The ornamental design for a travel case for an electric shoe polishing kit or the like, as shown and described.

DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a front, top and left-side perspective view of a travel case for an electric shoe polishing kit or the like showing our new design;
FIG. 2 is a front elevational view thereof;
FIG. 3 is a left-side elevational view thereof, the right-side elevational view being a mirror image;
FIG. 4 is a top plan view thereof;
FIG. 5 is a bottom plan view thereof; and
FIG. 6 is a rear elevational view thereof.

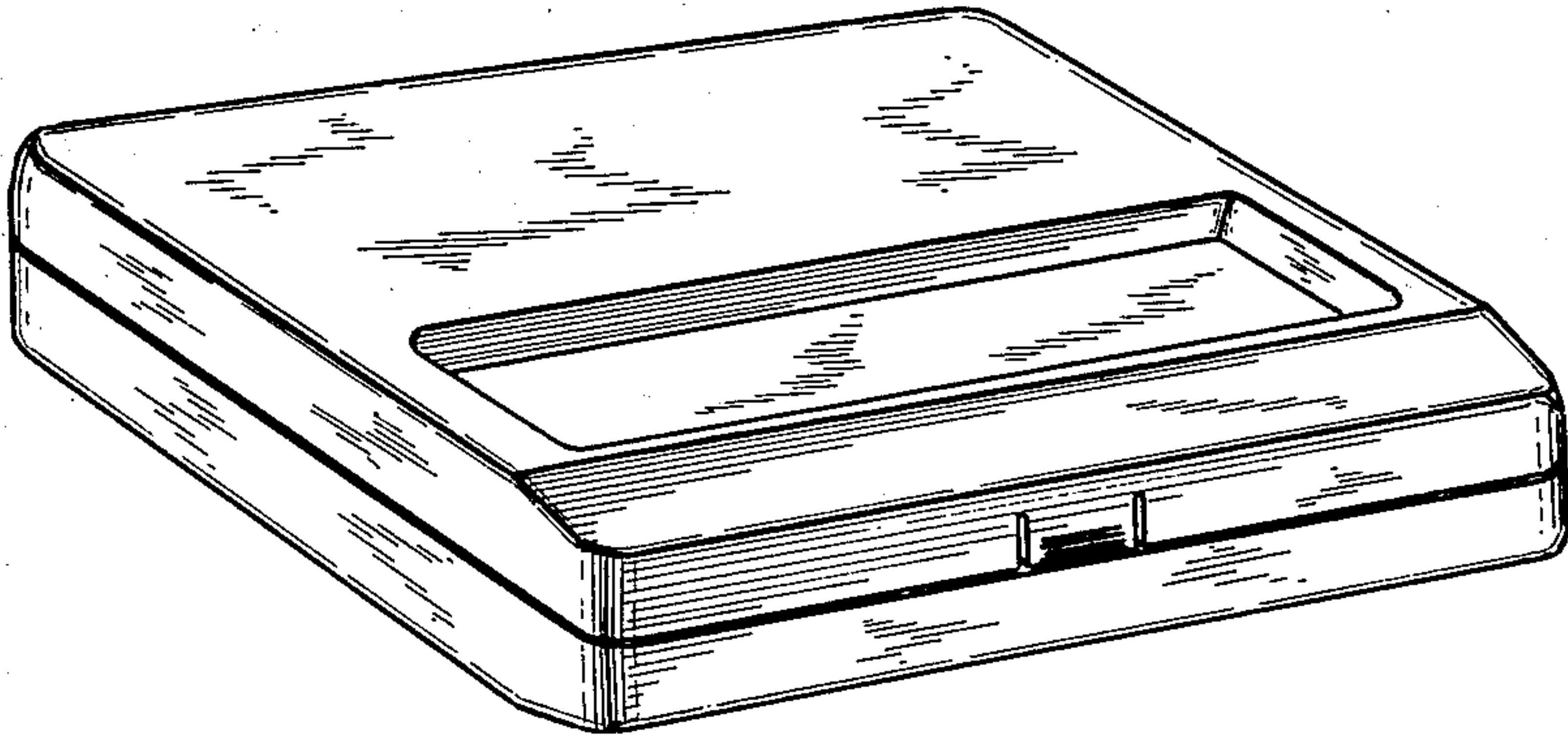

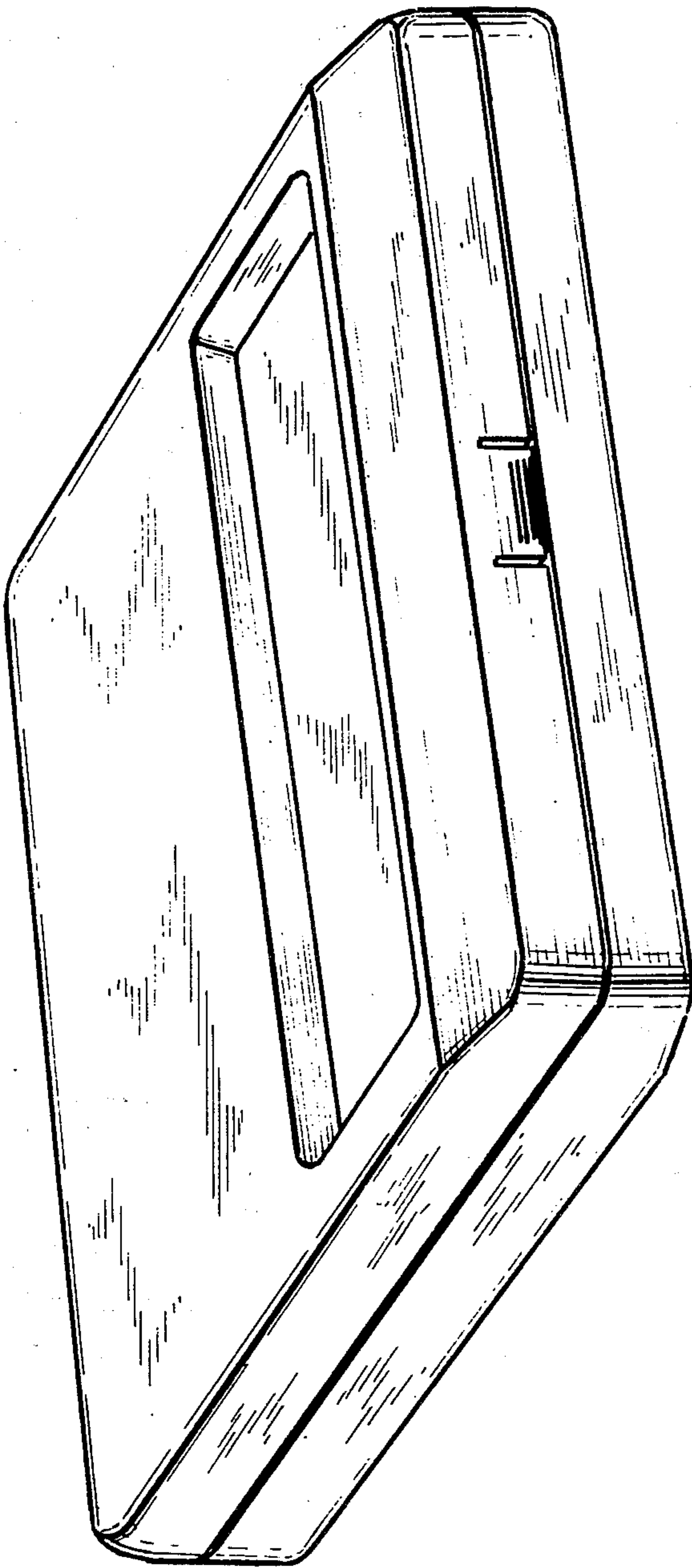

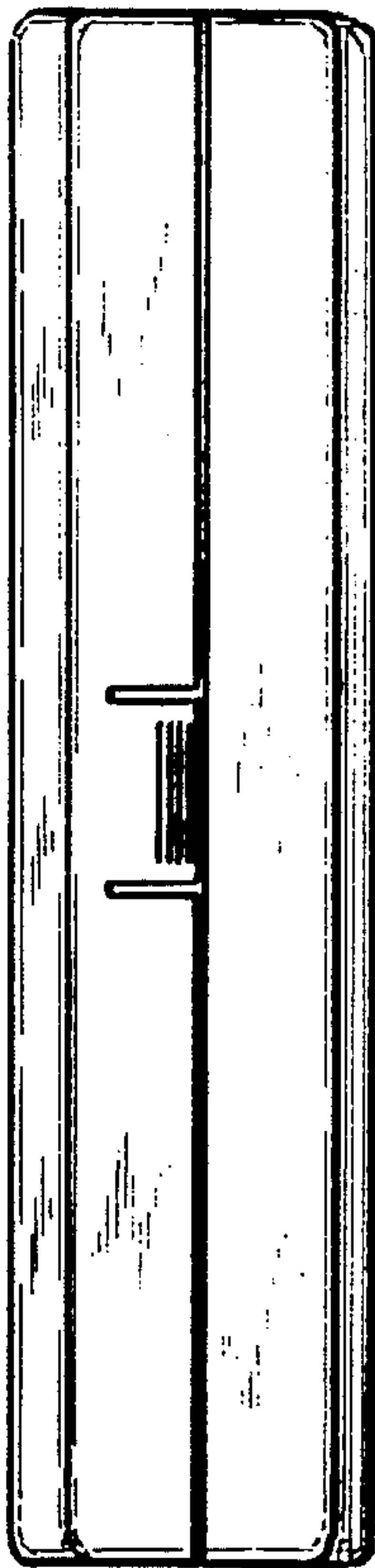

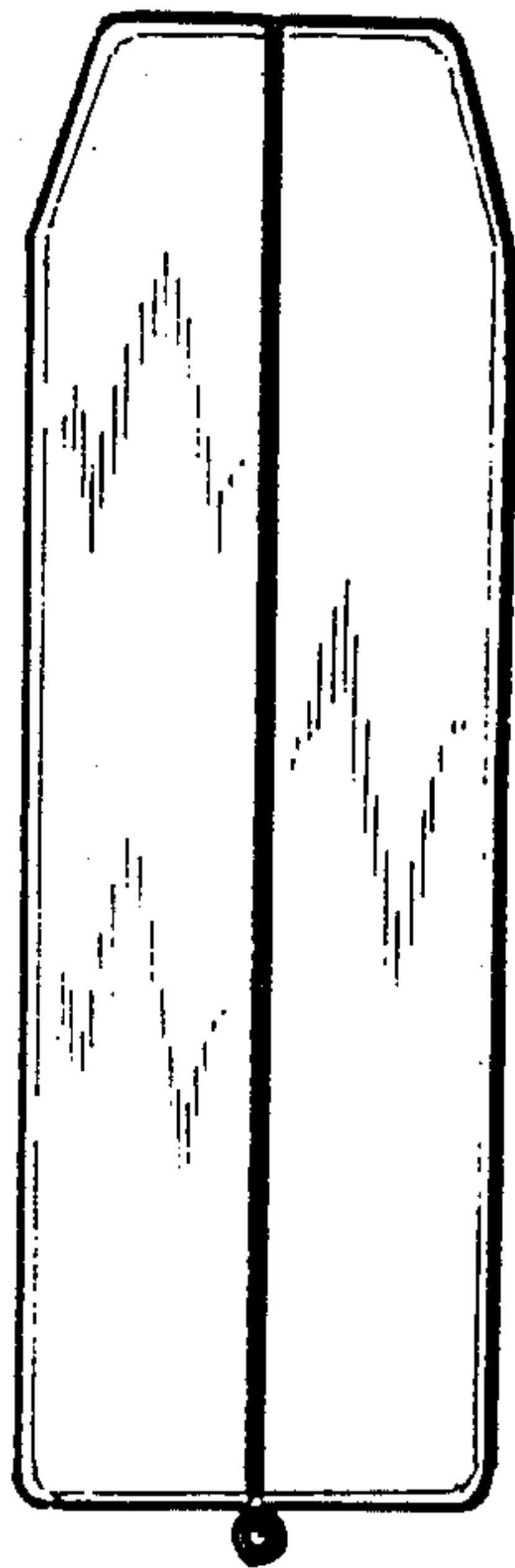

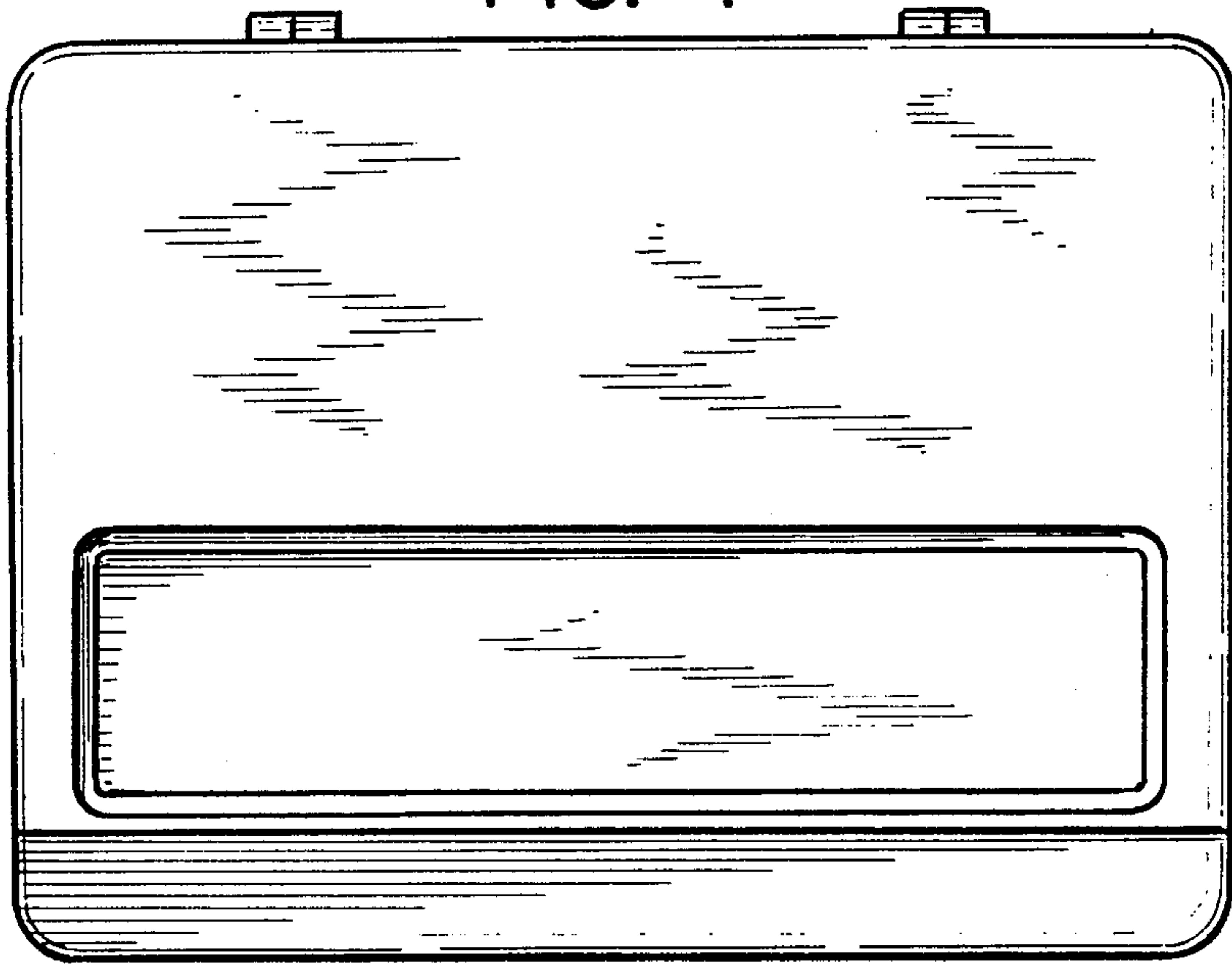

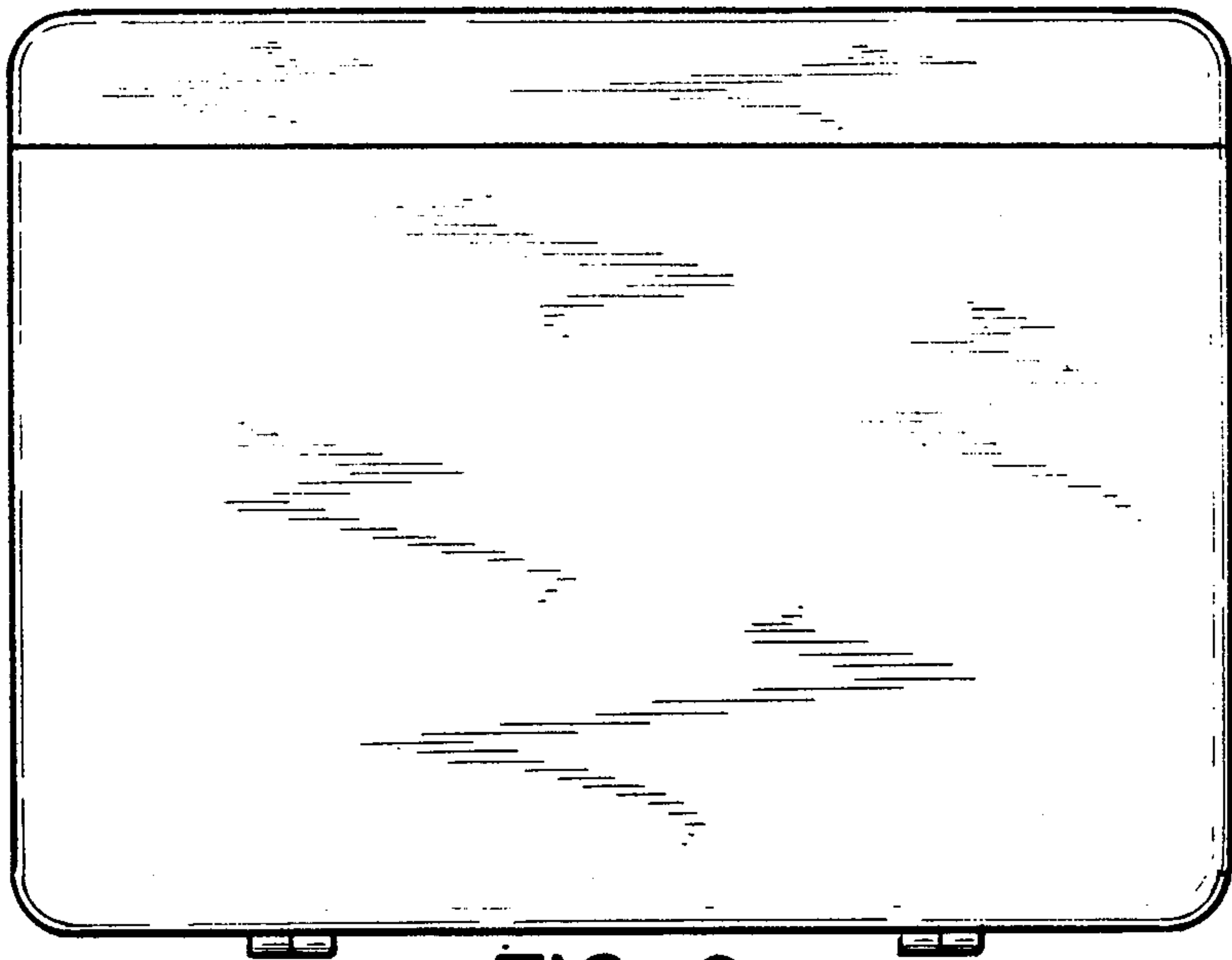
