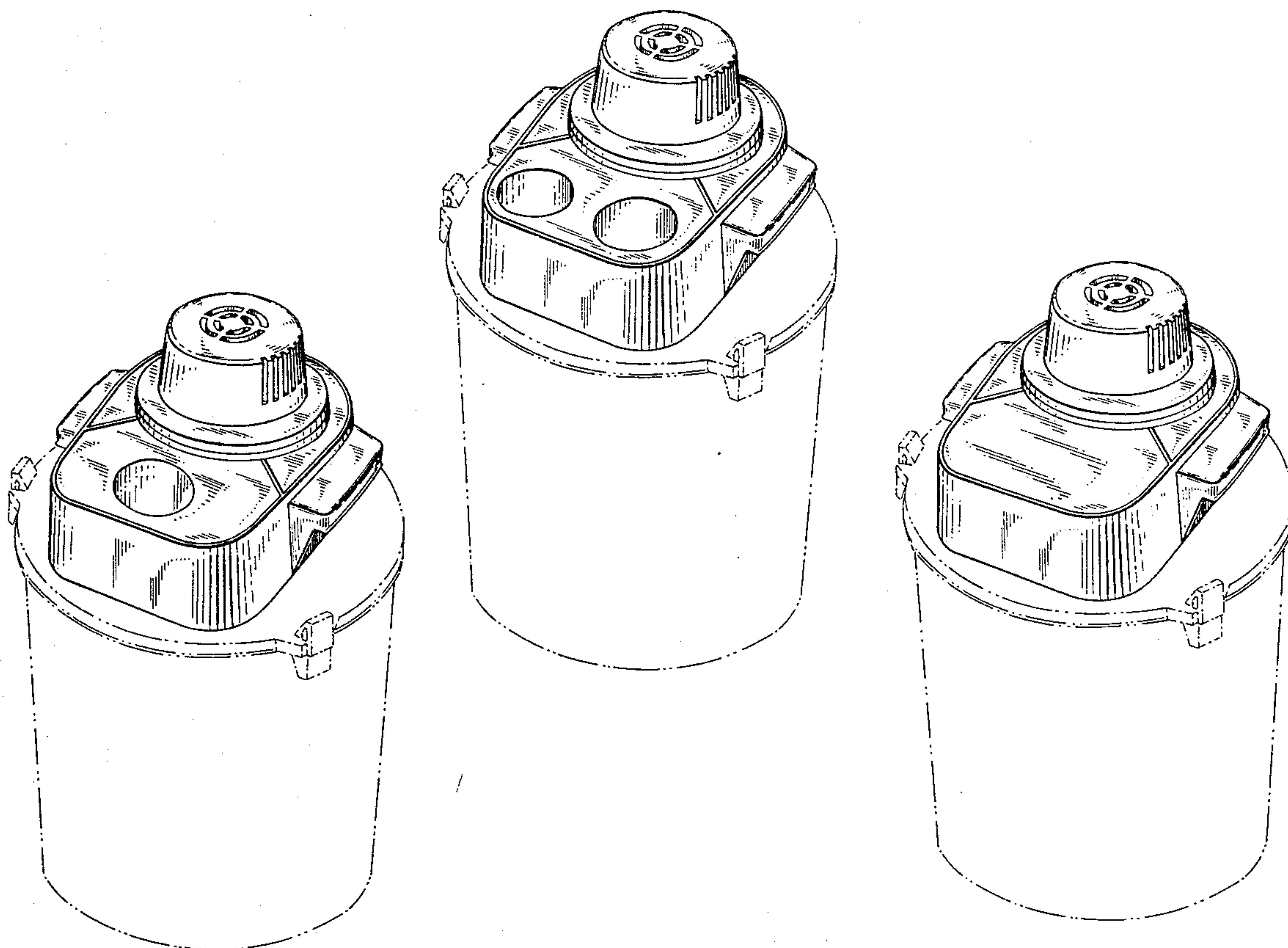

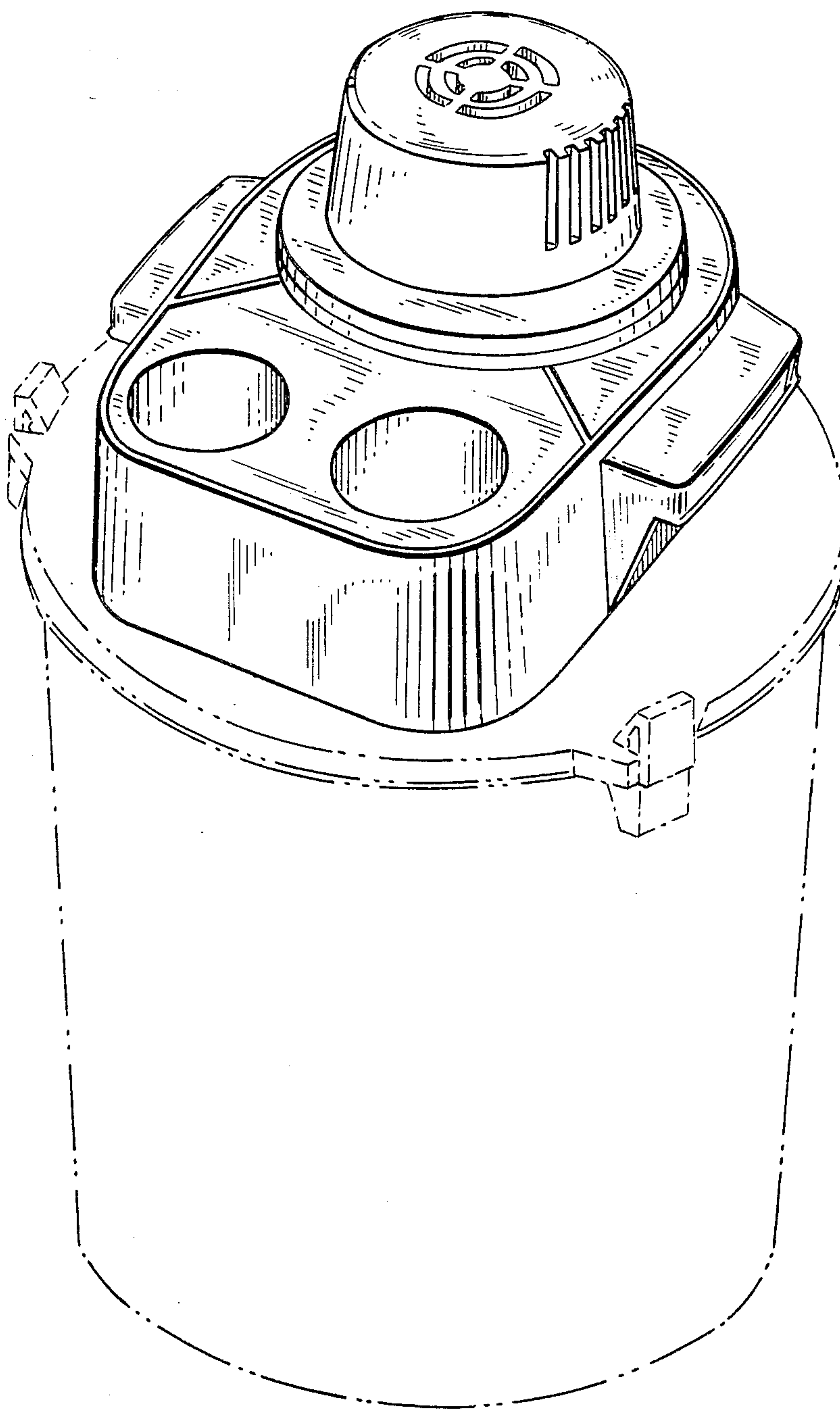
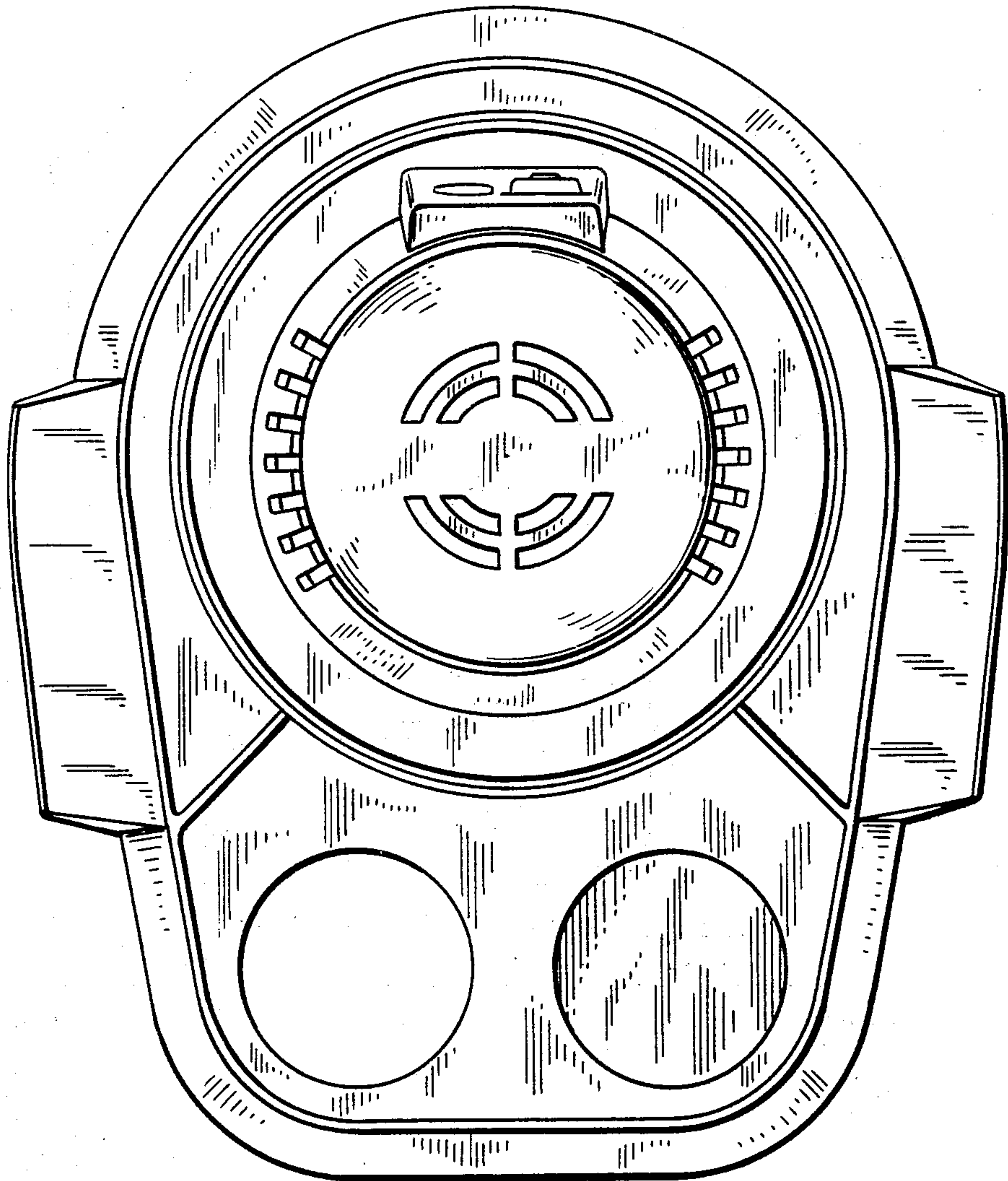

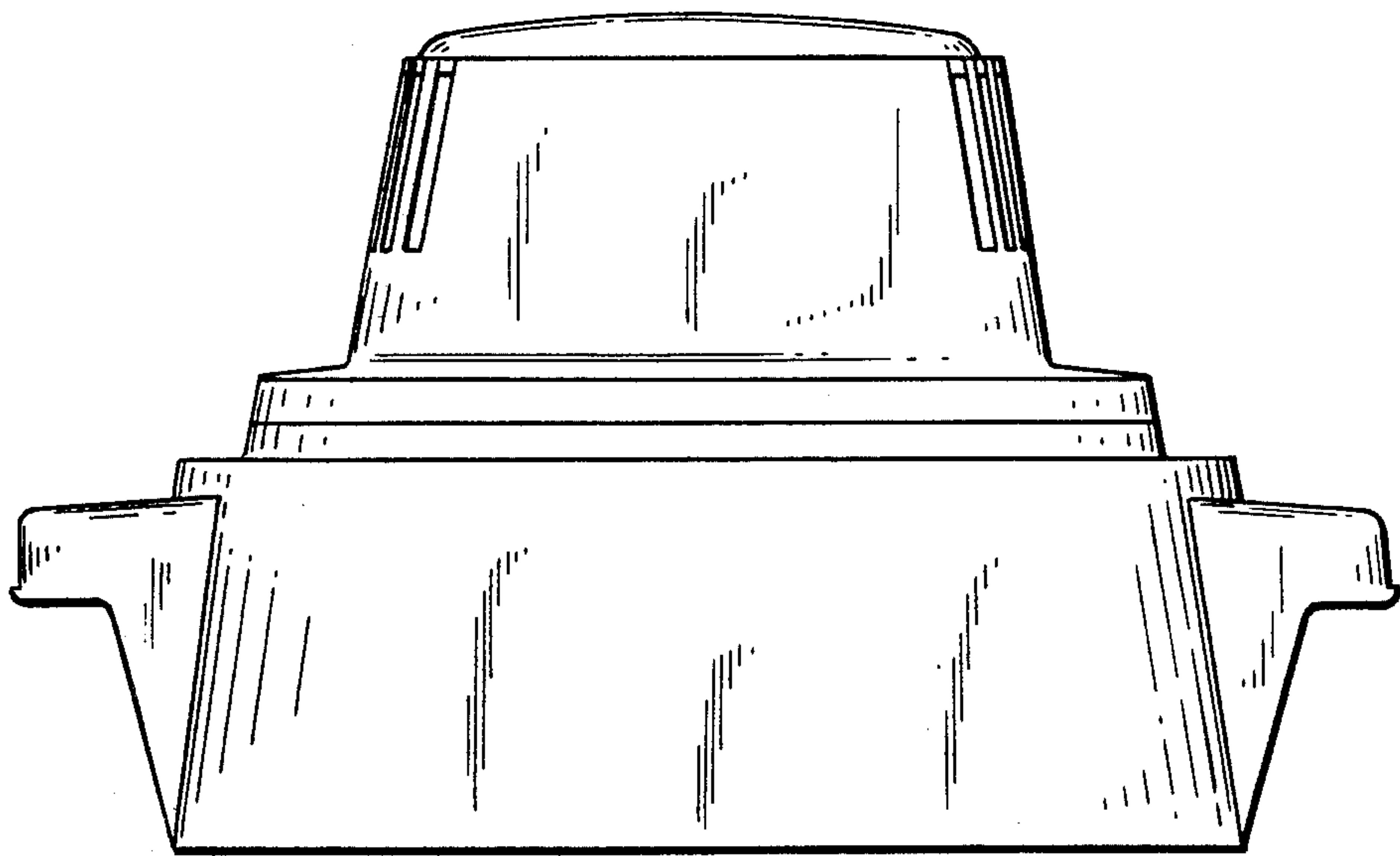

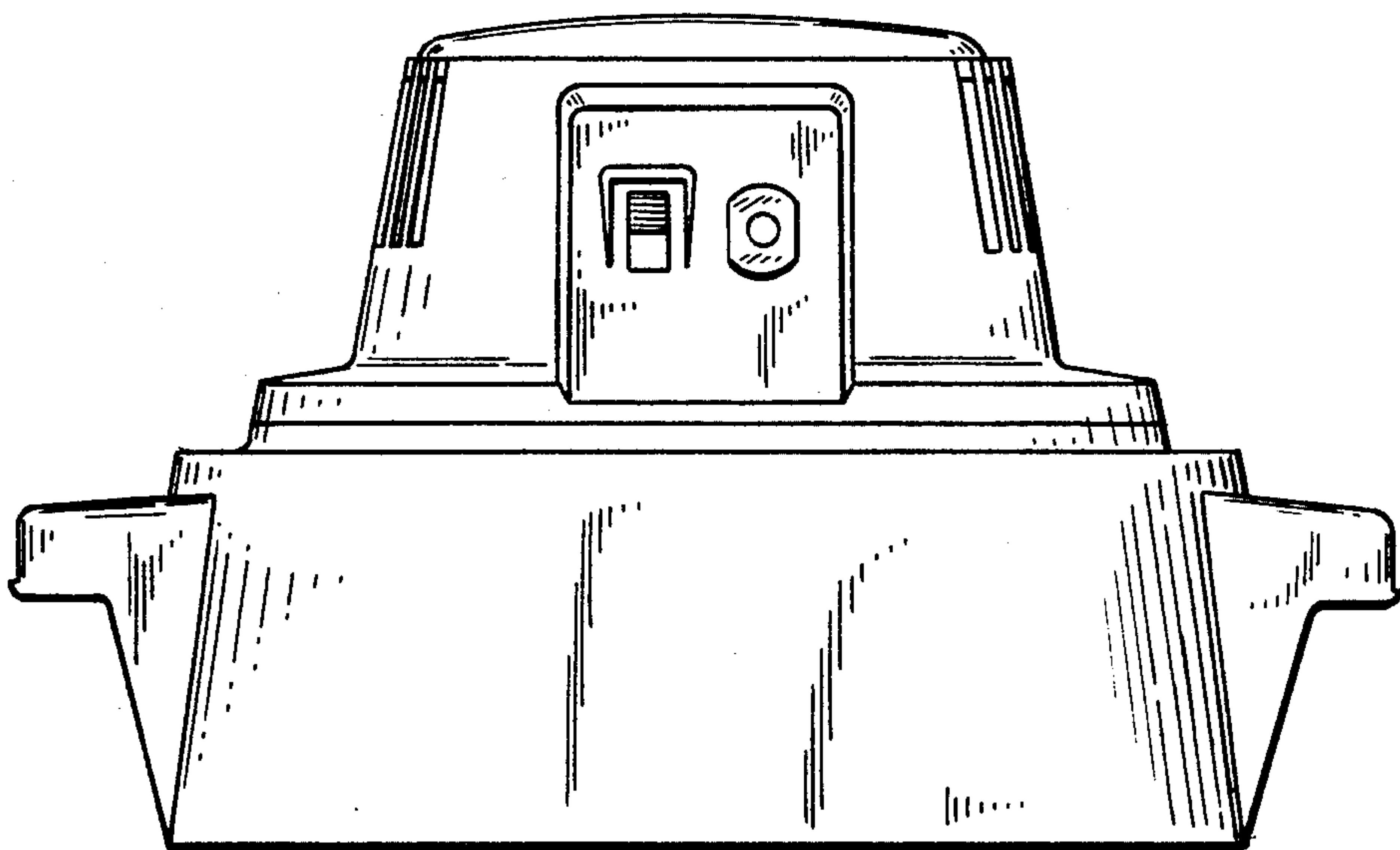

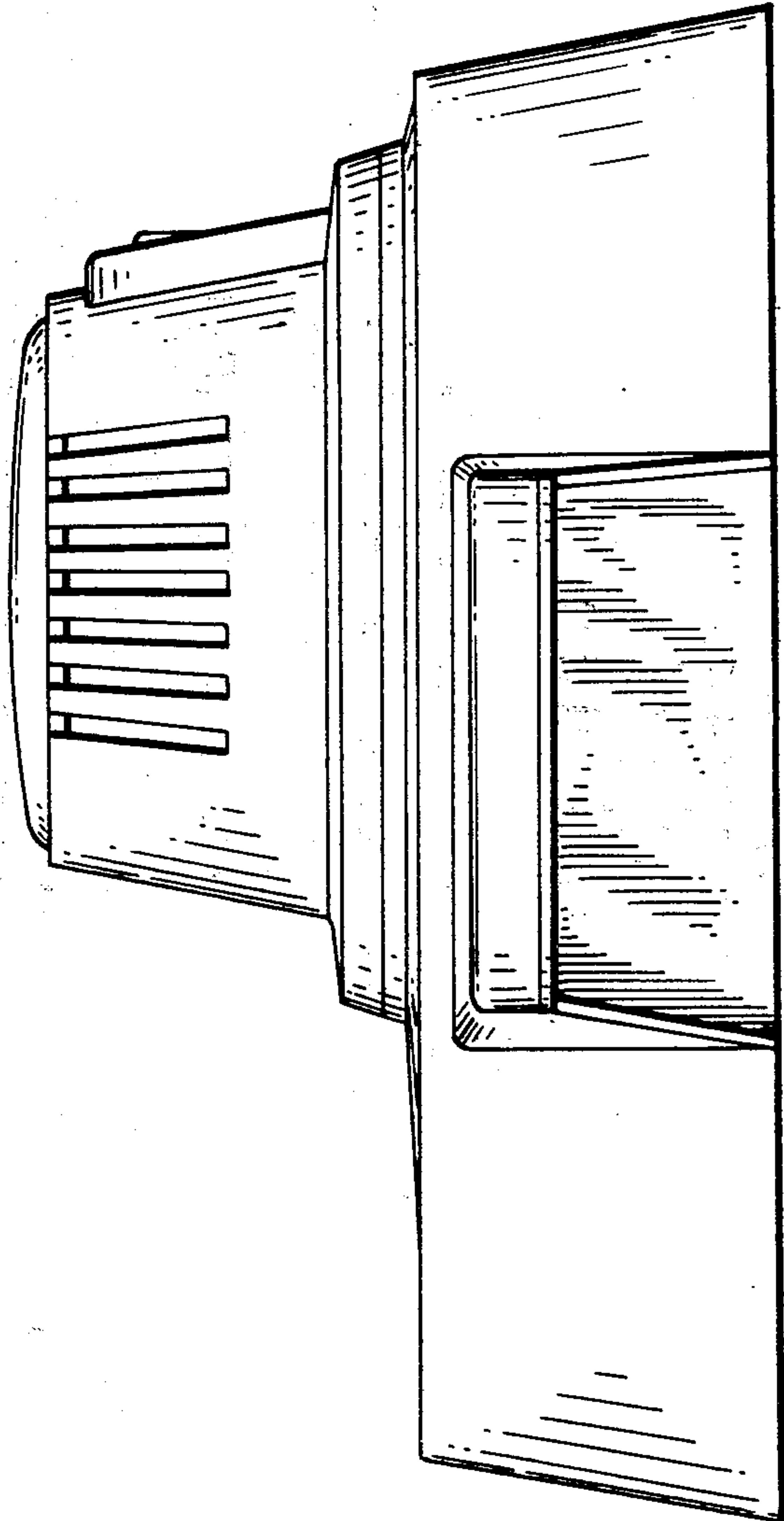

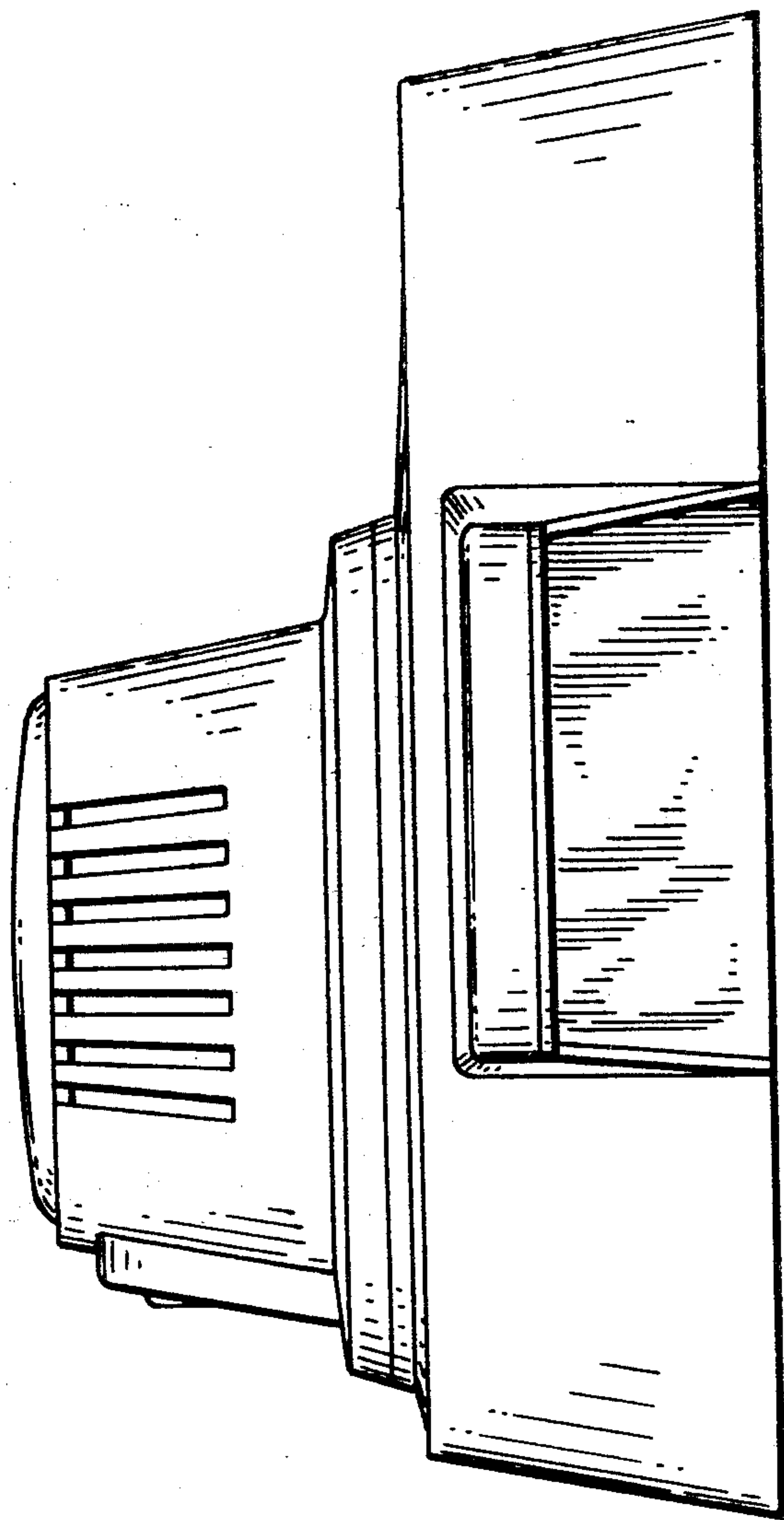

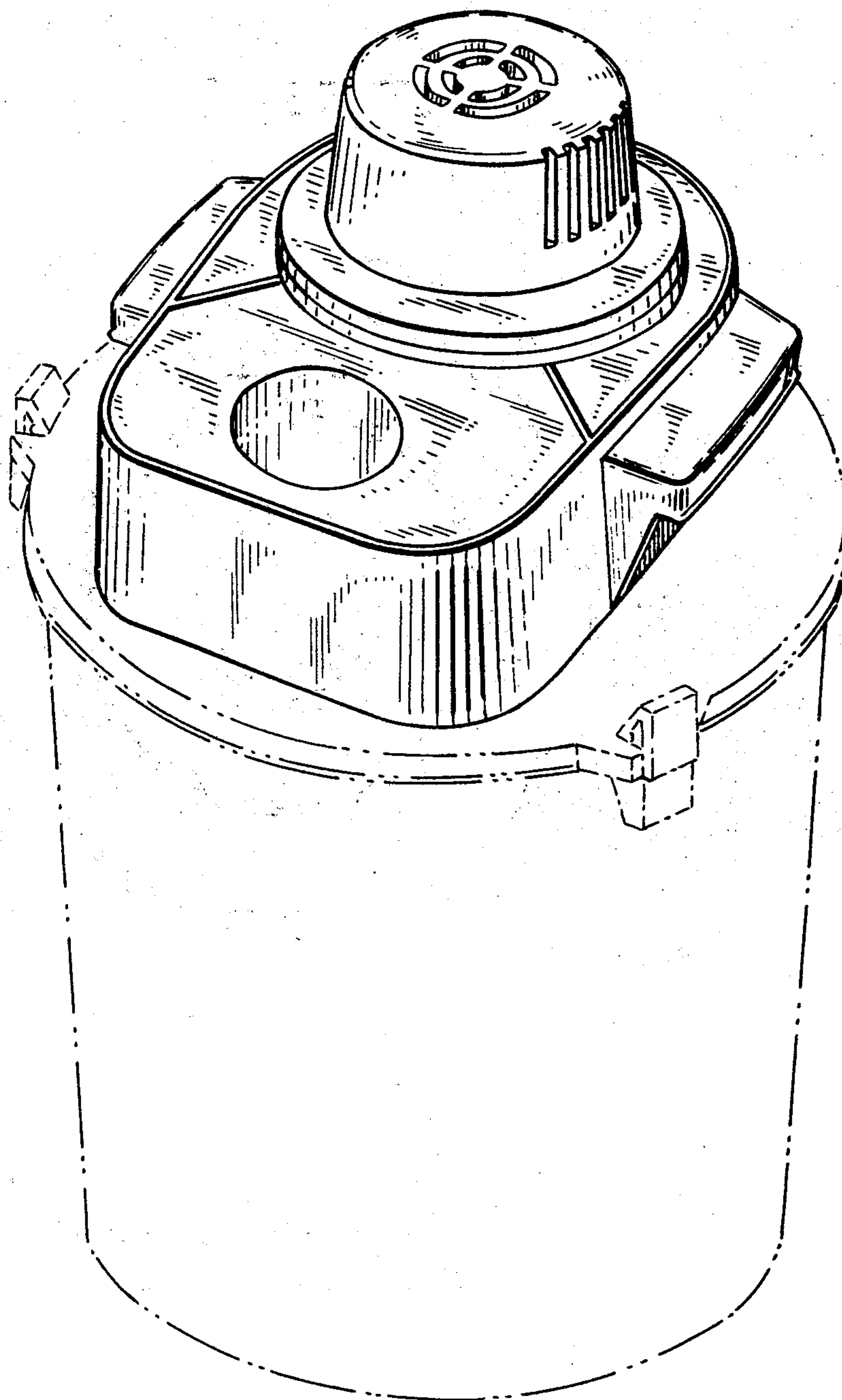
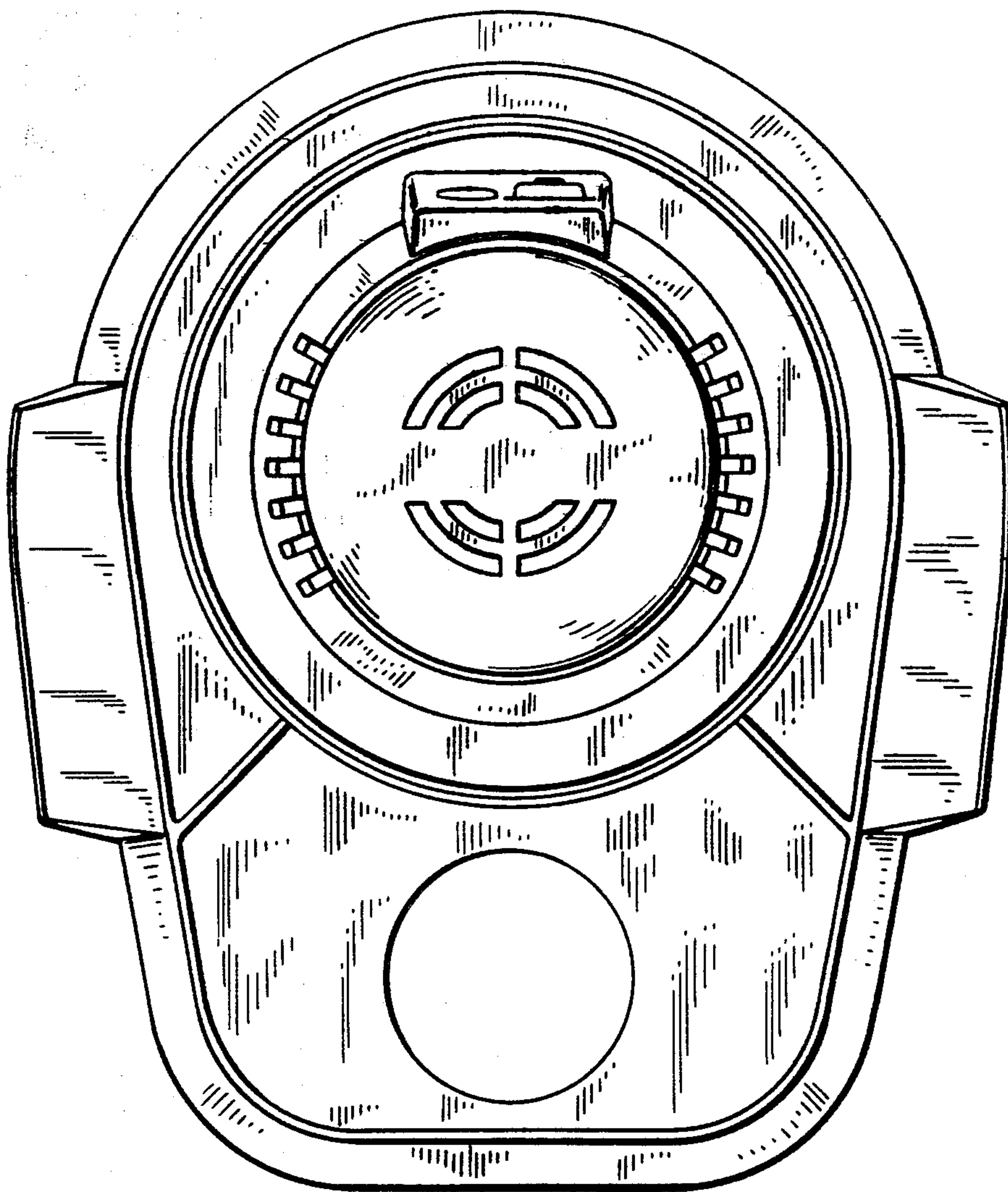

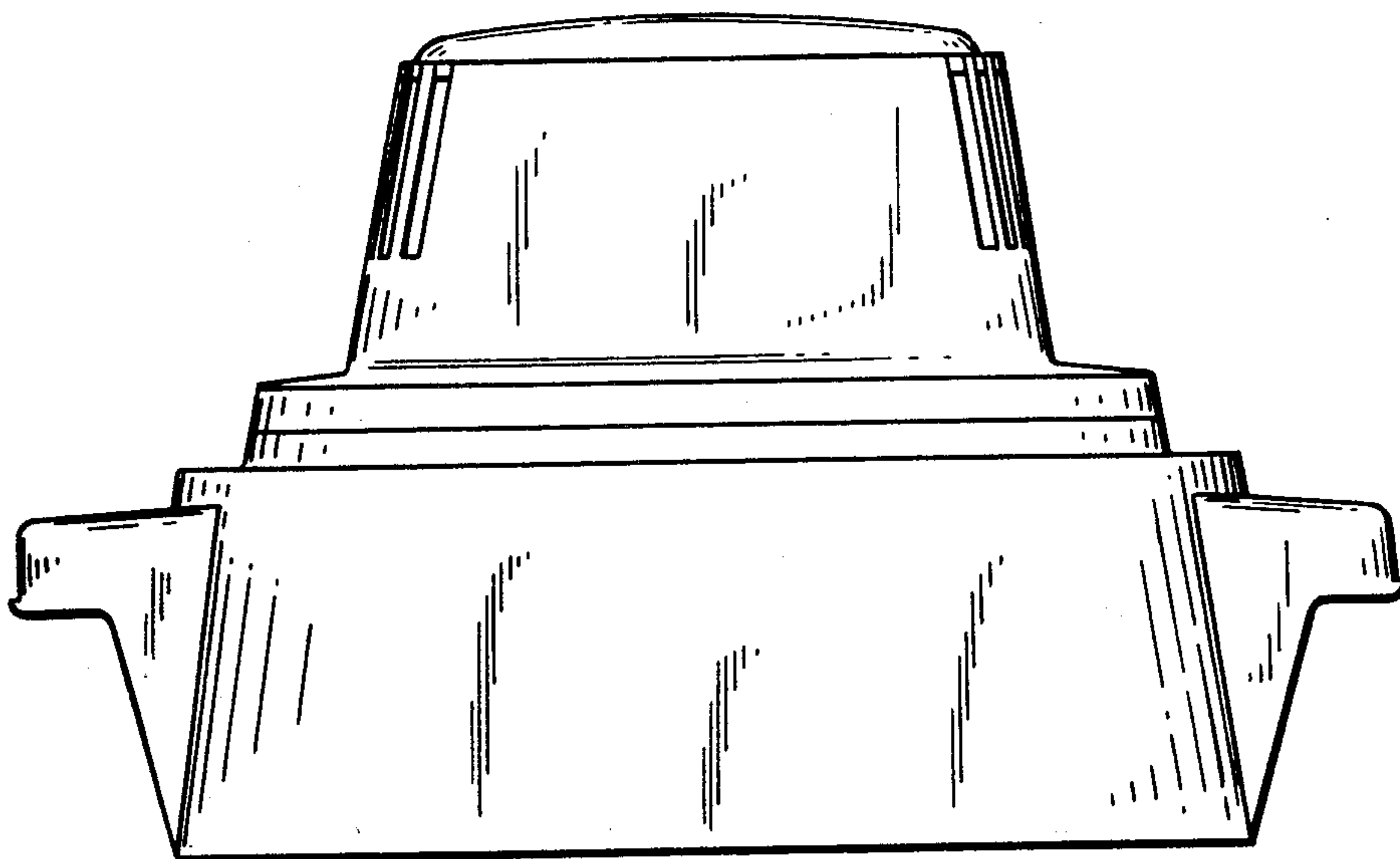

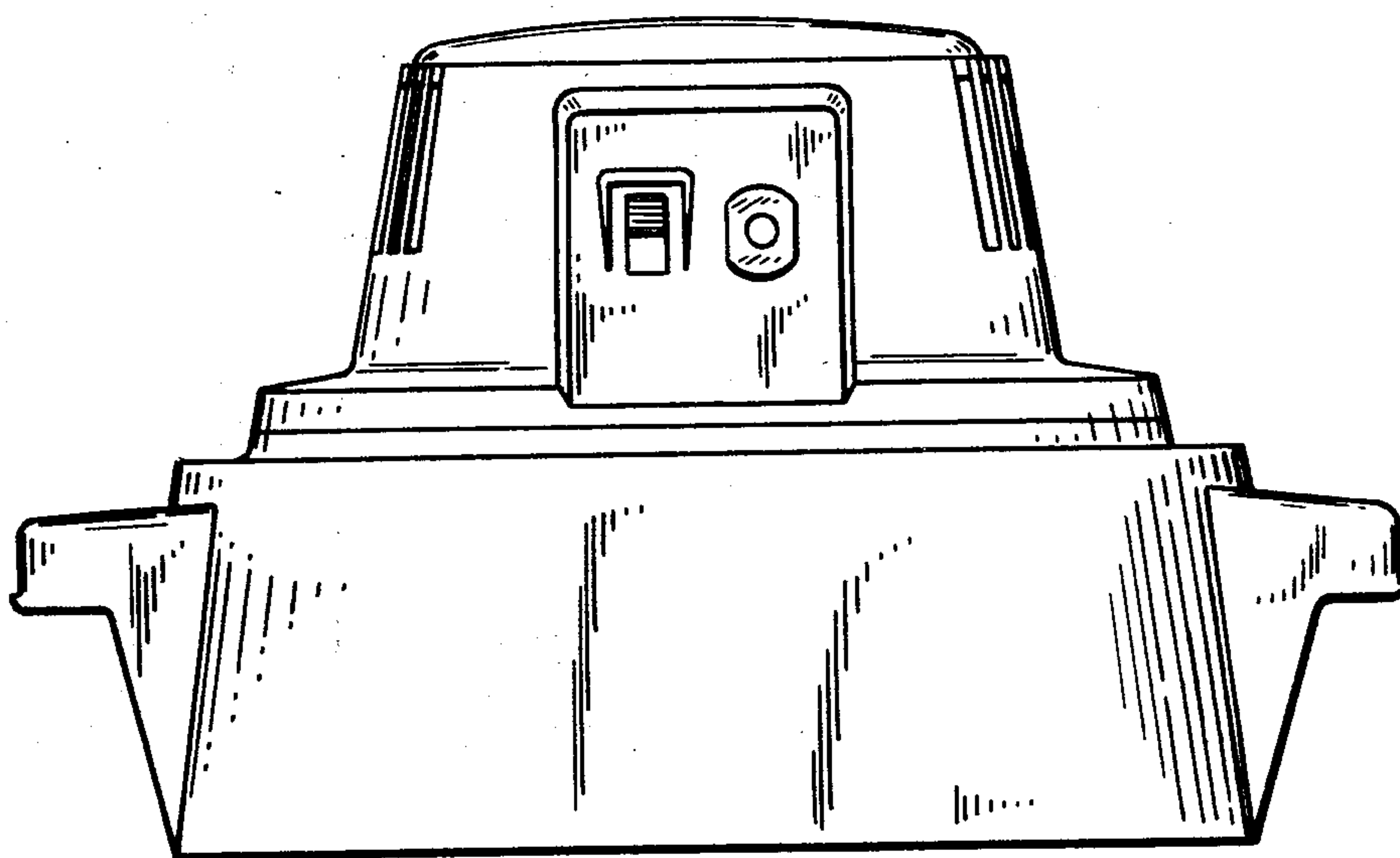

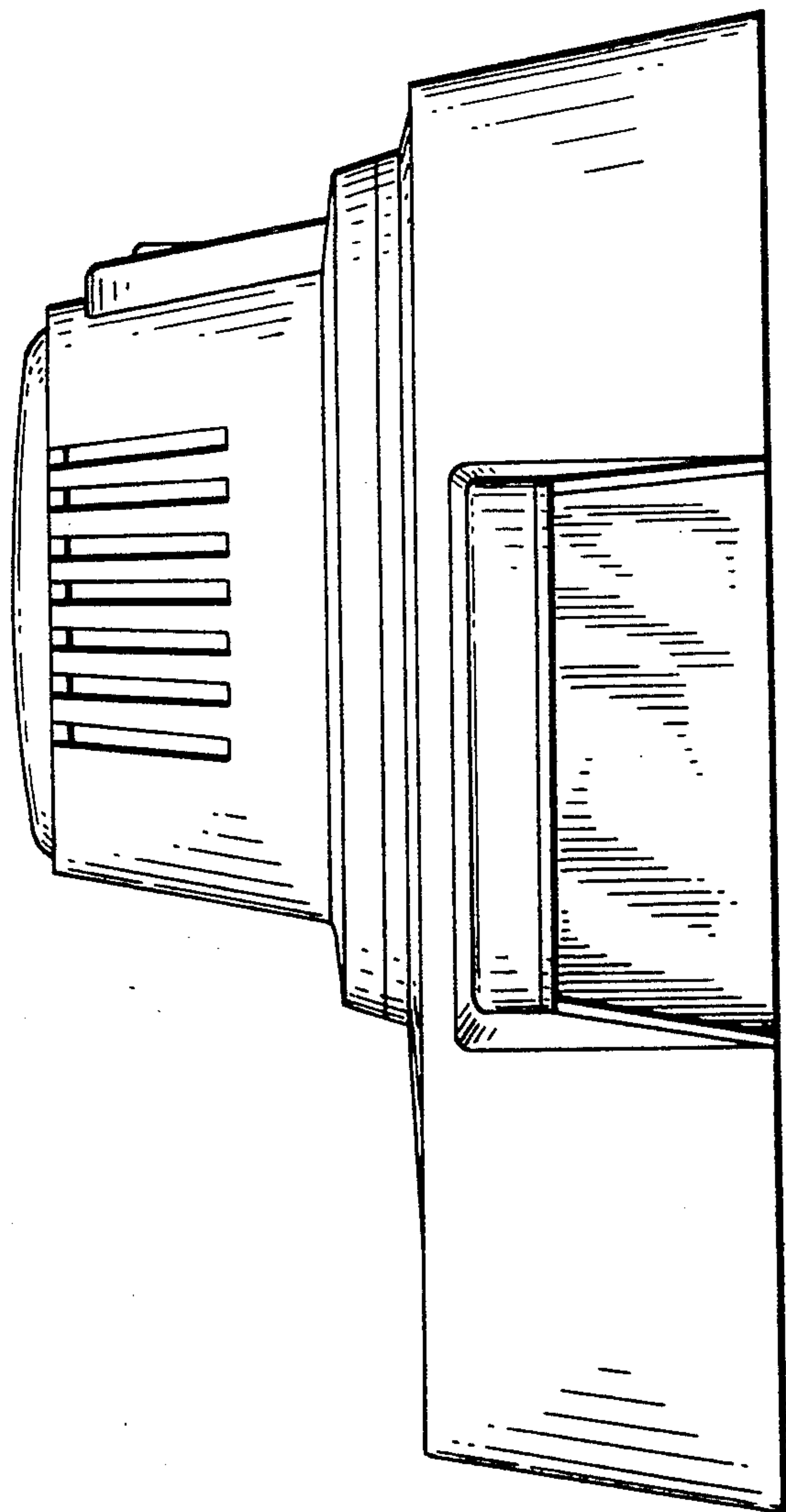

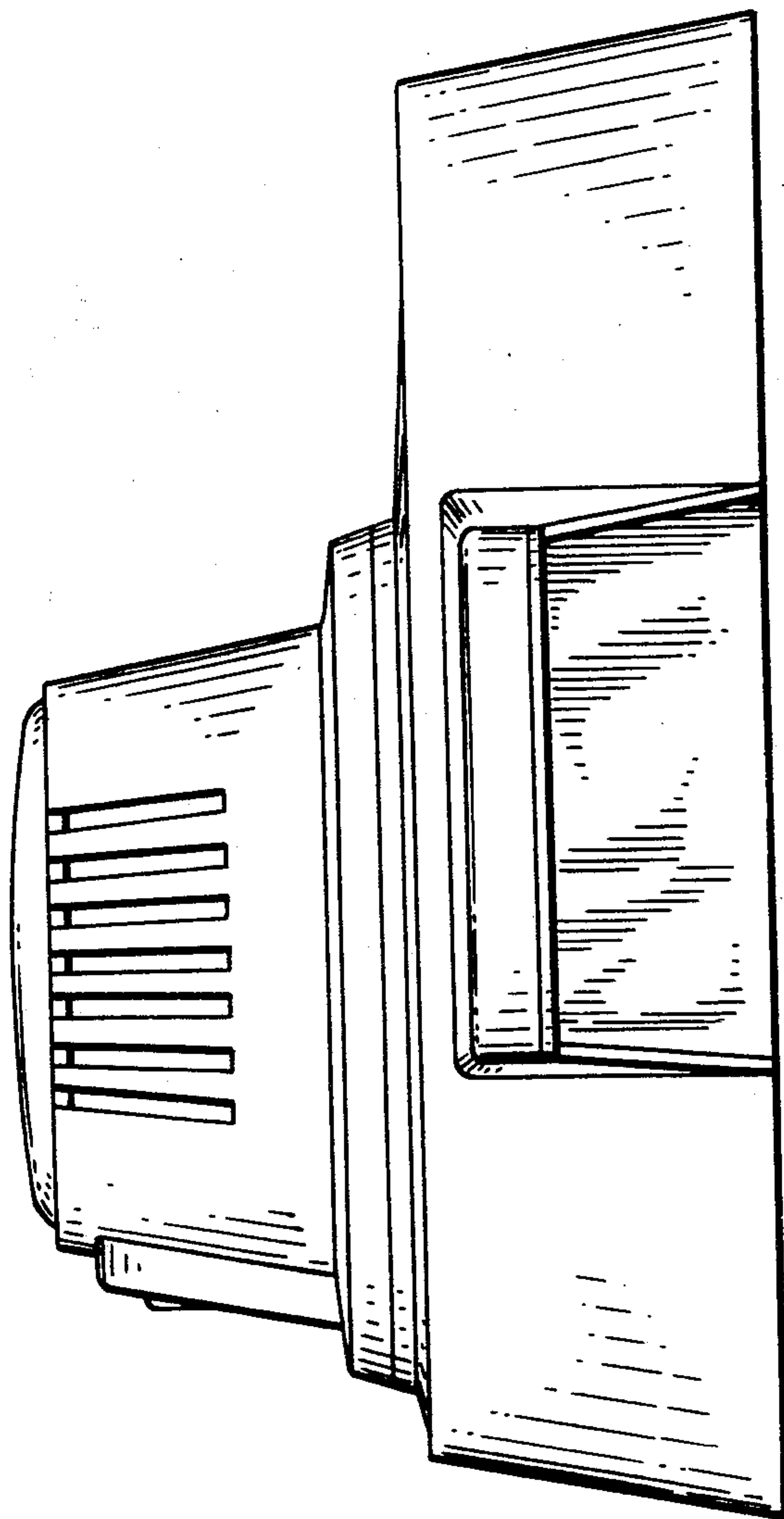

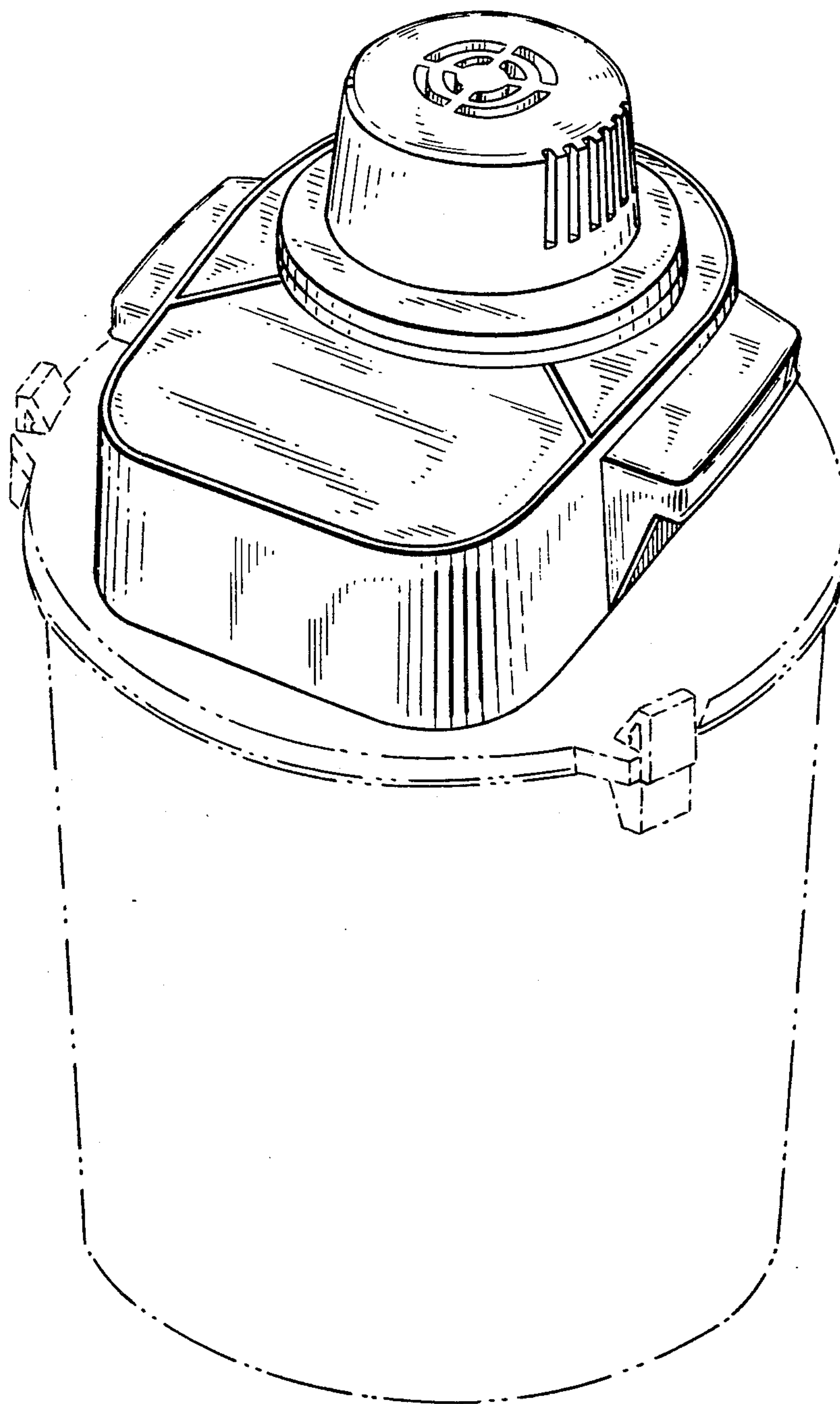
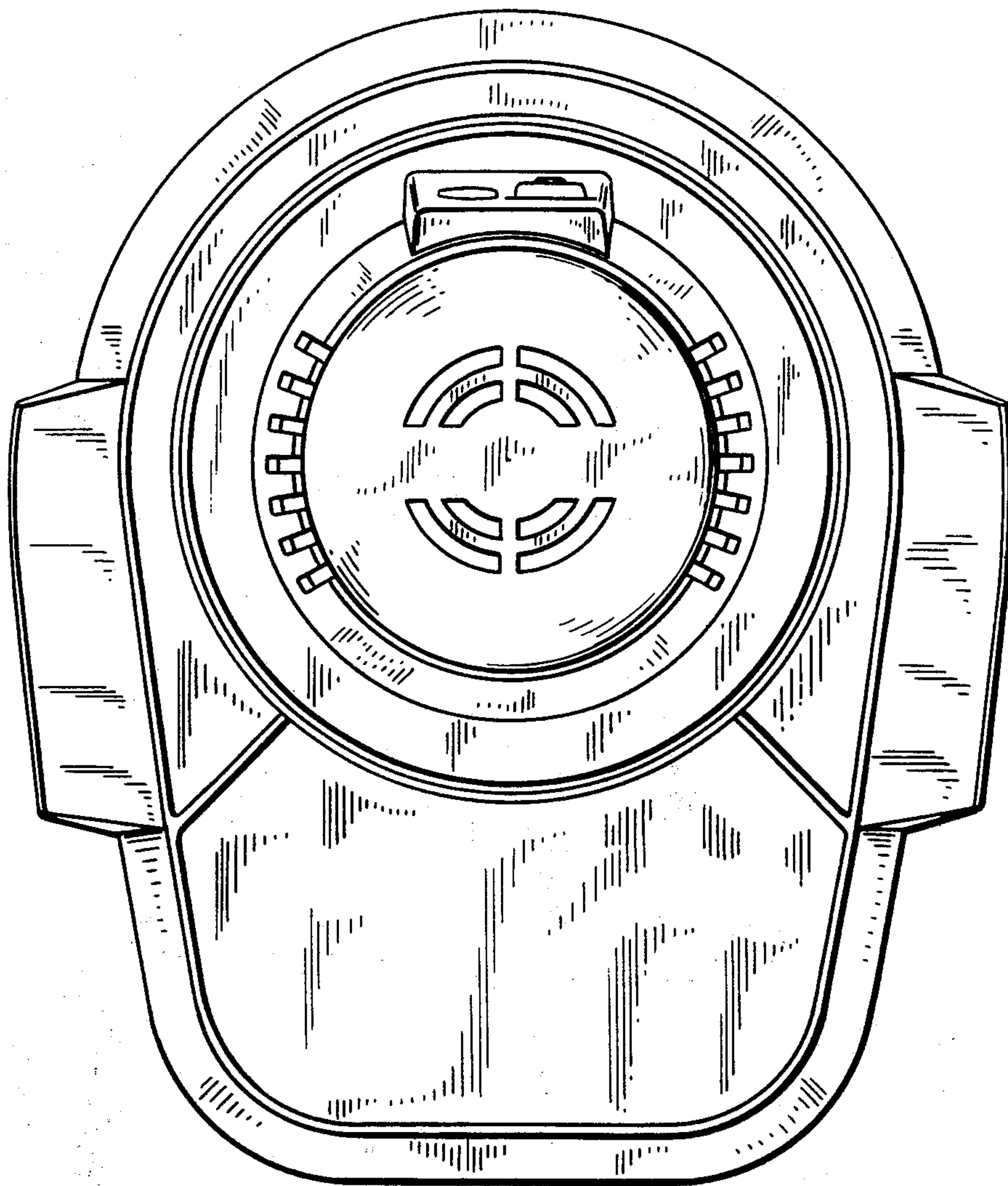

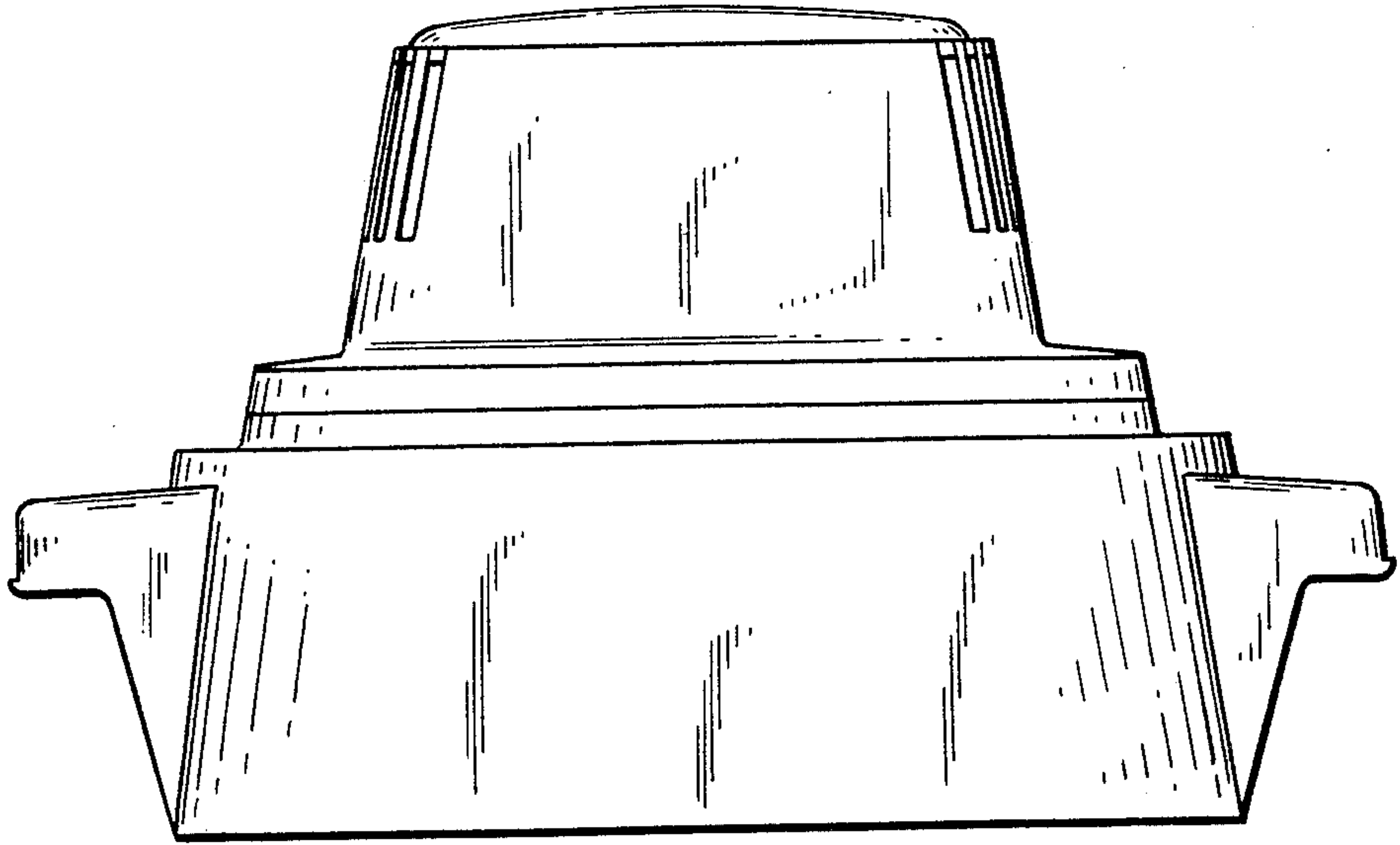

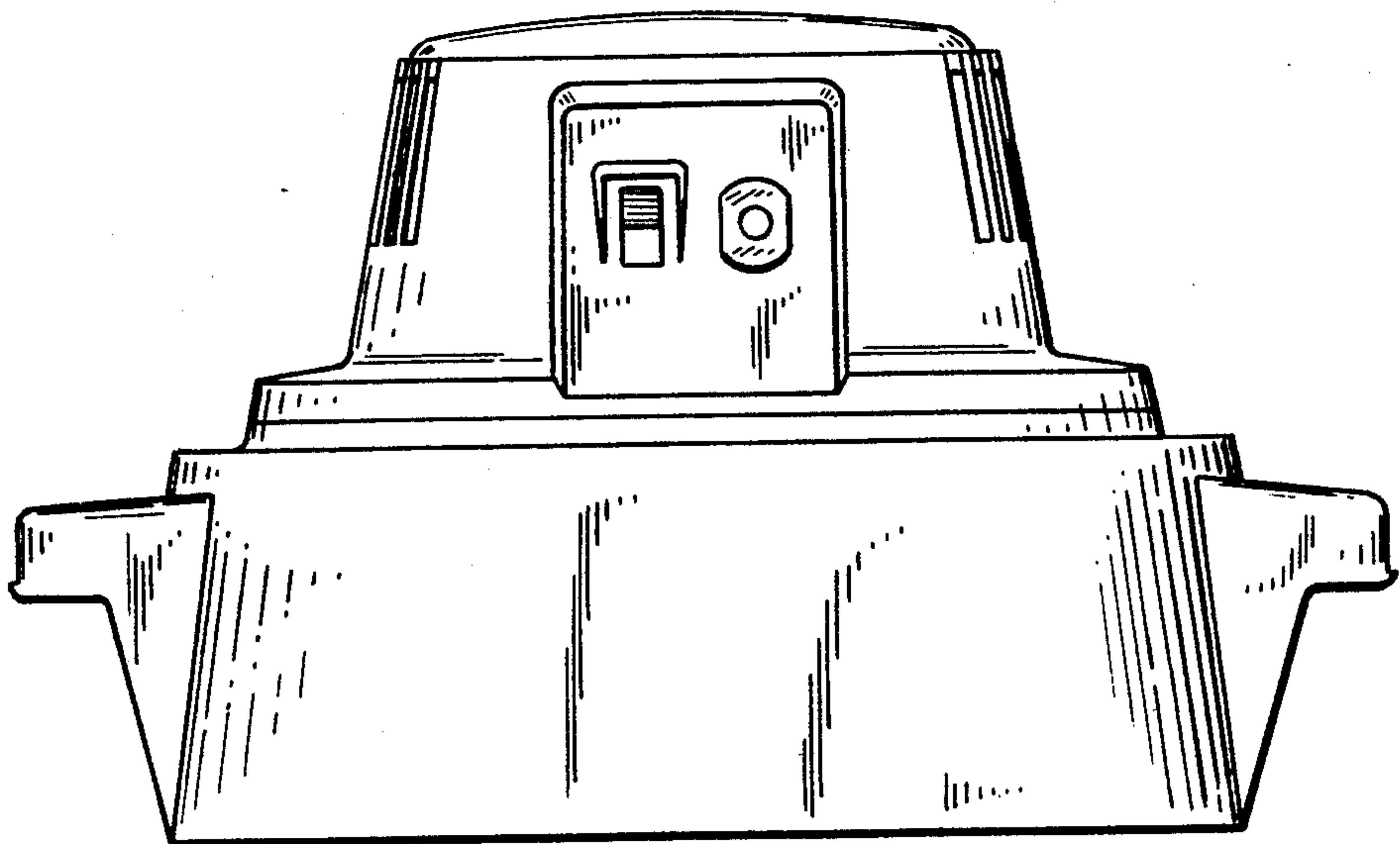

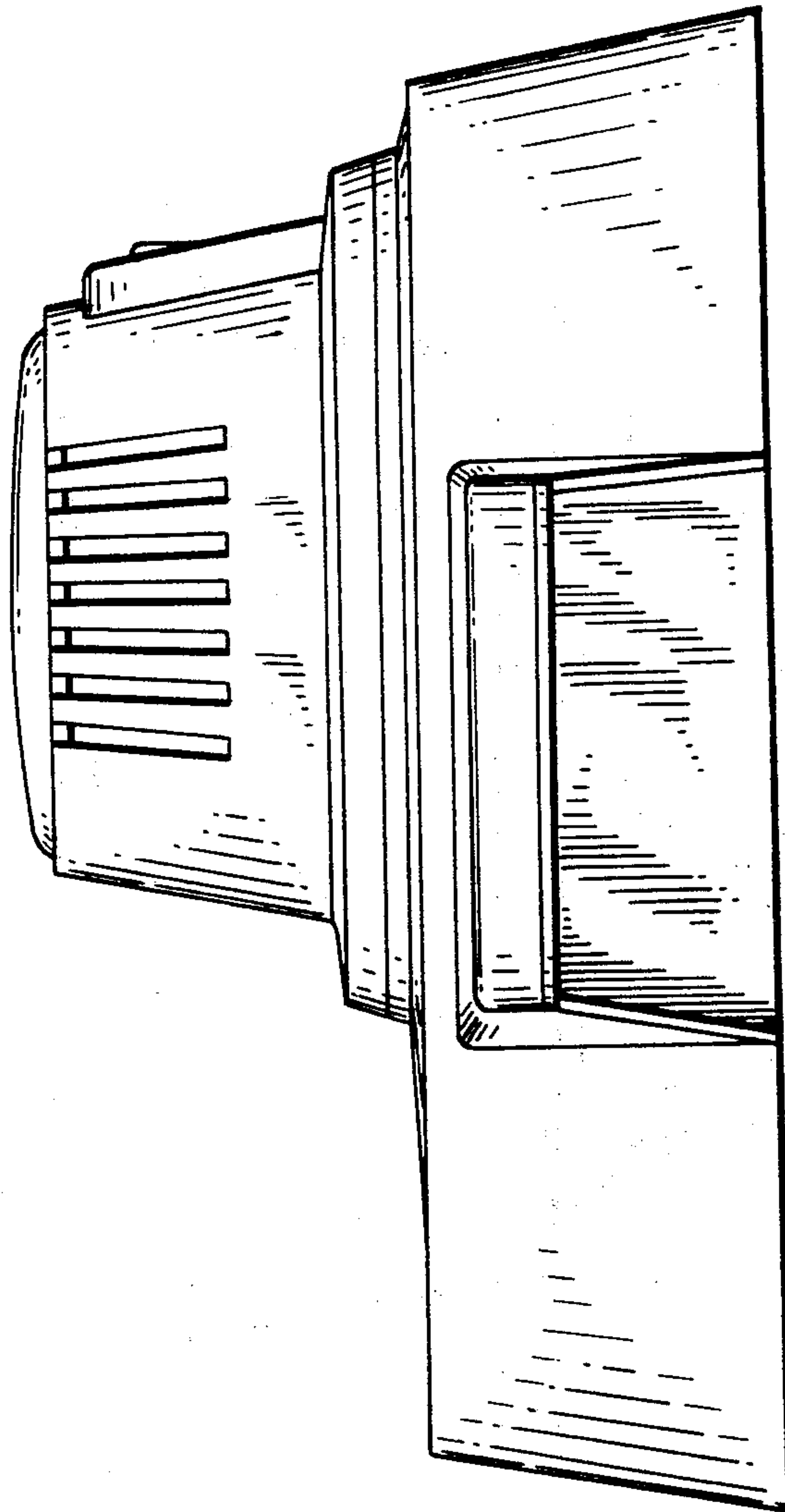

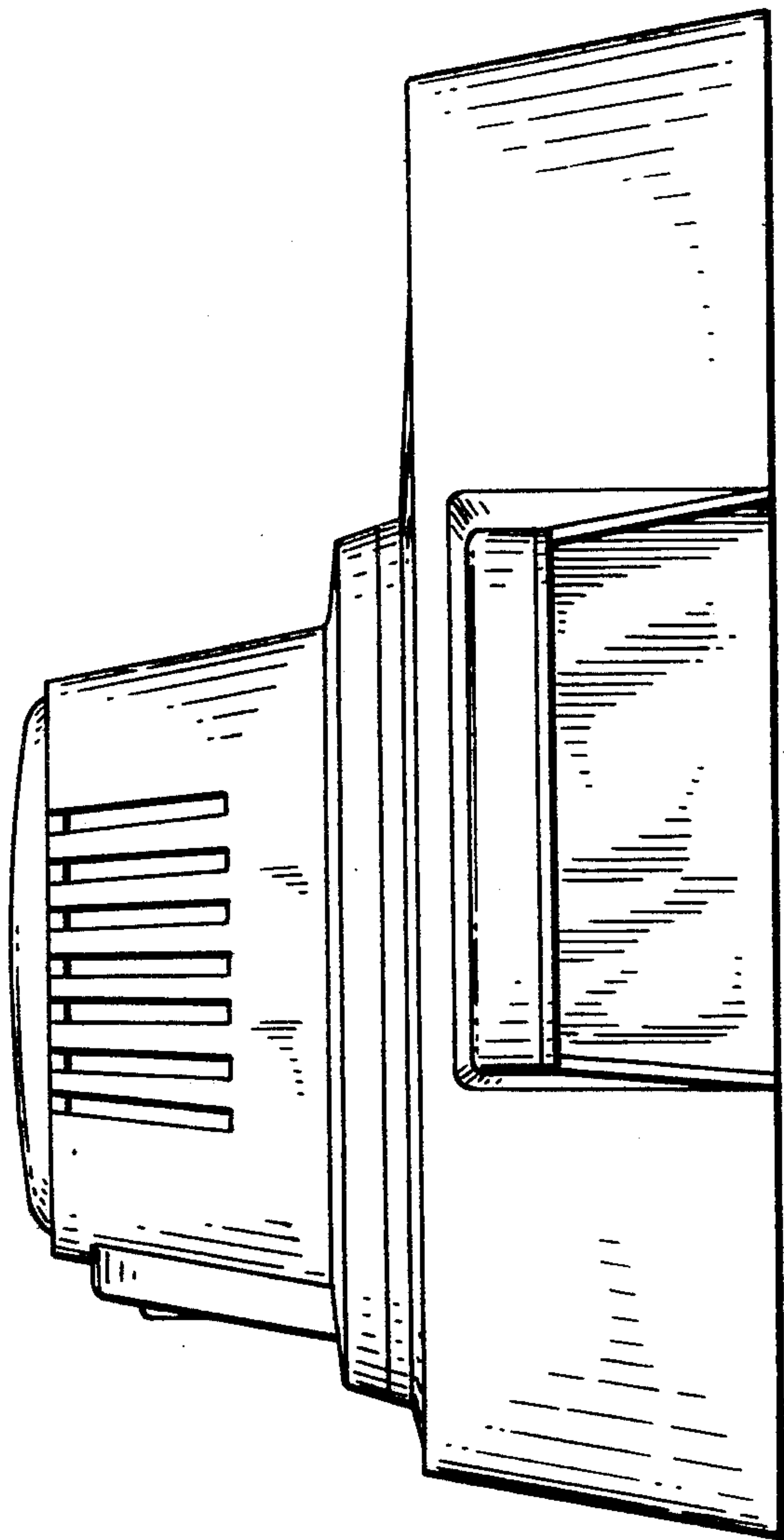
